

City Council Adopts Urgency Ordinance for Tenant Repayment Protections and Cap on Rent Increases

At their Tuesday meeting the City Council unanimously adopted an urgency ordinance for residential repayment protections and readopted the cap on annual rent increases for the 2022-2023 fiscal vear. The maximum rent increase for fiscal year 2022 – 2023 is 3.1%.

California's State of Emergency for COVID-19 is expected to end on Feb. 28, and city staff thought that the City should adopt an urgency ordinance to preserve the emergency housing protections that have already been adopted.

The rent repayment provisions that are currently in effect require that tenants must pay any unpaid rent accrued due to the eviction moratorium in full by May 31, 2023, after which landlords may charge or collect late fees for delayed rent, or seek eviction due to unpaid sums.

Once the City ends its state of emergency the repayment deadline and maximum rent increase percentage through June 30, 2023 will also end. If the City ended the state of emergency prior to May 31 or June 30, any unpaid rent would be due immediately, and rent increases could proceed.

The urgency ordinance preserves the rent repayment deadline of May 31, 2023 and the rent increase cap through June 30, 2023, regardless of when the City ends its local emergency.

The Council will also bring back an anti-harassment component to this ordinance after several public comments were made claiming landlords were harassing tenants for unpaid rent.

ceived a construction update from Fonder-Salari, Inc. the Bond Manager who took over last July after the previous agreement with Don Blake's Team Concept Development Services (TCDS) expired.

After numerous delays, El Rodeo is slated to open in June of 2024. The school has been closed entirely for reconstruction since 2019, which Blake alleged would expedite its completion. However, the reverse proved to be true. Blake's original budget was estimated at \$166,591,150. The current estimated budget is \$165,259,072.

Fonder-Salari said they currently have DSA approval on the existing plans for Building C at Beverly High. They have completed a full estimate and said that this project can go to procurement once the California Department of Toxic Substances Control [DTSC] approves the mitigation plan for this site, which is expected to occur by the end of the year. Until then, Fonder-Salari will work on project specific qualifications to have pre-qualified contractors compete for this project.



The Planning Commission of the City of Beverly Hills, at its REGULAR meeting on **Thursday, February 23, 2023**, will hold a public hearing beginning at **1:30 PM**, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard to consider the following:

Conditional Use Permit. A request for a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) to allow for the establishment of a private training center (LA School of Gymnastics) at <u>9135 Olympic Boulevard</u>. Pursuant to Beverly Hills Municipal Code (BHMC) §10-3-1604, a CUP shall be obtained prior to the establishment of such facility.



This project has been assessed in accordance with the authority and criteria contained in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA, Public Resources Code Sections 21000 *et seq.*), the State CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Sections 15000 *et seq.*), and the environmental regulations of the City. Upon review, the project appears to qualify for a Class 1 Categorical Exemption (Existing Facilities) in accordance with the requirements of Section 15301 of the State CEQA Guidelines, which is applicable to the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, leasing, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use. Accordingly, the Planning Commission will consider a recommendation to find the project exempt from the environmental review requirements of CEQA, pursuant to Section 15301.

Once the procurement phase has been completed, construction can start and is expected to take about two years to complete. The estimated project value is \$56 million, which is under the \$76 million project budget.

The bridge at Beverly High that connects Building A to Building B2/B3 can remain in place as the firm sees no reason for it to be demolished because it is 'perfectly safe'. However, it will need a bit of modernization for ADA requirements and they are working with the current design team to keep the bridge in place and make full use of it. Fonder-Salari is still within budget for both B3 and B4, as well as the Amendment 8 South Site Project. The current completion date for B3 and B4 is June of 2025.

The firm is currently working on a DSA pre-check for the new "BulldogAid Wellness Center" at Beverly Vista Middle School. DSA approval is to be obtained after completion of the design.

