

## KBEV to Induct Hall of Fame Members

Beverly High's TV station KBEV will induct five high school alumni and two retired faculty into its newly created Hall of Fame.

The first group of inductees include Dan Bruck ('74), Stephen Buchsbaum ('75), Scott Izen ('79), Jim Vines ('81) and Weekly Publisher Josh Gross ('91).

Retired faculty former Beverly High Media Director Dusty Stiles (1970-2005) and former Journalism teacher Gil Chesterton (1969-2002) will also be inducted into the Hall of Fame. Daniel Audell ('06) will receive the Bosse Angel Award for his volunteer work for the school's media center.

The first annual induction ceremony will take place Thursday, June 3 during the KBEV Telethon between 6 p.m. and 8 p.m. in the

media center TV studio.

The KBEV Hall of Fame recognizes former students who distinguished themselves in Beverly's media center and in journalism activities while they were students at the high school.

Stiles said both he and current Media Director Romeo Carey compiled a list of about 30 students to be inducted into the Hall of Fame.

"I'm starting with the early ones," Stiles said. "The idea from my perspective is to bring in five or six at a time. I'm working from the back from people from the early years and acknowledging people who made major contributions to the media center at a time when we didn't offer awards."

Stiles said though the Hall of Fame would only be open to alumni, the newly created

Dusty Stiles Award and Gil Chesterton Award will be presented to students who participated and contributed heavily to the media center and journalism program.

"Bruck was one of the first group of students I had there," Stiles said. "The main thing I remember about him was he became



very frustrated when the equipment wouldn't work, and he began taking machines apart and putting them back together to keep them running."

Stiles said Buchsbaum worked with Bruck, directing and running programming.

"[Buchsbaum] was one of the students who kept things moving," Stiles said. "Josh Gross was a [Norman] news anchor. Izen and Vines did a show called 'Monty Python's Younger Brother.'"

Stiles said the show is still on YouTube and on the Izen-Vines Web site.

"They stretched what a studio could do as part of that show," Stiles said. We did experimenting in lighting and settings. They wrote scripts, and then we shot those scripts and put them together. They gave us an idea of what was possible with next to nothing."

#### Permit Ringleader Loses Appeal

The BHUSD prevailed against opportunity permit parents in three hearings this week with the Los Angeles County Board of Education.

All three students were eighth graders entering their freshman year at Beverly High.

"I'm grateful that LACOE chose to stand by our school district's decision," said Board of Education President Steven Fenton.

Board member Brian Goldberg said he was also "pleased with the direction LACOE is headed."

"We are very optimistic that LACOE is going to continue to uphold the natural breaking point and not allow the students to continue on to the middle schools or high school," said Board of Education member Brian Goldberg. "But I can't emphasize enough that it's case-by-case so we're going to have to continue to go down there and articulate our argument."

One of the parents whose child lost an appeal was Michelle Menna, who, as the Weekly first reported in Issue 552, sent an e-mail to all opportunity permit families last month instructing parents how to approach LACOE's appeal system and what to say during the hearings, which some felt was a "cheat

sheet."

BHUSD Director of Human Resources Dr. Alex Cherniss said there are about 20 permit hearings in the next three weeks.

Of the nine LACOE hearings already completed, BHUSD has won six of them.

Menna could not be reached for comment.

#### Beverly Vista Teacher Receives Digital Voice Award from LACOE

Beverly Vista art teacher Ryan Lisko was one of many recipients of the Digital Voice Award for his work with technical arts in stop motion animation.

Beverly Vista students Danny Licht, Savannah LeMoine and Nobel Enayati also received an award for their entry "Untitled," a claymation project taught by Lisko.

School campuses countywide celebrated the technology achievements of teachers who were recognized Saturday, May 22 at Santa Monica High School as winners by Instructional Technology Outreach, a division of the Los Angeles County Office of Education.

"This is a great way to expose students to the real-life workings of how films and shows are made," Lisko said. "Working in groups, students develop their own story including characters, plot and setting. Students storyboard their idea and then make their characters from scratch using a styrofoam base, armature wire and plasticine clay. Using still cameras and tripods, donated by our school's PTA, they will film their claymation using the stop-motion method. The movie will be edited together using iMovie, where voice-over, sound and titles will put a finishing touch on their film. It is a lot of work, but the knowledge they've gained and their end result is invaluable."

