"Planning Commission to **Discuss Hillel Expansion**"

[Issue #1177]

I'm writing concerning a proposed project at Hillel School.

I've lived next to Hillel School for over 25 years. Some of my neighbors have been here for longer, one of them for almost 50 years! We have watched the school go from humble, quaint buildings to a very large, industrial-looking, multi-story complex. While we certainly accept the school has a home here, this is also our home

We have experienced increasing problems in recent years with traffic and noise. We are thus opposed to any further development of this school. Some specific points as it relates to this project.

- 1. Most of the students are not Beverly Hills residents. They live, for the most part, in Beverlywood and the area south of Pico.
- 2. We do not think the area can withstand yet another increase in enrollment. With the school almost doubling in physical size, it seems likely they will be adding more children. Our experience with Hillel is that they do not abide by their CUP agreements and other promises to the community, so we would question assurances that enrollment increases will be modest. The enrollment should be capped at current levels.
- 3. The large structure proposed is out of character with the neighborhood. This building, if erected, will block views of the snow-capped mountains in the distance and decrease the sense of open space that has already been compromised by Hillel's previous expansion. Along with other development in the area, it feels as if this portion of Beverly Hills is being urbanized.
- 4. We would like to suggest that the school require students to ride a bus to school rather than carpool. This is what Archer School does, and I believe Brentwood as well. No students can be driven to campus; they all ride the bus. This alleviates traffic on Sunset. Prior to the pandemic, the traffic on Olympic was severely impacted by Hillel's carpool. Cars backed up all the way to Beverly (and beyond) every afternoon. If the kids at Hillel rode a bus, this daily gridlock would be greatly alleviated, benefitting not just

Westside commuters and other BH residents.

5. Oakhurst and other small residential streets should not be used at all for parent traffic. The street is barely wide enough for two cars to pass. Cars must slow down to make sure they don't hit each other, and even then, it's often a pretty close call. All of us have had our parked cars hit by parents over the years. (My own car has been hit three times.) With the bus system, the buses could simply pull up along Doheny, drop the kids off, and depart. This is better for climate change and for fighting Beverly Hills' traffic gridlock.

As for the "cut through" option being proposed between Doheny and Oakhurst, and possibly through tiny alleys, we feel this will create a "freeway" past residences and is not a viable solution. It means that a high volume of traffic will have to go down Oakhurst, a street that is far too narrow to handle it. The alleys are even thinner, with barely room for one car. The alley behind the mini mall (the one with the Supercuts) that Hillel wants to use is especially dangerous as it is a blind left turn.

We are concerned, as well, that emergency vehicles cannot access Oakhurst during carpool. Nor can residents arrive or leave. We are trapped as there is no way to get past the traffic.

We would like to have speed bumps put on Oakhurst to prevent parents (and commuters) from using Oakhurst as a cut-through. (Though it does not relate to the school expansion, this would also solve the daily problem of drivers in sports cars accelerating to 60mph or more on Oakhurst)

6. We would like to come to an agreement on noise. I personally feel this is a bigger issue than even the carpool problems. We accept that kids will make noise as they play. Currently, "kid noise" lasts from 8am to 4pm every school day; the school has some kind of recess or PE all day long. It's already quite a burden for us to endure, but we can accept it. And we are fine with a few carnivals and special events.

But in recent years, we have had events featuring DJs and very loud music on almost a weekly basis, without notification or warning. Especially as many people now work from home, it is a real problem. During the summer of 2021, the music occurred every day during their summer camp.

Thus, regarding noise, we would like to suggest the following:

*The school should agree to a specific number of special events per year. For these events, they can use DJs, microphones, and amplified music outdoors. If we all know the dates ahead of time, we can plan to be away. Perhaps three or four events/carnivals/graduations per year is a good number. But whatever is agreed upon should be honored by the school. We are tired of having to call the police, who often agree the school has no permit, and that the noise violates code, but are (understandably) reluctant to ruffle feathers and end a carnival or

us immediate locals, but thousands of event in progress. What typically happens is the school tells the police the event "will end in a few minutes." But the event continues for hours.

> *Outside of these agreed upon dates, we ask that no amplification be used at all. This means that if the outdoor rooftop basketball court / playground is approved, the coaches and yard supervisors do not play music or use microphones.

> *We would ask that there be no outdoor evening or weekend basketball games or other events. These games feature audience chants, buzzers, whistles, air horns, DJs, and sound effects and are a disruption for those that live here.

Board of Education Receives Letter from Blake's Attorney

Attorney Michael Baker, of the law firm Snell & Wilmer, sent a letter to the Board of Education on Behalf of construction manager Don Blake in regards to the contract between TCDS and Blake. The letter was a follow-up to a meeting that was had between the District and TCDS on April 19.

Blake's contract will expire this summer and there is currently an RFP outstanding to address the construction program.

Baker claims that the meeting highlighted some basic misunderstandings of what information the District has had access to as well as a "disturbing lack of knowledge" of systems currently in place.

"TCDS is confused as to why the BHU-SD meeting participants believe they did not have all the Program information at their "fingertips" particularly in light of the easy access to the information that has always existed. To date no one has either objected to or complained about a lack of access to the Program information. It is contemporaneously updated on an ongoing basis. The same would be true of the invoicing, payment and warrant issuance system," Baker said.

Baker claimed the BHUSD meeting participants did not have a handle on the scope and operations of the system in place.

"The very people who criticize and disparage also seem to be the most ignorant and uninformed," Baker said.

Baker states that the District has had access to all the project documentation for years; it hosts the information within its IT system and that information requested by BHUSD representatives, is readily available to the District.

