Trump Supporters Rally in Beverly Hills, Clash with **Counter-Protesters**

The Beverly Hills Police Department declared an unlawful assembly Saturday, after a fight broke out at a weekly-scheduled Trump rally between a Trump protester and counter-protester.

Trump supporters have been gathering in Beverly Hills for the past several weekends leading up to Election Day. A counter-protest was held at Roxbury Park that had around 40 people, according to BHPD Public Information Officer Lt. Max Subin.

Subin said the counter-protesters marched to the Trump rally and a counter-protester got into a "violent fight" with a pro-Trump protester.

"It was at the point that an unlawful assembly was declared by the Incident Commander and the counter protestors did leave and march back to Roxbury Park," Subin said.

The last two Trump rallies in the city have been among the largest of the planned protests. It is unclear if the protests will continue now that Election Day has passed.

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BHEA and BHUSD Enter Negotiations, Prepare for Physical Phase-In Plan

The Beverly Hills Education Association, which is the union representing BHUSD faculty, met with the BHUSD last Monday to discuss the potential physical return of certain students and teachers to classrooms.

According to a BHEA newsletter, the district provided a 10-day notice of transition to an educational program for PRIME, Special Education Preschool and Special Education Assessments.

The BHEA bargaining team reached a tentative agreement to extend the current Memorandum of Understanding to June 30, 2021, add an addendum on in-person special education student assessments and add an addendum on the return of athletic programs and coaches for Beverly High.

According to a BHEA newsletter, the bargaining team has issued a counter proposal regarding in-person small group special education cohorts.

BHEA President Alana Castanon said negotiations are ongoing between the BHEA and BHUSD.

"There are many details that need to be worked out regarding any eventual return to face to face instruction. However, we are committed to continuing this process," Castanon said. "BHEA's goal is to keep student and staff safety at the forefront of all negotiations."

Castanon added that negotiations on the Collective Bargaining Agreement are slated to begin later this month.

Superintendent Michael Bregy said that as the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health continues to revise and relax restrictions in the Public Health Order, the district will continue meeting with the BHEA until a physical phase-in plan is established.

"Our goals are to work within the parameters of what LA County is allowing while maintaining the safest environment possible for our students and staff and prioritizing the instructional and social-emotional needs of our students," Bregy said.

He added that COVID-19 has pushed the BHUSD community to incongruous places, but they are determined to make this unprecedented time successful.

The next bargaining session is planned for November 5.

Superintendent Gives Update on School Reopening, K-2nd Grade Waiver and Student Cohorts

Superintendent Michael Bregy provided updates on the district's reopening plan last Tuesday, which included the Kindergarten-2nd grade waiver and allowing certain Beverly High athletes to return to campus for conditioning.

The State of California has implemented a color-coded tier system, in which colors indicate the number of COVID-19 cases in a specific county. School districts must refer to the color-coded tier system to determine when they can reopen. According to Bregy, the BHUSD remains in the purple or highest tier and therefore

can't reopen as of last Tuesday.

"We are still in an area of concern in the area," Bregy said. "This is an area that we've been looking at – we look at our numbers every single day."

According to Bregy, the county's public health order was updated to allow for small cohorts of certain students to return to campus.

"This is something that we are spending a great deal of time studying, looking at ensuring safety and need, and all the things that we are responsible for students and staff," Bregy said.

The BHEA and the BHUSD reached an agreement to add an addendum to extend the BHEA's current Memorandum of Understanding to 2021 and add a teacher's assistant for Beverly High athletics last month. Read more about the MOU in column one.

"I know that football and water polo are [last] week and slowly each week thereafter, we will have some additional sports coming offline for conditioning as well," Bregy said. "Again, following the public health order with health screening measures in place."

He added that the district has also been discussing eventually allowing Beverly Vista School athletes to return to campus for conditioning.

The BHUSD Board of Education also unanimously expressed support for applying to the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health for a K-2nd grade waiver

The public health department has started a waiver program that allows lower-grade students from qualified districts to receive in-person instruction if approved. According to the department's website, it is only approving 30 waivers a week and prioritizing schools with a higher percentage of students who qualify for free or reduced-price meal programs.

Bregy said it has mostly been private or charter schools that have applied for the elementary waiver but that has now changed. The Las Virgenes Unified School District was approved for a waiver and will begin in-person instruction for K-2nd grade students November 9.

"Most school districts are going to apply for this waiver just because they're not sure how long it will take to process [it] to have that in case the numbers are in a comfortable place and we want to start matriculating grade levels back in at an early age," Bregy said.

He added that the waiver probably won't be awarded to the BHUSD for a long time, due to the high volume of districts applying and the priority placed on approving low-income schools.

According to Bregy, the superintendent does not necessarily need formal approval to apply for a waiver but he wanted to hear feedback from board members regardless.

Board member Noah Margo said it's important to be prepared and apply for the waiver, though he does not recommend putting kids back in school now due to the spike in COVID-19 cases.

"If at any point not having that waiver trips us up, we're going to regret not applying for it," Margo said.

Board member Tristen Walker-Shu-

man agreed the district should move forward, but said it should walk carefully. She said she recognizes that LA County's COVID-19 cases were going down but they are now increasing again.

"A number of people have said 'Well, we shouldn't be going by LA County. Beverly Hills is different, we should be looking at our own cases," Walker-Shuman said. "As of October 15th, our case rate was 10.2 – so significantly higher even than the average LA County at this point."

Board Vice President Rachelle Marcus said there's no question in her mind that it's wise to have the waiver in the district's hands whether it uses it or not.

"The waiver is not going to expire, so we will always have it when and if we want to really talk about using it," Marcus said. "Obviously, we're not going to start talking about it right now – the numbers are going up."