The future projects the District has expressed interest in includes: Beverly High retaining walls, Beverly High re-abandonment of legacy oil wells, Beverly High Grand Lawn, and Beverly High South Site athletic fields project. Fonder-Salari estimates the athletic fields to cost around \$40 million.

Police Say no Arrest Made in Connection to Anti-Armenian Flyers

Beverly Hills police on Tuesday said no arrests will be made after anti-Armenian flyers were posted around the city last month.

On Jan. 28 the Beverly Hills Police Department launched an investigation into the posting of flyers. Although they say they are "offensive and insensitive", it has been determined that the flyers fall within the protection of the First Amendment, according to the department's Twitter.

An investigation was launched after flyers were found taped to street poles near



La Cienega and Wilshire boulevards.

"Wipe Armenia off the map," some of the flyers read in part.

The Police Department said they do not condone or tolerate any hate speech directed at anyone, for any reason.

Richards Weighs in on Girardi Case

Beverly Hills criminal defense attorney Ronald Richards weighed in on the federal indictment of disbarred attorney Thomas Girardi, who allegedly embezzled more than \$15 million from several of his legal clients.

Girardi owned the Los Angeles-based

Girardi Keese law firm until creditors forced his law firm into bankruptcy in Dec. of 2020.

Girardi and David Lira, along with the now-defunct firm's head of finance. Christopher Kamon, have been indicted on federal charges of wire fraud and criminal contempt after misappropriating millions in client funds. Although Giradi and Kamon are named in two separate indictments, one in Chicago and one in Los Angeles, Lira is only being charged in Chicago.

All three men are being accused of using clients' funds to pay expenses for the law firm, including payroll, as well as using some of those funds to pay back other clients whose settlement funds were also misused, and paying credit card bills for

Seal Beach. There's already been a court appointed conservator - his brother is in charge. There has been a finding that he is mentally impaired with Alzheimers. So, it's not guaranteed that he's going to have competency to stand trial," Richards said.

Richards is representing the law offices of Philip R. Sheldon, who is suing Lira, the signer on Girardi Keese's trust account. They believe Lira used money from the account that was owed to Sheldon Law on personal expenses. That case was set for trial for March 13, but that is likely to be put on hold due to the recent federal charges.

"I think the more significant case is in Chicago against his son in law, David Lira, who has resources. He's married to Tom

lawyer and he was the signer on the trust account. So, he has a bigger problem because he's definitely competent to stand trial," Richards said.

Girardi and Lira represented five clients who were relatives of passengers killed in the 2018 crash of Lion Air Flight 610. Girardi Keese filed lawsuits in federal court in Chicago against the plane's manufacturer, Boeing Co., and settled the suits in 2020. Boeing's counsel wired the settlement funds to Girardi Keese's trust account, with most of the money intended for the clients. The charges allege that Girardi, Lira, and Kamon misappropriated more than \$3 million of the settlement funds

"It's great for the victims to finally see a criminal prosecution because it took so long," Richards said.

Richards is also representing Christina Fulton, Nicolas Cage's ex, who is suing other Girardi Keese attorneys and Erika Girardi for alleged fraud and theft in a \$700,000-plus lawsuit. There is currently a case management conference scheduled to set a trial.

Richards first got involved in the case by tweeting about it when Girardi was about to be held in contempt of court in Chicago, and began telling the public that Girardi was potentially stealing client funds. Richards was also interviewed for a Hulu documentary, but right before it was going to air he got appointed special counsel, and Hulu could not air that part as he was no longer just a legal analyst.

Wells, Margo Disagree on **Role of Board President**

Board President Noah Margo and Board member Mary Wells disagreed at last Tuesday's Board of Education meeting after controversy arose over the role of the Board President in running the meeting, and setting the agenda.

Wells said she wanted to bring back the reading of the "Mission and Vision" statement and the "Community Pledge", as well as putting the "Community Spotlight" back on the agenda, both of which were spearheaded by Wells at the time of her Board Presidency.

