The Courier and the MTA

The Courier's recent "Breaking News" e-mail "Courier Right and MTA Wrong" is just the latest example of the Courier trying to become the story rather than report it.

The so-called "breaking news" was in response to MTA's criticism of the Courier's April 29 article, "MTA 'Final EIR' Favors BHHS Tunnel, Constellation Station," which was rife with opinions and short on objectivity. The April 29 article "reports" (in the loosest definition of the term) that "[t]he [EIR] appears designed to build a factual case for [one route over another]." The article goes on to say, "The route marked "direct connector" which avoids the BHHS tunnel would appear to be the best route but is not supported by the narrative portion." The Courier's "news article" casts an allegation that MTA has intentionally drafted the EIR to disregard facts contrary to its desired result, but it

does so without any factual basis. Where is a quote from MTA personnel on this issue? Where is a quote from the proposed route's opposition? Instead, the Courier attempts to support its position by giving a subjective opinion about which route would be best.

Moreover, the Courier magnifies its opinionated reporting by sending a "Breaking News" e-mail that you're right and they're wrong. Whether it is or not, how can the Courier objectively call an article entitled "Courier Right and MTA Wrong" a breaking news story? A better subject line would have been "Breaking Self-Serving E-mail". Also of note, the article mentions an e-mail from Jody Litvak at MTA that "alleges that the Courier's story 'might be read' to imply..." a final decision. Where is the full text of this e-mail? Given the Courier's propensity to determine what is "best" and for what result MTA is designing factual case, it seems to me that good reporting would require publication of both sides of the story instead of cherry-picking the parts favorable to your story.

Another example of opinion presented as journalism – the April 18 headline: "City Staff Tells Council, 'Close La Cienega Park To The People'". Is that what staff said? Or is that the Courier's choice of words?

Journalism is about reporting the facts without interjecting opinion. Editorializing is about interjecting opinion into current events. The Courier in recent weeks has taken to editorializing rather than reporting. The Courier's past few weeks have put it on a journalistic integrity list that includes Matt

Drudge, Andrew Breitbart and Fox News.

If you're going to publish opinion, THEN LABEL IT AS OPINION. Otherwise, just report the facts.

Board of Education begins superintendent interviews

Earlier this week, the interview process began for BHUSD's next superintendent. The Board of Education interviewed six candidates, three on Tuesday and three on Wednesday, for an hour and a half each.

"[The six candidates are] highly qualified, experienced, and extremely well-liked in their communities," Board President Lisa Korbatov said. "They got excellent references, each of them. They're all impressive, each in their own way."

The Board of Education will meet in closed session on May 5 to schedule the second round of interviews and decide which candidates to invite back.

The Board of Education hired the search firm Hazard, Young, Attea & Associates, based in Illinois, to seek out qualified candidates. The firm received 43 applications, and found 15 to 20 applicants to be qualified based on experience and potential to fit into the complexities of BHUSD. The firm conducted pre-interviews with 11 candidates, which were narrowed down to the six candidates invited to interview.

"The response was strong and we think the board will have a good slate of candidates to look at," said Bill Attea, who is leading BHUSD's search.

Attea said that more than half of the applicants are from out of state, representing 17 different states.

The community was invited to attend community meetings and fill out an online survey to provide input about desired skills and characteristics of the next superintendent. Eighty-nine people responded to the survey, and Hazard, Young, Attea & Associates interviewed 148 individuals for their input about what they wanted to see in the next superintendent.

"One [area] that got the highest rank was someone who demonstrates integrity, honesty and fairness, and second highest was someone who will foster a positive professional climate of mutual trust and respect among faculty, staff and administrators," Attea said.

City granted preliminary injunction against Measure 2P

Last Friday, Los Angeles Superior Court Judge Ann Jones issued a preliminary injunction regarding Measure 2P to the City of Beverly Hills. As a result, the city is not required to implement Measure 2P, which would require the city to offer two hours of free parking at all public lots, before a final ruling by Judge Jones.

"This will not change the city's commitment to its two-hour free parking program, but the preliminary injunction enjoins the implementation of Measure 2P until the hearing on August 26," City Attorney Larry Wiener said. "The electorate clearly supports the preservation of the city's two-hour free parking program, and the city council never intended to change that."

The city currently offers the first two hours of parking free at seven of its 17 parking

structures.

"Once again, we are disappointed that the City of Beverly Hills and its attorney, Larry Wiener, have refused to honor the overwhelming will of the people by dropping their challenge against Measure 2P," G&L Realty spokesperson Harvey Englander said in an e-mail statement.

On January 4, Los Angeles Superior Court Judge Ann Jones ruled Measure 2P invalid, and it was uncertain whether the measure would appear on the ballot. The 2nd District Court of Appeal stayed the decision pending the election.

The initiative, proposed by G&L Realty, passed on the March 8 election, 3,452-2,112.

A hearing on the matter has been scheduled for August 26.

Board of Education revises interdistrict permit policy

On April 26, the Board of Education approved a revision of the district's interdistrict attendance policy, which was prompted by assembly bill 2444. The bill, which was approved last September, states that once a student is in a school on an out-of-district permit, the student is not required to reapply for an interdistrict transfer each year.

In the past, the district required permit-holders to reapply every year. In a 4-1 vote, with Board member Myra Lurie dissenting, the Board approved a revision to its policy. Instead of submitting a renewal application each year, permit holders are now required to submit a renewal packet.

A significant change in policy will allow the district to revoke permits based on lack of funds. The revised policy states that interdistrict permits may be revoked if "appropriate and sufficient space and/or funding is unavailable in the existing class, school, specialized program or district as determined by the Superintendent or designee."

