

Basement Ordinance Referendum Proponents Narrowly Miss Certification; Hertz Requests Review

of the City's registered voters)-just 25 signature shy of the required 2,080 signatures (or 10 percent of registered voters) to qualify for filing. A total of 20,795 registered voters reside in Beverly Hills, according to the City Clerk.

Bradley Hertz with the Sutton Law Firm, authorized by then-proponent Branden Williams, filed the referendum petition with the City Clerk's office on April

11. The petition was circulated for signatures from March 12 to April 11.

If the petition qualified in time, the Basement Ordinance-which went into effect on April 6-would have been suspended until the Council either rescinded it or placed it on the ballot as a referendum.

Many local community members argued that the firm's method of signature gathering-which included paid petitioners-was "deceitful" to the residents. Gatherers were allegedly being paid \$10-\$15 per signature, compared to the average dollar per signature.

The City received 13 signature withdrawal requests and authorized ten of those withdrawals.

Since the petition failed to qualify, Aquilini's project is now subject to the Basement Ordinance unless the decision is reversed.

In an attempt to jumpstart that process, Hertz sent to the City Clerk's office a request to review the petition and all memoranda prepared by the County Registrar's office in the examination of the petition indicating which registered voters signed the petition.

By completing this review, Hertz aims to "determine which signatures were disqualified and the reasons therefor."

City Clerk Byron Pope responded on Monday by advising Hertz the need for written authorization from Williamseven though he later withdrew as the proponent-to proceed with the request, which Williams sent later that afternoon.

"I would like for this process to begin this week if at all possible," wrote Williams.

But Lago Vista resident Ronald Richards has encouraged the City to "continue the matter" for 30 days to allow the public to speak, or follow City Attorney Larry Wiener's suggestion to approve the exemption ordinance before the second reading if Loma Linda has not dismissed its 1184 lawsuit, or, if the lawsuit is dismissed, leave it on the consent calendar.

"Due to the ever changing facts, we will reserve a final opinion until the meeting," said Richards. "We do strongly believe that the City should get a release from Loma Linda before any exemption ordinance becomes effective and should push to get the release.

Mirisch Elected to LA Local Agency Formation Commission

Vice Mayor John Mirisch was elected to the Los Angeles County Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) Monday and attended his first meeting Wednesday.

"I'm looking forward to serving as a commissioner. It's not a well-known commission but it does important land use

work [like] the annexation of land and creation of cities in our county," said Mirisch.

Established by state law in 2000, LAFCO is a public agency with countywide jurisdiction. Its intent is to "discourage urban sprawl" and "encourage orderly and efficient provision of services."

LAFCO oversees changes to local government boundaries involving the formation and expansion of cities and special districts.

Responsibilities also include conducting special studies that review ways to streamline governmental structure and preparing a "sphere of influence" for each city and special district within each county.

Beverly High Graduate Advocates for Housing the Homeless

Brenda Arianpour, a 2009 Beverly High graduate, spoke on May 2 at a press con-

ference alongside Los Angeles Mayor Eric Garcetti in support of his homeless housing initiative "A Bridge Home."

For "A Bridge Home," Garcetti designated \$20 million to be divided among all 15 council districts to help fund new "Emergency Temporary Housing" the homeless.


A founding Board member of USC's "Swipe Out Hunger," Arianpour spoke on behalf of the Wilshire Center Business Improvement District (WCBID) about the importance of housing for Los Angeles' growing homeless population.

In her speech, Arianpour supported the initiative, highlighting that it will provide the homeless with the necessary resources to "rebuild their lives."

"The growing population of the homeless will only continue to rise unless we do something about it," said Arianpour. "This is neither [an] easy task nor a fast fix, but [A Bridge Home' is the start to some amazing progress."

Council Approves Landmark Designation for Union 76, 157 South Crescent

The City Council approved two res-



olutions designating the Union 76 Gas Station and 157 South Crescent Drive as local landmarks and placing them on the Beverly Hills Register of Historic Properties.

According to the staff report, the designation will "recognize [the properties] as important to the history of the City and help to ensure protection of these resources by requiring City review of any significant future work done to the property, including renovations, additions, and any potential demolition."

