


"Planning Commission Sends Back Hillel Project" [Issue #1883]

This letter regards the proposed Hillel expansion at the corner of Doheny and Olympic. I'm a longtime neighbor of the school who spoke at the most recent meeting regarding the project.

During the meeting, one of the Hillel parents also spoke. She had heard my concerns, as I had gone before her. At one point, she turned to me, quite earnestly, and said, "We at Hillel keep asking ourselves, 'What can we do to make the neighbors happy?" I felt this was a sincere question, and that this parent was genuinely wanting to reach an accord.

The format of the meeting did not allow me to respond. I will do so now.

There are two ways you can make us happy. And by us, I mean most Beverly Hills residents.

One is to have your kids ride a bus. This will instantly solve the parking problems, the traffic problems, and the kid safety problems. It will save Hillel the expense of building a new alley cutting across your campus, allowing you to return to your original design. It will save Hillel the expense of hiring a fulltime traffic coordinator, which, as you know, the new CUP will require. It will negate the other CUP requirement mandating 12 teachers to open and close car doors and put kids in car seats. It will save parents and nannies the hassle (and gas!) of idling in lengthy carpool lines. It will help businesses on Olympic that lose money as their customers can't access shops and restaurants due to your carpool. It ends the problem of Hillel parents parking on our permit-only streets to dodge the carpool line, something that about half the parents currently do each day. It returns the blocks near Hillel to the quiet, residential lanes they were from the 1920s to the 1960s, before your arrival on Oakhurst in 1964 and before your major expansion in 1988. It helps Beverly Hills in its quest to lower carbon emissions and battle climate change. And for the kids, it's pretty fun. They get to socialize and be away from their parents. I remember riding a bus to school as a kid. Way more fun than mom's car.

And the bus solves the most glaring problem of all, which became increasingly clear during the most recent meeting: there is, realistically, no way for you to run a carpool that isn't going to severely impact Olympic.

A bus means that the entire Westside would finally be free of the daily gridlock that has plagued Olympic for decades.

"But what about the BH schools like Hawthorne? They don't have to ride buses!" Well, maybe they should. But the Beverly Hills schools are public schools, free to all, serving a diverse population comprised entirely of Beverly Hills kids. (Over 75% of the Hillel students are non-residents.) More importantly, the carpools for the public schools, unlike Hillel, are not causing backups on a major artery. Nor are the public schools situated on narrow streets with room for only one car to pass.

Archer School in Brentwood faced a similar situation. They are on Sunset, which in that part of Los Angeles experiences notorious backups. In order to build their school, Archer had to promise to have all kids ride buses. Mandatory. The school is still there and, to my knowledge, is still flourishing.

Like Archer, you're being granted a favor by our city. For the third time. (You were allowed expansion sand zoning exemptions in 1970 and 1980.) Return the favor; you'll "make us happy."

The second way you can "make us happy?" Three parties per year.

Everyone loves a carnival. Have a few! Let us know the dates for the whole year so we know what's coming. Every other school puts out an annual calendar before the year commences, listing every event - why not you too? Hire a DJ. Tow in the ferris wheel. Irrigate the three-story water slides. Inflate the bouncy castles. Roll in the tanks. (Yes, Hillel brings actual military tanks onto campus during parties; they rumble right down Oakhurst Drive and onto their basketball court! And no, I have no idea why, but it's quite a spectacle!)

But outside of those three special, fun days, stop holding all these over-the-top outdoor parties. Stop using booming microphones. Stop using wedding DJs and rappers. Stop yelling through bullhorns. Stop yelling, period. If you want to indicate when one recess is over, and the next one is starting, instead of multiple staff members screaming at the top of their lungs, how about a pleasant chime? (That's what Marlborough school uses.) Want to get kids' attention? Use the "silent signal." (Two fingers raised in the air, which kids mimic. That's been standard operating procedure at most schools for decades)

The sound from these parties and events, which happen at least once or twice a week, is often as loud as - and I do not exaggerate this one iota - a rock or hip hop concert at the LA Forum.

