“Propositions 30 & 32”

Governor Brown has made clear that if Proposition 30 fails there will be billions of dollars of additional cuts made to K-12 public schools in California. No one disputes this fact. Opponents of Proposition 30 have spent millions of dollars claiming the money won’t go to schools or will be wasted by Sacramento bureaucrats, but the ads never claim that the threatened cuts are merely a chimera. California already ranks 47th out of 50 states in per pupil funding for K-12 schools. Deep new cuts will further devastate our public schools.

Several weeks ago Superintendent Gary Woods showed me a draft of what \$6,000,000 in cuts to BHUSD schools will

look like and it’s not pretty. Sacramento politicians have made a mess of our state but California’s voters deserve a fair share of this blame too. Proposition 30 may not be the ideal solution to school funding, but doing nothing is far worse. To counter the claim that higher tax rates lead to lower tax collections, one merely needs to remember the 1993 tax increases implemented by Bill Clinton. Five years later, by 1998, hundred billion dollar federal budget deficits had become hundred billion dollar budget surpluses. Beverly Hills schools face drastic and damaging cuts if Proposition 30 fails.

Proposition 32, which claims to eliminate the “big money special interests” from California politics, is an outright fraud. Informed Beverly Hills voters know that the infamous Citizens United Supreme Court decision guarantees that the real big money interests - insurance and real estate companies, superpacs, and billionaires like the Koch brothers, Charles Munger, Jr. and Sheldon Adelson - have the constitutional protections of the First Amendment. Proposition 32 will destroy the political voices of teachers, nurses, police officers, and fire fighters, and other workers throughout California.

The teachers of Beverly Hills USD ask voters to protect our schools and vote “yes” on Proposition 30. We urge a “no” vote on Proposition 32.

City Council adopts resolution to not take a position in support of Measure J

With two weeks left before the election, the City Council decided 4-1 during a study session on Tuesday it would not take a position in support of Measure J, a ballot measure that would extend the half-cent sales tax increase approved in 2008 by Measure R for an additional 30 years and accelerate public transportation projects. Vice Mayor John Mirisch dissented.

Speakers from the Los Angeles Bus Riders Union, PTA members, Beverly Hills community residents and Board of Education members Lisa Korbatov and Lewis Hall addressed members of the Council Tuesday afternoon. Most spoke against Measure J citing among other reasons: broken promises by Metro, the plan to tunnel under Beverly High and what many called Metro's disregard for the communities.

Beverly Hills resident AJ Willmer spoke in favor of Measure J saying the measure is about whether we will affordably build infrastructure cheaper and faster within a few years, not whether or not the tunneling will go under the high school.

"The courts will decide whether or not it will go under the high school. Let's hope we win. Let's hope it doesn't go under the high school," he said. "Then you would want Measure J."

Councilmember Julian Gold said he personally "hated" Measure J and agreed with the sentiment that many speakers felt that Metro had offended the community. He reiterated that he did not support tunneling under Beverly High, but he struggled with the role of the council.

"I'm struggling with what my role is sitting up here," he said, "to vote as I personally feel or as a ballot initiative, is this something we want people to decide? Is it appropriate to sort of vote for everybody in the city?"

Councilmember Lili Bosse said she felt the role of the Council was to represent the community and felt they should stand with the Board of Education and make clear to the region that the Council was "No on Measure J."

Councilmember Barry Brucker did not feel the Council was prepared to take a position without a drafted resolution.

"Make certain, this Council has been and continues to be in opposition of tunneling under our historic buildings and the heart of Beverly Hills High School. That position has not changed and in that respect we are standing side by side and hand in hand with our school district and community," he said.

Mirisch said a drafted resolution was not necessary and to say the Council unanimously opposes Measure J would be enough.

"We cannot condone Measure J by supporting or staying silent on it. We can just say no. I believe we need to stand by the schools," he said.

Mayor Willie Brien said the Beverly Hills business community has come out in

favor of Measure J. He said he opposed the route, but the measure was about funding. If passed, Measure R and J would bring \$50 million to Beverly Hills for use in local roadways and projects, he said.

"It's not fair to say that you cannot support the schools if you don't oppose Measure J," he said.

Julian Gold said he hoped the Council could come to a unanimous agreement

The council recessed for 30 minutes so Brucker and Bosse could draft a resolution. Mirisch said the resolution did not address civil rights or spending and that "not supporting" and "opposing" was not the same thing.

Specialty Surgery Center wins appeal hearing on 2-1 vote

The City Council voted in favor of an appeal by Specialty Surgery Center on Tuesday evening. Councilmember Barry Brucker voted against the appeal.

"I do believe in this case we have a blend of a horse and camel," said Councilmember Barry Brucker. "Surgeons perform surgeries. In my opinion, SSC provides OR facilities, pre-post [operation] facilities, nursing, equipment and medication taking that right off of Mr. [Allan] Cooper's letter and subsequently charges a facility fee to the insured or the patient and I took that right off the SSC filing from Symbion."

Vice Mayor John Mirisch said the Specialty case was a matter of common sense.

