

City Council approves funding for rent stabilization ordinance

The City Council unanimously approved the appropriation of \$250,000 from the General Fund toward the initiation of the of the contentious rent stabilization "interim" ordinance at its meeting last Thursday.

The Council received a report from Community Development Director Susan Healy Keene on some of the expenditures that are needed to implement the new ordinance, such as database development, rental registry software and facilitated dialogue meetings.

Earlier this month the Council approved the ordinance, which established a three percent annual rent increase cap and relocation fees paid to tenants evicted "without

cause."

The ordinance also dictates that the City will create a database for all the multi-family units in the City with descriptions of their current conditions. There are 979 property owners of 8,662 multi-family units throughout the City, according to the staff report.

The information will be used to establish a rental registry program similar to the one used by the City of Los Angeles. Specifically, landlords oppose the staff report also noted Los Angeles recently added an online registry through services provided by consultant 3Di, Inc.

Other surrounding cities which use rental registries include Santa Monica and West Hollywood.

A majority of renters were in favor of the ordinance because it lowered the annual rent increase cap and established relocation fees payable to tenants evicted "without just cause."

Many landlords felt they were underrepresented throughout the creation of the urgency ordinance. The relocation fees and the rent increase cap leave them with limited options for evicting "problem tenants."

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A majority of the Councilmembers continue to insist the ordinance remains "interim" as they are gathering more input from renters and property owners.

The Council directed staff to hold facilitated discussion session s between tenants and landlords. At the April 4 meeting, Councilmember Robert Wunderlich suggested recruiting a real estate professional to mediate the ongoing dialogue between the two parties.

Last week, Councilmember John Mirisch clarified that this individual, who will be appointed by the review of an Ad Hoc committee, will not be in responsible drafting policy or analyzing data.

"The facilitator's job is not to evaluate data," Mirisch said. "It's to create dialogue which is going to be between landlords and tenants. We [are] the ones discussing and creating policy that may need more data, but that's on us."

According to the staff report, the new rent stabilization policies go into effect on May 5.

Metro to move facilities for Section Two construction: **Council dissatisfied with** MOA

The Council expressed several concerns

regarding the proposed Memorandum of Agreement between the City and Metro for SoCal Edison's relocation of facilities in the Wilshire/ Rodeo Station area associated with Section Two of the Purple Line Extension project.

Mayor Lili Bosse called the proposal, which came before the Council at last Thursday's meeting, "half-baked."

"This is, as far as I'm concerned, what not to do when we're dealing with Section Two," Bosse said. "Everybody recognizes that [construction] is going to be a disruption, but I also think we can work together with the businesses and [Metro] to try and mitigate as much as possible, and that was not done. [We all have a goal] to support the MOA, but this is clearly half-baked."

Metro and SCE are requesting a per-

area on Reeves Drive, Wilshire Boulevard and the alley between Canon Drive and Beverly Drive and associated traffic control.

Several representatives from nearby restaurants, such as Spago and Citizen, attended the meeting to point out the issues they will encounter as a result of the construction.

Steven Wolff, general counsel for Spago, noted that the neighboring businesses were provided notice of the proposed left turn lane closures only two days before the Council meeting.

'Spago had no [objections] to the MOA that was presented," Wolff said. "But Tuesday of this week, we were advised there's going to be left-turn closures. This is exactly the type of last second change that we cannot tolerate. You can't have numerous outreach meetings and then 48 hours before a meeting like this you say, 'By the way, we're going to go close access for anybody coming from the west side of Los Angeles."

After hearing from the public, the Council agreed there was not enough notice and suggested that further solutions need to be recommended to remedy the issue of left turn lane closures.

SCE's underground facilities are the first utility to be relocated for construction of the future station and will be followed by the SoCal Gas and AT&T relocation work, according to the April 20 staff report.

Metro spokesperson Dave Sotero told the *Weekly* that "the impact [on businesses] should be minimal."

"Access to businesses will remain open [as this] is standard utility relocation where SoCal Edison will be moving an [underground] line," Sotero said. "Work will take place from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. [The lane closure] is required for the safety of workers. There were zero complaints about a similar lane closure in the area for pothole repairs in 2015. Construction should only last eight to 20 days."

