

City Manager George Chavez to Retire

After 35 years serving the Beverly Hills community, City Manager George Chavez announced that he will retire this Dec.

"George Chavez is a beloved treasure," said Mayor Lili Bosse. "For more than three decades, he has been the fiber of our community. As City Manager, his calm and

strong leadership and heartfelt connection to the essence of what makes Beverly Hills so special has always made him a cherished leader. On behalf of the City Council and our entire community, we are

deeply grateful to him for being the heart and soul of our community and wish him the very best in his well-deserved retirement."

Chavez was appointed Beverly Hills City Manager in June of 2019. He began his career with Beverly Hills in 1988 as a Building Inspector and has worked in a variety of positions including Assistant Director of Community Development/City Building Official and Director of Public Works before being named Assistant City Manager in 2016. He is a recipient of the City's Fred C. Cunningham Award for Distinguished Service.

"When I began my tenure as City Manager in 2019, I could not have predicted the unprecedented challenges that lie just around the corner," Chavez said. "From civil unrest to the global pandemic and its financial impacts to our City, it was the commitment and resilience of our City Council, employees and community that helped us emerge stronger and ready for the future. I leave the City in very good hands and will treasure the friendships I've made for the rest of my life. Thank you Beverly Hills."

Planning Commission Discusses Hedge Heights

At their Thursday meeting the Planning Commission discussed the rules regarding wall, fence, and hedge height requirements and provided direction to staff regarding a draft ordinance that will be presented to the Planning Commission at a future hearing. The discussion focused on hedge height in rear yards and they will discuss wall, fence, and hedge height in side and front yards at a future date.

On May 10 the City Council held a study session to discuss the rules governing the maximum height of hedges in residential zones and directed staff to work with the Planning Commission to draft an ordinance that would allow taller walls, fences, and hedges in rear yards in residential zones

The City has recently received an influx of inquiries regarding increasing allowable wall, fence, and hedge heights due to security concerns, particularly along rear alleys.

The Beverly Hills Municipal Code outlines the regulations that govern the height of hedges in the City. The allowable height is dictated by where in the City a property is located.

The maximum height in the City for rear yards is eight feet for most areas except in the hillside area where it is seven feet.

The Commission agreed that there should be no change in the Trousdale Estates and will discuss whether or not the hillside area of the City needs any change. The Commission was also interested in placing specific conditions for properties adjacent to alleys due to the increase in safety concerns.

They also agreed that a hedge allowance may be taller than a wall or a fence.

"You would encourage people who want more safety to have green instead of chain link," Chair Andy Licht said.

The Commission also agreed they needed input from the police department before any ordinance is drafted since most of the public concerns were regarding public safety.

"I think it is a two-edged sword. If you are completely obscuring your backyard from anybody looking into it they are not going to be able to see bad things happening there. It's complicated and that's why I think we need the input of the police," Commissioner Peter Ostroff said.

The Commission will continue this discussion at a future meeting.



Board Approves Grandparent Permits

The Board of Education approved the implementation of Grandparent Permits for the 2022-2023 school year, at their Tuesday meeting.

Superintendent Michael Bregy previously presented survey results to the Board at their May 24 meeting where many community members indicated an interest in having their grandchildren attend BHUSD schools through what is known as grandparent permits.

Upon the advice of counsel, the following process and procedure were recommended for granting the permits: a lottery system should not be considered due to the legal implications; a permit will be granted on a first-come/first-serve basis, and families will be notified by July 15 to allow them to plan accordingly.

The Board previously discussed three options for enrollment numbers: the first option was to base the number of permits based on the percentage of available space per grade level; the second option was to create a cap on the total number of permits, such as 100 total permits; the last option was to combine the first two options by using a percentage of the available space per grade level and creating a cap on the total number of permits, such as 25% of available space and up to 100 total permits.

The Board also discussed whether or not to implement residency requirements for the permits. The Board was presented with three options: whether to require two or more years of residency within the BHU-SD, 7 or more years, or 10 or more years.

The Board decided to go with a 10 year residency requirement and capping enrollment at 100 cumulative permits. They also agreed to provide permits to both elementary and secondary students.

Additionally, once a student enters the district they will not be turned away as long as they meet all the requirements.