"Common sense to me says seeing that the business of what surgery centers engage in is not a form of commercial rental as it is being practiced, at least by SSC," said Mirisch.

He said he believed that government is focused too much on generating revenue and the city should not "treat its residents or businesses like ATMS."

Specialty may have benefited from fact that Councilmember Julian Gold and Mayor Willie Brien, who are both physicians, recused themselves. Had they not done so, the vote may have been 3-2 in favor of the staff decision.

Allan Cooper, the attorney representing Specialty, said that Gold's and Brien's votes may have increased the margin by which Specialty won the appeal or it could have tipped the scales.

"I respect [Brucker's] different point of view," said Cooper. "What was telling about what he said at the end, he suggested maybe Los Angeles [who taxes surgery centers as professionals] doesn't know what surgery centers do or maybe they don't care because they pay on a gross receipts basis. What that says to me that it's really not the classification that matters to him but it's how they're taxed and he doesn't like the way professionals are taxed in the city."

According to city officials, a 2005 audit found the center was not filing under the appropriate tax classification and owed \$5.5 million in back taxes, penalties and interest.

Specialty Surgery Center had been filing under classification C, which is intended for professionals and semi professionals, such as physicians and lawyers. These businesses are taxed relative to the number of

employees and hours worked. Classification F is intended for businesses that lease commercial space. They are taxed based on gross receipts of approximately \$23.53 per \$1,000.

Specialty physicians and supporters maintained that they were providing professional services. City officials had previously concluded Specialty needed to register in both classifications C and F.

Fine Art Commission discusses locations for Obelisk and Derby; moves forward on Millard Sheets Mural installation

The Fine Art Commission discussed the relocation of the Derby piece above the Bvlgari building at a commission meeting on Oct. 18. The piece satisfied the building obligation when Bvlgari created the building. Since Louis Vuitton acquired the building, company representatives have determined they would like to donate the piece to the city.

The Derby piece was in reference to the famous Brown Derby restaurant that once operated that location.

"Nothing is happening as of yet," said Fine Art Commission Chair Terri Smooke. "There are questions whether moving affects the obligation or how it would affect the art."

Nancy Hunt-Coffey, staff for the Fine Art Commission, said the commission discussed relocating the Derby piece to Coldwater Park, but the Recreation and Parks Commission would like to study the location further.

The Fine Art Commission also recommended Joan Brown's *Center Obelisk* be placed in Roxbury Park. The Fine Art Commission had previously discussed placing the *Obelisk* outside the library on Rexford Drive near Kelly's Coffee.

Recreation and Parks Commission said it would like to study that location further and

look at other possible locations at its Oct. 23 meeting.

The Fine Art Commission has also continued work on the Fine Art Ordinance. Smooke said the commission was tightening the information so there was less confusion and the process would be clearer to developers.

Rosa Lowinger and Associates has restored Tony Smith's *Playground* and will be moving on to Henri Alfred Marie Jacquemart's *Hunter and Hounds* located in Beverly Gardens Park and *Spiral of Life* on the southeast corner of Rexford and Burton Way.

"The commission had already prioritized those two works," said Hunt-Coffey "They had Rosa first go out and evaluate conditions and ran them based on what needed attention first so *Spiral of Life* and *Hunter and Hounds* were high on the list."

The Fine Art Commission also discussed how the *Millard Sheets Mural* will be installed. The lowest bid to install the mural was estimated at \$273,440 by First California Construction, according to Hunt-Coffey.

"The next step is for the commission to meet with council liaison to discuss and then take a recommendation to the full council," said Hunt-Coffey.

The mural, which once hung at the Beverly Wilshire Hotel, has been in storage for about 20 years and will be placed above the Civic Center parking lot. It was gifted to the City after a hotel renovation and has been in storage since. The commission is making decisions on how it will be installed, said Smooke.

Plensa's "Endless" to arrive in first weeks of November

A piece of art by Spanish artist Jaume Plensa purchased by the city is expected to arrive in Los Angeles in the first few weeks of November, according to commission chair Terri Smooke. *Endless* will be installed in Beverly Gardens Park.

The piece will be stored for three weeks upon arriving in Los Angeles from Spain by L.A. Packing, while a base and lighting is installed for the piece. L.A. Packing will also install the Plensa piece, according to Nancy Hunt-Coffey, staff for the Fine Art Commission.

The City is paying for the artwork with the public art fund, which is maintained by contributions from developers. The City's fine art ordinance requires building devel-

opers to install fine art of a designated value at their properties or contribute to the public fine art fund in lieu of installing art on site.

The sculpture will be part of a sculpture garden featuring Yayoi Kusama's *Hymn of Life: Tulips* and the Roxy Paine's *Erratic*.

The Roxy Paine piece is located at the corner of Crescent Drive and Santa Monica Boulevard. It will be relocated to the west toward corner of Rodeo Drive and Santa Monica Boulevard, said Hunt-Coffey. The Fine Art Commission authorized the cost of a company to relocate the piece at its Oct. 18 meeting.