Council Adopts Urgency Ordinance Relating to Permit Requirements for Public Assemblies

The Beverly Hills City Council has unanimously approved an ordinance that updates its current permit requirements regarding large public assemblies and parades that went into effect November 4.

Over the past several months the city waived issuing public assembly and parade permits in order to accommodate various demonstrations; however, due to public safety needs surrounding recent large gatherings that utilized significant police and city resources, the council voted to again enforce its permit mandate.

An exemption, outlined in the new ordinance, includes those who wish to assemble to exercise their First Amendment rights as long as the following conditions are met:

- The assembly must be 500 people or less:
- Must take place in one of the following locations defined in the ordinance: La Cienega Park, Beverly Gardens Park between Crescent Dr. and Rodeo Dr. or the west side of City Hall adjacent to Crescent Dr.

"While we recognize the importance of public gatherings that allow the community to peacefully exercise their freedom of speech and right to assemble, it's imperative that we provide a safe and healthy environment in which they can do so by creating these guidelines," said Beverly Hills Mayor Lester Friedman.

The ordinance also prohibits targeted parades and assemblies which take place at a single residence for more than 15 minutes and prohibits parades and assemblies in residential neighborhoods between the hours of 7 p.m. or 30 minutes after sunset if earlier and 8 a.m. – unless the parade or assembly does not create any significant noise impacts.

Rent Stabilization Commission Will Discuss Potential Amendments to Tenant Relocation Fees

The Rent Stabilization Commission will discuss possible amendments to the Beverly Hills Municipal Code regarding relocation fees for no fault evictions Wednesday night.

According to the commission's agenda report, the Beverly Hills City Council approved in 2017 an urgency ordinance which set relocation fees for certain tenants in no fault evictions. The requirements to qualify for a relocation fee include the following, according to the report.

- Refusal to execute a lease.
- Change in building managers.
- Use by landlords.
- Demolition or condominium conversion.
 - · Major remodeling.
- Withdrawal of residential rent structure from the rental market.

Since then, the council has discussed and considered several changes with the ordinance. Topics of debate have included increasing relocation fee amounts and escalating relocation fees based on the tenure of tenancy. according to the report.

The commission will make a recommendation to the council on how to potentially amend the ordinance and its related relocation fees this week. According to the commission's agenda, they will discuss questions such as whether it should change the fee amounts and if fees should only be required once tenants have lived in the unit for a year.

Traffic and Parking Commission Will Discuss Transportation Planning and Engineering Projects

The Traffic and Planning Commission will discuss Thursday updates on the city's transportation planning and engineering projects, which include Beverly Hills' Complete Streets Plan.

The Complete Streets Plan includes goals guiding transportation policies, network maps identifying which streets to enhance and more. According to the commission's agenda report, it will also include a bicycle, transit, vehicle and pedestrian action plan.

Beverly Hills will begin these plans based on staffing and funding capacity, according to the commission's agenda report.

Projects currently underway include "Connect Beverly Hills," which is an initiative to develop street designs for Wilshire Boulevard and more. City staff are also implementing a bicycle and pedestrian awareness campaign and pedestrian crossing enhancements which are being funded by Metro.

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BHUSD Board of Education Debates CBOC Member Approval Process

The BHUSD Board of Education debated over the process of approving members of the Citizens Bond Oversight Committee last Tuesday.

The board approved Don Wyse, Bill Bymel, Paris Elias-Benyamin and Nathan Kruger to join the CBOC October 13. Board President Isabel Hacker and Vice President Rachelle Marcus, who are the board's liaison committee to the CBOC, conducted the candidate interviews with Superintendent Michael Bregy and two

other CBOC members.

At that meeting, Board member Tristen Walker-Shuman said she would have liked to listen in to the interviews and that she thought all Board members had conducted CBOC candidate interviews in the past.

Hacker responded that there is no process in place and it defaults to Bregy to define that process. She added that she agrees the board should set a protocol to use in the future and added it to the subsequent board meeting agenda to discuss.

Walker-Shuman said last Tuesday that CBOC candidate interviews don't happen often and therefore it wouldn't be difficult for all board members to participate in them

"I don't feel like it's overly burdensome for the entire board to be a part of the interview process and be able to ask questions, particularly because of the terms of the CBOC," Walker-Shuman said.

Board member Noah Margo said the CBOC is a required committee for districts to have by the state and the board needs to have a little more say in that process. He said he doesn't know if it should be up to the board liaison, considering that the liaison doesn't meet regularly.

"In the future, I would prefer the process to have all the board members be having the chance to vet out the CBOC members together," Margo said.

He later added that since there may be three new board members after the election, the current board should allow the new board to decide on the interview process. Walker-Shuman agreed with his statements.

Board member Mel Spitz said when he first heard about how interviews were deployed, he felt very comfortable about it.

"If you have the applicant reviewed by the board leadership and the CBOC leadership, I think that's very sufficient and it even makes it less likely that any appointments made in the CBOC are political appointments where one board member, for example, owes something to a supporter or whatever," Spitz said.

Marcus said she was not uncomfortable with the process at all, but doesn't feel particular about how it should be conducted either way.

"I was comfortable with the way that it was done, if the board wants to change

The adoption and implementation of the Interim Ordinance represents minor alterations in land use limitations and noticing procedures for certain projects and do not result in any changes in land use or density. It can therefore be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the proposed amendments may have a significant effect on the environment. In addition, the Interim Ordinance consists of an action taken by a regulatory agency for the protection of the environment due to the fact that it will apply inclusionary housing regulations to all multi-family housing developments. Accordingly, the City Council will consider the staff recommendation to find the Interim Ordinance exempt from the environmental review requirements of CEQA pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3), 15305, and 15308 of the California Code of Regulations because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question would have a significant effect on the environment.

