

## “A Who’s Who Of Events”

What if a group of people checked into a local hotel, held a magnificent party which you were specifically prohibited from attending, and then proceeded to send you the bill? If you live in Beverly Hills, that is exactly what happened earlier this month [covered in issue #349], and we all should be outraged by it. From June 1-4, 2006, a private organization known as the Academy of Achievement commandeered a sizable chunk of the business district surrounding the Regent Beverly Wilshire Hotel as they proceeded to host a four day conference of prominent people from around the world. The residents of Beverly Hills were denied entrance to this area by security paid for by, you guessed it, the citizens of Beverly Hills, to the tune of about \$400,000.

The Academy of Achievement, founded by wealthy Washington D.C.-area socialite Catherine B. Reynolds, hosts this annual event so that a selected group of graduate students can hob-nob with world-famous people for a few days. Big

galas and big schmoozing are fine with me, as long as the partiers are paying for their own party. When I attempted to get a response from the Regent Hotel management, they told me that the security was for MY safety too. Really? You mean the police were there to protect me in case Martha Stewart or South African Archbishop Desmond Tutu went on a rampage through our neighborhoods? Please. And if they were concerned about terrorism, I say that the City should be more concerned about the safety of the children attending our local schools. Why don't our schools get that kind of security?

The citizens of Beverly Hills are owed some answers for this ridiculous taxpayer rip-off. First, what was former Mayor Linda Briskman thinking? She knew the conference was set to be held here, and she could have put the brakes on it by refusing the extra security, or she could have demanded that the Academy of Achievement and its fabulously wealthy benefactor pay for it when she actually had the leverage. Of course, that would have potentially put her in conflict with the Regent Beverly Wilshire Hotel. Clearly, she chose the hotel's best interests over those of the taxpayer's. Our new mayor, Steve Webb, is lobbying Washington for reimbursement, but given what we know about trying to get the federal government to pay for anything, that effort is likely to fail. In that case, the mayor should demand payment from the Academy of Achievement, which has a

moral obligation to pay for the protection that was provided.

Regardless, changes to our city policy are absolutely necessary. In the future, it must be clear that any event requiring expensive security will have to be paid for by the beneficiaries, not the taxpayers of Beverly Hills.

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## Legacy Project On Wilshire Voted Down

Plan for a mixed-use building is turned down by the Beverly Hills Planning Commission.

After a two-year process involving input from residents, an environmental impact report and five hearings, the Planning Commission voted against the Legacy Partners application to develop land into a mixed-use building at 9200 Wilshire Boulevard.

The 3-1 vote against the project last Thursday comes after two years of planning. Commission member Noah Furie was the dissenting vote. Vice Chair of the Planning Commission, Sharam Melamed, recused himself because he lives one block north of the site.

"The project is far too big and an inappropriate use for the land," said Melamed. "It is not a good use of the property, and we have talked for a long time about four stories for mixed-use. This project was six stories and depending on how you look at it, and from whose angle, anywhere from 60 to 80 feet."

Melamed has been mentioned as a possible city council candidate in 2007.

The vote left some residents and the developer wondering why the commission had not raised concerns regarding the mixed-use project at an earlier time.

"I'm disappointed after all the time and effort we put into it," said Dennis Cavallari, senior vice president of Legacy Partners. "We thought we had explained our position well enough that the Planning Commission and staff would be able to see that it was an appropriate use for that particular location."

Legacy Partners submitted their application for the project in November 2004. The commission then held five hearings for the Legacy project in January, March, April, May and June of this year. The May hearing was cancelled after not enough people could be found to hold the meeting.

"I am amazed that the Planning Commission wasted so much energy of the community and

The Planning Commission will hold a public hearing to consider a proposed mixed-use project to be located at **8600 Wilshire Boulevard** ("Project") on Thursday June 22 at 7:00 p.m. in Commission Room A, Beverly Hills City Hall, 455 North Rexford Drive, Beverly Hills, California 90210. The public is invited to attend the public hearing to comment on the project. A Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) prepared for this project was released on Monday, April 17, 2006 for public review and comment.

