

But Byers appears to be holding chalk — not a spray can — and it is unclear that she added anything. Perhaps she has scribed the peace sign or heart in front of her.

Then in the next issue you ran a letter that regurgitates the Weekly's earlier allegation. "It's disheartening that a candidate for WeHo City Council [Chelsea Byers] could possibly hold anti-Semitic views," says letter-writer Tom Pease, who goes on to lament that the candidate hasn't addressed the allegation despite "having been given the opportunity."

This is unbecoming of the Weekly for several reasons. First, the initial news brief quotes Dillon Hosier, who evidently has appointed himself chief executive of his own Israeli-American Civic Action Network. But Hosier doesn't actually allege that Byers is anti-semitic; he says only that the candidate "failed to genuinely engage with key communities and listen to their concerns...."

I think we could charge many city council candidates with failing to "genuinely" engage constituents (whatever that means)...even right here in Beverly Hills.

Knowing candidate Byers, I don't believe that his characterization is accurate. And your own news brief suggests that she speaks her mind to whomever, whenever and wherever. So what has she said that is anti-semitic?

Second, the Weekly supported the charge of anti-semitism with a quote that doesn't actually allege it. Did the Weekly ask the candidate for a comment? I don't see that you did. If not then I think that is irresponsible. The candidate's phone number is right there on her campaign website.

Third, the picture itself is inflammatory. It is undated, for one thing, and it doesn't show that she did anything that would reflect anti-semitism. So why not peel-off a recent image from the candidate's website? There are the usual headshots and action pics of Byers marching at a women's rights rally and advocating for the unhoused. None of them support an allegation of anti-semitism.

Fourth, need I remind the Weekly that there is a difference between pro-Palestinian advocacy and anti-semitism? Your brief shows me that Byers has opposed the occupation of Palestine and indeed she has a record of advocating on behalf of human rights generally. That is not anti-semitism, of course, and I expect most voters in West Hollywood will agree.

Byers is free to speak-out in support of Palestinians — or anyone deserving of human rights — without fear of slander. Indeed Byers is active on many such issues, but your brief doesn't mention a single one. I encourage readers to visit <u>chel-</u> <u>sea4weho.com</u> to learn more.

Stepping back, I wonder why the Weekly's is helping to foment this unfounded allegation of antisemitism. Byers is a candidate for city council in West Hollywood. The Weekly has zero [print] circulation outside of Beverly Hills (according to your advertising agreement with the city). Does the brief inform that contest?

Lastly, I see that the Israeli-American Civic Action Network is registered to a post office box in Beverly Hills (street addresses only, says the Secretary of State). Hosier is not only the CEO but the contact for process service and he himself is a West Hollywood resident. It looks to me like he doesn't like one of his possible choices in the council race.

Now that I know who is holding the axe, I want to understand why the Weekly is grinding it for him.

City Council Discusses Joining Metaverse

At their Monday Study Session the City Council discussed a request from Mayor Lili Bosse regarding the City possibly entering the metaverse. The Council gave unanimous direction to move forward with the exploration of joining the metaverse.

"From my perspective, we are already here at the metaverse - this is the future," Bosse said.

According to the National League of Cities, "the metaverse is the next evolution of the internet that will further integrate physical and digital experiences." It is a hypothetical version of the Internet as a single, universal and immersive virtual world that is facilitated by the use of virtual reality and augmented reality headsets.

The metaverse is intended to form immersive virtual world experiences where digital information can be overlaid on the physical world.

In June 2022, the City Attorney's office filed Class 41 Trademark applications regarding the City Shield, this trademark applications protect the use of the City Shield in the metaverse.

Santa Monica was the first U.S. city to enter the metaverse. They currently offer a virtual way to experience its downtown district through FlickPlay, a metaverse app. FlickPlay provides users with an interactive map of the retail district where they can collect tokens as they move around Santa Monica. Some tokens can be used to unlock digital experiences in the app and others can be redeemed for physical items at retailers in the area. The app is also intended to draw users to visit real world local businesses.

