LA Marathon’s run through Beverly Hills to continue next year

Following a three-year run of the Honda LA Marathon through the City of Beverly Hills, the City Council unanimously agreed Tuesday afternoon to allow the marathon to pass through the City at least one more time next March.

The race has been controversial in years past because of street closures that divide the City in half for the preparation and duration of the marathon.

“I think the question for me is does this benefit our city and clearly we have had the last three years to try it out and this past year was definitely better than the two years prior. To me it’s impossible to ignore that our city is definitely cut in half in terms of access,” Councilmember Lili Bosse said. “I do feel that it really comes down to balance and weighing the pros and cons. I am willing to try this another year. I think given the fact that there’s been a lot of analysis and a lot of fixing on everybody’s part, I feel pretty confident that it can be a better event.”

Bosse, who is on the liaison committee for special events with Councilmember Barry Brucker, said she was initially not supportive of extending the agreement with the marathon because of its impacts. One thing that helped

Metro postpones Century City subway station vote; agrees to hearing with Beverly Hills

The Metro board voted April 26 to approve Phase I of the Westside Subway Extension, which would end with a station terminus at La Cienega and Wilshire, and to postpone approval of the second and third phases until after Metro holds a public hearing with Beverly Hills, which was requested April 22 by the City Council.

The Metro board voted 11-1-1, with Supervisor Michael Antonovich voting no and Supervisor Mark Ridley-Thomas abstaining.

As of Wednesday afternoon, Metro had not yet contacted the City about setting a date for the hearing, which will specifically address the proposed station location in Century City and the alignment tunneling under Beverly High.

"I'm quite pleased that [Metro] agreed to the hearing and that they did not take action on the siting of a subway stop in Century City," Mayor Willie Brien said. "My hope [for] the hearing [is by] getting information on the opinions of the experts from both sides, we'll be able to reconcile some of the differences in the science that exist at this point. I think that's important in ultimately making the next phase of the decision for Metro."

Metro Board member Richard Katz, a former San Fernando Valley Assemblymember, said Metro's attorneys told the board it could have voted on the second and third phase, but "in an abundance of caution" the board decided to hold off on voting until after the hearing with Beverly Hills.

"After all the hearings that have taken place, and all of the meetings that have taken place, one more hearing was just one more hearing," Katz said. "We'll have that hearing, we'll listen, and then at the next board meeting, the board will decide whether or not it wants to move forward on the second and third phases."

In terms of moving forward with Phase I, Katz said it was "good to see construction and activity" on a number of Metro projects, including the recent launch of the Expo line and breaking ground on Phase 2 of that project.

The City has requested the hearing to address concerns about the proposed station and subway alignment in Century City. The City Council voted to request the hearing after City Attorney Larry Wiener discovered a section of the Public Utilities Code that states "any city within the territorial jurisdiction of the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority may request a hearing before the Board of Authority concerning any proposal by the Authority to fix the location of facilities."

Following the hearing with Beverly Hills, the Metro board will prepare a written report with its decision and findings, and the board will consider the final two phases of the Westside Subway Extension at a subsequent board meeting, Metro spokesperson Dave Sotero said.

Phase I would also include the construction of stations at Wilshire and La Brea and Wilshire and Fairfax, with the entrance at Wilshire and Orange Grove Avenue instead of the northwest corner of Wilshire and Fairfax, next to Johnie's Coffee Shop. The entrance would be directly across the street from Los Angeles County Museum of Art on the south side of Wilshire.

According to information from Metro, the recommendation for the Fairfax station entrance was changed because "increased attendance at the museum plus the commitment of LACMA to raise money for a second portal on the north side of Wilshire made that entrance more desirable."

As proposed, the second phase of the subway extension would involve building a station at Wilshire and Rodeo and at Avenue of the Stars and Constellation in Century City, which would involve tunneling under Beverly High.

Phase III would add two stations in Westwood near UCLA and the VA Hospital.

changed her mind, Bosse said, is the potential opportunity to tie in the marathon with the City's centennial celebration, which will begin in 2013 and continue throughout 2014. Bosse said she also supported the charity and volunteerism components of the event.

Bosse expressed concern about Beverly Hills' position in the middle of the course, which starts at Dodgers Stadium and finishes at Santa Monica Pier. Out of over 23,000 participants in this year's race, only 67 booked rooms in Beverly Hills.

Bosse said she would like to see the Marathon work with the City's homeowners groups and CVB and Chamber of Commerce to see how the event can best serve Beverly Hills residents and businesses.

