


#### A Proposition 65 Public Notice

The California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement requires California Act businesses to advise employees and neighbors of any potential exposure chemicals considered to by the state to cause cancer, birth defects, or other reproductive harm.

Veolia Energy Los Angeles, Inc. wants you to know that detectable amounts of some of these substances may be found in and around its facility located at 2052 Century Park East, Los Angeles, CA. Potential sources of these substances can include common products such as gasoline, oil, natural gas, paint. Olympic. After purchasing our building, we spent nearly \$400,000 on improvements such as central air, new electricity, kitchen and bath remodels, paint, appliances, landscaping and other upgrades.

If we knew at the time we bought our building that there would be a 3% rent control restriction, it would not have made financial sense for us to spend so much money upgrading our building. Additionally, it would have cost us thousands of more dollars under this rent control ordinance to evict a tenant in order to be able to live in the unit we now live in. Moreover, studies have shown that costs for operating buildings have increased much more than 3% per year (e.g., look how much we now pay for water in the City, and as a landlord, I cannot control how my tenants consume water).

Price controls do not benefit any economy, and rent control is no different. Rent control will not encourage landlords to improve their buildings, and it certainly will not encourage development of multifamily rental dwellings within our city. The inventory of rental units in our City will decline as rental units will be redeveloped into condominiums at a faster pace. Would the City ever consider imposing restrictions on how much lawyers can charge for legal fees, economists can charge for economic studies or anesthesiologists can charge for their services?

The Planning Commission of the City of Beverly Hills, at its REGULAR meeting on Thursday, June 22, 2017, will hold a public hearing beginning at **1:30 PM**, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard to consider a request for Variances and a **Development Plan Review** to allow construction of a new 22'2" tall, two-story residential building containing one unit located at <u>331 North Oakhurst Drive</u>. The proposed project is located on a 3,327 square foot lot in the R-4 zone and would have a floor area of 2,865 square feet (including basement). Construction of the proposed project requires the following entitlements:

- Variances from the City of Beverly Hills Municipal Code (BHMC) for the following: • Variance from BHMC § 10-3-2805 in order to build habitable basement area in
  - a multi-family zone
  - Variance from BHMC § 10-3-2806 to deviate from the required modulation for multi-family buildings
  - Variance from BHMC § 10-3-2806 to allow the reduction of the required front yard setback
  - Variance from BHMC § 10-3-2807 to allow the reduction of the required side yard setback
  - Variance from BHMC § 10-3-2808 to allow the reduction of the required rear yard setback
  - Variance from BHMC § 10-3-2810 to allow extension of the basement lightwell to encroach into a rear yard setback
  - Variance from BHMC § 10-3-2816 to provide two parking spaces instead of the required three parking spaces
  - Variance from BHMC § 10-3-2817 to waive guest parking requirements
  - Variance from BHMC § 10-3-2818 to provide parking spaces not enclosed by solid walls (not shielded from public view) and provide such spaces in a required side yard setback

These variances are being requested in order to accommodate the proposed structure on the project site.

A **Development Plan Review** is required pursuant to BHMC §10-3-3100 and §10-3-3102 because the proposed project involves new construction requiring the granting of a variance.

This project has been assessed in accordance with the authority and criteria contained in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the State CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Sections 15000 et seq.), and the City's Local CEQA guidelines. The project appears to qualify for a Class 3 Categorical Exemption for new construction or conversion of small structures pursuant to Section 15303 of the guidelines because it is a multi-family residential structure that contains no more than four dwelling units. The Planning Commission will consider finding that the project will not have a significant environmental impact and is exempt from the provisions of CEQA.

Any interested person may attend the meeting and be heard or present written comments to the Commission. erty owners to bear under this rent control ordinance is similar to placing limitations on the sale price of your own single family homes. Everyone that owns property does so as an investment. Why not limit the price you can get when selling your single family home in order to encourage young families to move into Beverly Hills or allow seniors more affordable homes to own and live in? It is my property, and I should be able to manage it in the manner I see fit provided I properly maintain my building and provide adequate safety and security for my tenants.