"Are the District responsible parties who are involved in monitoring the Program, including Board members, so unfamiliar with the District's own website to the degree they do not know this information is already published and up to date? If so, there is nothing TCDS can do about that; it is entirely out of its control; and no transition plan can cure that deficiency," Baker said.

Baker then states that transitional services are not part of the TCDS Contract and that the Board has failed to give direction as to what concerns and issues the District has in regard to transition.

"The Contract contains no requirement that TCDS submit a transition plan in the event of Contract expiration or nonrenewal. The reason there is no such provision is that it was the expectation of both parties to the Contract that the Contract would be in place throughout the term of the Program Master Plan, with an extension after five years," Baker said.

Baker states that if the District hires a new bond manager it will lead to delays and unbudgeted costs. Baker also claims that the Board took an unjustified attack against Blake because he does not have a contractor's license.

"This action, undertaken with zero good faith legal basis, disparaged TCDS' reputation and caused it to go out of pocket over fifty thousand dollars to address and take steps to remove this issue that was nothing more than a bullying, ham-fisted attempt to get rid of TCDS by accusing it of doing work that required a contractor's license to force the creation of a transition plan for which the District would not otherwise be entitled to under the Contract," Baker said

Baker said that TCDS does not believe further meetings will be productive unless District participants have become able to engage in a meaningful discussion of the status of the Program.

"TCDS looks forward to continuing to provide exemplary service until the Contract terminates," Baker said.

Real Estate Developer Agrees to Plead Guilty to Bribery Charge

A real estate developer has agreed to plead guilty to a federal criminal charge for offering to buy a million-dollar home for a Los Angeles County public official in exchange for the official's assistance securing a \$45 million county lease for the developer, the Justice Department announced on April 27.

Arman Gabaee, 61, a.k.a. "Arman Gabay," of Beverly Hills, has agreed to plead guilty to one count of bribery, a crime that carries a statutory maximum sentence of 10 years in federal prison. Gabaee has agreed to pay a fine of at least \$1,149,000 and any restitution ordered.

Gabaee was a co-founder and co-managing partner of the Charles Company, a Hollywood-based commercial and residential real estate development firm. The then-county official whom Gabaee bribed was Thomas M. Shepos, 72, of Palmdale, who worked in Los Angeles County's Real Estate Division and was involved in awarding contracts to real estate developers and contractors, according to his plea agreement.

Beginning around 2011 and continuing until April 2017, Gabaee paid Shepos bribes and kickbacks of approximately \$1,000 per month in exchange for county leases, preferential contract terms, non-public information, and other benefits. From Dec. 2016 when Shepos began cooperating to April 2017, Gabaee paid Shepos \$6,000 in cash bribes during meetings Shepos secretly recorded at the direction of the FBI.

Additionally, in 2017, Gabaee offered to buy Shepos a Northern California residence - then worth more than \$1 million

- in exchange for Shepos' assistance securing a county lease in the Hawthorne Mall, which Gabaee owned and was redeveloping. Gabaee wanted the county to enter into a 10-year, \$45 million lease for county departments to rent office space in the Hawthorne Mall.

During other secretly recorded meetings with Shepos, Gabaee first offered to purchase him a home listed at \$1,199,000 in Sonoma County. Upon learning that this property was already in escrow, Gabaee offered to buy Shepos a different house, listed at \$1,095,000, and also located in Sonoma County. Gabaee placed two offers on this property, first for \$1,035,000 and later for \$1,065,000. Gabaee admitted in his plea agreement that he rescinded the second offer hours after he made it because FBI agents had approached and informed him that they were aware of his bribes to Shepos.

Shepos pleaded guilty in November 2018 to one count of making false statements to federal investigators who were investigating his financial relationship with Gabaee and one count of subscribing to a false tax return related to payments he received from Gabaee. Shepos is scheduled to be sentenced on June 27.

Rent Stabilization Commission to Discuss Fair Rate of Return, Rent Adjustment Application Process

The Rent Stabilization Commission is expected to discuss recommendations to the City Council regarding possible amendments to the Rent Stabilization Ordinance (RSO) for both Chapter 5 and Chapter 6 of Title 4 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code (BHMC) regarding surcharges that allow housing providers to pass through costs to tenants relating to water service penalties, at their Wednesday meeting. They are also expected to discuss possible amendments to Chapters 5 and 6 regarding the amount of the cap on maximum allowable annual rent increases

When the City Council adopted Chapter 5 it was meant to protect tenants who lived in units with low rent levels of \$600 per month or less from unwarranted evictions and excessive rent increases. At that time, the view was that tenants living in rental units who paid more than \$600 per month did not need those protections. Chapter 5 includes a provision that allows for an annual general rent adjustment and a procedure pursuant to which a landlord can apply to the City for a rent increase due to hardship.

However, the City Council became aware of excessive rent increases that were being imposed against tenants in units that were not governed by Chapter 5, according to the staff report. As a result, the City Council adopted Chapter 6, which generally was known as the "anti-gouging ordinance," because it only prevented rent increases that were greater than 10% per year for units that were not subject to Chapter 5.

"Due to changing circumstances in the economy and the City's rental market and

concerns raised by tenants, in 2017, the City Council adopted various amendments to Chapter 6, the most significant of which were: to impose a lower cap on annual rent increases of 3% or the increase of the CPI, whichever is greater, instead of 10%; to include a process by which a landlord can apply to the City for a rent increase based on a net operating income formula, and to add "just cause" eviction requirements," according to the staff report.

