

Attempted Robbery on South Beverly Drive

On Friday at 3:09 p.m., the BHPD received a report of three males involved in a physical altercation in the 200 block of South Beverly Drive, according to Lieutenant Giovanni Trejo.

It was later reported that one of the suspects was armed with a handgun.

Responding officers initially believed that the suspects had committed an attempted carjacking. After further investigation, it was then determined that the incident was an attempted robbery. Officers searched the area and it was determined that the suspects had fled Beverly Hills

BHPD Seizes Vehicle Associated with Sideshow

On Feb. 18 at 11:29 p.m., the BHPD responded to a large-scale sideshow take over at the Canon Drive / Lomitas Avenue intersection. Several arrests and vehicle impounds were made.

BHPD Traffic Investigators have been reviewing CCTV footage and other digital evidence in an attempt to identify vehicles and persons involved in the incident.

A license plate associated with one of the primary vehicles involved in the sideshow was identified.

Once investigators identified the license plate of the vehicle, a warrant was granted to seize the vehicle.

The vehicle was located by the CHP in south Los Angeles on Friday. The driver was arrested by CHP for additional violations committed during their enforcement stop. The vehicle was then impounded by BHPD officers, and will be stored for up to 30 days.

BHPD said they will continue to investigate this case and seek criminal charges for the crimes that occurred last weekend.

Candidates File for City Council

As of Wednesday morning, the following candidates have filed for the June 7 City Council election: Beverly Hills Freedom Rally founder Shiva Bagheri, attorney Darian Bojeaux, Councilmember Lester Friedman, Planning Commissioner Andy Licht, Public Works Commissioner Sharona Nazarian, and Mayor Robert Wunderlich. Incumbent Howard Fisher and Jake Manaster have filed for City Treasurer.

Blake's Costs Escalate

At their Feb. 22 meeting Board President Mary Wells pulled a change order from the consent calendar to question the hourly rate of some of Don Blake's Team Concept Development Services (TCDS) employees. The Board also removed a presentation from the Citizens Construction Advisory Committee (CCAC) from the agenda because they were only allowed five minutes due to time constraints

"I was looking to find an old report since I've been on the Board, a change order for hourly rates for TCDS. I noticed on a previous invoice when I first got on the Board where the hourly rates for any of the employees are say for example at \$133 an hour, and now I am noticing on current reports that the hourly rates have increased to \$185 an hour. That's like a 30% increase for hourly rates for certain individuals. And in another case almost 40% of an increase. I just don't see anywhere where that hourly rate increase came to the Board as an approval. So, I am curious how that happened," Wells said

The rate schedule was approved as part of the original contract with TCDS.

"I don't believe there has been any change in that rate schedule for a while. Let us take a look at that and see what is going on because that rate schedule was approved by the Board and any changes to that would come to the Board," Assistant Superintendent of Business Services Wade Roach said.

The Board also issued a RFP for Bond Management Services on Feb. 1. The move could effectively end the role of TCDS.

"I compared it to that 2017 contract and it has increased. And I compared it to

the proposed contract and it actually has proposed 10% increases on these 30% increases. I just think that's something that we should follow through," Wells said.

The CCAC was formed by Superintendent Michael Bregy and Blake and is composed of three people. They have met 22 times in the past three years, according to the presentation. The purpose of the CCAC was to help the Board pro-

vide accountability to the community. The CCAC was required to provide reports at least four times a year, at a regular Board meeting. However, this is the first time they have attempted to present a report.

The presentation included the cost of oil well remediation at Beverly High and

the remaining \$21 million cost. It also looked at demographic projections and current inflation.

The CCAC is now recommending frequent Study Sessions to "address issues identified by CCAC, CBOC, and FCC."

In Blake's Oct. 21, 2021 presentation he reported that the program is at

a shortfall of \$129 million. But, in the CCAC report, the number dropped to a \$69 million shortfall.