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it then we have to decide," Marcus said. "The only thing that I'm saying is that if we change it, we have to follow the process and do it that way all the time."

Hacker said she had run the interview process by the board's council, which determined that there was nothing irregular about it.

"I think this process is great, to be honest with you," Hacker said. "[The CBOC members] know exactly where their deficits are as far as people and what they need when they put these reports together."

She added that the Beverly Hills City Council has a strong process in place for selecting its commissions and the board's selection of CBOC members mirrored that.

Hacker, Marcus and Spitz were in favor of conducting the CBOC committee interview process similarly in the future, while Margo and Walker-Shuman were opposed. Hacker said the new board is welcome to change this process once they are installed.

Nadel Receives Kindness and Legacy Award

The City of Beverly Hills awarded resident Adele Nadel, 94, a "Kindness and Legacy Award" for her services to the city earlier this year.

Nadel, who has lived in Beverly Hills her entire life, said she saw the city grow from a small town into a large town. She described how when she was younger, children were able to get a soda after school and were told to come back tomorrow to pay if they didn't have money.

"That was the thing that appealed to me – it was easy to get involved in the community because you could see what you were getting involved in," Nadel said. "And the people were so open to it in those days."

One of Nadel's first forays into volunteer work was through the Parent Teacher Association. She ended up becoming PTA president six times at Hawthorne School, Beverly High and the PTA Council.

But of her accomplishments, Nadel said she's most proud of being on the Maple Counseling Center's founding committee. The committee was formed to address the city's drug problems, according to Nadel.

"That has turned into such a magnificent undertaking and very well-respected across the country," she said.

Nadel's friend of 50 years Rhoda Sharp said Nadel has always been the leader of the pack.


"She was [PTA] president first, I was president after," Sharp said. "She was my mentor and still is."

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Danny Licht

Author of "Cooking As Though You Might Cook Again"

What is your new book "Cooking As Though You Might Cook Again" about?

It's hard to say. It's a cookbook with very few numbers in it and so it focuses on a description of a way of cooking more than it does on a prescription for any specific end goal.

[I wrote it because] I like cookbooks. I like reading them and I think that there's too much attention placed on very specific instructions in recipes generally tain amount of unhappiness in cooking. So my hope was to help people cook more freely, happily [and] pleasurably.

your work?

It was amazing. It was an amazing compliment to receive. I am a fan of [Pertenell] – his books are wonderful.

How did you gain your passion for cooking?

Well, I guess accidentally. In college, I moved to an apartment out of a dorm and wanted to cook for myself - more or less out of necessity. I got a cookbook [and tried] to learn fundamentals [and] principles of cooking and one thing led to another.

What do you tell people who hate to cook?

I'm sure it did. I liked working on the paper. My first year on the paper, we had a teacher who was very encouraging to me and that meant a lot to me.

[Also, Dr. Steven Rubenstein] gave me the sense that writing could be powerful, that books could change lives. I don't know exactly how. He brought an energy to reading and writing that I hadn't really encountered before. I think he had the sense that close reading could materially improve lives. It was exciting and compelling for someone like me. It made me think that writing was worth pursuing -

Tell us about your family.

I have two siblings, a brother [Joey] and a sister [Lucy]. My parents are residents [Lisa Licht and Planning Commissioner Andy Licht]. My sister works for [a COVID-19] testing start-up. My brother is a video game streamer.

What is your favorite recipe from your book and why?

There's a chapter on salt I like a lot. It's short, it's concise, it gets to the point – I just said short in three different ways. I think salt is so important in cooking and so often ignored or taken as an afterthought. But salt is what makes things taste good.

What's your favorite meal to cook?

It's hard to say. I like cooking generally and I don't like thinking about cooking too

much, which might surprise you. I like cooking pasta, risotto, tacos, I love braising meat – that's probably my favorite.

What did you hope to accomplish by writing a cookbook?

I think we live in a world where so many aspects of our lives are becoming quantified and the kitchen can be a place where we don't need to quantify everything. [It can be] where we don't need an upper limit on what's possible or good. So my hope is to help people relax a little bit more while they're cooking.

Lastly, what's one piece of advice you have for people who are interested in starting to cook?

Read my book.



Such bidder's security must be in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the maximum amount of bid as a guarantee that the bidder will enter into the proposed Contract, if the same is awarded to such bidder, and will provide the required Performance and Payment Bonds, insurance certificates and any other required documents. The Contractor and all subcontractors shall furnish certified payroll records as required pursuant Labor Code section 1776 directly to the Labor Commissioner in accordance with Labor Code section 1771.4 on at least on a monthly basis (or more frequently if required by the District or the Labor Commissioner) and in a format prescribed by the Labor Commissioner. Monitoring and enforcement of the prevailing wage laws and related requirements will be performed by the Labor Commissioner/ Department of Labor Standards Enforcement (DLSE).

No bidder may withdraw any bid for a period of ninety (90) calendar days after the date set for the opening of bids.

Separate payment and performance bonds, each in an amount equal to 100% of the total Contract amount, are required, and shall be provided to the District prior to execution of the Contract and shall be in the form set forth in the Contract Documents.

All bonds (Bid, Performance, and Payment) must be issued by a California admitted surety as defined in California Code of Civil Procedure section 995.120.

Where applicable, bidders must meet the requirements set forth in Public Contract Code section 10115 et seq., Military and Veterans Code section 999 et seq. and California Code of Regulations, Title 2, Section 1896.60 et seq. regarding Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise ("DVBE") Programs. Forms are included in this Bid Package.

The successful bidder will be required to certify that it either meets the Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise ("DVBE") goal of three percent (3%) participation or made a good faith effort to solicit DVBE participation in this Contract if it is awarded the Contract for the Work.