"Speaking in my individual capacity (not for the Board), I'm thrilled to see the progress that Dr. Bregy and his cabinet have made on bringing the 'Grandparent Permits' to life. With a declining student population, it benefits our current students to keep a critical mass of students for our top notch programming, and I think BHU-SD can accomplish that with students that are extended members of our own Beverly Hills community," Board member Gabriel Halimi said

The Board formally approved the policy at their Tuesday meeting and the District will begin accepting applications within the next few days. The Board will review this program during the 2023-2024 school year to determine whether or not it will continue

Board Updates Bylaws

The Board of Education updated its Bylaws at their Tuesday meeting.

"I've always wanted to improve the governance of this Board. I think that fundamental things that the Board does is to set policy and the majority of our Board bylaws have not been updated since 2009," Board President Mary Wells said during a

Board study session.

Wells previously established two ad hoc committees to update and support board governance, a Board Governance Handbook Committee, and a Board Bylaw Committee.

One of the changes would require Board members to sign an annual affidavit confirming residency in the City of Beverly Hills under penalty of perjury. This change comes after Tristen Walker-Shuman stepped down from her position as a board member after allegations she moved from Beverly Hills to Pittsburgh.

Another change involves the selection of the Vice President. Instead of using total years of service, only their current term will count. If two members have the same length of service, then the person with the most votes will be selected as Vice President. A member that is appointed is considered to have zero votes.

The School Board intended to require the student board member to have at least one year of ASB experience. However, ultimately agreed that should be up to the students and the board should not dictate those decisions.

This past year, the student government reversed that requirement. Although this would have aligned with the proposed bylaws with the ASB Constitution, it would have prohibited the ability of the students to change this requirement in the future if they chose to do so.

The school board will also recognize the student board member as a duly elected member.

The new bylaws will also require resigning board members to notify the board president and the board secretary. The board secretary would then forward the resignation notice to the County Superintendent. Under Calif law, the resigning board member must notify the County Superintendent themself, and there is no requirement to notify any other individuals.

The changes would also provide a compensation of \$240 per board member per month. Board members may decline the stipend. School Board members, including former members, may also purchase healthcare plans from the District.

"I don't look at it as compensation as much as being able to cover some of the expenses that come with it. And I don't mean expenses in the professional term, I just mean stuff. Like working late and ordering some food for yourself. It helps offset for certain kinds of people living a certain lifestyle. I think this role is tended to lean towards a lot of kinds of volunteers and I would love to see more business professionals running for this position. I think this sends a signal that this is serious, you're being compensated and you're expected to really put in the time," Board member Gabriel Halimi said.

The new bylaws would also encourage all board meetings to end by 9 p.m.

City Council Discusses Universal Transitional Kindergarten

The City Council approved additional funding for the Community Services Department to hire four Part-Time Regular Childcare Counselors. These positions

would assist the BHUSD in addressing increased community demand for quality childcare services, including afterschool enrichment, due to the influx of kindergarteners into the District from the expansion of the Universal Transitional Kindergarten (TK) program.

On June 9 the City Council Liaisons / BHUSD Committee met to discuss the impact of Assembly Bill 22 should it become law and discussed opportunities it presents for collaboration between the BHUSD and the City including expansion of Community Services Department programming on school campuses.

On July 9, 2021, Governor Gavin Newsom signed Assembly Bill 130: Education finance: education omnibus budget trailer bill (AB 130). This bill provided statutory changes necessary to implement the 2021-22 Budget Act, including establishing Universal TK.

Committee members in attendance on June 9, discussed the phased expansion of BHUSD's Kindergarten program to extend to four-year-olds from their current five-year-old age limit beginning in the 2022-2023 school year. The implementation of this program in the fall of 2022 will impact both preschools as well as childcare services including the Adventure Camp program and other afterschool programming.

According to the staff report, additional Childcare staff would need to be hired to provide additional Adventure Camp classrooms starting as early as 1 p.m. Hawthorne currently has two Adventure Camp classrooms and a third would need to be added for parents seeking childcare for their 4-5-year-olds enrolled in this program. At Horace Mann, the City currently operates five Adventure Camp classrooms. The additional TK children in need of childcare would require a minimum of one classroom

The annual cost per staff is \$46,816 for a total of \$187,266 for all four positions.

Wayne Selected as New SFUSD Superintendent

Matt Wayne, a 1991 Beverly High graduate, has been selected as the new Superintendent for San Francisco Unified School District (SFUSD). According to the SFUSD website, the district currently has about 52,000 students. It is the seventh-largest district in California.

Wayne will be leaving his current position as Hayward Unified Superintendent

and begin his new position on July 1.

