

Bike Rack on Third Street to Remain



The Traffic and Parking Commission discussed a request last Thursday to change parking regulations and denied a request to move the bike share station on the 9200 block of Third Street.

The 10-hour parking signs on the north side of Third Street, adjacent to 331 Maple Drive building, would have been replaced with 1-hour parking. New disabled parking spaces would have been installed on the north and south side of Third Street.

The decision follows a comment resident David Gingold made at the December 7, 2017 Traffic and Parking Commission meeting stating concerns about the lack of disabled street parking near the Maple Drive post office.

Gingold also provided similar concerns

at public comment at the December 12, 2017 City Council/Traffic and Parking Commission Liaison Committee meeting and the December 19, 2017 City Council Formal meeting.

Staff previously conducted parking spot counts at Third Street several days in December 2017. On average, 62 percent of the 10-hour parking meter spaces on the

> north side of Third Street adjacent the 331 Maple building were occupied. On the north side, there was an average occu-

pancy of 56 percent.

Staff also found that the bike station, which was approved in April 2016, had an average of one person per day picking up a bike from the Third and Maple station. The study took place on November 30 (installation of the 10-hour parking signs) to December 19, 2017. There were a total of three round-trip rentals during that time period.

Staff concluded that utilization of the Third and Maple bike share station does not appear to impact parking activity on Third Street.

During deliberation, the commissioners pointed out that the purview of removing parking structures falls under the Planning Commission.

"We're a parking and traffic commis-

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sion, parking in this particular area is the purview of the Planning Commission," said Commissioner Jake Manaster. "If the City wants to change that I'd be all in favor of it because I think the Parking Commission has more depth and understanding at times as to the long-term impacts of parking being removed or replaced or changed within the City."

The commission unanimously agreed that they had "no particular opinion" regarding the duration of the meters located on Third Street, directing staff to determine their time and availability.

Council Adopts Resolution Supporting Protests in Iran

The demonstrations began on December 28, 2017 in Mashhad following Iran's high inflation and rising unemployment rates, ranging from 29 to 45 percent. Additionally, demonstrators have recently taken to criticizing widespread government corruption.

As a result, the current protests are the largest in Iran since its disputed 2009 presidential election. As of January 2, 21 deaths have been reported and hundreds of citizens have been arrested.

With other democratic nations like Canada, Germany and Israel expressing support of the protestors, the City felt it necessary to add its voice to the chorus.

"This is echoing the voice of the voiceless," said realtor and former Commissioner Yar Meshkaty said. "I think Beverly Hills can be really instrumental in this matter of echoing the voices of people who cannot be heard at this time."

At deliberation the Council discussed referring to the Iranian issue as an Apartheid, but Vice Mayor Julian Gold noted that the phrasing could be "distracting" and that the current wording would suffice.

The Council reached a unanimous consensus to adopt the resolution but not without making several amendments to the draft, one of which included adding a section encouraging other cities to follow in Beverly Hills' footsteps.

"There have been some times where I have been really proud of us as a Council, but I think this is the proudest I've ever been," said Mayor Lili Bosse of the Council's unanimous decision.

Traffic & Parking Discusses Santa Monica Parking Strategies

The Traffic and Parking Commission

discussed parking strategies on South Santa Monica Boulevard (SSMB), following the beginning of its construction in January 2017.

Some such strategies could include staff's suggestion of a Hybrid Alternative with EB left turn prohibition at Rodeo as a demonstration project upon completion of NSMB reconstruction project.

As part of the traffic mitigation program, SSMB was reconfigured to add capacity by removing on-street parking to better accommodate projected traffic diversion from NMSB to maintain access to the business triangle.

The City agreed with the reconfiguration for the project duration, and directed staff to "bag" rather than remove the meters entirely.

Although the plan was intended to be temporary during the construction period, it proved to be very successful in terms of traffic flow, leading many to question the advisability of returning to the pre-construction configuration.

Prior to construction, the lane/parking configurations on SSMB were two through lanes each direction with lim-

ited left turn pockets, 39 onstreet parking spaces, 2 loading zones, and no left turn lanes at Canon, Beverly, and Camden Drives, requiring turns from a through lane.

Some business owners on SSMB, however, voiced at public comment that they'd like on-street parking to return to the boulevard.

During deliberation, the commissioners noted while it's clear the current setup cannot remain as it is, they also do not

want to return to the prior configuration.