The CCAC presentation will be presented to the Board at a future meeting.

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through eighth grade, with enrollment that ranges from 516 to 721 students.

The project site is located in both the C-3T-2 Commercial Zone and R-4 Multiple-Family Residential Zone. The campus is currently composed of two buildings, generally identified as the Oakhurst building and the Doheny building on the northern portion of the project site along Olympic Boulevard with a partially subterranean parking structure located on the southern portion of the project site and accessed through South Doheny Drive.

An existing outdoor area with a playground and game courts is located on top of the parking structure. The project is primarily focused in the southern portion of the project site where a new gym and classroom building is proposed adjacent to South Oakhurst Drive and an addition to the existing Doheny building is proposed along South Doheny Drive.

The overall project would include 44 total classrooms and would provide 45 parking spaces within the existing parking area. According to the applicant, the intent of the overall project is to modernize the facilities and to enhance the learning environment. The applicant has stated that the existing buildings are "undersized, irregularly shaped, and lack amenities and features required to best serve current and future students."

Four out of five commissioners expressed concerns regarding the traffic management plan and its impacts on residents and three commissioners also had concerns with the rooftop playground.

Chair Andy Licht was the only commissioner who was ready to approve the project.

A letter was sent to the Planning Commission on behalf of residents on the 400 block of South Oakhurst Drive.

"The proposed project will exacerbate all of the problems we have experienced with traffic, noise, and access. We are already beyond capacity on South Oakhurst, with limited parking and bottleneck traffic at pick-up and drop-off times. For those of us working on zoom, the noise levels throughout the day and, especially, during holidays and school celebrations, is untenable, and exceeds acceptable levels of noise on residential streets. The proposed expansion will mean more traffic and more noise as the size of the building expands and enrollment increases," the letter said.

Rather than deny the project proposal, the commission directed the applicant to make changes in their plan to address the concerns of the commission. A future public hearing will take place on April 28.


Declining Projected Enrollment for BHUSD

At their Feb. 22 meeting the Board of Education discussed a demographic analysis and an enrollment projections report from King Consulting.

The district has been experiencing decreasing enrollment since 2007. Local population demographics is the primary cause. However, there is potential for the

district to enroll more of the students who live in its boundary.

In 2012 the total enrollment was 4,489

students, in 2021 that number was 3,150. The first number included several hundred students on opportunity permits, a program which has since been phased out.

According to the report, there are three factors that are important for future enrollment trends: incoming versus outgoing cohorts; residential development; and Universal Transitional Kindergarten.

The local birth rate has decreased by 17% between 2000 and 2020. Three of the last four years are at record low levels. This means that the availability of school age children to enroll is also decreasing. According to the United States Census Bureau, the median age for Beverly HIlls is 44.8 years. In 2000 the total number of people under 18 living in Beverly Hills was 6,705. In 2020 that number dropped to 5,547.

Historically, the district enrolled 50% to 60% of previous births in kindergarten five years later. In recent years, the ratio has dropped to between 40% to 50%. TK enrollment has generally been more stable compared to births. However, the TK program is about to change and could have a significant impact.

The Board also approved a new policy regarding Transitional Kindergarten (TK). These changes are required by State law.

Governor Gavin Newson has put in the budget Universal TK. Every district must now offer a TK program so that families no longer have to pay for it.

The Board already offers a TK program for eligible children who do not yet meet the minimum age criterion for kindergarten. The program is voluntary and is intended to assist children in developing the academic, social, and emotional skills they need to succeed in kindergarten and beyond.

Currently, the program admits students whose fifth birthday lies between Aug. 1 through Dec. 31 for each new school year. The program will now admit children whose fifth birthday occurs before June 30. State law requires the June 30 policy change to occur by the 2025-2026 school year.

By 2025 the district is expecting a net increase of up to 153 students due to the policy change.

Board Issues Measure BH Bonds

At their Feb. 22 meeting the Board of

Education approved a resolution regarding the future issuance of Measure BH bonds.