"Proposing a new and unknown game change for revocation is very unfair," Lurie said. She said it was unfair to establish that condition after students had already entered into an agreement with the school district. She also said adding lack of funds to the policy sounded like a way to get around adhering to assembly bill 2444.

"If you think we're doing the runaround, all we're doing is projecting fiduciary responsibility to who we can afford to deliver it to," Board member Jake Manaster said. "[There's a] finite [amount of] money we're given today."

In January 2010, the Beverly Hills Board of Education voted to not renew permits for more than 200 students attending its schools on out-of-district permits. The district's change from a revenue limit district to a basic aid district prompted a change in policy that would not allow students to renew their opportunity permits, or allow new permits.

In basic aid districts, local property taxes equal or exceed the district's revenue limit, making the district ineligible for per-student funding from the state based on average daily attendance. That means the district receives no additional money from the state for permit-holder students attending district schools.

The Board also voted 4-1, with Lurie dis-

Beverly Hills Relay for Life raises over \$100,000 for American Cancer Society

Beverly Hills Relay For Life event chair Jeromy Meyer is still in the process of counting registration forms from last weekend's American Cancer Society fundraiser, but he has already counted more than 1,000 forms.

The fundraiser raised \$101,426 to support cancer research and took place at El Rodeo's track, where participants took turns circling the track for 24 hours, because cancer never sleeps.

"The three schools that were involved, Horace Mann, Beverly Vista, and Beverly High were totally amazing, totally supported us this year," Meyer said.

Michele Kalt, who organized Team Sienna/Team Beverly Vista, got involved with Relay For Life because she wanted to throw a "Cancer Party" for her daughter Sienna Wolfe, a Beverly Vista first grader who was diagnosed with cancer last Halloween.

Kalt was looking for a way to make cancer not seem like a big deal to her three children and their friends.

"[Because of Relay For Life], I definitely accomplished my goal," Kalt said. "Everyone knows she has cancer, it's not a big deal in her little world. My goal was to keep the kids happy, keep them oblivious and solve this problem."

Kalt organized a kid zone for Team Sienna/Team Beverly Vista that offered arts and crafts, music and many other activities.

While Kalt set out to help her family, she found that the event touched many others in the community who have been affected by cancer.

Kalt and Meyer commented that the community support from businesses and individuals that donated time and services to the event was significant and unanticipated.

"I thank the community of Beverly Hills for coming out and supporting us," Meyer said. "The community coming together in Beverly Hills, it's so rare to see such a small-town event in this area. That was beautiful to see."

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senting, to not renew opportunity permits for students currently in fifth and eighth grade. Lurie has been an outspoken advocate for the opportunity permit program, despite the fact that the community has repeatedly elected candidates who pledged to end it.

The decision affects two students currently in fifth grade and 28 students currently in eighth grade who are enrolled on opportunity permits.

Interdistrict permit applications opened on April 15, but the district plans to grant new permits only to children of BHUSD faculty and staff, and city employees.

Recreation & Parks Commission rejects dog park at La Cienega Park

On April 26, the Recreation & Parks Commission discussed possibilities for an off-leash dog area in Beverly Hills. The city currently does not allow dogs to be off-leash at any city park.

One idea discussed was to designate hours when dog owners would be allowed to let their dogs roam off-leash on the senior league field at La Cienega Park. The infield would be closed, but the outfield would be open to dogs.

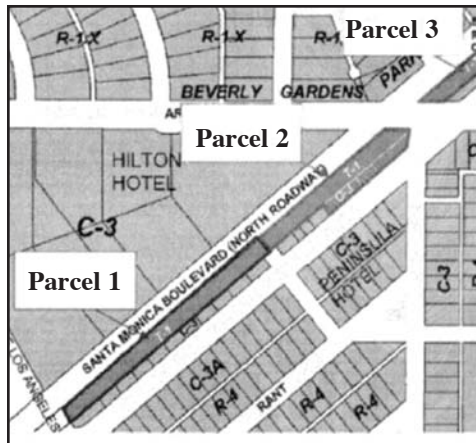
Commission Chair Alan Block said that although the commission is in favor of having a dog park, the commissioners did not like the idea of sharing the senior league field with the dog park.

"We said we want to keep the door open, look at other alternatives," Block said. "We'd rather not share the senior league field with a dog park."

The commission asked staff to look into other possibilities, which include an area at Roxbury Park, city-owned property in the industrial area, the orange grove near Coldwater Canyon Park and an area adjacent to the fire department.

Alternative possibilities will be discussed at a future commission meeting.

Planning Commission and City Council liaison consider the Gateway Project



On April 19, Planning Commission Chair Dan Yukelson, Vice Chair Craig Corman, Vice Mayor Willie Brien and City Councilmember Lili Bosse met to discuss plans for the Gateway Project.

"There is general consensus that we're willing to look at changing the zoning for the right type of property," Yukelson said. "We will study potential impacts [to the nearby] residential neighborhood, type of buildings, and [possibilities for] setback. There was general consensus we would like to move

this thing forward."

The Gateway Project refers to three parcels of land, belonging to three different owners, located along Santa Monica Boulevard near Wilshire Boulevard. The three landowners applied for a change of zoning from the current T-1 (transportation) zones to C-3 (commercial) zones, but the Planning Commission

rejected the request on March 24. One landowner also proposed a three-story, 90,000-square-foot office building with four levels of subterranean parking providing 274 parking spaces.

