Loma Linda Opponents Distribute Door Hangers Against Basement Ordinance Petition

Loma Linda opponents distributed door hangers over the weekend against



the Basement Ordinance Referendum, explained in last week's issue.

"Please do not sign petithe tion," the door hanger reads. "It requires referendum paid by YOUR TAX **DOLLARS**

to overturn

the Basement Ordinance which the City Council passed to protect our City's environment and prevent overdevelopment."

With attorney Bradley Hertz and realtor

Branden Williams reportedly at its helm, the petition uses professional signature gatherers to garner as much support as possible to place a referendum to repeal the Basement Ordinance on the November ballot

If they receive enough signatures by April 6, the newly-passed Ordinance will not go into effect. If they receive signatures by April 10 the ordinance will be suspended until the Council places it on the ballot.

The door hanger, distributed by Lago Vista neighbors Debbie Weiss, Peter Ostroff and Anne Ostroff, suggests that petitioners are garnering signatures based upon "misleading information."

Peter Ostroff, who serves on the Planning Commission, did not respond to a request for comment.

BHUSD At Impasse with Teachers Over Salary Formula

The BHUSD has reached an impasse with its teachers, leading to the involvement of a third party mediator in order to find an agreement.

The discord comes from the Board of Education's plan to discontinue the salary formula—a measure passed four years ago that provides raises based on property taxes.

At the time, the decision was packaged as a way to attract high-quality educators, but the district is now projected to deplete

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its already-underwater budget to the minimum three percent reserves in two year's time.

Chief Administrative Officer La Tanya Kirk-Carter emphasized at the March 27 Board meeting that this is why the dis-

remove its strict adherence to the salary formula.

But at that same meeting, several BHUSD teachers advocated for the mainte-

the formula, arguing that it alone was not responsible for the district's financial instability.

"The district has determined it can make no further progress at the bargaining table while BHEA continues to have an open mind," Beverly Hills Education Association President Telly Tse told the Weekly. "We want to work with the district and in fact, our proposal will save the district over \$2 million above their own proposal. The salary formula is sustainable and better for the district and employees over the long term. In many ways, we are trying to save the district from themselves."

The district has offered teachers a three percent increase over the next three years, something Tse says BHEA rejected due to a lack of long-term sustainability. They instead requested a six percent increase per year for three years. Historically, raises have been in the two to three percent range.

After six unsuccessful meetings with each other, both parties are now in the early stages of meeting with a mediator to reach consensus.

"It is important to recognize we must all work together to ensure the success of our students by attracting and retaining high caliber teachers while establishing and sustaining a financially healthy school district," said Superintendent Michael Bregy. "Eventually, we are going to come to an agreement and I am hopeful the next steps in working with a mediator prove to be successful in the negotiations process."

Design Review to Hold Expansion Meeting

The Design Review Commission will conduct a public meeting on April 9 at 7:00 p.m. in the Council chambers to consider potentially expanding the commission beyond the Central Area of the City, which is generally the area south of Sunset Boulevard.

The meeting will discuss altering the Design Review Program so as to include single-family zones in the Hillside and Trousdale Estates areas of the City.

Discussion points will include whether the Trousdale Estates should be included in expansion, whether properties not visible from the street should be exempt, whether the review should be limited to the street-facing façade, whether new findings should be developed for hillside areas, how often the commission should meet, and a review of trash enclosures.

The impetus behind the meeting follows the City Council's decision on March 6 to approve modifications to the Municipal Code regulating site grading and reducing the visual impact of retaining walls and exposed basement walls in the Hillside area.

The Council also, however, expressed concern regarding the fact that the new ordinance does not address the overall review of the architectural design of Hill-side Area properties and the potential for requiring the Design Review to "help further improve the aesthetics of the City's residential areas," according to the staff report.

Some residents have already begun to express support for the expansion, including attorney Ronald Richards, who has led the fight against projects on Lago Vista and Loma Linda.

"Due to rising property values, speculators have purchased small, irregular Hillside lots, and are now trying to cram as much square footage on the pad as possible," said Richards. "The designs that follow impacts the neighborhood dramatically, so a design review plan is necessary for the Hillside area."

The building envelope in both the Hillside Area and Trousdale is dictated by the requirements set forth in the Municipal Code and any proposed formal Design Review efforts with impact the surface aesthetics of new projects.

"The critical consideration for Design Review within the Hillside Area and Trousdale Estates is the vantage point or points from which the new or remodeled residence would be adjudicated," reads the staff report.

The public is invited to attend the meeting and be heard or present written comments to the commission.

The potential to expand the areas subject to Design Review in the City will also be reviewed in the future by the Planning Commission and City Council.

Beverly Hills Rabbi Meyer Heller Passes

Longtime Beverly Hills Rabbi Meyer Heller passed away on March 17.

A graduate of Yeshiva University and Hebrew Union College, Heller served in the U.S. Army Signal Corps, reaching the rank



of 2nd Lieutenant.

Heller held several Rabbi positions, most notably as the Head Rabbi at Temple Emanuel of Beverly Hills from 1969-1999 and Rabbi Emeritus from 1999-

Many remember Heller as an avid athlete, sports fan, and regular volleyball and basketball player at the Hollywood and Beverly Hills YMCAs.

One impactful message he often imparted was, "If you love someone, tell them now. Tomorrow it may be too late."

Heller was preceded in death by his first wife, Esther Marcovitch Heller, and his second wife, Judy Freedman Stockler Heller. He survived by seven children, seven grandchildren, and two great-grandchildren.