Yes, we "signed up" to live next to a school. We didn't, however, sign up to live next to an outdoor disco, a county fair, or SoFi Stadium.

And let's take a look at your first CUP issued in 1970. It mentions parents littering in our neighborhood. It mentions parents parking illegally. It mentions illegal use of the alley. It mentions noise concerns

These problems have been going on for over fifty years.

So those are two ways to make us happy. But let's take it further. Your enrollment has fallen dramatically (by hundreds) since its peak. A decline that began more than a decade before Covid. You, understandably, want to attract parents and again compete with other, more selective private schools that have to turn applicants away. You want to attract quality educators, too. Why not relocate? Prospective private school parents tour campuses that have green grass, expansive soccer fields, multiple buildings, and ample open space. No matter how well appointed your new building is, it's never going to be able to compete with that. It's still a box on the same tiny parcel. And you're stuck with an enrollment cap, which will permanently limit revenue and any further growth. Schools move all the time when they are ready to grow. Archer School did. Crossroads did. You did. Maybe it is time for Hillel to think bigger.

You'd also have the benefit of keeping kids at your current school while the new one is built. As opposed to having them try to learn in a noisy, dusty, construction

zone for three (or more) years.

Maybe you can sell (or donate) the old parcel, and it can become a park. (This corner of Beverly Hills could certainly use one.) "Hillel - The School That Gave Back."

Getting back to your proposed expansion... If you do stay, and if your proposal is (finally) approved, it is going to be a rough three (or more) years living next to a massive demolition and construction project. (I say "three years" because that is how long you are telling us it will take to build this.) It's going to be rough for commuters on Olympic and Doheny, as those two roads will need to have lanes closed regularly for trucks, bulldozers, and cranes. It's going to be rough on landlords who won't find any renters willing to endure the disruption and may even see an exodus of tenants. It's going to be rough...rougher than I think people are realizing.

You're asking a lot of us. And by us, I mean the citizens of Beverly Hills.

From you, we're asking your kids to ride a bus. And we're asking for only three parties per year. OK, we'll make it four.

I honestly don't think that's much to ask. Do those two things for a solid year. Prove yourselves. Then come back to our city with your expansion proposal. Right now, you're like a C student telling his parents, "Buy me a new video game console, and then I'll get A's." Doesn't work that way.

And that's the answer to your question. That's what will make us happy.

Traffic and Parking Commission Discusses Transit System

The Traffic and Parking Commission discussed an update regarding the selection of a transportation consultant firm and a tentative schedule for planning and community outreach for a potential City shuttle service, at their June 2 meeting.

At their March 15 meeting, the City

Council directed staff to begin developing a transit service plan with the Traffic and Parking Commission as the advisory body. Chair Sharon Ignarro, who also serves on the City's Climate Action and Adaptation Plan Community Advisory Committee (CAC), was also appointed to serve as the "bridge" between the Traffic and Parking Commission and the CAC.

The transportation planning firm of Kittelson & Associates Inc. (Kittelson) was selected by staff to prepare the transit needs assessment study to identify transit service options, which will serve as the foundation for the implementation and operation of a citywide system.

"I look at this and what I see is exactly what I was concerned about, which is a poster child for burying something in bureaucracy. Please don't let that happen," Peter Ostroff who currently serves on the CAC said during public comments.

Ostroff brought up some concerns he had regarding the report from Kittelson.

"I read this and this is what I see. The bottom line from Kittelson report on page 5 of their report in tab 6, 'the deliverable from this project should set the stage for more detailed future analysis of options including more detailed service planning and exploration of operating

models 'What on earth does that mean? It means to me that this is just a beginning to hiring more consultants, spending more money on something that does not require that. This is not that complicated. It's important. It is vital it seems to me. But please don't just delegate this to staff or consultants, take charge" Ostroff said.

Staff will continue collaborating with neighboring Westside Cities transit colleagues and Metro staff for potential regional connectivity opportunities with the City.

