Greystone Theater Opens; Preliminary Program Approved

At their evening meeting last week, the City Council approved a \$147,000 Preliminary Program and Budget request for the new Greystone Theater, which opened last Saturday with a staged reading of "Twelfth Night."

The budget request allocates funds for staffing, programming, operations and maintenance of the newly restored theater.

More specifically, \$70,000 will go toward programming. This includes paying performers, paying for movie rights, etc. \$150,000 will go toward operations. \$62,000 will go toward staffing. This includes a Program Operations Specialist and a Recreation Specialist, who will assist with events and operations.

Vice Mayor Lester Friedman inquired whether or not the staffing allocation meant hiring on new employees or adding hours to the current employees.

Assistant Director of Community Services Pam Shinault said that yes, the proposed plan requests allocating funds for hiring on new part-time staff, who would help with technical facility aspects, catering, and setting up/taking down for events.

With the new Greystone Theater opening this month, the program and event plan is designed to be a framework to start

The initial plan offers an amalgam of options like movie nights, lectures, theater and music events, and open houses. Staff intends on reaching out to groups in the coming months to help grow the number and types of programs offered at Greystone.

I think this is a wonderful addition to our community, truly a treasure, and probably the best-spent money for our community that will go for generations to come," said Councilmember Lili Bosse. "I'm very thrilled about it."

The approval covers funding through June.

Board Discusses Ongoing High School Construction

At a Study Session on January 23, the Board of Education discussed a master plan update for the Beverly High B3 and B4 buildings, which included construction costs projected at triple the original budget.

In a PowerPoint presentation, staff examined the current total budget estimate for construction of the little theater and performing arts area, subcontractor interest and cost containment. It also took a look at the markedly lower original 2016 cost estimate and what happened to create such a drastic disparity.

On September 30, 2016, the Board of Education received a cost estimate by Construction Manager CP O'Halloran of \$34.9 million. According to staff, this estimate which had been performed during the end of construction recession—was not based on drawings but instead on conceptual narrative as well as incomplete scope, and assumed a construction start of 2017.

The unidentified \$11.2 million scope didn't account for an additional 7,887 square foot increase, a soils report which indicated that contaminated soils be exported to a special site and clean soil to be imported, and unanticipated market conditions of 20 percent rather than the estimated 4.6 percent.

The presentation highlighted a sampling of unknowns encountered along the way, some of which included auditorium stem walls, ACM (asbestos-containing material) at tunnels under the auditorium and lobby area B3, hollow clay red block, north bridge demolition, exterior building signage and site improvements.

Staff therefore estimated that the total budget for B3-B4 construction ranges from \$99 million to \$105 million, which Mea-

sure BH, passed in 2018, would "sufficiently" cover.

But Measure BH wasn't always authorized to fund this project.

Board member Mel Spitz pointed out that in 2016 the Board had planned to initiate construction with Measure Y proceeds should it have passed.

At that time, Spitz and Board member Isabel Hacker voted against Measure Y, which was based on a plan he says was "hastily and impulsively developed."

Because the bond still passed 3-2 among the Board—with Board member Noah Margo and former Board members Lisa Korbatov and Howard Goldstein voting in favor—it required a 67 percent approval by voters.

The bond failed by a narrow margin, and ultimately would only have funded one third of the work on B3 and B4.

"Now, in retrospect, we can all thank our lucky stars that Measure Y failed," said Spitz. "In other words, it would have been a disaster of unimaginable consequence."

Chamber of Commerce Leadership PAC, BHPOA Announce Endorsements

The Board of Trustees of the City's Chamber of Commerce Leadership Political Action Committee (PAC) has endorsed Julian Gold and Lili Bosse for the upcoming March 3 municipal election. The BH-POA announced its endorsement for Bosse only.

In a press release, the PAC said it conducted one-on-one interviews with each candidate to learn about their positions on issues facing the business community and their vision for the future.

It also listed several priorities, including ensuring Beverly Hills remains a first class destination for visitors and businesses in light of the major construction projects occurring in the area and changes to the business landscape such as online retail; reducing the time and cost it takes to get approval for developments and opening businesses; attracting new and exciting businesses, including top notch cultural and food attractions; and enhancing nightlife in areas (such as the Golden Triangle) that will not adversely impact residents.

"Julian Gold and Lili Bosse have shown strong judgment, character and dedication in their time on the City Council," reads the statement. "Amongst other important achievements, both have shown dedication to key business issues, such as lowering parking requirements and fees, enhancing shopping after hours and considering ways to keep Beverly Hills relevant for the next generation. These actions in turn generate business revenue that supports the high quality of life that Beverly Hills residents enjoy."