#### Project Description

The Applicant, Wilshire Colonial Partners LLC, has proposed to develop a three and five-story, approximately 65-foot high mixed-use (commercial and residential) project on four lots located at the southwest corner of Wilshire Boulevard and Stanley Drive. Three of these lots front on Wilshire Boulevard, and one fronts along Charleville Boulevard (see map above). The project would include:

25 condominium units;

4,774 square feet of ground-floor commercial space; and,

86 parking spaces (25 surface-level and 61 subterranean)

Access to the parking would be provided via both Stanley Drive (commercial and visitors) and Charleville Drive (residents). The three lots fronting Wilshire Boulevard are located in a commercial (C-3) zone; and the lot fronting on Charleville Boulevard is zoned R-1 (single family residential).

Current C-3 zoning does not allow a mix of commercial and residential uses; and R-1 zoning does not allow for multi-family dwelling units, both of which are requested on this site. The Project would also exceed the existing three-story/45-foot height limit and 2:1 FAR (Floor Area Ratio) allowed in the C-3 Zone and the height limits for single family dwellings in the R-1 zone. Accordingly, the Applicant has requested a zone amendment (mixed-use overlay zone), and corollary General Plan amendments to allow the residential use in a commercial zone; to change the R-1 zoning to allow multi-family dwellings; and to allow additional height and density for the entire project. The Project will also be subject to the Planning Commission's Planned Development Review and the Architectural Commission's review of the building's exterior design features. The Planned Development Review will include review of the Vesting Tentative Tract Map for the proposed condominiums as well as modifications to the required setbacks for commercial-residential transition areas.

Copies of all relevant material, including the project specifications, the environmental Initial Study and the Draft EIR are available for public review in the Community Development Department at City Hall, 455 North Rexford Drive, Room G-40.

the developer in having a project designed when, from the beginning, they were opposed to mixed-use on that particular site," said

Commission didn't think that this was appropriate for mixed-use, why did they string this developer on - that's not right. This cost Legacy [Partners] a lot of money to buy the

Anitra Eskovitz, a resident on South Maple, who supported the project.

Plans for the one acre lot on Wilshire between Maple Drive and Palm Drive included a 65-foot building, which is 20 feet over the city's building height code. The plans included 53 condominiums and 14,000 square feet of retail stores and restaurants on the ground level. Three levels of parking for employees and residents were planned below ground.

"[Planning for the 9200 Wilshire lot] has been going on for two years," said resident Amy Perrone who lives adjacent to the Legacy property on South Maple. "If the Planning

property, and to waste all these years? The city is so disrespectful that way."

Legacy Partners purchased the land in May 2004 after the land changed hands several times before with failed attempts to develop the property. An earlier proposal before Legacy Partners came under ownership of the land was the Hotel Bel Jardin.

The city council approved the hotel plans in December 2001 despite strong opposition from residents. However, plans fell through when the primary investor left the project and the owner declared bankruptcy in the wake of the

## Thanks For The Memories

BHUSD retiring faculty and staff bid farewell to Beverly Hills.

As the 2005-2006 school year comes to a close so do the final days in the Beverly Hills Unified School District for 17 staff and faculty. With this year comes a relatively high number of retirees compared to last year's number of five. Here is a look back at their careers in the BHUSD.

The district held a reception for all the retiring faculty Tuesday afternoon.

When asked if she was going to miss teaching, Beverly High Spanish teacher Lynne Shapiro joked, "Should I tell the truth? At this point, I'm very tired."

And she should be after teaching at the district for 28 years. Before coming to Beverly High, where she taught Spanish for 23 years, Lynne taught at various schools in BHUSD.

Herself a 1954 graduate of Beverly High, Lynne said about retiring, "In a way, you could say I'm finally graduating."