"I am proud to be a product of public schools and an an outstanding school district like BHUSD. I am thrilled to have the opportunity to serve the students in

San Francisco so that they may have a similarly engaging and enriching experience," Wayne said.

Board Stalls Approval of ProWest Amendment

The Board of Education stalled the approval of an amendment to the lease lease-back agreement between the District and ProWest Constructors for retaining wall No. 5. The Amendment was previously tabled at their May 10 meeting and referred to legal counsel for review.

This decision comes after an audit revealed that ProWest billed BHUSD for costs in excess of actual charges, resulting in an overbilling to BHUSD of millions of dollars.

"The Board majority did not approve the amendment because it lacked necessary information. The new Bond Manager will be in place shortly and can negotiate on behalf of the district," Board President Mary Wells said.

City Council Receives Climate Action And Adaptation Plan Update

At their Tuesday meeting an informational report was listed on the City Council Study Session agenda regarding an update on the Climate Action and Adaptation Plan (CAAP) project.

The CAAP project began in order to complete the community's 2015 and 2019 Greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions inventory and forecast. The 2015 GHG emissions inventory is intended to be the baseline and the 2019 GHG emissions inventory is intended to see if there is any increase or decrease in the community's emissions.

According to the staff report, the CAAP project has progressed significantly with the completion of the GHG emissions inventory and forecast and the guidance from the Community Advisory Committee (CAC).

Overall, the 2015 and 2019 GHG inventory showed the community had seen a 10% reduction in GHG emissions. The reduction is attributed to energy reduction and efficiencies through technology and City participation in the Clean Power Alliance (CPA) program where residents and businesses are using 50% renewable electricity, according to the staff report.

The intent of forming the CAC was to have active community members engaged in the development of the CAAP. Planning Commissioner Peter Ostroff and Public Works Commissioner Wendy Nystrom serve as co-chairs of the CAC.

"It is very disappointing, but not at all surprising, that staff would write a report on this subject without seeking any input whatsoever from the CAC," Ostroff said in a letter addressed to the CAC and the City Council. "This is typical of the way that Ms. Epstein has handled drafting of the CAAP, generally ignoring any efforts by the CAC to have any involvement in preparation of the CAAP which preparation has been left entirely to consultants hand-picked by Ms. Epstein. Predictably the emphasis is on lauding the status quo while finding reasons to thwart or at least delay efforts to make things better."

Staff is planning to present the Draft CAAP plan in Winter 2022. When the draft plan has been recommended by the Public

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Contestant on the Weakest Link

1991 Beverly High graduate Justin Bauer appeared on, and won, the TV game show the "Weakest Link" on June 6.

You recently appeared on the *Weakest Link*. Tell us about that.

It is kind of funny how it happened. I get a message on my Instagram from a talent agency. And they say 'hey, we are looking for contestants for a game show.' I always thought you try out for a game show. I thought it was identity theft and someone was trying to steal my identity. So, I look up the guy's names on Facebook and we have a mutual friend. I message her and [ask] 'is this guy for real?' She [said] 'yeah, he does casting for talent.' So, I sent him a little video of myself [and] they said 'send me a picture of you in an outfit.' So I send them my go-to outfit and they [said] 'yeah we like it.' They had me do a video and they said they really liked me. So, they called me and they said 'we would love for you to be on the show. Can you come down to the studios?' I grew up in Beverly Hills, and I was a teacher at Beverly Hills High School. But I live in Redlands and my lifestyle out here is not very Hollywood, it's very desert. It's a nice area, but it's

almost rural. I felt like a fish out of water. It was a very – almost a surreal dreamlike experience. It was so weird that the day after it happened, I was not sure it happened.

It was [filmed] at ABC studios but it was an NBC show. I literally went just for giggles. I [thought] 'this would be so much fun to see how they film the show. I am going to order Chicken and Waffles from the craft services and I will just have a fun day off and mess around. So, I get down there and they had a little parking spot for me. I go into their waiting room and they come and bring you your outfits and they whisk us a way into this room that looks like a UFO. I feel like I am on another planet. I couldn't sleep the night before. I didn't prep at all because I wanted to go in cold. I [didn't] want to stress out and think I had to study this or that. I go into this UFO with seven other people.