The Beverly Hills Police Officers Association issued a statement commending Bosse's emphasis on community safety.

"Councilmember Bosse has always placed the safety of the citizens of Beverly Hills as a priority and we look forward to continuing to work with her and the council to make Beverly Hills the safest community," reads the statement.

City Request for Expedited Hearing Denied

The Los Angeles County Superior Court denied the City's request for an expedited hearing based on its allegation that voting equipment for the upcoming City Council election could be confusing to voters.

Last week's cover story "Ballot Battle" detailed the City's argument as to why a fifth candidate, incumbent Julian Gold, could be at a disadvantage for being on the second page of the ballot.

"We will continue the lawsuit and hope for a resolution before the November election," said City Attorney Larry Wiener.

City Highlights "Urgency" of Fuel Management Plan

As a response to the recent Los Angeles wildfires and an effort to be proactive, the City Council continued to discuss a proposed fuel management plan as a first step to reduce the fire risk in the areas north of Sunset Boulevard within the Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zone (VHFHSZ).

At their February 4 Study Session the Council reached consensus to immediately move forward with the fuel management plan. This "urgent" decision, they said, must prioritize not only public trees going forward, but also private trees--of which staff indicated up to 70 percent could be dangerous.

The Council also directed staff to send mailers notifying residents that progress is underway, meaning their own private trees could be examined.

"It is important to let the residents know that we are going to be addressing their private trees as well," said Councilmember Lili Bosse. "It is our job to educate people. We all love trees and we all love the greenery, but as soon as we hear that it's safety versus not, I think mostly everyone will come [around]."

The VHFHSZ designation by the California Department of Forestry and Fire Protection is based on data and models of potential fuels over a 30-50 year time horizon, their associated expected fire behavior and expected burn probabilities to quantify the likelihood and nature of vegetation fire exposure to buildings.

The Council's discussion follows a staff presentation on December 18 determining several types of trees known to have a higher flammability risk, 3,458 of which are located within public rights-of-way in the VHFHSZ. Such trees include Cedar, Cypress, Eucalyptus, Juniper, Palm and Pine trees.

In order to address the flammable trees, the report advocated for the removal of City trees along Carla Ridge that are "stressed, declining, exhibit poor branch architecture, or other maladies as well as other flammable tree species located in the VHFHSZ area."

It also advocated for breaking up continuous fuel chains that lead from wildlands to structures or even non-wildland edges of property to structures; and improving the safety of evacuation routes due to the

The Recreation and Parks Commission continued discussion on a comprehensive sign program for Beverly Gardens Park and opted to create an Ad Hoc Committee at their January 28 meeting.

The commissioners first expressed interest in such a program at their last meeting, the intention being to include use rules signs, directional/wayfinding signage, interpretive/historical information, vehicle or pedestrian information, cautionary signage, and other regulatory signs like "No Smoking."

They also indicated a desire to "augment the language" on a use rule sign and attract the attention of world-travelers by employing symbols. The proposed National Recreation Symbols includes 112 symbols and is considered an international pictographic language, therefore appealing to international visitors, said staff.

At their January 28 meeting, the commissioners discussed the next steps in developing the comprehensive sign plan. This includes evaluating the existing conditions by walking or photo/video documenting the site, creating the objectives of the sign plan, and considering the purpose and types and locations of the signs to be in the park.

Several concerns arose regarding the uniformity of rule signage clarity, and succinctness versus verbosity.

Commission Chair Julian Javor said that at a recent Mayor's Cabinet meeting, they considered the prospect of creating a "tourist-type event" where the QR codes were more present.

"For example, each block [would] almost be like a mini park in itself, but they also have their own historic components," said Javor, adding that the QR code could bring up photos on a map of what that area of the park used to look like. "That would make the parks an attraction to tourists who come into town, [if] all the hotels might be willing to provide this map."

He stressed that there is "a lot of opportunity" to create an informative signage theme for visitors, and then made motion to create an Ad Hoc Committee of two Recreation and Park commissioners.

"With the blessing of City Councill, [we'd] come up with not only a practical, rules-based signage scheme, but also something that creates more interest and more excitement about the parks," said Javor.

Assistant Director of Community Services Pam Shinault offered the following option in response-implementing an Ad Hoc Committee to identify the basic infrastructure, sharing that intel with the commission, and subsequently making a recommendation to the City Council Liaisons about where to further direct efforts.

