BHPD Captain Exposed to Coronavirus, Tests Negative

Beverly Hills Police Captain Mike Hill was exposed to coronavirus, according to several tweets by his daughter former Rep. Katie Hill (D-Santa Clarita). Mike Hill later said in an email Tuesday he had tested negative for the virus.

Katie Hill wrote a series of tweets that said her father discovered Saturday that he had been in close contact with some-



one who tested positive for the virus. She said that she's experiencing the virus' symptoms, and might have been exposed to it through her father or someone else.

According to Hill, she has shortness

breath, a fever and a dry cough. Mike Hill later sent an email to police department staff Tuesday that said he never developed a fever and likely had a minor case of the

"In order to alleviate some of the anxiety and stress that came as a result of my exposure, I am happy to report that I tested "negative" for COVID-19," Hill said.

Restaurants In Crisis

Beverly Hills restaurants are struggling to get by after being forced to close their doors and serve take-out only during the coronavirus quarantine.

Porta Via Beverly Hills, a bistro and bar on 424 North Canon Drive, has been serving only take-out after Beverly Hills City Council restricted restaurants to togo orders last week to prevent the spread

of coronavirus. Most other local restaurants, including Piccolo Paradiso, Anarbagh and Chin Chin Beverly Hills, have had to do the same.

Gar-Peter land. Porta Via's owner, said that busi-

ness has reduced by 95% and that he's had to let go of about 90% of his staff.

"Business is terrible, we've obviously had to shut our doors," Garland said. "There's limited people who need food in the neighborhood."

Porta Via, which first opened 25 years ago, was originally focused on take-out and catering before turning its focus more on being a restaurant where customers could dine. Garland said that with the new

restrictions on restaurants, it's been like going back to their roots. But it's been a struggle, he said.

Garland said Porta Via is doing what it must to get by. On top of offering take-out and delivery, it also started curbside pickups and delivering groceries from local farmers and vendors to customers.

"We didn't open a restaurant to solely do food to-go and delivery," Garland said. "We have nearly 4,000 square feet of space here seating 100 people and we can't seat one person."

A new location for Porta Via was originally set to open in Calabasas and is currently under construction. The opening has since been pushed back to an unknown date, since restaurants haven't been told when they'll be able to re-open their doors

Garland said that they've seen an increase in take-out orders recently, after marketing themselves to the community. He said that the best way for the community to help out would be to order take-out.

"It's a dire situation for all restaurants and for most of them, the idea of doing take-out and delivery is fool's gold," Garland said. "There's nothing at the end of the tunnel."

Chamber of Commerce Makes Requests To Assist Businesses

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Council that would assist small businesses in the city, which the council will consider in the future.

In a letter to the council, the Chamber of Commerce asked for the council to temporarily suspend or terminate City fees for businesses, offer city financed loans or

grants for small businesses, enhance partnership with the **Small Business** Development Center, allow restaurants to convert to popup markets and relax signage limitations on certain businesses for ad-

vertisements.

The letter is in response to several businesses in Beverly Hills closing after the council issued ordinances on March 16 that required non-essential businesses to close and restricted restaurants to take-out orders. Since the closures and restrictions, several businesses have reported severe drops in revenue and many have had to let go of their employees.

Chamber of Commerce President Todd Johnson said in his letter that there have been numerous reports of layoffs and businesses that are down to zero revenue.

"As this continues, business owners and employees will find themselves in increasingly desperate circumstances and we have received increasing inquiries about what can be done to help," Johnson said. "It is imperative that we support our businesses, which it is estimated provide upwards of 70 percent of General Fund revenue."

Its request for temporary suspensions or cancellations on city fees for businesses include refunds on business license fees for 2020, building permit fees where work can't continue because of COVID-19, the city's portion of the 2020 sales tax, the city's portion of the 2020 real property tax, rental tax fees for residential and commercial properties and outdoor dining

It's also asking for the city to suspend future license fees until the virus passes and to waive water and trash fees for closed businesses.

Another request made by the Chamber is for city financed loans, which the Chamber recommends the city implements by setting aside up to 10 percent of the City's General Fund for businesses with up to \$20 million in revenue in Beverly Hills.

How Are Moms Coping With the Lockdown?

Mothers of school-aged children shared their tips and tricks for being crammed indoors with their kids during the coronavirus quarantine.

Leah Yebri, a mom of four, said that she's doing her best to maintain a schedule to keep structure in her children's lives while they can't go to school. Her children are six, five, two and 11 months old respectively.

When her children aren't having virtual classes on Zoom in lieu of going to school, they play games in their backyard, do arts & crafts, read new books, finish learning exercises from workbooks she bought for them and watch educational programs on television.

Yebri said it's important to have a relaxed schedule, rather than a rigid one that's hard to maintain.

"I think if it keeps moms sane, it has to be a relaxed schedule so if you don't follow it by the hour, you don't stress about it," Yebri said.