The truth is that landlords are not in the eviction business. When I have good tenants, I do everything in my power to keep them. Keeping good tenants often means not increasing rent. Landlords are not looking to gouge tenants with constant 10% increases each year. To the contrary, if the rent gets too expensive, tenants move, units can and often will become temporarily vacant, and landlords incur expenses for painting, cleaning and other required maintenance. The potential "gain" in raising the rent of a tenant is often far outweighed by the cost of lost rent, painting, etc.

I understand the need to protect from "pricing out" fixed income seniors that may have lived in their rental units for many years. And, the City should absolutely consider providing some protections for seniors. But, I have a tenant, for example, that is supported by a trust fund that the City has no business in protecting through a rent control ordinance. With much of the apartment buildings in our City being owned by "mom and pop" operators like me, an often unintended consequence of rent control will become prevalent in that people of relatively modest means (like my wife and me) will be subsidizing the housing of the wealthy. In the "tech boom," cities like San Francisco and Santa Monica have experienced this.

At the time we purchased our building in Beverly Hills, although under no obligation to do so at that time, in order to take possession of a unit to live in, we worked out an arrangement with the tenant that we evicted to compensate her for moving and other costs. This tenant told us that the previous owner rarely increased her rent during the 20 years that she lived at the building, and because of that, during years when she had made a good living and could have afforded to buy a property of her own, she did not do so and merely spent her money. She told us how much she regretted not buying a property when she had the chance. Rent control also discourages people from buying property of their own.

I encourage you to consider an ordinance that is more balanced and fair. Some considerations:

• If you insist on continuing these rent control measures, 3% is just too low and does not cover increased operating costs.

• The City should consider giving those in need a rent subsidy rather than asking landlords to pay for affordable housing through a rent control ordinance.

• Rent increases should be permitted to encourage landlords to make capital improvements. Even under Los Angeles' rent control ordinance, landlords are permitted to recover capital improvement costs over a 5 year period.

• The costs proposed for a "no fault" eviction are excessive, and at a minimum, should be based on a tenant's monthly rent. Why compensate a tenant some \$20,000 when they are paying and can only afford \$2,500 per month?

• Consider that most of the rental housing in the City is owned by "mom and pop" owners like me. I have a fulltime job and do not have time to fill out forms, meet inspectors and comply with the burdensome regulations that are being imposed on me.

• If you really want to do something my tenants would appreciate, consider increasing the amount of overnight parking available on both sides of Olympic between El Camino and Roxbury Drives.

Please allow me the privilege of operating the property that I own. I took the risk, made a very large investment, work hard to operate and maintain it, and I should be able to determine how much I can charge for rent.

#### Singh to Facilitate **Dialogue Sessions in Rent Stabilization Program**

At their June 13 meeting, the City Council unanimously approved the Ad Hoc's recommendation of Professor Sukhsimranjit Singh to facilitate tenant/landlord dialogue sessions as a part of the rent stabilization program.

The decision comes after the Ad Hoc committee, consisting of Mayor Lili Bosse and Vice Mayor Julian Gold, interviewed four candidates. The recommended consultant is a professor at Pepperdine University, School of Law and the Associate Director of the Straus Institute for Dispute Resolution.

Professor Singh's role as facilitator will be to lead Beverly Hills tenants and landlords through dialogue sessions that allow each party to share thoughts and concerns. In his proposal, he details the scope



of work for each meeting, starting from the preliminary meeting and ending with facilitation sessions. "After a

clear identification of Sukhsimranjit Singh

issues in the first meeting, my focus on the second meeting will be to lead the discussions in focused groups toward consensus-building," said Singh in his proposal.

The City Council has said that this kind of input from landlords and tenants will assist in informing not only policy decisions, but also a fair and balanced rent stabilization program.

"By the time it gets back to us, [we hope everybody] feels they helped cultivate an ordinance that represents them," said Mayor Lili Bosse at the meeting.

