Planning Commission Approves Ordinance Regarding Lot Line Adjustments

At last Thursday's meeting the Planning Commission approved a draft ordinance to prohibit the creation or expansion of lots that cross the jurisdictional boundaries of the City.

Last Jan. the City Council adopted an urgency ordinance to prohibit the approval of lot line adjustments that would create or expand a lot that crosses City boundaries. The urgency ordinance was created because of the realization that these types of lot line adjustments could result in development that is inconsistent with the general plan related to zoning regulations.

The draft ordinance has permanent regulations to replace those in the urgency ordinance so that it would replace the urgency ordinance before it expires.

At the City Council meeting held last January, an issue arose on an appeal from the Planning Commission's denial of a requested lot line adjustment, which proposed to move a lot line away from the city boundary to create a parcel located both within Beverly Hills and the City of Los Angeles in Trousdale. This raised concerns about the relocation of property lines that coexist with the city's boundary line

Subsequently, the City Council adopted

the aforementioned urgency ordinance to prohibit lot line adjustments that would create or expand a lot across the boundaries between Beverly Hills and an adjacent city.

The draft ordinance only applies to single-family properties that are seeking a lot line adjustment, and does not apply to multi-family residences because those developments are automatically reviewed by the Planning Commission.

Single-family residential development does not automatically require review by the Planning Commission, but the draft ordinance would make it so that development crossing city boundaries and requiring a lot line adjustment is reviewed through the discretionary entitlement pro-

When a parcel is located within Beverly Hills and another city, a portion of the parcel is subject to the City's regulations and development standards, and a portion of the parcel is subject to the regulations and development standards of the adjacent city. Because the ordinance would not apply to the portion that is located in another city, a lot line adjustment that results in a lot with split jurisdiction, and any development of the split-jurisdiction lot, may not conform to the City's General Plan or zoning and building ordinances.

According to the staff report, this may negatively impact the public health, safety, and welfare because buildings that do not comply with Beverly Hills codes may be built with City services, and buildings can be built under another city's zoning regulations without appropriate development standards.

The Commission also exempted the residence location at 1276 Beverly Greene Drive from the ordinance because the resident brought concerns that the subject property would have to go through a discretionary entitlement process should the property owner or any future property owner choose to re-develop.

If any property owners have similar concerns, they could ask for a variance and state why they would experience hardship due to this ordinance.

"We urgently needed something that would allow us to address [these] issues when they arise," Commissioner Terri Kaplan said.

The draft ordinance will move to the City Council for final approval.

City Council Denies South Crescent Drive Petition

At their Tuesday meeting the City Council denied a resident-initiated petition request to modify the permit parking regulation on the 200 block of South Crescent Drive, between Charleville Boulevard and Gregory Way, and retained the existing regulations.

On Nov.16, 2021, the City Council reviewed the aforementioned petition to modify the existing regulations from "1-Hour Parking, 8 a.m. to 2:30 a.m., Daily, Permit 'Q' Exempt'" to "No Parking Anytime, Permit 'Q' Exempt."

On Feb. 6, 2020, the Traffic and Parking Commission reviewed a petition signed by 66% (25 of 38) of the households on the petition block in hopes to address com-

muter parking impacts from South Beverly Drive businesses, Beverly Vista Middle School, and driveway ingress/egress issues caused by blocked driveways.

Based on the majority support of the block residents, previously approved similar parking modifications on two adjacent blocks, impacts from changing Beverly Vista to a middle school and to create consistent parking regulations, it was recommended the Traffic and Parking Commission approve the modification. The Commission voted 3-1-1 in support of the recommendation. Commissioner Sharon Ignarro opposed the petition and former Commissioner Jay Solnit abstained citing the low parking occupancy data during non-peak school hours.

At the Nov.16, 2021, City Council meeting 14 comments were received from street block residents, BHUSD representatives and Beverly Vista Parent Teacher Association members. The City conducted additional parking spot counts in 2022 and discovered on average, 28% (19 of 67) of the on-street spaces were occupied.

Due to the fact that there is over 70% availability of on- street parking throughout most of the day, it was recommended the City Council deny the petition.

City Hosts Second Gale Yard Forum

The City held a second Gale Yard public Forum on Oct. 17 and discussed the long-term use of the Gale Staging Yard, located at 8421 Wilshire Boulevard.

The site is currently used by Metro to stage construction equipment related to the Purple Line Extension Project. The site is about 400 feet from the future Wilshire/La Cienega subway station. Metro will continue to use the site until 2024.

The City will retain ownership of the site following the opening of the subway station after 2024 and is considering what uses should be developed for long-term

The City had previously considered using the site in the future as a police substation or mobility hub in the Draft Plan for Connect Beverly Hills: Meet Me on Wilshire and La Cienega. A mobility hub is intended to connect a variety of modes of transportation, along with other amenities, in one place.

