Metro Westside Subway Extension and 30/10

I wanted [the City Council] to have a brief response to the four points [former Mayor] Steve Webb makes in the one-sided and inaccurate letter, which [the council] recently received from him.

1. Implication that the mass transit committee should have considered a tunnel under Beverly High. I served on the Mass Transit Committee and attended every meeting. Very simple: At no time whatsoever was the Committee given any route to consider that would or could go under the high school or anywhere near it. Period. With all the alternative routes suggested by Metro for Committee consideration (and there were several), that was never one of them. (In all the attachments to Steve's letter, there is no such alternative route. There never was. Just very general wording in the final report, none of it even mentioning schools. Any contrary implication is simply inaccurate.) Ask Aaron Kunz or any Committee member.

And since Metro itself was the Committee's principal source of information, possible routes and experts, how was it somehow "our failing" (as Steve writes)

to opine on a totally different route out of all those Metro put forward. Steve has now not-so-subtly tried to shift the blame from Metro to the Committee for the high school route. That's simply astounding.

2. Wait! Wait! Wait! Our City is virtually unanimous. For extraordinarily good reasons, we all want our City and School Board to use every proper means available to oppose Metro's choice to tunnel under the high school. Just as Metro is doing by pulling out all the stops (you'll pardon the intended pun) to placate the Century City Chamber and developers. And yet, for more than 10 months, Steve has urged the School Board and the Council to WAIT: Wait for the draft environmental report. Wait for the outcome of discussions with Metro. And wait for the Metro Board meeting.

Now once again it's wait for the final environmental report and wait until the high school has modernization plans. But everyone else is urging [the council] to be pro-active and to take every step to convince Metro to choose the Santa Monica Blvd. station. "Waiting" has only given Metro and the Century City proponents momentum and an unfortunate—and inaccurate—claim that we are a divided city. And exactly where has "waiting" all this time gotten us?

3. Why is opposing 30-10 financing "clearly inappropriate"? We're all fighting for the ability to be able to modernize our City's only high school so that we can once again be a beacon of public education. We're fighting for the safety of 2,500 students and teachers. We're fighting to

avoid Metro choosing to tunnel around oil and methane fields and under 85-year-old buildings. We're fighting so that we are not the only school in LA County (and perhaps in the state) to have a subway tunnel run underneath. And why—as Steve is urging [the council] to do—would we simply forego lobbying in Washington D.C. (as Metro is actively doing) and give up one of the most forceful arguments we have when Metro and the Century City proponents are using every possible means they have? That just doesn't make sense. Why would we support financing for a dangerous tunnel and subway extension that we oppose for good reasons? Steve would like us to be perceived as "nice guys" while Metro's train continues to inexorably move down the track.

4. District modernization plans. As to Steve's recommendation that the school district provide its plans now for any future project, the fact that the district may or may not have specific plans developed yet is immaterial to our objection to tunneling under the high school. The experts tell us that putting the subway tunnel under BHHS will negate or severely impact the ability to bring the 85-year-old facilities up to date. We can't afford that either economically or educationally. There is no way of knowing absolutely what future needs on the site may be, and BHUSD should not be limited in its flexibility to develop, modernize or enhance its only high school at any time necessary

City Council rejects 2012 Rose Parade float

After meeting with representatives of the Rodeo Drive Committee, the Conference and Visitors Bureau and the Beverly Hills Chamber of Commerce, the city council liaison reported that the CVB was interested in the possibility of entering a float in the 2012 Tournament of Roses Parade. However, the CVB was only interested in allocating \$250,000 from the City's centennial anniversary fund, and not \$350,000 that would cover the full cost of the float and last year's debt.

The city council voted 3-2 not to go forward with plans for the float, with Councilmembers Lili Bosse and John Mirisch voting in favor of funding a float.

According to Mirisch, who is on the liaison committee, the Rodeo Drive Committee endorsed the idea of the float, but the Chamber of Commerce has not yet responded.

The City Council sought input from Beverly Hills business entities to see if there was interest in allocating \$350,000 to cover the cost of a \$275,000 float for the 2012 parade and to pay the \$75,000 debt carried over from the 2011 float. Bosse pointed out the debt was actually a total of \$70,000 to cover \$60,000 owed to float maker Fiesta Floats and \$10,000 owed back to the city for a loan.

"No vote was ever taken on the merits of having a float for 2012 and no CVB money was approved to be allocated to a float for 2012," CVB Board member and former Mayor Linda Briskman wrote in an e-mail. "If the council wants to pay arrearages, if they want a float for 2012, it is strictly their call."

The City Council voted 3-2 against Bosse's motion to allocate \$200,000 toward the float, to cover the \$130,000 in matching funds that the Tournament of Roses Committee had requested in April, and \$70,000 to cover the debt. Although City Attorney Larry Wiener told the city council it was not legally obligated to pay the debt, the city council decided it was morally obligated to do so. Mayor Barry Brucker, Vice Mayor Willie Brien and Councilmember Julian Gold voted against the motion.

"Number one, I was not willing to spend \$350,000 on a float," Brucker said on Wednesday. "I think there are way better opportunities to bring business to Beverly Hills, to Rodeo Drive for the holidays, for holiday shopping. Secondly I was not willing to support my colleague's proposal to authorize something less than the total cost of the float because I think it would be irresponsible of us to contract out for half of a product."

Bosse supported the float because it would promote community, volunteerism and provide international television exposure.