Her band, Sam, and her take turns watching the

kids to maintain a healthy balance. When her kids do have television time, Yebri said that she makes sure she uses that time to relax with them rather than finishing other errands.

"I try to make sure that I am also sitting at that time, rather than running around trying to make breakfast, lunch or dinner," Yebri said.

Yebri is a real estate broker, but took time off when

she had her youngest child 11 months ago. She said she'd been planning to restart her business before the quarantine happened, which put her plans on hold.

She said that she is trying to keep some normalcy in her children's lives during this period, and recommends for others to do the same by keeping their children active and doing exercise.

Dena Cohen, a mother of three, is also trying to maintain as much normalcy for her children as she can. Her children are 13, seven and five years old respectively.

Cohen has kept up a schedule for her children so that they have a consistent wake-up time, get dressed like they normally would, have exercise and do their class assignments. Her children love to use an app called "Go Noodle" to have exercise by dancing, something Cohen recommends to other moms.

"I actually think [a schedule] is the key to keeping everybody behaving nicely and just keeping some sort of normalcy in this crazy time," Cohen said.

Prior to quarantine, Cohen wanted her children to spend their time with outdoor activities so she restricted their technology access during weekdays. Now, she lets her kids use educational apps to help them with learning, such as Freckle, Epic and Teach Your Monster to Read.

"I'm definitely more lenient because

I know that there are some really great educational apps and programs out there that the kids use in school that we're able to access through the class codes or the teacher," Cohen said.

Her eldest daughter, Sofia, is a ballerina who has been taking virtual ballet classes while her usual classes are canceled. She's also been speaking on the phone with her Bat Mitzvah tutor to prepare for her Bat Mitzvah celebration in June, even though Cohen isn't sure if the quarantine will last until then.

"I feel like this has been a time for people to really come together and try to be very supportive, understanding and gen-

erous with their time," Cohen

She said that she thinks they'll start doing more activities as a family and try to make the best out of the current situation. They've been playing board games and card games together in the evenings, like Monopoly and

With social distancing, Cohen said that she's fortunate to have a network of friends Horace Mann School to talk with and that it's im-

portant to maintain relationships even though you can't see people in person.

"We're in contact all day long and we're constantly giving each other feedback, but also just some humor in the midst of all this and updates of what's going on," Co-

Cohen is a party planner and is figuring out ways to continue her business during the quarantine, for instance making content that describes how to plan at-home birthday parties.

Her husband Steve's 50th birthday was Sunday, and they were originally supposed to go out of town to celebrate. Cohen was trying to figure out ways to have a virtual party, with her friends' husbands attending through Zoom, in order to make the day special for him despite the fact that they can't have a party.

"I think everyone's just trying to make the best of this crazy situation, which is [that] we just want to keep everybody safe and we want to keep our distance," Cohen said. "I don't think it's very smart that people are out there right now, not paying attention to what the news is saying."

Horace Mann's New Roof Completed

The BHUSD Board of Education approved the additional \$75K it cost to complete re-roofing Horace Mann School in its Tuesday meeting, which made the total cost for the project almost \$1.8 million.

The BHUSD awarded the school a "Re-Roof Project" in its April 9, 2019 meeting, which estimated that it would cost \$1,750,000 to repair and replace the school's roof. The old roof had termite damage, among several other issues that meant it was in need of repair.

Construction involved priming and



painting existing vent stacks and chimneys, replacing termite damaged roof sheathing, removing and replacing deteriorated counter-flashing and backing, replacing stucco and more. The project ended up costing more than estimated, with an additional \$75,374.79 needed to provide all the labor and material necessary to complete it.

The project's estimated final total is almost \$1.8 million, which the board approved and confirmed that the project had been completed in its Tuesday meeting.

Shading Coming to Beverly Vista and Horace Mann

The BHUSD Board of Education approved the installation of additional shading structures at Beverly Vista and Horace Mann School Tuesday, which is anticipated to cost the district almost \$200K.

Beverly Vista and Horace Mann School require additional shaded areas as a result of the increased number of students attending both schools after the district's reconfiguration. The installation for Beverly Vista is estimated to cost \$177,634.35 and the installation for Horace Mann is

through March 31. The decision was made following guidance from state and local health officials to limit the spread of coronavirus and encourage social distancing. Due dates for borrowed materials are automatically extended, no late fines will be assessed, and customers can return materials when the library reopens.

Library Director Skye Patrick said this is a challenging time for the entire Los Angeles County community and they are dedicated to keeping residents and staff as safe as possible. Patrick said they realize that many members of the community still depend on the library to access free materials, especially when schools and workplaces are closed. She said she believes this solution helps promote social distancing while still providing access to their resources at a time when many resources are limited.

