#### Coopwood Named Highest Paid Gov. Employee in State

Former Assistant Police Chief Marc Coopwood was named as the highest-paid California municipal employee, totaling \$716,284 in compensation for 2021.

In Oct. of 2021 Coopwood resigned from the City to pursue other opportunities in the private sector. Coopwood came to the BHPD from the Sacramento Police Department in 2017 after serving for 22



years. He is also the past president of the California Peace Officers' Association.

According to a report published by the state controller's office, Coopwood's total compen-

sation was \$716,284 in 2021, \$208,087 in regular income, with the rest for lump-sum and other pay.

The report details the top 100 paid employees of whom took home \$439,000 or more in total wages last year. Two other Beverly Hills employees have made the list, all from the BHPD. Fifty sixth on the

The West Hollywood City Manager came in third on the report for a total of \$629,104 in wages. The Artesia City Manager came in second at \$650,167.

#### **City Council Approves New** Commissioners

At their Tuesday Study Session the City Council approved two new commissioners to join the Recreation and Parks Commission and one for the Community Charitable Foundation.

The Recreation and Parks Commission panel included Councilmember Lester Friedman, Councilmember Sharona Nazarian, Chair Amie Sherry and Vice Chair Myra Lurie. They interviewed seven applicants for two vacancies on the Commission and approved Deborah Termeie to replace Outgoing Commissioner Alissa Roston and JR Dzubak to replace outgoing Commissioner Julian Javor. Both terms will begin Jan. 1.

The Council also approved Lisa Greer for the Community Charitable Foundation to replace outgoing member Allison Balson. Her term will begin July 1.

The City's Community Charitable Foundation (CBHCCF) is a non-profit organization dedicated to expanding philanthropic opportunities in the community. Although all donations to the City are tax deductible, certain patrons and companies



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require donations to be given to a 501(c)3 and the CBHCCF provides that opportunity

All approved candidates will attend commission meetings leading up to their appointments.

The City Council also approved a temporary extension of the following Design Review Commissioner: Barry Bernstein (term concludes: December 2022); Sandy Pressman (term concludes: June 2023); and Anthony P. Spann (term concludes: June 2023).

The Design Review Commission Interview Panel composed of Councilmember John Mirisch and Councilmember Lester Friedman, Design Review Chair Anthony Spann and Vice Chair Terri Smooke met on Nov. 3 and interviewed five applicants for three upcoming vacancies on the Commission.

After discussion, the panel recommended that the interview process be re-opened because they were of the opinion that applicants should be better prepared with an understanding of the Design Review Commission's roles and responsibilities.

Due to the number of upcoming vacancies for this commission and the timelines associated with the appointments, the panel requested that the current outgoing commissioners temporarily remain on the commission until their positions are filled.

Non-residents can still apply for one seat which requires a licensed residential or landscape architect. The application process has re-opened with a new deadline of Friday, Jan. 13, 2023 at 5PM.

### **Traffic and Parking Commission Approves Stop** Sign Request at Whitworth and South Palm

At last Thursday's meeting the Traffic and Parking Commission approved the establishment of an all-way stop control at the intersection of Whitworth and South Palm Drive, in coordination with the City of Los Angeles.

Last Aug. residents on the 400 block of South Palm Drive requested the City to install an all-way stop sign at the intersection of Whitworth and South Palm Drive due to concerns of collisions experienced at the intersection.

The north half of Whitworth Drive is in Beverly Hills, while the south half of the street is in Los Angeles. City staff requested that the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT) review the latest five-year collision data and conduct an all-way stop warrant analysis at the intersection. The results indicated that the conditions meet their established all-way stop sign guidelines.

The all-way stop control at the intersection of Whitworth and Palm Drive will be installed in coordination with the City of Los Angeles.

### **Board Now Opens with** "Land Declaration"

The Board of Education has begun opening each meeting with a "land acknowledgment", a formal statement that recognizes land originally inhabited by indigenous peoples.

Student Board member Alix Bodden opened Tuesday's meeting with the land acknowledgement.

County Supervisor Chair Janice Hahn also began her first Board of Supervisor meeting reciting a land acknowledgment.

"The people who first stewarded what is now Los Angeles County never ceded this land, and the process of losing it was a painful one. This acknowl-

edgement is going to open every one of our meetings in recognition of that injustice and serve as a reminder that we still have work ahead of us in the fight for justice for the First Peoples of this land. I'm grateful for the work that our Los Angeles City/County Native American Indian Commission and its community partners put into crafting this language," Hahn said

### **City Council Discusses Spring Place**

At their Tuesday meeting the City Council discussed an appeal of the Planning Commission's decision to adopt a resolution amending a previously approved Development Plan Review that regulates the rooftop uses for Spring Place, a private membership club and co-working office located at 9800 Wilshire Boulevard and 121 Spalding Drive. The Council approved this matter to be remanded back to the Planning Commission for it to be

Spring Place is a shared workplace designed to offer professionals a variety of places for all of the ways they work. Work space options include private offices, dedicated desks, open office coworking spaces, meeting rooms, phone booths, lounges, outdoor terraces, a conservatory and a library. Spring Place also has fivestar dining and personalized concierge services.

The Planning Commission directed staff at a previous public hearing to present a report due to complaints received regarding the nature of Spring Place's operations in recent months.