Lynne also recalls a Spanish department party that occurred last month as her fondest memory in all her years of working at the district. The party, which was called "Celebremos," which means "Let's Celebrate" in Spanish, garnered approximately 500 students to attend and featured food cooked and

prepared by students.

"Wednesday night was just phenomenal. We had no idea that it would be such a great turnout," Lynne said. "Up until that point I hadn't realized how much excitement and power there was in our department. There are 14 of us [in the department] and we've taught a lot of Spanish to a lot of kids."

She also attributes her foreign language education at Beverly High as a jumpstart to her career in teaching.

"I had a terrific Spanish teacher— Victor Seine— my senior year at Beverly and I went on to study Spanish at Wellesley College," Lynne said. "The teachers there had fled Franco, Spain and were very dynamic intellectual women who only spoke Spanish in the classroom. I got very excited about it and spent my junior year in Spain and then I've had a passion ever since. I love Spanish art and I try passing some of that onto my students."

Upon retiring, Lynne plans to do lots of traveling.

"I have lots of plans," Lynne said. "I want to drive across country and see a lot of places associated with my parents. I love art so I want to hit a lot of the museums that you don't get to

see when you just go to New York and also see some of the presidential libraries."

After her many years at the district, Lynne speaks fondly of her colleagues and hopes to keep in touch.

"It has been such a privilege to work with the other teachers here," Lynne said. "The teachers here read, talk and know what's going on in the world. We have a faculty book group. At lunch I eat with people who are very interested in films, politics and current events and we have interesting discussion. People travel broadly— it's just a really good, intelligent group of people. It's meant a lot to me."

Unlike Lynne, Beverly High Head Counselor Vivian Saatjian-Green does not have any current plans for her retirement but says she may do some traveling— she just has to figure out where she wants to go.

"The transition is unclear," Vivian said. "I'm going to take some time, regroup and see what other options might come my way."

After coming to the district in 1981 as a special education teacher, Vivian was promoted twice, first as a counselor in 1985 and then as head counselor in 1990.

"I've really enjoyed the college counseling

component and being able to meet a lot of people at the colleges and help kids in choosing their career paths," Vivian said. "It's very exciting to see kids take a course here on campus such as art history and end up majoring in college in art history because of Flory Schultheiss or Mike Federman. I find that to be really a lot of fun."

Prior to her 25-year career at Beverly, Vivian taught at five other high schools. Although she has had experience at all grade levels, she prefers working with high schoolers.

"What I like a lot about the job is the problem solving aspect," Vivian said. "I've always loved working with adolescents. I've worked at K-12 and had experience at all levels but I have enjoyed immensely the high school program."

Overall, what Vivian will miss most is working with her colleagues.

"I loved working with [retired faculty] Rick

## Hotels, Hookers, Hoffa

Tales from the Beverly hood.

From hookers to Hoffa, our city's hotels have some wonderful stories to tell. Some of my favorites:

Although the Beverly Hills Hotel has been seen in more movies, including **Neil Simon's** "California Suite," the Beverly Wilshire (now Regent) has stories that are more outrageous.

The BW received a major jolt in occupancy following the release of "Pretty Woman" in 1990. The story about a prostitute living the grand life, including shopping on Rodeo Drive, encouraged many big spenders to insist on occupying the impressive suite shown in the film. Most of that movie's fans, when learning the costs, settled for more modest rate rooms, but still cited the movie as their reason for coming to Beverly Hills.

However, three decades earlier the hotel rejected a request as a location for a film with sexual content: **Woody Allen's** "Everything You Wanted to Know About Sex." In one of the more hilarious episodes,

the **Gene Wilder** character falls slowly but inexorably in love with "Daisy" a sultry sheep. When his wife has him followed by detectives, he is caught in bed with Daisy. No sex act, of course, was shown, but when the then gm of the hotel read the script, he thundered: "There will be no sex with animals in my hotel." The movie used the downtown Biltmore.