The Council unanimously agreed to continue discussion to its next regularly scheduled meeting on May 2.

Board to hire Jackson as Assistant Superintendent

Amidst the contentious 23 certificated faculty layoffs, the Board of Education intends to bring on Beverly High Principal Dave Jackson as an Assistant Superintendent.

At its meeting on Tuesday, the Board voted unanimously in favor of hiring Jackson as the newly created "Assistant Superintendent, Construction Facilities." Vice President Lisa Korbatov did not attend the meeting.

The position will encompass the role of Chief Facilities Officer previously held by Eitan Aharoni, who was commuting from Bakersfield and left the BHUSD abruptly.

Jackson's annual base salary is \$200,000, according to the employment agreement, which is a \$20,000 increase from the former Chief Facilities Officer.

The Board recently issued 23 pink slips to faculty throughout the district as a means to assist in the budget crisis. The BHUSD is currently deficit spending by over \$4 million annually. It was recommended by Chief Administrative Officer La Tanya Kirk-Carter the district cut back \$5 million from its budget annually.

But Superintendent Michael Bregy took issue with the position being called "new."

"It is not a new position and I just want to be really clear that this has been an open position and we've been very careful as far as recommending someone to you," said Superintendent Michael Bregy.

Bregy justified the salary increase required to hire Jackson by explaining that a retirement contract does not include benefits.

"Mr. Jackson is technically retired, so some of those additional costs that we would incur for other employees for medical, [etc.] are all negated," Bregy said. "There are rules with a retirement contract that he cannot make any less than he's making otherwise there's a penalty."

Additionally, Bregy noted "this is a position [they] did not get a lot of applicants for."

This will be the second Assistant Superintendent Bregy will have hired, after former Chief Academic Officer Jennifer Tedord. During the meeting, Bregy indicated he intends to change other administrator's titles to "Assistant Superintendent."

"A lot of this is for alignment in the titles of the positions," Bregy said. "The term 'Chief' is really outdated. Part of my job is to help the leaders at the district office move on to other positions like Superindent and the position of Chief is a title that doesn't lend itself to someone who is a leader in a school district. [The Assistant Superintendent] title allows more flexibility and sharing of some of the responsibilities at the district level."

In March, Tedford received a reassignment notice with direction from the Board and Bregy to either resign or be placed in a non-administrative teaching position.

Several board members advocated for Bregy's plan.

"I applaud the out of the box approach to this position," said Board member Noah Margo. "It is a unique way to keep Mr. Jackson in the district."

Bregy previously recommended the creation of a new Director of Communications position to help communicate to the public the severity of the budget crisis and the areas in which the district over spends.

Members of the Beverly Hills Education Association, including President Telly Tse, actively spoke out against this idea in light of the 23 teacher layoffs.

Gage says Rosen's complaint against BHPD is "going to hold up fine"

Beverly Hills Police Captain Mark Rosen alleges he was subjected to discrimination, harassment and retaliation by the Beverly Hills Police Department for being Jewish and over 40 years old.

His attorney, Bradley Gage, told the Weekly he knows the claims "are truthful and accurate."

"I think [Rosen's case is] going to hold up fine," Gage said. "I know [his claims] are truthful and accurate. That's always the first step. They're very disturbing too."

The complaint filed by Rosen at the end of March alleges Chief Sandra Spagnoli, along with several other defendants, made derogatory comments toward Rosen and some his colleagues regarding their religious and ethnic backgrounds.

"Allegations of this type leveled against



high ranking officers in the police department are always a concern," Gage said. "Police are supposed enforce to the law. break not the law.

Discrimination is, of course, illegal and should not be tolerated in our society."

Different evidence can be used to prove allegations of discrimination, according to Gage.

"You can prove it [with] direct evidence, [like] statements against individuals" Gage said. "There is also circumstantial evidence, such as transferring someone to a certain job or taking away certain assignments and responsibilities."

Rosen's claim alleges Spagnoli transferred him to a project for "lower level employees" to retaliate for the initial employment discrimination complaint he filed against her last December with the Department of Fair Employment Housing.

Gage speculated that other Jewish employees were not considered for promotions, but may now receive interim promotions to offset Rosen's claims.