"[The float committee] felt very strongly that they will have the money and we are not going to get into the same situation that happened last year," Bosse said. "Whatever sort of deal we write, whether morally or legally,

[\$200,000] is what we're committing to. It is up to the committee to decide. They are hearing us, this is what we're giving them. They then can say this is not doable."

Julie Steinberg, who coordinated volunteers for the Beverly Hills Tournament of Roses Committee's 2011 effort, pointed out there were some extra costs included in the requested budget. *Courier* publisher Clif Smith, who was a 2011 committee member, appeared at the study session in April to request up to \$150,000 in matching funds from the city council, but the city council did not support the idea because it had not started studying its 2011-2012 budget. Smith was not present at Tuesday's meeting.

"When talking about how much the float cost, in the budget [we gave you] are about \$12,000 [to] \$14,000 of extras, which include pins, T-shirts, dinner and lunch for volunteers," Steinberg said. "We did a VIP lunch last year, so there's wiggle room. The cost of the float would be the \$7,000 entrance fee—this is based on last year—and \$250,000 for the float. There are extras in there to accommodate volunteers."

Gold said he might consider going forward with the float if the Tournament of Roses Committee came to the next meeting with \$150,000 of pledges. Since that was not part of the motion, Gold voted no.

"I'm loathe to commit until [we have] identified all sources of funding," Gold said. "I want to ensure we can cover our costs here."

Mirisch supported the float. "I think that if you don't do something that gives the best value for money, it calls into question everything else you're going to spend marketing dollars on," Mirisch said on

Wednesday.

The City of Beverly Hills allocates 2 percent of its transient occupancy tax revenue to fund City tourism and marketing initiatives. Over \$4 million was allocated for the 2011-2012 tourism and marketing budget.

"There are other cities like Glendale considering pulling support," Mirisch said. "None of them have \$4 million marketing budgets the way we do."

The *Los Angeles Times* reported Wednesday that West Covina has decided not to enter a float in the 2012 Rose Parade due to fundraising challenges, and the Glendale city council may vote to end its \$130,000 annual commitment to the Glendale Rose Float Association. Glendale has entered a float every year for the past 98 years. The Burbank City Council reduced its commitment by 10 percent and the Alhambra City Council has proposed ending its \$100,000 contribution to the Chamber of Commerce for the float.

The City Council still has to decide how it will pay the debt from this year's float, with the topic returning at the July 7 meeting.

Brucker, Villaraigosa discuss subway at Mayors Conference in Baltimore

About 200 mayors, including Mayor Barry Brucker, gathered in Baltimore for the U.S. Conference of Mayors 79th Annual Meeting from June 17 to 21. Mayors attended study sessions on

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topics ranging from climate control to housing to transportation and heard from public officials including United Nations Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon and Rep. Nancy Pelosi (D-San Francisco).

"The beauty of this conference is no one is there to upstage anyone else because we're all mayors of different cities. We can't run against each other," Brucker said. "It really becomes a forum where mayors speak very candidly about what is working and what isn't working in their cities."

The conference gave Brucker the chance to meet high-profile mayors from out of state—he sat next to Chicago Mayor Rahm Emanuel at one luncheon—as well as visit with neighboring mayors Richard Montgomery of Manhattan Beach and Antonio Villaraigosa of Los Angeles.

Brucker took the opportunity to meet one on one with Villaraigosa, who was sworn in Monday as President of the U.S. Conference of Mayors, to discuss the Metro Westside

Subway Extension.

"[Villaraigosa] understands quite significantly the concerns that we have regarding the tunneling and we have an appointment set up for [later] this week or early next week," Brucker said. "[The subway] is obviously an important subject for him so I was very happy we were able to get a chance to network personally together."

Brucker said Villaraigosa's speech focused on the 30/10 initiative, the plan to complete 30 years worth of transit projects in 10 years in Los Angeles County using a federal loan, that he coined America Fast Forward. Mayors adopted a resolution by that name to encourage Congress to expand and create innovative transportation and infrastructure programs to generate job growth throughout the country.

Brucker said Villaraigosa also brought up civility, which Brucker has been promoting with his Take a Moment campaign. Tucson Mayor Bob Walkup also spoke about civility at a luncheon, reflecting on the January

shooting of Rep. Gabrielle Giffords.

"One of [Villaraigosa's] themes was let's stop screaming at each other and start having more respectful dialogues," Brucker said. "This whole Take a Moment campaign, however it is coined, it is sort of thematic across the country."

Another memorable moment for Brucker was when Muhammad Younus Nowandish, Mayor of Kabul, Afghanistan addressed the conference, asking for mayors' expanded support of U.S. efforts in Afghanistan.

"I think he was waiting for a round of applause and the room was dead silent because one of the themes here at this conference is bringing our troops home," Brucker said. "We have a lot of issues to deal with here, including jobs, the economy, transportation, education, health care and we're spending billions of dollars in wars and defenses all around the world. Mayors are very determined to send a clear message to Washington. We need to first clean up house domestically and start spending dollars on

textbooks and not bullets."

Mayors sent that message by passing a resolution calling for the drawdown of troops in a measured way that does not destabilize the region, to make the \$126 billion in annual military expenditures in Iraq and Afghanistan available for domestic use.

Brucker said a visit to a revitalized area of Baltimore gave him inspiration for parts of Beverly Hills that could use rehabilitation, such as the Olympic Boulevard corridor and eastern Wilshire Boulevard.