McCourt Group Senior Vice President Howard Sunkin expressed willingness Tuesday afternoon to address many of the City Council's concerns. McCourt Group, which operates the LA Marathon, reimburses the City for all staffing and services provided for the event.

"We take our relationship with Beverly Hills quite seriously," Sunkin said. "It is a critical and essential partnership to the success of this race. Last November I stood before you and some of you were critical and at that point and rightfully so about the operation that occurred in the second year of the race. I committed to you on behalf of my team that we were going to correct many of those operational deficiencies. I think we have."

Happy anniversary, Il Fornaio!

Il Fornaio Beverly Hills celebrated its 30th anniversary on April 18 with a special anniversary menu and live entertainment from Douglas Roegiers, known as The Crooner.

Sunkin and Community Services Administrator Gisele Grable reported substantial improvements in the March 2012 marathon over the previous two marathons. Conditions were particularly challenging in 2011 due to heavy rain. Beverly Hills emergency personnel responded to dozens of cases of hypothermia during the race.

This year, Grable said by 12:30 p.m. on March 18 key north-south routes in the City had re-opened, and by 1:30 p.m. all streets were open to vehicles. According to Sunkin, that was two hours earlier than in 2011. He said the goal is to cut 30 to 45 minutes off that time next year.

Sunkin also highlighted that three charitable organizations based in Beverly Hills, including the Concern Foundation and Lupus LA,

raised \$185,000 from this year's marathon. Sunkin said it is the LA Marathon's goal to become a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization in the next two years to place a greater emphasis on the charitable nature of the event. Sunkin said there was potential for BHEF and The Maple Counseling Center to become marathon official charities, meaning they would be able to raise money by signing up runners for the race.

By partnering with Japanese running shoe company Asics in addition to Honda, Sunkin said the LA Marathon's goal is to attract 7,000 marathon participants from Japan. Sunkin said he was also interested in working with the CVB and the City to attract more marathon participants to eat, shop and stay in Beverly Hills.

Hills.

Councilmember Julian Gold spoke about the benefits of the marathon in terms of creating a sense of community.

"I'm particularly compelled by the charitable piece of this, [which is] something I was not aware of to the extent that [Sunkin] disclosed it today," Gold said. "I think the notion of creating this as a charity event, 501(c)(3), one in which more and more charities and specific to us, more and more Beverly Hills charities can and will participate is a very good thing and a strong point. I think the community feeling for this is really strong. I don't mean to minimize the impacts on the residents. I think we have to work to mitigate them but in the aggregate I think that this is an event that I can support."

All five councilmembers supported going forward at least one more year with a review after the 2013 race. Vice Mayor John Mirisch and Councilmember Barry Brucker supported a three-year commitment with an annual review.

City Council rejects staff-drafted UTA agreement

Despite expressing unanimous support for United Talent Agency's decision to remain in Beverly Hills, the City Council postponed finalizing a 15-year agreement with the talent agency, which plans to lease approximately 120,000 square feet of office space from Tishman Speyer at the former Hilton Headquarters on Civic Center Drive behind City Hall.

The agreement was intended to provide incentives for UTA to remain in Beverly Hills.

Former Mayor Mark Egerman, who represents UTA, said West Hollywood and Los Angeles aggressively pursued UTA after learning the 350-employee company planned to relocate to a larger space.

In a 3-2 vote, the City Council approved most of the terms, but pulled two of them for further discussion by a liaison committee. Vice Mayor John Mirisch and Councilmember Lili Bosse voted no because they disagreed with the process in which staff met with UTA to draft the agreement before presenting it to the City Council.

Assistant City Manager Mahdi Aluzri, who made the presentation Tuesday night, said the City first met with UTA about seven months ago after then-Mayor Barry Brucker and then-Vice Mayor Willie Brien made initial contact with UTA about remaining in the City. Aluzri and City Manager Jeff Kolin met with Egerman during the process of drafting the agreement.

Mirisch said he would have supported discussing the agreement in a study session.

"I don't believe staff should be making backdoor deals with ex-mayor lobbyists," Mirisch said Wednesday. "I think a lot of embarrassment could have been avoided if process had been followed and the council had been a part of the decision-making process from the very beginning rather than the very end. It's telling when the ex-mayor lobbyist says he has a deal with 'the city' that only involves staff, but didn't involve any of the actual policy makers."

Mirisch said UTA, the city council, the city and the residents "all deserve better."

"My No. 1 issue was that this entire conversation was made with staff and Mark Egerman, and I feel that it caused a lot of

Roxbury Park liaison meeting this Monday; Commission holds off on recommendation



The next Roxbury Park liaison committee meeting will take place this Monday from 2 to 4 p.m. at City Hall on the second floor in Room 280B.

