# **Community Mourns Student's Death**

Police continue investigation into the car crash on South Beverly Drive. By Marissa Pendergrass

Funeral services were held yesterday for Vahagn Setian, a junior at Beverly High, who was killed last Saturday after a fatal car accident on South Beverly Drive.

Police are investigating why three teenagers were riding with a 26-year old television actor in his Land Rover. The vehicle was heading Northbound on Beverwil Drive crossing over Olympic Boulevard when the vehicle hit the center median and struck a tree on the 300 block of South

Beverly Drive, in front of Islands restaurant.

No other vehicles were involved and South Beverly Drive was closed for approximately four hours while police conducted their initial investigation.

Lane Garrison, a supporting actor on the Fox-TV Drama "Prison Break", was behind the wheel and "displayed symptoms of alcohol intoxication" when he was questioned by police, said Beverly Hills police Lt. Mitch McCann.

All three juveniles were rushed to Cedars-Sinai Medical Center by the paramedics. Shortly after their arrival at Cedars, Setian, 17, succumbed to his injuries. The two 15-year old female passengers, who do not attend Beverly, were critically wounded.

One female was released from the hospital under stable condition but "the other one has been hospitalized in serious condition," Lt. McCann said.

"In 2006, we have had six traffic related fatalities, however this is the only one involving juveniles," Lt. McCann said.

Garrison was treated at Century City Hospital for his injuries and police are investigating his impairment at the time of the accident. "Mr. Garrison is not hospitalized and has been released to recover," Lt. McCann said.

Alcohol containers were removed from the SUV and detectives are awaiting the

> results from a bloodalcohol test that Garrison took the night of the accident.

"Everything is still under investigation and we do not want to comment," McCann said in regard to the speed of the

vehicle at the time of the accident. Garrison's publicist Catherine Olim at PMK Public Relations in West Hollywood did not return the Weekly's call to discuss

the accident.

Students at Beverly High organized an afternoon ceremony on Monday with an open mic to vent their sadness and confusion over the loss of Setian.

"He has touched all of us and there are few students at the high school that we would all be out here on the front lawn showing this much concern," Associated Student Body President Josh Tucker said.

A moment of silence was held for Setian and students wiped away their tears as his friends spoke about the great memories

Beverly High students wore green to school in honor of Setian's favorite color after word spread among students over the weekend. The former water polo player, guitarist and drama stu- Beverly High student Vahagn Setian dent, was known for his

affinity for green clothing and loveable personality.

Jonathan Pony, a junior at Beverly High, was one of his best friends and met him in water polo summer training their sophomore year.

"I spent a lot of time with 'V' and he's a really special kid, I love him a whole lot and I really miss him and I'm always going to," he said.

Students were reminded of a similar tragedy in 2004 when former Beverly High student Elana Rosenberg was permanently disabled as a result of a car accident on Sunset Boulevard.

Another former Beverly High student Pedram Kashani was killed in 1999 by a fatal car crash as he was making a left onto Whittier Drive from Wilshire Boulevard when a delivery truck plowed over his



"He just touched the lives of a lot of different types of people, not just your athlete or just your kid in the play, if you look out there you'll see all walks of life," Principal J. Guidetti said at the memorial at Beverly High.

When asked what his closest friends and fellow students needed, Guidetti said, "Students wanted a time and a place that coincided with the alleged time of his death which was at 11:50 at night and so they wanted to hold a vigil at that time."

Guidetti met with the Setian family Monday morning and said, "They are very much appreciative of all the support. There have been over 400 students that have come through their door and they just find it remarkable."



#### 2007 BUSINESS TAX RENEWALS

The City of Beverly Hills announced this week that 2007 Business Tax renewal forms are being mailed to all registered businesses in the city.

Business taxes are due, in full, by the January 31, 2007 deadline. Unpaid taxes become delinquent on February 1, 2007. Penalty and interest charges accrue on late registrations at a monthly rate of 10% and 1.5%, respectively.

Section 3-1-201 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code requires all businesses located or operating in the city to register and pay their taxes each calendar year. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in an estimated tax liability and legal prosecution.

Beverly High runner Ashley Menzies has signed a letter of intent to accept an athletic scholarship from Stanford, the school announced last week.

Menzies has won the Ocean League girls' 200 and 400 meter championships in each of her three years with the Normans and was the 2006 Mt. San Antonio College Relays seeded 400 champion.

"Ashley is a versatile all around sprinter with Pac-10 competitive marks sprint marks," Stanford Director of Track & Field Edrick Floreal said. "She will be an instant contributor at the national level on both of our relays."

Menzies is part of what Floreal, in his ninth season with the Cardinal program, called "our best and most complete recruiting class ever."