"They took us to an old mill that was in the center of town and was a blighted area and they really built a work, live and dine community around this whole mill complex," Brucker said. "That was inspiring."

The conference also gave Brucker the chance to further the brand of Beverly Hills, which he did by distributing Beverly Hills lapel pins.

"If anybody is questioning the strength of the brand of Beverly Hills, all you had to be was at this mayors conference," Brucker said. "I brought about 100 Beverly Hills lapel pins and everybody was asking for them. I'm out of pins."

Bosse expresses concerns about Roxbury Park community center

Councilmember Lili Bosse voiced concerns about plans for a new community center at Roxbury Park when she voted no on the City's capital improvements program budget based on those plans earlier this month. Bosse discussed her

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now or in the future. A fight to win, not posture

And a shout-out to Peggy Kaus

"I would rather be right and lose, than win by compromising."

You have to admire the integrity of that philosophical posture, and I have heard it expressed by doctrinaire purists on the far right and far left. However, the more extreme proponents of candidates for public office, or on issues, usually have their wish: They do go down to defeat.

Now, the debate on how to best win the battle to prevent a subway from going under the high school is far too important to even consider anything that could divide our community. What we do here and now will impact the lives and safety of children not yet born: the future students of our one high school.

Make no mistake. Tunneling under a school could be catastrophic. The science is so incomplete, the experts so divided, that even if there is no absolute finding of safety hazards, just the possibility of danger should be sufficient to deter accepting the route through Beverly Hills to Century City.

Now, here's the problem. Some very well intentioned community and civic leaders are demanding that we draw lines in the political sands, make threat of political retaliation and cite all those who are waffling in their support of the city's wishes as "enemies of the people."

There is one problem with this strategy: We don't have the voting power to carry out our threats. Beverly Hills is an infinitesimal minority in the political subdivisions that have the power to make the route decisions: the elected officials on the board of the Metropolitan Transit Authority.

As an example, our County Supervisor, **Zev Yaroslavsky**, routinely wins reelection, and our total vote in his sprawling district is about one percent!

What about campaign contributions? Yes, this community does provide a disproportionate percentage of donations to all kinds of candidates for public office, from national to local campaigns, and more recent years, to contenders in both parties, not just Democrats.

Someone made that point at Tuesday's city council hearing on a proposed subway resolution. The audience was packed with proponents who wanted the council to take a tough, all or nothing position.

There was only one problem with that argument—depriving campaign money to those with whom we disagree: Few if any of the big donors were in the room or have shown any interest in the subway battle.

In fact, that is part of the problem.

Instead of asking the school board and city council to lead this fight, why not form a broadly based, city wide committee to enter the fray. Take this out of local, political in-fighting and bring together all those who oppose the Century City route. If **Fred Hayman, Stanley Black, Mrs. Janet Salter, Dick Rosenzweig, Dar Mahboubi, Wolfgang Puck** and **Monty Hall**, to name just a few, were involved, the effort would take on some political reality.

Not that members of the council and board are without power. Clearly, to those watching the internal differences on strategy outside our city, their disagreements on strategy make us look inept and minimize their impact.

Settling old political wounds, personal conflicts among our elected officials is all too apparent among the decision makers outside Beverly Hills.

Yes, the proposed resolution: Either stick with the Santa Monica route or we will fight the whole subway project, or at the very least, oppose federal funding that would speed up completion, may sound great, but unless we turn this into a doable effort the only achievement will be a moral victory and a loss of the critical fight to prevent tunneling under the school. And that would be a shameful result.

Lost in Tuesday's highly charged council public hearing was a report by Mayor **Barry Brucker** on a conversation he had with Mayor **Antonio Villaraigosa** at a recent meeting of the Conference of Mayors in Baltimore. When Brucker explained to the Los Angeles mayor the possible political implications on the current debate on strategy, he listened very carefully, since he is one the leading supporters of the subway to the sea.

Of the ten elected officials on the school board and city council, several have significant outside political influence, but for different reasons and not with the same impact locally. Board president **Lisa Korbatov** is a major donor to Republican candidates, however almost all of our elected officials are Democrats. Board member **Myra Lurie** and her family have a long history of backing Democrats, **Sooky and Sam Goldman**, her in-laws, helped elect a small army of liberals to office.

On the council, Brucker has great clout, but the most well known of all is Dr. **Willie Brien**. When they discuss how to win this battle, we have to listen.

As we wrote last week, making personal attacks on the people in office

who have the ability to decide this issue is really very dumb. In fact, what is happening because of our more strident voices, is that we have become the villains, perceived as caring only about our own interests and not those of the whole region. Trust me, attacking Beverly Hills wins political brownie points almost everywhere else.

Some of those who are with the community in the campaign, but only a few, are showing their political biases or their private political interests. They seem too often to care about their own political power than what is really in the community's interests.

Barry Goldwater may have been intellectually honest when he made his famous claim about "extremism" being a kind of virtue, but he was clobbered in his drive to become president.

We may love the sound of our own voices demanding that our way or no highway (subway, that is), but winning, in this case, is everything.

There are few people in our village with whom I have had more disagreements and yet most admire than the redoubtable **Peggy Kaus**.

Truthfully, some of my most consistent opponents, on issues, are residents I consider among my best friends, Peggy being the first among this group. (The list would also have to include **Rose Norton, Gloria Seiff, Mel Spitz, and Bob Tanenbaum** and other "no-sayers.")

