

McCain Holds Beverly Hilton Fund-Raiser

Arizona Republican heads to Beverly Hills to raise funds

Sen. John McCain, R-Ariz., ventured into traditionally Democratic territory Tuesday by holding a \$1,000 per person luncheon at the Beverly Hilton to raise funds for his campaign for the Republican presi-

dential nomination.

The luncheon was closed to reporters and unlike a fund-raising reception last month at the Beverly Hilton for Illinois Sen. Barack Obama's campaign for the Democratic presidential nomination, there was no pool report.

McCain answered questions from reporters before the luncheon, lamenting the compressed schedule for the 2008 presidential campaign, saying the expected shift of primaries by California and several other large states reduces the "competitive environment."

"It puts increased importance on the first three states, Iowa, New Hampshire and South Carolina, and it doesn't give the party faithful a real opportunity to examine the candidates," McCain said.

As many as 19 states, including the costly-to-campaign-in states of California, New York, Florida, Illinois and New Jersey could hold primaries Feb. 5, when both parties' nominations are likely to be decided. The shift is also forcing an accelerating pace to fund-raising and for candidates to campaign nationally, instead of concentrating on the early states.

McCain's Beverly Hills fund-raiser came a day after another poll showed him falling further behind former New York City Mayor Rudy Giuliani in the race for the Republican presidential nomination.

Giuliani was supported by 34 percent of the 401 registered Republicans questioned in a survey taken for CNN Friday through Sunday, while McCain was preferred by 18 percent.

Former House Speaker Newt Gingrich,

who has said he will wait until the fall to announce whether he will be a candidate, and former Massachusetts Gov. Mitt Romney each had 9 percent. No other candidate received more than 3 percent.

The margin of error of the Opinion Research Corp. poll was 4.9 percentage points.

A poll conducted for CNN in late January put Giuliani at 32 percent and McCain at 26 percent.

Giuliani led McCain 44 percent-20 percent in a USA Today/Gallup poll released March 7.

McCain said he was "very happy where we are" in the polls.

"The polls jump around a lot," McCain said. "We are kind of in spring training, as you know. ... We are establishing a good political and financial base and that is what we have been looking for for a long time."

A Giuliani campaign official, who requested anonymity, said Giuliani's lead is growing because his "message of proven leadership and his record of results is resonating with voters."

Candidates in both parties are in a fund-raising frenzy in advance of the March 31 quarterly report deadline, a first test of the viability of their candidacies.

A candidate will need to raise \$100 million by the end of the year to be competitive, Federal Election Commissioner Michael Toner said recently.

The parade of candidates to Beverly Hills seeking funds is expected to continue next week when former North Carolina Sen. John

Edwards and Sen. Hillary Rodham Clinton, D-N.Y., are scheduled to hold fund-raisers in homes March 23 and March 24.

Weiss Starts Campaign For City Attorney

Los Angeles City Councilmember Jack Weiss, a 1982 Beverly High graduate, filed papers with the City Ethics Commission last week to officially become a candidate for Los Angeles City Attorney in 2009.

The position will become vacant because incumbent Rocky Delgadillo cannot run for re-election because of term limits.

Los Angeles Mayor Antonio Villaraigosa will chair Weiss' campaign, while former Mayor Richard Riordan will be its honorary chairman.

Weiss received his law degree from UCLA, where he was editor-in-chief of its law review after graduating with honors from Princeton University. He began his career as an assistant U.S. attorney before upsetting Tom Hayden to be elected to the City Council in 2001.

His mother Jacqueline was formerly a Beverly Hills Municipal Court Judge.

While at Beverly High, Weiss was also editor of "Highlights", the student newspaper.

"I believe my experience as a criminal prosecutor will allow me to effectively fight crime and gangs in Los Angeles and my experience in the workings of municipal government will allow me to save the taxpayers money by effectively representing the city in civil litigation," Weiss said. City Council: The Voters Have Spoken – Are You Listening?

The results of last Tuesday's City Council election were definitely a wake-up call to the Council and their current way of doing business.

We're hopeful the Council got the message loud and clear, and we'll see an improved attitude from them and city staff on some of the following issues:

- As their first regular meeting, the Council should correct their initial mistake and replace two hour free parking in all city lots.
- The Commission appointment

process needs to better reflect the viewpoint of individual Councilmembers and include a wider cross section of community opinions.