Sophomore forward Erik Munzer scored all three goals for the Normans as they opened their season with a victory in the pool play game Nov. 28 at St. Bernard. Munzer scored his first goal in the final minute of the 40-minute first half off Sam Forrest's assist.

Munzer headed in a cross from Scott Schwartz in the 50th minute to give Beverly Hills a 2-1 lead. Romeo Patroni began the scoring sequence with a steal in the right corner, followed by a pass to S c h w a r t z . Munzer headed in Jack Tiryakan's corner kick in the 75th minute for his third goal.

The Vikings scored their goal in the 12th

The Normans led 33-6 in shots and 15-6 in shots on goal.

Beverly Hills goalkeeper David Roston made five saves.

Midfielder Daniel Kohen, Munzer, defender-midfielder Ryan Neman and defender Jake Weissberg, drew praise for their play for the Normans from coach Steve Rappaport.





# Time Warner Shuts Us Down

And other winners and losers of the week. By Rudy Cole

Without any real notice, all Time Warner email system abruptly shut down Monday or Tuesday, depending on your area, and will not be functioning until later this week. If you sent me a nasty note and I didn't respond, pray for a return of Adelphia. They may have been right wing extremists, but they made the trains, or in this case, cable service run on time.

Seriously, I am not able to access many messages I hope will be saved if and when they work out the changes. One series of emails I can not now respond to raised some personnel issues in the police department. I know some of the people involved, but I have no idea who sent me the internal personnel letters via email or the merits of the complaints raised. I would prefer that whoever sent me the material, do so by making sure I know their names, not just the names of the person who had an issue. I would then be more able to discuss the problems with the chief and the police association. Naturally, we will protect all sources.

Having said that and with full sympathy for anyone who faces issues that could change their careers, and not able to judge the merits of the dispute, I do have confidence in the integrity and ability of Chief **David Snowden** and the leadership of the police association.

Being a chief of police means you serve many constituencies. First, you must convince your community that you are able and dedicated to protecting and serving. In Beverly Hills, the chief reports to the city manager, but must also have the confidence of the members of the city council. Snowden has all of that.

Los Angeles police leadership is more complex and the constituencies more diverse. The Los Angeles Chief reports to a police commission, the mayor, city council, an outside oversight team and the community. However, the chief must have the confidence of the men and women of his department, and they have enormous political clout. Chief **William Bratton** understands that role far better than his predecessor. It means walking a tight line when issues of excessive force are raised, as

they were recently. If the Chief jumps on the rush to condemn, his ability to lead will be diminished as will his effectiveness. On the other hand, he must be able to respond to community concerns.

Side note: When there is television coverage of incidents, no matter what the merits, the over and over again showing of the police action without any ability to assess what might have preceded, is terribly inflammatory and irresponsible. Yes, police should be accountable, but within the context of due process.

\*\*\*

A reader complains that this column (see Letters on page 2) was silent on the problems created by the planning and use of the D Lot, (north Beverly and north Canon Drives). On the contrary, we strongly urged the city to fulfill its objective of only renting space to retail uses. That is not what has happened and parking is not serving the shoppers and retailers as well as it should be because of the large demand by non-retail tenants, including a language school. On the other hand we do have a new book store and parking inventory has increased. As for the lot, the design is a maze as are the most of the city parking structures. And don't get me started on two hour free parking.

What has contributed to a major loss of parking in the city? A relatively new phenomena: Day time valet parking. Until about 10

years ago, restaurants and other merchants were not given day time permit parking- now hundreds of spaces are set aside for eateries and other. Some, such as Spago, take up as many as eight spaces. Even small diners now have valet parking at night and many for lunch. There are also many loading only spaces and commercial only signs in front of businesses and offices that have been closed for years or occupied for different purposes.

We don't loose parking revenues when meters are removed for valet parking - the city recovers revenue from the permit holders and a case can be made that valet parking reduces traffic since patrons aren't circling the block looking for a parking space. But many of these valet spaces are not fully used, sometimes not at all.

Its time for the Parking and Traffic Commission to call for a study of all the nonmeter spaces and the possible return to public use of as many as possible.

\*\*

Many of the school's teachers, including their association, are locked in a very unfortunate dispute with the board and some school parents over an issue that should have been compromised (See cover story on page 10).

What the board and some parents want is the actual text of tests and not just the grades of students. Teachers argue that giving the material violates their rights as the creative instrument and also makes it easy for following classes to learn just the answers to the tests.

A possible compromise should have made it possible for tests in the sciences to be

obtained, but probably not tests for anything else. Math and chemistry tests could more easily be changed each year, but not tests on history, for example.

The teachers are far more active partners in the education process that employees of the city are in municipal programs. Mostly, this works to the advantage of the students, but there is a line: The school board is elected to carry out the educational goals of the community and they set policies and the administrators are obligated to enact. Put another way, teachers have tenure, but board members can be ousted very easily at the next election.