**George White**, the GM and later president of the hotel under "proprietor" **Hernando Courtright**, received a weekend call from his front desk some 30 years ago when two of our finest arrived wanting to know if **Elizabeth Taylor** and **Richard Burton** were indeed sharing a suite.

Beverly Hills still had so called blue laws on our books then that made it unlawful for unmarried couples to share accommodations. It seems an energetic reporter from the *Daily Mirror*, a Times owned tabloid of the era, had called the police department's watch commander demanding to know if the city was going to enforce its ordinances.

Two officers were dispatched to very reluctantly make an investigation.

White told the desk clerk to have the officers wait while he called Chief **Clinton Anderson** at home. The Chief quickly ordered the cops out of the hotel. The next day, the same reporter arrived at the police station and confronted the chief. "What the hell are laws for if you don't enforce them," he demanded. Anderson immediately had him jailed for yet another ancient law that prohibited cussing in front of a lady, in this case Anderson's aging secretary. The media frenzy that followed was predictable. The reporter was released, the hotel insisted that the famous lovers had separate accommodations and had, in any case, left the hotel. The hotel made news, and box office sales for "Cleopatra" had a modest bump. (It wasn't until the 1990s that some of our ordinances were restored to reality.)

A more hilarious, but dangerous, episode at the hotel also involved White. One morning White had called a major staff meeting to address what he felt was a breakdown of discipline. The Austrian born White, when excited, reverted back to his Germanic accent, as he did at this meeting. Warming to his subject, he repeated over and over again that there "vill be no more laying down on the job."

As the chagrined staff was leaving a small

banquet room on the mezzanine, two gunmen invaded the hotel to rob a lobby jewelry store. As they were departing the shop, they shouted to those in the lobby to "get down" which frightened guests did quickly.

At that very moment, the dozens of hotel workers were entering the lobby from mezzanine stairs and the startled bandits shouted at them to "get down" too. Of course, they complied.

White hearing some shouting also walked down the stairs, but then the robbers fled through the front of the hotel. The only thing White saw was his entire meeting staff spread eagle on the floor. His immediate assumption was that this was some kind of protest to his insistence that there be no more "lying down on the job."

Incidentally, not the shrewdest of robbers, the invaders had used their own car and a front entrance parking attendant noted their license plates. They were arrested within hours and their heist recovered. Most of this tale did not make news.


Speaking of hookers and **Jimmy Hoffa**, there is a legend that Hoffa is buried under what is now the charming Luxe Hotel, but in an earlier incarnation, when it was called the Rodeo. The story was given some credence because the Teamsters lost a bundle when it financed construction of the Rodeo. Early investors included some of the "boys" involved in the Friar's Club gambling scam and some had ties to the Chicago mob.

I knew some of them because, in my more naïve days, I thought they were "just businessmen" and fellow Friar's. At the city council hearing considering the height pro-

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posals, I made the dangerous mistake of introducing **Ben Teitelbaum**, one of the hotel investors who, I later learned, had many mob connections, to one of the leaders of the Municipal League, **Ted Kimche**, who had come to speak against the hotel. When Ben saw Kimche go to the podium to oppose the hotel, he glared at me, shouting "you made me shake hands with that..." Reporter's duties be damned, I left the chamber post haste. I often wondered what Teitelbaum would have said had he known that the diminutive and shy Kimche was a controller for Forest Lawn!

That same hotel also had a remarkable run as a house of possible ill repute. The scheme devised by an earlier "Beverly Hills Madam" even worked for a while.

The "ladies" never offered their services for a fee. No, they worked the bar and when a "client" approached them, he was informed that they could be accommodated with a room visit if they talked to a very large lady occupying one of the nearby booths. This person would gladly rent them a room, at somewhat inflated rates, and then the friendly bar acquaintance would join them in the room. No sex was being sold, only rooms. It didn't take long for the scam to be discovered and fixed by a police department raid.