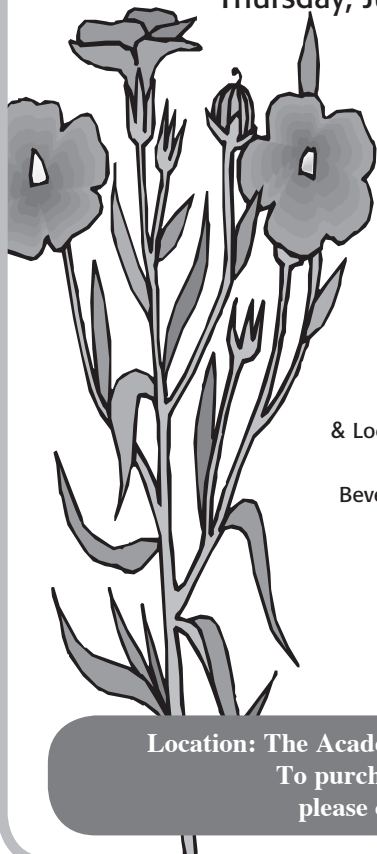
The parcels, totaling approximately three acres, were formerly part of a railroad right-

School Board: Keep our popular superintendent Dick Douglas

Lately our Board of Education likes to repeat the phrase "Insanity is doing the same thing over and over and expecting a different result."

But have they stopped to think that **insanity is likewise trying to recruit another out-of-district superintendent and expecting them to stay in Beverly Hills?**

The track record for attracting out-of-district candidates has been dismal—10 superintendents in 13 years—and the reasons for this chronic turnover are clear. To succeed as a school administrator in the BHUSD, you need to have deep ties in the community. We see that now with our five popular principals, four of whom taught here for

20+ years, and the other previously held an administrative position within the district.

It's not a coincidence why our principals are so popular—you can't just take anyone from any part of the country, stick them in Beverly Hills and expect them to succeed.

We already have a popular superintendent in Dick Douglas. He knows our community and has

taught many generations of our kids, after 20 years of teaching in Beverly Hills, plus being principal and assistant principal for another 10. Douglas then spent another 11 years leading an affluent basic aid district in another part of the state—but he never lost his ties to Beverly Hills.

You can't get that kind of connection with an out-of-state applicant who will get

here and have no idea how to deal with our super-involved school community. In the event the Board hires an out-of-towner, he or she will immediately be shopping his or

her resume around, as we've seen so many times in the recent past.

On top of all of this, at least two new Board members will be joining the Board at the end of the year, so shouldn't they have some input before being locked in to a 3-year contract with a new superintendent?

Recently the search firm retained by the Board to find a new superintendent held interviews with all the different stakeholders—parents, faculty, PTA, alumni, and community—with each group overwhelmingly voicing their support for Douglas to stay.

So we're begging our Board of Education—show us you understand the definition of "insanity" and keep a popular superintendent who knows what he's doing and has strong support. Call off this insane "search." Let's keep Dick Douglas on the job.

of-way and the current zoning allows the land to be used only for transportation purposes.

The Planning Commission wanted to keep options open for the parcels, because they are located at the city's western boundary, a key entry point into the city. One of the considerations is an overlay zone for the parcels, which would allow the city to create zoning specifically tailored for the three parcels.

"A term that was used when we were talking about the property was rational limitations," Bosse said. "The consensus was there

has to be a greenbelt, there has to be a green space, it has to be a very inviting gateway to Beverly Hills that reflects our community."

Bosse said it's also important that the development fits into the neighborhood, does not impact parking and traffic and doesn't create a wall or canyon effect. The possibility of bike lanes was also discussed.

"[This area is] almost the first thing that hits you when you drive into our city," Yukelson said. "I really want to see improvement, [because it] doesn't look like Beverly Hills when you drive by those properties."

Yukelson said the City Council and Planning Commission liaison committee would meet again before the Planning Commission considers details of the Gateway Project.

"We'll come up with some options, how we would want to craft this overlay zone," Yukelson said. "We need to respect the fact that these are three separate parcels and each of them may have different, unique properties that we're going to have to deal with. We can't necessarily treat each of these three properties the same."

Increase in gas prices affects city

Since the fiscal year began on July 1, 2010, the City of Beverly Hills has paid an average of \$18,900 per month to fill the tanks of the city's diesel-powered vehicles and \$32,900 to keep gasoline-powered vehicles fueled, according to fleet supervisor Craig Crowder, in the fleet services division of Public Works.

The city's 259 vehicles, including police and fire vehicles; 29 off-road vehicles, including tractors; and 72 pieces of non-self-

Decision time for schools

And keep it together on subway battle

School board members are meeting “off campus” to interview some finalists for Superintendent of Schools despite continuing support in the community to keep acting super, **Dick Douglas**, on the job for at least one more year.

At school meetings and even social gatherings, board members have heard strong pleas for the board to extend Douglas’ contract. A former classroom teacher and elementary school principal, Douglas was hired when another temporary superintendent, Dr. **Jerry Gross**, left the district. (By mutual agreement.)

The current search firm has won high praise for bringing some top rated educators here for consideration. Sources have told us that the field has been narrowed down to six, which may include a former west coast educator, now holding a top job in a New York suburban community with demographics similar to Beverly Hills, who wants to return to California. Another finalist is reportedly a Pasadena-area superintendent.

Why has the board not extended Douglas’ contract? Several board members argue that the district has simply gone too long without a permanent superintendent and that the time has come to actually make a choice, especially since this search firm seems to have actually found some highly qualified candidates.

“This is not about Douglas,” one board member told us off the record, “We all admire and appreciate his talents. But this process has simply dragged on far too long and creates an uncertain future for our schools.”