We'll get an idea of whether or not the Council is listening to the election returns when we see who they appoint to the Planning Commission, the city's most influential commission. There are two immediate vacancies (one prompted by **Shahram Melamed's** abrupt resignation; the other by **Nancy Krasne's** recent election to the Council). Two

more vacancies on the commission are coming up later in the year.

• **Maggie Soleimani** only missed getting elected to the Council by some 300 votes. Clearly this performance earns her a spot on the Planning Commission.

• We'd also like to see at least one of the four Planning vacancies go to someone who espouses the "slow growth" perspective (a point of view which was clearly ratified by **Nancy Krasne's** strong showing in almost every precinct). This could include residents like **Craig Corman**, **Gerald Lunn** (who has also been mentioned as a possible city treasurer candidate), **Valerie Wisot**, or even **Art Mishler**.

• We need more younger parents with school-age children in Beverly Hills public school appointed to our city commissions. Currently none of the five Councilmembers still have children in Beverly Hills public school (although the City Attorney does). This con-

stituency made up much of Soleimani's support base, yet they currently have a very small voice in our city government.

• Let's see some past or present Beverly Hills school faculty/staff who live in the city appointed to city commissions. This could include long-time residents like: **Merle Bauer**, **Marilyn Landau**, **Terry Brown**, **Susie Wallach**, **Linda Omansky**, **Janet Roston**, **Stephanie Schulman**, or **Craig Davis**. Currently there are no Beverly Hills teachers serving on any city commissions.

• Finally the city's communications department needs an "extreme makeover". Anyone who watched our election night program knows that the one thing the city truly doesn't effectively do these days is communicate.

By their actions, and not just their words, the Council needs to show us they got the wake-up call. We'll be watching.

Its Over, Now The Work Begins

Start With Appointing A Whole New Commission

You want to earn a doctorate in political science? Write a paper on the city council election and then make sure all the so-called political experts of Beverly Hills read your work because most were, to coin a phrase, clueless.

The conventional wisdom seemed reasonable, and it became the campaigns' mantra: Mayor **Steve Webb** would win, easily, and the second spot would go to either **Nancy Krasne**, **Maggie Soleimani** or **Jimmy Delshad**. After the fall out of the Farsi language translation, the "experts" were then convinced that **Jimmy Delshad** was out, Webb's lead would even widen and that the second office would go to either Krasne or Soleimani, with Krasne the most likely beneficiary of the Iranian language furor.

Before we examine, for the last time hopefully, some meanings and reasons for the "upset," a look at possible repercussions. Incidentally, although there may be some 300 ballots yet to be counted – and that

means up to 600 possible votes, the outcome is not likely to change. The only possibility would be some court challenges of alleged campaign irregularities and that seldom upsets results.

The changes in civic life will be obvious and almost immediate. Let's begin with **Barry Brucker**. He came on the council with an impressive first place win in 2005, but with few allies for his agenda, often finding himself at odds with his colleagues over both important and trivial issues. Then reconciliation happened.

Mayor Webb gave him almost every sub-committee assignment he wanted, he began working with the council in some measure of harmony and he even made peace with Councilmember **Linda Briskman**: They had major differences on the ethics ordinance.

However, the most surprising alliance was with Vice Mayor **Jimmy Delshad**.

Brucker had been a strong ally of

MeraLee Goldman and supported her strongly in her bid for reelection against Delshad in 2003. If any candidate seemed likely to have Brucker's backing it would have been Soleimani who worked diligently for Brucker two years ago. Brucker did give Maggie a nod, as he also did Webb, but he became Delshad's primary spokesperson, even hosting Jimmy's kickoff at his home.

Actually, the new alliance with Delshad didn't happen suddenly. Delshad became a second vote on many Brucker issues including the ethics ordinance and several zoning matters.

Had Delshad lost, Brucker would have some heavy fence mending to do, but now he can almost, but not quite, play the role of king maker. Not quite, because there were so many other unpredictable glitches in the council race.

It is entirely possible that a new majority, with an entirely different agenda, will emerge, but nothing is absolutely certain in this volatile situation. If Krasne, Brucker and Delshad find common ground, they could bring many changes to city government.