It wold also help both the teachers and the community, if their association reached out more effectively. One of the reasons we have strong support for police and fire is the work of their employee associations in the city. (It also makes for better services).

The teachers also deserve far more credit for their contribution to the schools. But the buck stops at the board and, mostly, this is a very excellent board and has been well served by its retiring president, **Myra Lurie**.

\*\*\*

Many years ago when, as president of the Greystone Foundation, I proposed the formation of a citizen support group to be called "Friends of Greystone," some of my board members warned this could mean the end of the Foundation.

The Foundation was created as an independent, city-appointed committee charged with finding a cultural use for the historic mansion. Under the leadership of **Fred Nicholas**, a very doable museum was

obtained that would have housed the Weissman collection, one of the finest modern art accumulations in the world. **Fred Weissman** was also prepared to fund restoration of the mansion and provide a world renowned curator. The city dropped the ball, not the Foundation.

But some of my fellow board members were right. The foundation was dissolved in part because of the Friends, but mainly because the Recreation and Parks Commission wanted advisory jurisdiction of Greystone. With that action, the challenge of finding a museum or other permanent, cultural use was abandoned.

However, exciting things have happened to Greystone, including restoration and repairs and many great programs, including the annual design and garden show, Theatre Forty, concerts and much more.

The Friends have become strong organizational advocates for Greystone and I am still pleased it was created. The whole board deserves applause for their contribution to the city including president **Lou Milkowski**. Much can be expected from the Friends' new president, J3

**Susan Rosen**, who has the confidence of the Friend's board and the city staff. Special thanks to my former board member colleague, **Marjorie Fasman**, who made a generous contribution enabling a recent improvement.

# COVERSTORY GIVING BACK THE TESTS

# Backed by the Board of Education and the PTA, the new Superintendent says teachers must release tests to parents. But faculty say it will negatively impact student learning. By Ryan Vaillancourt

Superintendent Kari McVeigh issued a district-wide directive last Wednesday that requires teachers, upon request, to release completed exams to parents within 48 hours of the initial in-class exam review with the student.

What seems like a routine request to some has provoked heated protest from many teachers who claim they were not appropriately consulted by district administration and that the test release policy jeopardizes test security.

McVeigh, recently appointed by the Board of Education, says the policy aims to strengthen the partnership between parents and teachers.

"Our goal is to make sure that assessments are used to the benefit of students, and that's also about the ability for parents to be able to participate in the

process," McVeigh said. "They have that right, as they should."

While teachers maintain that parents are encouraged to review test materials in class with them, they say that releasing the tests will be counterproductive.

"Once you no longer have control of [the test] you can no longer consider it to be a valid assessment because it's entirely possible that one or more children now have access to that material and to those questions," said Stewart Horowitz, a social studies teacher at the high school.

The teachers' concern is that students who see a test before they take it may study a limited selection of material, or worse, they will know the answers without grasping how they are derived.

The district has pushed the test release policy since at least the spring of 2005, when parents, including former Boardmember Barry Brucker, raised concerns about withholding math tests from students at the high school. These concerns led to a test release directive in the high school math department, but that policy was later withdrawn by former Beverly High principal Dan Stepenosky after

teachers circulated a petition opposing the policy

Stepenosky went on to establish a group of high school administrators and teachers called the Assessment Task Force. The group drafted a three page "vision" for assessment at the high school, which touched on multiple assessment methods, including test release. The guideline ultimately left it up to teachers to decide which methods to use.

"[The Assessment Task Force document] has been the order of the day so to speak for the last year," Beverly Hills Education Association President Chris Bushée said. "Everybody has been working under this document, so when Superintendent McVeigh approached me about this issue in October in one of our first meetings, for me, this was out of the blue."

At Tuesday's Board of Education meeting, Bushée called the directive "hastily issued" and derided the superintendent for "swatting away months of cooperation."

But for parents who want access to their child's test for use as a study guide, the test release policy is a welcome change and not a surprise. At least a dozen parents went on record at Tuesday's meeting in support of the directive, including PTA Council Co-Presidents Stacey Raskin and Aviva Laufer

"This is a long time coming," Beverly High PTA Co-President Kathi Rothner said. "This is something the parents have been asking for years and years."

One of those parents is Hayley Kaplan, who has two kids in the district. Both, she said, have been "directly hurt by the tests not coming home."

"I'm praying that this superintendent is strong enough to not let [the teachers] overturn the ruling," Kaplan said.

One of Kaplan's children has struggled with math at the high school and until now, she has paid a tutor to go to the high school to review, but not copy, her son's test.

"If you have someone that's going to cheat, they're hurting themselves," Kaplan said. "But you can't hurt the innocent people who generally want to do better because you're worried about that handful that might be cheating."