Designated locations will offer holds pick-up beginning March 17. The closest library to Beverly Hills is the Culver City Julian Dixon Library at 4975 Overland Ave, Culver City, CA 90230. Its phone number is (310) 559-1676. As more locations are identified and added, they will be posted at LACountyLibrary.org/coro-

Customers who have existing holds at an LA County Library location that is not listed will have to call their local library sometime Monday through Friday, 9 am to 6 pm, to have a hold transferred to a location that has an operational lobby in order to pick up.

City Council Will Consider Labor Agreements at March 31 Meeting

The Beverly Hills City Council will consider the memorandum of understanding with the Police Officers Association and Police Management Association at its Tuesday, March 31 meeting.

In accordance with state law, the City of Beverly Hills participates in labor negotiations with its employee associations. The results of the negotiations process are written agreements or contracts reached between the City and the City employee associations. These agreements are commonly referred to as MOUs.

The MOUs have been ratified by each of the employee associations and are subject to the adoption of the City Council on March 31. Negotiations with the groups were completed in the middle of February. The proposed MOUs cover salaries and benefits for a three and a half-year period for both associations.

Property Tax Late Penalty Can Be Canceled

Los Angeles County property owners affected by the COVID-19 virus may have late penalties cancelled if they are unable to pay their property taxes by the April 10 deadline, according to Treasurer and Tax Collector Keith Knox.

Knox said in a statement that the April 10 deadline cannot be extended, as outlined by State Law.

"However beginning on the day after property taxes are due, people unable to

pay on time for reasons related to COVID-19 may submit a request for penalty cancellation online," he said.

so, as the revenue helps keep the government running and provides services to the public.

There can be no in-person payments since county buildings are closed, instead payments must be done online, via telephone or by mail. Online credit/debit card transactions will be charged a 2.25% service fee and there is no charge for eChecks.



Request for renewal of a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) to allow the continued operation of a public dining facility in a nonconforming hotel, a Development Plan Review (DPR) to allow open air dining, and an Extended Hours Permit (EHP) to allow restaurant and open air dining

during extended hours at 469 N. Doheny Drive. The project site is in the Multiple Residential Zone



This is to give notice that the Director of Community Development is considering:

A request to renew a CUP, DPR, and EHP pursuant to Planning Commission Resolution No. $\dot{1}789$ to allow the continued operation of the public restaurant and open air dining with extended hours associated with the Beverly Terrace Hotel located at 469 North **Doheny Drive**

On October 13, 2016, the Planning Commission approved Resolution No. 1789 approving a CUP, DPR, and EHP to allow a public dining facility with open air dining and extended hours within a nonconforming hotel,. The indoor restaurant has 32 seats in approximately 475 square feet, and the outdoor dining area has 42 seats in approximately 515 square feet. The restaurant receives patrons between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 11:00 P.M. daily, with all patrons leaving by midnight. The proposed project involves a request to renew these entitlements, without any modifications, for a three-year term. This would allow the continued operation of the public restaurant and open air dining with extended hours associated with the Beverly Terrace Hotel. Pursuant to Resolution No. 1789, the aforementioned entitlements are set to expire unless they are renewed.

This project has been assessed in accordance with the authority and criteria contained in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA, Public Resources Code Sections 21000 et seq.), the State CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Sections 15000 et seq.), and the environmental regulations of the City. Upon review, the project appears to qualify for a Class 1 Categorical Exemption (Existing Facilities) in accordance with the requirements of Section 15301 of the state CEQA Guidelines.

In evaluating the request for renewal, any written comments received by the City within twenty (20) days of the date of this notice will be considered. Please note that any communication received by the City becomes part of the public record. The Applicant's request for renewal may be approved if the reviewing authority finds that the public restaurant and open air dining area have complied with all conditions outlined in Resolution No. 1789 and with all other applicable Beverly Hills Municipal Code regulations.

You will be notified by mail of the City's decision on this matter. Plans of the proposed project and application are available for review at the Beverly Hills Department of Community Development, Planning Division. How is an online education going to be implemented for BHUSD students?

What are BHUSD's expectations of students going to be in their online classes, in regards to things like assignments and grades?

Basically, what we [already] did if a student were to be away from school kind of like an independent study model in the sense that at minimum students will receive an hour of instruction, whether that be curriculum, or YouTube videos, or face to face Google Hangouts with the teacher. [It'll be at least] one hour per subject per week.

Families can expect five plus hours of work, depending on how many classes a student is enrolled in, [and] to be able to help with independent reading. We have a lot of resources too for open educational resources, to be able to supplement [lessons]. Grading will still proceed as normal.

We are still continuing the usual, outside of the fact that students will be learning at home versus in the brick and

Can you elaborate specifically on what kind of resources students are going to be using?

We actually are very fortunate that our Board of Education and our Ed-Tech is very robust in BHUSD. Our students have already had access to things like Mystery Science, which is an online science component where it walks [students] through different types of labs and different types of tutorials, to Accelerated Reader to help them be able to read and build vocabulary. So we've had a lot of opportunities already ... We leverage Khan Academy.