An update on the evaluation of what it would cost to rehabilitate the existing community center and the opportunity for a single-story building will be among items discussed.

The Recreation and Parks Commission discussed the community center at its most recent meeting on April 24. The Commission held off making a recommendation on what to do with the community center until it has received additional information, including the estimate of what it would cost to rehabilitate and bring the existing community center up to code.

That report is being prepared by contractor CW Driver, Commission Chair Susan Gersh said.

"What we discussed is a balance must be reached, a one-story versus two-story [building], surface versus underground [parking] and to maintain greenspace," Gersh said. "Originally we had only spoken about the community center but at Tuesday's meeting we did discuss Phase 2. Therefore, we looked at the entire project. Whether [Phases] 1 and 2 are ultimately combined is up to the city council."

Roxbury Park currently has some drainage and irrigation issues on its athletic fields, but the project as previously proposed did not address those issues. The park grounds were to be addressed in Phase 2 of park improvements, but some residents were critical of the City for not even providing an estimate of what the second phase would cost.

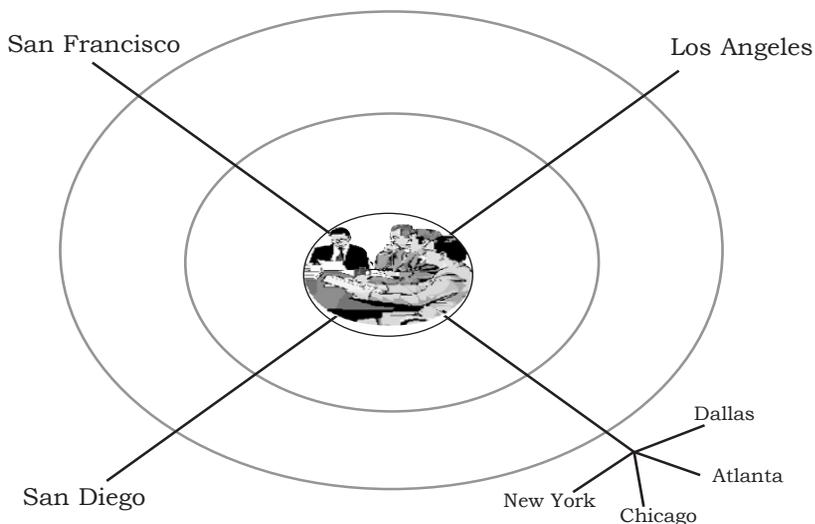
"My understanding is staff and the city council will eventually want us to make a recommendation," Gersh said. "Of course it's ultimately up to the city council. We were asked to make a proposal on Tuesday and we declined. We did not feel that [we could make a proposal] without the CW Driver report and for three of us, we felt we needed more information because we're not on the liaison committee. We're trying to be extraordinarily thoughtful on this."

Commissioners Alan Block and Simone Friedman represent the commission on the liaison committee.

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misunderstanding and problems that would never have had to occur had we had this conversation in open dialogue at a study session," Bosse said Wednesday.

All five councilmembers agreed they were not prepared to vote on two provisions, one which would allow UTA to install vanity street signs on Civic Center Drive designating the street as UTA Drive, and another that would require the City to maintain a right-turn arrow on a traffic signal for traffic heading east on Santa Monica Boulevard and turning right onto Beverly Boulevard.

At the end of the meeting, UTA CEO and co-founder Jeremy Zimmer said he felt very disappointed.

"I don't understand how business gets done," Zimmer said. "I don't understand how after all the wooing and all the loving I'm supposed to walk out of here with nothing. It's a very strange way to operate, and everybody started [by saying] how excited they are to have us in the city and then immediately took away what is the one critical thing to a company like ours [the sign]. It's all about branding. It's about having our positioning. By putting that [sign]

there, it says you guys are permanent. You're an institution. That's what we are. We'd like the city to recognize that."

Egerman also stressed the importance of the street sign.

"What the city did in negotiations was to say, while we will not change the legal name, while the name will remain Civic Center Drive, we will give you a placard sign below as we have done in the past," Egerman said. "It was only after we were given that assurance that my clients went ahead and executed a 15-year lease. I think this was a particularly sensitive issue since frankly we were granted a very little concession."

Bosse pointed out the City never made a deal, since the City Council was not involved in drafting the agreement.

Regarding the traffic signal, Brucker said he thinks the traffic light patterns and traffic flow should be left under the City's control.