I learned that Peggy was ill from someone who also had his own tussles with Peggy, former city manager **Mark Scott**, but who shared my affection for this remarkable lady. And "lady" is the operative word. Her precise, clipped English speech mode helped define her. It is as if her voice carried a twinkle. Yes, she could be emotional on issues, mostly her concerns about the uses of Roxbury Park and the southwest areas of the city, but her efforts and disagreements were always civilized and respectful, even when most passionate.

Wife of the highly respected late state supreme court justice, Otto, and mother of a well known political pundit, Mickey, inside our village, the best known in the family was and is Peggy.

We are a better community because Peggy spent most of her life among us. I know you will join Josette and I in hoping for her speedy recovery. I look forward to her next scolding on not being more concerned about too massive plans for Roxbury.

With all the other important challenges facing the school board, one would have hoped that how a letter of invitation for a school visit program to China was processed would not receive all that much attention.

But this being Beverly Hills, where side

and petty fights too often take the place of reality, we should not be too surprised when some board members lose touch with priorities.

Here's what happened. Board member and past board president **Myra Lurie** received a letter inviting our schools to participate in a complicated visit to China program. The letter was obviously intended for the school superintendent. What she did was according to the rules: she immediately forwarded the communication to School Supt. **Dick Douglas**. Reports that Lurie "waited ten days" to send the communication to Douglas, as reported elsewhere, are totally untrue, and confirmed by Douglas. (He received it the next day.)

There were serious time problems involved in the Chinese invite, which the head of the music department, the most directly involved, **Joel Pressman**, tried to point out at a board meeting. It was his department that was most impacted by the invitation. Unfortunately, internal disagreements on the board again intervened with responsible discussion, and Pressman was refused an opportunity to be heard. Lurie took flack from a colleague for not sending the message to the whole board. Wrong. Following Brown Act rules, Lurie, a lawyer, forwarded it to Douglas who then could share it with all board members.

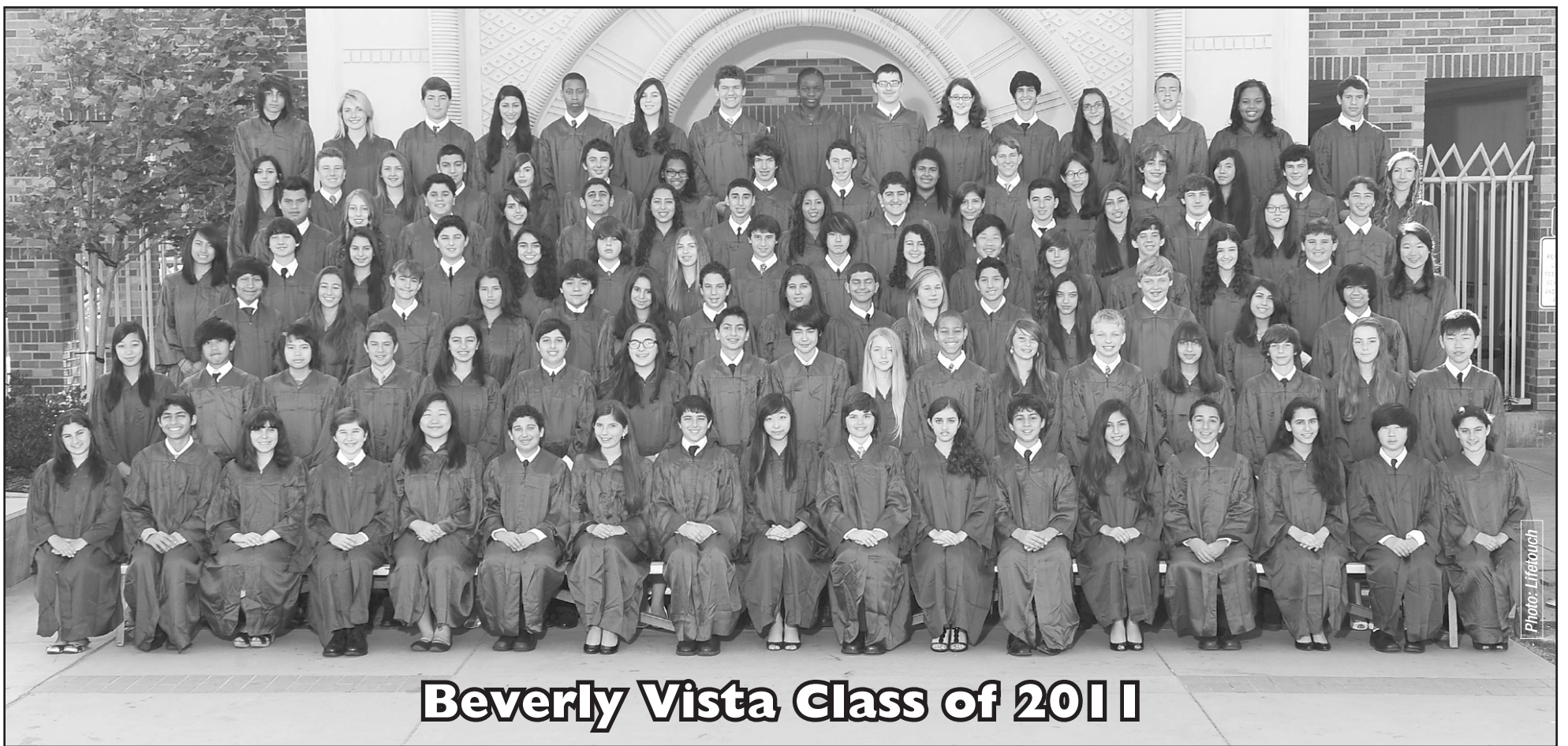
Does this sound too trivial to even ponder? Well, the invitation letter took up valuable time at two board meetings. When it became too volatile, member **Jake Manaster** tried to intervene on a point of order. Why board president Lisa Korbatov became so enraged and made this so personal, is hard to understand. Earlier, Lisa had proclaimed her desire to make the board less confrontational, more collegial.