The Rodeo Drive Committee and the Conference and Visitors Bureau have also begun discussions regarding the potential opportunities of the metaverse. Both agencies, as well as the Chamber of Commerce, are supportive and willing to participate in future discussions regarding the metaverse.

Councilmember John Mirisch was generally supportive of the idea but was skeptical of the use of cryptocurrency as he said it is extremely destructive to the climate.

"There is nothing as bad for the environment when it comes to carbon footprint as Bitcoin mining. Until and unless they develop cryptocurrencies that are carbon neutral, I would say 'stay away from anything involving cryptocurrency as a must. Otherwise, we are contributing to Climate Change. That said, I would absolutely support looking at this as a way to promote the City," Mirisch said.

According to whitehouse.gov, crypto-assets result in about 0.3% of global annual greenhouse gas emissions through global electricity generation.

"I think technology is going so fast, I think there are so many advantages for what this can do for our City," Bosse said.

unanimously approved a recommendation from the Planning Commission to amend the Beverly Hills Municipal Code related to walls, fences, and hedges in certain single-family and multi-family residential areas of the City. Councilmember Sharona Nazarian recused herself from the discussion because the ordinance affects her home.

The City regulates the allowable maximum height for walls, fences, and hedges in residential zones. Generally, the heights are regulated based on the zone of a property, as well as the location of a wall, fence or hedge on a property.

The City has recently received an influx



of inquiries regarding increasing allowable wall, fence, and hedge heights due to security concerns, particularly along rear alleys.

"Security has become a much bigger issue than it has in the past. I think this is an appropriate way to raise the height," Councilmember Lester Friedman said.

The Planning Commission recommended the following amendments for Single-family residential zones in the Central Area of the city: increase the maximum allowable height of a wall, fence, or hedge located in a rear yard from eight feet for walls, fences, and hedges, to 10 feet for walls and fences and 16 feet for hedges; increase the maximum allowable height for that portion of a wall, fence, or hedge located in a side yard and within five feet of a rear lot line from eight feet for walls, fences, and hedges, to 10 feet for walls and fences, and 16 feet for hedges; and increase the maximum allowable height of a wall, fence, or hedge located in a side yard, but not front yard, that is adjacent to an alley from seven feet for walls, fences, and hedges, to 10 feet for walls and fences, and 16 feet for hedges.

The Planning Commission recommended the following amendments for Multi-family residential zones in the Central Area of the city: increase the maximum allowable height of a wall, fence, or hedge located in a rear yard from eight feet for walls, fences, and hedges, to 16 feet for hedges; increase the maximum allowable height for that portion of a wall, fence, or hedge located in a side yard, but not in a front yard, and located within five feet of a rear lot line from eight feet for walls, fences, and hedges, to 10 feet for walls and fences and six feet for hedges; and increase the maximum allowable height of a wall, fence, or hedge located in a side yard, but not the front yard, that is adjacent to an alley from seven feet for walls, fences, and hedges, to 10 feet for walls and fences to 16 feet for hedges.

The Central area encompasses the geographic areas of the City generally south of Sunset Boulevard.

At the Planning Commission study session on June 9, two representatives from the Trousdale Estates Homeowners Association provided public comment regarding the inapplicability of the proposed changes to the Trousdale Estates Area, since lot configurations, development patterns, and grade differentials vary significantly as compared to the Central Area of the city. The Commission concurred with this assessment and no regulation changes were proposed to this area of the City.

The development pattern, lot configurations, topography, and location of side and rear yards in the Hillside Area are also irregular, and the Planning Commission did not give direction on whether amendments should be made to the Hillside Area regulations. Subsequently, the Hillside area has also been excluded from the regulation changes.

Chief Mark Stainbrook has also said that the changes would not adversely impact BHPD's ability to patrol neighborhoods.

Blumenfeld Wins Big on Bankruptcy Ruling

A Los Angeles bankruptcy judge grant-

ed the loan company "Glan Investments LLC" relief from a homeowner's Chapter 13 automatic stay, resulting in a big win for Former Human Relations Chair Ori Blumenfeld, the attorney representing Glan Investments.