The events hosted by Spring Place have been previously described by their representatives as events designed to create memorable experiences for members and to cultivate connections to brands, publications, personalities, and cultural insti-

tutions. Spring Place was allowed to host occasional events on the rooftops during the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., Monday to Friday, and 9:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., Saturday to Sunday. Additionally, occasional events may be held outside of the hours of operation for members and up to three guests per member. Since it began operating, Spring Place has hosted various events on the rooftop facilities and within its interior space. Spring Place was not intended to hold events for the general public.

A few public comments were made at the Planning Commission meeting regarding concerns that Spring Place was hosting events that utilized live music, and that the events appeared to be open to not just members and guests of members.

Additionally, it was also raised at the Planning Commission meeting that some events held in the last few months were more consistent with events that would be held in a banquet facility, and that the rooftop space was being rented out to the general public for these events.

The Commissioners agreed to place much stricter restrictions on Spring Place. The rooftop will be limited to 30 people, hours are limited from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., no events, and no amplification will be allowed. Food and beverage sales will also be restricted.

On June 8 former Mayor Mark Egerman, attorney for Spring Place, filed a timely appeal of the Commission's decision. Spring Place is currently subject to the Planning Commission's Resolution until the appeal is processed.

#### Traffic and Parking Commission Discusses Transportation Safety Educational Campaign

At last Thursday's meeting the Traffic and Parking Commission discussed the 2023 Transportation

Safety Educational Campaign.

The City has completed various safety campaigns as part of events or projects that focused on transportation. For example, in 2019, city staff produced the Bicycle and Pedestrian Awareness Campaign meant to bring attention to traveling safely as cyclists and pedestrians.

The City has received feedback from the community, Traffic

and Parking Commission, and City Council in response to past campaigns that a more robust campaign is needed to reach all road users.

The structure of the 2023 Transportation Safety Educational Campaign consists of: umbrella slogan for all campaign materials, monthly calls to action for road users, supplemental monthly key messages, communication tactics and rationale, collateral details and placement considerations, and graphic design direction.

The umbrella slogan identified for this campaign is, "We watch out for each other." This slogan is meant to convey the community's sense of pride in their city and support for their neighbors, friends, and businesses. It is also meant to remind residents that their care for one another translates to their personal actions on the roads. The slogan will be used on all materials developed for the campaign.

Each month, the campaign will feature a different theme based on traffic safety issues observed by the community. Each theme will have specific, direct calls to action for road users intended to improve traffic safety by watching out for each other.

Some monthly themes for next year include: pedestrian safety, right-of-way at intersections, speeding, an safety around schools, among others.

#### Yelton Receives Fred C. Cunningham Award

On Tuesday, Beverly Hills City Building Official and Assistant Director of Community Development, David Yelton, received the prestigious Fred C. Cunningham Award for Distinguished Service, the City's highest recognition for outstanding service to the community.

The award was named after the City's longtime former Executive Director of Public Affairs, Fred C. Cunningham and recognizes an employee who has a true vocation for serving the community and who has demonstrated expertise and commitment tempered with grace and humility. Yelton is the fourth honoree to receive the award, following Fred C. Cunningham, City Manager George Chavez and Beverly Hills Fire Chief Greg Barton.

"I couldn't think of a more deserving person than David to receive this award," Mayor Lili Bosse said. "He has shown us how his incredible leadership has shaped a department that works around the clock to

## **City Council Oks Temporary Extension for OpenBH**

At their Tuesday Study Session the City Council approved extending the temporary OpenBH program for an additional 9 months through Sept. 30, 2023 while the OpenBH Subcommittees continue their work.

The City created the OpenBH program in June 2020 to allow businesses to temporarily expand their services to adjacent outdoor areas such as private parking lots, sidewalks, and metered parking spaces, otherwise known as parklets, through a no-fee Special Event Permit. This was in response to the pandemic.

The Council did not approve an extension of the street closure and temporary outdoor dining tent for Spago due to an opposition letter received from the property owner in the 100 block of North Cañon Drive. City staff is currently working with Spago to determine the removal plan for the temporary outdoor dining tent to be scheduled for Jan

Businesses will be able to budget for three additional 90-Day no fee renewals. A discussion regarding the fiscal impact of a long-term fee-based program will be brought back to the City Council in the future. This discussion will also include a timeline for implementation of a feebased program along with any continued fee waivers or stop-gap measures until a program is implemented.

City staff will return to the City Council in the coming months regarding design standards, code changes, and fee structure for the long-term conversion of the Open-BH Program dining participants.

## **Deadline for Signatures Approaches**

UNITE HERE Local 11 has been circulating a petition in an attempt to reverse the City Council's decision approving the Cheval Blanc Beverly Hills Specific Plan Project.

UNITE HERE Local 11 is a union that represents over 32,000 workers employed in hotels, restaurants, airports, sports arenas, and convention centers throughout Southern California and Arizona.

On June 30 the City received an appeal petition from GK Law on behalf of UNITE HERE appealing four resolutions adopted by the Planning Commission regarding Cheval Blanc. They previously claimed that the EIR inadequately analyzed the Project's impact on

"UNITE HERE Local 11 believes there is a regional problem in which developers often receive favorable development conditions to build commercial projects like hotels, but those same favorable conditions are not always offered to housing developments. We are
