

Board of Education Approves Single Site Plan for Student Achievement

District addresses communication, math strategies and bullying

The BHUSD presented its plan of action to raise the academic performance of students and improve the school's educational program. The single site plan for levels K-12 aligns district goals with local, state and federal resources and requirements. The Board of Education unanimously approved the site plans Tuesday night.

Single Site plans are required by the Education Code regulations and state law and ask for all the school site councils to develop and approve a plan with goals for student achievement for schools participating in programs funded through the consolidated application process.

"These are measurable and differentiated goals," said Board of Education member Myra Lurie. "Just as we look at differentiated instruction, child by child, we see the differentiated needs site by site, which has always been the intention of site improvement funding."

Assistant Superintendent Dr. Ilene Straus presented the K-12 site goals to the Board of Education.

According to Straus the goals for Beverly High required coordination with a lot of groups. The larger the school, the more complicated the process.

Benchmark assessments were at the top of the list for Beverly High. The goal is to have courses within the Science, Math, English, History and Foreign Language create and administer quarter and semester standard based assessments. Focus will also be directed at engaging students within the classroom, the goal is to increase classroom participation by 50 percent.

Algebra is another main issue for Beverly High, based on new standards students must pass Algebra in order to graduate. The goal for Beverly High is to increase the percentage of students to 80 percent who score proficient or above on the 2007-2008 Algebra California

Standards Test (CST) in the 9th grade.

"Algebra is a target course for 8th grade and mandatory in 9th grade. We have also increased our standards so all students are enrolled in Algebra this year and we are really focused on our struggling Algebra students to make sure all students are proficient," said Straus.

Moreno High, which is the continuation school, was also analyzed, and part of the main goal is to have students complete each module of instruction with 75 percent mastery, and have students increase their scale score by 10 percent on the STAR assessment.

The courses offered at Moreno High are not college preparatory, they are courses taken to satisfy high school graduation requirements.

The middle schools all had tailored goal plans. Beverly Vista will focus on the level of math literacy, reading time, and increasing communication among students to share perspectives.

El Rodeo presented a target plan by grade levels. One of the main goals for all teachers is to provide opportunities for students to share meaningful thinking with others 50 percent of the time through the implementation of well-planned questions.

The school will also target students in grades 4-8 who have problems in mathematics.

"This is a really important strategy, when you focus on which students need intervention. El Rodeo has made that choice in mathematics," said Straus.

Hawthorne and Horace Mann will also focus on mathematics.

For Hawthorne expectations are to have 80 percent of all students score proficient or advanced on the mathematics CST and to have 80 percent of the students in grades K-5 score a 3 or 4 on the mathematics benchmarks. Whereas Horace Mann wants to focus having 65 percent of students in grades K-5 earn scores of 3 or 4.

Each K-8 schools tailored their site plan based on student performance and the needs of the school.

A key concept that Hawthorne will focus on is stopping student bullying. One of their goals is to have 95 percent of all students learn how to identify the signs of bullying and provide students with the

tools and strategies to use in situations where they maybe confronted.

"Again you are watching some school safety behaviors and interpersonal relationships come out of the K-8 plan," said Straus.

Beverly High Coordinator of Special Events and Professional Development Diane Mead said for underperforming schools there are requirements to meet goals over time and there are progressive consequences for failure to meet those goals.

"None of our schools are underperforming," said Mead. "School progress toward goals with data to support that progress is one of the requirements to be considered for state Distinguished School and national Blue Ribbon recognitions, both of which our district and community value."

According to Board of Education President Myra Demeter education is changing all the time and creating a site plan that highlights the positive and the negatives allows for positive change.

"It is exactly by admitting your flaws that you are able to set and achieve your goals," said Demeter.

Every single site plans for student achievement must be developed by the school site council The site plans must also be reviewed and approved by the Board of Education annually and/or whenever there are any material changes that affect the academic programs for students.

"What many people don't understand is that this is a fluid document that has evolved," said Demeter. "This document

is really putting together all the different pieces and I think that is what's so significant. This puts together in a living document the WASC recommendations, the goals for the district, it personalizes the goals for the schools that are linked to the goals of the district and WASC goals. Each one of the them is unique to the school."

"WASC" stands for the Western Association of Schools and Colleges, which is one of six regional associations that accredit public and private schools.

"The school is required in their action plan to address the recommendations and required goals provided by WASC during the length of their accreditation, and to show progress and effort toward addressing those recommendations," said Mead. "When the accreditation team revisits to monitor progress toward those recommendations, they look for evidence in the school plan and documentation to support the school's efforts to meet their goals."