The commission unanimously agreed with Shinault's suggestion and proceeded to approve an Ad Hoc Commission consisting of Javor and Commissioner Amie Sherry.

"The information our residents provide to the U.S. Census Bureau will help to ensure critical federal funding for important programs that truly make an impact in our community," said Mayor John Mirisch.

The Census is conducted every ten years and the data informs funding for programs such as early childhood education, senior nutritional programs and more. The data collected is also used to determine California's apportionment in the U.S. House of Representatives.

Beginning March 12, households will begin receiving official Census Bureau mail with information regarding how they can fill out the questionnaire. By April 1, which is known nationally as "Census Day," all homes will have received information about the Census.

Between April 8-16, the U.S. Census Bureau will begin delivering paper Census forms that can be filled out and mailed back. Beginning in May, U.S. Census Bureau representatives will begin visiting homes that have not responded. The last day to participate in the 2020 Census is July 31.

\$10,000 Reward for Information Leading to Recovery of LA Library Sculpture

A reward of up to \$10,000 is being offered to anyone with information leading to the recovery of sections of the long-lost sculpture, "Well of the Scribes," which disappeared from the Los Angeles Public Library's Central Library 50 years ago. The 1926 bronze fountain went missing from the Central Library in the 1960's when the West Lawn was razed for a parking lot. The sculpture's fate was unknown until last year, when a section was discovered in Arizona.

Alta magazine and its publisher William R. Hearst III, in collaboration with the Los Angeles Public Library, have announced a reward for information leading to the return of the Well's other three pieces. Anyone with information should contact Alta magazine at tips@altaonline.com.

The mystery of the missing sculpture first captured the imagination of Susan Orlean, who wrote about it in her 2018 bestseller, The Library Book. Prompted by the book, Alta managing editor Blaise Zerega assigned journalist Brandon Reynolds to chronicle the Well's disappearance and theories about its fate. When the article was published in July 2019, the sculpture was still nowhere to be found.

Meanwhile, an antiques dealer, Floyd Lillard, in Bisbee, AZ, knew for years that he had acquired something special. Lillard would conduct occasional Google searches to help him identify the object in his possession. Shortly after the Alta magazine article was published, Lillard's Google search yielded the image he had been waiting a decade for, and he immediately recognized it. He had a section of the Well of the Scribes.

Lillard contacted Alta magazine and Los

Angeles City Librarian John F. Szabo with the news that he had one of four pieces of the sculpture. Szabo traveled to Bisbee, met Lillard, and verified it as a portion of the Well of the Scribes. On October 4, 2019, the section of the bronze was returned to its rightful home, and unveiled at a press conference at the Central Library.

The search for the rest of the Well intensified. Alta magazine hired a private investigator, who tracked down several promising leads. Although these efforts did not lead to the missing sections, the investigation is ongoing.

Not to be deterred, Alta magazine, in collaboration with the Los Angeles Public Library, is asking for the public's help and offering a reward of up to \$10,000 to anyone who provides information leading to the recovery of one or more of the missing pieces.

The Well of the Scribes was designed by artist Lee Lawrie, the artist responsible for the many sculptural embellishments adorning the historic Central Library building and its grounds. The semi-circular bronze sculpture formed a basin that greeted visitors at the entrance to the gardens, which faced the library.

Rendered in a subtly detailed relief, the sculpture's design featured three sections: a Pegasus, symbolizing inspiration, flanked on each side by a procession of elegantly detailed figures representing scribes from eastern and western cultures, and a spout located above the pool. The basin graced the gardens from the library's opening in 1926 until 1969 when the gardens were paved over and the sculpture disappeared.

Why are you running for City Council?

Julian Gold: I think the City is at a very important moment in time. We have change that is going to happen on our west border, we have a subway on the east border and changes in the triangle, we have retail, which is under stress by online shopping. I think it is going to take seasoned leadership to get us through this with as little turmoil as possible, and to create the Next Beverly Hills. This is our opportunity to create the future of Beverly Hills. I think that I have the skillset to be able to make that happen.

Lori Greene Gordon: It's time for a change in our city. I'm a 50-year resident, alumna of our schools, former PTA mom, businesswoman, and member (and past Chair) of the Beverly Hills Planning Commission. My background gives me the experience, knowledge, and ability to bring a new voice to city council. The City Council manages hundreds of millions of dollars of public money and property, yet not one sitting Councilmember has any experience running a business. I have my MBA from the Anderson School of Management at UCLA and have worked in both sales and commercial real estate for nearly 40 years. I will bring a much-needed thoughtful, fiscally responsible perspective to city council

Robin Rowe: One, because I was asked. I've been on the Beverly Hills Technology Committee since 2016. Two city council members urged me to run for office in this election. I won't name who because I don't seek endorsements. And, I don't accept campaign contributions either. That's to avoid an expecta-

tion that I will be reciprocating with favors later, after I'm in office.