In June 2018, BHUSD voters passed Measure BH with 60.8% support for \$385 million in bond authorization. Approval of 55% was required.

Approximately \$160 million was accessed in June 2019 to meet the

district's first phase of construction projects.

The District will now issue the rest of Measure BH bonds in the amount of \$225 million.

In less than 30 years, several boards of education have spent slightly under \$1 billion on BHU-SD school construction.

Taxpayers will notice an increase in the next set of property tax bills, due in Nov.

Superintendents Request DPH to Align with State Masking Policy

On Monday Beverly Hills Superintendent Michael Breggy was one of 32 superindients in LA County, who had signed a petition that was shared with County Public Health Director Barbara Ferrer and all of the County Supervisors asking LA County Public Health to align with the state regarding the mask policy.

"From the beginning of this pandemic, the LADPH has always allowed its districts to be more restrictive in their policies regarding Covid. We request that this same practice is afforded to school masking policy. We believe the baseline must be county alignment to state policy and that districts choosing to be more restrictive will have every opportunity to do so," the letter said.

As of Monday, the state has lifted its mask policy for schools, effective March 11. The County has also followed suit and will be lifting the mandate on March 12. School districts will have the option to be more restrictive.

BHEA President Alana Castanon did not respond to a request for comment.

City Council Discusses BHUSD Task Force

At their Tuesday Study Session the City Council discussed creating a special task force between the City and BHUSD to work collaboratively on enhancing early childhood education (ECE) and community-based programming.

On July 9 Governor Gavin Newsom signed Assembly Bill 130: Education finance: education omnibus budget trailer bill (AB 130). This bill includes the establishment of Universal Transitional Kindergarten (UTK).

Villanueva Speaks at Rotary

LA County Sheriff Alex Villanueva spoke at Beverly Hills Rotary on Feb. 14. He discussed the current state of law enforcement and how they catch criminals in the midst of criminal justice reform.

On Feb. 17 City Council Liaisons, Mayor Robert Wunderlich and Councilmember Lester Friedman, as well as Board President Mary Wells and Board Vice President Noah Margo discussed the impacts and opportunities presented by the adoption of AB 130 to further expand UTK throughout the City.

The Committee members expressed eagerness to how the City might strengthen ECE offerings and community-based programming for children including: the potential development of a central hub for ECE resources like a Early Childhood Center in Beverly Hills, and new parks and open space for recreation offerings and program partnerships.

At the conclusion of the meeting, the committee members recommended an item be taken to the City Council for approval to create a special task between BHUSD and the City to work collaboratively on enhancing ECE and communi-

ty-based programming.

It was recommended by Wunderlich and Friedman, that the Council approve the creation of a special task force to foster collaboration in the City.

A similar item will be brought to the BHUSD Board of Education for their approval of a joint task force.

BHPD Arrest Robbery Suspects

On Feb. 15 the Beverly Hills Police Department announced they have ar-

rested multiple suspects believed to be responsible for a series of armed robberies in 2021 in Beverly Hills and other Southern California cities. A comprehensive investigation by BHPD detectives, including numerous outside law enforcement agencies, led to the identification of several suspects.

On Feb. 10 members of the BHPD's SWAT team and Detective Bureau conducted search and arrest warrant operations in the cities of Hemet, Banning, and Winchester. SWAT team members from Santa Monica Police Department, North Orange County, Riverside County, Hemet Police Department, Murrieta Police Department, and Menifee Police Department provided support to the joint operation.

This large-scale investigation included Irvine, Brea, Hemet, Upland, Santa Monica, and Menifee, Murrieta Police Departments, Riverside and Los Angeles County Sheriff's Departments, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, and the United States Secret Service.

The following suspects were arrested for robbery and conspiracy to commit robbery: 19 year old Jeremy Hays of Hemet; 19 year old Ronald Christopher Mendez-Cantu Jr. of Hemet; and a 15 year old male juvenile.

