#### "BHUSD Files Another Metro Lawsuit" [Issue #957]

The following is a response to Ira Friedman's open letter to the editor, printed on February 8 [Issue #958]:

Question # 1 from Mr. Friedman: How much has BHUSD budgeted for this latest lawsuit?

Answer: As of December 2017, the District has spent \$12.8 million on litigation related to METRO.

Question # 2 from Mr. Friedman: How much of a retainer did BHUSD pay its lawyers?

Answer: Unfortunately, this is privileged information.

Question # 3 from Mr. Friedman: How much per hour is BHUSD being charged by its lawyers?

Answer: Lawyer rates vary by firm and by case. Lawyer rates being paid for by BHUSD are anywhere from \$200 to \$800+/ per hour.

Question #4 from Mr. Friedman: What was the source (fund) the retainer and ongoing funds for this lawsuit will be paid?

Answer: The District has used and continues to use Measure E/bond funds to pay for litigation associated with METRO.

Question #5 from Mr. Friedman: How much per year/per student does BHUSD spend on all of its attorney fees?

Answer: Last year the District spent approximately \$3.2 million in legal fees (\$2,192,298 from bond + \$1,044,689 general fund).

Question # 6 from Mr. Friedman: How does BHUSD payments per student for attorneys fees compare to other school districts in Los Angeles County?

Answer: I don't have this data to compare, but METRO is a unique factor that contributes to litigation costs.

## **SUMMARY NOTICE**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on March 6, 2018, the Council of the City of Beverly Hills adopted an ordinance entitled:

## AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS REVISING REGULATIONS RELATED TO BASEMENTS IN SINGLE FAMILY AREAS OF THE CITY AND GRADING AND RETAINING WALLS IN THE HILLSIDE AREA OF THE CITY AND FINDING THE ORDINANCE EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT

Vice Mayor Gold, and Councilmembers Mirisch, Wunderlich, and Friedman voted for the adoption of the Ordinance (Ordinance NO. 18-O-2751). Mayor Bosse recused herself from discussion on the Ordinance. A summary of that Ordinance, which has been prepared for publishing in accordance with the requirements of Government Code Section 36933, follows.

#### **Summary of Ordinance**

The Ordinance includes the following measures:

- The definition of "floor area" in single-family residential zones would be amended to define a "basement" as an area that is located directly below the portion of a story above which has a finished floor level that is a maximum of three feet (3') above finished grade at any cross-section cut through the building with certain exceptions for driveways, light courts, pools and water features, and stairs and access ways that might otherwise cause a basement to be exposed by more than 3' above grade. The amendments would also require a basement that extends beyond a story above to be located entirely below both finished and natural grades. (Amendment to Beverly Hills Municipal Code [BHMC] § 10-3-100.)
- A definition of "light court" would be added to the BHMC. As proposed, a light court would be an excavated area adjacent to a building that extends more than 4'-0" from the building perimeter that is enclosed on four sides, open on the top, and allows light into a below grade level of a building. The BHMC does not currently contain a definition of light court. (Addition to BHMC § 10-3-100.)
- The definitions of "finished grade" and "natural grade" would be added to the BHMC to ensure clarity of the code and consistency in its application. (Additions to BHMC § 10-3-100.)
- The language governing the maximum height of walls, fences, and hedges within the Hillside Area of the City would be amended to limit the total height of any wall fence or hedge to 12'-0" regardless of the side of the wall, fence, or hedge from which a measurement is being taken. An R-1 Permit is also proposed to be added to allow relief from these regulations (Amendment to BHMC § 10-3-2516.)
- The language governing the construction of series of walls in the Hillside Area of the City is would be amended to allow for a maximum cumulative height of 12'-0" for all walls constructed on the same property within any 50' perpendicular section. A 10'-0" landscaped horizontal distance must also be provided between each wall. An R-1 Permit is also proposed to be added to allow relief from these regulations (Amendment of BHMC § 10-3-2516.)
- The calculation method provided in the BHMC that defines the total cubic yards of landform alteration (cut/fill) allowed on a site in the Hillside Area of the City within a five year period would be amended. (Amendment of BHMC 10-3-2521.)
- The regulations regarding import/export of earth material within the Hillside Area of the City would be amended to clarify that cubic yardage will be based on in-ground earth volumes. The code does not currently stipulate whether the amount of earth material is in ground compacted earth material or excavation un-compacted earth material. (Amendment of BHMC 10-3-2521 and BHMC 10-3-2521.1)
- The definition of "height of building" would be changed to bring the method of measuring the height of buildings in the Hillside Area of the City in line with the method of determining whether or not a portion of a building can be considered a basement. (Amendment of BHMC 10-3-100)
- The findings pertaining to Hillside R-1 Permits would be amended to add a provision that the total number of construction-related vehicle trips associated with a project as a whole may be considered by a reviewing authority when considering a Hillside R-1 Permit for import and export of earth material. (Amendment of BHMC §10-3-2550)
- Language pertaining to the applicability of the proposed ordinance to projects that are currently under review by the City of Beverly Hills (pipeline projects). The ordinance would exempt the following pipeline projects from the new provisions: all pipeline projects in the Central and Trousdale Areas of the City, pipeline projects in the Hillside Area of the City that have previously received an R-1 Permit, pipeline projects in building plan check in the Hillside Area of the City that do not include a new home or addition of more than 50% floor area on the site, pipeline projects in building plan check in the Hillside Area of the City that do include a new home or addition over 50% floor area that do comply with the new retaining wall regulations, and pipeline projects that have been submitted for entitlement review prior to the effective date of the ordinance. Pipeline projects that are not exempt will be allowed to request an R-1 Permit for review of the project under the existing code provisions by the Planning Commission.
- Language that would waive the entitlement fees for projects in the pipeline that are required to seek an R-1 Permit due to the changes in the BHMC.
- Language that includes provisions to provide an additional 18 months beyond the effective date of the ordinance in which to obtain building permits for pipeline projects, provided that a valid application for a building permit was filed before the effective date of the ordinance.