William Knowland must be rolling in some grave. Our late Republican Senator, dubbed the Senator from Formosa, would have had problems adjusting to a Republican, Korbatov, fighting to assure we sent our kids to China. Of course, we all favor cultural exchanges and better relations with the largest, remaining Communist country in the world, but we also need to remember their record on human rights is far from exemplary.

It does seem that being elected to the school board, historically, gives you a badge to combat your colleagues. The more things change, the more they remain the same, too bad. But someone owes Lurie a public apology.

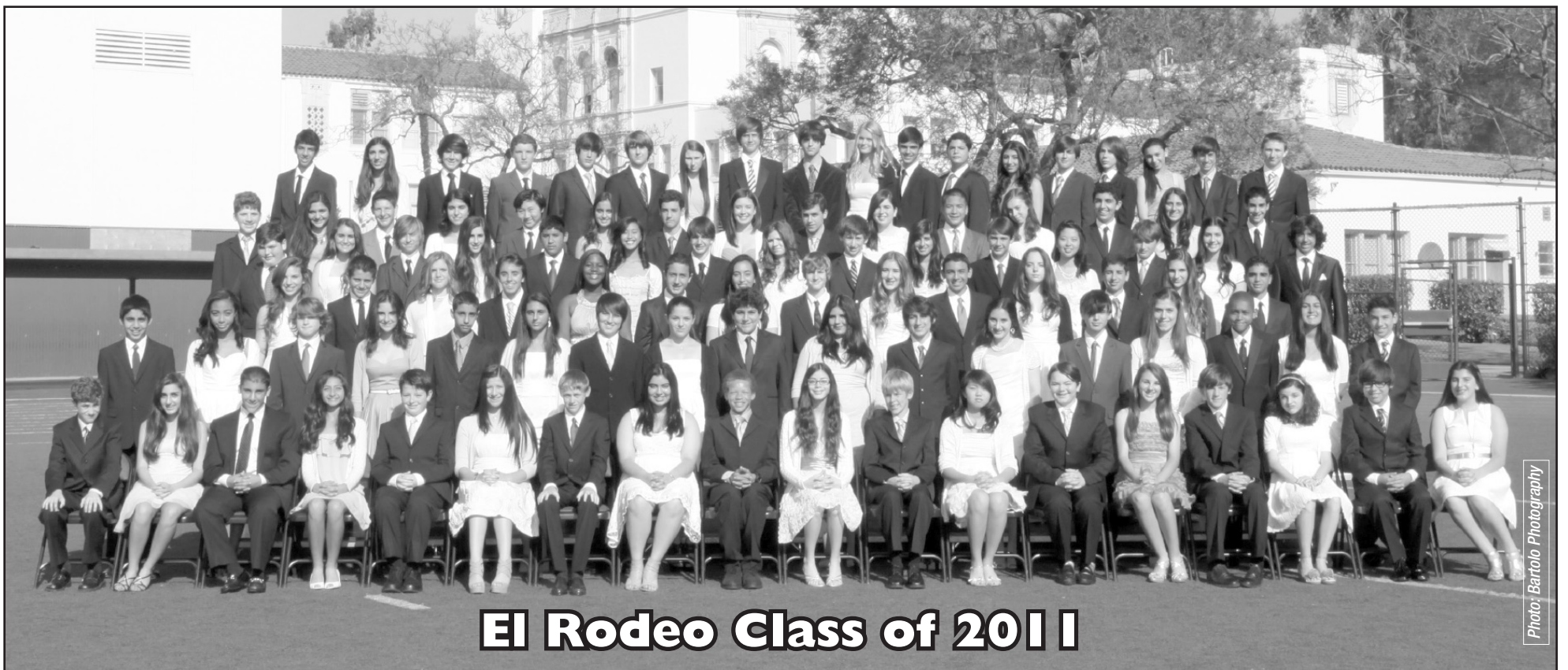

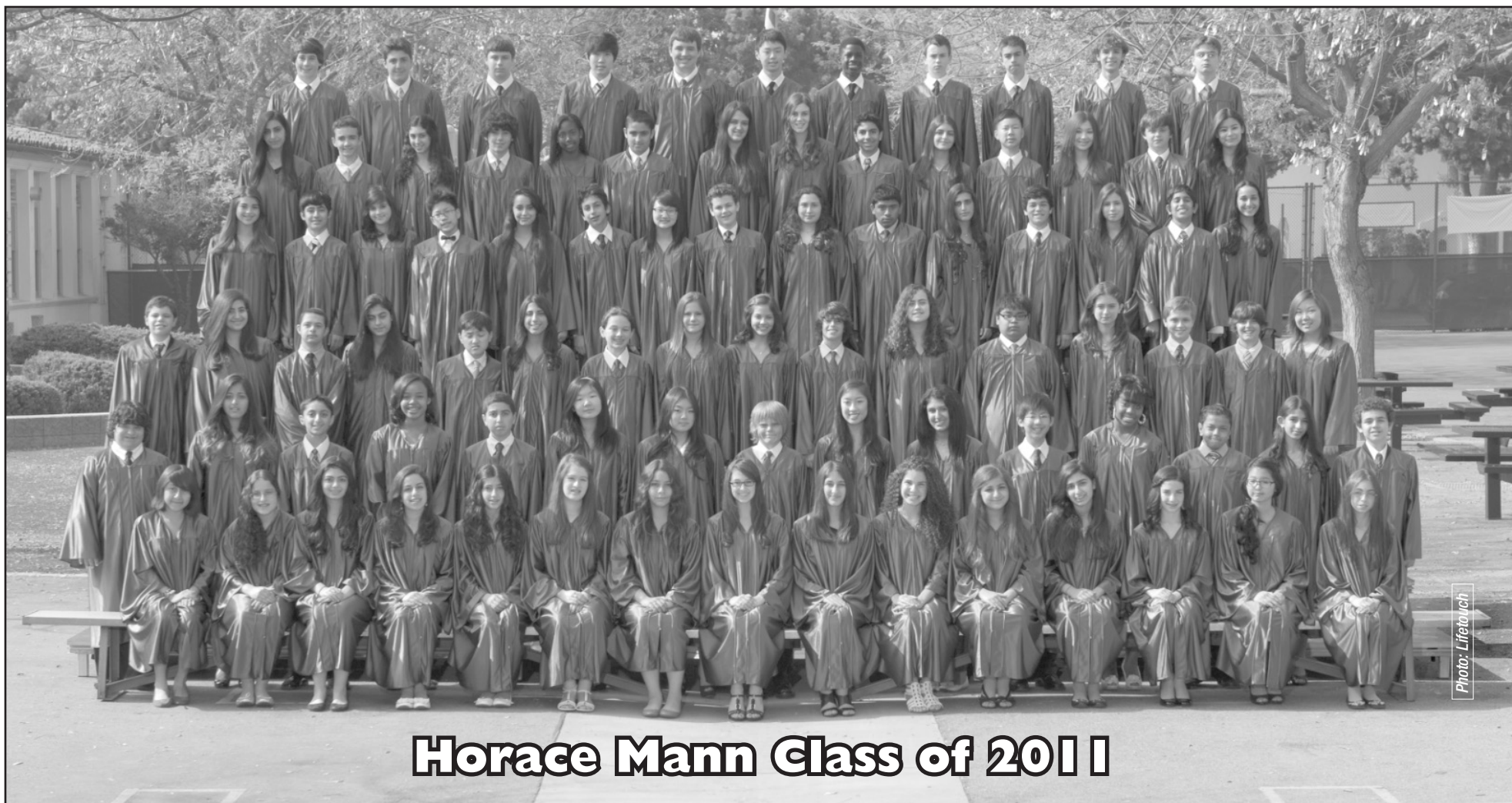

Since my first day of Kindergarten until my graduation day at Beverly Vista, I had

been looking forward to attending Beverly High. What an experience it was!

Everyone should try freshman football, even if you don't think you are a spectacular athlete. Joining this team opens a lot of opportunities, teaches you lots of skills, and gives you a new group of friends right away. It's also fun to represent BHHS at games, and to have people cheering you on. During my four years of high school I played football, baseball, wrestling, lacrosse, and swimming, and probably would have played more if I had had the time. I noticed that if I wasn't playing a sport, I got lazy, had a lack of energy, and sometimes didn't have my homework done for the next day.

I began Boy Scouts as a Cub Scout, and achieved the honor of Eagle Scout while I was in high school. I learned many important life and survival skills, teamwork, and organization. I also began to really develop my leadership skills teaching the younger Scouts the way I had been taught. I also graduated from the Beverly Hills Police Explorers Academy, which taught me leadership skills and what to do in emergencies.