Mirisch and Bosse also said they were not prepared to vote on a provision that would require relocating the Farmers Market west to allow UTA access to its driveway on Civic Center Drive, and a provision related to the

City's ability to rezone the former railroad right-of-way adjacent to the UTA building. As a result of moving, the Farmers Market would wrap around Civic Center Drive and likely block the Civic Center Drive entrance to the library parking structure.

"This wasn't a statement regarding UTA," Bosse said. "It was more of a policy issue that I would have had with any business. I think if we had had a study session to talk about policy issues, perhaps we could have all come to a consensus."

Regarding the street sign, Bosse said, "I think before we go ahead and do that, I think we should have sat down and talked about under what circumstances do we want to make that kind of policy decision? I felt it was not fair to [approve the sign] without having had that conversation."

Brien said he didn't think the process was that bad, but he acknowledged it could have been better.

"We can debate process. We can debate words on a [PowerPoint presentation] slide about current policy," Brien said. "Not everything in here was based on current policy.

There were some things in here [Aluzri] acknowledged that talk about minimizing risks of setting certain policy. This is a philosophical disagreement on where it goes and how it should go."

Brien said the agreement could not have been negotiated in closed session because the City does not own the property.

Despite their concerns, the council was unanimous in expressing support for a long-term relationship between UTA and the City.

"UTA needs to know that we are a city that will be a wonderful place for them to work and I am convinced they will feel that way and again want to extend their lease even beyond [15 years], [but] because of the way this was handled I think that message got lost," Bosse said.

And notes on events

Political campaigns, subway routes, restaurant notes, events and the best drain cleaners—is there any connection? Probably not, but in a too busy week, that's the best lead I could contrive.

Eating out: Still working on an updated compendium of favorite and not so lovable restaurants in our village, but beginning with some good and bad news:

Although not officially confirmed, it appears reasonably obvious that one of our most famous restaurants, Spago, has renewed its lease on North Canon Drive. That's the welcome news.

The reason we can assume **Wolf Puck** will keep his flagship diner operating in BH is that, and here's the down side, the often delayed remodeling will begin on July 8, closing Spago for at least 60 days.

Hotel and Italian restaurants aside, and considering our dining habits and appeal to tourists and other visitors, surprisingly we really only have three that are likely to be named as world class: Spago, The Grill on the Alley and Bouchon. Fortunately for our diversity of food interests, these three are quite different and unique.

We have always supported fine Italian eateries from the original La Scala to La Famiglia. But now the Drago family has raised this to a new level: We probably have passed Rome in the per capita number of Italian diners.

However, the most recent explosion of new eating choices has mainly been driven by Asian dining, from a new Korean on South Beverly to Indian to, not my favorite, sushi places.

The area around the South Beverly Drive post office has not had a durable record of successful eateries, even the popular pizza delivery, Jacopo's, could not make it there, but now a Japanese and Indian restaurant will have side-by-side offerings.

A new and unique Austrian diner has

opened on Little Santa Monica to very positive reviews from the *Los Angeles Times* co-critic **S. Irene Virbila**.

Bier Beisel is, to coin a phrase, small, but not the food portions. We had a very generous schnitzel with some fine Austrian beer at reasonable prices.

Not quite as overwhelmed as Virbila, but clearly worth trying again.

As for Bibigo, the new Korean diner on South Beverly, the mostly eastern European wait staff (we spotted no Korean server) were charming, helpful and efficient, maybe just one step too much of all three.

When we asked for some pepper for a kind of big bowl dish with a variety of meats, vegetables, rice and, yes, a fried egg, our helper smiled and said: "You won't need pepper." I honestly thought I had reached an age when I could make those choices for myself.

My award for the best Venezuelan restaurant in Beverly Hills goes to Coupa Cafe on North Canon Drive. Of course, it is also the only one of its kind, but the genuinely courteous, friendly service, unique food choices and a most genial owner, have made this a new community favorite.

Strangely, the *Los Angeles Times* reviews recently have not included ratings. Despite the favorable bit on the Austrian diner, no stars in the article. This may be because our surviving daily, which has laid off reporters and reduced political columnists, now has two well-read critics: Virbila and **Jonathan Gold**, who created a strong following with reviews in the *LA Weekly*.

Clearly, Gold is both knowledgeable and creative, but Virbila's reviews are, whether you agree or not, really brilliant reporting and good literature. This is one time when more may not be better.

I would never claim any special exper-

tise in dining, my tastes are personal, pedestrian and locally loyal. My only claim to credibility is that I found the only French wife who does not cook.

Factor's, outside my usual area of reporting, has a program that does support one of my favorite service groups. Every Wednesday, the restaurant donates 25 percent of receipts to Jewish Vocational Services.