Another reason for me to run is because the city council needs a technologist, someone who expects to operate at the speed of Moore's Law. High tech, driven by Moore's Law, improves every 18 months. The city takes a decade of longer to produce changes.

In December, the city council passed an "urgent" resolution to amend a zoning regulation that has been driving restaurants out of Beverly Hills. On the eve of an election, change became urgent, but that law was from 1974. Not ten years. It took our city council 45 years to fix an obvious problem. The incumbents said during the recent Beverly Hills Chamber candidate forum that maybe they should revisit other laws of that era. You think? The city is learning the hard way from avoidable mistakes. Problems that would have been prevented had a technologist been in the room.

Simchah Green: I am a candidate because I want to represent the majority of residents of Beverly Hills who are of the Jewish faith while at the same time being very concerned for the minority non-Jewish population. Since there are nine orthodox synagogues in Beverly Hills and only two non-orthodox I shall speak out on behalf of the majority but will be respectful to the minority non- orthodox as well. There has never been a request from a Beverly Hills synagogue that the council has turned down because there has never been a request. The synagogues don't realize that they can make such requests. Thecityattorneydoesnotunderstandwhat the separation of church and state means. I shall succeed in teaching him what the law really is.

I addition I am the only candidate running on a platform of medical marijuana to be permitted in all forms in our city which presently limits it to delivery only. The majority of Beverly Hills residents agree with my position. If they come out and vote for me we will both win.

If elected, what do you hope to accomplish?

LB: There are many things I hope to accomplish, but my essential, constant goals on the Council are always to protect our quality of life, ensure our financial stability and enhance our safety and security. I also want to continue my efforts towards making Beverly Hills the most transparent City anywhere. I believe that our future success will depend on how open and inclusive we are dealing with the important issues on our agenda. I will work to make sure that the extensive public process of developing a new vision for La Cienega Park will result in a plan our community will be proud of and benefit from for generations to come. I will work with our community as we look at our current multi-family zoning requirements and decide together how we can best meet our future needs. I recently spearheaded a pro-active Council effort to re-visit our commercial parking codes with the goal of creative solutions for all our stakeholders. I will continue my work to mitigate disruption caused by subway construction and also to make sure that we secure appropriate, safe subway stations at the end of this process.

JG: Apart from being a wonderful place to live-which, as residents, we all absolutely appreciate-we have to recognize that we are an international destination in part because of that quality of life. But becoming an international destination is in part what created that quality of life; the two go hand in hand. The reason we have the services we do at the levels we do is because the City revenues are where they are and half of them come from tourism, visitors, hotels and restaurants. I want that to continue. But the question is, in an environment where retail is under pressure, what do we replace it with? I think we can be creative with that. I think retail will be here forever, but I also think we have to evolve. In evolving, we have to recognize the experiential element of shopping and dining today and how we're going to get there. We need to find ways to make being on Beverly Hills, being on Rodeo Drive, being in any of our communities an experience. We have to be respectful of our past, but we also have to be mindful of our future. That's what the challenge for this next Council is going to be, and I think we need to have seasoned leadership to get us there.

LGG: I have many goals that relate to my desire to have our Council be more responsive to the needs of all of our residents. These include Prioritizing relief for cut-through traffic that is plaguing our residential neighborhoods; providing free parking after 6:00 p.m. to residents visiting our business districts; encouraging smart development, both residential and commercial, that makes Beverly Hills more accessible to all (especially young families and seniors); supporting new businesses and new business models to help keep retail vital; increasing and/or eliminating certain fees relating to residential parking, waste removal, and water; re-imagining Beverly Hills as a charitable community, rather than an excessive one.