Teachers on the other hand, argue that their credibility as professional educators has been overridden.

Beverly Vista math teacher Mark Frenn said he used to release tests but when the

2005 directive was issued, he reversed his policy in support of the high school math teachers. Since then, he has devoted one class period to reviewing tests with the students.

"Having done both methods, I can tell you that retaining tests is a far superior way of handling this as far as using the test as a learning tool," he said.



other teachers say they will have to spend too much time making new tests.

"I don't just throw any old random problems on my test. I really thoughtfully put powerful problems on the test that are going to truly assess the kids' abilities. That takes time and even in math, there are a limited number of really strong problems." Frenn said.

Extra time spent creating new tests, Frenn and other teachers say, means less time available for evaluating student performance.

Merle Bauer, who teaches English at Beverly Vista and opposes the directive, said her students' past record speaks for itself

"Last year, 88 percent of my students scored Proficient and above on the STAR test in English Language Arts; two years ago, my students ranked 9th in the entire state of California," Bauer said. "I have been very proud of my students' success."

Because the directive requires teachers to release a test only upon a parent's request, the policy's unfolding will depend largely on the insistence of parents.

In a special request of their own, Frenn and Bauer sent letters home to their students' parents on Friday and Monday, urging them not to take advantage of the directive. Beverly Vista Principal Erik Warren responded to the letters in an email to all teachers, asserting that as a matter of policy, all letters sent home must be preapproved by the principal.

If enough parents choose not to request tests, current teaching practices could go unchanged. But judging by the outpouring of parental support for the directive at Tuesday's meeting, it seems unlikely. What is sure to last is the rift between teachers and district administration.

BHEA has its executive board meeting today and while members intend to comply with the directive for now, the group will look into copyright issues that could prove the directive to be illegal. Teachers who do not comply risk disciplinary action, but serious consequences are unlikely unless there are multiple infractions.



Section 2. A new Chapter 9 (Graffiti Prevention, Prohibition and Removal) is hereby added to Title 5 (Public Health, Welfare and Sanitation) of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code to read as follows:

Penalties 5-9-13: 5-9-1: Purpose and Intent:

The purpose of this chapter is to provide a program for the removal of graffiti from walls, structures and other permanent surfaces located on both public and private property and to provide regulations designed to prevent and control the further spread of graffiti in the City of Beverly Hills.

5-9-2: Definitions: "Adhesive label" shall mean any so called "bumper sticker", sheet of paper, fabric, or plastic, or other substance with an adhesive backing.

"Aerosol paint container" shall mean any aerosol container, regardless of the material from which it is made, which is adapted or made for the purpose of spraying paint, undercoating, spray insulation, or other substance capable of defacing property.

"Felt-tip marker" shall mean any indelible marker or similar implement with a tip which, at its broadest width, is greater than one-eighth (1/8th) of an inch and which contains an ink or other pigmented liquid.

"Graffiti" shall mean any inscription, word, figure, picture, painting, design or other defacement that is written, marked, etched, scratched, sprayed, drawn, or painted, engraved, pasted, or otherwise affixed to or on any wall, structure or other permanent surface of any public or private real or personal property within the City of Beverly Hills to the extent the same was not authorized in advance by the owner or occupant thereof.

"Graffiti Implement" shall mean an aerosol paint container, a felt tip marker, gum label, paint stick, etching tool capable of scarring glass, metal, concrete, wood, or other surface, adhesive label, or any other device capable of being used to leave a visible mark at least one-eighth (1/8th) of an inch in width upon any surface of any material.

"Paint stick" or "graffiti stick" shall mean a device containing a solid form of paint, chalk, wax, epoxy, or similar substance capable of being applied to a surface by pressure, and upon application, leaving a mark at least one-eighth (1/8th) of an inch in width

"Structures" shall mean any structure as defined in the City's Building Code, and shall include, but not be limited to, buildings, walls, fences, poles, signs, and cargo/shipping containers.

#### Graffiti Prohibition:

A. It shall be unlawful and a misdemeanor for any person to apply graffiti to any building, structure, tree, shrub, curb, or vehicle located within the City. It shall also be unlawful and a misdemeanor for any person to apply or affix any adhesive label to any building, structure, tree, shrub, curb, or vehicle not owned or lawfully possessed by such person, or without advance authorization by the owner thereof.

B. It is unlawful for the owner of any private property to permit graffiti to remain so as to be capable of being visible from any adjacent property (private or public), street, sidewalk, alley, or other public right-of-way or other area open to the public .

#### Possession of Graffiti Implements by Minors

A. It shall be unlawful and a misdemeanor for any person under the age of eighteen (18) years ("minor") to possess any graffiti implement while upon private property without the prior written consent of the owner of such property.