However, the school board election will take place this November. If there are new board members, and it seems almost certain there will be at least one, a new superintendent would have as a boss someone who had no part in the selection—the same issue Dr. **Brian David Goldberg** and **Steven Fenton** faced when they won in 2007.

Goldberg has made it clear he will seek a second term but Fenton has been equally

up front about not wanting to run again. (Fenton recently married television personality **Leeza Gibbons**. Editorial note: Congratulations and good wishes. Fenton told us he has not ruled out running for city council, just not sure when. As for the minor flap between Fenton and Mayor **Barry Brucker**, see below.)

The changing of school board members could make any reasonably sophisticated super applicant very cautious. Although it is less probable this year than it was in 2007 when educational direction and philosophy made the election very divisive, it is still likely for any new member to have preferred to have been involved in the hiring. That year, and the most recent in 2009, saw the defeat of an incumbent. In 2007, **John Millan** opted not to seek reelection and in 2009 **Myra Demeter** did the same. In recent years, the only incumbent to win and run ahead of the winning challenger was **Myra Lurie**. The loser in 2007 was **Alissa Roston** and in 2009, **Nooshin Meshkaty**.

Interesting historical note: Roston probably lost her reelection because she was tagged with responsibility for losing a very popular school principal, **Irene Stern**, of Beverly Vista, now back on the job.

That’s worth another ironic note: The then-school board felt they had to support their Superintendent **Jeff Hubbard** who had major differences with Stern. Stern was reassigned to lead the adult school, a job she refused, but last year the new board brought her back to BV, and Hubbard found himself caught up in the Strategic Concept legal problems, now facing trial.

No, this is not a clear-cut issue and there are no good guys and no villains on the board. The two members most anxious to find a new, permanent superintendent, **Goldberg** and board president **Lisa Korbatov**, are doing what they feel is best for our schools—ending the uncertainty of leadership. They too praise Douglas.

Fenton has been the strongest voice for extending Douglas’ term. **Jake Manaster** too wants to end the process as soon as possible and **Lurie**, the senior board member, has expressed reservations about hiring anyone prior to the election. Unless one of the five finalists found by the search firm is so outstanding that there is an urgency in signing a contract, **Lurie** and **Manaster** could opt to keep Douglas on the job.

If not, why not hold off the final decision until after the election, let the new board, if one is elected, be part of the process and avoid any doubts about the decision having broader support. Also, it would certainly benefit the district if Douglas helped in the transition.

What Douglas has done for the district is not insignificant. He has created a new era of confidence in our schools, too often riddled with personality conflicts and the coming and going of a small army of administrators. Clearly, the schools are more focused on serving and less on wrenching infighting. The credit for this also has to go to all the board members and board president **Korbatov**. But also to Douglas.

This new era of reasonably good internal vibes makes it much easier for the Beverly Hills Education Foundation to launch such innovative fundraising efforts as BHEF board chair **Jonathan Prince**’s One Million in One Week drive. (Wouldn’t hurt to extend the time limits.) This new board, with Douglas’ leadership, simply has to be credited with improving community support

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of our schools.

Who wants Douglas to stay? Every single PTA leader. The teaching staff. Colleague administrators and all five site principals. And the rest of the education community. I have not heard one single voice, outside the board, who does not insist that Douglas should be kept on the job, not one.

Will this be an issue in the election? At least one likely candidate has told us he thinks Douglas should be kept on the job for at least another year. Since Goldberg may be the only incumbent on the ballot, this could impact his reelection. Reportedly, some of his most loyal backers have urged him to reconsider the Douglas contract extension.

Goldberg does have a strong base, especially among younger parents in the Horace Mann area. He has been an effective voice for assuring that each of the elementary schools receives equal support from the district.

In a sense, you have to credit him with biting a tough and unpopular political bullet. But politics aside, hopefully Goldberg will work for a sound compromise of seeking the best permanent superintendent possible while using the special experience, talents and, most important, Douglas' insights into our education community by extending the contract. If that was the option when Goldberg first ran, I am reasonably certain it is one he would have supported—giving a possible new board a role.

Final thoughts: this board may be too close to the action to really appreciate the enormous discontent that existed just months ago before Douglas was hired. Divisive battles on out-of-district permits. Scandals involving consultants. A revolving door in the superintendent's office, with some bad choices. Internal board squabbling. Fiscal uncertainty. And much more.

As the campaign director of the last school

bond election, I am reasonably certain that this community would not now have voted Yes on Measure E. Douglas has helped restore confidence, at the very least.

Critical to the success of a new superintendent is not to have him or her come here in the midst of a deep controversy over a Douglas contract extension. Neither Douglas or his backers want that, and a one-year extension is a good compromise.

What about possible candidates? One strong candidate has emerged, **Damien Bean**. He is clearly very independent, not tied to any incumbent and is prepared to run an aggressive campaign. Now, the pressure is on others who have said many times they will not run. But if **David Seidel** and Prince change their minds, this could be a very interesting campaign.

Both have strong family ties to education—Seidel's mother, **Joan**, was a PTA president and former city treasurer and Prince's father, **Dr. Martin Prince**, was one of the most idealistic and respected members of the school board several decades back. Jonathan has given the BHEF a much needed shot in the fundraising, community-support arm.

Lurie, a former board president, has made it very clear she will not seek a third term. However, she has been under considerable pressure from former PTA colleagues—she came to the board after extensive PTA service—to run again. As for family credentials, her mother-in-law, **Sooky Goldman**, is one of the true heroes of our city's public schools. What was one of Sooky's major accomplishments? Insisting that then-high school principal **Ken Peters** be chosen as superintendent. Yes, promoting someone from within was the issue then too.