"In this case, there were some recent promotions made but I understand Sergeant Max Subin, who is Jewish, was passed over for promotion," Gage said. "I wouldn't be surprised if he might be put into an active [lieutenant] position as a defense to the lawsuit."

The BHPD named Marc Coopwood, a Sacramento Police Captain, the new Assistant Chief of Police earlier this month. He was sworn in on Monday.

"The City has been making tremendous

progress under this chief and this lawsuit will not interfere with that progress," said City Attorney Larry Wiener to the Weekly in Issue #915.

Rosen's attorneys are now seeking a Pitchess motion, which will allow them to obtain information from the BHPD's investigations on this case and other similar cases in nature, set to be heard on May 31.

Who's going to pay to clean up the oil well?

Venoco, the operator of the oil well located on the Beverly High campus, filed for a second bankruptcy, according to a press release from the BHUSD.

Venoco remains in possession of the property and is responsible for monitoring the conditions of the oil wells. In addition, the company is required to decommission the oil wells and restore the property.

The City adopted an ordinance in 2011 that required the oil wells to cease operation in 2016. The wells stopped production at the end of last year, pursuant to the terms

on the lease.

While the first bankruptcy in 2016 was part of a plan for reorganization, the current plan proposes dissolution of the company and its assets. The bankruptcies are unrelated to Beverly Hills operations, according to the release.

"The key issue for the district is to ensure that the condition of the wells continue to be monitored to ensure public safety and that Venoco's obligations to fully decommission the wells and to restore the condition of the property to its original condition are full performed," wrote Superintendent Michael Bregy in the statement.

The statement also indicated the district is engaged in active dialogue with Venoco, as well as different governmental and private agencies to ensure the necessary work is performed with adequate funding available.

Expanded smoking regulations to go into effect next Friday

Starting May 5, smoking will be prohibited within 20 feet of open-air dining areas except while actively passing by and in the public right-of-way, which includes public sidewalks, alleyways and streets.

"Now everyone can enjoy Beverly Hills' beautiful outdoor spaces without breathing second-hand smoke," wrote Mayor Lili Bosse in a statement.

The new ordinance strengthens the City's existing smoking regulations that, in addition to state laws, prohibit smoking in parks, outdoor events, at the Farmers' Market, in outdoor service lines such as a theater box office and public and private plazas.

The ordinance is aimed at all types of smoking, including tobacco, e-cigarettes and marijuana.

The Health and Safety Commission, at the request of the Beverly Hills City Council, is exploring the feasibility of regulating smoking in multiunit housing.



ROBERT K. TANENBAUM Mayor 1992-1993

When the rioting occurred, Robert K. Tanenbaum was a speaker at the First A.M.E. Church where Rev. [Cecil] Chip Murray was the pastor. He was asked to speak to the congregants and the members of the public in an effort to calm the community following the verdict of the Rodney King case.

Tanenbaum hadn't realized riots were taking place out on the streets until it was suggested that he be escorted out of the church. He returned home to his wife and children watching Los Angeles aflame on television.

Later, Tanenbaum went back into the South Central churches to speak to the congregations. He decided with then-Faithful Central Pastor Kenneth Ulmer Beverly Hills would host a gospel concert and the proceeds would be donated to people who were in serious need.

The following October, the Beverly High auditorium was packed with attendees for the gospel concert, which raised thousands of dollars.

The concert was filmed for a video called "Voices of Hope." The video was submitted to the cable award ceremonies and won the best documentary of the year.

UPDATE:

Twenty-five years after the riots, Tanenbaum told the Weekly he believes "the only way for race relations to improve is through education." However, he feels that Los Angeles political officials are undermining progress by neglecting charter schools.

"Through education people will be able to problem solve in a serious, informed, compassionate and ultimately tolerant fashion," Tanenbaum said. "The power structure of Los Angeles keeps funding the failing public schools and neglects the progress being made by

After the weekend of the riots, Pope returned to work at Warner Brothers and remembers business continued "without missing a beat." He was the custodial services manager in the studio facilities at Warner Brothers during the week and the minister of music for Paradise on evenings and weekends.