The property owners are also now eligible for current and future incentives offered to local landmarks, including the ability to request a Historic Incentive Permit, a Mills Act contract for possible property tax relief, or both.

Located at 427 North Crescent Drive, the Union 76 includes a triangular canopy supported by three concrete piers which cover the gasoline pump stalls and a single-story service building composed of square concrete blocks tucked underneath.

It was designed by Chinese-American architect Gin D. Wong—who was a partner in the William Pereira and Associates

The Planning Commission of the City of Beverly Hills, at its REGULAR meeting on Thursday, May 24, 2018, will hold a study session beginning at **1:30** PM, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard to provide an opportunity for the public and the Planning Commission to discuss the potential expansion of the City's single-family Design Review program beyond the Central Area of the City, which may include single-family zones in the Hillside and Trousdale Estates areas of the City. The potential to expand the areas subject to Design Review in the City will also be reviewed in the future by the City Council.

The Planning Commission's discussion regarding expansion of Design Review may include, but is not limited to, the following topics of discussion:

Preliminary Topics for Discussion

- If Design Review is expanded to the Hillside Area, should it also be extended to Trousdale Estates?
- Should review be limited to the street-facing façade only, as in the Central Area, or should review include other elevations that may be visible from surrounding properties or streets?
- Should properties that are not visible from the street (e.g. flag lots, large estates, significant landscaping, etc.) be exempt from Design Review?
- Should the required findings be the same as in the Central Area, or should new findings be developed for hillside areas?
- Should story poles (poles and flags outlining the envelope of a structure) be required to better understand where a project is visible from and how the massing fits into the topography?
- For projects that require review by both the Planning Commission and Design Review Commission, is there a preferable sequence as to which Commission reviews the project first, or should one Commission be designated to conduct the review in its entirety?
- Should Design Review include review of accessory elements such as retaining walls, fences, accessory structures, swimming pools, water features, game courts, decks, mechanical equipment, landscaping, lighting, paving, etc.?

Review of trash enclosures

- Should there be options for Track One (Staff level) and Track Two (Commission level) review of projects, and should the Style Guide apply?
- What are the staffing and project timeline impacts that might result from expansion of Design Review, and how can these best be minimized?
- What type of public notice should be provided and should bus tours by the Commission be required?
- Review of the Design Review Commission's recommendations from their April 9, 2018 Study Session regarding this matter.

Any interested person may attend the meeting and be heard or present written comments to the Commission. Any comments submitted will be considered as part of the public record.

at the time of design.

Originally intended for a location on Century Boulevard near the airport, the "modernist design reflects the influence of the aviation age."

The "Weller-Schrieber Apartment Building" on South Crescent was designed in the French Revival-Eclectiv Architectural style by an unknown architect.

The building features "distinctive period details" like a mansard roof, quoin details, articulated doors and windows, brick chimneys and entry stoops, embellished entry door surrounds and a small garden enclosed by a perimeter wall and hedge at the entry.

The Cultural Heritage Commission unanimously voted to nominate both properties on February 27 and April 11.

"This project is really a tribute to compromise, and I thank [everyone involved] for helping to accomplish that goal," said Councilmember Lester Friedman. "I hope it continues to serve our community for many more years to come."

Council to Reinstate Summer B.O.L.D Program

After last year's Businesses Open Later Days (BOLD) initiative, the City Council has decided to approve the program for a second year.

Starting in August, the CVB, Chamber, Rodeo Drive Committee and Next Beverly Hills Committee will come together to create BOLD-a way to attract visitors to shop and dine in Beverly Hills.

In order to compete with neighboring business communities, Beverly Hills businesses will remain open until 8:00 p.m. to increase revenue-based opportunities.

Last year's program included custom banners, bistro seating on Rodeo Drive, audio speakers for music, and warm, white lightning in the business triangle. Additionally, a launch event included fireworks and a concert by Poncho Sanchez and his Latin Jazz Band.

This year's proposal includes similar activities, but with "newer elements" due to support from Next Night.