IS THERE A RIFT ON SUBWAY ROUTE DISPUTE

What appears to be a minor misunder-

standing has led to some divisive issues between Mayor **Barry Brucker** and school board member, and former board president, **Steven Fenton**: how best to oppose a subway route under the high school.

First, it was when Brucker was mayor that he made the generous and thoughtful action to allow **Frank Fenton** to leave the council as mayor, stepping aside for the last three weeks of his term. Fenton, who had served with distinction as school board member, board president, city treasurer and recreation and parks commissioner, had decided not to seek a second term.

Frank was then able to retire with the title of former mayor, an honor he richly deserved and one that Brucker made possible.

What apparently disturbed Steven Fenton was a difference on how best to fight any proposed subway route under the high school. I think they share a common goal, if not how best to win the fight.

Fenton feels the whole council should join the school board in a clear message to the MTA: If the subway goes under the school, the city will fight the whole subway project.

How best to express that is also a problem. Under the leadership of President Korbatov, the board is militant and clear on this issue while the council is trying to achieve the same goal by careful negotiations.

In a sense, they are both right, but what this community most needs is a clear, united voice and not public disputes on strategy. The board is spending the big bucks in the fight, even hiring a prestigious lobbying/lawyer group to take the battle to Washington. If we fail to convince the MTA

board, the next, and very drastic step, would be to fight federal funding for the entire subway project.

An ideal strategy? Every elected official should make it clear, they will never under any circumstances support a subway project that endangers our schools, and that includes Good Shepherd as well.

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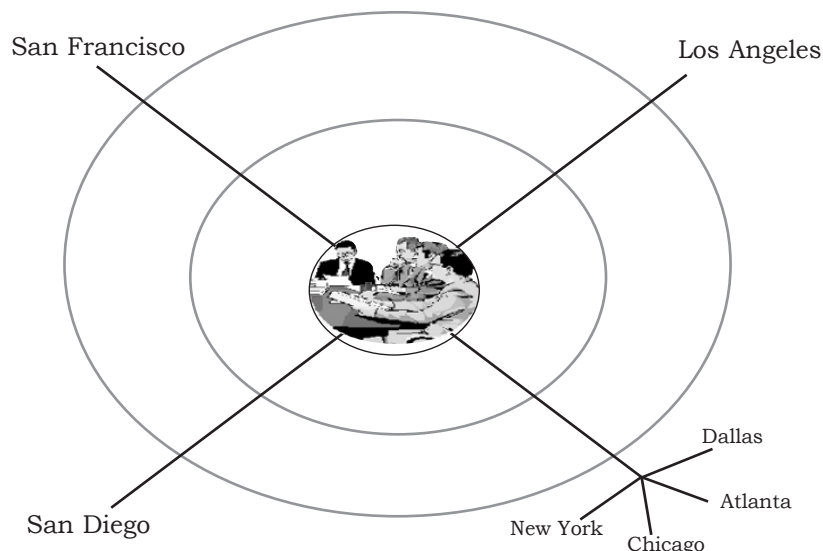

ALL FOR ONE

BHEF's One Campaign is on a high-profile mission to raise \$1 million for BHUSD

The Weekly interviewed BHEF Chair Jonathan Prince on Tuesday, the official second day of the One Campaign.

The Los Angeles Times ran a story about the One Campaign this morning. What was your day like?

I actually called a friend of mine whose son I coached in Little League and this guy happens to be a writer for the *LA Times*. I said to him, I wonder if there's an angle here. This is one of the most elite communities in the country and they're raising money for their schools. If this elite community is forced to have this emergency fundraiser then clearly so many other districts are in trouble. How are other districts handling it? Is there a possibility that the One Campaign is a role model for other communities that are in similar situations?

He pitched the story to a writer named Howard Blume, who did an amazing story and suddenly we wake up this morning and we're on the front page of the *LA Extra* section, and the story gets picked up by the AP news wire. Before we know it, local KABC news was at the high school today, KABC radio did interviews today, Fox News is coming tomorrow morning, NBC news is coming. It became a national story. In fact, it ran on local news in New York City. If you went to Google right now [and searched] "Beverly Hills schools million dollar campaign," you'll see it got

picked up by newspapers in Kansas City, Detroit, Tallahassee. Everyone's running this story.

Now the challenge is how do we turn that attention into dollars? How do we get the community to say, 'Other people recognize this as a story of value, as people who are trying hard to solve a problem within their community.' And I keep saying to everybody, 'Okay, turn that into a donation, turn to companies who exist in Beverly Hills or cater to Beverly Hills people, whether it's a restaurant, clothing store, law firm, talent agency, people who have made money off of Beverly Hills, off of this name and these people for so long.' How do we go to people who have never given to our schools and say, 'Do you understand now?' It's real; there's no crying wolf here, no chicanery here. My feeling is to use the local news, national news, television and radio news to drive people to give.

What was the impetus for this campaign?

When I first heard that our district was going to be cutting teachers and positions and counselors not due to shrinkage of the district, not due to choice by the board, superintendent or principals, but merely because we couldn't afford the positions, I was angry. We have to be able to make decisions based on what's best for our kids, best for our schools, what's best for each individual principal and for the superintendent, not based on our budget. I was frustrated because I knew plenty of people had generously donated to BHEF in the past, to the PTA in the past, plenty of people had been part of the Apple Ball, I didn't know how to sort of raise the issue once again with the group of people who have already been generous. How do you keep going to the same people over and over again?