Professor Singh estimated his work could be completed in approximately 15-20 hours, at \$250/hour.

Staff is now currently working to schedule informational meeting workshops so as to ensure maximum community attendance-likely in late June.



#### **228 South Beverly to Build** Lunchroom

Following several attempts, the Planning Commission has approved a plan to install a lunchroom on 228 South Beverly Drive.

In 2014, project applicant Moshe Kraiem originally submitted a proposal that the lunchroom be 2,202 square feet, which the Commission recommended for denial. Kraiem withdrew and redesigned the application, which at the June 8 meeting proposed 1,166 square feet-accounting for 14 percent of the total floor area of the 8,475 square foot building.

The Planning Commission has the authority to require additional parking for lunchrooms that exceed 10 percent of the total floor area of the building, but in this case Kraiem requested that the Planning Commission not require any additional onsite parking for the rooftop use.

Both the Commission and public com-

person with an interest in organic farming. I have been growing edibles in Beverly Hills since I was 7 years old. Around 6 years ago, I turned my front yard into a small orchard and raised bed vegetable garden. I have literally grown everything from a-z. I have a worm composting system, a mason bee house, and box turtles and birds do my pest extermination. I was inspired to return to school to educate myself in organic techniques, and earned a horticulture certificate from UCLA. I became a SHARE gardener (Simply Have an Area Reserved for the Environment) and pledged to not use pesticides and to provide local habitat for our neighborhood pollinators. The City of Beverly Hills generously allows me the use of an area in Greystone Mansion Park to provide residents with the opportunity to learn how to garden organically: For the past three years a California Co-operative Extension Master Gardener has taught Victory Garden to sold out classes in our demonstration garden. The summer before last, we held a sold out farm to table camp for youth through Recreation and Parks. This coming October, we will be teaching organic farming methods to children also through Recreation and Parks. I also started the first ever 4-H club in our B.H. zip codes and our club has become a state-certified organic produce supplier and sold organic produce from the Geystone Demonstration Garden at our own Farmer's Market. Our ultimate goal is to see the lower Greystone Park Greenhouse Area revived, restored, and used by the community as a priceless historical asset and educational facility.

In conclusion, I am sure that there are other organic farmers in our city limits. We probably tend to be a rather quiet crowd, you may not have us on your radar, but we are here, digging away! (And wishing we could keep a few chickens, and maybe a honey bee hive).

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS, CALIFORNIA AMENDING THE DEFINITION OF "PERSON" CONTAINED IN SECTION 1-2-1 OF THE **BEVERLY HILLS MUNICIPAL CODE AND ADDING ARTICLE 47 TO CHAPTER** 3 OF TITLE 10 OF THE BEVERLY HILLS MUNICIPAL CODE TO PROHIBIT ALL COMMERCIAL CANNABIS ACTIVITY (BOTH MEDICAL AND NON-MEDICAL) EXCEPT FOR DELIVERIES OF MEDICAL CANNABIS, AND MAKING A FINDING OF EXEMPTION FROM CEQA UNDER SECTION 15061(b)(3) OF THE CEQA **GUIDELINES** 

The proposed Ordinance would amend the definition of "person" contained in Section 1-2-1 of Chapter 2 of Title 1 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code to include the words cooperative and collective as part of the definition.

The proposed Ordinance would add Article 47 to Chapter 3 of Title 10 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code to prohibit all commercial cannabis activity in the City. "Commercial cannabis activity" is defined to include the cultivation, possession, manufacture, distribution, processing, storing, laboratory testing, labeling, transportation, delivery or sale of cannabis and cannabis products. The term "commercial cannabis activity" also means and includes the activities of any business licensed by the State or other government entity under Chapter 3.5 of Division 8 or Division 10 of the Business and Professions Code, as they may be amended from time to time. The prohibition on commercial cannabis activity would apply to cannabis used for medical, non-medical, or any other purpose.