We have already been leveraging a lot of the tech tools. The learning curve isn't huge for our staff or our students – a lot of them have already had access [to them]. [Online tools] like Naviance for the college search process, there's a lot of activities through Naviance that our students in high school can use to still continue their post-secondary options, finding career clusters.

For younger children who may not be as used to having to do all of their homework on the internet, how is BHUSD planning on helping them bridge that gap?

We'll be emailing, for our younger students, directly with [parents]. But our [students] have had access to a device from Kindergarten up. Our pre-K through second grade have already had access to an iPad and so they are familiar with logging into some of our systems that we have used to be able to help differentiate curriculum in the classroom now it'll just be at home. Many teachers will communicate directly with parents [about] the assignments and the expec-

tations, so that way the parents can help track and monitor the younger students. But as far as the technology goes, our younger students have already had access to that.

How is BHUSD helping students during shutdown, in the terms of offering school lunches and other forms of support?

We'll also be sending out a list of resources, like around mental health ... Any cioeconomic need, we will be able to provide them with a free lunch.

Technology as well – if a student has a need to access [technology] and doesn't have a data plan or doesn't have the internet, there will be communication where they can reach directly out ... to be able to help bridge that gap. Also, we'll be releasing any student that doesn't have a home device or doesn't already have a BHUSD device because if you recall we're already one to one. That's another obstacle that we don't have to climb over, that other districts are faced with. If they need additional devices or any of that, they can also pick that up at Horace Mann between that 10:30 and 12 pm window. We'll be doing curbsides, so


[if] the students are actually coming out to the campus, we'll come directly up to the car and meet them at the car.

Now that parents are going to have to play a more hands-on role in their children's education, how can they play a part in motivating them with

their lessons? Can you give specific tips on that?

One of the resources we'll be sending out is just a graphic organizer to help the parents organize time - it's kind of a weekly organizer so when staff releases information to the student and/or the parent depending on the grade-band, they can graph out and chart to keep them on track. not only the parent organized, but the student organized as

well. Then obviously, a lot of the open educational resources we are sending are gamified, meaning they're a little bit more fun and a little bit more engaging than just sitting and reading sometimes. We want to leverage those as well, so an example would be Mystery Science and being able to plug the student into Mystery Science and it's a little more engaging and kind of game-like where we kind of trick them into learning. So that's something to help with that engagement piece. Plus, we are leveraging our library resources. If you look at the Beverly Hills Library, they offer robust opportunities, as well.

What do you think the psychological impacts of this pandemic are going to be?

I think the thing that I've been thinking about the most is stress. Stress can be different for different people. But I think that there's a lot of very practical stress that's impacting people's lives, in terms of all the scrambling that everybody's having to do to arrange for childcare or set up some alternative arrangements with their employer or manage their business or whatever it might be that is important for them to do, that's being disrupted... I think there's a level of collective stress that everybody seems to be feeling right now. Whether it's waiting in the grocery store line or sensing it from all of the news that is continually going on. So I think everybody is just really stressed. That can have all sorts of negative consequences just in and of itself.

That's the first thing that comes to mind. Obviously, there are very practical implications for people, [that are] financial and all that sort of thing. But in terms of the mental state, I think, its first and foremost stress.

What are some negative ways that you've seen people coping with a crisis like this?

Well, I wouldn't say that I have observed it myself because I think we're still pretty new into this. But I do know that everyone has coping mechanisms for handling stress. Sometimes we have positive coping mechanisms and we're able to do them, like for example, getting some extra exercise or meditating or going to the spa or however you're sort of "healthy, taking care of yourself" strategies are. But sometimes we also have coping strategies that aren't helpful. They seem to be solving a problem, but they're not really solving a problem. For example, having that extra drink to unwind after a stressful day or zoning out through online gaming, or comfort food eating, those are all efforts to try to soothe ourselves when we're stressed but obviously, they can lead to unhealthy consequences. So I think when the stress goes up, the risk of people relying on unanisms increases.

I think that interpersonally among family members, for example, suddenly children are at home. Parents may need

to be at home with the children and [they] may find themselves being very short with their kids or speaking to them in a tone that they don't normally use or don't want to use because they're just so stressed... Then what happens, is the parents start to feel like, "Oh, I'm a bad parent because I'm snapping at my child because I'm just trying to juggle all this," or they begin quarreling with their spouse. In extreme cases, those elements will spiral to really bad outcomes. I mean, much, people becoming violent, interpersonal violence, kids

CORONAVIRUS CRISIS CONTINUES

Beverly Hills Businesses, Schools and Residents Under Los Angeles-Area Quarantine

Beverly Hills adjusted to its new reality under the coronavirus quarantine this week, with schools, City Hall and non-essential businesses closed, restaurants taking only to-go orders and residents stuck

There have been 13 deaths and 799 cases of coronavirus in Los Angeles County as of Wednesday. According to LA County Public Health, 13 of the 799 confirmed cases are Beverly Hills residents.