Also, there had been some skepticism about the role of BHEF and the role of PTA as to how they're spending the money, so I called into a room our superintendent Dick Douglas and two board members, heads of the PTA Council, [BHEF President]

Annette [Saleh], and we together created this notion of having a comprehensive campaign in which principals and the superintendent would decide which jobs were of greatest value at the five sites, to try to save those jobs. The PTA and BHEF would both fundraise and execute the campaign, that for the first time I can remember the BHEA, our teachers union, would be a part of this campaign. They would message the campaign, they would send those envelopes home with every K-12 student with instructions that their parents are to fill out that form and either donate or not donate, but to sign it to show that indeed you've read it, seal it and give back to the teacher. If that's run through the classroom [there's] finally the chance that every parent knows what's going on. I didn't want people, come next September, to say, 'What happened to the instrumental music program at the middle school? What happened to the K-5 technology teacher?' Secondly, BHEA is asking its own members to donate toward this campaign to show they believe in it.

Now you have a campaign that was led by principals and the superintendent, messaged and donated to on a daily basis by teachers and the union, administered and executed by fundraisers, PTA and BHEF, and given passion from the students from ASB who also got involved. That comprehensive campaign, a true educational community campaign, had a chance to create this notion of the One Campaign in which one would try to raise \$1 million in one week with 100 percent of funds going to pay for teachers' salaries with complete transparency.

Why is it important for the entire community to be involved?

There is a recent RAND report that states for every point of the API scores in the district, for every point those scores go up, the community in which that public school lives, those homes are worth more money, the businesses do better, newspaper readership goes up, police and fire go up, city services go up. Education is the single most effective driver to raise life-

style and raise property value and business value in a community, much more than anything else, more than building a mall, more than putting in a theme park, more than putting in a subway stop. The most important thing to do is raise the value of public education.

What was the response at the Apple Ball when the campaign was launched?

The response in the room was spectacular. That night alone, in the half hour we spoke about it, we raised about \$60,000 and by the time pledges came in online overnight, we had saved one job thanks to the Apple Ball. That's pretty special. Now the downside is the same 20 percent of the people who always give money are also the same people who happen to be at the Apple Ball. The question was, could it expand?

Monday morning we sent the [donation envelopes] out. It's Tuesday afternoon now, we've now saved a second job. We know now we've saved two positions due to generous online donations and beginning of collecting some donations at school and I would say to readers of the newspaper, there are many days left.

How do you feel about the response so far?

I'm greedy so I'm not content with the fact we've saved two jobs in two days. I want to have saved ten jobs in two days because I want the district to be successful, I want the campaign to be successful, I want the community to be able to congratulate itself for having come together and done something unique and passionate. I would say there's many people who would say, 'Wow, good start,' and I would say, 'Yeah, good start, but not good enough.' And I expect more of my friends and neighbors. I think we can do better, I think we can be better.

What are some of the inspiring things people in the community have done?

We're finding really generous private families who are donating as much as \$10,000 and \$15,000 and \$25,000 gifts. We're finding people who say I can't afford to give anything at all, and yet they give a dollar per day per student in the district. So someone with three kids multiplies 365 times three and writes a check for that much, because even if they can't afford anything, they want to give.

I loved watching the ASB students declare today One Day and they were all wearing black and white clothing, and they were selling bracelets. They weren't selling the bracelets to make money, although I think they made close to a thousand dollars today, but they were doing it to raise awareness. They were doing it so the kids would go home at night with black and white bracelets and say to Mom and Dad, 'You've got to give to the One Campaign.' So the spirit of the kids is amazing, spectacular.

The partnership of BHEF and PTA is as good or better than I thought it would be. The leadership of Dick Douglas and Carter Paysinger and the four K-8 principals, their leadership has been really important in this and I think the desire of the Board of Education to make this work, to take a role that says who can we call and how can we help, and everybody putting down their disagreements and putting down their individual feelings about things that have been potentially challenging for us and divisive for us, everyone putting down for a week and raising money, that's pretty cool and we don't get that often in Beverly Hills.

Why black and white?

We made black and white the colors because when we chose to do the One Campaign literature, we wanted it in black and white because we didn't want to spend

lots of money on glossy color ads. So we did it in simple black and white, and because the phrase, there it is in black and white, meaning read it, you can see it's right there.

How have local businesses responded?

We got a generous donation from Saks Fifth Avenue, so when you see that a retail organization like Saks believes in education, that's a huge statement and it says to other department stores and restaurants [in] our community, 'What are you doing? How much money are you giving?' I challenge and I say to restaurants on Beverly Drive and Robertson Drive and Santa Monica Boulevard and Wilshire Boulevard, 'Where are your donations?' I think it's the same thing with retail stores. I look at the people on Rodeo Drive and say, 'Are you our partners?' I challenge

them and say if you're not going to invest in education of young people of the community in which you do business, then what are you investing in? This isn't a donation; this is an investment.

What is happening the rest of the week and through the weekend?

Tomorrow morning and every morning the PTA is at the five schools reminding parents they have to give. Tomorrow night El Rodeo has its variety show. They're contributing money toward the campaign, but also there will be 500 parents in the auditorium and we'll remind them the importance of the campaign. Thursday night Horace Mann has its variety show, its fundraiser. Each of the schools continues to message, even the high school kids. This is the week of AP tests, and yet today they held a rally, they'll continue to

sell bracelets. We continue to make phone calls to our friends at businesses and private families, asking them to donate and tell them you have until Monday morning.

Do you have any final thoughts for our readers?

If you have given, thank you, and please call 10 people and encourage them to give. And if you haven't given, go online and give right now, and call 20 people and tell them that you just gave.