On April 6 the commission was introduced to the above-mentioned topics for discussion. The Commission requested additional information regarding these topics, including on the "just and reasonable return" doctrine and the rent adjustment application process, which is in response to the commissioners' request for more information on the issue of a "just and reasonable return."

"The "just and reasonable return" doctrine allows landlords an opportunity to request a rent increase above the annual general rent adjustment if the landlords are not receiving a "just and reasonable return" from their properties, according to the staff report.

The commission is expected to discuss what, if any, revisions should be recommended to the City Council regarding surcharges, including seismic retrofit, and allowable annual rent increases, or request staff to provide additional information to assist in making a recommendation to City Council.

Beverly Hills Celebrates May as National Bike Month

The City joins communities throughout the country to celebrate May as National Bike Month. National Bike Month was established in 1956 in an effort to promote the many benefits of bicycling which includes improved health, environment and local economy impacts.

Throughout the month, the City will launch a series of educational activities, encouraging the community to try riding a bicycle more often. The City has various types of bikeways including the following: Sharrows; pavement markings that indicate a shared lane for bikes and cars in which bicyclists may use the entire lane; Bike lanes; space in the roadway designated for bikes only with striping or pavement markings; and Protected bike lanes; lanes separated from traffic by a physical barrier such as planters or posts.

Additionally, the City encourages the community to stay up-to-date on California State laws regarding how to travel safely on City streets. The following are tips cyclists should adhere to: Ride in the same direction as traffic; Be predictable and use hand signals when turning; Wear a helmet (required for people under 18) and increase your visibility at night with

a light; Ride with confidence and stay safe by staying aware; and Always yield to pedestrians.

As a driver: Watch for cyclists and pedestrians, especially when turning and always yield to pedestrians; When getting out of the car, use your right hand to open the door and turn your body to look for oncoming bikes; Give cyclists at least three feet between vehicles and bikes when passing; and put your phone down – distractions increase reaction time.

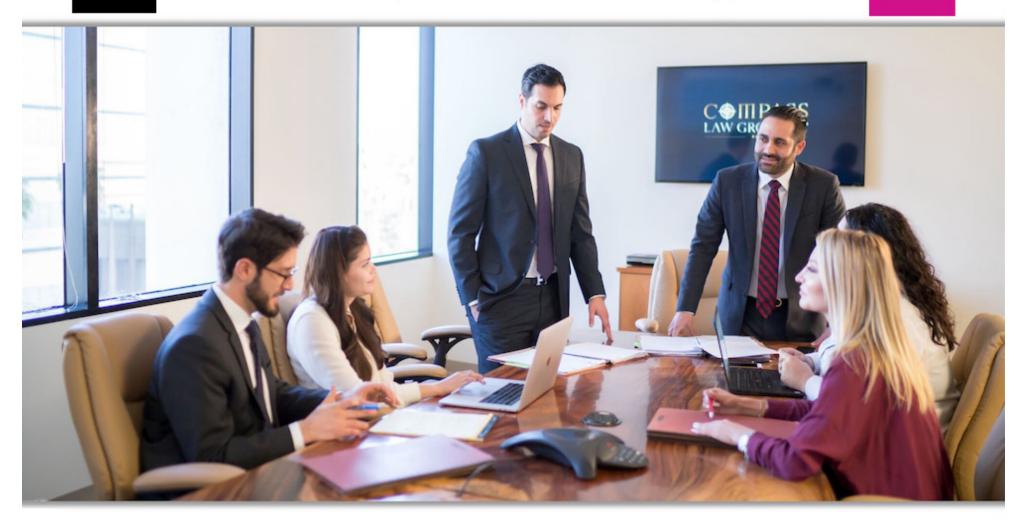

Time for Change

During the evenings of Wednesday and Thursday, April 27 and 28, Thomas White, Chairman of the Municipal League and I engaged in conducting Questions and Answers with City Council and City Treasurer Candidates. The sessions were televised. Try and view on television all the candidate interviews. The election is set for June 7.

At the outset, we thanked all the candidates for participating. Significantly, I advised them that our interviews would focus on their character and values, especially those that reflected ethical and moral forthrightness, honor and courage. At the time, I had not personally endorsed any candidate. I still have not. Simply, I had no horse in the race.

I began the process with five year City Council incumbent candidate, Lester Friedman. I focused on several areas where Lester had played a serious role as a City Council member.

The inquiry began with respect to a political piece that was mailed from the Lester Friedman campaign which I had received at home. It was a one page glossy front and back encased in plastic. Its context was boldly printed on one side: "Public safety is my #1 Priority!"

Right beside that statement were two separate photos depicting Lester standing alone in one photo with *the Police Chief in uniform* and, in the other photo, Lester standing alone with *the Fire Chief, in uniform*. I made inquiry that focused on Lester's knowledge and approval of the glossy edited mailed piece.

Lester stated that he had approved the political mailer but did not obtain permission from either the Police Chief or Fire Chief to have the photos of them used in the political mailer. Also, neither Chief had endorsed Lester as a candidate in the political campaign.

In my judgment, the political piece in question created and disseminated by the Lester Friedman campaign triggered impermissible campaign activity: The two photos depicting Lester standing beside the two Chiefs, separately and alone in each photo was intended to be "suggestive" that both prestigious Chiefs, individually, had endorsed him and that presenting the Chiefs *in uniform*, alone just with Lester in each photo, raised legal issues, to wit: State law prohibits political activity participation of any kind for officials and employees *in uniform*, even if off duty.