Adjacent to the site, at 8423 Wilshire Boulevard, is the "clock market site," which is also owned by Beverly Hills and could be incorporated into future development of the site.

Potential amenities that were discussed during the public comment period include a police substation, affordable housing, and additional parking.

"The streets are packed with parked cars. We would be able to shift a lot of those cars to that parking," South Gale resident Daniel Batista said.

The City previously sent out a survey to residents in order to get community input.

According to survey results, the top amenities people want to see developed are a restaurant or cafe, a market/grocery/health food store, a public plaza with outdoor seating, and a police substation or

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other public safety amenity.

The feedback from the community meeting will be reported to the City Council. Then, the City plans to prepare a Request for Proposals (RFP) soliciting development proposals for the site based on input from the community and direction from the City Council.

Halimi Questions BHEF for Lackluster Fundraising

At last Tuesday's Board of Education meeting Board member Gabriel Halimi criticized the Beverly Hills Education Foundation (BHEF) for the overall lack of money raised by the organization.

"When Mayor [Lili] Bosse was at our event she said we can have anything we want in terms of support from this city. That's the kind of city that we have but

in order to get to educational excellence it requires every part of the community to work together to get there. I see an opportunity to do better than we're doing today and I'm not going to stop until

we get there," Halimi said.

The primary focus of the BHEF is to raise money and awareness for the district.

Halimi said the way to raise the bar is to look towards other examples that are doing a better job. He pointed to how Manhattan Unified has a \$20 million endowment and BHUSD has \$3 million.

"I implore the community to give to BHEF but I also expect that BHEF is going to open up and accept the help that I think we all want to give. It's a two-way street. I'm disappointed but I expect that's going to open up and I expect that we're going to do a lot more and raise a lot more money for our students," Halimi said.

City Council Expresses Support for Prop 1 and 31

At their Tuesday meeting the City Council discussed a request by Councilmember John Mirisch where they expressed support for proposition 1 and 31.

Proposition 1 would add an amendment to the state constitution to prohibit the state from interfering with or denying a women's choice to have an abortion or contraceptives.

This comes after the Supreme Court overturned roe v wade.

If Proposition 31 passes, then SB 793 would become law. This would prohibit a retailer from selling certain flavored to-bacco products or tobacco product flavor enhancers.

Planning Commission Chair Myra Demeter spoke at the meeting in regards to her support for proposition 31. She did not speak on behalf of the Planning Commission.

"In 2020 California passed a bipartisan landmark law (SB 793) to prohibit the sale of flavored tobacco products. Since that

time, Big Tobacco has gathered signatures to oppose this ban and it is on the November 8th ballot as proposition 31. It jeopardizes the health and safety of our children by seeking to overturn the prohibition of flavored tobacco products. To protect our children from the evils of flavored tobacco it is very important to vote "YES" on proposition 31 to retain the prohibition," Demeter said.

As the sale of most tobacco products are prohibited in Beverly Hills, there is no anticipated fiscal impact on the City if Proposition 31 passes.

"Moms in Office" Endorses Dodes for Board of Education

"Moms in Office" has announced their support of Farrah Dodes' campaign for the Beverly Hills Board of Education.

"Moms in Office is proud to support Farrah Dodes for Beverly Hills School Board. As a mother of two and an active leader in the school district, Farrah has a proven track record and firsthand experience on the issues that matter to us parents the most. She will be ready to lead on day one and fight for safety, quality education and more resources for the district," Founder and Executive Director Simona Grace said.

Grace founded the organization with the mission to "break down the barriers that keep women with caregiving responsibilities out of elected office." The organization said they are proud to support Farrah Dodes for the "fight for gender equity in government and economic justice for all women."

Planning Commission Moves Closer to Approve 1510 Lexington Road Project

At last Thursday's meeting the Planning Commission approved a motion to bring back a resolution for the approval of a project that consists of a hillside R-1 permit to allow the total of the cumulative floor area developed on a site to exceed 15,000 square feet, and a hillside R-1 Permit to allow more than 3,000 cubic yards of earth material to be exported from the project site at 1510 Lexington Road.

Additionally, the applicant requested a Tree Removal Permit to allow the removal of 10 protected trees associated with the construction of the new two-story single-family residence.

The Tree Removal Permit is to allow the removal of five existing heritage trees in the front and street-side yard and to formalize the removal of five heritage trees that were removed previously without a permit, for the total removal of 10 trees from the property.

At first, the Commission could not come to a consensus on whether or not to approve the removal of the trees and suggested leaving that out of the resolution to further study that issue.

Attorney Ronald Richards, who is representing the applicant, said that in order to prevent any more cost-related delays in further postponing the approval of the project, they would be willing to withdraw the request to remove the additional trees and take any penalties related to the

removal of the former five trees.