What will be the council's first real challenge? Filling two and possibly even four seats on the Planning Commission and, trust us, every developer is nervously awaiting their choices. The plans for six or seven

major projects now are all in some political suspension, with the possible exception of 9900 Wilshire which seems to have less community or even this council opposition than most of the others.

This is a great opportunity for the council to fill those vacancies with some really talented, able people. The Planning Commission has not had the confidence of the council for many months and has been reversed on major land use proposals often.

Instead of waiting for people to apply, the council should aggressively seek out outstanding candidates, many of whom may not want to put their own names forward without some encouragement.

So far, several names are already being talked about. These include **Nan Cole**, no relation, who is a recently appointed member of the Public Works Commission. Brucker recently introduced her to us and called her one of the best appointments the city ever made. The other name mentioned is that of **Virginia Maas**, a former school board president who lost her bid for reelection in 2003. Her chances diminished somewhat with the departure of Webb.

Others who should be considered are **Lili Bosse Lou Milkowski**, **Marty Geimer**, **Gloria Seiff**, **Ken Goldman**, **Victor Bardack** and **Maggie Soleimani** – all able and qualified.

Going outside would also make good sense: Imagine if **Richard Rosenzweig** or **Samuel K. Freshman** were willing to serve? Richard is one of our most respected community leaders and Freshman is a nationally recognized authority on real estate law and a

long time resident.

There are two immediate vacancies on the commission. Krasne, because of her election to the council, and **Shahram Melamed** who suddenly resigned last week following his loss in the council race. I think we can understand Melamed's decision, even though it left a void on a commission in the middle of long standing project deliberations. Whatever our disagreements on issues and in the campaign, he and his family have given many years of service to our city and he deserves our gratitude for his past contributions.

Two other members of the commission's terms will expire late this year – **Kathy Reims** and **Stacy Marks**. There are good reasons why they too should leave, and those have nothing to do with their abilities, only some political realities. They had too many issues with their former colleague, soon to be Councilmember Krasne, to have a comfortable relationship with the new city council. They were also reversed too often in what became a plethora of miscommunications with the council, not entirely their fault.

It just makes good sense to not wait for their terms to end at the end of the year, but find a whole new commission majority that can learn to work together, and with the council and the professional staff, as we enter the final stages of adopting a new General Plan for the city. Yes, we lose some experience and continuity, but we gain in new leadership, closer cooperation.

The council may rush to fill the Melamed vacancy immediately, bypassing interview processes. This is likely to happen, but it

would not be wise to do this before Krasne takes her seat on the council. She served on the commission and should be part of the selection procedure. She was the clear first choice in the election.

Some sidebars on the election: As we said last week, Delshad benefited from Webb's urging his supporters to give their second votes to him. At the same time, Delshad's were splintered among other candidates. Clearly, Delshad's appeal to Iranian voters and the pride they would have in electing the first Persian mayor in our city's history worked and led to mammoth defections from Soleimani and probably cost her the election. Soleimani led in several precincts but was hurt by the ballot fallout. In a sense, that issue galvanized the Iranian community behind Delshad.

Before the community becomes too concerned about appeals to voters because of their ethnicity, the same arguments have been made in our country for greater representation by gender and race. In Beverly Hills, it wasn't until the late 1960s that we elected our first female councilmember and it was over 30 years before the first member of the Jewish community was elected to the council or school board.

Delshad was not elected by the Iranian community in his first try – he won because of an endorsement issue. Interestingly, his vote then was almost the same as this year. In 2003 his total was 2,417 and this year, 2,579. As for Soleimani who finished strong and will be a major force in government, she had more votes in losing, 2,299 than Linda Briskman had in 2001 when she won with

received 2,033 votes.

There were many complaints about this election, some that need clarification. The most serious was identification of voters. Although it is a crime to vote if you are not a legal resident of the city, federal rules make it unlawful to ask for identification at the polling place, as amazing as that seems. Last minute smears on candidates, unsigned distribution pieces, disputes on forum sponsorship, voters registered at postal boxes, enforcement of spending limits and much more need urgent attention, not just for this election, but for future integrity in the process. The city needs a citizen election committee to study ways of making our elections both more efficient and transparent.