ORDINANCE NO. 20-O-2821

AN URGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS AMENDING ARTICLE 2 OF CHAPTER 3 OF TITLE 4 (ENTITLED PARADES AND ASSEMBLIES) OF THE BEVERLY HILLS MUNICIPAL CODE AND DECLARING THE URGENCY THEREOF

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the City of Beverly Hills recognizes the importance of public gatherings that allow the community to collectively express its concerns about public issues, and supports the rights of all people to peacefully exercise their First Amendment rights to free speech and assembly; and

WHEREAS, beginning on May 30, 2020, the City was subjected to widespread acts of violence and property damage, including looting and rioting, by people who were taking advantage of the protests concerning the tragic death of George Floyd, but now desires to terminate that emergency; and

WHEREAS, on June 5, June 12, and June 27 of 2020, a group called "OCCUPY" conducted large nighttime protests in the residential area of the City which began at approximately 10:00 PM and continued until approximately 1:00 AM, and which included the use of bullhorns, amplified music, fireworks, and other items used to disrupt the tranquility of the residential neighborhood during hours when many people ordinarily would be sleeping; and

WHEREAS, since May 30 the City has been host to a number of protests from across the political spectrum including protests organized by "Mr. Checkpoint," Freedom Rallies, and protests regarding the conflict between Armenia and Azerbaijan; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to adopt regulations that will promote the free exercise of First Amendment rights through parades and assemblies, and simultaneously serve the significant interests of protecting the public health and safety of our community, including those involved in or observing parades and assemblies; and

WHEREAS, the City particularly desires to protect its residents' rights to enjoy the tranquility of their homes during nighttime hours when people ordinarily would be sleeping; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of public peace, health and safety, it is necessary for the City Council to exercise its authority to adopt this urgency ordinance to adequately respond to the continuing threat of nighttime protests in the residential area and the use of fireworks in connection with parades and assemblies which would be unregulated upon the termination of the state of emergency declared on May 30th.

<u>Section 1</u>. Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 4 (entitled Parades and Assemblies) of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"ARTICLE 2. PARADES AND ASSEMBLIES 4-3-200: ASSEMBLIES OF LESS THAN FIVE HUNDRED PEOPLE:

Notwithstanding any other provision of this

Article, assemblies of less than five hundred (500) people will be allowed without a permit in that portion of Beverly Gardens Park between Crescent Drive and Rodeo Drive, La Cienega Park, and on the Crescent Drive side of the City Hall. No sound amplification equipment shall be permitted if it will generate Significant Noise Impacts.

4-3-201: PERMIT REQUIRED:

No person shall engage in, conduct, or carry on the activity of a parade or assembly without a permit issued under the provisions of Chapter 1, Article 1 of this Title. The permit may authorize the use of sound amplifying equipment and electrical generators in conjunction with a parade or assembly without a permit issued under Article 5 of this Chapter.

4-3-202: **DEFINITIONS**:

ASSEMBLY: Any meeting, demonstration, picket line, rally, gathering, or group of persons, animals, or vehicles, or a combination thereof, having a common purpose, design, or goal, either (1) upon any public street, sidewalk, alley, or city park path which numbers twenty-five (25) or more and which assembly will or tends to substantially inhibit the usual flow of pedestrian or vehicular traffic, other than a "parade," as defined in this Section, or (2) upon any park or other public place which numbers seventy-five (75) or more and which occupies any public area, other than a "parade," as defined in this Section.

PARADE: Any march, demonstration, procession, motorcade, or promenade consisting of persons, animals, or vehicles, or a combination thereof, having a common purpose, design, destination, or goal; upon any public place, which parade, march, demonstration, procession, motorcade, or promenade does not comply with normal and usual traffic regulations or control.

SIGNIFICANT NOISE IMPACTS: The generation of noise that is distinctly audible from within the nearest residence or dwelling.

4-3-203: EXEMPTIONS:

In addition to the assemblies described in Section 4-3-200 above, the permit application provisions of this Article shall not apply to the following:

- A. Spontaneous parades or assemblies occasioned by news or affairs coming into public knowledge within three (3) days before such assembly, provided that the organizers thereof, if any, give written notice to the City at least twenty four (24) hours prior to such parade or assembly.
- 1. Such written notice shall contain all of the following information:
- a. The name, address and telephone number of the person or persons seeking to organize or conduct the parade or assembly. This person or these persons shall be considered a permittee for the purposes of this Article.
- b. The name, address and telephone number of the headquarters of the organization, if any, and of the organizer or responsible head of such organization by whom or on whose behalf the parade or assembly is proposed to be conducted.
- c. The name, address and telephone number of the person who will chair the parade or assembly and who will be responsible for its conduct.
- d. The location and date of the proposed parade or assembly, including the assembly area, disbanding area, and the route to be traveled.
- e. An estimate of the approximate number of persons who will be participating in the parade or assembly and an estimate of the approximate number of persons who will be observing the parade or assembly.
- f. The time at which the parade or assembly will start and conclude.
- g. The type of security or other arrangements that will be provided to assure that participants are properly directed.
- h. The type of sound amplification equipment and electrical generators that will be used, if any.
- i. Whether participants in the parade or assembly will be wearing masks.
- 2. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee may deny permission to conduct the

parade or assembly within eighteen (18) hours of the submission of the notice pursuant to subsection B of Section 4-3-205 if the City Manager or the City Manager's designee makes finding requiring denial pursuant to subsection B of Section 4-3-205. If the City Manager makes a finding requiring denial pursuant to that subsection, the City Manager shall immediately provide notice of the denial, including the reason for the denial, by telephone to the permittee and shall also provide written notice of the denial including the reason for the deni-al. If the permittee provides an email address for the purpose of receiving notices, the City Manager shall provide written notice of the denial by email immediately upon making the denial decision. If the proposed parade or assembly is denied, an assembly of less than 500 (five hundred) persons may still occur pursuant to Section 4-3-200 of this Article.