The ceremony included a red carpet photo opportunity and the screening of a classic silent movie accompanied by a live organist. A total of 54 winning entries were announced from among hundreds that took part in the awards competition.



## A Voter Scam

Issues and people in the news

Is there a petition somewhere I can sign to totally ban television political spots? The massive amounts being spent in this election by candidates and supporters of a ballot measure are inane.

Although most consumer protection organizations and local governmental agencies, including our own city council, have condemned state Proposition 16, placed on the ballot by petition, I have yet to see one television commercial opposing the measure.

What we are viewing is a blizzard of spots with the mother and apple pie slogan that calls this "The People's Right to Vote (or decide)" proposition.

What is at stake is not all that complicated. Under current state law, municipalities can elect to take over public utilities such as electric services and create city run agencies. Los Angeles created the Department of Water and Power, but most communities are served by private entities such as "Edison."

Whatever the arguments for or against local ownership, this measure avoids

most of the substantive questions with the more simplistic message of not permitting city councils to decide but requiring a "vote of the people."

What the message fails to mention is that no takeover could happen without a two-thirds voter approval. In real terms, this means allowing a minority of voters to block city ownership. You can imagine how many campaign dollars would pour into an election to prevent Beverly Hills from ever creating a city-run power company. A two-thirds vote is an almost impossible barrier, especially when some special interest is prepared to spend whatever it takes to protect their investments. Even legislative bodies, including our state legislature, become grid locked with the two thirds requirement to pass a state budget.

This grab for power, and forgive the obvious pun, is so blatantly not in the public interest that it makes this campaign the poster boy for campaign reform. Special interest spending, including professional petition circulators, are defeat-

ing the whole purpose of reform by ballot measure the great **Hiram Johnson**, our one-time governor and United States Senator, envisioned as a means of protecting us from corrupt state or local governments, once under the thumb of such big spenders as the then rail road entities.

One point on the merits: Even if local governments aren't willing to take over power companies, the ability to do so helps keep the utilities in line.

There is a good, historic example of government by ballot that snubbed public interest by massive spending and hoodwinking voters: It was called Proposition Six.

In the 1960s, the county assessor looked at all the land that was privately owned and used by exclusive country clubs and decided their property tax should be based on "best possible use." Meaning that if, as just one example, the Los Angeles Country Club property was developed what would the tax rate be? Obviously, club members using some of the most valuable land in Southern California just inches from Beverly Hills had no desire to have their dues raised to continue enjoying their pristine grounds for a round of golf, and quickly anted upped money to support a preventive ballot measure vote. (They were joined by Hillcrest in the common country club cause, an alliance that had other kinds of social significance.)

So, a quickly formed ad hoc association of country clubs raised the big bucks necessary to hire one of the state's then-premier political consulting firms, Baus and Ross.

They were brilliant operatives and came up with a fantastic slogan: "Keep California Green." Now, who could vote against open spaces and the loss of all that beautiful green land? Not the electorate, most of whom would have been arrested for trespassing if they ever came close to the club's entrances.

Of course, few if any private country clubs, and certainly not Los Angeles, Hillcrest, Wilshire or Brentwood would have ceased operating. However, the costs of playing would simply have been more realistic and less dependent on what really amounted to a tax subsidy.

How have campaign tools changed? That ballot measure won by the massive use of billboards, not just television. Today, TV soaks up most campaign bucks.

Hopefully, the voters will see through the Proposition 16 block on city government's right to run power companies; and congratulations to our own city council for voting unanimously in opposition.

Speaking of our city council, when one of our councilmembers, **John Mirisch**, decided to enter the high voltage debate on Arizona's immigration law and used the opportunity to attack the West Hollywood City Council for passing a resolution of opposition; Mayor **Jimmy**

**Delshad** apologized to the West Hollywood City Council, distancing himself and our city from Mirisch's position, first expressed in a "guest editorial" in the Beverly Hills Courier.

Clearly, Mirisch has an absolute right to his opinions and Mayor Delshad has the same rights, maybe even obligation, to make sure that there is no misunderstanding: Mirisch's opinions are private even though the guest editorial identified him as a member of the Beverly Hills City Council.