This is a truly community driven campaign and if we don't get all the way to a million dollars, at least we will have tried and you'll feel better for having been a part of that effort.

propelled equipment, including water pumps, consume on average 4,900 gallons of diesel and 8,700 gallons of unleaded gasoline each month.

The city fuels its fleet at its central fueling station, located in the Public Works complex area, off the corner of Third Street and Foothill Road. The Fire Department has fueling capabilities at its headquarters, at Fire Station Number 2 at Coldwater Canyon, and at Fire Station Number 3 on Doheny Drive.

The fueling stations stock 87-octane unleaded gasoline and diesel, which the city purchases from SC Fuels, which is part of Southern Counties Oil Company. Crowder said the city is in its second year of a three-year contract.

The city's contract is tied to the oil price information service, which Crowder said is published each day. Crowder said the city currently pays about 1.3 cents higher per gallon for unleaded gasoline than the OPIS figure, and about 1.7 cents higher per gallon for diesel.

"We are paying a significantly lower price than the normal person at the pump pays," Crowder said. "I believe our last fuel cost was, we paid \$3.09 [per gallon for unleaded gasoline] and \$3.16 per gallon for diesel. That was in the third quarter of this fiscal year."

Crowder said the city also has an account with the 76 gas station at Wilshire Boulevard and Whittier Drive, which is where the city's motorcycles fill up because they require 91-octane gasoline.

"There are a number of vehicles driven outside of the city and those get fueled under other provisions," Crowder said. He said the majority of outside usage is police and fire vehicles, but he added that most city vehicles use the central fueling station.

Crowder said the city is doing a number of things to cut down on fuel costs and oil dependency. The city is currently seeking proposals to build a compressed natural gas fueling station, and has recently purchased four new street sweepers that run on CNG to replace four older diesel-powered sweepers, as well as two new refuse collection vehicles powered by CNG.

"We can realize savings with CNG compared to diesel, [and it's] also cleaner burning

and better for the environment," Crowder said.

The city has about seven hybrids and two fully electric vehicles.

"We've been kind of conservative in our hybrid purchases strictly because the return on investment on hybrids is not fully realized, so if you're not careful you can actually spend more money than you're saving by going to the hybrid," Crowder said.

Crowder said the return on investment may not be fully realized because the initial cost of hybrid vehicles is higher than many non-hybrid vehicles. However, Crowder said the city plans to purchase a few more hybrids to replace some of the city's administrative vehicles that travel throughout the city.

Local businesses support the One Campaign

On April 27, BHEF launched the One Campaign in an attempt to raise \$1 million in one week to save BHUSD teaching, counseling, special education and custodial staff positions. One hundred percent of donations will directly support faculty and staff salaries.

On Friday, Menchie's frozen yogurt will be on sale at Beverly Vista from 2 to 3:30 p.m. One hundred percent of proceeds will benefit the One Campaign. On Thursday and Friday, the yogurt shop, located at 9609 South Santa Monica Blvd. in Beverly Hills, will donate 20 percent of yogurt sales to BHUSD schools. Customers should mention Beverly Vista to the cashier, and do not have to be affiliated with the school.

Last Monday, Michael Nourmand, President of Nourmand & Associates Realtors in Beverly Hills, announced he would match funds up to \$20,000 for donations made by his agents.

"I thought it was a good way for our agents to get involved in the community and also just to show that our community supports local schools," Nourmand said. "It's hard to find good public schools from K-12 in the greater LA area."

Nourmand graduated from Beverly High and his wife Michelle Nourmand, also a Beverly High graduate, teaches third grade at Hawthorne. Nourmand said a number of his agents have had children go through BHUSD schools.

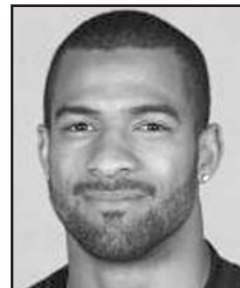
Society of Young Philanthropists gala to benefit Jerusalem medical center

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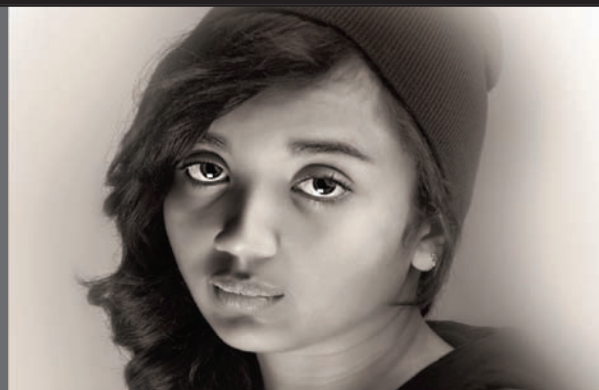
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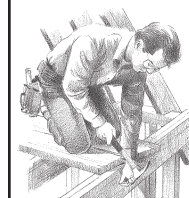

ORDINANCE NO. 11-O-2608

INTERIM ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS PROHIBITING HIGH IMPACT CONVENIENCE STORES UNLESS SPECIFICALLY APPROVED BY THE

CITY, AND DECLARING THE URGENCY THEREOF.

is hereby declared.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. On April 5, 2011, the Director of Community Development recommended that the City Council study the City's regulations regarding the operation and development of convenience stores.

Section 2. The Director has reported that prohibiting high impact convenience stores, as defined below, is necessary to protect against an immediate threat to the public health, safety or welfare and to avoid a conflict with any future potential regulation. The Director has also recommended that the interim ordinance include discretionary review in order to allow certain convenience stores to be approved during the interim ordinance period if the Planning Commission, after reviewing the specific project, can make the findings set forth in Section 8 below, thus concluding that the convenience store will not adversely affect the public health, safety or welfare.