4-3-204: APPLICATION FOR PERMIT:

- A. A person seeking issuance of a permit pursuant to this Article shall file an application with the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, on forms supplied by the City.
- B. The application shall be filed with the City Manager or the City Manager's designee in accordance with the following time limitations:
- 1. Not less than six (6) days prior to the date of the parade or assembly if the parade or assembly is proposed to take place in whole or in part on, in or along the roadway portion (other than moving within crosswalks) of the following streets in the City of Beverly Hills: Wilshire Boulevard, Olympic Boulevard, Santa Monica North Roadway, Sunset Boulevard, La Cienega Boulevard, or Robertson Boulevard;
- 2. Not less than four (4) days prior to the date of the parade or assembly if the parade or assembly is proposed to take place in whole or in part on, in or along the roadway portion (other than moving within crosswalks) of any other street in a commercial zone within the City of Beverly Hills;
- 3. Not less than three (3) days prior to the date of the parade or assembly if the parade or assembly is proposed to take place in whole or in part on, in or along a roadway portion of a street or sidewalk or any other portion of the public right of way in a residential zone, or outside of the roadway in a commercial zone or residential zone, but within the sidewalk or any other portion of the public right of way;
- 4. Not less than two (2) days prior to the date of the parade or assembly if the parade or assembly is proposed to take place in whole or in part on, in or along any park or other publicly owned public forum in the City of Beverly Hills not governed by subsections B1 through B3 of this Section.
- C. The application shall include, but shall not be limited to, the following information:
- 1. The name, address and telephone number of the person or persons seeking to organize or conduct the parade or assembly.
- 2. The name, address and telephone number of the headquarters of the organization, if any, and of the organizer or responsible head of such organization by whom or on whose behalf the parade or assembly is proposed to be conducted.
- The name, address and telephone number of the person who will chair the parade or assembly and who will be responsible for its conduct.
- 4. The location and date of the proposed parade or assembly, including the assembly area, disbanding area, and the route to be traveled.
- 5. An estimate of the approximate number of persons who will be participating in the parade or assembly and an estimate of the approximate number of persons who will be observing the parade or assembly.
- 6. The hours when the parade or assembly will start and conclude.
- 7. The type of security or other arrangements that will be provided to assure that participants are properly directed.
- 8. The minimum and maximum speeds that the parade is to travel, if applicable, and the maximum number of platoons or units, if any, in the parade or assembly and the maximum and minimum interval of space to be maintained between the units of such parade or assembly.
- 9. The maximum length of such parade or as-

sembly in miles or fractions thereof.

- 10. The number and type of vehicles and animals in the parade or assembly, if any.
- 11. The number and type of electrical generators to be installed, carried, possessed, and/or operated during the parade or assembly, if any.
- 12. Whether any of the participants in the parade or assembly will be wearing any type of mask or other face covering.
- 13. A statement to be signed by the person seeking the permit that the permittee will hold harmless and indemnify the City of Beverly Hills, its elected officials, officers, employees and agents from any damages which may arise as a result of the alleged willful or negligent acts or omissions of permittee, its officers, agents, or employees in connection with the permitted assembly or parade.
- 14. If the assembly or the parade set up or dispersal is to be conducted on private property, the applicant must submit with the application proof of the property owner's permission for the property to be used for that purpose.
- 15. The number and type of sound amplification equipment that will be used in the parade or assembly, if any.
- D. Within twenty four (24) hours after the submission of the application, the City Manager or the City Manager's designee must notify the applicant, in writing, whether the application is complete. If no such notice is given within twenty four (24) hours after submission, the application will be deemed to be complete.

4-3-205: GENERAL CRITERIA FOR ISSU-ANCE OR DENIAL OF PERMIT:

- A. In lieu of the criteria for issuance or denial of a permit under the provisions of Section 4-1-103 of this Title, the following criteria shall apply to issuance or denial of a parade or assembly permit.
- B. The permit shall be issued by the City Manager or the City Manager's designee unless there is a finding that:
- 1. The information contained in the application is false or intentionally misleading; or
- 2. The parade or assembly is proposed to take place in the roadway portion of any street in a commercial zone between the hours of eight o'clock (8:00) A.M. and ten o'clock (10:00) A.M. or between the hours of four o'clock (4:00) P.M. and six thirty o'clock (6:30) P.M., Monday through Friday, unless the parade or assembly will occur on a national holiday; or
- 3. The parade or assembly is proposed for a time and location for which another event permit has been previously issued, such as licensed sporting events, youth sports camps, and other licensed or permitted public entertainment events; or
- 4. The parade or assembly will require the simultaneous closure of the roadway portion of more than two (2) streets that run in a generally north and south direction between the hours of seven o'clock (7:00) A.M. and eight o'clock (8:00) P.M., Monday through Friday, or between the hours of ten o'clock (10:00) A.M. and six o'clock (6:00) P.M. on Saturday, unless the parade or assembly will occur on a national holiday; or
- 5. The parade or assembly will require the simultaneous closure of the roadway portion of more than two (2) streets that run generally in an east and west direction between the hours of seven o'clock (7:00) A.M. and eight o'clock (8:00) P.M., Monday through Friday, or between the hours of ten o'clock (10:00) A.M. and six o'clock (6:00) P.M. on Saturday, unless the parade or assembly will occur on a national holiday; or
- 6. The parade or assembly, by itself or in combination with other parades or assemblies, will require closure of the roadway portion of any street in a commercial zone for more than three (3) hours in any one day between the hours of seven o'clock (7:00) A.M. and eight o'clock (8:00) P.M., Monday through Friday; or
- 7. The proposed route or location of the parade or assembly traverses a street or other public right of way that was scheduled for maintenance, construction or repair prior to the application for that parade or assembly permit and the conduct of the parade or assembly would interfere with such maintenance, construction or repair or the maintenance, construction or repair would represent a threat to the health

or safety of the participants in the parade or assembly; or

- 8. The proposed area for the assembly or for the set up or dispersal of a parade could not physically accommodate the number of participants expected to participate in the parade or assembly, as reflected in the application completed and submitted pursuant to the requirements of this Article; or
- 9. The parade would result in a violation of any Federal, State or local law or regulation.