B. This section shall not apply to any minor attending, or traveling to or from school, at which time the minor is enrolled, if the minor is participating in a class at said school which has a written requirement of the class for the possession of the graffiti implements or if the minor's employment requires possession of any graffiti implement, provided the minor has written verification of any such job requirement and written consent from the employer which is dated and signed. The burden of proof in any prosecution for a violation of this section shall be upon the minor student to establish enrollment in a class or employment requires the possession of the graffiti class or employment requires the possession of the graffiti implements

#### 5-9-5: Furnishing Graffiti Implements to Minors Prohibited:

It shall be unlawful and a misdemeanor for any person, other than a parent or legal guardian, to sell, exchange, give, loan, or otherwise furnish, or cause or permit to be exchanged, given, loaned, or otherwise furnished, any graffiti implement to any person under the age of eighteen (18) years without the consent of the parent or other lawfully designated guardian, which consent shall be given in advance in writing.

9-6: Possession of Graffiti Implements Prohibited in esignated Public Places:

It shall be unlawful and a misdemeanor for any person to have in his or her possession any graffiti implement while in or upor any city-owned buildings, grounds, park or other city facility or while in or within ten (10) feet of an underpass, bridge, abut ment, storm drain, or similar types of infrastructure not normally used by the public, unless otherwise authorized by the City.

#### 5-9-7: Graffiti Constitutes a Nuisance

Pursuant to California Government Code Section 38771 the City Council hereby declares the maintenance of graffiti visible from any adjacent property (private or public), street, sidewalk, alley, or other public right-of-way or other area open to the public to constitute a nuisance, the abatement of which shall be provided as set forth in this Chapter.

#### 5-9-8: Graffiti Removal Requirement:

A. Any person applying graffiti within the City shall remove the same within twenty-four (24) hours after notice to said person by the City or by the public or private owner of the property involved. Failure of any person to remove graffiti shall constitute an additional violation of this Chapter. Where graffit is applied by an unemancipated minor, the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) shall also be responsible for such removal or for the payment therefor.

B. It is unlawful for any person who is the owner, or who has primary responsibility for control, repair or maintenance of private property, to permit the property to be defaced

with graffiti for a period in excess of three (3) days after service of notice by the City regarding the defacement of the property with graffiti.

C. For purposes of this chapter, the removal of

C. For purposes of this chapter, the removal or abatement of graffiti shall include the repair or replacement of the portion of the property defaced by graffiti, in the event that the graffiti cannot be removed cost effectively.

5-9-9: Abatement of Graffiti By City With Consent of Property Owner or Possessor

5-9-9: Abatement of Grainti by City With Consent of Property Owner or Possessor.

A. Whenever the Director of Community Development, or his or her designee, determines that graffiti is located on public or privately owned real or personal property within the City so as to be capable of being visible from any edicated transfer of the property (private or public) street sidewalk allow or

located on public or privately owned real or personal property within the City so as to be capable of being visible from any adjacent property (private or public), street, sidewalk, alley, or other public right-of-way or other area open to the public, the Director of Public Works and Transportation, is authorized to provide for the use of City funds for the abatement of the graffiti, or if the graffiti cannot be abated cost effectively, the repair or replacement of the portion of the property that was defaced, upon the following conditions:

1. In abating the graffiti, the painting, repair, and/or replacement of an area more extensive than where the graffiti is located shall not be authorized, except where the City owns the structure or property and the Director of Public Works and Transportation, or his or her designee, determines that a more extensive area must be repainted, repaired, and/or replaced, or where the private property owner agrees to pay for the costs of repainting, repairing, and/or replacing a more extensive area.

2. Where the structure or permanent surface is owned by a public entity other than the City, the removal of graffiti may be performed only after securing the consent of the public entity having jurisdiction over the structure or permanent surface and only after such entity executes an appropriate release and right of entry form permitting such graffiti removal.

3. Where the structure or permanent

graffiti removal.

3. Where the structure or permanent surface is privately owned, the removal of graffiti by City employees or by a private contractor under the direction of the City, may be performed only after securing the consent of the owner or possessor and only after the owner or possessor executes an appropriate release and right of entry form permitting such graffiti removal.

B. As an alternative to the procedure provided in subsection A above, upon discovering the existence of graffiti on a

B. As an alternative to the procedure provided in subsection A above, upon discovering the existence of graffiti on a privately owned structure or other permanent surface on privately owned property within the City so as to be visible from any public right-of-way or other public or private property, the property of Community Development, or his or her designee, shall have the authority to cause the abatement and removal thereof in accordance with the procedure set forth in Section 5-9-10.

5-9-10. Abatement of Graffiti By City Without Consent of Property Owner or Possessor.