Would it offend common sense to suggest that the political glossy piece was an "implied suggestive endorsement" by the

Police and Fire Chiefs while in uniform? I questioned Lester regarding these matters. Suffice to say, Lester disagreed. He believed that the mailer presented no such issues and conclusions and that all was well. At all times, I asked questions and Lester gave answers uninterrupted. Of course, we are both entitled to our opinions.

Based upon the facts, I believe that the "political piece" was *misleading creating a false impression*, manipulating unwisely, for Lester's own benefit, two significant, independent prestigious community leaders, our Police and Fire Chiefs! Assuredly, the Chiefs had no expectation at the time the photos were taken that they would be used in a political mailer piece.

We moved on and picked up with a matter that concerned a prior police chief who was hired in 2016 and retired in 2020. I pointedly questioned Lester with his handling of the Beverly Hills Police Captain Mark Rosen case and others related.

Captain (Capt.) Mark Rosen was "on the job" with BHPD for over 30 years earning the rank of Captain through job performance. During his entire tenure the police department's evaluations of his service reveal an outstanding personnel record. During the period of time that he was serving as a Capt., he filed allegations that the prior chief was guilty of anti-Semitism that adversely affected him and others. Receiving no satisfaction, Capt. Rosen, represented by counsel, filed a lawsuit in Superior Court in L.A. County. More than fifteen other cases were filed by police officers and other individuals who had grievances different from Capt. Rosen's complaint while working in the Police Dept. under the Prior Chief. The charges ranged from anti-Semitism to racism to homophobic misbehaving. As a result of defending the Prior Chief, the City paid out several millions of dollars as did the insurance company employed by the City.

For example: in a case entitled *More-no, et al.* litigation, four plaintiffs were joined for the trial. For the duration of the litigation, in total fees, the City paid out \$1,739,269.00 and in costs another \$494,596.84. The result of the trial in Superior Court were as follows:

•Plaintiff *Renato Moreno* – Jury Verdict – \$350,000 – Plaintiff;

•Plaintiff Michael Foxen – Jury Verdict - \$250,000 – Plaintiff;

•Dona Norris – Jury Verdict – \$250,000 – Plaintiff;

•Shan Davis -0 – City won.

With respect to the Capt. Mark Rosen case, after extensive litigation that covered years and enormous costs, e.g., City Total Fees \$1,129,393.00 and Total Costs \$168,975.77, the case settled for \$2.3 million which the insurance company

paid. At the start of all this "Prior Chief" litigation, the insurance deductible was one million dollars. Now the deductible has been raised to three million.

Throughout the entire litigation with charges by

15 plaintiffs in the police dep't alleging against the Prior Police Chief anti-Semitism, racism and homophobic misbehavior. Lester and his Council colleagues supported and defended the Prior Police Chief. As a matter of fact. Vice Mayor Julian Gold, at the time of the civil lawsuit served as Mayor. During his State of the City address, he stated that "our Police Chief is the best in the country." Really? Or is it more appropriate to say "Come on, Man!" With respect to the Capt. Mark Rosen case, I believed that the City should have tried the case in Superior Court. Lester defended the management of the case stating that decisions were based on consultations with legal and insurance alleged experts.

Lester stated that if the City refused to settle for the \$2.3 million to be paid by the insurance company, tried the case and lost then any potential total judgment in excess of the 2.3 million would have to be picked up by the City.

For two reasons, I still thought the cause should be tried which I made clear during the Q&A:

1.Settling for 2.3 million is a big number – it's fair to say that such a large settlement indicates at least some credibility in the Capt. Rosen allegations of "Prior Police Chief anti-Semitism.

Since Lester defended the "Prior Police Chief throughout all this litigation, the large settlement defeated the notion that Capt. Rosen's allegations of anti-Semitism was not righteous.

2. The second reason I had hoped that the case should be tried was attributed to the extremely serious nature of the Capt. Rosen charge. Settlements leave open the righteousness of the allegation notwithstanding legal language avowing that the Defendant City is not agreeing with the Plaintiff's allegation.

At trial the Rosen allegation could be defeated assuming that the City had immutable facts supported by convincing corroborative evidence, all legally admissible. If the City lacked such facts and evidence, Settlement makes sense but then why would Lester defend the "Prior Police Chief" and regard Capt. Rosen's allegation of anti-Semitism not righteous! As a matter of interest, if no such facts and corroborative evidence existed, then the fear of a large jury judgment makes eminent good sense.

Having prosecuted successfully scores of serious felonies and murder cases, I understand and respect the notion that there are no guarantees of outcomes when you try a case. Yet, there are cases that morally require a public airing of the facts resolving whether or not the Police Chief in our City possessed and acted out abhorrent anti-Semitic misbehavior, assuming the City was equipped with the

evidence to prove its case.

In any event, once the other fifteen complaints kept pouring in, the "Prior Police Chief" should have been placed on administrative leave pending a thorough, highly competent investigation. The City never should have left the Prior Police Chief in charge during those sorrowful events.

It's fair to say that the most important job of government is to keep us safe. For the past five years, while Lester has served on City Council, crime has not only increased but surged with newly committed types of crime not seen five years ago:

•the torching on Rodeo Drive;

•the rampaging of alleged demonstrators on N. Rexford Drive screaming obscenities at residents in their homes on the 500/600 blocks north of Santa Monica Blvd.; and

•smash & grab in our jewelry stores, on and on the list goes.

My point with Lester during the Q&A on this subject, is that in spite of his sincere efforts to try and lessen the crime threatening us, he and his colleagues have been regrettably unsuccessful. Why then should any of the incumbents be rehired on election day?