Chapter 13 allows a debtor to keep property and pay debts over time, usually three to five years.

argue a policy consideration that will now carry persuasive value in future similarly situated cases where a bankruptcy debtor attempts to abuse the code to wrongfully extend the maturity date against super-priority lender's that fund health and safety receiver certificates. Thankfully the bankruptcy court is a court of equity and looks beyond just the code itself," Blumenfeld said.

The judge accepted the argument that no lender would advance money to receivers trying to alleviate safety and public health problems if their short-term loans were frozen in bankruptcy proceedings or lengthened into paybacks over the course of sev-

Glan Investments provided three-month loans totaling \$97,000 to Mark Adams to alleviate violations of the Calif. Health and Safety Code. Ogbeni subsequently filed a Chapter 13 bankruptcy, which automatically stayed debt collections.

"It definitely feels good to be on the right side of the law in this instance," Blumenfeld said.

City Council Extends North Cañon Drive Closure

At their Monday Study Session the City Council approved the extension of the North Cañon Drive closure for an additional nine months at Wilshire Boulevard until June 30, 2023.

The street was closed and a cul-de-sac was created in Sept. 2019, followed by the construction of the temporary sound wall across North Cañon Drive at Wilshire Boulevard per the MOA with Metro. City Council approved a mural designed by Tomokazu Matsuyama, which was completed in Nov. of 2019. On Sept. 21, 2021, the City Council approved a one-year extension of the temporary closure until the end of Sept. 2022.

Metro will continue to set up cranes to access deck panels along Wilshire Boulevard for material deliveries and pump concrete to continue to construct below ground station's entrance, platform, walls, concourse level, and other components. Due to this, Wilshire Boulevard between Beverly Drive and Crescent Drive is reduced to a minimum of two lanes in each direction during day shifts and a minimum of one lane in each direction during night shifts.

Metro also anticipates starting construction of multiple appendage structures along Wilshire Boulevard as early as 2023, which would also require traffic lane reconfiguration for additional piling and excavation.

City staff will continue maintenance of the mural and the landscaped planters to upkeep the cul-de-sac as aesthetically pleasing. The City will also monitor community concerns and work with Metro and appropriate City departments to mitigate any closure-related concerns. Near the expiration date of the closure, staff will provide updates on the North Portal project to City Council to consider whether or not to further extend the temporary closure of North Cañon Drive at Wilshire Boulevard.

The Wilshire/Rodeo station is not scheduled to open until 2025.

Board Approves New Construction Director

In a 4-1 vote, the board approved an agreement employing William Karrat as the new Executive Director of construction

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services, at last Tuesday's Board of Education meeting. Board Vice President Noah Margo was the sole dissenting vote.

"I am not going to be supporting this tonight, not because of the person we are hiring but because of the position. They say 'if we don't study history we are doomed to repeat it.' We have been here before where we are about to be. I lived through it, it did not work. I don't think that we have restructured the background correctly, that this position will succeed," Margo said.

Karrat will be contracted for 3 years, commencing on Sept. 12, 2022, and terminating on June 30, 2025.

"I foresee a duplication of efforts. I foresee communication lines being crossed. We had this structure before and it did not work for us," Margo said.

The base annual salary will be \$186,500 and Karrat is expected to receive a 2.5% increase for the 2023- 2024 school year.

"I think it's a shame that you're not going to vote for this. But I will say this - even though the structural process may have been the same, there's strategy, there's structure, there's process, and there are people. Just because you had one of those pieces the same, does not mean that history is going to repeat itself," Board member Gabriel Halimi said.

City Council Denies Request to Order Review of Sign Accommodation

At their Monday Study Session meeting the City Council declined a request from Councilmember John Mirisch to call up for review the Architectural Commissions decision conditionally approving a sign accommodation to allow the installation of a mural located at 139 South Beverly Drive.

On July 27, the Applicant was issued a Special Events permit to allow a temporary mural, by the artist Dean Stockton, including an unveiling and ribbon cutting event. The site for the mural was the north-facing wall of an existing commercial building. The permit for the mural was set to expire on August 25. The Applicant subsequently requested that the Architectural Commission review the mural in order to maintain the large-scale graphic design beyond the expiration.