On Sunday Sinai Temple had around 50 Holocaust survivors come out to speak to middle school students, with one of the survivors having just turned 103 years old. About 120 people attended the event.

"Holocaust education is more important than ever now. We need to educate our youth, so that they are knowledgeable and understand what it means to say, never again. We want to ensure that such atrocious acts will never occur towards another group, culture, or religion," Councilmember Sharona Nazarian said.

I also know that there is no data to correlate the reading of the Mission Vision and Community pledge to student success. The majority of the Board was in agreement to add back the Community Spotlight, but to limit it to 10 minutes and not do it every meeting.

"I don't want this to feel as though it's an insult to you. When we talk about setting the agenda and the president setting the agenda I think it's a really important job about making certain when things should get on and whether the board has the information to come with those items. I feel that those are procedural [and] the items that we are talking about are more substantive. These are substantive items that we as a Board have agreed to and that we have been supporting as a mission. I don't see this as managing the agenda. So, I'm sorry that you take that personally,' Wells said.

Planning Commission to Discuss Fractional **Ownership**

At their Thursday meeting the Planning Commission is expected to discuss an ordinance that would recommend the adoption of the draft ordinance to the City Council to prohibit fractional ownership of properties in the city.

Fractional ownership is when shares of ownership rights are sold to multiple buyers. This allows each buyer an ownership interest and right to use the property for a certain period of time.

This operates similarly to a timeshare, although it conveys actual ownership rights instead of a narrow right for use of the property for a certain time period, and also divides a property into fewer frac-

On July 15, 2021, the City Council adopted an interim ordinance to prohibit the fractional ownership of residential and commercial properties in the city as it was believed this would detract from the sense of community in some neighborhoods and have a negative impact on the existing housing crisis. The Council also discussed this topic in relation to a proposed development project.

The One Beverly Hills project was approved in 2021 and includes a fractional ownership component.

The City Council extended the ordinance, with an expiration date of July 14. City staff has drafted an ordinance with permanent regulations to replace those in the interim ordinance, with the intent that the permanent regulations would become effective before July 14 when the interim ordinance expires.

The Planning Commission is expected to conduct the public hearing, discuss the draft ordinance, and possibly adopt a resolution recommending approval of the ordinance to the City Council.

City Council OKs Inaugural **MADE** in Beverly Hills **Event**

At their Tuesday Study Session the City Council approved a proposed new event - MADE in Beverly Hills. This 4-day festival from Thursday, May 4 - Sunday, May 7, would feature arts, architecture, fashion, design, and outdoor landscapes throughout Beverly Hills. MADE is an acronym meaning Modern/Architecture/ Design and Experiences.

The organizers intend to create a weekend celebration and education of art, architecture, landscapes, and community aspects of Beverly Hills. It is a collection of tours that will be both residential and

of lectures, films, and movies. They are also trying to incorporate local businesses to be able to participate. They anticipate about 6,000 tickets being sold.

The festival features over 20 events including iconic residential, commercial, and park tours, lectures, films, a luncheon fashion show, and cocktail parties organized by Modernism Week staff, with some events featuring City-led parks and municipal tours as well.

MADE is the parent company for Modernism Week in Palm Springs. This will be the first time that they have created a platform for a similar-styled festival outside of Palm Springs. This new event is proposed to be announced during Modernism Week on February 24, 2023.

MADE is a non-profit focused on the intent to foster and nurture the appreciation of architecture and design, as well as encourage education and preservation. The Palm Springs event draws 100,000 attendees and is an 11-day celebration. Its mission is to give back. They have a scholarship program for students that are studying design and architecture.

Some of the proposed MADE events include:

A City Hall and Sculpture Park Tour of the second floor, with special access to the look-out tower still under renovation, led by the City Architect. The tour would also include an Art Tour of pieces from the City's Fine Art collection with volunteer docents.