Certainly my questioning of him was sharp and direct, in my judgment, for good cause attributed to, among other things, an absence of transparency on the important issues.

I have no animus toward Lester, nor any of the candidates. I believe that he has attempted to do well but has not succeeded.

FINAL THOUGHTS

Robust debate on the issues is essential to a vibrant democracy and should not be taken personally. To question a public official is a necessary act to ensure expected job performance. The public official should welcome the opportunity to answer all relevant questions. At all times, Lester was given the opportunity to answer without interruption as he saw fit.

If the public official cannot handle and welcome an appropriate 40-minute Q&A, up and back, how can he claim to have the guts, strength and intellect to protect our community against the forces of evil that seek to destroy our peace and tranquility and keep our residents living in fear? And shame on those who unlike Lester avoid the public stage and engage in hateful whispering behind closed doors.

The following value oriented thoughts are most appropriate:

"Then out spake brave Horatius,
The captain of the gate:
To every man upon this earth
Death cometh soon or late.
And how can man die better
Than facing fearful odds
For the ashes of his fathers
And the temples of his gods."

HILLEL EXPANSION CONDITIONALLY APPROVED

The Planning Commission discussed a proposed project involving the renovation and expansion of Harkham Hillel Hebrew Academy, located at 9120 Olympic Boulevard. The proposed project was conditionally approved, 4-1, with Commissioner Myra Demeter dissenting.

Harkham Hillel Hebrew Academy is a private school for early childhood through eighth grade, with enrollment that ranges from 516 to 721 students. About 25% of students are from Beverly Hills with the remaining being from the City of Los Angeles, according to the ap-

plicant.

The campus is currently composed of two buildings, generally identified as the Oakhurst building and the Doheny building on the northern portion of the project site along Olympic Boulevard with a partially subterranean parking structure located on the southern portion of the project site and accessed through South Doheny Drive.

The project is primarily focused in the southern portion of the project site where a new gym and classroom building is proposed adjacent to South Oakhurst

Drive and an addition to the existing Doheny building is proposed along South Doheny Drive.

The overall project would include 44 total classrooms and would provide 45 parking spaces within the existing parking area.

At the meeting the commissioners expressed concern regarding several aspects of the project including existing and potential traffic impacts. Additionally, the Commission expressed concerns regarding the existing vehicle queueing currently experienced on Olympic Boulevard, a portion of which may be attributable to the existing pick-up and dropoff configuration in front of the school on South Doheny Drive, which can only accommodate three vehicles at a time.

The Planning Commission made several conditions to address these issues. Student enrollment would cap at 650, playground hours would be limited to 7:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., including one weekend per month. The commission also proposed a three-student carpool permit and a single carpool lane in a revised alley.

The vehicles would access the new proposed drive aisle by making a right turn into the drive aisle from southbound South Doheny Drive. Once students have been picked up/dropped off the vehicles would proceed to exit the drive aisle at South Oakhurst Drive. The alley referenced is the east-west alley located between South Oakhurst Drive and South Palm. There will be a right turn only onto Oakhurst Drive. The commission also recommended staggered pickup times with a dedicated staff coordinator as well as possibly extending the time of the green light on Olympic.

These changes are expected to decrease the overall traffic impact currently felt on Olympic.

"I am still very concerned about your pick up and drop off. I do see your efforts but I would like you to think about other things because I am very skeptical about the safety issues as well as your capacity," Demeter said.

The commission will be presented with a resolution for conditional approval on May 26.

COVERSTORY SPARKS FLY AT BEVERLY HILLS CANDIDATE FORUM

Controversy between City Councilmember Les Friedman and Former Mayor Robert K. Tanenbaum rose as the City Council candidates met for a forum hosted by the Beverly Hills North Homeowners Association and the Municipal League of Beverly Hills on April 27.

Candidates took the floor in pairs with Friedman and Public Works Commissioner Sharona Nazarian appearing first, next was followed by Vera Markowitz and Planning Commission Chair Andy Licht, and ending with Darian Bojeaux and Councilmember Bob Wunderlich.

The event was moderated by Tanen-

baum and Municipal League Chair Thomas A. White.

During the first round of questions, Tanenbaum asked Friedman a series of questions on a flyer that was sent out by his campaign showing him in photos with the police chief and fire chief, which Tanenbaum said is a violation of Calif. law regarding officials from participating in political acts while they are uniformed. Friedman said the photos did not violate any Government Code as they were not taken for political use.

Tanenbaum then grilled Friedman over the rise in crime during his time on the council and that smash and grabs did not occur until after he was elected.

Friedman said that although there are still things that could be done to decrease crime, Beverly Hills is still the safest City in Calif. He also stated the steps that have been taken to make the community safer. Such as the drone program and the 2,000 cameras that have been installed.

Tanenbaum also questioned why Friedman sought after the LA County Democratic Party endorsement even though he did not get it, while he did not ask Nazarian who actually got the endorsement.

Nazarian was asked about her experience as an immigrant, her credentials, her work on the Rotary Club, and her thoughts on safety.

The following day, the remaining candidates also took the floor in pairs with with Councilmember John Mirisch and Robin Rowe appearing first, followed by Akshat "A.B." Bhatia and Shiva Gordon Bagheri.

Controversy also arose between Mirisch and Bagheri. Bagheri started off her statements by accusing Mirisch of playing both sides when it comes to things like election fraud and voter harvesting. Mirisch cleared the record by stating he does not believe there was enough fraud in the 2020 election that caused Trump to lose but that he is very concerned with voter harvesting, especially because city elections have been won by very few votes.