On August 17, the Commission conditionally approved a Sign Accommodation and unanimously allowed the installation of a mural for the property.

The mural is by Dean Stockton and reflects his known Pop Art aesthetic with an illustration of a fictional female figure.

"We support art and I think art is something that helps pedestrians walk South of Wilshire because everybody is mainly in the triangle, and I thought - why not?" de-

> veloper Michael Hakim, who owns the property, said.

Planning Commission Approves 313-323 North Rodeo Drive Project

At last Thursday's meeting the Planning Commission unanimously approved a project for Dior that involves the demolition of two existing commercial buildings located at 313-323 North Rodeo Drive.

"This is a beautiful project. It will be an enhancement to Rodeo Drive. Which, despite its reputation, is like any other street in any other city. It needs periodic updating," Commissioner Terri Kaplan said.

The project includes the demolition of the existing commercial buildings and surface parking lot and the construction of a new three-story commercial building with rooftop uses, a small surface parking lot, and an alternative parking facility located in the subterranean parking level. Access to the proposed building would be provided via the main pedestrian entrance along North Rodeo Drive.

Retail uses would be located on the ground and second floors. A restaurant with open-air dining would be located on the third floor along with a reception lobby and a private dining room. A paved terrace and rooftop penthouse were proposed and would include various amenities including a lounge area, coat room, closet, pantry, and dressing rooms. A courtyard that opens towards the sky and rooftop is also proposed.

"I do think this is a beautiful project. I like the idea of bringing more dining and particularly open air dining into the City," Commissioner Jeff Wolfe said.

Beverly Hills Man Sentenced for Attempting to Hire Hitman to Kill Woman

A Beverly Hills man was sentenced on Monday to 60 months in federal prison for attempting to hire a hitman to kill a woman he briefly dated and who repeatedly tried to break off their relationship. Scott Quinn Berkett, 25, pleaded guilty on June 13 to one count of use of interstate facilities to commit murder-for-hire. He has been in federal custody since his arrest in this case in May of 2021.

According to the affidavit, Berkett met the victim online in 2020, and the woman flew to Los Angeles to meet Berkett in 2020. The victim, who described Berkett's behavior as "sexually aggressive," tried on several occasions to break off the relationship following the trip, the affidavit states.

In April 2021, a family member, who had learned that Berkett continued to contact the victim, called and sent text messages to Berkett's father's phone, and, on April 20, Berkett appeared to have responded by saying, "Consider this matter closed."

Soon afterward, he solicited and paid for murder-for-hire services via a website on the darknet for a group that purportedly offered such services. Berkett provided the darknet group with specific directions and details about his victim. As payment for the victim's murder, Berkett sent the darknet group bitcoin payments totaling approximately \$13,000.

In May 2021, an undercover law enforcement officer, posing as a hitman from the darknet group, contacted Berkett. The undercover officer sent Berkett pictures of the victim and confirmed that the pictures showed his intended victim and that he had made bitcoin payments to obtain her murder. Berkett further requested proof of her murder and made an additional \$1,000 payment to the undercover officer.

[Berkett's] crime was not a momentary lapse in judgment, but a premeditated plot to kill the victim because she rejected his advances," prosecutors argued in a sentencing memorandum. "While attempting to take a life is atrocious enough, [Berkett's] chosen method of carrying out the crime – using the Dark Web to hire a hitman and cryptocurrency – speak to his sophistication, meticulous planning, and attempts to anonymize his illegal conduct in the commission of this offense, and are aggravating in nature."

Greystone was dedicated as a City park just over 50 years ago in Sept. of 1971. Sept. also marks the month the Doheny family moved into their home in 1928. Since the City acquired the estate, it has been a place where visitors arrive to rest and relax while taking in the natural splendor of the 18 acres of green space.