Arrest warrants for robbery and conspiracy to commit robbery are outstanding for the following individuals related to this investigation: Darrell Skakhan Hollawayne, Jr. of Hemet, Desmond Jay Hines, of Winchester, Mahmoud Fathi Salah, of Hemet, and Dmari Josiah Beed, of Murrieta.

These suspects are considered armed and dangerous.

Several pieces of evidence connecting the suspects to the crimes were collected during the search of their homes, including a semi-automatic handgun, which was illegally converted to full-automatic.

Detectives are still conducting follow-up, which may result in the identification of additional individuals.

Indictment in Case of Beverly Hills Man Killed With Fentanyl

A Koreatown man was arrested Saturday on federal charges alleging he worked with a Hollywood woman who ran a drug-delivery operation that in

one incident sold counterfeit oxycodone pills containing fentanyl that resulted in a fatal opioid overdose of a Beverly Hills man. Mucktarr Kather Sei, 36, whose stage name is Kather Sei, was charged in a feder-

al grand jury indictment returned February 24. The indictment alleges that Sei delivered fentanyl-laced pills that led to the death of a Beverly Hills man in 2020.

The second defendant in this case who allegedly orchestrated the drug-delivery service - Mirela Todorova, also known as "Mimi," 33, of Hollywood - is currently being held without bond after being charged last year for possession with intent to distribute cocaine and MDMA.

Todorova and Sei are charged with one count of conspiracy to distribute and possess with intent to distribute controlled substances resulting in death, and one count of distribution of fentanyl resulting in death. The four-count superseding indictment filed last week also charges Todorova with the two previously alleged drug counts stemming from the seizure of cocaine and MDMA at her residence in March 2021.

Todorova provided cell phones and narcotics, including counterfeit oxycodone pills that contained fentanyl, to Sei and other drivers to facilitate the delivery of drugs to customers across Los Angeles County and elsewhere, according to the indictment. Todorova also delivered drugs herself and gave Sei keys to her Hollywood apartment so Sei could access drugs when Todorova visited Mexico, where she continued to manage her drug operation while tending to her pet jaguar, "Princess."

The indictment alleges that on Nov. 15 and 16, after a 37-year-old man placed orders for oxycodone pills to Todorova's phone number, Sei allegedly delivered pills laced with fentanyl that caused the man's fatal overdose in his Beverly Hills home. As part of that transaction, Sei called the man from a phone that Todorova provided to facilitate drug sales.

Before and after the fatal overdose, other drug customers raised concerns about the authenticity and safety of the oxycodone pills that Todorova and Sei allegedly distributed. Several weeks before the death of the drug customer in Beverly Hills, according to the indictment, another customer texted Todorova, "Yo mimi the oxys are dirty."

The charges of conspiracy to distribute drugs and drug distribution resulting in death carry a mandatory minimum sentence of 20 years in federal prison and a maximum sentence of life imprisonment.

Tell me about your play "Daughter of the Wicked."

When I left Israel at the age of 18, I wanted to pursue acting. I went to London and then New York and I did 25 plays in New York. And then I came to

LA because that's the place to do movies, television, and to pursue acting. I did lots of movies of the week and miniseries. **know that anything is** said "this is the most extraordinary play." I met my husband Sam Schwartz with a music agency, repre-

senting a lot of famous composers and artists, like John Williams, James Newton Howard, and James Taylor.