Restoration on the *Kusama* piece will begin Nov. 5. The piece was under a 10-year warranty by the manufacturer, who will be restoring the piece at no charge, said Hunt-Coffey.

"It's a great team there and I'm just learning what my role is and how to make the blog my own."

Pincus recalls attending Laker games at the forum and his father screaming at the television game when Magic Johnson played against Larry Bird.

"Growing up in Beverly Hills, it's hard not to be a Laker fan," he said. "I have a great appreciation for the Clippers and entire game. I can write or talk about any team at any given moment. [This job] is a chance to do something I love to do and get compensated for it."

As senior NBA writer at HOOPSWORLD.com, where he has worked for the past 10 years, Pincus said he would write about the Lakers probably a few times a month when something interesting would happen. With his new gig at the Lakers Now, Pincus will be blogging about the team about five times a day.

Pincus, whose first day was Sunday when the Lakers fell to the Kings 99-92, said it had been one of his goals going to get his name in the printed publication. He achieved this goal by Monday morning with a contributing by-line in an article by Mike Bresnahan, the *Los Angeles Times* Lakers beat writer.

Readers can expect Laker coverage at both a micro and macro-view, said Pincus. To frequently update the blog, he might look at individual player's statistics, a set of plays or five minutes in a game or offer a larger perspective about how the Lakers fit into the league financially and possible future trades.


He will continue to cover the Clippers and

Ingle, who was 84, passed away Sept. 16.



Beverly Hills resident writes historical fiction tale

Sandra Ramos O'Briant's first novel, *The Sandoval Sisters' Secret of Old Blood*, is a historical fiction novel set around two wealthy and prominent sisters during the Mexican-American War in Santa Fe, N.M.

"There's all of this history behind it and no one had written how the influx of men has affected the women in New Mexico," she said. "There's a strong emphasis on sisterhood: the Sandoval sisters but also sisterhoods that form whenever women get together -- nuns, prostitutes in a brothels, and the women in the streets worried about their husbands, brothers, and sons thrown in jail by Americans."

Though her book is historical fiction, she said some of her inspiration came from a family tale.

"In an old family tale, my mother told me of people heading west on the Santa Fe Trail," she said. "Two Anglo children were adopted by the Sandoval sisters. My grandma was a Sandoval. I couldn't find any proof of it, so I decided I would make up the story."

Her novel is written about three sisters before they adopted the children and their upbringing in Santa Fe. Alma runs off to Texas with her young lover to escape an arranged marriage with an older man. When she leaves, her younger sister Pilar takes her place at the altar. The Mexican-American War begins and Santa Fe is invaded. Oratoria, the eldest, was adopted into the family Sandoval at the age of 5. The story is told from each of the sisters' point of view as they document events in diaries, as had been the practice of the Sandoval family for hundreds of years.


The story also touches on superstition and includes an element of witchcraft and voodoo, O'Briant said.

"When people don't understand something or feel oppressed or are losing their land, livelihood and loved ones, they turn and pick a target," she said.

The book, which she has been working on for 12 years, is the first of a family saga. The next book is centered on the two adopted children who inherit the Sandoval legacy. The first chapter of the second book is called, "First we were O'Reilly's."

O'Briant is married to former Board of Education member Gerald Lunn.

Though this is O'Briant's first novel, her short stories have been featured in various anthologies and online journals. O'Briant's book launch was on Oct. 7 at Vroman's Bookstore in Pasadena. 

Board of Education approves Choicelunch as new lunch provider for K-8 schools

The district approved an agreement with Choicelunch Tuesday night at the board meeting for the 2012-2013 school year. The decision was approved upon receiving a letter from Chartwells, the food service company, would end its five year contract with the district as of Nov. 16.

The district unanimously vote to approve a five year contract with Chartwells in July 2011. When the program began in Sept. 2011, it boasted success and personnel was added to accommodate long lines and student participation.

Board of Education member Jake Manaster said he was under the impression Chartwells ended the contract based on financial reasons. He believed that from a business perspective, it may not have been in Chartwells' interest to continue providing service to the district.

Chartwells bore the cost of the food program. The food program, a cost of about \$500,000, will come out of the district's

general fund. The board also approved termination of four food service workers to decrease costs by \$47,000.

Keith Cosbey, one of the Choicelunch owners, said the company provides food services at 250 schools throughout state, 75 percent of which are private and 25 percent are public.

"We have the only iPhone transactional app in the country for school lunch. It launched last year," he told the board.

The item was approved to not disrupt food service in the district for the K-8 schools. The board has not decided how food will be served at Beverly High. Manaster said the use of branded food was being discussed.

City Council decides not to take action on solid waste equipment operator job description

The City Council unanimously agreed at a special meeting on Tuesday to not take action on amending the job description of the solid waste equipment operator and let negotiations resume between city staff and the Municipal Employees association until Dec 18.

The city said safety concerns were reasons for amending the position to requiring at least one year of experience with operating solid waste machinery.