Every five years a new plan must be submitted to the state. Currently, BHUSD's plan remains in effect until 2008.

Demeter addressed the five school principals.

"I know that at times you have felt uncomfortable, and I know at time you felt that you were being stretched, and asked to do a lot, but I think that the result is very evident. You have each grown professionally and becoming wonderful leaders of each site," said Demeter. "I think that out of this feeling is a feeling of self-satisfaction, leadership, drive and goals."

Food, Strike and More

Once around very lightly

It may be one of the best kept secrets of the new year, but a leading restaurateur in America, **Joachim Splichal**, has opened a new eatery in Beverly Hills called, and don't ask me what the name means, the Paper Fish.

Doing what the industry calls a "soft opening" the newest entry in the dining industry of our village is at what used to be the Maple Drive. Loved their chicken in the pot and occasional jazz offerings.

Splichal, founder and chief of the Patina Group, also runs the new restaurant in the Disney Center. Our newest restaurant is in the home office building of New Pacific, the original developers of the 9900 Wilshire project. The restaurant began by serving lunch only, but is now also open for dinner.

Since the closing of Maple Drive, all those new entertainment groups that have made the former Industrial Area, now Entertainment District, their home have

been without a walk- to dining resource.

You may also have missed some ambitious plans being considered by the ICM talent agency for that same area of our city. ICM had left Beverly Hills for Century City when they could not, according to their recent comments at a city council hearing, find sufficient space to keep their people at one location.

ICM has now acquired the rights, with a developer they have chosen, to present plans and concepts for city owned land on what was to have been the Sports and Community Center. It would be a lease, not a purchase deal.

The surprise element in their plans: Creation of a "five star" luxury hotel along with a building large enough to house the whole ICM organization.

Somehow, the hotel idea has not yet received much scrutiny, although it is no secret and has been very much a part of the council discussions. Approval would

require the council first buying into the final proposal and agreeing to a contract with ICM and their partner developers, and then the laborious planning process.

How the immediate neighborhood will react to these plans will be interesting. Although not as close to residential, when a medical use, actually a surgery center, was on the table, area residents effectively organized opposition and the use, meant to house a cancer research group as well as a surgery facility, failed to gain city approval.

There is something about hotels that draw more opposition than most other developments, however, is that realistic? Every traffic study proves that hotels generate far less traffic than any other use except residential developments. Hotels are also, by far, our most significant source of tax revenues. Compare hotels to comparable size retailers or mammoth discount stores or, better yet, medical buildings, and you will see the advantages of hotels.

But, is the Industrial Area, whoops, Entertainment District, the right place for a "luxury" hotel? This area is one of the few in the city that witnessed a rapid change in zoning some 30 years ago. Then it evolved from single family (R1) to multi apartments and later condominiums

(R4).

An even broader issue is best possible use, and this is very pertinent because the property is owned by the city. The city did have several proposals on the table for various kinds of housing. In the bidding process was the Snyder Group and G and K Realty. Both have long and successful histories in residential development; and why new housing wasn't considered as important as an entertainment - hotel complex is puzzling. Yes, ICM and a hotel bring more revenue than an apartment building, but we also have a critical need for housing, including moderate and affordable apartments and condos. This would have been a good place to consider incentives for housing for city and school workers and for families with school age children.

Where are all the vocal opponents of the Sports Center and the medical complex down the street? Having won their battles, they should continue to be engaged in the planning process.

Some notes for history buffs: In the early 1960s, the Victor family brought a proposal for a 200 bed hospital to be created on property they owned in the then Industrial Area to the city.

The opposition was fierce. First, the Litton organization, the then major defense contractor with home offices in Beverly Hills, wanted to expand into the Industrial Area. They acquired the building across from city hall MCA once owned, and did not want increases in that area's land value.

Also opposing the hospital plan, just as they did the more recent surgery center, was Cedars Sinai. Together, they marshaled strong opposition among area residents.

As you know, Beverly Hills never has had a people serving hospital, just places that care for animals. Cedars dealt the hospital proponents a jolt.

They unveiled plans, at a formal city council meeting considering the appeal by the Victor group, for a massive non-profit hospital of 1,000 beds near Wilshire and Veteran in Westwood. This was to prove that our region did not need any more hospitals. I drive by that area frequently and, although it has been 40 years, I have yet to see the start of construction.

What replaced what was to be called the Beverly Hills Hospital? The main Beverly Hills Post Office. Two hundred bed hospital? Post office?