The city declared the pandemic a local emergency last week, which resulted in non-essential businesses being required to close. Restaurants have been permitted to remain open but can only accept to-go orders. City Hall is closed to the public and Beverly Hills Courthouse will be closed indefinitely. Events throughout Beverly Hills have been canceled in March and April, including performances at the Wallis and the Beverly Hills Farmers Market.

In order to assist people while they're told to remain at home, City Council established that non-payment of rent will be temporarily forgiven, certain parking restrictions are eased and utility shut-offs are temporarily suspended.

Mayor John Mirisch has also established a COVID-19 Kindness Task Force, which will be made up of residents who want to help community-members during the quarantine.

"We encourage members of our community to call their friends and loved ones, develop networks and support neighbors," Mirisch said. "By offering assistance in a safe and responsible way, we demonstrate our resilience as a community and will prevail healthier and stronger."

The task force will help seniors and others who are the most vulnerable to coronavirus through tasks such as buying groceries. People with prior health conditions and aged over 65 are considered to be the most vulnerable to falling terminally ill from the disease.

Gov. Gavin Newsom declared an order for California residents to stay at home Thursday, in order to slow the spread of the virus. Newsom also issued an executive order to fight the virus, which includes increasing the health care capacity of clinics.

Newsom has not mandated schools in California close as of press time, but the BHUSD Board of Education decided to close its schools March 12. Students began online instruction March 24, after the end of their spring breaks.

Superintendent Bregy said that as of now, opening and closing of schools is determined by districts. BHUSD schools will be closed until at least April 6, though it's likely to be closed for longer.

"It is too premature to make this determination," Bregy said in a statement. "As soon as we know something, we will let you know."

Classes are continuing online, through

programs like Google Classroom and Google Hangout, and students will work on assignments at home. According to Bregy, home learning will involve individual teachers instructing students digitally since the district does not have an established online teaching program.

"I am convinced that every stakeholder at BHUSD realizes how quickly the daily routine of life has changed significantly in a matter of days and how we all have had to adjust to multiple changes," said Board President Isabel Hacker in a statement

Julie Goler, a Beverly High Honors English teacher, said that she used Zoom, an online video-chat website, and Google Classroom to discuss literature and edit re-

search papers with students.

"Google classroom is great for teaching writing," Goler said. "It's terrible for giving objective tests and I will not be doing any of that right now."

According to Assistant Superintendent for Education Services Dustin Seemann, students will receive a minimum of one hour instructional time per subject each week. (See page six for an interview with

Seemann.)

"There is no doubt that the COVID-19 pandemic is pushing us into uncharted territories, to that end I ask for your patience and understanding while we learn,

> adapt and grow in our new reality," Bregy said in a statement. "In all likelihood. every day and week will look different as we see what is working well and what we need to change."

> For their part, Beverly Hills community members are adapting to life under quarantine and finding different ways to spend their time in the last week. Goler, for instance, has made her book club virtual.

> "I'm continuing to book groups online. We are using Zoom for all book groups," Goler said. "I haven't missed one this week."

> Goler has authors calling in to discuss their work with her book groups. She has offered a book group with Kevin Wilson,

author of, Nothing to See Here, to all staff members at BHUSD.

"Book groups are a great way to create community in difficult times. They stave off loneliness and give people something to look forward to," Goler said. "It has been remarkably healing for all. It's gratifying to see that the book groups are helping people get through this."

being physically punished. The pathway is accelerated towards those outcomes when people feel that they can't cope.

Can you describe some healthy coping mechanisms for this period of time? What should people do in this situation, when they're stuck indoors?

Each person probably knows what strategies work for them. They know what makes them feel good and they know what to do if they're feeling out of sorts under general circumstances. I think the problem that we're in right now is that some of those normal ways that you take care of yourself or make yourself feel better are being denied, because you can't go to the gym. Or you can't do your half hour of meditation that you do every day once the kids have gone off to school, because they're not going off to school. Or you can't get together with that group of friends that you have coffee with every weekend. That's [all] an important part of your social life.

So people are going to have to start to think creatively [about], "What is something that I can do on my own, that doesn't involve getting together with other people? What is something that I can do, even if it's just a small thing every day, to help me stay connected with the people that I care about? If I'm somebody who loves going to the gym, and I don't feel good when I'm not getting any physical exercise, maybe I can go for a great walk by myself?" [It's about] finding a modification to the things that usually are natural go-to's when we're not feeling well.

I think that social isolation is going to become more and more of a problem, the more we have to stay separated from each other. I would really encourage people to spend time on the phone with people that they care about. Maybe do a video, FaceTime or Skype [call] with people that are important to [you] so that we can maintain a sense of connectedness even though we can't get together with those people.