Bagheri opposes mask mandates in schools and supports constitutional rights. She also discussed her experience dealing with the City Council in regard to censorship as the founder of the Beverly Hills Freedom Rally. Bhatia discussed safety, the importance of having a stronger relationship with the School Board and City Council, and supporting small businesses

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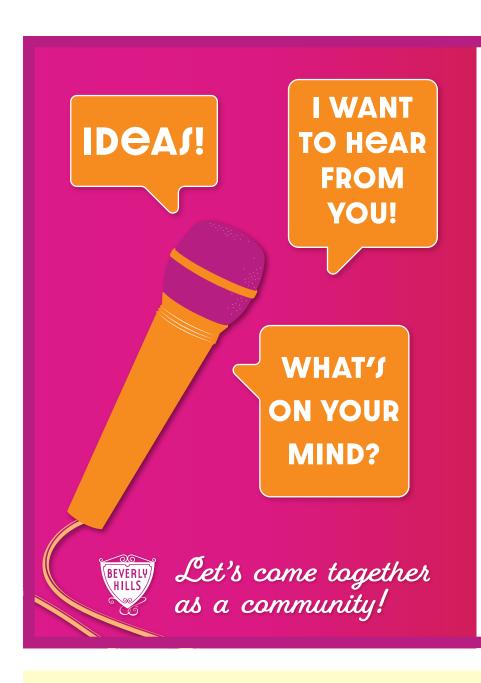

ORDINANCE NO. 22-O-2859

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY
OF BEVERLY HILLS ADOPTING A
MILITARY EQUIPMENT USE POLICY IN
ACCORDANCE WITH ASSEMBLY BILL 481

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, on September 30, 2021, the State Legislature enacted Assembly Bill 481 ("AB 481"), adding sections 7070 et seq. to the Government Code, requiring law enforcement agencies to obtain approval from their governing body before acquiring military equipment, as defined by Government Code section 7070(c); and

WHEREAS, AB 481 requires law enforcement agencies to obtain approval from their governing body by an ordinance adopting a "military equipment" use policy, at a regular meeting held pursuant to open meeting laws, prior to taking certain actions relating to the funding, acquisition, or use of military equip-

ment. AB 481 also requires that in seeking the approval of the governing body, a law enforcement agency shall submit a proposed military equipment use policy to the governing body at a public meeting and at least 30 days prior to any such public meeting, the law enforcement agency shall make the military equipment use policy available on the law enforcement agency's internet website; and

WHEREAS, the Beverly Hills Police Department currently possesses equipment that qualifies under the definition of military equipment pursuant to Government Code section 7070(c), and wishes to continue to use such equipment in a responsible manner to ensure the safety of the community and its residents; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of the proposed military equipment use policy is necessary in order to continue the use of such equipment for the purpose of protecting the safety of officers, residents and visitors in the City of Beverly Hills; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Government Code Section 7071(a)(2), a law enforcement agency seeking to continue the use of any military equipment that was acquired prior to January 1, 2022, must commence the governing body approval process for the military equipment use policy no later than May 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Government Code Section 7071, the Beverly Hills Police Department has commenced the governing body approval process and has posted a copy of the proposed military equipment use policy on the Beverly Hills Police Department's website on March 10, 2022. Said posting is more than 30 days prior to the April 12, 2022 City Council meeting.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 22-O-2859 and the proposed military equipment use policy were presented and introduced to the City Council at the public meeting held on April 12, 2022, at which time the public had the opportunity to comment on Ordinance No. 22-O-. 2859 and the proposed military equipment use policy

NOW, THEREFORE,

Section 1. The City Council hereby finds that all of the facts set forth in the Recitals above are true and correct.

Section 2. Legislative Findings. Pursuant to Government Code Section 7071, the City Council commenced the governing body approval process prior to May 1, 2022 and considered the adoption of this Ordinance at a regular, public meeting on April 12, 2022, and based on the facts set forth above, the Agenda Report, the information provided to the City Council at the public meeting, and the record thereof which is incorporated by this reference, the City Council hereby determines and makes the following findings:

A. The military equipment identified in Beverly Hills Police Department Policy 706 is necessary because there is no reasonable alternative that can achieve the same objective of officer and non-officer safety for the reasons identified in the Beverly Hills Police Department Military Equipment Inventory; and

B. The proposed military equipment use policy (Beverly Hills Police Department Policy 706) will safeguard the public's welfare, safety, civil rights, and civil liberties for the reasons identified in the Beverly Hills Police Department Military Equipment Inventory; and

C. The military equipment identified in Beverly Hills Police Department Policy 706 is reasonably cost effective compared to available alternatives that can achieve the same objective of officer and non-officer safety for the reasons identified in the Beverly Hills Police Department Military Equipment Inventory; and

D. Prior to the adoption of Beverly Hills Police Department Policy 706, the Beverly Hills Police Department was not required to have and did not have a specific policy relating to the use of military equipment. Any improper use of Departmental equipment or alleged violations of Department policies were evaluated and reviewed with corrective action taken pursuant to Policy 1010 when appropriate. After the adoption of this Policy, the designated Military Equipment Coordinator will ensure future compliance with this Policy.

Section 3. Pursuant to Government

Code Section 7071, the City Council hereby adopts the military equipment use policy entitled Beverly Hills Policy Department Policy 706 as set forth in the attached Exhibit A and incorporated by this reference.