The proposed Ordinance contains an exception that allows for the delivery of medical cannabis into the city. Additionally, consistent with State law, the prohibitions adopted under the proposed Ordinance will not prohibit a person twenty-one (21) years of age or older from: (1) possessing, processing, purchasing, transporting, obtaining or giving away to persons twenty-one (21) years of age or older, without compensation whatsoever, not more than 28.5 grams of marijuana not in the form of concentrated cannabis or up to eight (8) grams in the form of concentrated cannabis; (2) smoking or ingesting marijuana or marijuana products; or (3) possessing, transporting, purchasing, obtaining, using, manufacturing or giving away marijuana accessories to persons twenty-one (21) years of age or older without compensation whatsoever, to the extent that such activities are authorized by Health and Safety Code Sections 11362.1 and 11362.2, as the same may be amended from time to time.

This project has been assessed in accordance with the authority and criteria contained in the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA"), the State CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Sections 15000 et seq.), and the City's CEQA Guidelines. Pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3), the Planning Commission will consider finding that the project will not have a significant environmental impact because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the Ordinance will have a significant effect on the environment. The proposed Ordinance will not result in a permanent alteration of property nor the construction of any new or expanded structures.

Any interested person may attend the meeting and be heard or present written comments to the Commission.

menter Dr. Sharon Ignarro expressed concerns about parking space and noise, should the project be approved at 1,166 square feet.

"Sound travels in line of sight, so it will certainly impact the community," said Ignarro, a neighbor who lives close by. "This is not only commercial, but commercial that backs up to residential."

It was suggested that one of the lunchroom bathrooms be removed, or that the lunchroom simply be carved into the existing lunchroom since South Beverly already maintains a high-demand for parking, but project attorney Joe Tilem noted that rooftop lunchrooms often reduce lunch hour traffic.

Tilem also argued that going too small would make the project economically unviable.

"The idea is to make [the lunchroom] comfortable enough and large enough to make [the project] worth doing altogether," said Tilem.

The project space used to be occupied by restaurant Saffron Grill, and will now house Kraiem's jewelry business.

They settled on an agreement to reduce the size of the lunchroom to 847 square feet so as to only account for 10 percent of the total floor area, which the Commission approved unanimously.



#### Amenities Could be Added to the Electric Fountain Location

The purchase and installation of both amenities is under \$10,000 and would utilize the current Community Services Department budget.

Consistent with these amendments, the applicant is requesting amendments to Vesting Tentative Tract Map No. 67884 to reflect the revised project and revise the maximum number of residential condominiums to 193 units. All common interest developments also require approval of a Development Plan Review.

This project has been assessed in accordance with the authority and criteria contained in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the State CEQA Guidelines, and the environmental regulations of the City. 

#### Comanche Works Out For NBA Teams

Former Beverly High standout center Chance Comanche has worked out for the Lakers, Memphis Grizzlies, Toronto Raptors and Utah Jazz as they evaluated possible selections for next Thursday's

NBA draft, team officials confirmed.

Jazz vice president of player personnel Walt Perrin described Comanche as "intriguing, but a ways away" and "an athletic big" who "needs to get a lot stronger" and "a little more experience."

Comanche "did some things" in the workout "we weren't able to see" when he played in college

because coach Sean Miller "kind of kept him closer to the basket," Perrin said after the June 7 workout.

"In our workout, we had him get outside the NBA (23-foot, 9-inch 3-point line) and show us he could shoot that," Perrin said.

The 6-foot-11-inch Comanche declared for the 2017 NBA draft on April 8, but kept

the option of returning to Arizona for his junior season by not hiring an agent. He announced on May 5 that he would give up the final two seasons of his college eligibility to remain under consideration for the NBA draft.

Comanche averaged 6.3 points, 3.6 rebounds and 18.1 minutes in 37 games during the 2016-17 season, including two starts.

If selected, it is believed Comanche would be the first Beverly Hills alumnus to be chosen in the NBA draft since 1981, when Steve Craig, a 1975 graduate who went on to play for Brigham Young, was selected in the fifth round by the Philadelphia 76ers with the 114th overall selection.