What should people who are feeling anxious in this period of time do to ease their anxieties?

I think with anxiety, one of the most important things is for people to recognize that a lot of what's driving anxiety is their thoughts. This is a time when using what we call "self talk" can be helpful. Sometimes when you're very anxious, your [mind] starts running and you're like, "Okay, now this might happen, and then that might happen. What if I can't ever get water again? What if I can't do this and then that?" It can really get going. So if somebody can stop for a minute or two, and even if it's a simple script they come up for themselves, to tell themselves something like, "This is a temporary situation." That's a corrective thought that might help them feel a little less anxious. Or "I know I can get through this" or "My family and I will figure out a way to cope." These [are] types of coping statements, something that means something to them. It's really important to try to insert some thoughts that are going to be positive, as opposed to just letting the negative thoughts take up all the space.

I don't mean to minimize it by saying, "Oh, everything's going to be fine if you just think positive!" Because it's really not that at all. It's not about just thinking positive, especially for a depressed person – that's just not helpful for them to be told to look at the bright side. But I do think that there are times when, like if you're getting a cold and you have low energy and you just don't seem to be able to get things to work, it's helpful when you tell yourself, "You know what, of course I'm not going to be at my best right now. I'm getting sick. I can't expect myself to remember every single thing that I was supposed to do today.'

So similarly, I think if you can tell yourself, "Yes, I'm feeling anxious right now. This is what anxiety feels like. But this is a temporary situation, and I'm going to get through it." That can at least give yourself permission to cut off some of the spiral.

ORDINANCE NO. 20-O-2805

AN URGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS ADOPTING EMERGENCY REGULATIONS RELATED TO RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL TENANT EVICTIONS, CLOSURE OF CERTAIN ESTABLISHMENTS WITHIN THE CITY, AND OTHER MEASURES AND DECLARING THE URGENCY THEREOF

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOL-

WHEREAS, international, national, state, and local health and governmental authorities are responding to an outbreak of respiratory disease caused by a novel coronavirus named "SARS-CoV-2," and the disease it causes has been named "coronavirus disease 2019," abbreviated COVID-19, ("COVID-19"); and

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2020, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors and Department of Public Health declared a local emergency and local public health emergency to aid the regional healthcare and governmental community in responding to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2020, the Governor of the State of California declared a state of emergency to make additional resources available, formalize emergency actions already underway across multiple state agencies and departments, and help the state prepare for broader spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, the President of the United States of America declared a national emergency and announced that the federal government would make emergency funding available to assist state and local governments in preventing the spread of and addressing the effects of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2020, the City Manager, in his role as the Director of Emergency Services, proclaimed the existence of a local emergency pursuant to Section 2-4-107 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code to ensure the availability of mutual aid and an effective the City's response to the novel coronavirus ("COVID-19"); and

WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the California Department of Public Health, and the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health have all issued recommendations including but not limited to social distancing, staying home if sick, canceling or postponing large group events, working from home, and other precautions to protect public health and prevent transmission of this communicable virus; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the public health emergency and the precautions recommended by health authorities, many tenants in Beverly Hills have experienced or expect soon to experience sudden and unexpected income loss; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of California has stated that individuals exposed to COVID-19 may be temporarily unable to report to work due to illness caused by COVID-19 or quarantines related to COVID-19 and individuals directly affected by COVID-19 may experience potential loss of income, health care and medical coverage, and ability to pay for housing and basic needs, thereby placing increased demands on already strained regional and local health and safety resources, including shelters and food banks; and

WHEREAS, further economic impacts are anticipated, leaving tenants vulnerable to eviction: and

WHEREAS, the City of Beverly Hills is redoubling its efforts to maintain hand hygiene, respiratory etiquette, and social distancing. It is absolutely critical that the City does everything possible to slow the pace of community spread and avoid unnecessary strain on our medical system. To aid in these efforts, the City Council is ordering a series of temporary restrictions be placed on certain establishments throughout the City in which large numbers of people tend to gather and remain in close proximity.

WHEREAS, during this local emergency, and in the interest of protecting the public health and preventing transmission of COVID-19, it is essential to avoid unnecessary housing displacement, to protect the City's affordable housing stock, and to prevent housed individuals from falling into homelessness; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of public peace, health and safety, as affected by the emergency caused by the spread of COVID-19, it is necessary for the City Council to exercise its authority to issue these regulations related to the protection of the public peace, health or safety.