At the end of my sophomore year, my dad took the whole family out to break some important news. We were moving to Rochester, New York! We couldn't believe it at first. Everything we had come to know, all our friends, our favorite restaurants, things to do, and places to go were all gone. The sunshine was gone as well! We had to start a new life in this small city back east. Even though this new life lasted only a year, the knowledge we gained, and the experiences we had was a blessing in my opinion.

There was no way I would see Tom Cruise at my sister's softball game, but I might run into the local mail carrier, or paper delivery boy.

Parties were very different, too. They all had basements; it was like partying in an old '80s movie. The restaurants were not fancy. I had a job working at a place called the Char Broil. Rochester is known for the creation of the garbage plate: macaroni salad, home fries, and your choice of two burger patties or hot dogs on top. Then they scramble it all together and put the secret tiger sauce on top. It's AMAZING!

Concerts in Los Angeles are a big deal. In Rochester, one of the most noticeable differences for me was not having such a vast selection of concerts to attend. But I saw a Grateful Dead tribute band, called the Dark Star Orchestra, so I'm not complaining.

I now really understand that the people, the values, and the culture of Rochester were much more representative of America itself. Everyone worked after school, and I got my first job in Rochester, and collected my first paycheck. I took on more responsibility around the house. I learned to really listen to people's stories about their lives, and learn from the things they told me.

Beverly Hills is one of the best-known and premier places to live on the entire planet, but it is very different from the rest of the United States. Here, we live the lives that people all over the world, covet, dream about and would actually risk dying for. Some actually do: with TV and Internet, people in the Middle East now see what great lives we have, and are fighting a revolution to live in the same way. Hopefully, they see the values and culture of all of the United States, and will succeed in their quest.