A. If the consent of the private property owner or possessor of the property cannot be obtained, graffiti which is located on a privately owned structure or other permanent surface on privately owned property within the City and which can be viewed from any adjacent property (private or public), street, sidewalk, alley, or other public right-of-way or other area open to the public may be abated by the City at the owner's expense as a public nuisance pursuant to the following provisions:

The Director Development, or his or her designee, shall issue a three-day notice of intention to abate and remove the graffiti as a public notice of intention to abate and remove the graffiti as a public nuisance to the owners of the affected property and shall serve such notice in any of the following methods: (i) by personal service on the owner, occupant or person in charge or control of the property; (ii) by posting at a conspicuous place on the property or abutting public right-of-way; or (iii) by sending a copy of the notice by United States mail addressed to the owner or person in charge or control of the property, at the address shown on the last available assessment roll, or if the owner's address is unknown, then in care of the property address. Service by mail shall be complete at the time of deposit with the U.S. Postal Service, and service shall be made on the day the notice is dated and by affidavit, the original of which shall be filed with the City Clerk. The owner shall have three (3) days after the date of service of the notice to remove the graffiti or be subject to abatement of the graffiti by the City and assessment of the costs of such abatement as a lien or special assessment on the subject property.

2. The notice shall be on City letterhead in substantially the following form:

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ABATE GRAFFITI NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that you are required at your expense to remove or paint over the graffiti in existence on the property located at (address)

California, which is visible to public view, within three (3) days after the date of this notice.

The graffiti is visible to public view and, therefore, constitutes a public nuisance. If you fail to comply with this order, City employees, or private contractors employed by the City, will enter upon your property and abate the public nuisance by the removal or painting over of the graffiti. The cost of the abatement by the City employees, or its private contractors, will be assessed upon your property and such costs will constitute a lien or a special assessment upon the property until paid.

Any person having any objections to, or interest in, said matters may file wi nuisance to the owners of the affected property and shall serve such notice in any of the following methods: (i) by personal

ises for such purposes after obtaining a warrant authorizing the entry upon the property for abatement of the graffiti. 5-9-11: Assessment of Costs:

A. The personnel or persons who abate the nuisance under the provisions of this Chapter shall keep an account of the cost of abatement. Such personnel or persons shall submit to the City Council for confirmation an itemized report showing such costs. The City Council may modify the report if it is deemed necessary and shall confirm the report by motion or resolution.

B. Pursuant to Government Code Section 38773.5, the total cost of the abatement, including all administrative costs, shall constitute a special assessment against that parcel. After the assessment is made and confirmed, it shall constitute a special assessment on the parcel.

C. Such special assessment shall be collected at the

same time and in the same manner as ordinary municipal taxes are collected and shall be subject to the same penalties and the same procedures and sale in case of delinquency as provided for ordinary municipal taxes.

D. Alternatively, pursuant to Government Code Section 38773.1, the total cost of the abatement, including all administrative costs, shall constitute a lien against the property on which the nuisance is maintained. After the assessment is produced confirmed, it shall constitute a lien as the served. s made and confirmed, it shall constitute a lien on the parcel

E. Prior to a recordation of a lien or special assessment for the recovery of abatement and related administrative costs, the City, in accordance with California Government Code Section 38773.1 or 38773.5, shall provide written notification, by registered or certified mail, to the property owner that a lien or special assessment will be assessed against the

property.

F. As used in this subsection, the term "related administrative costs" includes, but is not limited to, court costs, attorneys fees, and the law enforcement costs incurred by the City in identifying and apprehending the minor or other person.

5-9-12: Abatement of Graffiti By City at Graffiti Perpetrator's Expense:

A

The expense of abatement of graffiti shall become A. The expense of abatement of graffiti shall become a lien against any property owned by any minor or other person creating, causing, or committing the nuisance and shall be a personal obligation of such minor or other person as set forth in Government Code Section 38772. The parent or guardian having custody and control of such minor shall be jointly and severally liable with the minor and the expense of abatement of such graffiti shall be a personal obligation and become a lien or an assessment on the property of such parent or guardian.