While we should welcome any and all candidates, we might want to increase filing requirements. Candidates without any real support qualify by finding 20 voters willing to sign their nominating papers and then are able to appear at every forum. It may require changes in state law, but that number should reflect a larger proportion of voters. Having at least 200 signatures would at least demonstrate some broader voter appeal.

A word about Mayor **Steve Webb**. He leaves city government after decades of service on the council, two city commissions and a city study committee. He loved this city, worked hard at making it better and gave of his time and energy far beyond what was demanded of him. He and Bonnie deserve our expressions of appreciation for the enormous sacrifices they made for all of us. Even when we disagreed, we know he did what he thought was right and did so with integrity

and commitment.

Congratulations to soon to be mayor Jimmy Delshad. He and Nancy Krasne can help pull our community back together as we face the daunting task of adopting a new General Plan.

One final thought: The Beverly Hills election received considerable attention outside our community and mostly because of the Farsi ballot issue. Labeling our community bigoted was ludicrous. Just as many Iranians as non-Iranians questioned the need for the translation and design.

The results of the election speak for themselves. **Jimmy Delshad** could not have led Mayor **Steve Webb** without non-Iranians support and Maggie Soleimani made her impressive showing with non-Iranians votes. Was it an issue? Of course. Are there cultural issues? Yes. But this community – the vast majority, judge people on their worth, not their country of origin. For the small minority who voiced bigotry, you did us harm, but we will survive and move on together as we always do. We were not, as some argue, torn apart. The healing we need goes deeper and has to do with the quality of life decisions we need to address.





MAYOR WEBB REFLECTS

BH Weekly: What were your priorities as mayor this year? What were you most proud of accomplishing?

Steve Webb: My priorities as Mayor this year included the formation of the Mass Transit Committee and getting their input so that the City could take a formal position relative to The extension of what had been referred to as the Red Line, making certain that all future development in the city was environmental sustainable and becoming a "green" city, attempting to complete the general plan process, cleaning up our streets, sidewalks and alleys and enhancing our recreational park facilities. In one degree or another the City took great strides with respect to all of the above priorities.

Tell us about the role of being mayor, from your perspective, and how is it different than just being a Councilmember? To what degree is it the mayor's role to unify the whole council?

Being Mayor carries a number of additional responsibilities beyond that of a council member. First and foremost, the Mayor sets the agenda for the Council meetings and leads the discussions. The Mayor alone controls the conduct of the meeting, who speaks and when, the amount of time allotted to the public to speak, etc. Secondly, the Mayor has responsibility with respect to important issues to build consensus among his or her fellow Council Members. This does not mean the need to obtain unanimity; however, I believe that a good Mayor, even if there is a three to two vote, should try to take in to account the views of the minority Council Members and incorporate amendments where appropriate in an effort to try and achieve unanimity in appropriate circumstances. The Mayor also makes committee assignments which play a critical role in the ultimate decisions that are made by the Council. More often than not, the Council will adopt recommendations from its sub-committees and so sub-committees can have great influence on Council decisions. Finally, and of equal importance, the Mayor is the face and voice of the City in various public forums and to the press.

Prior to serving on the Council, you served on the Traffic & Parking and Planning Commissions. In your opinion is commission service a pre-requisite to serving on the Council?

I don't believe that serving on a City commission is a pre-requisite to serving on the Council IF the individual has comparable background experience. For example, Jimmy Delshad did not serve on a commission, however, he served on the Board of Directors and

then was President of Sinai Temple, a very large organization, and founded and ran a very successful business enterprise.

What city staff members, specifically, will you most remember working with?

Please keep in mind that I have worked with city staff for almost twenty years starting when I served as co-chair of the Livable Streets Committee and worked closely with Maria Rychicki, who is certainly one staff member that I will miss. When I served on the Traffic and Parking Commission I worked closely with Aaron Kunz and have continued to do so through my tenure on the Council. When I served on the Planning Commission I worked with Mahdi Aluzri who recently left the city. Before serving on the Council I worked closely with the entire staffs of both the Transportation Department and the Planning Departments and they of course will all be missed.