I kind of stopped acting because I felt that supporting him was more important. I have two amazing, magnificent daughters which I consider my biggest achievement, raising those two girls. One I gave birth to, and one I adopted. I stopped acting but I didn't leave the creative, I was producing movies and I produced for New Image, the movie "Nobody's Baby" with Gary Oldman. I was doing it for 15 years but I wasn't really satisfied with it. It was really doing business

rather than creating something new. And when my girls got married and left the house I wanted to come back to that side of my brain, which was the creative part. Even though I didn't do it for so many years, I thought 'what am I going to do with my life? How am I going to reinvent myself?' And then I thought 'I think I am going to write my own life story.' I wasn't going to go audition like in my 20s, 30s, and 40s, and go and look for a part. I was going to write my own play, write my own story, a woman one sole show, and perform it. And that's going to be fulfilling enough. During the last three years that's all I did, was write my play and send it to very extraordinary writers. I worked with amazing writing coach-

> es. I sent it to famous writers like Julian Fellowes, you know, Downton Abbey. He said 'this is the most You know, for an actress, writer, you don't believe it.

But when we performed a year ago to limited audiences just to test it out, they confirmed it was worthy enough to move forward and open it at the Odyssey The-

You have said that "This is an immigrant story that many audience members will relate to" can you elaborate on that?

I left Israel when I was 18. So, it's my journey. I left Israel because life was really tough in Israel. I lived in a hut for 13 years. I was born on the floor in a hut. Israel, in those days, everyone lived in



those huts. They were temporary huts. They were supposed to be temporary solutions for the countless immigrants that came from all over the world to the newly established country of Israel. We lived in a one room hut, with dry wood floors, no electricity, no roads. The toilet was outside in a hole in the dirt, and that's how we lived. From there we moved to the Shikunim which were the projects. They were worse than the huts. The huts were at least in nature surrounded by eucalyptus trees. The Shikunim was crowded and people came from all over the world. But when I was 18, I had to leave. I wanted to be an actress but I couldn't tell my rabbi father 'oh I want to be an actress.' You had to be a teacher, a nurse, or something else. But not an actor.

The reason it's an immigrant story is because immigrants leave their countries for different reasons. I left my country because I am Yemenite and I am darkskinned. I was called Shvartze, which is Black. I wanted to be celebrated and I wanted to be appreciated and loved for being exotic.

Tell me more about your acting career in New York and Los Angeles

When I left [Israel] I reinvented myself. I went to New York and I became an actress. I worked on many, many plays. Lots of Mario Fratti's, I worked with

Christopher Reeve.

That was my dream, I realized that's what I wanted to do. Obviously, the natural step was coming to LA. So I came to LA and I would do miniseries and movies of the week. As an actress, I played in the miniseries Onassis with Raul Julia. I played Artemis, Onassis's sister. I played Dark Holiday with Lee Remick, and many more.

Then when I met my husband the most important thing was raising my kids. So, then I switched to producing movies, which I did the Gary Oldman movie, "Nobody's Baby". For me this was full circle, returning to my roots. I was very embarrassed by them, and no one knew. I was hiding it all those years.

Tell me about your husband, agent Sam Schwartz.

My husband is the most extraordinary guy. He has people skills like no one else. He is ambitious. I talk about him in the play. I say in my play 'when you look for a husband, you end up marrying your father.' But, my husband is the opposite of my father. Because he is so ambitious, outgoing, a real talker, and amazing at what he does. He represented the most famous clients for the past 40 years. He had the most successful agency.

What do you hope to accomplish with your play?

That people will identify with my pain and learn how to overcome it like I have. And come to terms with their past. An immigrant that comes to this county, [I want them] to know that anything is possible. It's not only about my past pain and to overcome it, but it's an immigrant story, that [shows] anything is possible. For any immigrant, it doesn't matter what county. And for being Black as well. No matter what your skin is, you can accomplish whatever you want.

At their Feb. 24 Special Meeting the Planning Commission debated the Cheval Blanc project while several residents called in to voice their concerns over the proposal.

The commission decided to send the project back with revisions to address the issues that were raised.

Cheval Blanc is a 115 room luxury hotel with restaurants and ancillary services, a private club, and street level retail uses proposed for North Rodeo Drive. The site is located at 456 and 468 North Rodeo Drive.