Speaking of Cedars-Sinai, and all history aside, it is still one of the finest medical institutions in the country, their public relations office missed a somewhat significant part of the news they recently released.

The hospital proudly announced that a Beverly Hills resident, **Dr. Willie Brien**, had been elected chief of staff. However, somewhere in their news release they might have found room to mention that Dr. Brien is the grandson of former California governor and later Chief Justice of the United States, the late **Earl Warren**. I think they also failed to note that our Willie is a former president of the Board

of Education.

There has been much moaning and groaning on our loss of the annual Golden Globes event this year because the Writers Guild strike kept other union members from participating. But was all that anguish warranted?

The Golden Globes are an incredibly valuable resource for Beverly Hills.

Few if any events held in our city gain anywhere near the exposure and name promulgation we receive from the foreign press produced award ceremony. Having it at the great Beverly Hilton was a big plus.

True, we had some cancellations of rooms, and at one of the worst periods for hotels, however, occupancy rates were about the same as last year when the Golden Globes did function. As for banquets, their cancellations were not as deep as first thought. For many reasons, we don't have sufficient places for all the events, from fund raising dinners to wedding, we need, – and there is always a long waiting list at most of our hotels. Some cancellations because of the Globes were quickly filled. As for restaurants, they experienced about the same traffic as last year. There were other, significant peripheral regional economic losses, just not as direct a hit on our city as reported.

Which brings us to the core issue: The real, human impact of the Writer's strike is on the lives, not only of the writers, but

the entire industry including related service businesses. Here the impacts have been horrendous. (See story on page 10)

Federal arbitration efforts have not worked; the parties are not even engaging in meaningful collective bargaining and there are accusations of attempts to bust the union and, on the other side, demand being made that can not even be measured much less implemented.

It is time for intervention and who better to make the effort than our union card carrying governor who has very strong ties in many sectors of the entertainment industry.

I know Gov. **Arnold Schwarzenegger** has been asked by many in and out of the industry to try to work out a settlement, but I have an idea that may be more palatable for the guy that still shares dining tables with me at Caffe Roma. True he can't light his cigar and my pipe is quiet, but we do have that restaurant, if not our politics, in common. Actually, he has done some really good work as governor and my Democratic bent approves. As for cuts in education, well maybe we should get back to settling the strike.

Here's the idea: The governor appoints a personal, unofficial committee of two or three respected industry leaders, people not directly involved in the current negotiations, to act as arbitrators. If their efforts aren't successful, and if they are truly without conflict or interest, they could make their findings public and, if everything else fails, cause members of the two groups to force a settlement. It would be

very hard for the union or the industry to reject a rational compromise.

Long before he became governor and not just another celebrity who enjoyed the pasta, we would, on rare occasions talk politics. It was hard not to, we had adjoining tables. So, trading on that slim chance of a memory flash, I did call his office yesterday to offer my thoughts of an arbitration panel.

Who will turn out the lights? Major city department and division heads are at a "retreat" in Ojai and Mayor **Jimmy Delshad** is in New York, returning from a trip to Europe.

Reactions to last week's offering: **Barry Brucker** is not yet prepared to give up any of his term so **Frank Fenton** could leave the council as mayor. Councilmember **Nancy Krasne** was reportedly willing to give back to Brucker some of his lost days if and when she became mayor. There are practical, mechanical as well as political arguments against shortened terms, no matter how well intentioned.

Linda Briskman reiterated her plans not to run for a third term despite my threat to endorse her and thus guarantee her loss.



GLOBES DENT BEVERLY HILLS; COULD OSCARS BE NEXT?

Local business owners fear continuing effects of writers' strike

For over 30 years Beverly Hills has welcomed the star studded Golden Globe Awards Show. But the ceremony that awards the best in the television and film industry saw its longstanding tradition broken this year due to the Writers Guild strike, ultimately affecting local businesses throughout Beverly Hills.

"The Golden Globe Awards Show is certainly the highlight of the year," said Beverly Hilton Director of Public Relations Lynda Simonetti. "We had hoped the show would go on for all the entities involved."

Due to the Writers Guild strike the Hollywood Foreign Press Association (HFPA) cancelled the awards and replaced it with an hour-long press conference at the Beverly Hilton to reveal the recipients.

"At the end of the day, our mission is to execute an event whether grand and glamorous or simply informative to honor those winners," said Simonetti.

Although the Beverly Hilton serves as a venue for over 175 red carpet events per year, the cancellation of the Golden Globes also resulted in loss of revenue from lack of room occupancy to terminations in catering orders.