Question #7 from Mr. Friedman: How much in attorneys fees has BHU-SD spent on the Christiansen case?

Answer: The District has spent \$2.5 million from the general fund to pay for litigation associated with the K. Christiansen case.

#### Question #8 from Mr. Friedman: Did BHUSD have any opportunity to settle the Christiansen case?

Answer: Unfortunately, this is privileged information.

It is important to note that the answers provided to the questions in this letter came directly from monthly warrant reports approved in open session by the board of education. This information is public.

Added Pfalzgraf, "Trees were the original identifying element of this City. If you ever get an airplane and look down, you'll know exactly where my town and my trees are.

Staffed by three International Society of Arboriculture (ISA) Certified Arborists, the Urban Forest Bureau participates in trade associations and contributes to the greater good of arboriculture through presentations at regional conferences and trade journal publications.

The bureau administers and oversees trimming, removing, planting and watering the City's 25,000 street and park trees.

Service lines include general tree maintenance, which covers the trimming, supplementary watering and integrated pest management. Crews typically visit over 10,000 tree sites. The annual funding for tree maintenance is approximately \$1,200,000.

Other services lines are CIP reforestation, and the replacement of declining Canary Island Date Palms on 15 streets and the removal of the final third of the Ficus trees along Olympic Boulevard.

Currently, 1,150 Date Palms are planted around the City, some of which date back to 1907. A vascular disease called Fusarium infiltrated the area some time ago, clogging up the palm's transport tissue.

Fusarium results from either from poor sterilization practices such as chainsaw usage—which Pfalzgraf says the City has not done in years—or from the soil.

The Street Tree Master Plan works to prioritize the replacement of trees by the severity of loss on each street. This means that the trees with the highest loss rate, like the Date Palms, will be planted out first.

Following a decade of poor tree performance, a Street Tree Committee was formed in 1959 to improve public support for City projects that required the removal of old trees. Today, public hearings still exist to enlist public support for tree replacement projects.

"We're trying to build uniformity back

Additional projects that require a Street Tree Master Plan include North Elm Drive, El Camino Drive, South Hamel Drive, Cinthia Street, Park Way, North Rexford Drive, South Santa Monica Boulevard and Robertson Boulevard.

In his place as the new Beverly Vista Interim Assistant Principal will be longtime physical education teacher Todd Radonsky.