- Graffiti Nuisance Abatement Lien. The City may collect the costs of abatement of graffiti, as well as related administrative costs, by a graffiti nuisance abatement lien upon the lot or parcel of the minor or other person who applied administrative costs, by a graffiti nuisance abatement lien upon the lot or parcel of the minor or other person who applied graffiti to the property, or upon the lot or parcel of the parent or guardian of the minor. If the total costs of abatement of the graffiti are not paid to the City in full within ten (10) days after the date of the notice from the City of the City Council's determination regarding the costs of the abatement, the City Clerk may record, in the county recorder's office in the county in which the parcel of land is located, a graffiti nuisance abatement lien, which, from the date of recording, shall have the force, effect, and priority of a judgment lien. Prior to the recordation of the lien, notice of the lien shall be personally served upon the person owning the lot or parcel of land upon which the lien is sought, whether such person may be the minor, other person, or parent of guardian of the minor, in accordance with California Government Code Section 38773.2. The graffiti nuisance abatement lien shall specify the amount of the lien, that the lien is imposed on behalf of the City, the street address, legal description, and assessor's parcel number of the property, upon which the lien is imposed, and the name and address of the recorded owner of the property. The lien will continue in full force and effect until the entire amount due, is paid in full. The graffiti nuisance abatement lien may be foreclosed by an action brought by the City. As used in this subsection, the term "related administrative costs" includes, but is not limited to, court costs, attorneys fees, and the law enforcement costs incurred by the City in identifying and apprehending the minor or other person.
- Special Assessment. As an alternative to the procedure set forth in subsection (B) of this Section, the City may make the costs of abatement of graffiti, as well as related administrative costs as defined in subsection (B) of this Section, a special assessment against the lot or parcel owned Section, a special assessment against the lot or parcel owned by the minor or other person or by the parent or guardian having custody and control of the minor, as provided in Government Code Section 38773.6. If the total costs of the abatement of the graffiti are not paid to the City in full within ten (10) days after the date of the notice from the City of the City Council's determination regarding the costs of the abatement, the City may cause the total costs of abatement, including related administrative costs to be charged to the owner of the subject lot or parcel on the next regular tax bill. The assessment may be collected at the same time and in the same manner as ordinary municipal taxes are collected, and shall be subject to the same penalties and the same procedures in case of delinquency as provided for ordinary municipal taxes. All laws of the State applicable to the levy, collection and enforcement of municipal taxes are hereby made applicable to the special assessment.

#### 5-9-13: Penalties:

- A. Criminal Penalties. Any violation of this chapter shall constitute a misdemeanor offense and subject to the penalties set forth in Chapter 1-3 of this Code.
- Additional Penalties. Whenever deemed appro priate, it is the City's intent to petition a sentencing court to impose the following additional penalties or conditions of any grant or probation, diversion, deferred entry of judgment, or other court supervision (including upon a determination that a minor is to be a ward of the court as a result of committing an act of vandalism or graffiti) upon conviction:
- 1. Suspension or delay in issuance of driver's license (pursuant to California Vehicle Code section 13202.6);
- Community service and/or graffiti removal service (pursuant to California Penal Code sections 640.6 and 1203 et seq., Welfare & Institutions Code sections 728 and 729.8, and Vehicle Code section 42001.7).
- C. Cumulative Remedies. The remedies provided in this Ordinance are in addition to other remedies and penalties available under provisions of other applicable City ordinances, the laws of the State of California, or the laws of the United States."

Section 3. Severability. If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or petent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this Ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared

sions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, or invalid, or ineffective.

Section 4. Publication. #### **ORDINANCE NO. 06-O-2509**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS CREATING ANTI-GRIDLOCK ZONES TO PROHIBIT THE PARKING OF VEHICLES DURING PEAK HOURS AND AMENDING THE BEVERLY HILLS MUNICIPAL CODE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS

HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. California Vehicle Code section 22507 authorizes a city to restrict the stopping, parking or standing of vehicles on certain streets, or portions thereof. The City desires to amend the Municipal Code to create an institution of the control of the control of the control of the city desires to amend the Municipal Code to create an institution. "anti-gridlock zone" on major arterial roads to allow an additional, continuous lane for through traffic during peak hours of

Section 2. A new section 7-3-121 is hereby added to Article 1 of Chapter 3 of Title 7 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code to read as follows.

"7-3-121: Parking Prohibited in Anti-Gridlock Zones:

(a) For purposes of this section, the following words have the following meanings:

"Anti-Gridlock Zone" shall mean arterial streets designated by the Transportation Official on which the stopping, parking or standing of vehicles is prohibited during peak hours to ensure that the curb lane is available as an additional, continuous lane for through traffic in order to avoid gridlock during peak hours."

"Peak hours" shall mean the hours in which week-day traffic flow is the heaviest for the day as designated by the Transportation Official.

- (b) The Transportation Official is authorized to establish Anti-Gridlock Zones on any arterial streets in the City during peak hours.
- The Transportation Official shall place or caused to be placed signs on such streets giving notice of the Anti-Gridlock Zone and that any vehicle stopped, parked or left standing in violation thereof may be removed.
- (d) When signs authorized by the provisions of this section are in place giving notice of an Anti-Gridlock Zone, no person shall stop, park or leave standing any vehicle during the time and day period posted on such signs. Vehicles stopped, parked or left standing may be removed."