The present owners, the Harkham family, and very orthodox, have given the hotel a more upstanding image. As for Hoffa, let him rest in peace.

One great irony of the Beverly Wilshire is the role of Courtright in providing the major

funding for the referendum that kept the Four Seasons out of Beverly Hills. Long after Courtright sold the hotel to the Regent group, they contracted with the Four Season's, now the hotel operators. It could actually be called The Four Seasons, Regent Beverly Wilshire Hotel.

Some quick hotel notes: The magnificent Peninsula, probably one of the finest hotels in America, with my favorite dining room, The Belvedere, had a seven year ordeal before winning city approval. The hotel itself was originally called The Belvedere and only became the Peninsula during construction. Two very attractive additions to the lobby of the Beverly Hilton: "Hours, Minutes, Seconds" and you have to guess what they sell in their smartly designed space. A really impressive design also houses "Le Chateau" a very tempting venue for incredible chocolates and California's coastal wines.

In future issues, more hotel stories including how one of our leading hotels managed construction in a residential area by first building a legal apartment house and then converting it to a hotel - something that could no longer be done, and what the financial impacts could be if the Beverly Hilton builds condos on much of its property, plus a preview of the coming of the Montage Hotel and Gardens, which will dramatically increase our inventory of world class hotels.

Quick bits: Our neighbor, a very tiny but friendly and price reasonable jeweler, Tina K. Designs, has reopened at 140 S. Beverly

Drive. The owner had to make an emergency visit to an ill sister in New York, but the shop is back in business and well worth the visit... Attended an impressive luncheon honoring some outstanding women last week at the Beverly Hills Hotel. The Israel Cancer Research Fund gave recognition to **Rosalie Zalis, Linzi Glass, Barbara Hayden, M.D. and Norma Fink**. Our own **Fred Hayman** was one of the presenters. Guests I spotted included Dr. **Sandra Aronberg, Betty Hayman, Lorna Berle, Donanne Kasikci, Judy Henning, Patricia Kennedy, Annabelle Begelman, Katy Sweet** and **Ann Weston** who is the producer of "The Stranger Game" to be shown on Lifetime on June 18.

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## Contract Brings Turf One Step Closer To High School

A contract with Empire & Associates may end debates over the turf field at Beverly High. The Board of Education approved a California Multiple Award Schedule contract

The company does not partake in the actual selection.

The Mission Viejo-based company, concluded two days of discussions last week meant to generate community input for the search.

The eight-member company was started by Jake Abbott, a former superintendent. The company's employees are all former superintendents. Abbott formerly worked in Huntington Beach, El Diablo and Fresno. He also went on to work at UC Berkeley before starting the company.

This is not the first time the district hired Leadership Associates to aid in a search for a superintendent. The company provided candidates when the district

hired Supt. Gwen Gross six years ago.

"I have full trust and respect for the [Leadership] Associates," said Board of Education President Myra Lurie. "If it doesn't turn out to be the right person, we certainly won't be settling [with that person]."

## Briskman Named Vice Chair Of Council Of Governments

Members of the Westside Cities Council of Governments elected Beverly Hills City Councilmember Linda Briskman to serve as the group's Vice Chair beginning in July.

"I look forward to providing leadership, resources and visibility to the regional issues that are affecting the Westside cities," Briskman said in an e-mail. "With the continuity of my involvement in the COG last year and now, with my new role in the coming year as Vice Chair, Beverly Hills has an active role in participating in solving regional matters that are of mutual interest to all five cities."

The Council of Governments fosters communication between the organization's five member cities of Beverly Hills, Culver City, Santa Monica, West Hollywood and West Los Angeles. Council members hold meetings and discuss issues and solutions that impact the member cities. These issues include homelessness, traffic and housing.