In the recent years, the city switched from two-axel disposal trucks to three-axel trucks, which are larger. Labor attorney Peter Brown said even experienced drivers have trouble maneuvering down Beverly Hills alleyways.

The department is also switching to natural gas vehicles, which are larger than the three-axel disposal trucks.

"We need to make sure we have people who are qualified to do this job," said Brown.

Greg Gomez, who represented the

Municipal Employees Association, said the main issue was that the one-year qualification blocked the possibility of a promotion.

"Half of current employees have promoted from within the city," said Gomez. "The manager worked his way from helper to manager. This is the type of opportunity

we're asking you not to close the door on current employees."

"One of the things that good for city is it does offer opportunity to advance. I think it's attractive to the city and keeps people here. I wholeheartedly support that," said

The Metro Board of Directors authorized placing Measure J before voters in Los Angeles County. Measure J will extend for 30 additional years the existing one-half cent sales tax that was approved in 2008 and is currently set to expire in 2039 (Measure R). The additional funds will be used to secure bonds, which will allow Metro to accelerate construction of traffic relieving projects and the related job creation. TAP Is Your Ticket

Whatever type of fare you're using, it must be loaded on a TAP card to ride any Metro Rail line or the Metro Orange line. Starting soon in stations with turnstiles, expect them to be locked. Food and politics

And council bites bullet

So, you want to serve your community and run for City Council? If you think that means loads of fun events and an appreciative electorate, take a few hours out of your life and watch last Tuesday's afternoon and evening council meetings, and then run for the Beverly hills.

Not that Tuesday's sessions were all that atypical: with five strong people making tough decisions there are certain to be differences, and in our village never be shocked if that becomes somewhat emotional. We can rush the barricades over the height of a neighbor's hedge, and do battle as if that were to determine the fate of western civilization.

On the table were some tough calls, and yes emotions flowed freely:

How should the council respond to a request from the school board to join them in opposing the MTA sponsored ballot Measure J which would extend the taxing period for funding of mass transit?

Will the council uphold an appeal from a staff decision that could cost the city over \$5 million in tax revenues?

Should immediate neighbors concerns ice plans for a skating rink off Santa Monica Boulevard?

For the record, some observations on what happened and a note of appreciation for the city staff and City Council for some hard calls and for keeping the process fair and open.

Beginning with the least contentious: Everyone supports the concept of an ice skating rink for the holiday season. It will be fun for residents, attract tourists and remind us of a New York tradition. But quite wisely, the council put off a final approval until city staffers and, at the direction of Mayor **Willie Brien**, a City Council liaison committee had an opportunity to consider objections from immediate neighbors.

Sometimes it is impossible to meet resident objections when a broader city need is in play, but here there are options. First, staff and council should see if there are any mitigations that would reduce noise and traffic for residents – and if those are acceptable to neighbors, let the skating begin. If no reasonable or rational protections are possible, the rink should be moved, either to the boat court or another venue with less impact on the quiet enjoyment of homeowners.

Yes, this means losing all the visibility of a rink on one of our most traveled streets, but a month long intrusion right against residential is not really fair. For the record, we raised these issues weeks ago when the site was first proposed. Right call by the City Council.

It was heated, very divisive and no compromise could possibly satisfy all five coun-

cilmembers or community activists, but four members of the council faced reality and adopted the only resolution that had any chance of succeeding on Measure J. The lone dissenter was Vice Mayor **John Mirisch**.

What the council approved was this message: It would not take a position in support of Measure J, not quite the same as urging a NO vote, but also not giving city approval to an extension of an earlier voter approval of financing of the entire mass transit plan.

Obviously, the intent was to send the MTA a message: No tunneling under the high school or we, Beverly Hills, will fight any tax plan for mass transit.

Time for some reality: What happens to J will have little or no impact on the tunneling decision. In fact, the whole question of tunneling has been so overblown as to detract from some very serious questions about the impact of a subway on our village, and this has done a horrendous disservice to future residents. Passing resolutions, creating near hysteria about route choices and scaring the hell out of the community has been an exercise in political futility.

No matter what the rhetoric now, there will never be a tunnel under any part of the high school where classes are held. Would I prefer a Santa Monica route choice? Of course. However, it is long past the time when we can disregard the science and safety concerns.

Now, what are the equally important questions we should be asking? And let me preface that by agreeing with those who support mass transit expansion for the Los Angeles basin; just not sure that should mean any subway through Beverly Hills.

1. According to the MTA's own original traffic study, traffic may not be reduced by a subway. There are some obvious reasons: First, a subway may bring massive new development to the Westside, mitigating against removing auto travel. Second, without park and ride and other supportive elements, just as with a subway in Florida, the mass transit option may not lead to people giving up the family gas burner.

2. What impact will subway construction have on Wilshire Boulevard? How will it affect one of our most significant revenue sources: hotels, major department stores and large office buildings? The negative effects could damage us for decades.

3. Aren't there more important priorities for spending of mass transit dollars including a subway to the airport from the Central City and, probably more difficult, mass transit from Western Los Angeles to the Valley, just maybe to make our connecting canyons more usable?