The project is located within the northern portion of the Business Triangle near retail and restaurants. North of the site, across South Santa Monica Bou-

levard, are smaller retail and restaurant storefronts. Further to the north, located on North Santa Monica Boulevard, are city-operated parking structures and Beverly Gardens Park.

The proposed building is four stories on the North Rodeo Drive side, has multiple step-ups in building height towards the east side of the project site, and a maximum height of 9-stories on the project's North Beverly Drive side.

Some concerns were raised about the project height, including opinions indicating that the nine story building will

destroy the sense of village in the area.

Several retailers also voiced concerns about plans to relocate an alley located on the 400 block between Rodeo and North Beverly Drive. Multiple commenters indicated that clientele access stores through rear doors adjacent to the alley. They said these are key entrances and temporary or permanent disruptions will have a direct impact on business. Several retailers retained local attorney Murray Fischer to represent them.

The existing alley would be relocated

from a north-south configuration to the southern portion of the project site, accessible from North Beverly Drive.

Commissioner Peter Ostroff stated that there needs to be good faith communications between the applicant and the neighbors of the alley to address this is-

said the issues regarding the alley must be resolved before the project can move forward.

The commission expressed concerns over the flow of traffic on little Santa Monica. The building's motor court would be located on little Santa Monica Boulevard. Valet parking is proposed for the hotel, club, spa, restaurant, and retail uses.

"The biggest issue for me is the traffic impact. I'd really like to see this project be designed in a way where cars enter the motor court and stay on the property. Don't exit, don't go back on little Santa Monica Boulevard and have to go around the block. It's awkward, it's complicated and it threatens to create a big traffic problem. Both coming into the motor court and exiting the motor court on a relatively small street," Commissioner Gary Ross said.

The building design includes a private club integrated into the hotel portion of the building. It is expected the majority of club members will enter the building through the hotel lobby and make their way to club facilities inside the building because vehicle access to the project is through the motor court.

"I have a real problem with the cars exiting onto little Santa Monica. I've tried to offer solutions. I am anything but an expert in this area, but to me the most logical one is a down ramp inside the motor court," Commissioner Andy Licht said.

Ostroff also addressed his concerns with traffic, and the vehicle turn movements associated with the Project.

The commission expressed they would like to get to a point where they can approve the project, but that a lot of work needs to be done to address the issues that were discussed.

Even if the Planning Commission rejects the project, the developers can still appeal it directly to the Council.

'We appreciate the thoughtful feedback to our proposal from the Planning Commission and will continue working to address their comments as we move through the public review and approval process. We have engaged extensively with neighboring retailers about the alley and other issues, and will continue to seek common ground while preserving the core benefits of the project. To date, we have met with close to 300 Beverly Hills residents and other stakeholders about our proposal, and we have been delighted by the community's strong support for this vision. Cheval Blanc Beverly Hills will be a new landmark in the Golden Triangle that reinforces the City's role as a global leader in style and quality, while creating significant economic value for the community," LVMH Spokesperson Jessica Miller said.

The next hearing will take place on March 24. It is unclear if the project will make it to the Council before the June 7 election.

Illinois is the only other state in the country who has established something similar

The goals of the commission include providing resources to various state agencies and the public to inform them on the state of hate and advising the Legislature, the Governor, and state agencies on policy recommendations to promote intersocial education designed to foster mutual respect among California's population.

Starting July 1, 2023, the bill requires the commission to issue an Annual State

of Hate Commission report that describes its activities for the previous year and its recommendations for the following year. The report would be required to provide a comprehensive accounting of hate crime activity statewide and report on relevant national hate crime trends and statistics.

The Commission also approved a motion recommending to the Council to sign onto a letter of support to Newsom urging him to include in the state budget funding for the State of Hate Commission.

The Normans were out-hit, 6-5. Smith and Park singled in the sixth for Beverly Hills' other hits.


Roberts said he was "very impressed" by his team's play.

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
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