Greystone Mansion: Exclusive Access Tour & Self-Guided Tours for an exclusive behind the scenes tour beyond the first floor of Greystone, including the bowling alley, prohibition bar and more. This tour is guided by Greystone's Venue Coordinator, and would be offered at a rate of \$60. The self-guided tour "Inside the Mansion" will showcase Greystone's main floor and gardens with a charge of \$20.

A Architectural Trolley Ride for a 4-mile loop of Beverly Hills with interactive architectural stops along the way will also be included. Guests will receive a map of the route showing the stops where they can depart and discover more.

Additional events are being discussed with local businesses, but could include highlighting community treasures such as Edelweiss Chocolate, a lecture at Spago restaurant, or taking in a midcentury mural at the rooftop of the Beverly Hilton Hotel.

Residents will be able to purchase tickets two weeks in advance before they go on sale for the general public on March 1. Residents will also get a discount of 25% for the tickets that they purchased.

Critical Conversations State of Women's Rights Event to Take Place Tonight

The City will be hosting a free speaker series called Critical Conversations: The State of Women's Rights in Modern Times tonight, at 7 p.m. in the Municipal Gallery inside City Hall.

Sponsored by the City's Human Relations Commission in partnership with the Community Services Department, this speaker series invites leaders to discuss their roles in cultivating a community of greater kindness, equity, inclusion and belonging. The discussion will be moderated by Human Relations Commission Chair Noelle Freeman. There is also an opportunity to ask a question for the panel upon registration, and at the event as well.

"I am beyond excited to have these incredible women speak about their own special journey to becoming the leaders they are today," Mayor Lili Bosse said. "It is so important that women continue to use their voices to speak out for equality and women rights until we no longer have to."

BHHS Football Coach Resigns

Marquis Bowling has resigned as Beverly Hills High School's football coach, in part because of uncertainty over whether he will continue to live in Southern California and his belief that he ``may have taken the program as far as I can take it."

"It would probably be the best for everybody at this point" if "someone else picks up the baton and runs with it," Bowling said.

Bowling said he may accept a position in Houston, the Memphis, Tennessee area where he was raised or Nashville, Tennessee.

The Normans were 1-19 in Bowling's two seasons as coach as they continued to lack players. Beverly Hills was 0-10 in 2022, including forfeiting a game to Leuzinger "because of a lack of healthy available players," Bowling said.

The Normans began the season with

34 players and when they met for practice four days before they were to play the Olympians, there were 16 players available, Bowling said

The lack of players has been a key reason the Norman football program has struggled in recent years, with players forced to play offense, defense and special teams with little time for rest on the sideline

Bowling said he has recommended that defensive coordinator Beau Hankins, a former Georgia Tech linebacker, succeed him.

Bowling's successor will Beverly Hills' sixth coach since Carter Paysinger resigned following the 2008 season to concentrate on being assistant principal. He became the school's principal in 2010. Only his immediate successor, his younger brother Donald Paysinger, lasted more

than three seasons.

The Normans have had 11 consecutive seasons of three victories or less and have not qualified for the Southern Section playoffs since 2010.

The Beverly Hills Athletic Alumni Association's (BHAAA) Joe Sutton Scholarship is intended to provide financial assistance to fellow athletic alumni in need. The Ornest Family Foundation has donated a six-figure grant to BHAAA in honor of the late Maury Ornest in hopes of helping people with mental health issues get the assistance and ther-

apy they need. David Bernstein and Berry Robinson are the liaisons for the Joe Sutton Scholarship that will be awarded for mental health. This subject was discussed in issues #1092 and #1145

managed his own life and his home in Beverly Hills. It was very difficult for him and for the family off and on at different times.

What was exciting for him is that he found art. He was a jock and one of his therapists suggested that he try painting. So, he embarked on a lifelong, passionate journey of painting. When he died of

heart failure in 2018, at the age of 58, we found 1,400 paintings. My husband [Rick Leslie] and I ended up putting on a show for him because what he always wanted was to be part of the art communi-

ty. But with his paranoia and fears, he couldn't do it. He dreamed of people buying his art. We treated his house like a gallery and we invited eight charities to benefit from any painting sold. We raised \$83,000 for these charities.