Upon making any finding set forth in this subsection, the City Manager or the City Manager's designee shall deny the permit application.

C. As a condition of the issuance of a permit under the provisions of this Article, the City Manager or the City Manager's designee may require that the parade or assembly be limited to a portion of the width of the street or right-of-way upon which the applicant seeks to conduct the parade or assembly, provided that such limitation does not limit or interfere with the conduct of the parade or assembly to violate any other provision of this Article or any other Federal, State or local law or regulation.

4-3-206: NONDISCRIMINATION:

The official designated by the City to act on permit applications shall uniformly consider each application upon its merits and shall not discriminate in granting or denying applications; and, shall not deny any permit based upon political or religious grounds or reasons.

4-3-207: NOTICE OF ISSUANCE OR DENIAL OF PERMIT:

A. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee shall approve or deny the permit application within the following time limitations, and shall notify in writing the applicant of the action taken:

If the permit is sought under the provisions of subsection 4-3-204(B)(1) or (B)(2) of this Article, within two (2) days after submission of the application. If the permit is sought under the provisions of subsection 4-3-204(B)(3) or (B) (4) of this Article, within twenty four (24) hours after submission of the application.

B. If the permit is denied, the notice of denial shall set forth the reasons for denial.

4-3-208: INTERFERENCE WITH PARADE OR ASSEMBLY:

No person shall knowingly join or participate in any parade or assembly conducted under permit from the City in violation of any of the terms of said permit, nor knowingly join or participate in any permitted parade or assembly without the consent of the permittee, nor in any manner interfere with its progress or orderly conduct.

4-3-209: PROHIBITIONS:

The following prohibitions shall apply to all parades, assemblies, protests, demonstrations, picketing, or rallies on public property (for the purposes of the section, "parades and assemblies"):

- A. It shall be unlawful for any person to carry or possess, while participating in any parade or assembly, any length of lumber, wood, or wood lath greater than one foot (1') in length, unless such object is of wood, is blunted at its ends, and is one-fourth inch (1/4") or less in thickness and two inches (2") or less in width, or if not generally rectangular in shape, such object shall not exceed three-fourths inch (3/4") in its thickest dimension.
- B. It shall be unlawful for any person to carry or possess any length of plastic or metal pipe, rod or other object greater than one foot (1') in length or greater than one-quarter inch (1/4") in its thickest dimension, including rods attached to signs, posters, plaques, notices.
- C. It shall be unlawful for any person to carry any sign, poster, plaque, or notice, whether or not mounted on a length of wood as specified in subsection A of this Section, unless such sign, poster, plaque, or notice is constructed solely of a cloth, paper, or cardboard material no greater than one-quarter inch (1/4") in thickness.
- D. It shall be unlawful for any person to ride, drive, or cause to be ridden or driven any animal or any animal drawn vehicle upon any public street, unless specifically authorized by a permit.

- E. It shall be unlawful for any person to carry or possess any projectile launcher or other device which is commonly used for the purpose of launching, hurling, or throwing any object, liquid, material or other substance.
- F. It shall be unlawful for any person to carry or possess weapons such as firearms, knives, swords, sabers or other bladed devices, axes, hammers, hatchets, ice picks, razor blades, nun chucks or martial arts weapons of any kind, box cutters, pellet or BB guns, conducted electrical weapons (CEWs), including, but not limited to, tasers or stun guns, metal/composite/wooden knuckles, any chain greater than twenty inches (20") in length or greater than one-fourth inch (1/4") in diameter, or toy or replica firearms unless such toy or replica firearm is fluorescent colored or transparent.
- G. It shall be unlawful for any person to carry or possess any balloons, bottles or any other container containing any flammable, biohazard, or other noxious matter which is injurious, or nauseous, sickening or irritating to any of the senses.
- H. It shall be unlawful for any person to carry or possess any aerosol spray, tear gas, mace, pepper spray or bear repellant.
- I. It shall be unlawful for any person to carry or possess glass bottles, whether empty or filled.
- J. It shall be unlawful for any person to carry or possess shields made of metal, wood, hard plastic, glass or any combination thereof.
- K. It shall be unlawful for any person to carry or possess bricks, rocks, pieces of asphalt, concrete, pellets or ball bearings.
- L. It shall be unlawful for any person to carry or possess baseball or softball bats, regardless of composition or size; provided, however, that such items are permissible when configured of cloth, cardboard, soft plastic, foam or paper for expressive purposes.
- M. It shall be unlawful for any person to carry, possess or wear, any gas mask or similar device designed to filter all air breathed and that would protect the respiratory tract and face against irritating, noxious or poisonous gases. This Section shall not apply to any cloth or polymer face covering worn to protect the wearer and/or nearby persons from the transmission of infectious disease.
- N. It shall be unlawful for any person to carry or possess any open flame torches, lanterns, fireworks, or other devices that utilize combustible materials such as gasoline, kerosene, propane, gunpowder, pyrotechnic stars, or other fuel sources.
- O. It shall be unlawful for any person to carry or possess any device that emits a single point of light amplified by the stimulated emission of radiation that is visible to the human eye, including laser pointers and laser scopes.
- P. It shall be unlawful for any person to carry or possess any device which contains one or more metal, wood, hard plastic, or glass spikes, barbs, or other sharp protrusions, including homemade spike strips.
- Q. It shall be unlawful for any person to carry or possess an electrical generator, whether wired or portable, unless the specific generator is installed, carried, possessed, and/or operated pursuant to a permit issued pursuant to this Article.
- R. It shall be unlawful for any person to carry, possess, or ride a skateboard in a public thoroughfare or right-of-way.
- S. It shall be unlawful for any person to participate in a parade or assembly which takes place in the roadway or sidewalk abutting any residence or dwelling not in a commercial zone between the hours of seven o'clock (7:00) P.M. or one half hour after sunset, whichever is earlier, and eight o'clock (8:00) A.M., unless the parade or assembly does not cause significant noise impacts as defined in Section 4-3-201.
- T. It shall be unlawful for any person to engage in a targeted Parade or Assembly. For the purposes of this subsection, "targeted Parade or Assembly" means a Parade or Assembly which focuses on a single residence or dwelling in the City and which proceeds solely in front of that residence for a period of more than 15 minutes.
- U. It shall be unlawful for any person to fail to abide by the instructions of a police officer or a traffic control officer given for the purpose of accommodating traffic, including emergency vehicles, through and across a parade route,