RR: Housing. Beverly Hills is anticipating that the state will pass a law requiring we build more affordable housing. To build over 3,000 units. With so little undeveloped land here, there

is nowhere to build but up. Transportation. A new skyway connecting the Rodeo Drive subway stop to the rest of the businesses in Beverly Hills. More public transportation cuts pollution and alleviates traffic and parking congestion. Tourism. The Beverly Hills Skyway will be a tourist attraction, a way to see the city. Quiet enjoyment. That's the experience that residents hope for living in Beverly Hills. I will restrict leaf blowers, which are noisy and smelly. The landlords and landscape crews causing this problem are not residents, do not listen when residents ask them to stop. Clean streets. I will have a crew keep our streets spotless, like Disneyland. Air pollution. Some areas of Beverly Hills have twice as much air pollution as others. I've done the Walk with the Mayor for years. I currently walk with the Beverly Hills Walkers, meeting at the park on Mondays. Walking is supposed to be healthy, but it's not great to exercise in air pollution. None of the incumbents are talking about fixing this. There's much the city can do to cut pollution using technology. Health care. While I was walking with the Beverly Hills Walkers, a woman felt unwell and had to turn back. Everyone was very concerned. The woman refused to have an ambulance called. Someone said she didn't think the woman had health insurance. An ambulance trip in Beverly Hills costs \$1,800. Beverly Hills has a Senior & Disabled Bus Service. Mainly used to take vulnerable patients to their doctor. Putting sick people together on a bus, to have them sit together in a hospital waiting room, spreads contagious diseases. I will expand the Nurse Practitioner program. Check patients at home for infectious diseases. Avoid getting more people sick. Community Access Television. I'm a community access TV success story. Producing a dance documentary with a community access station led to me being hired as a technical director for television broadcast news at NBC. I will have the city hire a community access director dedicated to supporting community access. Increase the use of our TV studio without adding to the workload of our government channel crew. Better budgets. Beverly Hills has \$255M in unfunded pension liabilities, plus \$109M in retiree medical. At a recent city council session, it was mentioned there is an \$18M overrun in the current budget. Nobody seemed concerned. In fact, the council asked that the budget be tweaked to shift funds earmarked for specific projects back into the general fund. That would make overruns less obvious.

Why should someone vote for you?

LB: We are entering an important new decade in the history of Beverly Hills - one that will be full of amazing opportunities, as well as some serious challenges. We have had years where just maintaining the status quo was enough in the life of our City—2020 is not one of those years. Now, more than ever, we

need positive, effective leaders who are willing to listen, be creative, and think out of the box. Some time ago, I initiated my Healthy City Program - Healthy People, Healthy Economy, Healthy Government. I never make a decision without asking myself, "Will this benefit the health of our City?" My energy and enthusiasm for the job fire me up every day. I am grateful that our community and my colleagues have recognized my work ethic and level of preparation on the Council. In every election cycle, candidates are often labeled 'pro-resident' or 'pro-business'-the only label that works for me is PRO BEVERLY HILLS!!

ORDINANCE NO. 20-O-2799

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEV-ERLY HILLS AMENDING THE BEVERLY HILLS MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING COMMISSION RULES OF PROCEDURE

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS DOES OR-DAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City Council hereby amends and restates Section 2-2-107 (A) of Article 1 ("General Provisions") of Chapter 2 ("COM-MISSIONS AND COMMITTEES") of Title 2 ("ADMINISTRATION, PERSONNEL, AND PROCEDURES") of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code to read as follows:

A. The City Council shall adopt rules of conduct and procedure for all Commissions.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance for any reason is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council hereby declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, sentences, clauses, phrases, or portions thereof be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Publication.</u> The City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation published and circulated in the city within fifteen (15) days after its passage in accordance with Section 36933 of the Government Code, shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause this Ordinance and the City Clerk's certification, together with proof of publication, to be entered in the Book of Ordinances of the Council of this city.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Effective Date.</u> This Ordinance shall go into effect and be in full force and effect at 12:01 a.m. on the thirty-first (31st) day after its passage.

ORDINANCE NO. 20-O-2800

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS EXTENDING INTERIM ORDINANCE NO. 19-0-2797 PROHIBITING RESIDEN-

TIAL DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS THAT

FAIL TO COMPLY WITH INCLUSIONARY HOUSING REQUIREMENTS AND CERTAIN PUBLIC NOTICING REQUIREMENTS, AND DECLARING THE URGENCY THEREOF

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEV-ERLY HILLS HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOL-LOWS:

Section 1. Legislative Findings.

The City Council of the City of Beverly Hills finds and determines that the City, along with other large real estate markets throughout the state, is facing a housing supply crisis. As the demand for housing continues to exceed avail-able housing units, the City's housing market is becoming increasingly expensive, jeopardizing residents' ability to find and retain affordable housing. Continued residential development that does not meaningfully address the City's affordable housing needs threatens to deplete existing affordable housing resources, compounding residents' housing difficulties and exacerbating the statewide housing emergency recently declared by the California Legislature. The ongoing loss of affordable housing units would create significant risk to the public health, safety, and general welfare of the City. As such, the City Council wishes to consider enacting permanent ordinances to provide affordable housing units in the City, including by the creation of an inclusionary housing program.