During the Commission's deliberations on the tree removal permits, an arborist report that was submitted in 2018 was brought up where it was revealed that four of the trees are "declining, have decayed areas with drywood throughout, and are in precarious conditions and therefore should be removed," and one three "is leaning toward the street, been topped in the past, and is in a precarious condition and therefore should be removed."

"Are they in fact a danger? I don't want the applicant to say 'well because it is too complicated, we will just keep them,' if in fact, they could be in danger of falling and hurting someone or damaging property on the street," Commissioner Jeff Wolfe said.

Director of Community Development Ryan Gohlich said one of the trees was in an area of significant grading and that at the very least, this tree could not be retained because the scope of the project would have to change.

The Commission directed staff to obtain an independent arborist report on the condition of the trees at the applicant's expense to determine whether they are in fact a danger.

"If the arborist does in fact say that the trees need to be removed, then the existing plan remains as is," Wolfe said.

Richards suggested that in order for the report to be prepared in time for the next Planning Commission meeting, the applicant could provide the arborist.

"It needs to be prepared by the City because we need [an] unbiased [report]," Chair Myra Demeter said.

If there is no need for the removal of the trees, the Commission could deny the tree removal.

The Commission at a previous hearing also requested that the applicant modify the amount of earth material that is being exported on the site. The applicant modified the project and cut the export amount from 5,326 cubic yards to 3,276 cubic yards. Demeter questioned why the applicant did not modify the project some more so that the amount of export did not exceed 3,000 cubic yards. However, the majority of the Commission could make the findings to approve the permit to remove the earth material.

The Commission will formally vote on the approval of the two R-1 permits and re-evaluate the status of the trees at a future meeting.

Public Works Commission Receives Update on Street Sweeping Schedule

At last Thursday's meeting the Public Works Commission received an update regarding the new daytime posted street sweeping schedule installment where it was revealed that the project is expected to be completed by the end of next year.

On Aug. 13, 2020 the Public Works Commission was presented with a new proposed daytime street sweeping schedule for all residential properties south of Santa Monica Boulevard that was intended to address the challenges with overnight parking south of Santa Monica Boulevard. The City allowed overnight parking by permit, due to the shortage of on-site parking in multi-family properties. Due to this, many of these parked cars cannot all fit on the streets designated for daytime street sweeping which would then overflow into the streets designated for nighttime street sweeping. This primarily impacted residential multi-family streets. The implementation of the new schedule is meant to provide an opportunity to create a uniform schedule for a more efficient operation.

On Oct. 27, 2020, the City Council approved a new proposed daytime street sweeping schedule.

City staff has recently completed the eighth phase of the project, which consisted of the street segments along Doheny Drive North/South of Wilshire.

It is anticipated that the phase 9 installment will be completed by the end of this year, bringing the project to 70% completion

Each recipient will receive funding for projects that are intended to bring new and inventive ideas to the classroom.

Projects include: bolstering dual enrollment and CTE pathways through animation and the visual arts via Cintiq drawing tablets for high school students, support for mental health awareness in the middle school community, increasing focus and stamina in the first grade classroom, expanding math education through play for elementary school students, and exploring physical computing and its relation to future careers for elementary school students.

City to Host Parking Permit Program Town Hall Nov. 3

The City's Preferential Parking Permit program is preparing to relaunch and the public can attend a Town Hall meeting on Thursday, Nov. 3 from 6 - 7:30 p.m. The in-person meeting at Beverly Hills City Hall will also be streamed virtually with online participation available.

The parking permit program will primarily rely on vehicle license plates, also known as Permit by Plate. The police department will utilize license plate recognition technology to further expand consistent coverage and maintain visibility within neighborhoods. There will be no parking permit policy changes or changes to the annual charge for parking permits. There will also be no change in how residents obtain guest parking permits and no charge for them.

Following the Town Hall meeting, the proposed program relaunch will be presented to the City Council. If approved, current permits will be automatically extended until Jan. 31, 2023, and residents will receive permit registration and renewal instructions starting by Jan. 3, 2023. The permit renewal process will continue through Jan. in coordination with community education and an information campaign to ensure permit program awareness. The proposed Preferential Parking Permit Program would officially begin on Feb. 6, 2023.

City to Purchase Emergency Evacuation Boxes

At last Tuesday's meeting the City Council received an informational update on their Study Session Agenda regarding new Wildland Emergency Evacuation Boxes the City will be purchasing.

The City contracted with FlameMapper, LLC to provide wildfire modeling and mitigation effective analysis, which includes the creation of the Beverly Hills Fire Department's Wildland Emergency Evacuation Boxes, or commonly known as Beacon Boxes.