The Arizona law, mandating law enforcement to require legal residency papers from anyone they stop or even suspect of not being here legally, is troubling, as is some of the overblown opposition rhetoric.

What has not been answered is why the law is even necessary unless it is really punitive and a means of racial profiling. If it is legal to ask for identification of any kind, why do we need laws to permit it?

The perception here also matters, or should. If anyone feels targeted and vulnerable, then this law is indeed regressive and discriminatory, and certainly many Hispanics do see this as directed at their community.

While I have reservations on boycotts since it hurts the innocent as well as the perpetrators of unwanted actions, I understand the frustrations and anger of the anti-Arizona law. The same kinds of reactionary responses to "illegal immigration" prevented the saving of many lives during the **Hitler** years. However, comparing Arizona to the Nazi holocaust is overblown.

Immigration issues are very complex. Neither Democratic or Republican administrations have been able to make our borders more secure, and that is part of the real problem. How we now deal with 11 million illegals will not be by simplistic slogans or tougher law enforcement. Some kind of responsible amnesty program will have to be devised, while at the same time, we make our borders less porous.

However, there is a new dimension to the debate: The Arizona legislator who authored the identification requirement law has broadened the issue and, at the same time, discredited his efforts and exposed his real agenda.

Arizona State Sen. **Russell Pearce** says he will next introduce legislation that would invalidate citizenship of children born to illegal aliens unless one parent is a United States citizen. If this is not a clear intrusion into federal responsibilities, than we are returning to a pre-civil war state's rights era.

While I caution comparisons to Hitler Germany, this does require an historical perspective. The first anti-Jewish act by the totalitarian regime was to argue that Jews were never really legal residents of Germany. Most Germans of that time bought the argument, put more simplistically: "If a cat has kittens in a fish market, that doesn't make her progeny seafood."


Now the Arizona state senator has exposed his racist intentions and real

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motives. It is time to speak out in a rational and compassionate manner and urge our good neighbor to repeal their regressive law.




## Al Scates

**Volleyball Coach at Beverly High, 1962**

### **Was it hard teaching elementary school P.E. while you were coaching volleyball?**

No, I enjoyed teaching in the [BHUSD] because you had instant success. When you were working with a second or third grader you saw results immediately in skills such as batting a softball or shooting a basketball. It was extremely rewarding, and I enjoyed it every year up until the last year, and then I was getting a little bit tired. I'd always been able to work without sleeping a great deal, and then as I got older, I finally started getting a little bit tired that last year. So I decided that was it. But I enjoyed working with the kids. I taught a little bit at the high school to begin with, and I coached one year of volleyball at Beverly High. After I coached football at Daniel Murphy in 1961, I was a trainer intramural director and volleyball coach at BHHS for the

remainder of the 1961-62 school year while I finished my master's degree at UCLA. Once volleyball became an NCAA sport in 1970, I couldn't do that anymore.

### **Who were some of your most memorable students?**

I remember a few students. Brad Neufeld and David Corbin are some of the guys that I keep in contact with once in a while with e-mail. The Heumann brothers back in the 60s. I remember those guys from El Rodeo. One was the quarterback of the football team, and he was my first recruit when I started the volleyball team at Beverly High because he was the best athlete in the school. Once I got him to play, then all the good athletes wanted to come and play. I think he's over in Maui now. The younger brother was just a nice kid I enjoyed teaching at El Rodeo. I used to see him at UCLA a lot. Occasionally, I still see people in their 40s and 50s that remember me teaching them driver education at Beverly High. I don't know who those people are.

I still see Marc Crandall at Hawthorne School. He's an attorney for Google now. And I took my son [David] to Hawthorne School in the fourth grade when they started doing mandatory busing in L.A., and he's great friends with Mark.

### **Tell us about how you were hired.**

I was teaching in Santa Monica, and I got recruited by I think [the late] Dr. Richard Bertain. One of the teachers

moved to Beverly Hills and started teaching there and suggested I meet with the principal at Beverly Vista, and so I met with him and then he told the personnel director about me. They didn't have the job, but they said they were going to create another position. And after I received tenure in Santa Monica the third year, I was offered the job in Beverly Hills. I was teaching elementary physical education in Santa Monica at Roosevelt School. It was more hands on than Beverly Hills.