Section 3. Section 7.3.113 of to Article 1 of Chapter 3 of Title 7 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (a) Any vehicle which is parked or left standing in violation of this code upon a street for seventy two (72) or more consecutive hours from the issuance of a written warning or citation for the violation of this code shall be subject to removal.
- (b) Any vehicle which is stopped, parked or left standing in an Anti-Gridlock Zone as defined in Section 7-3-121 during peak hours in violation of this code shall be subject to removal."

Section 4. The City Council hereby finds that it Section 4. The City Council nerepy finds that it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility the adoption and implementation of this Ordinance may have a significant effect on the environment. The Ordinance is therefore exempt from the environmental review requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations.

Prior to the issuance of a completion certificate, the Contractor is required to file a Corner Record for survey monumentation that is replaced. All such survey work shall be performed under the supervision of a California lincensed Land Surveyor or a Civil Engineer authorized to perform

The Contractor shall provide the City a copy of the office calculations and documents submitted to the County for filing in con-

The payment for surveying, related professional services, office calculation, and furnishing all labor, materials, equipment, tools and incidentals, and for doing work involved shall be considered as included in the various items of work, and no additional compensation will be allowed therefore.

Section 3-3.2.2 shall be changed as follows:

(a) Labor. The costs of labor will be the actual cost for wages of workers performing the extra work at the time the extra work is done, plus the employer payments of payroll taxes, health and welfare, pension, vacation, apprenticeship funds, and other direct costs, resulting from Federal, State, or local laws, as well as assessments or benefits required by collective bargaining agreements.

The following will revise Section 3-3.2.3 of the Greenbook:

(a) Work by Contractor. An allowance for overhead and profit shall be added to the Contractor's cost as determined under 3-3.2.2 and shall constitute the full and complete markup for all overhead and profit on extra work performed by the Contractor. The Contractor shall be compensated for the actual increase in the Contractor's bond premium caused by the extra work. For costs determined under each subsection in 3-3.2.2, the markup shall be:

a) Labor	20%
b) Materials	15%
c) Tools & Equipment Rental	15%
d) Other Items	15%

(b) Work by Subcontractor. When any of the extra work is performed by a Subcontractor, the markup established in 3-3.2.3(a) shall be applied to the Subcontractor's costs as determined under 3-3.2.2. An allowance for the Contractor's overhead and profit shall be added to the sum of the Subcontractor's costs and markup and shall constitute the full and complete markup for all overhead and profit for the Contractor on work by the Subcontractor. For Contractor markup of Subcontractor's costs, the allowance shall be 10% on the first \$2,000 or portion thereof, and 5% on costs in excess of \$2,000.

LIQUIDATED DAMAGES - There will be a Five Hundred Dollar (\$500.00) assessment for each calendar day that work

PREVAILING WAGES - In accordance with the provisions of Section 1770 et seq., of the Labor Code, the Director of the Industrial Relations of the State of California has determined the general prevailing rate of wages applicable to the work to be done. The Contractor will be required to pay to all workers employed on the project sums not less than the sums set forth in the documents entitled "General Prevailing Wage Determination made by the Director of Industrial Relations pursuant to California Labor Code Part 7, Chapter 1, Article 2, Sections 1770, 1773, 1773.1".

A copy of said documents is on file and may be inspected in the office of the City Engineer, located in Room G10 of City Hall, at 455 North Rexford Drive, Beverly Hills, California 90210.

Attention is directed to the provisions of Sections 1777.5 and 1777.6 of the Labor Code concerning the employment of apptices by the Contractor or any subcontractor under him. The Contractor and any subcontractor under him shall comply the requirements of said sections in the employment of apprentices.

Information relative to apprenticeship standards and administration of the apprenticeship program may be obtained from the Director of Industrial Relations, San Francisco, California, or from the Division of Apprenticeship Standards and its branch

PAYROLL RECORDS - The Contractor's attention is directed to Section 1776 of the Labor Code, relating to accurate payroll records, which imposes responsibility upon the Contractor for the maintenance, certification, and availability for inspection of such records for all persons employed by the Contractor or by the Subcontractors in connection with the project. The Contractor shall agree through the Contract to comply with this section and the remaining provisions of the Labor Code.

INSURANCE AND BOND REQUIREMENTS - The Contractor shall provide insurance in accordance with Section 3-13 of the City of Beverly Hills, Public Works Department, Standard Contractual Requirements, included as part of these Specifications. In addition, the Contractor shall guarantee all work against defective workmanship and materials furnished by the Contractor for a period of one (1) year from the date the work was accepted in accordance with Section 2-11 of the Standard Contractual Requirements. The Contractor's sureties for the "Performance Bond" shall be liable for any work that the Contractor fails to replace within a specified time.

**GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS** - Bids must be submitted on the Proposal Form prepared for this project and shall be delivered at the office of the City Clerk within a sealed envelope supplied by the City and marked on the outside as follows: "STREET RESURFACING - VARIOUS LOCATIONS".