In celebration of Greystone's 51st anniversary as a public park, "The Great Outdoors at Greystone" celebration of Nature will honor healthy living, with an array of activities for everyone, including seedling plantings, a poetry wall to share words, meditation moments, a scavenger hunt, sketching, photography, self-guided tours of the grounds, and more.







BHHS Football Team To Play Whittier Christian Friday

Beverly High will face Whittier Christian and its run-oriented pro I formation in a nonleague football game Friday night at Whittier College. The opening kickoff is set for 7 p.m.

"They're going to run the ball at you," Normans coach Marquis Bowling said. "You have to come downhill. You have to make tackles. Period. Point blank. There's no if ands or buts about it.

"If we do not line up and come downhill and make tackles, they will absolutely bludgeon us to death."

The Heralds (2-1) defeated Pacific of San Bernardino, 48-0, Friday, the second consecutive game they scored at least 40 points.

Whittier Christian defeated O'Farrell Charter, 40-8, Sept. 2, running for 140 yards on 17 carries, an average of 8.2 yards per carry, according to statistics posted on the high school sports website, MaxPreps.

Bowling said he scheduled the game because "I thought they were on par with us as far as our talent level, our numbers. I thought we had a good matchup with them based on what I saw from last couple years of their records and their numbers."

The Heralds were 2-6 in 2021, including a 24-12 season-opening loss to O'Farrell Charter and a 22-14 victory over Maranatha of Pasadena, which defeated Beverly Hills, 38-0 in 2021 and 42-6 Aug. 26.

The high school football website Cal-Preps projects a 35-7 victory for Whittier Christian.

The Normans should have won Friday night's nonleague game at Nickoll Field, Bowling said.

"The self-inflicted wounds really hurt us," Bowling said after his team's record fell to 0-3. "We got down to the 10- (yard line) a couple of different times and for whatever reason, we ended up outside of the 30, an interception or something not in our favor forced by ourselves.

"As much as they were improved, I can't get the fact we gave the game away out of my head."

Bowling blamed the loss on committing "penalty after penalty" and turnovers.

"One of the biggest ones that bothered me the most was the fact that we were tackling up high and getting personal fouls," Bowling said. "At one point, I had a kid on the sideline show him how we've been practicing tackling since the spring in front of the A.D. (athletic director).

"I was so frustrated that everything that we've practiced didn't translate into the game."

The Eagles (2-1) took a 6-0 lead in the first quarter. There was no additional scoring until the fourth quarter.

Beverly Hills should have taken a 14-0 lead, Bowling said.

"We missed our first pass terribly," Bowling said, describing a screen pass that was thrown out of bounds. "We didn't get aligned properly on the next pass play. It's simple things like that that cost us."

One of Bowling's goals for the game was to try to control the ball.

"We did a decent job with ball control," Bowling said. "It could have been better."

Senior cornerback-receiver Peter Lojdi "caught the ball really well for us and played really solid defense" and Max Siemons "played pretty well as a nose guard," Bowling said.

The effort by the Norman players "improved a lot" from the 69-0 loss to Bishop's Sept. 2 but "I am still not satisfied by the effort," Bowling said.

"It has to mean more to you," Bowling said. "I try to explain to them any time your name is attached to something you want to represent your name to the best of your ability.

"I can honestly say that I don't know if everyone did that."





The CITY reserves the right to waive minor irregularities and omissions in the information contained in the prequalification application submitted, and to make all final determinations. Where a timely and completed application results in a rating below that necessary to pre-qualify, an appeal can be made by the unsuccessful Contractor. An appeal is begun by the Contractor delivering notice to the CITY of its appeal of the decision with respect to its prequalification rating, no later than two business days following notification that it is not pre-qualified. The notice of appeal shall include an address where the Contractor wishes to receive notice of the appeal hearing. Without a timely appeal, the Contractor waives any and all rights

to challenge the decision of the CITY, whether by administrative process, judicial process or any other legal process or proceeding.

If the Contractor gives the required notice of appeal, a hearing shall be conducted no earlier than five business days after the CITY's receipt of the notice of appeal and not later than five business days prior to the date of the Notice Inviting Bids for this Project.