Following the incident, Paradise developed a covenant relationship with Temple Emanuel. The relationship lasted for the remainder of 1992 into the beginning of 1993, which included exchange worship services at both churches.

Pope brought his mass 100-voice choir to the City to perform a free joint concert at Civic Center Plaza with the Beverly High Madrigals Singers. That was his first introduction to the City with then-City Manager Mark Scott. Beverly Hills Rotary Club sponsored the concert.

Pope left Paradise at the end of the 1990s and he joined Faithful Central. The gospel concert, described by Tanenbaum, was in collaboration with Faithful Central.

UPDATE:

Progress for Los Angeles shows itself in the form of improved developments and infrastructure, according to Pope.

"I'm an Inglewood resident, so to see that the [Rams] stadium is being built, that the Forum has been refurbished and is being used as a concert venue, and that the Metro [Crenshaw/LAX line] is being built from the airport all along the old rail road throughout L.A. is really exciting to me. That's going to change the whole L.A. basin moving forward," Pope said.

He also noted the value of a powerful protest hasn't changed, but the nature in which people express themselves has.

"Of course in this climate, there's a lot of protesting going on now," Pope said. "But the protests aren't getting out of control to the point of rioting, as they did back then. That to me shows progress as well."



MICHAEL SALTER President – Beno's Son of the late Mayor Max Salter

Michael Salter's family-owned clothing business, Beno's, was based in the men's clothing district in down-

town Los Angeles. Salter had been following the King trial closely. A few days before the riots broke out he suggested to his partners that they get an armed guard for each of their properties. By the time he had arrived at his office the morning of Thursday, April 30 looting had already begun on Washington Boulevard near Maple.

Salter and his partgathered about 50 men who worked in the warehouse to assist in defending the store. They

were unarmed, but felt they had strength in numbers. Looters scattered from the building when they saw the large group approaching, but had already left the store in disarray. Salter recalls that they stole mostly Nike shoes.

The store could not be locked up because the back door could not be closed, so Salter and a few other people stayed most of the night to defend the building from being burnt to the ground. At one point, rioters shot bullets through the front door of the store.

The merchandise lost was in the tens of thousands of dollars; however, the structural integrity of the building remained intact. The building south of Salter's warehouse was burnt to the ground.

UPDATE:

Salter expressed his feelings that the nation has not received as much recognition for the strides it has made, not only since the riots, but within the last few years.

"What I had hoped would have changed when we elected a black president and reelected him that the [BLM] activists would understand that we're not basically a racist nation," Salter said. "Are there racists among us? Yes. Will there be racists in the future? Probably, unfortunately so. We still have to address the problem but we have made great progress. But with the activists you wouldn't come to that conclusion."

He also added this is often reflected by the depiction of police officers in the media.

"Not a fair portrait is portrayed of [police officers] and because of that there is a perception amongst some people that we haven't made progress. The press really doesn't help the situation."

ORDINANCE NO. 17-O-2731

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS AMENDING THE BEVERLY HILLS MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING TEMPORARY BUSINESS SIGNAGE DURING SUBWAY CONSTRUCTION

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council hereby adds Section 10-4-615 to Article 6 ("Nonresidential Zones") of Chapter 4 ("Zoning; Signs") of Title 10 ("Planning and Zoning") of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code to read as follows:

"10-4-615: TEMPORARY SIGNAGE DURING SUBWAY CONSTRUCTION:

Notwithstanding any other restriction contained in this chapter, an additional sign or signs may be placed or affixed on commercially zoned property fronting Wilshire Boulevard while the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority constructs the Westside Purple Line Extension subway project in the city, provided that construction obstructs the visibility of a substantial portion of the property or building entrance and the requesting business is otherwise permitted to display business identification signage pursuant to sections 10-4-604 or 10-4-608 of this chapter. Such signage shall be subject to approval by the director of community development or his or her desianee provided that the signage satisfies the requirements of this section and comports with design guidelines approved by the City Council. Any sign placed or affixed pursuant to this section shall immediately be removed at such time when construction no longer obstructs the visibility of the property or building entrance."