### **What was it like working in BHUSD at that time?**

It was just great. The kids loved P.E. It was fantastic. They were so motivated and I was at El Rodeo and Hawthorne from 1965-1976, and Bob Craig was the department chair at El Rodeo, and everything was very smooth, and it was a great teaching situation. And the teachers were so good. Dick Eubick was there, and he really kept a tight reign on the students. As far as discipline goes, the students knew they were held accountable. I'd go over to Hawthorne in the afternoons and work with Dr. Ken Reich, the P.E. teacher there. It was funny because Bob Craig was the enforcer at El Rodeo, and I could be a little more friendly with the students. All Bob had to do was give them a look, and then they would work on their exercises, and then at Hawthorne I had to be the strict one. Both situations were good, but they were different.

### **Who do remember working with most?**

I didn't work with Bob after 1976. I took a coaching job in El Paso, so I took a little leave. And when I came back, I was at Hawthorne full time, so I worked mostly with Ken Reich, and Dr. Milt Rowen was principal. Later Dick Eubick became principal there.

### **What did you learn from coaching at UCLA with John Wooden?**

I learned how to run a practice. He does things quickly. He used to change drills very frequently, and he used to give immediate feedback without stopping the drill. He would demonstrate what the students did wrong and then

demonstrate how to do it correctly. But he'd do that very quickly, and that's something I incorporated into my teaching at BHUSD. To stop a game and just quickly take a student aside and show them how to do it correctly without slowing things down.

### **How were students different at the end of your teaching career than at the beginning?**

Certain students didn't seem to be as into physical activity as they originally were. The playgrounds used to be full of kids everyday after school, and in the beginning, almost everybody would stay around. Then at the end, playgrounds would be empty in the afternoon. Kids seemed to lose interest in doing any physical activity on their own. I think they spent a lot more time playing computer games and listening to their walkmans then actually coming out and participating after school like they used to.

### **What's the difference between teaching K-8 schools and coaching college volleyball?**

I used to teach volleyball to kids in the fourth grade, and the skills are the same as I teach to the athletes I'm coaching now, only I would lower the net. I had the school district purchase nets that went up and down on the sleeve. I'd teach them to jump serve. I'd have little kids jump serve in the fourth grade. It seems the problem was none of them grew up tall enough to play at the college level. We average 6'7". I had lunch recently with Brad Neufeld, and he talked about still playing at the L.A. sports center.

But teaching is teaching. You have to be a good teacher to be a good coach. And teaching the skills isn't very different.

### **What was the biggest challenge working in BHUSD?**

I would have to go back to my driver training days. It was really hard teaching kids how to drive.

Also, at least one of the girls would be crying every day, and I would immediately lose about 10 other girls who'd run

## Ten BHHS Athletes Win League Track Titles

### Norman boys' swimming team finishes second in league finals.

Freshman Sydney Segal won the 1,600 meters and 3,200 in dominating fashion and six of her Beverly High teammates also won individual league championships in the Ocean League track and field finals May 7 at Culver City High.

Segal won the 1,600 in five minutes, 33.15 seconds, 10.86 seconds ahead of the runner-up Emily Berkin, a Santa Monica freshman. Segal won the 3,200 in 12:05.8, 15.28 seconds ahead of the second-place finisher, Amanda Botfeld, a Santa Monica junior.

Norman senior Kemi Olonade won the long jump, leaping 16 feet, seven inches, and qualified for the Southern Section Division II prelims by finishing second in the 100 high hurdles in 16.61 and second in the triple jump, leaping 37 feet, 10 inches.

Beverly Hills got a 1-2-3 finish in the 800, with all three runners qualifying for the Division II prelims. Raquel Hefflin won in 2:18.25. Sydney Gray was second in 2:22.16 and Brianna Simmons third in 2:22.53.

Brianna Prince won the 400 in 1:00.8. Fellow Norman senior Kiarra Brown finished second in 1:01.61, also qualifying for the Division II prelims.

Beverly Hills' other individual event winners were high jumper Chelsea Austin (four feet, eight inches), discus thrower Ariana Luster (84 feet, 10 inches) and pole vaulter Melina Nasib (six feet, eight inches).