The next steps include: gathering stakeholder and public input; understanding transit needs in the community; analyzing existing transit services to identify gaps/unmet needs, and identifying the goals and objectives of the new transit services.

The agreement with Kittelson for the transit needs assessment study is \$49,833.

Mirisch Re-appointed to LAFCO

At its meeting on May 25 meeting, the Los Angeles County City Selection Committee appointed Councilmember John Mirisch, to the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO). However, the appointment is contingent on Mirsch being re-elected to the City Council, which

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

Allowed for the conversion of vehicle service bays to a convenience store retail use. Extended Hours Permit. Allowed for 24-hour operations of the convenience store on a property located in a Commercial-Residential Transition Zone. Pursuant to Condition No. 16 of Resolution No. 1764, the project shall be reviewed by the Planning Commission two (2) years after the expansion has been completed and operations have commenced to determine whether the project is causing any adverse impacts and whether additional conditions should be imposed to address those impacts.

This project has been assessed in accordance with the authority and criteria contained in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA, Public Resources Code Sections 21000 et seq.), the State CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Sections

15000 et seq.), and the environmental regulations of the City. Upon review, the project appears to gualify for a Class 1 Categorical Exemption (Existing Facilities) in accordance with the requirements of Section 15301 of the state CEQA Guidelines. This exemption is applicable to the minor alteration of existing public or private structures involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use. Accordingly, the Planning Commission will consider a recommendation to find the project exempt from the environmental review requirements of CFQA.

It is recommended that written public comments be submitted to the Planning Commission Recording Secretary by 11:30 AM on the meeting date. Public comments will also be taken during the meeting when the topic is being reviewed by the Planning Commission. Written comments should identify the Agenda Item number or topic in the subject line of the email. In order to be read at the meeting, written comments will be allowed with a maximum of 350 words, which corresponds to approximately three (3) minutes of speaking time. If a comment is received after the agenda item is heard, it will not be a part of the record. Any written comments received by end of the day on Tuesday, June 14, 2022 will be attached to the agenda report regarding this item. Any comments received after Tuesday, June 14, 2022, but prior the public hearing, will be distributed to the Commission under separate cover.

According to Government Code Section 65009, if you challenge the City's action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City, either at or prior to the public hearing. Please note that any comments received prior to or during the public hearing will be considered as part of the public record. 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Come from Away

Sharone Sayegh, a 2002 Beverly High graduate is performing in Come from Away until June 12 at the Ahmanson. Come From Away tells the true story of 7,000 stranded passengers and the small town in Newfoundland that welcomed them after planes were forced to land during the aftermath of 9/11.

You are in the touring production of Come from Away. Tell us about that.

It's a really beautiful Broadway show. They like to say it's a 9/12 musical rather than a 9/11 musical because it's all about [how] there were many planes in the air when 9/11 hit that was rerouted because they couldn't land in the U.S. So, it's about this story in Gander, Newfoundland, which is an island off of Canada. And in a matter of a couple hours, 38 planes landed in this tiny town that had about 9,000 people in it and 7,000 passengers landed in it in a matter of a couple of hours. So, it almost doubles the population of the town. And they were stranded there for five days. The story is all about these people in this town of Gander who literally opened up their homes, had them stay with them, cooked for them, clothed them, fed them, and

took care of these people for five days. It's kind of about amidst really terrible tragedy, how wonderful we can all be to one another; help each other, and how we are all one, which is really beautiful. It's a completely true story, too.

Tell me about your performing arts career.

I grew up in Beverly Hills, and when I moved to New York City I made my Broadway debut in Mamma Mia. Which was really fun, I did that for a couple vears. The next Broadway show I did was the original Broadway cast of The Band's Visit, which won the Tony Award for best musical. Then a whole bunch of off-Broadway things and shows throughout the county. After the Band's Visit, I joined the tour of Come from Away.

You were in the Beverly High Madrigal Singers, graduating in 2002. In what ways were you influenced by the late [choral director] Joel Pressman.