<u>Section 2.</u> <u>Termination Date.</u> This ordinance shall be automatically repealed and have no further force or effect on and after January 1, 2025, or on such date when the city engineer determines in writing that physical construction of the Westside Purple Line Extension subway project within the city is complete, whichever date is earlier.

Section 3. CEQA. This ordinance was assessed in accordance with the authority and criteria contained in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the State CEQA Guidelines, and the environmental regulations of the City. This ordinance temporarily allows some additional business signage to mitigate impacts on businesses affected by subway construction. This temporary business signage will not result in a substantial or potentially substantial adverse change in the environment. It can therefore be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the proposed ordinance may have a significant effect on the environment. Therefore the City Council finds that the ordinance is exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question would have a significant effect on the environment.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Severability.</u> If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or place, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Publication.</u> The City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation published and circulated in the city within fifteen (15) days after its passage in accordance with Section 36933 of the Government Code, shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause this Ordinance and the city Clerk's certification, together with proof of publication, to be entered in the Book of Ordinances of the Council of this city.

<u>Section 6.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Ordinance shall go into effect and be in full force and effect at 12:01 a.m. on the thirty-first (31st) day after its passage.

RESOLUTION NO. 17-R- 13135

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS DECLARING AND IMPLEMENTING STAGE C WATER CONSERVATION MEASURES

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Southern California was mired in a five-year drought with several of those years being the worst on record, including a snowpack in 2015 that was the smallest in 500 years.

WHEREAS, on September 2, 2014, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 14-R-13007 which enacted Stage "B" of the City's Emergency Water Conservation Plan in response to the State's regulations, calling for a 10% reduction, with the inclusion of the State outdoor watering regulations, and restricted outdoor watering to three times per week.

WHEREAS, on April 1, 2015, Governor Brown signed Executive Order B-29-15, directing the State Water Resources Control Board to impose restrictions to achieve a statewide 25 percent reduction in potable urban water usage through February 2016. as compared to the amount used in 2013. The Governor instructed the State Water Resources Control Board to consider the relative per capita water usage of each supplier's service area and to require those areas with high per capita use to achieve proportionally greater reductions than those with low use. As a result, the State Water Resources Control Board released a framework, outlining reduction targets from 8% to 36% for each water supplier, with Beverly Hills having of having an initial reduction target of 36% and then subsequently reduced to a 32% reduction target.

WHEREAS, the City of Beverly Hills adopted and implemented water conservation Stage D on May 5, 2015 by Resolution No. 15-R-13037 in response to the State's regulations, calling for a 30% reduction, including enforcement of State outdoor watering regulations, and limited outdoor watering to two times per week.

WHEREAS, on November 13, 2015, Governor Brown issued Executive Order B-36-15 (EO B-36-15) calling for an extension of urban water use restrictions until October 31, 2016, should drought conditions persist through January 2016.

WHEREAS On May 9, 2016, Governor Brown issued Executive Order B-37-16 directing actions aimed at using water wisely, reducing water waste, and improving water use efficiency. The Executive Order, in part, directed the State Water Resources Control Board to adjust emergency water conservation regulations through the end of January 2017, and make adjustments in recognition of the differing water supply conditions across the state.

WHEREAS, on May 18, 2016, the State Water Resources Control Board adopted Resolution No. 2016-0029 to amend and re-adopt the February 2016 Emergency Regulation primarily focusing on replacing the state-developed, demand-driven standards with locally developed conservation standards based upon each agency's specific water supply reliability conditions. The regulation required individual urban water suppliers to self-certify the level of available water supplies they have assuming three additional dry years, and the level of conservation necessary to assure adequate supply over that time. The City of Beverly Hills, along with the majority of suppliers passed this "stress test" and has not been subject to State conservation mandates.

WHEREAS, as a result of that order, the State Water Resources Control Board and other State agencies released a draft plan that shifts from statewide mandatory water restrictions toward a set of long-term water-use efficiency standards that reflect California's diverse climate, landscape, and demographic conditions. The plan also calls for permanently prohibiting wasteful practices, regular reporting by water suppliers, tightening up leaky systems, and strengthening plans for water shortages. These actions will help to ensure all communities have sufficient water supplies and are conserving water regardless of the conditions of any one year.