Prior to getting elected, Briskman served on the Beverly Hills Planning, Traffic & Parking and Solicitations Advisory Commissions. In 2001, she was elected to the city council.

## Barquist Continues To November Election Ballot

Beverly Hills resident and Superior Court Judge candidate, Janis Barquist, will be on the election ballot in November after placing second in the primary election race.

Barquist, who is running for the Office 144 seat, received 134,291 votes (20.9 percent) as of press time. Her opponent in November, David Stuart, received the most votes during the primary election with, 174,302 votes (27.1 percent). Only a total of 5,065 people voted in last Tuesday's election despite there being 3.8 million total voters eligible to vote.

Barquist is currently the Los Angeles Deputy City Attorney and represents the Los Angeles Police and Fire Departments. She also served on the Beverly Hills General Plan Committee.

This is the first time Barquist ran for the position. Under former Governor Gray Davis, she applied for appointment to the position, but voters recalled Davis before any action was taken.

## Beverly Hills Bookstore Plays Host To Al Gore

Dutton's Beverly Hills Books will host a visit from former vice president Al Gore on June 24 who will discuss his book, "An Inconvenient Truth" and the movie based on the book. A book signing will follow the discussion.

The premise of the book rests on the negative impacts global warming does to the environment. The movie focuses on Gore's decision to educate people on such climate issues. After a \$50,000 donation, Beverly High students were sent to watch the film at a special screening held in Hollywood last month.

## Board of Education Agrees To Algebra Class Size Reduction

Ninth grade algebra class sizes will be smaller in the fall after the Board of

## City Proposes Deal For Animal Hospital

A proposal, announced by City Manager Rod Wood, would allow the Amanda Foundation to continue operating at 351 N. Foothill Road. This reversed an original plan that would displace the Foundation from its current facility.

According to Teri Austin, President of the Amanda Foundation, neither she nor Dr. Anthony Shipp, the property owner, were contacted by the city about the new proposal. Shipp owns the land where Dr. Shipp's Animal Hospital and the Amanda Foundation operate.

"I'm hoping this means that they're going to leave us alone," Austin said. "We're really anxious to hear about what that means. We felt strongly that they didn't need the land, so I'm glad they rethought this."

Wood announced the plan at Monday's city council meeting suggesting the Foundation could continue operating at 351 N. Foothill Road. The city originally wanted to purchase property from 347 to 351 N. Foothill Road, but the new plan would have the city buying only a portion of the land.

As previously reported in the *Weekly* [issue #349], the city wanted to purchase the property possibly using eminent domain, because Shipp was not interested in selling the land.

with Empire for an artificial lawn installation on the high school's field.

"We're hoping to save money," said Board of Education President Myra Lurie. "It requires us to go and negotiate separate prices with vendors as opposed to one general contractor doing it. It's good because it will save us time because we know we'll be getting a favorable price."

As reported in the *Weekly* [issue #345], the turf field has been the subject of a contentious debate because of cost and contract issues. A landscaping architect has already been used as part of the process to draw a variety of plans for review by the school board.

As the next phase in this process, the CMAS contract, approved by the board, will allow for further price negotiations with Empire. The CMAS contract will also allow the school to bypass the public bid process, which is used in most contracted work cases.

## Leadership Associates Aiding School Board In Superintendent Search

The Beverly Hills Board of Education is receiving help from search firm, Leadership Associates, in the search for a new superintendent. The company's main purpose is to find candidates for the superintendent position, which the board will then select from.

Education approved the Morgan Hart Bill for High School Class Size Reduction at a regular meeting Tuesday. Class sizes will average 20 students with a maximum of 22 students in each class.

Approval of this bill will only affect those students enrolled in one of the four sections of Algebra A or the one section of Algebra 1 chosen to participate in this plan.

Administration and faculty chose to implement smaller class sizes for the math courses based on students' needs to pass the state exit exam, STAR testing and Beverly High's own algebra graduation requirement. As a result, reduced class sizes will no longer be offered for ninth grade World History.