Because the public process of adopting these ordinances may be lengthy, and to prevent the depletion of existing affordable housing resources in the intervening period, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 19-O-2797, an interim ordinance that took effect immediately on December 17, 2019, (the "Interim Ordinance"). The Interim Ordinance changes several provisions of the municipal code related to housing development, including by estab-lishing an inclusionary housing requirement for projects with five or more housing units, providing an in-lieu fee for projects with between five and ten housing units, and requiring afford-ability restrictions for certain projects. Projects that enter into a development agreement with the City are exempted from these inclusionary housing regulations. To facilitate community awareness of development projects undertaken pursuant to these new regulations, the In-terim Ordinance also changes public noticing requirements, including by requiring that (1) adjacent neighbor mailed notice be given to all properties within 100 feet of project sites in single-family, multi-family, and commercial-transition zones, and (2) neighborhood meetings be held for any proposed projects located in a multi-family zone or a commercial-residential transition area, with standard mailed notice sent to all owners and residential occupants within 1,000 feet plus block-fact of a potential project site.

Section 2. Authority.

Pursuant to Government Code Section 65858, the City Council may adopt, as an urgency measure, an interim ordinance that prohibits any uses that may be in conflict with a contemplated zoning proposal that the City Council is considering, studying, or intends to study within a reasonable period of time. After public notice, the City Council may extend the interim ordinance by a period of ten (10) months and fifteen (15) days, pursuant to Government Code Section 65858. Notice of the public hearing at which the City Council considered adopting this extension ordinance was duly published on January 3, 2020 in the *Beverly Hills Courier*, and on January 9, 2020 in the *Beverly Hills*

Section 3. Urgency Findings.

The City Council finds and determines that failing to implement immediate changes to its housing development and public noticing requirements would result in an immediate threat to the public health, safety, and general welfare. As described in Section 1, the City faces a housing supply crisis that jeopardizes the provision and maintenance of affordable housing units. The continued development of market-rate housing that is not affordable to the vast majority of the community and surrounding areas, without an inclusionary housing ordinance, will exacerbate the demand for affordable housing. Such demand threatens many residents' ability to find and maintain housing, and thus places the public health, safety, and general welfare at risk during the Council's review and consideration of permanent regulations. Enhanced public noticing of new housing development projects is necessary to facilitate active public participation in land use decisions and ensure that new developments address the City's urgent affordable housing needs. To preserve the public health, safety, and general welfare, the City Council declares it necessary that this Ordinance take immediate effect to prevent these harms.

Section 4. CEQA Findings.

The City Council hereby finds that it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the adoption and implementation of the Interim Ordinance or extension thereof may have a significant effect on the environment. This extension of the Interim Ordinance does not authorize construction and, in fact, imposes greater restrictions on certain developments in order to protect the public health, safety, and general welfare. This extension is therefore exempt from the environmental review requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations.

Section 5. Severability.

If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or place, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall be and remain in fully force and effect..

Section 6. <u>Approval and Extension of Ordinance.</u>

This Ordinance, adopted as an urgency measure for the immediate protection of the public safety, health, and general welfare, containing a declaration of the facts constituting the urgency, and passed by a minimum four-fifths (4/5) vote of the City Council, shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and shall amend and extend the effect of the Interim Ordinance for a period of ten (10) months and fifteen (15) days. After notice pursuant to Section 65090 of the California Government Code and public hearing, the City Council may extend the effectiveness of the Interim Ordinance for an additional one year period, as provided in Government Code Section 65858. This Ordinance is extended with the following amendment:

Ordinance No. 19-O-2797, Section 4, Paragraph 3 A. is amended as follows:

"A. This section shall apply to all residential developments, as defined herein, where the lots or units will be offered for sale or for rent, and when the development application or applications for the residential development is deemed complete after the effective date of this ordinance, except that the pending project 457 N. Oakhurst is not subject to the inclusionary housing requirements of the Ordinance so long as it is deemed complete within 120 days from the date of adoption of Ordinance No. 20-O-2800."

Section 7. Publication.

The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause this Ordinance and her certification, together with proof of publication, to be entered in the Book of Ordinances of the Council of this City.