demonstration, rally, picket line or assembly.

Nothing in this Section shall prohibit a disabled person from carrying a cane, walker, or similar device necessary for providing mobility so that the person may participate in a demonstration, rally, picket line, parade or assembly.

4-3-210: CONTENT OF PERMIT:

In each permit, a copy of which shall be maintained and kept upon the person in charge of the parade or assembly at the parade or assembly site at all times during the parade or assembly, including during assembly and dispersal, the City Manager or the City Manager's designee, shall set forth the following information as that information is set forth in the approved application:

- A. The name, address and telephone number of the person to whom the permit is issued.
- B. The names, addresses and telephone numbers of the sponsoring organization, if any.
- C. The name, address and telephone number of the chairperson of the parade or assembly.
- D. The date for which the parade or assembly is scheduled.
- E. The assembly area for the parade or assembly
- F. The starting and ending time for the parade or assembly.
- G. The minimum and maximum speeds at which the parade is to progress, if applicable.
- H. The route which the parade or assembly will take
- I. The maximum number of platoons or units, if any, in the parade or assembly and the maximum and minimum interval of space to be maintained between the units of such parade or assembly.
- J. The maximum length of such parade or assembly in miles or fractions thereof.
- K. The disbanding area for the parade or assembly and the disbanding time.
- M. The number and type of vehicles and animals in the parade or assembly, if any.
- N. Whether participants in the parade or assembly shall be wearing masks.
- O. The type of security or other arrangements that will be provided to assure participants are properly directed.
- P. The number and type of electrical generators and sound amplification equipment that will be used in the parade or assembly.
- Q. The amount of a deposit, if any, necessary to reimburse the City for traffic control costs under Section 4-3-211.

The parade or assembly permit shall also set forth any condition imposed pursuant to subsection 4-3-205C of this Article. Additionally, the permittee shall advise all participants in the parade or assembly, of the terms and conditions of the permit, prior to the commencement of the parade or assembly.

4-3-211: CITY'S COSTS TO BE PAID BY PERSON OR ORGANIZATION RESPONSIBLE FOR PARADE OR ASSEMBLY:

Prior to engaging in a parade or assembly, a permittee under the provisions of this Article shall deposit with the City an amount necessary to reimburse the City for all traffic control costs incurred in connection with diverting traffic due to any occupancy of the roadway portion of a City street. These costs shall be established by the City Council by resolution. No fee shall be charged based upon the need for security or increased police protection due to the nature of the parade or assembly.

4-3-212: VIOLATION:

Any violation of the terms or conditions of a parade or assembly permit, or a parade or assembly notice pursuant to Section 4-3-203 of this Article, by the permittee or any participant in a parade or assembly is a misdemeanor.

4-3-213: JUDICIAL REVIEW:

Any applicant or permittee pursuant to this Article may seek judicial review of any decision made pursuant to this Article in accordance with the provisions of Section 1-5-302 of this Code."

Section 2. CEQA. The City Council hereby finds, in the exercise of its independent judgment and analysis, that this ordinance is not

a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as State CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(5) provides that a project does not include organizational or administrative activities of governments that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment. This ordinance merely amends the City's regulations governing parades and assemblies, and does not allow any new uses land within the City that would result in direct or indirect physical changes to the environment. In addition, this ordinance is also exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as there is no possibility the proposed ordinance would have a significant impact on the environment pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3). A Notice of Exemption has been prepared and will be filed in accordance with CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.

<u>Section 3. Termination of Emergency.</u> The City Council hereby terminates the emergency called by the Director of Emergency Services on May 30th and ratified by the City Council on June 5th.

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Severability</u>. If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be considered a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity and enforceability of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 5. Publication. The City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation published and circulated in the City within fifteen (15) days after its passage in accordance with Section 36933 of the Government Code, shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance, and shall cause this Ordinance and this certification, together with proof of publication, to be entered in the Book of Ordinances of the Council of this City.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance is adopted as an urgency ordinance for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety within the meaning of Government Code Section 36937(b), and therefore shall be passed immediately upon its introduction and shall become effective at 12:01 a.m., of November 4, 2020 upon its adoption by a minimum 4/5 vote of the City Council.

<u>Section 7. Certification</u>. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance.