The boxes are fire-resistant, waterproof, and durable and function as a source of accurate and localized information for mutual aid first responders who may not

be familiar with the area. The content can only be accessed by first responders and consists of the following: Battalion Resource Summary Sheets, pre-attack plans, and egress areas. The contents also contain a telephone directory, along with road networks, turnaround places, hydrant locations, and other water sources.

The fiscal impact for the creation of approximately eight beacon boxes is estimated at \$32,000.00.

Art Show Winners Announced

The Beverly Hills Art Show held this past weekend, brought thousands of visitors to Beverly Gardens Park where over 230 artists exhibited their work along four blocks of Santa Monica Boulevard from Rodeo Drive to Rexford Drive. Guests enjoyed artwork in ceramics, digital art, drawing and printmaking, glass, jewelry, photography, mixed media, painting, sculpture and watercolor categories.

Sixteen first place and special category winners were announced by Mayor Lili Bosse, with the assistance of Director of Community Services Jenny Rogers, Arts and Culture Commission Chair Liliana Filipovic and Recreation and Parks Commission Chair Amie Sherry, at a special Awards Presentation and Breakfast for the artists on Sunday, Oct. 16, prior to the final day of the Art Show event. Arts and Culture and Recreation and Parks Commissioners were present as well to support the artists.

Best of Show was awarded to Fortune Sitole, a self-taught artist who uses mixed materials and paints on ostrich eggs, wood and canvas, which tell stories that pay homage to his ancestors, family and community of day-to-day life in black South African townships.

"Shanties exist throughout the world and my art tells a story of the universality of poverty," Sitole said. "The characters in my scene are about communities who have overcome adversity and have progressed into the 21 st century."

Also awarded each year is the Mayor's Purchase Award. The Mayor's Purchase Award is given to an artist from whom the Mayor selects art for installation at one of the City's public facilities. The awards were established to affirm the City's support of the arts and its commitment to the cultural community.

Mayor Lili Bosse selected Limitless, by long-time resident and Beverly Hills Art Show patron Pamela Beck.

Bosse said about Limitless, "I loved this piece because I saw it as illuminating hope, light, the future and limitless possibilities. I love that when our community enters city hall, they are embraced by the sense of optimism, inclusivity, and the positive light that bonds each of us."

Beck is a writer/producer and self-taught artist who has been a contemporary art collector for many years. She is influenced by the Light and Space art movement and considers her work its own kind of storytelling. Her journey as an artist is all about color, light and imagination, the balance between chance and control, the elegance of linear lines and the endless potential of abstraction.

Limitless, a 48 x 36 photographic image, "is all about color, light and reflection, and the magic that happens when you put it all together," Beck said. "As a first time Beverly Hills Art Show exhibitor, receiving the Mayor's Purchase Award was both humbling and thrilling at once."

The Normans had "a pretty good first quarter," which ended in a scoreless tie, then began being plagued by injuries in an Ocean League game at Hawthorne Friday night,

Injuries forced Bowling to "pretty much scrap everything we had planned with our game plan because we didn't have people that could execute," by midway through the second quarter, he said.

Bowling opted to start Cameron Park, usually a running back, at quarterback "to try to see something different," Bowling said.

Beverly Hills has scored two touchdowns through seven games. The Normans scored six touchdowns in their first seven games of the 2021 season, Bowling's first as their coach.

Bowling described Park as a more mobile quarterback than the usual starter, Matthew Recupero, who started at tight end against the Cougars (4-4, 2-1).

Park's right hand was stepped on early in the second quarter and suffered what was later diagnosed as a "deep, deep bone bruise," that will force him to miss the Inglewood game, Bowling said.

Recupero replaced Park at quarterback. Left tackle-linebacker Nathaniel Werner suffered a possible concussion and is in the concussion protocol, Bowling said. Beverly Hills' starting right tackle was

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not allowed to play because of an initial positive COVID-19 test. He later tested negative twice, Bowling said.

The Normans were without two players who suffered concussions in their last game, a 52-0 loss to Morningside Sept. 30, Bowling said.

The chances of those two players playing against Inglewood Friday are "very slim," Bowling said.

Beverly Hills forfeited its scheduled Oct. 7 game against Leuzinger "because of a lack of healthy available players,' Bowling said.

The Normans began Friday's game with about 25 players in uniform and had about 18 available by the end of the game, including nine freshmen, Bowling said.

"It basically comes down to we don't have enough kids," Bowling said. "The guys have to play everything - offense, defense, special teams.'

Bowling said he had planned to play the freshmen mostly on special teams against Hawthorne, but "that quickly changed in the first half."

When asked if there were any positives for his team from the game, Bowling responded, "Defensively I thought we really played well at the beginning. We held our own. We stopped them from scoring the first couple drives.

"Offensively, we kind of got things started up. The first quarter was actually decent. Before the injuries started taking over, it was a competitive game."