Section 4. Severability. If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance, is for any reason held to be invalid or unenforce-able by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unenforceability shall not affect the validity or enforceability of the remaining sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases of this ordinance, or its application to any other person or circumstance. The City Council declares that it would have adopted each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase hereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases hereof be declared invalid or unen-

Section 5. Publication. Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation published and circulated in the City within fifteen (15) days after its passage in accordance with Section 36933 of the Government Code, shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance, and shall cause this Ordinance and this certification, together with proof of publication, to be entered in the Book of Ordinances of the Council of this City.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall go into effect and be in full force and effect at 12:01 a.m. on the thirty-first (31st) day after its passage.

Section 7. Certification. Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause the same to be published in the manner prescribed by law.

Military Equipment Use Policy

706.1 PURPOSE AND SCOPE
The purpose of this policy is to provide guidelines for the approval, acquisition, and reporting requirements of military equipment (Government Code § 7070; Government Code § 7071; Government Code § 7072).

706.1.1 DEFINITIONS
Definitions related to this policy include (Government Code § 7070):
Governing body – The City Council of the City of Beverly Hills which oversees the Department.

Military equipment - Includes but is not limited to the following:

- Unmanned, remotely piloted, powered aerial or ground vehicles.

 Mine-resistant ambush-protected (MRAP) vehicles or armored personnel carriers
- High mobility multipurpose wheeled vehicles (HMMWV), two-and-one-half-lon trucks, five-ton trucks, or wheeled vehicles that have a breaching or entry apparatus attached. Tracked armored vehicles that provide ballistic protection to their occupants.
- Command and control vehicles that are either built or modified to facilitate the operational control and direction of public safety units.
- Neaponized aircraft, vessels, or vehicles of any kind
- Battering rams, suges, and breaching apparatuses that are explosive in nature. This does not include a handheld, one-person ram.

 Firearms and ammunition of .50 caliber or greater, excluding standard-issue shotguns and standard-issue shotgun ammunition.
- Specialized firearms and ammunition of less than .50 caliber, including firearms and accessories identified as assault weapons in Penal Code § 30510 and Penal Code § 30515, with the exception of standard-issue weapons.

 Any firearm or firearm accessory that is designed to launch explosive projectiles.
- Noise-flash diversionary devices and explosive breaching tools.

 Munitions containing tear gas or OC, excluding standard, service-issued handheld pepper spray.

- Centes (LPQUS).

 Kinetic energy weapons and munitions.

 Any other equipment as determined by a governing body or a state agency to require additional oversight.

706.3 MILITARY EQUIPMENT COORDINATOR
The Chief of Police should designate a member of this department to act as the military equipmen coordinator. The responsibilities of the military equipment coordinator include but are not limited to

- Acting as liaison to the governing body for matters related to the requirements of this policy
- Identifying department equipment that qualifies as military equipment in the current possession of the Department, or the equipment the Department intends to acquire that requires approval by the governing body.
- nust requires approval by the governing body.

 Conducting an inventory of all military equipment at least annually.

 Collaborating with any allied agency that may use military equipment within the jurisdiction of the Department (Government Code § 7071).

 Preparing for, scheduling, and coordinating the annual community engagement meeting to include:
- Publicizing the details of the meeting.
- Preparing for public questions regarding the department's funding, acquisition, and use of equipment.
- Preparing the annual military equipment report for submission to the Chief of Police and ensuring that the report is made available on the department website (Government Code § 7072).
- Implementing the procedure for a person to submit a complaint.concern, or question about the use of a type of military equipment, and how the Department will respond in a timely manner.

706.4 MILITARY EQUIPMENT INVENTORY
All military equipment maintained by the Beverly Hills Police Department shall be inventoried and logged with the following information:

- The description of each type, including the manufacture's description of the equipment.
- (b) The capabilities of the equipment.

 (c) The purposes and authorized uses for which the Department proposes to use the equipment.

- (e) The fiscal impact of the equipment, both initially and for on-going annual maintenance (f) The quantity of the equipment, whether maintained or sought.

 (g) The legal and procedural rules that govern the authorized use.

When stocks of military equipment have reached significantly low levels or have been exhausted the Department may order up to the pre-authorized quantity approved by City Council, of stock in a calendar year in accordance with the annual military equipment report and this policy.

The Chief of Police or the authorized designee shall obtain approval from the governing body by way of an ordinance adopting the military equipment use policy. As part of the approval process, the Chief of Police or the authorized designee shall ensure the proposed military equipment use policy is submitted to the governing body and is available on the department website at least 30 days prior to any public hearing concerning the military equipment at size (Government Code § 7071). The military equipment use policy must be approved by the governing body prior to engaging in any of the following (Government Code § 7071):

- Requesting military equipment made available pursuant to 10 USC § 2576a
- Seeking funds for military equipment, including but not limited to applying for a grant, soliciting or accepting protein, local, state, or federal funds, in-kind donations, or other donations or transfers.

 Acquiring military equipment either permanently or temporarily, including by borrowing or leasting.
- (d) Collaborating with another law enforcement agency in the deployment or other use of military equipment within the jurisdiction of this department.
- Using any new or existing military equipment for a purpose, in a manner, or by a person not previously approved by the governing body.

 Soliciting or responding to a proposal for, or entering into an agreement with, any other person or entity to seek funds for, apply to receive, acquire, use, or collaborate in the use of military equipment.
- (g) Acquiring military equipment through any means not provided above

706.6 COORDINATION WITH OTHER JURISDICTIONS
Military equipment used by any member of this Department shall be approved for use and in accordance with his Department policy. Military equipment used by other jurisdictions that are providing mutual aid to this Department or operating in conjunction in a law enforcement capacity

tment, shall comply with their respective military equipment use policies in rendering

708.7 ANNUAL REPORT Upon approval of a military equipment use policy, the Chief of Police or the authorized designes should submit a military equipment use report to the governing body for each type of military equipment approved within one year of approval, and annually thereafter for as long as the military equipment is available for use (Government Code § 7072).