No Beverly High alum-

nus has played in the NBA. Comanche helped lead the Normans to the 2014-15 Southern Section Division 3A championship and was selected as the division Player of the Year in his only year at the school.

**6:47 p.m**. I park my car in the visitor lot and proceed to walk to the Beverly High Science & Technology building where the weekly 7:00 p.m. Toastmasters meeting takes place. I wonder if I'm going to have to speak.

6:52 I find the building after a bit of aimless wandering, and am greeted by a friendly woman named Ann Hastings, the founder of Toastmasters 90210. She wraps me in a warm hug and says, "You must be Olivia!" My reporter's notebook must have given me away. She leads me into classroom S105.

6:54 Leon Kolaski, Toastmasters 90210 Vice President, introduces himself and shows me to my seat: a chair lined against the wall in a section designated for guests. I sit down and begin to read the meeting agenda resting on my chair. I'm promptly greeted by club member Jeannette Ceja, who hands me a guestbook to sign.

Because the clock is quickly approaching 7 and Leon emphasized that the meeting starts at 7:00 sharp, I hastily jot down my name and email. It's messy, but it'll do.

7:00 Toastmasters President Allison Samon walks to the front of the room and uses her gavel to call the meeting to order. She then introduces the new members, one of which is a vivacious man named Donnie Johnson. He scans the room briefly and proceeds to say, "I'm the token black guy!" The room erupts in laughter.

7:08 Allison continues with her opening speech, talking about the executive committee. Her voice is playful, sing-songy, and fun to listen to. I decide she's a great speaker and that it makes sense why she's the president.

7:11 Suddenly, she turns to the guest section and asks us to introduce ourselves. I had a feeling! The man seated next to me stands up and says that he had been contemplating attending Toastmasters for a while and finally decided to take the leap. He tells them he wants to become a better leader and speaker. When it's my turn, I straighten my skirt and stand tall, hoping to come across as "Toastmaster-y" as possible. As I speak about the Weekly, I wonder if they're all silently grading my delivery.

7:15 After us guests have finished introducing ourselves, all eyes return to Allison, who proceeds to introduce the Vice President of Education and this week's Toastmaster, Bernadett Swarthout, They switch places, with Allison returning to her seat and Bernadett at the front of the room launching into a story about growing up in a small Hungarian town. She explains what it was like to move to the United States at age 19, using this anecdote to explain the theme for this week: "moving away from home."

7:26 Bernadett then talks about the structure for the meeting, which I assume this is for newbies like me. It will start with something called Table Topics, transition into speeches, and finish with evaluations. She introduces functionaries-roles like the General Evaluator and the Grammarian that shift every week based on volunteers—who each make a brief introduction. 7:30 While the functionaries are talking,

> I keep hearing a high-pitched Ding! I initially try to ignore it, but when curiosity inevitably gets the best of me I whisper-ask nearby member Karina

Guzman what the shrill noise is for. She smiles and says the answer will be revealed shortly.

7:32 Sure enough, not even three minutes later Andrew Citron introduces himself as the Bell Master, a functionary role that rings a bell every time someone uses filler words such as "like" or "um." I feel silly for being impatient.

7:34 Table Topic Master Ann Hastings walks to the front of the room. I recognize her from earlier. She asks a question in line with the "moving away from home" theme: "When you left home, did you make the decision yourself or were you shown the door?" Immediately after, she calls out the name "Rona" and a woman walks to the front of the room. Without hesitation, she answers the question with grandiose hand gestures, confidence, and a solid dollop of humor. She even goes as far as to mimic her parents' New York accent as she explains that even though they offered to buy a car in an effort to make her stay, she was more than ready to move out. Despite

the occasional ding! during her speech, one look around the room shows just how irrefutably captivated this audience is. I wonder if anyone in this club isn't an expert speaker.