The other Norman individual qualifiers for the Division II prelims were Asia Williams, second in both the 100 in 12.76 and long jump, leaping 16 feet, three inches; and Gitla Shooster, third in the 3,200 in 12:31.5.

Beverly Hills' 1,600 relay team of Gray, Simmons, Hefflin and Prince won in 4:05.61. The Norman 400 relay team of Williams, Brown, Dejah McCoy and Prince qualified for the Southern Section Division II prelims by finishing second in 51.17.

#### Boys' Track and Field

##### Ocean League Finals

Donovan Dickens won the 110 high hurdles and 300 intermediate hurdles and Beverly Hills had two other individual event winners — high jumper Willie Green and sprinter Julian Sarokin — May 7 at Culver City High.

Dickens won the 110 high hurdles in 15.5, then won the 300 intermediate hurdles in 41.64. Marcus Silbiger was second in the 110 high hurdles in 15.53 and fellow Norman senior Martin Cadres was second in the 300 intermediate hurdles in 41.86, both qualifying for the Division II prelims.

Sarokin led a 1-2-3 Beverly Hills sweep in the 100, with all three sprinters qualifying for the Division II prelims. Sarokin won in

10.85, with Kenny Bassett finishing second in 11.24 and Cameron Countryman third in 11.25.

Green, a sophomore, cleared six feet to win the high jump.

The Norman 400 relay team of Sarokin, Bassett, Countryman and Trevor Walters won in 42.91. Beverly Hills' 1,600 relay team of Zach Gallagher, Cadres, Countryman and Bassett finished third in 3:29.95, qualifying for the Division II prelims.

In both the girls' and boys' meets, league champions automatically qualify for the Southern Section prelims. Second- and third-place finishers qualify if they meet designated standards.

## STUDENTS SCARED STRAIGHT:

But does the “Every 15 Minutes” program work?

The big bang was just the beginning of a gruesome display of blood, bodies and debris.

A girl, sprawled across the floor in a red pool, shrieked in pain and terror. Her blood-soaked face was nearly unrecognizable. More stomach-twisting cries came from inside a white Toyota Camry, its driver slumped over the wheel. It appeared to have been side-rammed by a black BMW, the upturned hood of which lay the dead body of another student.

Seconds later, police officers arrived, then firefighters and paramedics with the Jaws of Life. The coroner eventually made his way to the scene. Three dead. One paralyzed for life. Several other taken to Cedars-Sinai. One arrested.

It was chaos. It was hard to watch. And it was all fake.

Every 15 minutes in the U.S., someone is either injured or killed in an alcohol-related incident — and that statistic was hurled in front of Beverly High juniors and seniors Tuesday as they watched 15 of their peers re-enact a fatal DUI collision.

Emotions ran high for many who said they felt as though years-long wounds had been painfully reopened, recounting the devastating loss of Beverly High student Vahagn Setian more than three years ago from a drunk-driving accident outside Island’s restaurant.

“Seeing the kids, it wasn’t even acting

to me; it was real,” said Farnaz Sherf, who, though in attendance Tuesday, graduated from Beverly last year. “The feeling of watching it, it triggers all those emotions I felt before. I feel the pain. It’s as if it just happened.”

Sherf said the program is necessary to make students aware of how common alcohol-related accidents are, though she admitted that not everyone may walk away and change their partying habits.

“As long as we’re saving one life, it’s better than saving no life,” Sherf said.

When the program first started at Beverly High in 2008, several students were so affected by it, they sought help from The Maple Counseling Center, said Annette Saleh, the public relations representative for the program.

Karen Setian, Vahagn’s father, said he doesn’t believe the effectiveness of the program has dissipated since the 2008 program, when his son would have been a senior at Beverly.

“It’s new kids and a new generation,” Setian said. “This is going to be a whole new experience. We want to make sure that all of the new generation kids come to learn. Many don’t know how it ends. This is the perfect tool to teach them.”

Setian said it was tough to watch the re-enactment.

“It’s hard to go through this every time,” Setian said. “But it’s important, and because of that, I’m here.”

This year’s two-day program also incorporated the dangers of texting while driving. It took nearly one year to put the program together and cost more than \$40,000 through the support of Cedars-Sinai, The Maple Counseling Center, the PTA Council, Beverly Hills Police and Fire Departments, Beverly Hills Rotary, The Beverly Hilton and the Vahagn Setian Charitable Foundation.