"As with any group business that results in a cancellation, there is an economic impact," said Simonetti. "However, we have a strong partnership with the Hollywood Foreign Press Association and all of the entities involved and therefore, look forward to next year's Globes."

Bread & Butter Catering and Event Planning owner Michael Brooks said his business has seen a drop in revenue since the writers strike began.

"We began catering a lot of events for writers but after a few weeks things shifted," said Brooks. "It's unfortunate that the Golden Globes were cancelled."

Brooks whose catering company is located on Robertson said that over the last year has catered over a dozen studio screenings and says everyone is scaling back since the strike began.

"I have catered over 15 private screening parties," said Brooks. "You name the movie and I've probably catered the event."

Although he has been able to build a close relationship with the Hollywood Foreign Press Association, Brooks is concerned with the ramifications the cancellation of the Golden Globes will have on future events. This includes whether the industry will continue to have such extravagant events.

"I am a luxury tool," said Brooks. "I am concerned."

But with the Golden Globes now being history, many wonder if the Academy

Awards will also fall victim since the Writers Guild did not grant waivers for members to work on the Oscars.

"There is a concern of the Oscars being cancelled. I don't think that has ever happened, but there is always a first," said The Woods Exquisite Flowers Vice President George Woods. "Our business would probably be hurt."

Known as one of the top floral companies to service entertainment hosted events, located off San Vicente Boulevard, The Woods Exquisite Flowers shop, lost approximately 35 percent of its business due to the cancellation of the Golden Globes.

"Business comes from various avenues such as entertainers, publicists, studios, and actors," said Woods. "You definitely did not see the post flower arrangements being ordered. Usually fellow celebrities or publicists will order congratulatory arrangements."

Woods has been in business for over 20 years and says he has never experienced such a phenomenon.

"This strike and the cancellation of the Golden Globes proves that we are a small city driven by entertainment," said Woods. "[The strike] is like a heat wave, you just have to live through it."

Muguet Flower owner Thomas Muguet on Rodeo Drive said he lost 75 percent of his business.

"With the [Golden Globes] suspended we lost a large amount of revenue. Because of our location, we depend heavily on the awards season," said Muguet. "25 percent of our orders for the Oscars have already been cancelled. Companies don't know if they want to host Oscar parties or to what extent they want to throw their bashes."

Beverly Hills Administrative Services Director and Chief Financial Officer Scott Miller said the cancellation of the Golden Globes overall would have a minimum effect on the city's transient occupancy tax, which comes from hotel visitors.

"We feel this way because the hotels are already at 80-85 percent capacity and that many if not most of the participants in the Golden Globes are locals or are guests of locals," said Miller. "The major factor is sales tax and most sales tax is generated by restaurants. This could have a material effect on the restaurants, especially if private parties were cancelled. However, we have heard that many of the private parties were still held-so we may not see as much of a material effect as first thought."

Miller said the city would see an effect if the Hollywood Foreign Press Association used Beverly Hills services for the event

such as florists, party supplies, or limousine services.

"But there is no way to measure that with any accuracy," said Miller. "However, we also don't know if many of the services they have used in the past were LA based firms or Beverly Hills based firms."

Beverly Hills Nexus Chauffeured Limousine owner Joan Alvarad estimates he lost approximately \$10,000 in revenue due to lack of activity last Sunday.


"The cancellation of the Globes had a domino affect," said Alvarad. "Our business was down significantly. We get calls from major limousine companies, management offices, hotels, restaurant and this year most of our business was cancelled."

According to Alvarad many drivers are in fear of the Academy Awards being cancelled and some have talked about getting part-time jobs to make up for the revenue loss.

"We are already booked for the Oscars, so if they were to cancel, it would greatly impact us," said Alvarad. "The studios can definitely weigh out for another eight to nine months. In the meantime the strike is having a chain effects on all sectors."

Vice Mayor Barry Brucker agrees that the Writers' strike had a rippling effect on many services.

"So many services like beauty salons, restaurants, hotel, and taxi companies were affected by the strike," said Brucker. "I think the Writers Guild, although passionate on their point of view, damaged not only the [Golden Globes] but took revenue out of a host of service producers in [Beverly Hills]. It's unfortunate for all parties concerned."

According to Miller, the cancellation of the Golden Globes meant less work and overtime for Beverly Hills police, fire and public works personnel.

"It saves the city a little in expenses, since our rates do not cover 100 percent of our direct and indirect costs, but again that would be an immaterial amount," said Miller.

The Academy Awards are scheduled to air Sunday, February 24 on ABC.