"The current state of affairs is not adequate," said Commissioner David Seidel. "That's too impactful for the businesses. Although [as far as] riding down that street—I would not do it the way it was before. I would not ride on South Santa Monica Boulevard the way it was before."

City Council OKs Funding for Concours d'Elegance



The City Council approved on Tuesday to approve funding for the 25th Annual Concours d'Elegance on June 17.

With an estimated attendance of over 50,000 people, the free annual car show will include a display of over 100 automobiles featuring custom cars, sponsor booths, and food trucks.

It will also include an additional \$46,200 in City funding—from \$125,000 last year to \$171,200 this year. The total cost of the 2018 Concours d'Elegance is \$280,000, but the City's contribution will cover costs associated with the closure of Rodeo Drive, marketing for the event, and programming for the street such as the stage, step and repeat, and food trucks.

Rodeo Drive Committee President Kathy Gohari said that the increase would help with the event's declining sponsorship.

"There are a lot of car shows in the City, [so there are] many opportunities for sponsorship. Were finding it challenging to find sponsors who want to specifically sponsor a car show," said Gohari. "We're not trying to keep the money; we're just making sure we don't come to you two weeks before and say we're in trouble."

Rodeo Drive/Special Events Liaison Committee member and Mayor Lili Bosse called the request fair and said it is "one of the best events in the City."

City Council Grants MA-ZON Two Free Use Days at the Wallis



At their meeting on January 9, the City Council voted to approve a request by MAZON: A Jewish Response to Hunger to use two of the City's free days at the Wallis for a traveling art exhibit titled "This is Hunger".

The free exhibit is proposed for February 5 and 6 in the motor court area of the Wallis. Because MAZON is a nonprofit organization, the limited funding for the exhibit is not enough to cover the costs of

the Wallis' motor court.

Therefore, the Wallis referred MAZON to the City to see if they were willing to donate two of the City's free usage days for the travelling exhibit, which showcases the need for all communities to be involved in the campaign against hunger. It consists of a 53-foot trailer that has traveled for 10 months on a tour of 30 cities.

It also includes photos and first-person accounts from affected individuals and groups.

Although it's free, MAZON requires participants to sign up for a one-hour time frame to enter the exhibit since the truck can only accommodate 30 people at a time. About 100 people are expected to attend per day.

Because the two-day use of the motor court is covered under the City's agreement with the Wallis, there will be no additional funding. MAZON will fund ancillary costs including advertisements, security and all logistical needs.

At the meeting, Mayor Lili Bosse called MAZON a "wonderful program," encouraging staff to do what they can to get the word out and have the community fill the entire day.

"My feeling is that since we have the Wallis for two days, let's take advantage of it," said Bosse. "I think part of it is getting the word out, but with social media these days it's really easy to do."

There will also be breakfast bagels and cream cheese donated by the Nosh of Beverly Hills and lunch sandwiches donated by Rose Kaiserman and family.

Approximately 150 people are expected to attend the event, whose topic this year is #Bhhealthycity.

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



looked at the finances could quickly see that we were on a financially unsustainable path," said "[But Goodrich. EPEC] refused to accept the reality of the situation."

The schools were closed in June 1991, with Peninsula reopening that September with approximately 3,000 students.

By the time the November Board election took

place, incumbents Jack Bagdasar and Joseph Sanford, who supported the consolidation, lost to opposition candidates Davidson, and Barry Hildebrand.

"I wasn't happy about it, but the people had spoken. It's really easy to sit on the sidelines of a football game, much harder to be the quarterback," said Younggren, noting that although Hildebrand won that year, he was unseated when he ran for re-election in 1995.

But looking back over 25 years later on the Board's decision to address the PVPUSD's financial tribulations, both Goodrich and Younggren said they have "no doubt" they made the right move.

Younggren said that the closures helped Peninsula High School blossom into a "rich education opportunity." He also pointed out that the middle schools are the top in the nation.

"Change isn't easy, but it isn't necessarily wrong. Schools take on the appearance of a living entity, but they are businesses and you don't want to cash in on quality education for convenience or local issues," said Younggren. "What you want is to produce the absolute best education you can given the limited dollars [you have]."

As for those angry parents?

"I think some of [them] finally came around and recognized the reality of the situation once they cooled off, and were more objective about it," said Goodrich. "When you've got a population such as Palos Verdes where people expect a first-rate curriculum, [it's clear that without the reconfiguration] we just wouldn't have been able to maintain it."