#### District Buildings To Be Utilized During Disasters

As part of an agreement made between the school district and the Red Cross, district buildings will be used as shelters during natural disasters. The Board of Education approved the agreement at the meeting Tuesday night.

The Red Cross agreement is largely procedural as part of the district's Hazard Mitigation Plan.

This signed agreement gives the superintendent, or someone chosen by the superintendent, to allow the Red Cross access to district buildings and grounds in the event of a disaster. In signing the agreement, the Red Cross will reimburse the district for food or supplies used during such events.

#### District Negotiates Employee Contracts

A public hearing was held to discuss any cost increases incurred from talks between the district and the California School Employees Association. District officials and the Association came to an agreement on certain salary terms in the contract, and the Board of Education approved the tentative agreement.

One of the contract changes included a stipulation to provide certain employees with the tools and uniforms they need for work. Prior to this, \$20 each month was provided for tools and uniforms. Another contract change includes a 4 percent differential for district employees working at night. Before this, nightshift employees received \$20 each month.

The agreement will be sent to the Los

Angeles County Office of Education.

#### Loyola Student Teachers Expected In Fall

The Board of Education approved an agreement with Loyola Marymount University that will place student teachers throughout BHUSD for the coming school year beginning in August. This will be the first year the district will have student teachers from Loyola.

An agreement with university student teachers can be beneficial for the school district because it may lead to recruiting of some students into the district.

The agreement between the school district and Loyola will be for two years beginning August 1 and lasting through July 31, 2008. The students will receive a \$150 stipend.

#### Iranian Women In Exile At BH Library

Five Iranian women will present a new anthology, "Let Me Tell You Where I've Been", about Middle Eastern culture, politics and society at the Beverly Hills Public Library, Sunday, June 18 at 7 p.m.

The anthology will feature over one hundred selections (two-thirds of which have never been published before) from over fifty contributors—including such well-known writers as Susan Atefat-Peckham, Tara Bahrapour, Firoozeh Dumas, Azadeh Moaveni, and Farnoosh Moshiri.

#### Registration Open for Excursion to Farm, Pow Wow

The Beverly Hills Community Services Department has open registration to anyone interested in a June 17 trip that takes visitors through an exotic animal farm and a Native American Pow Wow.

The day-long excursion begins at the Moorpark College Teaching Zoo where visitors will get a tour of the facility. The zoo is home to exotic animals and a presentation with some of the animals is included in the tour.

Following the zoo, visitors will go to the Native American Intertribal Pow Wow located across the colleges campus. People can learn Native American customs through dances, poetry readings and jewelry-making. Visitors will also have the opportunity to eat and shop.

The one-day trip costs \$18 for Beverly

Hills residents and \$23 for non-residents. Those participating in the excursion will meet at the La Cienega Tennis Center and be transported by bus. The trip is from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. To register, call (310)550-4753.

A few months passed from the beginning of school I was loving high school and was having a ball. I started to meet more people, hanging around with the funniest kids I had ever met, going to lots of parties, and having fun at my classes. Everyday after school my friends and I went out "chilled".

After my freshman year all the students in my class were starting to take their GEDs so they can leave high school and attend community college. It was confusing to me why they wanted to leave high school at such a young age. I said to myself, "Why would these kids leave a high school that is fun to attend where they get a great education?" Thus I asked my friends that are planning to take the GEDs—Gabe Davoudpour and Avi Cohen— why these kids were taking their GEDs and go to college. They explained to me that some students in high school were failing their classes and wouldn't be able to graduate high school or some did what he did and left high school because they believed that they were ready for college.

travel industry's slowdown after 9/11.

In August 2003, Ellas properties bought the land, but no other plans surfaced until Legacy purchased the property.

According to Eskovitz, neighbors fought development of the hotel because of concerns over traffic. Concerns from others living in the neighborhood included the building's height, which had always been a contentious issue for the property's development.