Memorial contributions may be made to Temple Emanuel of Beverly Hills.

"Rabbi Heller had an impact on generations of families in Beverly Hills for more than twenty five years," said Temple Emanuel Rabbi Jonathan Aaron. "His dynamic presence, his deep booming voice and great smile, along with is Judaic knowledge, brought people closer to their Judaism, and at the same time, closer to each other. He was a man who warmed and inspired many hearts, and Temple Emanuel will miss him deeply."

HELLOS AND GOODBYES

Deputy Director of Public Works Erick Lee on the way out; Assistant Superintendent Laura Chism on the way in

After 21 years with the City of Beverly Hills, former employee Erick Lee will assume a new position as the Executive Director of the South Bay Regional Public Communications Agency on April 9.

Tell us about your new position as the Executive Director of the South Bay Regional Public Communications

Agency

I'm very excited about this new opportunity to be the Executive Director of the RCC. There are three member cities that make up the Joint Powers Agency: Gardena, Hawthorne and Manhattan Beach. And there are also three additional cities that contract for services: Culver City, El Segundo and Hermosa Beach. So it's six cities and it's a joint police and fire dispatch center servicing about 250,000 residents. We provide all the 911 dispatching services for police and fire. Additionally, [there's] a vehicle shop where they install all the technology for all the public safety vehicles for the six cities.

What specifically does your job en-

As the Executive Director I'll be in charge of the entire agency. I think there's about 61 dispatchers and supervisors and also vehicle personnel as well,

so it's about 70 people that will be reporting to me.

What has it been like working in Beverly Hills?

Working in Beverly Hills has been the greatest opportunity I've ever had. I've been with the City for 21 years total, left on [March 29]. It's an amazing place to work. It was awesome working for a community that really wants to

provide the highest level of services to its community and empowers the staff to go out and do that. As far as people I'd like to thank, certainly [City Manager] Mahdi Aluzri and [Assistant City Manager] George Chavez for investing in me for years. I got hired in 1996 by Records Manager Allison Zuniga, but George and Mahdi are the two who have been supporters of mine in the

last few years, helping me to expand my career. And then [Former BHPD] Chief [David] Snowden—his investment in me I will never forget. He's the one who promoted me to commander about six years ago.

I spent 19 years in the [BHPD] and

the last two years in Public Works. The last four years at the police department I was the Division Commander [and] reported to Chief Snowden. He was just an amazing leader to work for. For the last two years in Public Works, half that time I reported to George, and over the last year I've been working for Shana Epstein. [I'd like to] thank her for leadership and mentoring me because she's

definitely someone who I have tremendous respect for. She's a great boss.

What are the biggest differences between working in the Police Department vs. Public Works Department?

The Police Department has a very defined mission, whereas Public Works is a much larger department and there are over a dozen different business lines that we

run, some overlap, some are very disparate. It was a challenge for me to learn how that business was run, but we've got great employees in Public Works that really know the business, and it was a blessing for me to help lead that organization for the two years I was there.



Laura Chism

Assistant Superintendent of Student Services Laura Chism joined the BHUSD last year in a new position that combines two previously different departments.

Tell us about your background.

I hold a Master's degree and a Bachelor's degree in sociology from UCLA. I started as a teacher for emotionally disturbed students here in Los Angeles. I worked in several districts throughout Los Angeles, Riverside and San Bernardino counties as a special day class tutor as well as a resource specialist, teaching grades K-12.

How did you get to Beverly Hills?

I went to Pomona Unified as a Program Specialist and I was there for seven

years. Then, I left there and went to Orange Unified in Orange County as a Coordinator and was there for a little over a year. Then, I went to San Bernardino County Superintendent of Schools as the Program Manager for East Valley SEL-PA, where I managed clients and special education programs as well as due process and mediation for five districts in that county. That was my immediate job preceding Beverly Hills Unified.

How does working in the San Bernardino East Valley SELPA differ from working in the BHUSD?

The major difference that instead of five districts, I'm [now] working in one district. However I'm still dealing with the same types of issues and concerns and programs as far as special education and student services, which is what I was doing there in East Valley SELPA. So it's focusing on one district versus five

What does "student services" entail?

It's the combination of two different departments. Previously, before the reorganization of the district by Dr. [Michael] Bregy in the 2017-2018 school year, special education and child welfare and attendance and student services were under [education] services. Dr. Bregy reorganized it and made students services

its own division, and I was hired as the Assistant Superintendent of Student Services. So, under student services we have special education; we have child welfare and attendance; we have home

hospital instruction, health and welfare of students, drug prevention programs things like that. All those things fall under the umbrella of student services for the district.

Special education is a significant expense for the district. What can be done to mitigate that?

I've been spending my time looking at how we are running our programs, how

we are administering them, finding ways to run them more efficiently, looking at our scope of services and programs that we're providing the students. We are looking at revamping how some of our programs are run; we are looking at using staff more efficiently; we're looking at a little bit of reorganization of the department to provide additional support to help provide better education for students, so we don't have parents who feel they have to resort to litigation to get what their student needs. Those are

> some of the initiatives we're putting in place.

> Where do you see special education legislation headed in the future?

> Hopefully we'll be looking at getting additional funding. Special education has never been a fully funded mandate at neither the state nor federal level. There's a real push, particularly at the state level, for the governor to

look at additional funding for special education. It would be my hope that [special education] gets closer to being fully funded so that we can provide the type of support and programs and services that our students need without having to pull from the general fund to do so.