7:35 Ann returns to the front and repeats the process of asking a question related to moving away from home and calling a random name in the audience. She poses a wide variety of questions like the defining moment that revealed it was time to move out, advice to pass along to others wanting to do the same, and even if moving back in is an option. Four more members are summoned, and each one provides a thoughtful answer. Ding, ding, ding, ding!

7:40 After each speaker finishes, we

all for our favorite table topic speaker and are told the winner will be revealed at the end

of

meeting. I vote for Rona, partly (mainly) because her New York accent was on-point.

7:42 Now it's time for the prepared speeches to begin. Donnie walks to the front of the room and begins speaking zealously about his "assignment" on earth, which is to empower others through slight religious undertones. "Stay lined up with your assignment and purpose! And if you don't know what your assignment and purpose is, ask Him or ask someone else" says Donnie. He talks very loudly, perhaps a smidge too loudly, but the sheer passion in his voice is palpable. The room is still. After he finishes, everyone stands up and claps.

7:51 She introduces the next speaker, a man named Jesus Rodriguez. Though not as visibly passionate as Donnie, Jesus' speech about carving out time to relax and take care of mental health is utterly relatable and well-organized. I decide I might take a spa day next weekend.

7:59 The Toastmaster announces the third and final speaker Andrew Citron. In the most even-toned voice of the three, Andrew launches into a story about his first experience at Toastmasters, and how he was riddled with anxiety. The story follows his transformation of self-insecurity into self-confidence, and he tosses in couple self-deprecating jokes along the way. I notice how powerful his eye-contact is. He finishes with the line, "I would urge all of you to create whatever you want-something incredible-out of your fears," and the audience responds with a unanimous "Awww." Many peoples' eyes begin to well with tears. I will not say whether or not I am one of those people. (I am.)

**8:06** We vote for the best speaker. I have an inkling of who's going to win this one.

**8:10** General Evaluator Christine Owen walks to the front and introduces each speaker's evaluator. She does not stutter

and talks in a very mellow, serene manner. I think she must teach yoga in her spare time.

8:11 Evaluator Rika Kanaoka walks to the lectern and begins to critique Donnie's speech. She asks the audience if we notice how confident and passionate he was. I nod. She also praised his impeccable rhythm, but noted that he spoke a bit too fast. Since she is from Japan, Rika says she processes things more slowly and that Donnie could benefit from utilizing the phrase, "less is more."

8:13 Michael Tanenbaum, the second evaluator, reviews Jesus' speech. He commends Jesus for how organized the speech was, stating that he followed the rubric per-

fectly. He also notes, however, that Jesus used his hands too much.

8:17 Finally, it's third evalu-Rosanne ator Rabito's turn review to Andrew Citron. She makes a

good point in

mentioning that the overall goal of the speech was slightly vague-something I hadn't noticed because I was so transfixed by his actual storytelling. She also mentions, though, that "everyone in the room knows why Andrew is [considered by Toastmasters International] an advanced speaker."

8:21 Christine returns to the front of the room and asks everyone to vote for the best evaluator. I chuckle to myself because we've essentially been instructed to evaluate the evaluators. Is this what "meta" is?

8:26 After Christine shares her general review for the evening and Grammarian Karina delivers the verdict of who used what filler words and how much they owe the "piggy bank," Bernadett returns to the front of the room. She presents the awards: Rona wins Best Table Topics, Rika wins Best Evaluator, and Andrew wins Best Speaker. (Knew it.)

8:28 Bernadett returns control to President Allison, who recites information about several workshops occurring in late June as well as a mentorship program for new members. Leon volunteers to be next week's Toastmaster. Allison closes by asking two late straggling guests to introduce themselves, and thanking everyone for coming.

8:40 The meeting is adjourned five minutes early. Old members, new members, and non-members begin mingling and hugging. It's clear in that moment that Toastmasters 90210 is more than a Monday night commitment for these people; it's a support system. Looking around the room, I come to the realization that nearly every single person in it spoke at least once. Even me.