Having served on the Council now for four years it would take me forever to list all of the staff people who I have worked closely with and will miss. Amy McHarg is the staff person assigned to the Mayor and Council and I could not have handled this last year without her invaluable assistance. As an attorney, I truly appreciate the advice and counsel of our City Attorney Larry Wiener. The city is truly fortunate to have somebody of his caliber providing us with legal advice and counsel, especially considering that he grew up here and is a resident of our city. Finally of course, I will miss working with Rod Wood, our City Manager, who has done an excellent job in re-organization city staff and cutting out a lot of fat in the city's budget.

In what ways was your 2007 campaign different than your 2003 campaign, and what did you learn about yourself this time around?

The difference between this year's campaign and the one in 2003, is that this time as the Mayor and incumbent I was criticized for everything that was supposedly wrong with this city, including traffic congestion, ugly houses, the loss of Dutton's Bookstore and of course, for many things that just weren't true, such as the alleged agreement to widen Santa Monica Boulevard which everyone will now learn was not true.

To what degree do you think the voters were trying to send a "protest" message to city hall given the election results?

I think it is somewhat difficult to interpret the election results because there were so many different factors and influences in play. When the Hilton Hotel held its Press Conference and announced its plans for the new Waldorf Astoria, the community incor-

rectly assumed that this is a project that had been reviewed and approved by the city, which it had not. This announcement heightened the community's anxiety relative to the potential of over-development in the city. This was unfortunate considering that there were only two commercial projects in the past year that have been conditionally approved, the Legacy Project on Wilshire and the office retail building at Robertson and Wilshire, both of which are relatively small projects. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the community sees the 300,000 cars that pass through our city and it becomes easy for them to blame that on development within the city rather than focusing their anger and frustration at Century City, Westwood, downtown Los Angeles, etc.

Certainly the Farsi translation on the ballot influenced some voters and again the belief of others that the City Council had approved the widening of Santa Monica Boulevard, had an impact.

What are your post-Council plans?

First and foremost I need to get back to the full time practice of law and spend more time with my family. I am going to also spend some time with my son helping him with his Carvel Ice Cream store (hopefully I won't gain any weight), and as I have for the past twenty five years, will continue to volunteer my time to certain community based organizations in the city.

In addition, I will remain a community activist speaking out with respect to those issues that I feel are important which will include giving input relative to certain proposed provisions to the General Plan, continued advocacy for the expansion of the Westside Subway, enhancement of our recreational and park facilities and the need for a community center at whatever location the Council feels is best.

Do you think the Community Sports Center proposal will be shelved due to you leaving the Council?

No, I don't believe that the community center will be shelved. Please keep in mind that every candidate stated that they supported in concept a New Community Center. The only disagreement was the nature and extent of such a center and where it should be located. The city will immediately look at proposals for enhancement of the recreational

facilities at Roxbury and La Cienega Park. The question will be whether or not those are appropriate locations for what is being proposed and how will it be paid for.

The real question is what will be done with the 5 1/2 acres of city land that is located in what is referred to as the industrial area. I had proposed that half of that land be used for a community recreation center and the other half leased out for residential or commercial use, the income from which would support a revenue bond to build the community center. Others in the community believe that the 5 ? acres should be left empty just in case there may be some use for municipal uses sometime in the future. Others might propose that the entire five and one half acres be turned into an office complex with an emphasis on the entertainment industry.


Your family, including your wife Bonnie, played a major role in your campaign. Do you want to recognize or thank any of your supporters?

I couldn't and wouldn't have run for office without the support of my wife. Unfortunately this became a very unpleasant experience for her this time due to the continuous attacks on my integrity. I certainly had a great campaign team with Julie Steinberg as my campaign manager and Judie Fenton's sage advice and counsel. I had a wonderful group of residents who gave of themselves in volunteering their time and energy for my re-election. Unfortunately, this may become a thing of the past since some of the candidates hired canvassers to walk precincts for them. Simply put, I could not have asked for a better campaign team and I thought they did a phenomenal job. The fact that I failed to win re-election lies at my feet. I was unable to make my case to the voters.

What advice will you give to the new Council?

The new Council is really the old Council, simply without me. I don't think they need my advice and I am confident that they will continue to do an exceptional job in representing what is in the best interest of the residents of this community. I hope they will continue with the course that they have been on and not make any drastic or radical changes in their priorities or philosophies simply because of the election results.