I know how much therapy helped him and it's helped me. I believe in it. When Steven Fenton talked about the scholarships that they give out, I said, 'What about therapy?' He said, 'Well, because of the needs that somebody may have, that is often last on the list'. So, that's how the idea was born. It seems like they're a really good group of people. The work BHAAA is doing, trying to help people with these scholarships in such a meaningful, direct way, is wonderful and we want to help people.

Why is mental health important to you?

David: The Ornest Family Foundation has been so generous to make this donation. A lot of people today are suffering, and a lot of people don't get the proper help that they need. I think it's important because this will give us the opportunity to help other people and help people get better. Like any illness, there are varying degrees of issues that go on from depression, the stress of everyday life, as well as addiction and alcoholism. I think it's hard enough for people to understand

what they're going through, but then even harder to reach out, to ask for help. I think that through this scholarship, we will really have an opportunity to help a lot of people.

I have had a lot of help dealing with my own mental health issues. Without that help, I would not be where I am today. Change is possible and I'm grateful that I can help others in their own journeys to get better.

Laura: I've been on the Board of Didi Hirsch Mental Health Services for more than 20 years, and in that arena too I have just seen the power of talk therapy. I know from my own personal experience how much it helped Maury. That coupled with medication helped him tremendously. There was no simple answer. These days we've heard since

COVID, anxiety and depression have been on the rise, especially among young people. It's a complicated world we live in. I believe so much in getting good therapy to help with anxiety. His illness was debilitating at times, and I've seen anxiety and depression can be debilitating, too. I think there's less of a stigma than there used to be for mental

illness, but it seems to me it's still not at the same level as cancer, tuberculosis, or diabetes where it is a health issue. The more that we can make it easy for people, and make it accessible for people to get the help they need in this area, the better.

Laura, tell us about the Ornest Family Foundation.

It was started by my father, and I'm the CFO and CEO. After my father passed and then after my mother passed, the four siblings, Laura, Cindy, Mike, and Maury became the directors. We donate to various causes encompassing medical, mental health, Jewish causes, social education - it's a range.

Among the many donations, The Or-

nest Family Foundation donates Jewish Family Service. I'm on the board of Jewish Family Service and Didi Hirsch Mental Health Services which we also donate to. Jewish Federation, Cedars

Sinai Medical Center, The Guardians, some universities for scholarships, The Friends of the Semel Institute for Neuroscience and Human Behavior at UCLA, American Civil Liberties Union: St. John's Hospital, Casa Colina, and a number of smaller charities for social justice and mental health, [the Foundation has donated to].

What do you hope this scholarship accomplishes?

David: To help as many people as we can - wanting to bring mental health to the forefront, to be able to discuss it openly. The stigma of mental health is diminishing, but hopefully, it will bring out the ability for people to ask for help and to be able to change their lives. It's never too late to change your life and

there are a lot of people that want to help others do that.

The Joe Sutton Scholarship by the Ornest Family Foundation in honor of Maury Ornest is really important because not only, I think to carry on what he went through, Laura is really striving to help other people and to help other people that are going through

mental issues. When people say mental health, the first thing most people think of is addiction or alcoholism. But usually, the underlying issues in some of those cases are on the basis of more of a mental health condition, whether it's depression or being manic depressive. Maury was amazing because he battled his own depression and mental illness and used his art as an outlet to help himself. It's about hopefully giving someone else that opportunity to change and to get the help they need.

Laura: I hope that it will allow people who would not otherwise be able to get talk therapy, get it, and it'll afford them the opportunity that they wouldn't otherwise have at this difficult time in their lives.

David, how did you get involved with this scholarship?