And worth noting, JVS will hold its annual and highly popular Strictly Business Luncheon at the Beverly Hilton on Thursday, May 17. This year the honorees are **Barry Simmons** of Bank of America and **Ken Wiseman** and **Jay Catlin** of AMS Fulfillment. Always the best luncheon for networking and general mixing, plus a very worthwhile community service. For info and some possible reservations, call 323.761.8888.

One more worthwhile and, yes, fun event is the annual car drawing and movie premiere fundraiser by The Maple Counseling Center. This year's film will be "Mighty Fine" and the auto there to be won, a 2012 Fiat.

All in the family note: TMCC was actually a continuation of a substance abuse clinic founded by the **Sooky** and **Sam Goldman** family. Now, retired school board president and Sam and Sooky's daughter-in-law, **Myra Lurie** (**David Goldman's** wife) has been elected to the Center's Board of Directors.

With all those Beverly Hills city and school tax dollars being spread among consultants, lawyers and scientific experts in the effort to prevent a subway from tunneling under our high school, guess who came up with the one obscure means of preventing a rush to judgment? Our own City Attorney **Larry Wiener**.

Larry found the legal means of requiring a full Metro Board hearing in state law granting municipalities certain procedural rights. Obviously, not a complete solution or win, but it does give the schools and city—now, thankfully, working more closely together instead of arguing over who has the biggest stick in the fight—time to gather together some more solid reasons for not selecting the Constellation route.

Metro may now have a new dilemma. Up to now, the agency has had very strong support from trade unions, especially those in the construction industry. It was probably union members who helped distribute the *Los Angeles Times* editorial supporting Constellation at city markets last week.

Now the super mass transit agency has angered local unions by an apparent decision to outsource the construction of 235 subway cars to a Japanese company, Kinkisharyo.

Just maybe organized labor will place some of those "No Subway Under the High School" lawn signs in front of union headquarters.

It does seem odd that an agency arguing that the subway will benefit our regional economy should send this major contract outside Southern California. Were the costs so much lower and the expertise so limited as to warrant a departure from "spend locally?"

BULLETIN: The city has hired a top-gun land use law attorney, **Robert McMurry**, to represent us when Metro holds its next hearing on the route choice. McMurry is a highly regarded lawyer in environmental law. He will be working with City Attorney Wiener.

Next week: Date for hearings and former battles that reached high levels of emotion.

Bvlgari's is certainly a valued upscale retailer on Rodeo and we should be very pleased that although they are moving from the corner of Wilshire and Rodeo just down the street, they are remaining in Beverly Hills, with somewhat reduced space.

But how did they ever win permission for the loudest, most shrieking sign in our city's history, promoting their new venue? You have to see it to hate it.

Fortunately, we will be taping interviews with the Architectural Commission today, a program that you can watch later this month, and we will ask the question on how signs win permission.

A side issue has to do with preservation. When Bvlgari won approval of the design for its first store on Rodeo it was replacing a very historic landmark: The Brown Derby.

To retain the memory, Bvlgari was required to put an original replica of a brown derby on top of its new structure, and it has remained there ever since. Hopefully, when the new occupants go to city hall for a building permit, they will be reminded of this earlier condition and the derby retained. (When I spoke to Bvlgari's people, they had no idea why their building had a top-of-structure hat!)

Almost forgot: Best drain cleaner? Hardly a scientific study, but I clogged a sink at our place, and efforts to use a plunger and then a large bottle of Drano Max Gel, all failed. Enter "Liquid Plumber Power Gel" and almost instant success.

Final word: Really good to see the legendary **Kirk Douglas** at the Rosenstein family's event for assembly candidate **Torie Osborn**. Should not be forgotten, but it was producer Douglas who broke the black list when he hired **Dalton Trumbot** to write the script for "Spartacus." Less courageous film types followed.