When I came back to Beverly Hills last fall, I could see very differently. I could see underneath all the material things, the cars and homes and clubs, and look for what was really important. I could respect and value people for who they are and not just for what they have. As a senior, I could think about the future and what I wanted to do seriously.

My family has always espoused Jewish values and felt a close connection to Israel. My brother and sister had their Bar and Bat Mitzvahs in Israel, and we stayed there and visited the country for a few weeks. I really loved the beauty of the land and the idealism of the people. I felt very

connected to Israel. As I thought about what I should do after high school, I realized that I needed more time to think about what I wanted to do in college, and also that I wanted to dedicate a part of my life to Israel. I wanted to use what I had learned as an Eagle Scout and at the Police Explorers Academy, and my leadership skills. I decided to turn my focus, my dedication, and my skill-set toward the defense of the Jewish people and to join the Israel Defense Forces. High school has definitely shaped who I am today. Going to school every day was exciting not only because I saw my friends, but also because I got to practice and compete with my teams for volleyball, basketball, and softball. High school sports was everything to me and anyone who knows me knows that it has always been my greatest passion. Being out with my teammates and playing together every day preparing for competition was what I loved most about my four years at Beverly. As captain of my teams I learned skills of leadership and responsibility. All I wanted to do every day was to play because it gave me an indescribable feeling and defined who I am. Without playing sports, a part of me would be missing.

On March 20, 2010 I was playing in my second-round CIF basketball game and with 0.5 seconds left in the game I scored as the buzzer went off, and collapsed to the floor in the most pain I have ever felt. All I could think of was if this injury could ruin my chances for my trip to Hawaii for a tournament with my volleyball team, how my senior year would be ruined and my chances of playing college volleyball could end. Unfortunately, I tore my ACL and meniscus [a piece of cartilage in the knee that provides a cushion between the shin and thigh bones], which resulted in surgery. I would not be able to do any physical activity for six months, meaning I was not going to play with my team in Hawaii. I was devastated and could not believe that something this bad could ever happen to me. Having to do nine hours of painful physical therapy a week while watching my teammates continue to play was definitely the hardest thing I ever had to go through. No one understood how I was feeling and the fact that I was so incapable of doing what I loved most was making my life feel worthless. I had to find a way to get healthy enough so I could play with my teammates in Hawaii, because there was no way I would allow myself to travel all the way there just to sit on the bench.

Although my coaches did not believe in me and did not expect me to be able to play, I worked my butt off every single day to get myself healthy enough to get back on the court. The tournament was only five and a half months away, but I ignored the fact that it normally takes six months to a year for many athletes to return to competition following this type of injury. I wanted to prove everyone wrong, so I pushed myself for hours a day, no matter how much pain I was in. Two days before I was to leave for Hawaii with my team, I was told that I was cleared to begin playing, although with many restrictions and I had to wear a huge brace on my entire leg. Although I was playing only at 75 percent, I was so happy and knew I would make my last season the best.

No one could believe that I came back from this injury early and jumped into my summer sessions of six intense hours of volleyball a day. This incident was a life-changing experience for me, helping me grow stronger and become more positive and thankful for my health. Going to Hawaii with my volleyball team was one of the most amazing experiences of my life. Being back on the court was thrilling, but at the same time it was nerve-wracking. I was scared to bend my knees and I was doing whatever I could to protect my knee, since my biggest fear was reinjuring myself. At the tournament, my coach took me to the corner and told me that if this continued she would move another freshman girl up to take my spot on the team. I was devastated and could not believe my coach had no understanding of my pain and fear, and that she did not appreciate what I went through for the team. It was my senior year and I made sure no one would take my spot by gradually overcoming my fear so that I could play competitively. I blocked out all the negative thoughts and tried to remember how good it felt to play. My teammates helped me through it. We competed in tournaments and bonded, which prepared us for our upcoming season. I grew close to the seven girls on my team and we were friends on and off the court.

In addition to high school sports, I loved seeing my friends every day, meeting new people and even going to class. I spent three years in Mr. [Keith] Rust's Art Appreciation and drawing and painting classes and my senior year with Ms. [Michelle] Halimi in Service Learning. I loved giving back to my community and doing something good for others, and having art throughout high school because it allowed me to express myself. Throughout my years at Beverly I have learned through many experiences about trust and the true meaning of friendship. I have learned to deal with people who try to destroy you and put you down and through that I have built confidence. It is still shocking to me that once we graduate, this chapter in my life will be over. I will no longer be rushing every morning to my favorite place trying to be on time for class, hanging out with my friends in between classes in the alley, or competing in athletics. Instead I will be a college student preparing for my future and my life ahead of me. I can honestly say I lived my high school experience to the fullest being so involved with extracurricular activities and I have absolutely no regrets.

concerns at the Municipal League of Beverly Hills Annual Meeting on June 15, and during a phone interview on Monday.

"My first big concern was that there hadn't been an EIR [Environmental Impact Report] done on this building," Bosse said on Monday.

Bosse disagreed that the proposed building should have received an exemption back in 2008, the same year that the city council approved the Parks Master Plan for improvements at Roxbury and La Cienega parks. Bosse believes the proposed community center should require an EIR because it is a larger building and would have intensification of use due to new programs and facilities at the community center.