These are questions we should be asking

instead of focusing entirely on the tunneling question. But also, if all those millions being spent on lobbyists to fight the MTA plan are working, why do we even need a quixotic political movement that will not even be felt for decades to come?

Mass transit, yes. It bring jobs, just might make streets more livable and we too are a part of the economy of Southern California. But without prejudging all the other major questions we should be asking, the tunneling battle, often far too rough house, selfish and political, has not served our community. I, for one, really want to know what this will do to our most important boulevard, Wilshire –for all the economic and safety reasons that are so obvious, and to future growth. Even the young editors of the high school newspaper “get it.”

But the hardest call of the night was on how to tax surgery centers. Tuesday, the council voted by a two to one margin to “forgive” \$5.5 million dollars in tax revenues – not an insignificant amount of money as we struggle to meet city revenue needs.

In a move to obviate any possible questions of conflict, our two doctor- councilmembers, Willie Brien and **Julian Gold**, recused themselves, leaving the decision to Mirisch and Councilmembers **Barry Brucker** and **Lili Bosse**. Brucker opposed, and Mirisch and Bosse supported the appeal.

Bosse did an incredible job in first studying and then analyzing and explaining the history of the whole surgery center tax methodology.

Brucker, while dissenting from his colleagues, asked some very important questions, facing down the often overly sardonic and contentious attorney for the appellant, even though, admittedly, he won and was prepared.

Also, this was Vice Mayor John Mirisch's first major role as presiding officer, and he handled the gavel with consideration and fairness, even urging an audience that was on his side of the argument, to show restraint.

There is a side issue, and avoiding going into the merits of the decision, it was interesting to note that some of the same people who fought medical use at a Robertson and Wilshire building, supported a possibly more intensive traffic generator – a surgery center, at many other city venues. In fact, one of the strongest supporters of the surgery center made the argument that the city was far too hostile to medical, and this resulted in many empty rentals on the east side of the city.

Without even judging the merits of the pending law suits – and we always argue for compromises instead of litigation, isn't it time to make a real effort to find some reasonable solution to the Robertson/Wilshire medical use option?

If a sense of community responsibility is a factor in judging a conflict, the **Kobar** family, owners of the property, have earned our respect and merit one more effort at working out a rational plan that would per-

mit them to rent space to doctors. They do not herald their support, and do so with real humility, but their civic generosity is very real. At the very least, this should earn them one more shot at a settlement outside the courtroom. If this can be resolved, the city too will be a fiscal winner. But mostly, the Kobars have merited a shot at compromise. They have paid their dues far more than an east coast surgery center conglomerate – and they are part of our community, and have been in a most responsible manner for many years.

FOOD FOR THOUGHT

This merits much more space, but the major changes in the design, and even menus, of Spago's are enormous. The interior, designed by **Waldo Fernandez**, has given the restaurant an entirely new look from the entrance to the two separate dining areas and includes a retractable roof in the garden,

Portions are smaller, selections broader, but service is even more professional and attentive. The mixologist may need some retraining on the making of a Bloody Mary.

The overall impression is very good, but I liked and was very comfortable with the way it looked and felt before. However, maybe a more intense look soon. After all, as long as **Wolf Puck** runs his shop, all is well.

My lunch friend was **Fred Hayman**, and we had an interesting visitor with some news: **Linda Schwartz** said she and founder and former publisher of the Beverly Hills Courier **March Schwartz**, were endorsing and are strong supporters of Dr. Willie Brien's bid for reelection.

This is not to imply any endorsement by The Courier. That decision is up to the current owner. Incidentally, March is totally alert and looks excellent.

And speaking of the council race, we should have mentioned earlier that former Mayor **Nancy Krasne** will be a candidate in the election, something she confirmed to us this week. She is certain to enliven the contest and will be a major contender, no matter who else runs.

LOCAL HERO. We generally don't honor people who have decided to live in Minnesota, but an easy exception is this week's Local Hero, **Amy McHarg**, who did such an incredible job as assistant for the City Council before moving to the far north.

Amy had that rare and needed quality of never being flustered or frustrated by the demands of her job and doing her work with class, style and professionalism. No matter the status of the person needing help, Amy was always resourceful and totally courteous. She was an incredible asset to the city in handling the needs of staff and councilmembers, and she will be missed. For her always cheerful, optimistic and helpful service, we make her this week's Local Hero, something we should have done while she was still serving our community.

Councilmember Julian Gold. "That said, notion of a 50,000 pound truck driving down 15 to 20 foot alley in the hands of someone who hasn't done that before gives me quite a bit of pause both in the public safety and safety of people driving the vehicles."

The city had decreased the number of personnel and trucks making it difficult to train employees on the job where before the city had the ability to provide in house training, the city no longer has those resources, according to James Burnley, solid waste manager.

Brown presented examples of how employees might get training elsewhere outside of the city, but those details had not yet been worked out.