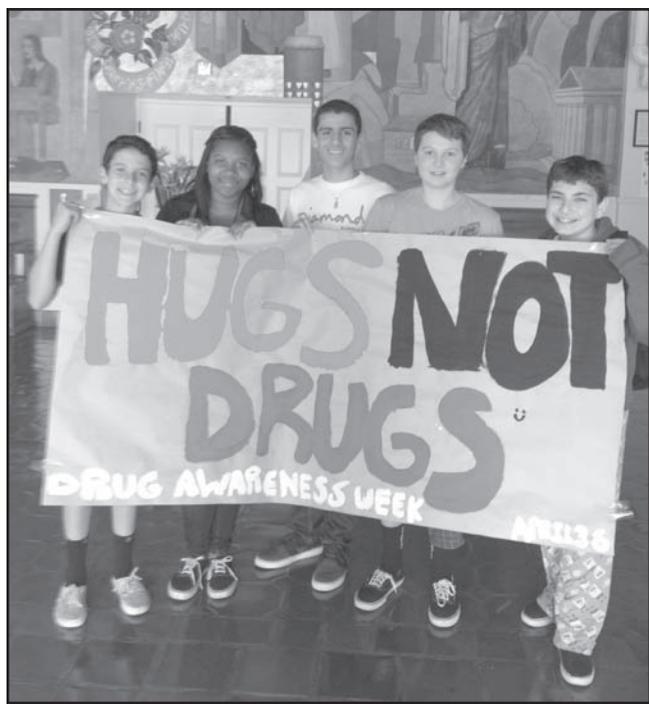

High has prompted mixed reactions from the community.

"Methane gas, toxic chemicals and teenagers don't mix, but this dangerous combination is on the verge of exploding at Beverly High, turning the school into a mega disaster," a narrator states at the beginning of the video. "Hard to imagine. Not if Metro has its way and runs a subway under the school."

The video features appearances by Vice

Mayor John Mirisch, Superintendent Gary Woods, Transit and School Engineer Tim Buresh, and Louis Pandolfi, who is identified as a methane mitigation expert that discusses the potential dangers of methane gas and oil wells under the high school campus.

PTA Council Co-President Susie Roberts said the project was done as part of the PTA's advocacy mission, which looks out for the safety and welfare of students and staff. Roberts said all five PTAs contributed to fund the video.

"I think it conveys a message to really take a good look at the situation," Roberts said. "It can be viewed in lots of different ways. We have heard some negative comments that 'it's scary, it's overkill.' The whole point of the video was to get people to really take a look at these studies and look at the potential for any issues."

Roberts said the PTA is not anti-subway, but she wants a safe subway. She said the goal was to encourage Metro to fully investigate any potential dangers that could come from tunneling under the high school.

"Sometimes you have to grab somebody's attention in a way that really makes them stop," Roberts said. "This video does that."

Councilmember Barry Brucker said he thought the video did not advance the city's position with respect to the subway.

"I think that if the PTA leadership had seen the video prior to them authorizing the funding of it, they may have thought twice about doing it," Brucker said. "I understand they're trying to appeal to the community and bring awareness of the methane gas issues, but I personally think the video does not advance our city's position in the best light."

Brucker said the City's goal and objective is to "see whether the testing by Metro was done sufficiently to rule out Santa Monica Boulevard and look at some of the environmental issues and future construction barriers that may be placed upon the high school should the building codes become more restrictive and prohibit schools or hospitals located in a fault zone being built over a tunnel. That I think is a very real concern for the school district and community at large."

Planning Commission confirms CIP projects conform with general plan

In advance of the City Council's consideration of the budget for the 2012/2013 fiscal year, the Planning Commission voted 5-0 April 26 to approve the City's capital improvement program for consistency with the City's general plan.

The CIP outlines funding for the City's major infrastructure and facility development over the next five years.

The Planning Commission's task, Chair Craig Corman said, was to simply determine whether or not the projects in the CIP comply with the general plan. The Commission does not make recommendations on projects.

"We don't have a say one way or another if we think [a project is a] good idea [or a] bad idea," Corman said.

Corman said many projects in this year's CIP

THE WEEKLY TURNS THE CAMERA ON ITSELF

Director Eric Adrian Marshall discusses tomorrow's premiere of his documentary profiling Beverly Hills Weekly

For six weeks, a film crew from USC followed the Weekly staff around to city council meetings, the farmers market and the office on deadline. In a conversation with reporter Melanie Anderson, director Eric Marshall reflects on the experience.

So, what is *The Weekly* about?

The Weekly is a documentary about you and your job as the reporter for *Beverly Hills Weekly*. It follows you over the course of about four to six weeks and [portrays] the difficulty of being a reporter in a time when there's less money for local newspapers for their operations, and at a time also when it's so important for accountability journalism to be at a high level and still be active.

What inspired this project?

The characters. Hearing all the stories you brought home about [Publisher] Josh [Gross] and the ad [staff] and about the unique atmosphere and relationships in the office. It was great sitting down with [columnist] Rudy Cole, who to me really personifies the unique character of this city and is just a wealth of information about the history of media and the political relationships in Beverly Hills. That combined with how media is changing really inspired me. I heard a radio story on *On the Media* about how newspapers are going out of business and reporters are being laid off. We could lose a reporter covering the White House or Wall Street. If one or two reporters got laid off from those beats we'd still be okay as a nation. If you're a resident of a small city or town like Beverly Hills where there are two reporters covering the city council, and if one gets laid off, that's a huge loss in diversity of opinion that comes out of the media. It's a huge loss in perspective. It's damaging to our democracy. What I really wanted to do was honor small town newspapers and small town reporters for the vital role that they play in keeping institutions accountable and standing up for citizens.