#### Planning Commission OKs Zoning Code Amendments

The Planning Commission reviewed modifications to the City's Zoning Code that clarify language on existing regulations related to various items.

Included in the modifications are the height of paving buffers in the Central Area of the City, the location of required paving buffers in in the single-family areas of the City, decks over driveways in the Central Area of the City.

Paving buffers are walls or hedges no less than two feet or more than three feet that are required to be provided and maintained along the front and sides of any front yard paving.

Regarding the paving buffer height, the height requirements for hedges and walls that are required by the Zoning Code as a bugger between front yard paved and landscaped areas will be modified to make the requirement consistent with the maximum height requirement for walls, fences, and hedges located within three feet of a front property line on a site located within the central area.

For the paving buffer location, staff will add language to clarify that a hedge or

wall that serves as a required buffer adjacent to front yard paving is not required to be located on the front of a walk way, where the walkway interests the sidewalk.

Staff will also correct a typo which incorrectly refers to ramps leading to subterranean parking rather than referring to a single driveway.

Other modifications include public noticing requirements and the list of projects for which a Development Plan Review is required. One such amendment specifically identifies that new construction involving 2,500 square feet or more of new/additional floor area requires a Development Plan Review.

Commissioner Peter Ostroff inquired how staff reached the 2,500 figure, who said it seemed like a "fairly high" number. "I know we've had this issue come up in other contexts where numbers are selected and it's a difficult line-drawing process," said Ostroff.

According to City Planner Ryan Gohlich, developers used to be able to build commercial by-right multi-family or commercial buildings as long as they met the code requirements.

The Development Plan Review was subsequently added as an entitlement to require discretionary review for almost all projects. It was found that a subset of minor projects shouldn't be subjected to that additional review procedures.

Although Gohlich didn't know the exact methodology behind selecting 2,500 square feet, the commissioners expressed full support of the changes regardless.

"The changes are pretty de minimis and not material," said Commissioner Alan Block.

The approval follow staff's review and findings of seven areas of the code that require "clean up" language to ensure they are applied and interpreted correctly.

According to the staff report, the language clarification will "contribute to creating orderly change to the community by providing clear rules to regulate land use."

#### City Could Get Automated Parking Systems

At their meeting on March 8, the Planning Commission reviewed three existing automated parking systems in the neighboring municipalities of Los Angeles, Culver City, and West Hollywood.

Each case study covers a different type of automated parking system technology and basic information on the operational and maintenance characteristics of each system.

The purpose of these case studies is to gather information on the effectiveness of automated parking systems in the event that the City decides to implement its own.

The Planning Commission has been in talks for several years about using automated parking systems for developing policy and legislation, and current planning projects.

In 2013, the Commission developed a subcommittee to discuss a request that Council add the development of an automated parking ordinance. At the time, Council did not identify the topic as a top

### Howard Edelman Retiring Track & Field Coach Howard Edelman on 30 years of Beverly High athletics

You're filling in for [Athletic Director] Kevin Brown. How has that been?

#### It's been hectic. Absolutely crazy.

## Girls' basketball just won CIF for the second time in a row. Tell us about that.

It was very exciting; it was a fun ride. CIF is our version of March Madness. One of the exciting things about March Madness is that it's "one and done"; CIF is like that too. At that point, no matter how good your season was or how high or low you're ranked, once you loose your season is over. So it was really great how they went through all their rounds against other top teams they had in their league and survived and moved on. And then [we went] against Flintridge Prepwhich the week before in the semi-finals—set the number one ranked team. which was Oxford Academy. We had a real tough matchup against Flintridge Prep; they were a well-coached team with good players. And our girls obviously had a great team too and came out on top.

#### Beverly High's football team has been struggling in recent years. Why is that?

I'm not sure. I think we've been through a handful of coaches and I'm not saying anything about the coaches, but I think when there's been a lot of coaching turnover, it's sometimes hard to get things going. What I found out as a track coach here is that it took me about three years until I felt the team was *my* team. It takes a while. I think that might be part of it. I'm not saying the coaching staff was less than good; I just think it's the amount of turnover. When you get someone [and] the team might not be successful with wins and losses [but] they stick around, sometimes things turn around. There could be other things too that I'm not aware of because I'm not a football guy; my answer is my opinion as someone who has been a track coach and PE coach for a long time.