He was a really big influence on my life. I loved him as a teacher and I had him for all four years because I was in the regular choir, then Minnesingers, and then Madrigals. I also worked on all the musicals with him throughout my four years. He really taught me about ensemble singing, which really has helped me. He really introduced me to a lot of musical theater: material, music, and composers, and really brought out my joy of music. I really loved him.

How did you get involved in Broadway productions?

After Beverly, I went to study musical theater at Syracuse University and I studied it there for four years. I just always knew that was my goal in life, I just wanted to be on Broadway. That was my dream. After college, I moved to New York City and I started auditioning. I auditioned for *human kindness, and* everything I could. About two years after I moved to the City I got Mamma Mia. So, story that we all really that was an exciting first Broadway show.

What's it like to ac- tually perform in your hometown of Los Angeles?

I am so excited. [May 31] was our first performance here. Most of the shows

I've done have been in New York, so family has had to travel to come see me. It will be really cool to perform here and have a bunch of my friends and family come see me at the Ahmanson. I am also

Traffic and Parking Commission Discusses North Portal Conceptual Design

At their June 2 meeting the Traffic and Parking Commission discussed a presentation on the North Portal project, including its purpose and next steps for community engagement.

The Rodeo Station North Portal will provide a second entrance/exit to the Wilshire/Rodeo Drive Purple Line Station at the northwest corner of Wilshire Boulevard/Beverly Drive.

During discussions of the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) between Metro and the City for the construction of the Wilshire/Rodeo station, concerns were raised that subway users would not have direct access to the Business Triangle on the north side of Wilshire Boulevard.

The primary objectives of the North Portal are to provide direct access from the north side of Wilshire Boulevard to

the Wilshire/Rodeo Purple Line Station; provide direct pedestrian access to jobs, retail, and amenities in the business triangle; improve pedestrian flow and avoid significant degradation of vehicular flow in the vicinity of the Wilshire/Rodeo Purple Line Station; and minimize pedestrian street crossings on Wilshire Boulevard.

The Draft EIR analyzed three potential north portal locations on the north side of Wilshire Boulevard: the West side of North Beverly Drive, the West side of North Cañon Drive, and the North Cañon Drive Staging Yard site. There was an overwhelming number of public comments stating a preference for Beverly Drive due to its closer proximity to the Triangle. On Nov. 10, 2020, City Council certified the EIR and selected Beverly Drive as the location, and approved a Settlement Agreement between the City and Metro, which included a cost-sharing agreement that each party will contribute 50% of the project cost.

The next step is to complete the design of the North Portal. The North Portal on the west side of Beverly Drive will be designed as a half-portal consisting of stairs, one "up" escalator, and two elevators within the existing street and sidewalk right-of-way. The adjacent sidewalk on the west side of Beverly Drive will be widened, resulting in the removal of parking spaces on both sides of the street south of Beverly Cañon Gardens

and the removal of the short-term tour bus loading zone. The City's goal

is to have the North Portal opening coincide with opening of the the Wilshire/Rodeo Station in late 2025, which is anticipated to take 18 months. The cost to design the North Portal is \$9.79 million.







Without a timely appeal, the Contractor waives any and all rights to challenge the decision of the CITY, whether by administrative process, judicial process or any other legal process or proceeding.

If the Contractor gives the required notice of appeal, a hearing shall be conducted no earlier than five business days after the CITY's receipt of the notice of appeal. Prior to the hearing, the Contractor shall, in writing, be advised of the basis for the City's pre-qualification determination.

The hearing shall be conducted by a panel consisting of three members of the Public Works Department senior management staff (the "Appeals Panel"). The Appeals Panel shall consider any evidence presented by the Contractor, whether or not the evidence is presented in compliance with formal rules of evidence. The Contractor will be given the opportunity to present evidence, information and arguments as to why the Contractor believes it should be pre-qualified. Within one day after the conclusion of the hearing, the Appeals Panel will render a written determination as to whether the Contractor is pre-qualified. It is the intention of the CITY that the date for the submission and opening of bids will not be delayed or postponed to allow for completion of an appeal process.