What do you see as some of the challenges our paper is facing?

There's the finances, there's the lack of staff, and of course those two are related. You know the difficulty that comes with having to write and edit an entire newspaper by yourself. Josh says this in the film, "If you're at the *L.A. Times*, you're going to write two stories a day. You need to get used to that pressure." From my perspective, I see a small town reporter as someone who doesn't just have to write the paper, but really has to be the second publisher. You're going out there finding stories, you're representing the paper to the community because you're the person the community really interacts with. You have a tremendous amount of responsibility. I think it's a greater challenge than working at a large metro daily. There are two levels of challenges: the personal challenges the reporter faces every day, and the financial challenges that the business faces. Seeing that level of sacrifice that reporters like you across the country in small towns and communities have to [make], we found that to be really inspiring.

Beverly Hills Weekly wasn't your only subject. Tell us who else appears in the film.

[Recent] Mayor Barry Brucker has a presence. We had a great conversation with him in his office. We ran into him a few times out in the community. That's something you only get in a small town and that's something we really wanted to portray. As a reporter in a small town you might run into a city councilmember or a member of the school board when you're just out at the park walking your dog or at the farmers market buying your groceries. I think that's something bloggers and people who are just working off the Internet don't really get.

Everyone that we've met has been really warm and helped us out so much with the film. Gloria [Boraz] and Stanley [Goldblatt] were the couple you inter-

viewed for your Valentine's article [in Issue #645]. We spent a great day with them. We also had the privilege of visiting Beverly High and the staff of the *Highlights* newspaper. Seeing such a passionate and talented group of young people who want to be journalists was really inspiring. It helped us understand where Josh comes from. We talked to so many people in the city that we could not include because of [USC's] time constraints [limiting our film to 24 minutes]. [Courier Publisher] Clif [Smith] was helpful and gave us great background as far as the city goes and the media landscape. Marla [Schevker] and Marcia [Hobbs] who work at the *Courier* were also a huge help. They could not make it into the film but they did really assist us. We talked to a lot of residents on the street about their preferences for local media. What we found is the strongest film really is not this broad survey of Beverly Hills media. We found that the strongest story we could tell was really just about one paper. For the most part it's you, it's Josh, it's [Advertising Manager] Tiffany [Majdipour] and it's those relationships that form when you're in a small office working against pretty heavy odds.

You mentioned being out and about filming in Beverly Hills. What was that experience like?

It was great. The City was so welcoming to our crew. The producers and I sat down with the City about a month before we started shooting and laid out what we were going to do. Here at USC, the City of Beverly Hills is known to be a challenging place for students to film and we did not find that to be the case at all. We found them to be extremely welcoming. Therese [Kosterman] in the communications office, Benita [Miller] and Scott [Lipke] in the film office [helped] us get

what we needed. We filmed a lot on public property, we filmed at the city council meetings, we filmed in parks. I would go back to Beverly Hills and film anything from a narrative feature to another documentary.

Before this project, what was your perception of Beverly Hills?

I think my perception was like a lot of people who live in Los Angeles. We know it's a wealthy community. You see movies that are made about Beverly Hills that completely misrepresent the city. In Hollywood, you have *Beverly Hills Cop*, *Beverly Hills Chihuahua*, Beverly Hills whatever. It's always the same. What we wanted to do with our documentary is show that Beverly Hills is not this reduction. It's not just people driving around in Bentleys. There's a big second-generation American population. There's a huge first-generation immigrant population. There's a lot of economic and social diversity in the city. We wanted to show it's a complex city, it's a different city, and it needs media and it needs good reporting, just like a small city like Bell—it's obviously a different demographic—but it still needs that sense of accountability.

Was there anything unexpected or surprising that you learned about the community while making this film?

I was surprised how involved the community was in government and local politics. I was really surprised at some of the city council meetings how many people attended. [The Roxbury Park meeting in January] was one we filmed at. There is also the Metro issue. I think it's really interesting and I think it speaks to the job that the newspapers and the digital media does at informing the citizens and how there is this diversity of voices and there is this dialogue still in Beverly Hills. One

thing that I wish we could have included more in the film was that sense that all the papers play off each other and how there's a media conversation that goes on every week in Beverly Hills.

This was your first effort directing a documentary. Tell us about some of the challenges you faced.