Proposed highlights include a BOLD Launch night with live entertainment and fireworks, DJs every Friday evening, an innovative family-oriented dance program, and the annual Next Night event.

The opening launch night on Rodeo Drive will take place on August 2, two days of programming for four weeks will take place from August 3-25, and closing night (hosted by Next Beverly Hills) will take place on August 25.

Excluding City permit fees and direct costs, the total 2018 Summer BOLD program is projected to cost \$784,637, supported by the CVB, RDC, Chamber and Next Night.

The CVB will provide traditional and digital marketing with support from participating stakeholders; the Chamber will provide outreach/marketing support; the RDC will lead social media and digital marketing efforts; and Next Beverly Hills will provide social media and digital marketing support.

The City's in-kind contribution consists of an estimated \$33,585 for permit fees and \$80,785 in direct City costs that would be absorbed within the various City Departments' budgets for a total City cost of \$114,370.

This includes hourly personnel costs for Police, Fire and Public Works, equipment, deposits and permit fees.

The Total estimated cost is \$899,007down \$198,045 from last year.

Following the dance championship, a fundraising gala for Conga Kids will be held at The Conga Room in support of next year's countywide program.

Council Discusses Noise Ordinance

The City Council discussed an update on a previously approved policy to address "loud and unruly" gatherings in the Citv.

Approved in August 2017, the ordinance would "protect residents from excessive noise and public nuisance issues that negatively impact the neighborhoods during loud gatherings."



Hawthorne Celebrates '83 Reunion

The Hawthorne Class of 1983 celebrated their 35-year reunion last weekend at the home of Jennifer Simon Wooster. Hosts included Wooster, Wendy Brokaw Kretchmer, and Cameron Silver.

Previously there was no master permit for private parties in residential areas, nor were there special event permits in residential areas.

"Noise complaints remain the most common issues associated with parties," reads the staff report. "Many public nuisance issues and crimes regularly occur in the neighborhood where an unruly party takes place."

The report goes on to list several examples, such as loud noise or music that results in a violation of the noise regulation, obstruction of a street or other public

right of way, public intoxication or drinking in public, vandalism and littering of any trash on real property or on a public right of way.

Staff will present a formal presentation on the draft ordinance and fines in June.

VOTE NO ON BH

The BHUSD is once again asking Beverly Hills voters to approve the ultimate blank check—this time for \$385 million—to continue the district's poorly conceived and even more poorly executed construction plans.

Beverly Hills Weekly has published in detail the board majority's runaway legal expenses, in many cases totaling \$2 million or more per quarter. This is going to continue, unabated, if Beverly Hills voters approve this new bond.

The new bond includes no safeguards against using bond money for legal fees. In fact, the board recently filed a NEW lawsuit against Metro, as if their previous \$17 million on LLL (Lisa's Losing Lawsuits) was not a waste at all.

The good news is help is on the way. At least two new candidates have come forward to run for the Board of Education in November. Soon, this board majority, which has failed in almost everything they tried to do, will be of blessed memory. But until a board makes a policy that they aren't going to squander bond moneys on lawyers, we are not going to support a new bond. A bond is supposed to be for construction---not a lawyer's and lobbyist tax, which is exactly what the Measure E bond became.

Our Issue #474 editorial regarding Measure E, which is available on our website bhweekly.com, correctly pointed out at the time that it was a blank check which would not end well. Ten years later, we stand by what we wrote. To put it mildly, Measure E was a colossal failure. We urge Beverly Hills voters to not make the same foolish mistake again.

For those district parents who feel



coverstory A DAY IN THE LIFE OF THE WILSHIRE/LA CIENEGA SUBWAY STATION

The Weekly goes underground

THURSDAY, MAY 3, 2018

10:00 a.m. I arrive at the Metro office on Wilshire Boulevard at La Brea where I am greeted by LA Metro Communications Manager Dave Sotero and Skanska Traylor Shea Community Relations Coordinator Billy Parent.

10:10 a.m. As we enter a conference room to receive a safety briefing, I am handed a hard hat, neon yellow safety vest, goggles and gloves. For the briefing, I am reminded of the importance of wearing closed toed shoes, long-sleeved shirts and pants.