#### Do you think the football program could be eliminated in the next couple of years?

I really have no idea. That's beyond my purview.

#### What skills specifically do incoming 9th graders not have to excel in football?

Like any kid in any sport, football in particular it helps to have size, to work on getting stronger and faster. If you come from somewhere that has a strong Pop Warner program go to the local high school, those kids already have a lot of experience and a "heads up" versus some other place where football isn't part of the culture.

You were first hired at Beverly High in 1985. Tell us what has changed in

#### athletics since then.

One of the changes is that we used to have a diversity program where used to get kids from different districts, particularly in Los Angeles. [BHUSD] had some sort of program where a certain number of kids could get in. They were interviewed by a committee and a handful of those kids every year grew up

with athletics and they were contributors to our sports team. We don't have to have those kids anymore. They were no coaches on the interview committee, so they had to qualify other ways—academics, school involvement, that kind of thing. We did get quite a few athletes from that program.

We've also had many people who taught and coached here for their careers

and retired. So it's a bit of a coaching carousel. For example, me—I'm retiring at the end of this semester after 30 years here.

#### For the majority of your career you coached track and field and cross-country. How did you pick those sports?

That's what I was. I ran track and cross country in high school and college and then I started coaching way back in 1975. I was at two other high schools from 1975 to 1985 so when I got here I had already been coaching for ten years. When I ran track and cross-country, I fell in love with it. It was a passion.

#### Tell us about some of your mentors at Beverly over your 30-year teaching career.

[Retired coaches] Ron Crawford, Chuck Kloes, Dick Douglas and Carter Paysinger. [They taught me] a sense of integrity, hard work, love for the kids, and setting the bar high in terms of a standard for excellence. And I'm not talking about ability so much as work habits and ethics.

### What have some of your goals been as interim athletic director?

I've just tried to do the best I can to keep things going in a positive direction.

#### Tell us about your family.

I'm married [to my wife Selma] with two kids [Spencer and Jesse]. They're both in college now.

## When you retire, what's the future look like for Beverly's track program?

We're going to have to hire a new head track coach. Right now our current head track coach [also has] an interim label. Just like we're doing with football, we need to find a new head track coach and cross country coach. We're dealing with football first and then track will be next. And who knows? Maybe we'll find a football coach who can also coach track.

priority.

The idea was also discussed again in 2014 and 2015, which resulted in little progress.

But in 2016, the Municipal Code was finally changed to conditionally allow alternative parking facilities to provide required parking in commercial zones. It also established a pilot program to permit up to two applications for alternative parking facilities—which permits semi-automated facilities that require staff and/or operators.

The commission unanimously agreed on March 8 that they would like to pursue the idea of fully automated parking systems after studying the nearby cities.

"This was something that we talked about before and I'm interested in it. I want to pursue it," said Commissioner Alan Block. "I view this as something that could really provide needed parking in the southeast area of the City, particularly on Robertson which would really [help] to

But Charlotte is not quite like any other woman that Shaw has met before. She is a woman that he must consider to be his intellectual peer.

"No man can resist a woman once she has set her sights on him, unless thwarted by another woman," declares Charlotte. But Beatrice Webb, co-founder of the London School of Economics, who introduced the pair, also has strong feelings for Shaw.

**COMES TO BEVERLY HILLS** Protestors gather in opposition to the president's LA visit

#### **By Olivia Anderson**

Hundreds of activists flooded Beverly Canons Parks on Tuesday afternoon to demonstrate against President Donald Trump's most recent visit to California.

Some represented the LGBTQ community, others represented immigrant right groups, but all showed up with posters, signs, and the goal of affecting change.

For Los Angeles resident Kathia Garcia, her reason behind attending is a personal one.

"Everything Trump has said against DREAMers, him removing DACA, trying to pass a proposal that will go against our parents—that's really inhumane and that's really cruel," said Garcia. A DREAMer herself, Garcia said she feels scared about her future under the Trump administration.

The term "DREAMers" (Development, Relief and Education for Alien Minors) refers to certain undocumented immigrants who were illegally brought to the United States as children. They have typically grown up in America and know little to nothing about their native countries.