I've never done something on this level where we were shooting 15 hours with a full crew over the course of a couple months. It was challenging because we were forced to plan in a way that I had never had to do for docs. For the still photography I've done in Berkeley, when there was a protest going on outside City Hall, I could pick up my camera and shoot it in the course of an afternoon. This was such a challenge having to plan a week or two in advance for something that we didn't know if it would happen or not. We just had to take a chance. As a filmmaker being able to accept that as the process, being able to accept the universe is going to give you what it's going to give you and making something great out of that has probably been the biggest change for me personally. It was truly a team effort and what's great about documentary is that oftentimes the director of photography or the editors have a significant amount of control over the story, certainly much more than in fiction. We had a challenging story to tell and I think every person on the team really pulled together to create something that we're really excited to share with people in Beverly Hills and across the country.

How'd you end up in film school?

I grew up in San Diego and I was very involved with the arts and especially music as a teenager. I did my undergraduate work at UC Berkeley, where I met you in a music class. During my years as an

undergraduate I started to gravitate toward filmmaking, all the while I also was studying economics. While I was in college I was involved in politics. I had an internship with Congresswoman Barbara Lee (D-Oakland). After I graduated I worked for a state assembly campaign in the Bay Area. After the 2008 elections, I felt like it was now or never for me to pursue a career doing what I was really passionate about, which was making films. So I took some more classes and when I felt my portfolio was strong enough, I applied to only a few film schools. I decided to attend USC because of the tradition of excellence that the school is known for and the opportunities it provides its students.

Every film has outtakes. What were some unexpected or funny things that happened that didn't make the cut?

Being with Josh on a day-to-day basis is just kind of a reality T.V. show, to be perfectly honest. The office is an outrageous environment. When you were telling me these stories you didn't misrepresent them. We ended up making a more personal film, but the comedy is definitely there. You're in a situation where you have a guy who's trying to make the best out of a business model that really doesn't have much of a future, from my perspective. And he said it himself, is [the paper] going to be around in 10 years? We don't know. But his attitude toward that eventuality is what really attracts a lot of people to him. He loves the fact that it's a tough business. He hires [college students] to run his advertising department and develops really great [friendships] with them. That interplay he has with his advertising staff is fantastic. I remember there was a moment when we were packing up—we didn't end up getting this on film—he walked in and made a comment on his furniture. I think that day we had been

talking to you about your compensation for the amount of work you do. He said to me, "You know Eric, it's your choice. We can either pay Melanie more or get new furniture. You tell me what you would prefer?" Just stuff like that, where he really does take pride in how he's been able to manage his business. I think the fact that the circumstances are not great is something you have to have a humorous attitude about. I think he really does have that. I think that's why we found him [to be] such a great character.

A lot of people have not seen the inside of the *Weekly*. They see the paper every week but they don't get a sense of where you guys work. We found that to be very entertaining. I think the audience will as well. It's definitely something to look forward to in the film to get a behind-the-scenes feel of how a paper gets made. And it's not all serious.

Now that you've gone through this process, would you recommend other directors make their significant others the subject of a documentary?

I would. I certainly learned more about you and have much more compassion for you. In a documentary you really connect with your subjects. Being able to meet the people you work with every day and being able to see that side of you [gave] me a greater understanding of what you go through.

Without giving away too much, what do you hope viewers will come away with after seeing this film?

More than anything, I really want people to understand that when they read an article in the paper, be it your Valentine's piece or an article about a city council proposal or a new building project, when they read the byline I really want people to know what goes into that kind of report-

ing. There is a difference between the kind of reporting reporters like you do where there's research involved, there's back story involved, you call sources, you call multiple sources, you get stuff confirmed. That's the kind of thing I think journalism is moving away from, that kind of in-depth, labor intensive reporting, just because it's expensive. I want audiences to know what goes into that, so maybe when they're reading their morning paper they can take a little more time reading that byline and understanding that there's a person behind that article who is looking out for you.

What are your goals for the film?

I think the film has potential to reach audiences in small towns across the country, so we're going to submit to a lot of film festivals. We want to show it to professional journalists, journalism schools and academic institutions across the country and broaden the awareness of the importance of community media specifically. After festivals, we'll see if there's an interest for broadcast. There's online streaming, like Netflix or Hulu. There's also local public television [like] KCET. We'd also like to screen it inside Beverly Hills, but we don't know what format yet that would take, whether it would be something through the City or Beverly High, or renting out a theater within the city limits. The residents, the elected officials and members of the press in Beverly Hills made this film possible. We want to make sure that everyone in the city who wants to see the film has an opportunity to do so.