Although Bosse said she believes the community supports improving the community center, she does not believe the community wanted the expansion or intensification that would come with the scale of the proposed facility, which includes a gymnasium, teen center, rock climbing wall and banquet facilities among other things.

Bosse pointed out that the exemption was granted based on a 22,300-square-foot community center, but current plans call for a 26,700-square-foot community center. Bosse said the plans for the 22,300-square-foot

community center were also used to estimate project costs and to analyze parking needs.

"I think it's very important that we do a real accurate cost assessment of what it would cost to build the building as it's being proposed now, which is 27,000 square feet," Bosse said. "All costs that have been evaluated have been on a smaller building."

Bosse said one argument city officials made for building a new community center instead of renovating the existing building is that the cost difference would be just \$1.5 million. However, Bosse discovered that the \$13.2 million estimate for renovation includes a new 11,000-square-foot multi-purpose room expansion for \$4.7 million. The cost of building a new 22,300-square-foot community center is estimated at \$14.7 million.

"When the community was told it was going to be \$13 million to renovate, that number is not accurate because of this new multi-purpose room expansion that was put into the equation," Bosse said.

Bosse also brought up parking, because she does not believe that current plans provide for enough parking to accommodate uses at the new community center.

"The city is using street parking as a way to suggest that the building will be parked efficiently and will be able to accommodate the needs, and my experience is we never used street parking to calculate for having

sufficient parking, [since] you can't guarantee that that parking would be available," Bosse said. "I feel that it is our responsibility when we do build a city building that we build for ample parking and that we don't create any possible situation that could cause impacts to the neighborhood."

Finally, Bosse said that the City should take into account the school district's modernization plans using the \$334 million Measure E bond.

"We need to coordinate because I know the school district has talked about interest in building a gymnasium [at Beverly High]," Bosse said. "To me it doesn't make sense to be repeating the same type of building just two blocks away."

On Tuesday, Mayor Barry Brucker said that he and Bosse would have to "agree to disagree respectfully" about certain issues related to the Roxbury Park community center.

When Brucker was asked if he would consider renovating the park without the added cost of the 11,000-square-foot multi-purpose room, he said, "What we have currently is a completely inefficient, outdated, poorly designed community center. I certainly am not a fan of slapping on a Band-Aid when its time has come to be replaced."

However, Brucker said, "I am openminded to hearing from our residents, my colleagues,

experts and our commissioners, and if there are certain elements that maybe we don't need, I'm openminded to it. If there are elements maybe we should add I'm openminded to it."

To Bosse's concerns about intensification of use related to the banquet facilities, Brucker said "the council will set a policy as to what uses are appropriate." Brucker said he did not think weddings and Bar and Bat mitzvahs would be likely uses for the facilities.

Brucker said he was not opposed to counting street parking as part of the required parking, because the park was designed and developed with parking on the street and its own dedicated parking lot.

Brucker said he expects bids to come out in the late summer or early fall.

"At that time we will see where costing comes out and there may be requirements to scale back due to costs," Brucker said. "We may even find our estimates were higher than what they come in at because contractors are hungrier for jobs. I'm cautiously optimistic that the contractors will come back with very competitive rates."

Like Bosse, Councilmember John Mirisch supports improving the community center, but on a smaller scale, while Vice Mayor Willie Brien and Councilmember Julian Gold support the proposed, larger plans.

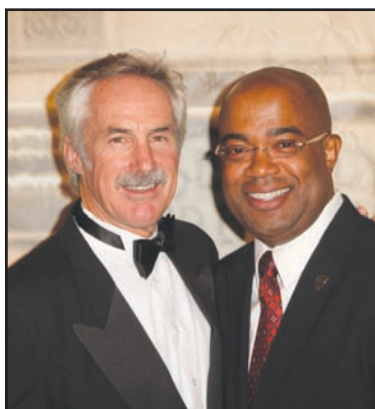

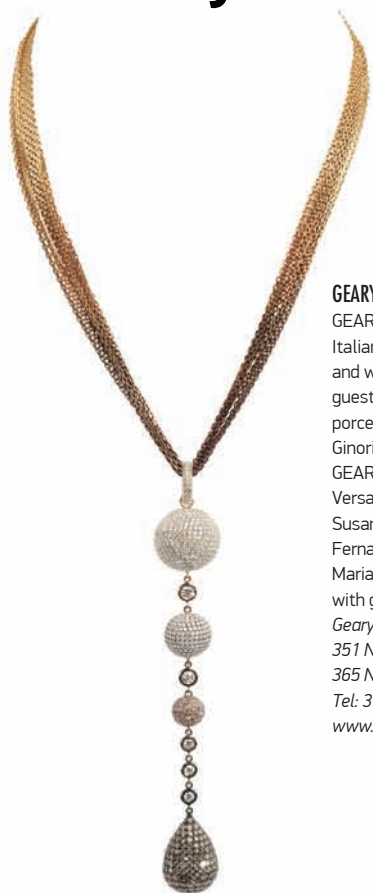

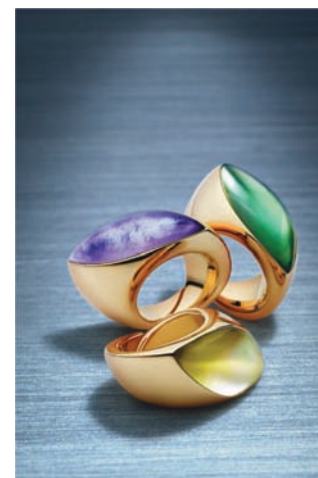