"I do have concerns about both sides. Safety has to be a critical component of any decision we have to make. I don't think putting someone new behind a truck is a good idea. On the flip side, even experienced drivers have significant problems," said Mayor Brien. "The best way to hire people is to hire from within because you know who they are and already have understanding of their qualities and work ethic."

Negotiations will resume between the city and the Municipal Employee Association.

BHHS Football Team Shut Out By Morningside

The Beverly High football team was one inch away from having the opportunity to take a fourth-quarter lead in its Ocean League game against Morningside Friday night at Coleman Stadium, according to Norman coach Donald Paysinger, when it was called for a rare penalty.

"They called an illegal procedure penalty on us, saying that the center turned the ball," Paysinger said. "I've never had that penalty called on me ever in life."

The penalty came during a series of eight plays when Beverly Hills had the ball inside the Monarchs' 10-yard line. The Normans were unable to score and Morningside scored a touchdown on the ensuing drive and added a two-point conversion for a 14-0 victory.

Beverly Hills (1-7, 0-3 in league play) also had the ball inside the Monarchs' 20-yard line five other times, Paysinger said.

The Normans' inability to score is the result of opposing defenses knowing "we cannot throw the ball, so they put nine guys at the line of scrimmage and we only have six guys (to) block nine," Paysinger said.

The loss was Beverly Hills' sixth in a row and marked the second consecutive game it was shut out and third time this season. The Normans were held to seven points or less in three other games.

Morningside opened the scoring with a touchdown pass in the third quarter, but missed the conversion to take a 6-0 lead.

The bright spots for Beverly Hills were its defense, which "kept us in a position to win the game" and Sajun Bibbs, who had two long kickoff returns and a long punt return, Paysinger said.

The Normans are scheduled to play host to Hawthorne (1-7, 0-3) Friday night at Nickoll Field in their homecoming game

and final home game. The opening kickoff for the Ocean League game is set for 7 p.m.

Sophomore quarterback Michael Massie will make his first varsity start for Beverly Hills. Paysinger said he decided to make the switch from Zack Bialobos "to give us a different look."

"He's able to run the ball," Paysinger said of Massie. "He can throw the ball."

BHHS Runners Record Victory, Second-Place Finish at Mt. SAC Invitational

Beverly High finished second in its 25-team Division 3 boys' race in the Mt. SAC Cross Country Invitational Friday.

Senior Eli Flesch was the top Norman finisher, finishing third, completing the three-mile blue course in 15 minutes, 54 seconds. Senior Chanan Batra was the next Beverly Hills finisher, finishing eighth in 16:14 to third.

The Normans finished with 108 points, 58 fewer than third-place Esperanza. Laguna Hills won with 87.

Buena Park senior Gilbert Solorza won in 15:39, two seconds ahead of Santa Margarita senior Jason Engel.

Beverly Hills senior Sydney Segal was a winner for the second consecutive year, completing the three-mile blue course in 18:22, five seconds ahead of runner-up Jeanette Zambrano of Bolsa Grande.

The Normans finished fifth in the 18-team race with 157 points, five fewer than sixth-place finisher Bolsa Grande, and 30 more than fourth-place finisher Mater Dei. Laguna Hills won with 43.

The meet is billed by organizers as the world's largest cross country competition.

BHHS Boys' Water Polo Team Loses to Brentwood, El Segundo

Beverly High lost at Brentwood, 12-8, in a nonleague boys' water polo game Sept. 27 with David Prokopenko scoring three goals for the Normans, including two in the second quarter.

Beverly Hills goaltender Hans Tercek made five saves.

Bernardo DiPietro, David Hakakian, Justin Kim, Frosty Poppadinkus and Keon Youssefzadeh also scored for the Normans.

Beverly Hills trailed 4-1 at the end of the first quarter and was unable to get any closer than two goals after the Eagles scored four minutes, 46 before halftime to take a 5-2 lead.

The Normans trailed 7-3 at halftime and 10-6 entering the fourth quarter.

Beverly Hills lost to El Segundo, 14-7, in its Ocean League opener Oct. 3 at the Swim-Gym, with Rafalian scoring four goals and Tercek making eight saves.

The Normans (7-7) allowed the first three goals and trailed 4-2 at the end of the first quarter. Rafalian and Maggio scored for Beverly Hills. Johnathan Combs scored all four of the Eagles' goals.



BEVERLY HILLS' FIRST LADY

Dr. Connie Brien discusses politics, family and life in Beverly Hills

So you and Willie met when you were both medical students at UCLA?

That's correct. We met when we were third year medical students and we were both working on a general surgery rotation at Wadsworth VA, UCLA's veterans' administration hospital, and surprisingly we were both working on a urology rotation which pretty much was taking care of expressly male patients who had lots of problems with their reproductive anatomy, so it was kind of humorous that we were working at the same time on this particular rotation, but we got to know each other and had some fun after that and made medical school really great.

He comes from a very political family. Was that intimidating at all?