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Beverly Hills does adopt the following emergency regulations which shall take effect immediate-

- 1. A temporary moratorium on eviction for non-payment of rent by residential tenants impacted by the COVID-19 crisis is imposed as follows:
- a. During the period of local emergency declared in response to COVID-19, no landlord shall endeavor to evict a tenant in either of the following situations: (1) for nonpayment of rent if the tenant demonstrates that the tenant is unable to pay rent due to financial impacts related to COVID-19 or (2) for a no-fault eviction unless necessary for the health and safety of tenants, neighbors, or the landlord. A landlord who knows that a tenant cannot pay some or all of the rent temporarily for the reasons set forth above shall not serve a notice pursuant to CCP 1161(2), file or prosecute an unlawful detainer action based on a 3-day pay or quit notice, or otherwise seek to evict for nonpayment of rent. A landlord knows of a tenant's inability to pay rent within the meaning of this Ordinance if the tenant, within 30 days after the date that rent is due, notifies the landlord in writing of lost income and inability to pay full rent due to financial impacts related to COVID-19, and provides documentation to support the claim. For purposes of this Ordinance, "in writing" includes email or text communications to a landlord or the landlord's representative with whom the tenant has previously corresponded by email or text. Any medical or financial information provided to the landlord shall be held in confidence, and only used for evaluating the tenant's claim. Nothing in this Ordinance shall relieve the tenant of liability for the unpaid rent, which the landlord may seek after expiration of the local emergency and the tenant must pay within six months of the expiration of the local emergency. Six months after the end of the emergency if the rent is unpaid, a landlord may charge or collect a late fee for rent that is delayed for the reasons stated in this Ordinance; or a landlord may seek rent that is delayed for the reasons stated in this Ordinance through the eviction or other appropriate legal process.
- b. For purposes of this Ordinance, "financial impacts related to COVID-19" include, but are not limited to, tenant lost household income as a result of any of the following: (1) being sick

with COVID-19, or caring for a household or family member who is sick with COVID-19; (2) lay-off, loss of hours, or other income reduction resulting from business closure or other economic or employer impacts of COVID-19 including for tenants who are salaried employees or self-employed; (3) compliance with a recommendation from a government health authority to stay home, self-quarantine, or avoid congregating with others during the state of emergency; (4) extraordinary out-ofpocket medical expenses; or (5) child care needs arising from school closures related to

- c. For purposes of this Ordinance, "no-fault eviction" refers to any eviction for which the notice to terminate tenancy is not based on alleged fault by the tenant, including but not limited to eviction notices served pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure sections 1161(1), 1161(5), or 1161c.
- d. This Ordinance applies to nonpayment eviction notices, no-fault eviction notices, and unlawful detainer actions based on such notices. served or filed on or after the date on which a local emergency was proclaimed.
- 2. A temporary moratorium on eviction for non-payment of rent by commercial tenants impacted by the COVID-19 crisis is imposed as follows:
- a. During the period of local emergency declared in response to COVID-19, no landlord shall endeavor to evict a commercial tenant in either of the following situations: (1) for nonpayment of rent if the commercial tenant demonstrates that the commercial tenant is unable to pay rent due to financial impacts related to COVID-19 or (2) for a no-fault eviction unless necessary for the health and safety of tenants, neighbors, or the landlord. A landlord who knows that a commercial tenant cannot pay some or all of the rent temporarily for the reasons set forth above shall not serve a notice or otherwise seek to evict for nonpayment of rent. A landlord knows of a commercial tenant's inability to pay rent within the meaning of this Ordinance if the commercial tenant, within 30 days after the date that rent is due. notifies the landlord in writing of lost income and inability to pay full rent due to financial impacts related to COVID-19, and provides documentation to support the claim. For purposes of this Ordinance, "in writing" includes email or text communications to a landlord or the landlord's representative with whom the commercial tenant has previously corresponded by email or text. Any medical or financial information provided to the landlord shall be held in confidence, and only used for evaluating the commercial tenant's claim. Nothing in this Ordinance shall relieve the commercial tenant of liability for the unpaid rent, which the landlord may seek after expiration of the local emergency and the commercial tenant must pay within six months of the expiration of the local emergency. Six months after the end of the emergency if the rent is unpaid, a landlord may charge or collect a late fee for rent that is delayed for the reasons stated in this Ordinance; or a landlord may seek rent that is delayed for the reasons stated in this Ordinance through the eviction or other appropriate legal process.
- b. For purposes of this Ordinance, "financial impacts related to COVID-19" include, but are not limited to, tenant lost business income as a result of any of the following: (1) being sick with COVID-19, or caring for a household or family member who is sick with COVID-19; (2) income reduction resulting from business closure or other economic or employer impacts of COVID-19; (3) compliance with a recommendation from a government health authority to stay home, self-quarantine, or avoid congregating with others during the state of emergency; (4) extraordinary out-of-pocket medical expenses; or (5) child care needs arising from school closures related to COVID-19.
- 3. If a dispute arises between the residential or commercial tenant, and the landlord regarding whether a financial impact exists or whether the financial impact is related to COVID-19, the residential or commercial tenant may appeal to the Standing Committee of the City Council appointed to hear disruptive tenant hearings in order to make a final determination of the dispute, until such time as the Rent Stabilization Commission is appointed in which case the Rent Stabilization Commission shall make a final determination of the dispute. The hearing procedure shall be established by the

City Attorney.