10:15 a.m. Several Metro employees enter the room to answer questions and provide background, one of whom includes Metro Construction Senior Manager and former miner Alex Mismas-who was around for the very first subway station in the early 1990's. I learn that Metro construction is separated into five phases, each of which varies in the amount of time it takes. Phase 1 is site preparation, which entails protecting

or relocating any underground utilities like power and water lines. Phase 1 generally requires temporary street closures and traffic detours around the work site.

Phase 2-which Dave tells me the Wilshire/La Cienega station just completed-consists of the installation of concrete decking. This allows traffic

to continue to flow while construction continues underneath. Essentially, vertical support piles are installed along the edges of the street and steel beams are installed across the construction area atop these piles, which makes room for concrete decking to go on top.

I learn that the La Cienega station is currently on Phase 3, which consists of removing the earth within the area that will eventually become the station box. Workers then install "shoring" along the edges of the excavation to support the ground around the station box. This phase will likely take about a year.

Once excavation is completed to the bottom of the station box. Phase 4 begins. This is where workers start construction of the inside of the station. Finally, Phase 5 entails removing the decking.

I am both confused and fascinated at the same time, hoping that seeing the construction site in action will bring the briefing to life.

10:45 a.m. Dave, Alex and I leave the office to drive to the La Cienega site. As we're in the elevator, I comment on how meticulous the process is. "We have to include every minor detail on the schedule," says Dave.

I follow Dave a couple miles to the Stinking Rose, where we park our cars. Once parked, Dave, Alex, and I gear up in our safety equipment and reconvene with Billy. We walk a few blocks to the excavation site, at which point I realize I forgot to put on my goggles. I hope silently that no one says anything.

11:00 a.m. At the La Cienega station, I am immediately able to identify the concrete decking and feel like a star pupil. However, I also notice a large silver tube peering into the construction box. Billy tells me this is a ventilation tube, which delivers clean air to the workers.

11:05 a.m. We walk around to the front of the site so that we're able to peer underneath the decking station. Billy tells me that they have excavated about 15 feet below ground thus far, but have about 65 feet to go.

11:15 a.m. As we continue to explore the site, I notice there are four giant barriers surrounding the site. I have an inkling of what this means, but I ask anyway. Billy says this is intended to contain the sound as much as possible so as not to disrupt neighboring buildings and apartments.

I also learn that the La Cienega station yielded a plethora of fossils, which Paleontologist Ashley Leger later elaborated on. She told me that even though the team expected to find fossils at the Wilshire/Fairfax station because of its close proximity to the La Brea tar pits, they were underwhelmed with the findings. The team had even included special provisions in the contract for the Fairfax stations assuming they would find "loads and loads" of fossils. At La Cienega, however, they found fossils from a wide variety of species including both ice age elephants (mammoths and mastodons), horse, bison and giant ground sloths. Leger says these are tens of thousands of years old.

When I asked Leger why she thinks so many fossils were uncovered at La Cienega she laughed, "Because mother nature has a sense of humor. There have been very little at Fairfax, but La Cienega is a treasure trove. We have no idea why, but we will take it."

Upon initial discovery, the fossils are first transported to a laboratory in Riverside where they are cleaned, prepped, photographed, and documented. Once the construction project is completed, Metro will accession all the fossils into one of two museums: the Los Angeles Natural History Museum and the La Brea Tar Pits Museum.

11:45 a.m. Following the tour, we returned to the parking lot at the Stinking Rose to return our gear and part ways. Alex tells Dave and I stories about his first-hand construction experience, including being involved in the very first Los Angeles subway, the Red Line. Alex says that safety techniques weren't nearly as thorough as they are now, pointing out that in the 1990's injuries and fatalities were much more common.

"It was a different world back then. I've seen things change a lot. The technology has changed; it's made the whole environment a lot safer. Still, with tunneling you have to watch your butt down there because you're the softest thing down there," said Alex.

With risk comes reward, though, and

Alex says he's supportive of the longterm impact Metro is in the process of marking. "It's something where I can say, 'Yeah I was proud of that. That is going to be here a hundred years from now."

The station is scheduled to open in 2023.