In planning for the mixed-use building, Legacy developers made plans to build exits

and entries into the building so that traffic would be directed towards Wilshire. Planners also positioned the swimming pool on the roof so that it could not be viewed from the street.

"If you go along this strip of Wilshire, it's a pretty dead strip in terms of pedestrians," said Legacy Partners land use attorney Dale Goldsmith. "People go to their offices and they leave, and they're gone. We think this project would enliven the frontage along Wilshire and could help provide a catalyst to a more vibrant pedestrian streetscape, which you're not going to have with an office building."

"I'm going to miss a lot of the things that have to do with Beverly Hills and the education working together to build Beverly Vista and the camaraderie and the amount of togetherness that we built as a staff and a community," Irene said.

Irene first came to BHUSD from Long Island, New York, as a B.V. parent and substitute teacher. She became a full-time social stud-

ies teacher in 1981 and then later promoted to assistant principal. She was again promoted to principal at Beverly Vista seven years ago.

"It's been part of my life for 33 years and obviously it's been a great part of my life with great memories and great experiences," Irene said. "I came here and [now] we have a great life here together with my son, daughter-in-law and my grandson."

Out of all her years working at the district, Irene recalls winning the Blue Ribbon award for Beverly Vista as her most favorite.

"Truthfully, going to the ceremony in Washington is something I will take with me and treasure. I'm just sorry that everybody couldn't go and get the same feeling," Irene said. "It shows the quality of the people that are working on the campus and the families and how much they value education. It's a wonderful feeling."

Irene currently has no plans for retirement. "At this point nothing is signed, sealed and delivered and I don't want to talk about definite plans," Irene said.

After Legacy purchased the property, planners met with neighbors to get their suggestion and feedback on the property.

"This developer, Legacy Partners," Perrone said, "has been exemplary with their relationship with the neighborhood. They have changed their plan so many times when they've gotten feedback from the residents living on Maple and Palm. I don't know any developer who has done that."

Normally, Perrone and Eskovitz often oppose large projects as in the case of Hotel Bel Jardin. However, the two, along with some of

the other neighbors, supported the Legacy mixed-use building.

Legacy, a real estate development firm based out of Irvine, plans to appeal the commission's decision. Appeal papers are filed through the city clerk's office. Regardless of an appeal, the council will discuss the matter as the Legacy project would be an exception to the city's current height requirements.

"We're obviously going to appeal to the city council, and we're very hopeful that we'll have a more elevated perception of our viewpoint from the City Council," Cavallari said.

Twenty-seven year veteran, Terry Brown, who teaches eighth grade history at Horace Mann, also says she has no plans for retirement.

"I'm going to drift a while and let myself find out where I want to be," said Terry, who came to the district as a special education teacher. "I'm going to sample all my options and opportunities and hopefully create new adventures for myself."

Also a Horace Mann and 1962 Beverly High graduate, Terry, is one of a few teachers in the district who actually live in Beverly Hills. Both her children graduated from Beverly High.

"I have a close connection to Horace Mann because I went there as a child," Terry said.

"I walk down the street and I cannot walk three blocks without saying hi. In fact, I trained for a marathon and one of the parents was my running buddy. It's just wonderful to have these relationships with the parents."

Being very proud of her profession, Terry says she is honored to have taught her students and will miss teaching.

"When you're teaching a class and all of a

sudden you see the kids nodding as the light turns on and they start understanding a complex idea, that's just a fabulous memory," Terry said. "I really loved teaching and still do."

All retirees say they will miss working in the district and will value the relationships they have cultivated over the years. Irene echoed the feeling amongst many of the retirees this year.

"The friends I've made over the years will still be friends," Irene said. "I will miss seeing people everyday and conversations that relate to what's happening at our school and the students that I've become friendly with. That's the reason we're all here—for the education of our students and I will miss meeting with them on a regular basis."

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
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
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