The Chief of Police or the authorized designee should also make each annual military equipment report publicly available on the department website for as long as the military equipment is available for use. The report shall include, at minimum, all information required by Government Code § 7072 for the preceding calendar year for each type of military equipment in department

Any member of the public may ask questions, register concerns, or make complaints by submitting a 'Military Equipment Use Inquiry and Complaint Form' on-line via the Beverty Hills Police Department's website. The receipt, processing, investigation, and response will be handled by the Department's Professional Standards Unit.

706.10 COMPLIANCE
The designated Military Equipment Coordinator will ensure that all Department members comply
with this policy, Any alleged violations of this policy will be investigated pursuant to Policy 1010 and
may be subject to disciplinary action. The Beverly Hills City Manager has final oversight authority
over the use of military equipment.

While it is the intent of the prequalification questionnaire and documents required therewith to assist the CITY in determining bidder responsibility prior to bid and to aid the CITY in selecting the lowest responsible bidder, neither the fact of prequalification, nor any prequalification rating, will preclude the CITY from a post-bid consideration and determination of whether a bidder has the quality, fitness, capacity and experience to satisfactorily perform the proposed work, and has demonstrated the requisite trustworthiness.

All qualifications submittals are required to be submit electronically via PlanetBids. The electronic submittal system will close exactly at the date and time set forth in this request for qualifications.

Any questions regarding the questionnaire and qualification package should be submitted via PlanetBids by 2:00PM, May 12, 2022. Questions sent via email or over the phone; with the exception of those related to accessing or using PlanetBids, will not be answered.

Contractors are responsible for submitting and having their documents accepted before the closing time set forth in the request for qualifications. **NOTE**: Pushing the submit button on the electronic submittal system may not be instantaneous; it may take time for the Contractor's documents to upload and transmit before the documents are accepted. It is the Contractor's sole responsibility to ensure their documents are uploaded, transmitted, and arrive in time electronically. The City of Beverly Hills will have no responsibility for documents that do not arrive in a timely manner, no matter what the reason.

The prequalification packages shall be labeled "CONFIDENTIAL PREQUALIFICATION STATEMENT FOR THE CIVIC CENTER THE CONFIDENTIAL PROPERTY AND THE CHILLED WATER LINES REPLACEMENT

The prequalification packages submitted by Contractors are not public records and are not open to public inspection. All information provided will be kept confidential to the extent permitted by law. However, the contents may be disclosed to third parties for purpose of verification, or investigation of substantial allegations, or in an appeal hearing. State law requires that the names of contractors applying for prequalification status shall be public records subject to disclosure, and the first page of the questionnaire will be used for that purpose

Each questionnaire must be signed under penalty of perjury in the manner designated at the end of the form, by an individual who has the legal authority to bind the Contractor on whose behalf that person is signing. If any information provided by a Contractor becomes inaccurate, the Contractor must immediately notify the CITY and provide updated accurate information in writing, under penalty of perjury.

The CITY reserves the right to waive minor irregularities and omissions in the information contained in the prequalification application submitted, and to make all final determinations. The CITY may also determine at any time that the prequalification process will be suspended for the Project and the Project will be bid without prequalification.

Contractors may submit prequalification packages during regular working hours on any day that the offices of the CITY are open. Contractors who submit a complete prequalification package will be notified of their qualification status no later than ten business days after submission of the information.

The CITY may refuse to grant prequalification where the requested information and materials are not provided by the due date indicated above. There is no appeal from a refusal for an incomplete or late application, but re-application for a later project is permitted. Neither the closing time for submitting prequalifica-tion packages for this Project will be changed in order to accommodate supplementation of incomplete submissions, or late submissions, unless requested by the CITY in its sole dis-

In addition to a contractor's failure to be pre-qualified pursuant to the scoring system set forth in the prequalification package, a contractor may be found not pregualified for either omission of or falsification of, any requested information.

Where a timely and completed application results in a rating below that necessary to pre-qualify, an appeal can be made by the unsuccessful Contractor. An appeal is begun by the Contractor delivering notice to the CITY of its appeal of the decision with respect to its prequalification rating, no later than two business days following notification that it is not pre-qualified. The notice of appeal shall include an address where the Contractor wishes to receive notice of the appeal hearing. Without a timely appeal, the Contractor waives any and all rights to challenge the decision of the CITY, whether by administrative process, judicial process or any other legal process or proceeding.

If the Contractor gives the required notice of appeal, a hearing shall be conducted no earlier than five business days after the CITY's receipt of the notice of appeal and not later than five business days prior to the date of the Notice Inviting Bids for this Project. Prior to the

hearing, the Contractor shall, in writing, be advised of the basis for the City's pre-qualification determination.

The hearing shall be conducted by a panel consisting of three members of the Public Works Department senior management staff (the "Appeals Panel"). The Appeals Panel shall consider any evidence presented by the Contractor, whether or not the evidence is presented in compliance with formal rules of evidence. The Contractor will be given the opportunity to present evidence, information and arguments as to why the Contractor believes it should be pre-qualified. Within one day after the conclusion of the hearing, the Appeals Panel will render a written determination as to whether the Contractor is pre-qualified. It is the intention of the CITY that the date for the submission and opening of bids will not be delayed or postponed to allow for completion of an appeal