Notice is hereby given that the City of Beverly Hills ("CITY") has determined that all bidders for the Elevator Modernization at the 221 N. Crescent Parking Structure and Wheelchair Lift Replacement at the Santa

5 Parking Structures ("Project") must be pre-qualified prior to submitting a bid on that Project. It is mandatory that all Contractors who intend to submit a bid, fully complete the

prequalification questionnaire, provide all materials requested herein, and be approved by the CITY to be on the final qualified Bidders list.

No bid will be accepted from a Contractor that has failed to comply with these requirements. If two or more business entities submit a bid as part of a Joint Venture, or expect to submit a bid as part of a Joint Venture, each entity within the Joint Venture must be separately qualified to bid. The last date to submit a fully completed questionnaire is 5:00 PM Wednesday, November 25, 2020.

Contractors must register as a vendor at the following website in order to download the prequalification package, and to receive clarifications and notifications when issued.

Answers to questions contained in the questionnaire are required. The CITY will use these documents as the basis of rating Contractors with respect to whether each Contractor is qualified to bid on the Project, and reserves the right to check other sources available. The CITY's decision will be based on objective evaluation criteria.

The CITY reserves the right to adjust, increase, limit, suspend or rescind the prequalification rating based on subsequently learned information. Contractors whose rating changes sufficiently to disqualify them will be notified, and given an opportunity for a hearing consistent with the hearing procedures described below for appealing a prequalification rating.

While it is the intent of the prequalification questionnaire and documents required therewith to assist the CITY in determining bidder responsibility prior to bid and to aid the CITY in selecting the lowest responsible bidder, neither the fact of prequalification, nor any prequalification rating, will preclude the CITY from a post-bid consideration and determination of whether a bidder has the quality, fitness, capacity and experience to satisfactorily perform the proposed work, and has demonstrated the requisite trustworthiness.

All qualification submittals are required to be submitted electronically via Planet Bids. The electronic submittal system will close exactly at the date and time set forth in this request for qualifications.

Any questions regarding the questionnaire and qualification package should be submitted via PlanetBids by 2:00PM, November 16, 2020. Questions sent via email or over the phone; with the exception of those related to accessing or using PlanetBids, will not be answered.

Contractors are responsible for submitting and having their documents accepted before the closing time set forth in the request for qualifications. **NOTE:** Pushing the submit button on the electronic submittal system may not be instantaneous; it may take time for the Contractor's documents to upload and transmit before the documents are accepted. It is the Contractor's sole responsibility to ensure their documents are uploaded, transmitted, and arrive in time electronically. The City of Beverly Hills will have no responsibility for documents that do not arrive in a timely manner, no matter what the reason.

The prequalification packages shall be labeled "CONFIDENTIAL PREQUALIFICATION STATEMENT FOR THE ELEVATOR MODERNIZATION AT THE 221 N. CRESCENT PARKING STRUCTURE AND WHEELCHAIR LIFT REPLACEMENT AT THE SANTA MONICA 5 PARKING STRUCTURES"

The prequalification packages submitted by Contractors are not public records and are not open to public inspection. All information provided will be kept confidential to the extent permitted by law. However, the contents may be disclosed to third parties for purpose of verification, or investigation of substantial allegations, or in an appeal hearing. State law requires that the names of contractors applying for prequalification status shall be public records subject to disclosure, and the first page of the questionnaire will be used for that purpose.

Each questionnaire must be signed under penalty of perjury in the manner designated at the end of the form, by an individual who has the legal authority to bind the Contractor on whose behalf that person is signing. If any information provided by a Contractor becomes inaccurate, the Contractor must immediately notify the CITY and provide updated accurate information in writing, under penalty of perjury.

The CITY reserves the right to waive minor irregularities and omissions in the information contained in the prequalification application submitted, and to make all final determinations. The CITY may also determine at any time that the prequalification process will be suspended for the Project and the Project will be bid without prequalification.

Contractors who submit a complete prequalification package will be notified of their qualification status no later than ten business days after submission of the information.

The CITY may refuse to grant prequalification where the requested information and materials are not provided by the due date indicated

above. There is no appeal from a refusal for an incomplete or late application, but re-application for a later project is permitted. Neither the closing time for submitting prequalification packages for this Project will be changed in order to accommodate supplementation of incomplete submissions, or late submissions, unless requested by the CITY in its sole discretion.

In addition to a contractor's failure to be pre-qualified pursuant to the scoring system set forth in the prequalification package, a contractor may be found not prequalified for either omission of or falsification of, any requested information.

Where a timely and completed application results in a rating below that necessary to pre-qualify, an appeal can be made by the unsuccessful Contractor. An appeal is begun by the Contractor delivering notice to the CITY of its appeal of the decision with respect to its prequalification rating, no later than two business days following notification that it is not pre-qualified. The notice of appeal shall include an address where the Contractor wishes

to receive notice of the appeal hearing. Without a timely appeal, the Contractor waives any and all rights to challenge the decision of the CITY, whether by administrative process, judicial process or any other legal process or proceeding.

If the Contractor gives the required notice of appeal, a hearing shall be conducted no earlier than five business days after the CITY's receipt of the notice of appeal and not later than five business days prior to the date of the Notice Inviting Bids for this Project. Prior to the hearing, the Contractor shall, in writing, be advised of the basis for the City's pre-qualification determination

The hearing shall be conducted by a panel consisting of three members of the Public Works Department senior management staff (the "Appeals Panel"). The Appeals Panel shall consider any evidence presented by the Contractor, whether or not the evidence is presented in compliance with formal rules of evidence. The Contractor will be given the opportunity to present evidence, information and arguments as to why the Contractor believes it should be

pre-qualified. Within one day after the conclusion of the hearing, the Appeals Panel will render a written determination as to whether the Contractor is pre-qualified. It is the intention of the CITY that the date for the submission and opening of bids will not be delayed or postponed to allow for completion of an appeal process.



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