In order to protect this group, the Obama administration established in 2012 a policy called DACA (Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals). It al-

The SERP, also known as the "golden handshake," is a retirement incentive that may encourage senior employees over the age of 55 to retire early.

It will provide participating eligible employees with a monthly benefit of 75 percent of their final year salary. The program requires all employees to resign by June 30.

Declining enrollment warrants the district to be able to absorb positions instead of layoff.

At a future date, Keenan Financial will hold orientation meetings at district locations to answer questions and provide information regarding the program to eligible employees.

The district will fund the SERP through a fixed annuity from a Keenan Financial insurance company, which guarantees the cost of the program and, according to the lowed for a renewable two-year period of deferred action from deportation and work permit eligibility.

Over 800,000 people were enrolled in the program as of last year.

At their meeting on Tuesday, the Board of Education approved a ratification of an agreement with Quality Fence, Inc. to install fencing around Beverly High, including the front lawn.



#### ORDINANCE NO. 18-O-2750

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS ESTABLISHING THE FINANCE DE-PARTMENT AND THE HUMAN RESOURCES DEPARTMENT AND REGARDING THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION

#### RECITALS

WHEREAS, the divisions of finance and human resources are under the umbrella of the administrative services department: and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to create a separate finance department and human resources department in place of the current administrative services department; and

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission has not been active for many years in the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS. CALIFORNIA DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City hereby re-names, amends and restates Article 6 ("Ada "inistrative Services Department") of Chapter 3 ("DEPARTMENTS AND OFFICES") of Title 2 ("ADMINISTRATION, PERSONNEL, AND PROCEDURE") of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code as follows:

Article 6. Finance Department

2-3-601: CREATION AND FUNCTIONS:

The finance department is hereby established and shall be under the direction of the director of finance who shall be accountable to the city manager. The duties of the director of finance shall be as follows:

A. Act as ex officio finance director under provisions of the state Government Code and pursuant to section 40805.5 thereof perform the financial and accounting duties imposed on the city clerk commencing with section 40802, and pursuant to section 37209 perform the duties imposed on the city clerk relative to issuance of warrants commencing with section 37203;

B. Act as the accounting officer of the city, maintain records reflecting the current financial condition of the city, and furnish advice and reports on city financial matters as may be requested by the city manager;

C. Institute and administer a system of accounts and financial reports, and approve the payment of vouchers and the payroll;

D. Act as the purchasing agent of the city and perform such duties as may be imposed by law upon that position;

E. Administer the annual budget, interpret the purpose and intent of appropriations, and account for appropriations and expenditures;

F. Direct and supervise the administration of general accounting, payroll, accounts payable, purchasing, management and budget, revenue administration, and cashiering and utility billing, and establish procedures and policies for their effective administration:

G. Administer and enforce the business tax, uniform transient occupancy tax, and other taxes administered by the City; and

H. Perform such other duties as may be required by the city manager.

SECTION 2. The City hereby adds Article 14 ("Human Resources Department") to Chapter 3 ("DEPARTMENTS AND OFFICES") of Title 2 ("ADMINISTRATION, PERSONNEL, AND PROCEDURE") of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code as follows:

Article 14. Human Resources Department

2-3-1401: CREATION AND FUNCTIONS:

The human resources department is hereby established and shall be under the direction of the director of human resources who shall be accountable to the city manager. The duties of the director of human resources shall be as follows:

A. Administer the personnel system rules and regulations;

B. Formulate and recommend for approval the policies and procedures regarding the personnel management of the city;

C. Provide personnel services for city employees;

D. Administer the city's insurance programs;

E. Administer the risk management program;

F. Administer the employee benefits program;

G. Prepare, promulgate, and enforce, with the approval of the city manager, such administrative regulations as are deemed necessary to accomplish assigned responsibilities; and

H. Perform such other duties as may be required by the city manager.

SECTION 3. The City hereby amends and restates Section 2-3-001 ("Department and Position Name Modifications") of Article 0 ("Name Modifications") to Chapter 3 ("DE-PARTMENTS AND OFFICES") of Title 2 ("AD-MINISTRATION, PERSONNEL, AND PROCE-DURE") of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code as follows:

#### Article 0. Name Modifications

2-3-001: DEPARTMENT AND POSITION NAME MODIFICATIONS:

Wherever in this Code the following department and position names appear, it shall be understood to mean the new names listed below:

A. All references to the "Building and Safety Department" shall now mean "Department of Community Development".

B. All references to the "building and safety division" shall now mean "department of community development".

C. All references to the "building department" shall now mean "department of community development".

D. All references to the "building director" shall now mean "director of community development".

E. All references to the "building division" shall now mean "building and safety division of the department of community development".