Section 3. The impacts of high impact convenience stores, which primarily serve commuters, differ from the impacts of neighborhood convenience stores, which primarily serve local residents and pedestrians. Without regulation, high customer turnover and the vehicle-focused nature of high impact convenience stores will likely result in increased localized traffic, parking problems, and unwanted commercial intrusions into established residential neighborhoods. Associated impacts may include commercial parking on residential streets, increased litter, and excessive noise that would deteriorate the quality of life for those in the immediate vicinity. In addition, high impact convenience stores would not promote the City's brand and for the reasons discussed above would harm neighborhood character.

Section 4. Section 65858 of the California Government Code authorizes the adoption of an interim ordinance as an urgency measure to prohibit any usage of land that may be in conflict with zoning proposals being considered or studied by a legislative body, Planning Commission, or Planning Department.

Section 5. In light of the findings stated in Section 3, the Council has directed staff to prepare an interim ordinance to prohibit high impact convenience stores, allowing them only pursuant to a convenience store conditional use permit.

Section 6. Pursuant to Government Code Section 65858, the City Council finds and determines that the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare requires the adoption of this interim Ordinance. As described in Section 3, high impact convenience stores pose a significant threat to the health, safety and welfare of the community. Without regulation, the high customer turnover and the vehicle-focused nature of high impact convenience stores will likely result in increased localized traffic, parking problems, and unwanted commercial intrusions into established residential neighborhoods. Associated impacts may include commercial parking on residential streets, increased litter, and excessive noise that would deteriorate the quality of life for those in the immediate vicinity. In addition, high impact convenience stores would not promote the City's brand and for the reasons discussed above would harm neighborhood character. The City Council finds that allowing the unregulated development of high impact convenience stores during the City's consideration of how to properly regulate such stores would result in the negative impacts described above, would erode the existing character of the City's neighborhoods and would frustrate the purpose of any regulations ultimately adopted. To ensure that the development of convenience stores during this period of study is consistent with the goals and objectives of protecting the City's character, the City Council finds it necessary to adopt this Interim Ordinance to both respect property rights and protect the public health, safety and general welfare. Absent the passage of this interim Ordinance, inconsistent development of high impact convenience stores poses a current and immediate threat to the public health, safety, or general welfare, and approval of additional entitlements for any development inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance would frustrate the City's ability to protect the public health, safety, and welfare. Therefore, this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and its urgency

Section 7. The City Council hereby finds that it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the adoption and implementation of this Ordinance may have a significant effect on the environment. This Ordinance does not authorize construction and, in fact, imposes greater restrictions on certain development in order to protect the public health, safety and general welfare. This Ordinance is therefore exempt from the environmental review requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations. Further, this Ordinance is exempt from CEQA on the separate and independent ground that it is an action of a regulatory agency (the City) for protection of the environment because it will protect residential neighborhoods and commercial uses from impacts associated with intensification of commercial uses, and thereby qualifies as a Class 8 exemption pursuant to Section 15308 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations.

Section 8. No lot, premises, building, or portion thereof in the City of Beverly Hills shall be used for any "high impact convenience store" as that term is defined in Section 9 of this Ordinance, unless the City issues a convenience store conditional use permit. The City shall process an application for a convenience store conditional use permit in the same manner that it would process an application for a conditional use permit pursuant to Article 38 of Chapter 3 of Title 10 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code. The City may impose any conditions on a convenience store conditional use permit that are necessary to preserve the public health, welfare or safety, or to mitigate any potential adverse impacts resulting from the establishment of a high impact convenience store. The City shall not approve a convenience store conditional use permit unless it makes each of the following findings:

1. The proposed use is compatible with the surrounding area and uses;
2. The proposed use will have adequate buffering between the use and residential areas, schools, parks, and other locations where children gather;
3. The proposed use will not create an adverse traffic impact or a traffic safety hazard to pedestrians or to vehicles, including, but not limited to, an adverse impact on traffic circulation or parking;
4. The proposed use will not create excessive noise, unpleasant odors, noxious fumes, excessive lighting, increased litter, or substantial interference with neighboring properties or uses due to the activities associated with the proposed use or its hours of operation;
5. The proposed use will not create an overconcentration of convenience stores in the area.

Section 9. For the purposes of this Ordinance, "high impact convenience store" shall be defined as follows:

"High Impact Convenience Store: Any retail store with the following characteristics: (1) more than half the square footage is dedicated to the sale of general food and drink products not intended for home preparation and consumption, tobacco, magazines, and toiletries, (2) the store is open to customers before 7:00 a.m. or after 9:00 p.m., Monday through Friday or before 9:00 am or after 9:00 pm on Saturday or Sunday, and (3) meets one of the following – is served by on site surface parking or located within three hundred feet of a residential zone."

Section 10. This Ordinance, being an Interim Ordinance adopted as an urgency measure for the immediate protection of the public safety, health, and general welfare, containing a declaration of the facts constituting the urgency, and passed by a minimum four-fifths (4/5) vote of the City Council, shall take effect immediately upon its adoption, and remain valid for forty-five (45) days, unless extended in accordance with Government Code Section 65858.

Section 11. Severability. If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or place, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect. To the extent that the discre-

tionary process to approve a convenience store conditional use permit, or any part thereof, is determined to be invalid, the prohibition against high impact convenience stores shall remain valid.

Section 12. The City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation published and circulated in the City within fifteen (15) days after its passage in accordance with Section 36933 of the Government Code, shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause this Ordinance and his certification, together with proof of publication, to be entered in the Book of Ordinances of the Council of this City.