WHEREAS, on February 8, 2017, the State Water Resources Control Board extended its existing water conservation regulations (initially set to expire on February 28, 2017) through the Spring of 2017 in order to better ascertain the state's hydrologic water conditions for 2016-2017.

WHEREAS, on April 7, 2017, Governor Jerry Brown ended the drought state of emergency in most of California and released a long-term plan to better prepare the state for future droughts. The Governor's Executive Order (EO) B-40-17 directs the State Water Board to rescind the water supply stress test for urban water suppliers, and to maintain urban water use reporting requirements and prohibitions on wasteful practices such as watering during or after rainfall, hosing off sidewalks, and irrigating ornamental turf on public street medians until these requirements expire towards the end of this year. Despite the generous rain fall and snowpack. EO B-40-17 notes the effects of the drought persist in areas of the Central Valley, including groundwater depletion and subsidence.

WHEREAS, drought conditions have improved due to ample rain and snow pack, but Southern California still suffers from abnormally dry conditions per the State Water Resources Control Board. Therefore, the City wishes to go from the Stage D Emergency Water Conservation Plan to Stage C.

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Beverly Hills does hereby resolve as follows:

Section 1. Water Conservation Stage D is hereby repealed and replaced with Water Conservation Stage C throughout the City's service area mandating a minimum twenty percent (20%) reduction in potable water use.

Section 2. The City Council hereby directs that the Director of Public Works implement Water Conservation Stage C as follows:

Stage C Requirements:

1. A stage C shortage shall be declared when the city manager determines that a twenty percent (20%) reduction in potable water use is required.

2. Stage C compliance elements shall include the following mandatory elements:

- a. Restaurants shall serve water upon request only;
- b. All public restrooms in the city and private
- bathrooms in hotels shall notify patrons and employees of water conservation goals;
- Plumbing and irrigation leaks shall be repaired as soon as practicable. The city may issue notices to repair visible leaks;

3. Violation by any person of the stage C mandatory requirements shall constitute a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00). Water supply through irrigation water services may be terminated for continued excessive use. The violation of each element, and each separate violation thereof, shall be deemed a separate offense, and shall be punished accordingly.

Section 3. The City Council hereby adopts the following additional conditions during the Stage C Water Conservation Plan:

1. During the months of October through May, outdoor watering shall occur a maximum of two (2) day per week as follows:

> a. North of Santa Monica Boulevard – Monday and Friday

 b. South of Santa Monica Boulevard – Tuesday and Saturday

2. During the months of June through September, watering shall occur a maximum of three (3) days per week as follows:

> a. North of Santa Monica Boulevard – Monday, Wednesday and Friday

 b. South of Santa Monica Boulevard – Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday

3. The State's permanent watering restrictions per Executive Order B-37-16 (see https://www.gov.ca.gov/docs/5.9.16_ Executive_Order.pdf) shall remain in effect.

Section 4. The City Council hereby finds, in the exercise of its independent judgment and analysis, that this Resolution is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") because the requirements for water conservation contained in this Resolution will not have a significant effect on the environment, and the adoption of this Resolution and the timing thereof is mandated by the current drought conditions and the State Water Resources Control Board 's water reduc-tion target for the City. In this case, the City is acting at the direction of the State Water Resources Control Board to protect, maintain, restore and enhance natural resources and the environment. To comply with the requirements of the State Water Resources Control Board, the City Council finds that the adoption of this Resolution is categorically exempt from the requirements of CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Sections 15307 and 15308. furthermore, this Resolution will have no possible 2 significant effect on the environment, given that the provisions of this Resolution provide similar regulations as currently exist and will not in and of themselves cause any change in the Environment. Staff is hereby directed to prepare and post a notice of exemption pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15062.

Section 5. In accordance with Beverly Hills Municipal Code Section 9-4-303, the City Council hereby directs the City Clerk to publish this Resolution within 10 days of its adoption at least once in a newspaper of general circulation within the city and to post this Resolution in at least three (3) public places and continue to post this Resolution until such time as the restrictions set forth herein are repealed by resolution of the City Council.

Section 6. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this resolution and shall cause this resolution and his certification to be entered in the book of Resolutions of the Council of the City.

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
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