I was very good friends with [the late] Joe Sutton, who was good friends with my father. I grew up with Mike and Robbie, his sons. After Joe passed, they decided [with BHAAA founder] Steven Fenton to create the Joe Sutton Scholarship. It was something that I was very willing to get involved with to help other people. As I got older, I realized how important it is to help others. So, I thought it was a great way to help alumni athletes who are in a tough spot.

Laura, your brothers Mike and Maury Ornest were honored at the athletic alumni dinner last year. Maury has passed away. Did this encourage you to get involved with this scholarship?

My youngest brother, Maury, was a star baseball player at Beverly High and was honored and inducted into the Hall of Fame. He was drafted by Major League Baseball out of Beverly High and went on to play minor league professional baseball. He loved baseball. He was a lively, funny, charismatic, handsome, smart guy. He had the misfortune of getting an illness out of the blue when he was in his early twenties - schizoaffective, he had a psychotic break. So, thus began a difficult journey for him. There were ups and downs. He

ORDINANCE NO. 23-0-2871

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS AMENDING CHAPTER 5 AND CHAP-TER 6 OF TITLE 4 OF THE BEVERLY HILLS MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING EVICTIONS

WHEREAS, the Beverly Hills City Council established the Beverly Hills Rent Stabilization Commission ("Commission") pursuant to Ordinance No. 19-O-2776, effective on May 3, 2019; and

WHEREAS, one of the duties of the Commission is to make recommendations to the City Council regarding possible amendments to Chapters 5 and 6 of Title 4 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code in connection with issues that have not been resolved by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, one such issue relates to Sections 4-5-512 and 4-6-6 (K) of the Municipal Code, which allows a landlord to bring an action to recover the possession of an apartment unit if the landlord seeks in good faith to recover possession so as to do substantial alteration work on the building for the purpose of major remodeling; and

WHEREAS, on August 5, 2020, the Commission held a duly noticed meeting to consider proposed modifications to Chapters 5 and 6 of Title 4 of the Municipal Code related to evictions for the purpose of major remodeling and, by a majority (4-2) vote, the Commission voted to recommend to the Council that the major remodeling provisions be eliminated from Chapters 5 and 6 of Title 4 of the Municipal Code in their entirety, and directed the City Attorney's Office to draft a resolution setting forth the Commission's recommendation; and

WHEREAS, on September 2, 2020, the Commission adopted Resolution No. RSC 3, setting for the Commission's recommendation; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting on December 13, 2022, the City Council considered the recommendation of the Commission and determined that the Municipal Code should be amended in accordance with the recommendation of the Commission.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment of Chapter 5 of Title 4 of the Municipal Code. The City Council hereby amends Article 5 of Chapter 5 of Title 4 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code regarding evictions by deleting Section 4-5-512 (Major Remodeling) in its entirety.

Section 2. Amendment of Chapter 6 of Title 4 of the Municipal Code. The City Council hereby amends Chapter 6 of Title 4 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code regarding evictions by deleting subparagraph K (Major Remodeling) in its entirety from Section 4-6-6 (Evictions).

Section 3. CEQA. This Ordinance is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3) which is the general rule that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environ-

ment, and CEQA does not apply where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity may have a significant effect on the environment. It can be seen with certainty that the amendments to the City's rent stabilization regulations to regulate evictions will not cause a significant effect on the environment. In addition, the amendments are not a project that is subject to the provisions of CEQA, pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(2) and (b) (5).

<u>Section 4.</u> <u>Severability.</u> If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be considered a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity and enforceability of the other provisions of the Ordinance

Section 5. Publication. The City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation published and circulated in the City within fifteen (15) days after its passage in accordance with Section 36933 of the Government Code, shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance, and shall cause this Ordinance and the City Clerk's certification, together with proof of publication, to be entered in the Book of Ordinances of the

Council of this City.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall go into effect and be in full force and effect at 12:01 a.m. on the thirty-first (31st) day after its passage.