So, we start the show. I am a nice guy and I don't like to hurt peoples feeling or be abrasive. And if I have to be mean I am low-key about it. But [in] the show you literally have to vote people off right in front of them and tell them why you

are voting them off. So, I am immediately uncomfortable. We go into the show and it just starts happening. I didn't think I really had a shot. There were six different rounds and in the first round everyone was like 'you're so calm, cool, and collective.' And it was because I didn't care. I didn't think I was going to win. I was just doing

it for chicken and waffles. And I started doing really well and I didn't realize until the sixth round that I really had a good shot. It was just the most bizarre, surreal experience and it was the easiest money I've ever made in my entire life. I even said to them 'what time should I come tomorrow?' It was amazing.

The whole thing was a miracle because I have a business [JD Bauer Botanicals]. I recently quit teaching, and I started my own soap business. All-natural, vegan, medicinal soaps. And it's taken off really well. So, I had a lot of people wanting to invest. And like I told you, I am a nice guy. I do not want to take somebody's money and lose their money. And taking people's investments in my company petrified me. And what if I failed and lost somebody's money? I couldn't live with myself. So I need capital to start building my company. And then I get on this game show and I win.



How much did you win?

I won \$79,500. It's a good little start-up fund.

What advice do you have for people hoping to get on the show?

Don't think you can't, you can. Don't ever go into something thinking you can't do it. You can do it. I will say it's 80-90% mental. That was a big one for me. I've done some things in my life -I've joined the Marine Corps. This was the most intimidating experience I've ever had. It was scarier than boot camp for me. You just go into this foreign environment, you're on the spot. There are no go-backs. The thing that helped me the most was just going in there with a positive attitude, don't take it too seriously [and] enjoy yourself. That's my advice. If you're going to go through it, please go through it smiling, even if you lose. I didn't go there expecting to win. If you watch it, I am utterly surprised at the end.

A Message from Former School Board President Hon. Brian David Goldberg, Ph.D., Psy.D.:

It has been a long 7 years since I was falsely accused of battery by a disgruntled neighbor, and I am happy to share with the community that I have been fully exonerated of any wrongdoing, both criminally and civilly, with regard to this matter. Those who believe in the bedrock principle of our legal system, that a person is innocent until proven guilty, stood by and with me. There are too many people to thank individually but you know who you are. I want to thank you publicly for always having my back.

The other party in the civil suit demanded that the terms of the settlement reached be kept confidential, but I required that the following language be made public or we would go to trial:

"The only exception to the confidentiality provision is that the parties may state as to the case, 'The parties agree that there is no admission of liability. The parties agree that neither party intentionally struck or made physical contact with the other.'

The BHPD lied in their press release that I was arrested when in fact and in law I was merely detained. They also omitted the words allegedly from a press release sent around the world. The responding police officers that night lied under oath as to having access to video from the alleged incident, corroborated by a sworn affidavit from the building manager who, on camera, escorted the officers to the video room that night. These officers and the responding sergeant that night also lied under oath that they did not know who I was, even though the sergeant was a former School Resource Officer and one of the initial officers had sat in School/City Liaison meetings with me. Unfortunately, it is very difficult to sue a police department and the City won on summary

judgement where the Federal Court found the officers had probable cause because the neighbor claimed injuries. The Federal Judge never really looked at the evidence that impeached the officers on the scene and the command staff who oversaw my detention. I have kept all the video evidence, depositions, and affidavits from witnesses and will provide this evidence to anyone who is suing the BHPD and any of the officers involved in my cases as a tool to impeach their testimony. This all began because I uncovered and reported former Chief Snowden's financial relationship with the security firm he recommended to replace the School Resource Officer program, costing the BHUSD tens of millions of dollars in funds from our general fund that could and should have been used to provide our resident children the high quality education they deserve. Chief Snowden's financial relationship with the security firm was withheld from the School Board and City Council.


The only crime akin to murder is to ruin a person's reputation. Like murder, once committed it can never be undone. My mistake was thinking that I could make a difference for our students, teachers, staff, and community as a member of the School Board. The powers that be are still in charge and continue to pay only lip service and pose for photo opportunities when they serve their political interests. We still do not have the restoration of our School Resource Officer program and the School District continues to spend millions of dollars on private security while the City Council use the same, tired excuse from 2009 that they do not have enough officers to restore the program. They tried to silence me; they tried to take my freedom; they tried to ruin my reputation; but here I am, still standing and still fighting for what I believe is right. I hope you will join me in demanding more accountability from our local, state, and federal government.

Beverly Hills Librarian Karen Buth has cataloged and cared for the books that fill the shelves in the Beverly Hills Public Library since 1983.


Engaging with the com-

Babies to 12th graders who read for at




The Varsity Club consists of athletes that best exemplify everything that the coaches expect and want in a student athlete,> Ellis said.