Section 2. The following regulations are imposed on businesses, including bars, night-clubs and restaurants, located in the City of Beverly Hills in order to implement recommended practices as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic:

a. All bars and nightclubs in the City of Beverly Hills that do not serve food shall be closed to the public.

b. Any bars or nightclubs or other businesses in the City of Beverly Hills that serve food may remain open only for purposes of continuing to prepare and offer food to customers via delivery service or to be picked up. Dine-in food service is prohibited.

c. All restaurants and retail food facilities in the City of Beverly Hills shall be prohibited from serving food for consumption on premises. Restaurants and retail food facilities may continue to operate for purposes of preparing and offering food to customers via delivery service, to be picked up or for drive-thru. For those establishments offering food pick-up options, proprietors are directed to establish social distancing practices for those patrons in the queue for pick-up. Such restaurants and retail facilities in the City shall establish health and safety measures for their employees and customers including appropriate gloves and masks.

d. The following are exempt from this Ordinance:

(i) Cafeterias, commissaries, and restaurants located within nursing homes, or similar facilities.(ii) Trucks and other vehicles engaged in the delivery of grocery items to grocery stores, when such items are to be made available for sale to the public, are hereby exempt from having to comply with any City codes, rules and regulations that limit the hours for such deliveries

e. Business located in the City with self-service unwrapped food items such as buffets are

prohibited.

f. Relax City codes and regulations as City staff deems appropriate in connection to commercial signs and banners displayed on or adjacent to restaurants, bars or other businesses that are permitted to remain open pursuant to this Ordinance.

g. City shall provide for additional loading zones near restaurants that are authorized to remain open in order to facilitate the pickup of food

h. All movie theaters, live performance venues, and arcades shall be closed to the public.

i. All gyms and fitness centers shall be closed to the public.

j. All businesses providing physical health and beauty services, including spas, hair salons, massage parlors, and nail salons, that do not provide medical care or services that supplement medical care as directed by medical professionals will be closed to the public, except for the purpose of retail sales and provided in paragraph (I) below.

k. In addition, the City Council hereby issues guidance to the leaders of the City's houses of worship and urge them, in the strongest possible terms, to limit gatherings on their premises and to explore and implement ways to practice their respective faiths while observing social distancing practices.

I. All non-essential retail businesses shall be closed except for pick up, delivery and transactions by appointment. In order to protect employees and customers of non-essential retail businesses that are authorized to operate under this Ordinance, such businesses shall establish health and safety measures such as requiring employees to wear appropriate gloves and masks if employees compriste gloves and masks if employees compriste gloves and masks if employees compristed in the City are exempt from this Ordinance: grocery stores, food banks, banks, drug stores, car rentals, convenience stores, pharmacies, gas stations,

car mechanics, pet supply stores, laundromats, hardware stores, dry cleaners, mailbox stores, Federal Express and UPS, and other exemptions as determined by the Director of Emergency Services in writing and ratified by the City Council at its next regular City Council meeting.

m. All elective medical and surgical procedures and all elective non-necessary dental procedures are prohibited. The City will defer to the medical judgment of the medical professionals to determine what are non-elective procedures.

<u>Section 3.</u> Hoarding. The City Council urges residents not to hoard essential goods such as hand sanitizer, cleaning supplies, toilet paper, canned food, frozen food and other needed supplies. The City Council strongly condemns hoarding. Retail establishments located in the City shall be responsible for limiting the sales of such items, as they see fit to provide greater accessibility to a larger group of customers.

Section 4. Violations. This Ordinance shall be punishable as set forth in Section 2-4-111 and Chapter 3 of Title 1 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code. In addition, this Ordinance grants a defense in the event that an unlawful detainer action is commenced in violation of this Ordinance

<u>Section 5.</u> Remain in Effect. This Ordinance shall remain in effect for the duration of the local emergency.

<u>Section 6.</u> <u>Uncodified</u>. This Ordinance shall not be codified.

<u>Section 7. Severability</u>. If any provision of this ordinance is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be considered a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity and enforceability of the other provisions of this ordinance.

<u>Section 8. Publication</u>. The City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation

published and circulated in the city within fifteen (15) days after its passage in accordance with Section 36933 of the Government Code, shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause this Ordinance and the city Clerk's certification, together with proof of publication, to be entered in the Book of Ordinances of the Council of this city.

Section 9. Effective Date. This Ordinance is adopted as an urgency ordinance for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety within the meaning of Government Code Section 36937(b), and therefore shall be passed immediately upon its introduction and shall become effective at 12:01 a.m., March 17, 2020 upon its adoption by a minimum 4/5 vote of the City Council.

<u>Section 10.</u> <u>Duration</u>. This Ordinance shall remain in effect until it is superseded by another Ordinance adopted by the City Council.

<u>Section 11. Certification</u>. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance.