Oh, absolutely. I grew up in Riverside and Laguna, and my family were engineers. No one was in medicine, but no one was involved in politics at all either and there were things that were imposing about Willie that had little to do with who he was. I already thought it was intimidating the fact that he was a resident of the city of Beverly Hills. That was an intimidating thing because I had all of these preconceived notions about who lived in Beverly Hills and I felt that it wouldn't be anyone that I had anything in common with. When we met I thought, "Oh, this is kind of a negative. We'll see how this works out." And when I learned about his mother and her father and the legacy of the Warren family, it was just another thing for me to be intimidated by. So at the beginning, I wasn't very sure about whether this boy and I had anything in common other than medicine, but then again, it turned out great.

So, were you surprised when he went into politics?

Not at all. In fact, I knew it would happen by the very nature of how he participates in everything. He tends towards a leadership position of any group he's ever involved with. When he began participating in coaching the kids in AYSO soccer, it was just irresistible to him to start to merge into the commissioner role and division directors. He assumed leadership positions in all of the kids' sporting events and organizations that they were involved in, so in soccer he moved onto the board of directors. When our kids started playing little league baseball, he started participating with the board of directors. He can't help himself. He enjoys helping to organize things, so it was never a surprise that he would try to help

organize things on the city level.

You lived in New York City after medical school for a while.

We did. Yes, one our children [Brent] was born there. From 1988 to 1989, we lived in Manhattan. Willie was in training doing his fellowship at Sloan Kettering Hospital and that's affiliated with another hospital called the Hospital for Special Surgery and in the world of orthopedic surgery, the Hospital for Special Surgery was and probably continues to be one of the most prestigious places for training in the world.

Tell us about your full time medical practice.

I'm an obstetrician. So I'm a board certified OB/GYN and I did additional training in a subspecialty called maternal fetal medicine and its a subspecialty that's involved in helping take care of patients with more complicated pregnancies and very much

study science and math. Those are essentially the subjects that came easy to me so I took science and math classes because they required less effort than things where you had to use words. I'm not a writer. My parents encouraged me to pursue a path as a pre-med student for traditional medical school. I wasn't sure that's what I wanted but I knew I wanted to take the science classes so to please my parents I applied to medical school. Then, when you got to medical school, it all came together. Just the thirst for the infor-

involved in the area that is called prenatal diagnosis, that is, the opportunity to learn about the health and wellbeing of the fetus. I do a lot of genetic counseling -- genetic testing of the fetus and amniocentesis and certain genetic screening tests -- so I work as a consultant for obstetricians. Patients come to me by a referral from their obstetrician to evaluate, to tell them that the fetus is fine and that the mother is fine. The other part of my practice is taking care of women that develop medical problems during pregnancy and they maybe would require medications for a variety of different medical treatments. I participate in helping to decide what the proper medicine is that would be both safe for the baby as well as the mother. Even though I'm an OB/GYN, my practice doesn't involve any GYN. It's all based on the care of a pregnant patient.

Why did you pursue a field in medicine?

So, when I was an undergraduate, I went to UCLA and I entered thinking I loved to

mation became obvious so I thought it was fantastic. And I still love practicing medicine because I love the science. In medical school, I loved surgery, really. It was very satisfying to fix something. As a math person, it is nice when there's an answer. So, in surgery, its precision was very appealing to me. But I wasn't sure that I was like all the other surgeons because I think I like to talk a little bit more. I also liked talking to my patients and learning about them and socializing and OB offered a little more opportunity to participate in people's lives when it was a wonderful time in their life. The anticipation of a newborn is pretty exciting. I also get to work as someone who's making a decision and I get to be the end of the specialty.

Is it difficult to manage your time between a full-time practice and attending events with the mayor?

Oh yeah. My whole life has been pretty crazy as far as juggling. I mean, raising four

kids while working and have a husband who's doing a lot of things at the same time, it's been a real challenge. I don't think every woman wants to be working full time or be a professional. There are a lot of other options that everybody has and I think they're all great. I think every individual gets to choose now whereas 50 years ago, everybody didn't have the choices. I actually have probably more of like a three-quarter practice. It's not really full time. I do have a lot of afternoons off. I have the enormous good fortune of having a business associate who is flexible and equally dedicated to his family, so the two of us, over working together for 22 years have managed to figure out the balance so that I really could, if there was an emergency, leave the office and run home. I honestly didn't miss soccer practices, baseball practices, swimming practices, and horseback riding lessons. I mean I've been running around sporting events to participate with my kids the whole time. To have an equally busy husband, now my kids are in college, to attend events is just another thing that was going to happen in the afternoon. There are times when Willie's responsibilities overlap some with my business responsibilities, so I can't attend every event or I can't leave town on some of the opportunities he's had to go on some of the mayor's conventions and things like that. I have to say, Willie and I have found a pretty good way to balance things. We didn't miss much with raising the kids and having them play sports. So I think that it's been a good journey. I did have another wonderful situation where my in-laws were within walking distance of my house. So my kids' grandparents participated with them on a daily level, which was great.

Tell us more about your family.