V. All references to the "director of public services" shall now mean "director of public works".

W. All references to the "director of recreation and parks" shall now mean "director of community services".

X. All references to the "director of traffic and parking" shall now mean "director of public works".

Y. All references to the "director of transportation" shall now mean "director of community development".

Z. All references to the "director of transportation and engineering" shall now mean "director of community development".

AA. All references to the "human services department" shall now mean "human resources department".

BB. All references to the "library and community services department" shall now mean "community services department".

CC. All references to the "planning department" shall now mean "department of community development".

DD. All references to the "planning director" shall now mean "director of community development".

EE. All references to the "public services department" shall now mean "department of public works".

FF. All references to the "public works administrator" shall now mean "director of public works".

GG. All references to the "recreation and parks department" shall now mean "department of community services".

HH. All references to the "recreation department" shall now mean "department of community services".

II. All references to the "superintendent of the building department" shall now mean "department of community development".

JJ. All references to the "transportation department" shall now mean "department of community development".

KK. All references to the "transportation and engineering department" shall now mean "department of community development".

LL. All references to the "transportation official" shall now mean "director of community development".

MM. All references to the "transportation/engineering official" shall now mean "director of community development".

NN. All references to the "water department" shall now mean "department of public works".

OO. All references to the "water manager" shall now mean "director of public works".

**SECTION 4.** The City hereby renames, amends and restates Article 3 ("Civil Service Commission") of Chapter 2 ("COM-MISSIONS AND COMMITTEES") of Title 2 ("ADMINISTRATION, PERSONNEL, AND PROCEDURE") of the Beverly Hills Municipal

Code as follows:

#### Article 3 ("Reserved")

SECTION 5. The City hereby renames, amends and restates Section 2-5-209 ("Appeal to Civil Service Commission" of Article 2 ("Personnel Procedures") of Chapter 5 ("CIV-IL SERVICE, PERSONNEL PROCEDURES, AND EMPLOYEE REGULATIONS") of Title 2 ("ADMINISTRATION, PERSONNEL, AND PROCEDURE") of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code as follows:

2-5-209: APPEAL OF DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS AND GRIEVANCES:

An employee's rights regarding appealing a disciplinary action or a grievance shall be governed solely by any provisions related to such appeals that may be contained in the memorandum of understanding between the city and the employee organization.

**SECTION 6.** <u>Severability</u>. If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or place, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect.

**SECTION 7.** <u>Publication</u>. The City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation published and circulated in the City within fifteen (15) days after its passage in accordance with Section 36933 of the Government Code, shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance, and shall cause this Ordinance and his certification, together with proof of publication, to be entered in the Book of Ordinances of the Council of this City.

**SECTION 8.** Effective Date. This Ordinance shall go into effect and be in full force and effect at 12:01 a.m. on the thirty-first (31st) day after its passage.

Notice is hereby given that the City of Beverly Hills ("CITY") has determined that all bidders for various restoration projects at Greystone Mansion ("Project") must be pre-qualified prior to submitting a bid on that Project. *This prequalification is valid for two years and for more than one project.* It is mandatory that all Contractors who intend to submit a bid, fully complete the prequalification questionnaire, provide all materials requested herein, and be approved by the CITY to be on the final qualified Bidders list.

No bid will be accepted from a Contractor that

has failed to comply with these requirements. If two or more business entities submit a bid as part of a Joint Venture, or expect to submit a bid as part of a Joint Venture, each entity within the Joint Venture must be separately qualified to bid. The last date to submit a fully completed questionnaire is 2:00 PM Tuesday, March 27, 2018. Contractors are encouraged to submit prequalification packages as soon as possible, so that they may be notified of omissions of information to be remedied or of their prequalification deadline for this Project.