More than 70 volunteers, 22 of which were students, helped organized “Every 15 Minutes.” Members of the program’s executive committee included Beverly High Principal J Guidetti, Lisa Kay Schwartz, Jodi Galen, Gail Millan, Les Bronte, Karen Setian, Cindy

Burrows, Nikkie Sedaghat, Mathew Forman, Michelle Halimi, Officer Mike Yamada, Maria Bennett and Mike Reynolds.

BHPD Officer Mike Yamada, who specializes in reconstructing accidents, helped recreate the realistic scene, including debris fields and the skid marks of the vehicles.

“We’ve learned in the past two years, and we

were far more organized this year,” said Executive Committee member Les Bronte. “We produced a magnificent video which was shown [yesterday]. The students that were involved in the accident scene and related events were fantastic. They were emotional. They

were responsive, and they were lost in the event.”

Bronte said three students were taken to Cedars-Sinai, where one was pronounced dead. Two had died on the scene.

When asked whether he felt the program was effective in changing the long-term behavior of high school students, Bronte said, “We hope so.”

“We try to follow the students, and many who participated in 2008 also came to the event [Tuesday],” Bronte said. “We point out to them that based upon what they’ve experienced, they should become teacher to their contemporaries.”

But the impact of “Every 15 Minutes” doesn’t necessarily reflect in numbers.

According to the BHPD, there were 341 DUI arrests and 54 minors involved in DUI-related collisions in 2007. DUI arrests were down 7.6 percent the next year to 315, and the number of minors involved in DUI-related collisions only slightly increased to 57.

Last year, the numbers saw a more dramatic hike. There were 369 DUI arrests and 73 minors involved in DUI-related collisions. Approximately 98 percent of the minors arrested for DUI said they were drinking at a private residence, according to BHPD Sergeant Shan Davis.

Davis also said, however, the incidences of DUI-related injuries and deaths nationwide have dropped.

“[This program] is really personal for a lot of people, including law enforcement,” Davis said. “One of the sergeant’s daughter was in a DUI-related accident. It hits home. [Some of the officers] were chocking away tears [during the re-enactment].”

Obituary notices for the three students who died in the crash were read over the school P.A. system, and parents of the “deceased” and “injured” students were notified. Students involved in the DUI-collision re-enactment participated in a retreat Tuesday night in order to simulate their separation from their families and school community.

A mock funeral service was held Wednesday for Beverly High juniors and seniors, where video footage of the hospital, booking of the drunk driver and court appearance were shown.

over and console her, and I only had 40 minutes of class. They had to dress and shower and redress, but then we did away with showers. The teachers would complain that the boys smelled bad. What happened was I couldn’t get past the hormones going off of these girls crying about a boyfriend or something. It seems like everyday that would be happening.

I would always try to separate the boys and girls so that we could play flag football or a real game of basketball with the boys, but the principals would always try to get us to have them play coed basket-

ball. The younger grades coed was fine, but by eighth grade. some of these boys could hurt the girls.

**How do you respond to studies that find poor fitness levels among today’s youth?**

I can totally see it. When I’m driving by schools today, the kids look very obese, in most of the schools. It’s a combination of poor eating habits and lack of exercise. You have to do both things. Somebody has to watch the kids. Generally, children who are fat grow up into fat adults, and it’s just not healthy.

People are getting diabetes now in an early age. I hate to see the decline of P.E. programs nationwide, but as you cut budgets, that’s what happens. It’s really important. I think it’s probably some of the only exercise some of these kids get, but if they can make them enjoy what they’re doing, then they’ll exercise more.

**Who do you still keep in touch with?**

Nobody lately. They have to e-mail me first, and then I’ll respond. I run into people at various places and social events. Not my colleagues so much. I don’t think anybody went into coaching. There was a

boy, Dr. John Kornhandler, who later came out for the team that I taught volleyball to at El Rodeo.

**What’s your proudest accomplishment?**

I’ve received letters from students in college going back to mentioning what I’ve taught them, and how now they’re playing for sports teams, or they learned to compete. I wish I saved some of those letters, but I didn’t. Every once in a while, I get an e-mail out of the blue. People know how to reach me. And it’s always enjoyable to read something like that.

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


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