Oh they're great. They're so much fun. My oldest, his name is Willie Jr. He attended Beverly Hills schools and went to Yale undergrad and now he's at Harvard as a third year law student. He is a relaxed, unpretentious, wonderful smart kid who makes everything look really easy. He's looking forward to returning to Los Angeles and he will be working at a law firm starting next year when he graduates. It's very satisfying to me that my eldest will be returning home. The second child, Brent, he also attended Beverly Hills schools. Brent went to Carnegie Mellon University. He was a Bio major thinking he was pre-med and finished as a business major and now he's a first year law student in the University of Minnesota. He's our entrepreneurial son. He started several businesses when he was in college. He also set up a non-profit for consumer protection and consumer advocacy. He initially entered law school with the intent of concentrating on consumer advocacy and apparently the University of Minnesota has a very good consumer advocacy program so that's why he landed there. My third, Kelly, is now a senior at the University of Colorado at Boulder completely enjoying Boulder and everything it has to offer. I think it will require a lot of effort for us to get her to come home. She should be finishing in December and I really want her to come home. She was

a swimmer at Beverly and she was a very good equestrian as well. She didn't spend as much time as my other daughter but she loved riding horses, too. She's a psych major and she's not exactly sure what she wants to do when she graduates. The fourth child, her name is Ashley. She just graduated from high school, and she is a freshman at Duke University. She's the equestrian and so, she's settling in and getting to understand North Carolina a little bit. I'm an empty nester. It's a little bit sad.

You're an equestrian as well.

I started riding as a child when we lived in Riverside. I rode mostly western and then I started riding English there and jumping. I had my own horse. [It was] not a sophisticated, competitive environment. I just loved being there. There was something that was so peaceful about being around the horses and being able to take care of them. When the kids got older, I decided that I wanted everyone in the family to ride horses because I thought it was an important skill. They all learned how to ride somewhat reluctantly and then it was with the fourth child [Ashley] when it finally stuck. Although every vacation, I take the entire family horseback riding, wherever we are, in any country, I can always find horses. But the little one, when it cooked with her, that was when we bought our first horse, and we bought her a little pony when she was 9. Then she started competing and then it became really her passion, so now she and I have had a chance to share the sport, although she competes and I do not. I did when I was in high school. I actually think I will in the future, but all of our effort was helping her to be in an area where she could be competing. She's riding in college. She rides on the equestrian team at Duke. There are opportunities to compete even in our 50s so I probably will start competing at some point, but to me it's just about being there and riding. I love it.

What do you love about Beverly Hills?

So, first off, my introduction to Beverly Hills was through my husband when I met his friends who he attended high school with. When I got to know his friends and I saw how close they all were and they all loved Beverly High so much and they all maybe they went away for their undergraduate education but everybody seemed to come back. The magnetism of Beverly



Hills at bringing these very successful, well-educated individuals back to the city was unusual for me. Everybody wanted to come back to Beverly Hills. I thought, "This is kind of a special place." Why are these people so close? I think it has to do with growing up in a small community and the way the school system was set up, they had an opportunity to really develop life long friendships. That was very appealing to me as far as raising my own kids. And the other thing I found was so nice was that I realized how uninformed I was on

who the people of Beverly Hills are. When we began raising children, we moved to Beverly Hills, deliberately -- both of us were professionals and we wanted to live near one set of grandparents. I was again somewhat intimidated thinking I'd never be able to fit in to such a fancy place and when we began meeting other families who were raising their children, you realize it's a community of genuine, hardworking, hon-

est people. It's such a remarkable place and it really isn't a group of wealthy pretentious individuals, which is what other people might assume. I find that it's inspiring that so many great people work so hard to participate in their community and also raise their children here and try to make the city and southern California a better place. I've lived in Beverly Hills now for 23 years and I feel like it's my home town, too.

Have you ever considered a life in politics yourself?

Oh no. [laughs] I recognize it's important and I think that there are people who are really very good at it. I am a social outgoing person. I thoroughly love taking care of my patients and I love meeting people. I'm not a public speaker. I'm very uncomfortable in terms of being in front of large groups of people speaking formally. I had a great opportunity to participate as a commissioner on the solicitations commission for six years and I thoroughly enjoyed that which was more getting at the nuts and bolts of philanthropy and understanding the challenges of fundraising from the opinion or the perspective of the fundraising organization, but also from the perspective of the commissioner where our charge in our commission actually was to protect our generous citizens from participating in charitable events or fundraising endeavors that really weren't efficient or helpful to the designated charity. I would love to be a commissioner again, when I have more time. Public works would be my passion. Maybe because I'm kind of a scientist and public works is kind of like the physiology of the city, isn't it? Isn't it about the set up and the architecture or the infrastructure? How the city works is very interesting to me, maybe because it's kind of like a human body. If I was going to serve on a commission again, that's where I would go.

Where do you see yourself in five years?

I don't know, probably traveling around to visit my kids wherever they're living at that time. In five years, my life will be different because my children will have finished with the majority of their education. I imagine I will still be working. I always thought I'd be working because I enjoy it that much. I love the science and I love my patients. Maybe working a little less and traveling more and enjoying my family and the next part of their lives.

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
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