Answers to questions contained in the attached questionnaire (posted on the City's Website [Beverlyhills.org -> Business -> Bid Listings -> Prequalification Package for Greystone Mansion Restoration Projects]) are required. The CITY will use these documents as the basis of rating Contractors with respect to whether each Contractor is qualified to bid on the Project, and reserves the right to check other sources available. The CITY's decision will be based on objective evaluation criteria.

The CITY reserves the right to adjust, increase, limit, suspend or rescind the prequalification rating based on subsequently learned information. Contractors whose rating changes sufficiently to disqualify them will be notified, and given an opportunity for a hearing consistent with the hearing procedures described below for appealing a prequalification rating.

While it is the intent of the prequalification questionnaire and documents required therewith to assist the CITY in determining bidder responsibility prior to bid and to aid the CITY in selecting the lowest responsible bidder, neither the fact of prequalification, nor any prequalification rating, will preclude the CITY from a post-bid consideration and determination of whether a bidder has the quality, fitness, capacity and experience to satisfactorily perform the proposed work, and has demonstrated the requisite trustworthiness.

The prequalification packages should be submitted under seal to the Office of the City Clerk, City of Beverly Hills, 455 North Rexford Drive, Room 290, Beverly Hills, CA 90210. The prequalification packages submitted by Contractors are not public records and are not open to public inspection. All information provided will be kept confidential to the extent permitted by law. However, the contents may be disclosed to third parties for purpose of verification, or investigation of substantial allegations, or in an appeal hearing. State law requires that the names of contractors applying for prequalification status shall be public records subject to disclosure, and the first page of the questionnaire will be used for that purpose.

Each questionnaire must be signed under penalty of perjury in the manner designated at the end of the form, by an individual who has the legal authority to bind the Contractor on whose behalf that person is signing. If any information provided by a Contractor becomes inaccurate, the Contractor must immediately notify the CITY and provide updated accurate information in writing, under penalty of perjury.

The CITY reserves the right to waive minor irregularities and omissions in the information contained in the prequalification application submitted, and to make all final determinations. The CITY may also determine at any time that the prequalification process will be suspended for the Project and the Project will be bid without prequalification.

Contractors may submit prequalification packages during regular working hours on any day that the offices of the CITY are open. Contractors who submit a complete prequalification package will be notified of their qualification status no later than ten business days after submission of the information.

The CITY may refuse to grant prequalification where the requested information and materi-

als are not provided by the due date indicated above. There is no appeal from a refusal for an incomplete or late application, but re-application for a later project is permitted. Neither the closing time for submitting prequalification packages for this Project will be changed in order to accommodate supplementation of incomplete submissions, or late submissions, unless requested by the CITY in its sole discretion.

In addition to a contractor's failure to be pre-qualified pursuant to the scoring system set forth in the prequalification package, a contractor may be found not prequalified for either omission of or falsification of, any requested information.

Where a timely and completed application results in a rating below that necessary to pre-qualify, an appeal can be made by the unsuccessful Contractor. An appeal is begun by the Contractor delivering notice to the CITY of its appeal of the decision with respect to its prequalification rating, no later than two business days following notification that it is not pre-qualified. The notice of appeal shall include an address where the Contractor wishes to receive notice of the appeal hearing. Without a timely appeal, the Contractor waives any and all rights to challenge the decision of the CITY, whether by administrative process, judicial process or any other legal process or proceeding.

If the Contractor gives the required notice of appeal, a hearing shall be conducted no earlier than five business days after the CITY's receipt of the notice of appeal and not later than five business days prior to the date of the Notice Inviting Bids for this Project. Prior to the hearing, the Contractor shall, in writing, be advised of the basis for the City's pre-qualification determination.

The hearing shall be conducted by a panel consisting of three members of the Public Works Department senior management staff (the "Appeals Panel"). The Appeals Panel shall consider any evidence presented by the Contractor, whether or not the evidence is presented in compliance with formal rules of evidence. The Contractor will be given the opportunity to present evidence, information and arguments as to why the Contractor believes it should be pre-qualified. Within one day after the conclusion of the hearing, the Appeals Panel will render a written determination as to whether the Contractor is pre-qualified. It is the intention of the CITY that the date for the submission and opening of bids will not be delayed or postponed to allow for completion of an appeal process.
