Traffic and Parking Approves Beverly/Cañon/ Lomitas Roundabout

The Traffic and Parking Commission discussed the conceptual design options for infrastructure improvements at the Beverly/Cañon/Lomitas intersection, and recommended adding a roundabout with pedestrian refuge/ channelization islands and flashing beacons at the intersection.

At the May 5, 2022 Commission meeting, city staff provided an introduction to the issues observed at the intersection and discussed an evaluation being conducted by engineering design firm, GHD, Inc.

At the Sept. 1, 2022 meeting, the Commission was presented with the results of a safety review and revealed this intersection has experienced a low record of reported collisions, with a total of 23 injury collisions between 2014-2020.

Video analysis of the intersection found that there are conflicts between road users or narrowly avoided collisions occurring all day. The design is intended to improve safety and accessibility for pedestrians.

Six conceptual design options were considered. This included raised midblock crosswalks, raised midblock crosswalks and turn pockets, intersection crosswalks, intersection crosswalks and turn pockets, roundabout, or no change.



The program creates a 30-60 day enrollment window. Interested employees submit an irrevocable letter of resignation during the enrollment period, and at the end of the enrollment period, a fiscal analysis is conducted to determine the savings, or cost to the district. Based on these results, the Board will determine if the plan proceeds or if it is canceled. If the plan proceeds, the employees resign. If the plan is canceled, the offer and resignation letters are rescinded.

In order to be eligible for the plan, employees must have completed at

least 5 years of district service, are eligible to retire under CalSTRS or CalP-ERS, and must resign on or before June 30, after completing the current school year.



life, or \$600 paid out over 15 years. Currently 133 employees are eligible for the program.

No matter the option an employee chooses, it will cost the district 80% of final pay. This is intended to put the flexibility in the hands of the employees to make the best financial decision for them.

The ultimate savings or cost of the program will be determined based on the actual number of enrolled employees, resulting replacement employee costs and the number of positions backfilled. A final analysis based on the actual enrolled employees will be presented to the Board after the close of the enrollment window. If the program is unable to demonstrate fiscal savings, the program may be rescinded.

Planning Commission Approves Cosmetic Spa

At last Thursday's meeting the Planning Commission approved a Conditional Use Permit in a 4-1 vote to allow for the establishment of a cosmetic spa, Integrative Wellness by Dr. Rahi, on the ground floor of a commercial building located at 421 North Rodeo Drive. Chair Myra Demeter was the sole dissenting vote.

> South Santa Monica Boulevard and Brighton Way. The site is developed with a three-story commercial building, The Rodeo Collection, owned by Daryoush Mahboubi-Fardi. Immediately adjacent to the space, within the Rodeo Collection, is another cosmetic spa that was approved by the Planning Commission in Aug. of 2022.

> Integrative Wellness by Dr. Rahi plans to offer anti-aging and regenerative medicine services including: in-depth consults, dermal fillers, neurotoxins, supplements, IV Drips, electro muscular stimulation, laser hair removal, chemical peels, micro-needling, and more.

> The project site sits in-between a bakery to the south and a previously approved cosmetic spa to the north. The site is currently developed with a mix of retail, restaurant, medical, and office tenants. The current directory lists eight retail stores, three restaurants, nine medical uses, not including the subject suite and the 2022-approved Cosmetic Spa, and six salons. Approximately 35% of the building's businesses listed on the website are medical uses.

> The Commission considered whether this project could result in an overconcentration of Cosmetic Spa and Medical Uses in the 400 block of North Rodeo Drive, but the majority ultimately approved the project as the spa already operates at 9615 Brighton Way, and is only moving locations.

Beverly High Principal Search to be Finalized Soon

At Tuesday's Board of Education meeting Superintendent Michael Bregy said the search for a new Beverly High principal is still ongoing, however, three candidates have moved onto the second round of interviews after two panels of community members, parents, staff, alumni and board members interviewed seven candidates on Monday.

Former Beverly High Principal Mark Mead was appointed last year to the Cabinet Level Position of Director of School Safety.

On Wednesday, each finalist was giv-

en a student-led tour and participated in a cabinet interview. Each candidate was given a short form case study to prepare in advance for a discussion with the cabinet. They then met with district principals who provided their elementary and middle school perspectives. Thursday, Bregy will conduct the final round and make a recommendation to the Board by the next meeting.

Drew Stewart and Kim Decatrel currently serve as Interim Beverly High Co-Principals for the 2022-2023 school year. Samantha Jung also serves as Interim Assistant Principal for the same duration. This is the first time the high school has had two co-principals serve at the same time.

Festival Beverly Hills Coming Next Month

At last Tuesday's Study Session the City Council approved proposed plans for the inaugural Festival Beverly Hills, scheduled for Sunday, March 12, 8am-1pm. Festival Beverly Hills is a new event for the Arts and Culture Commission as part of the City's Embrace and Celebrate Culture Initiative.

Festival Beverly Hills will serve as the new signature event for the Arts and Culture Commission to enhance arts and culture events and programming in the City. The creation of the Festival was identified as the top priority through a community-wide survey.

This concept was presented on Sept. 21, 2022, at the Rodeo Drive Special Events Committee meeting. Mayor Lili Bosse and Councilmember Lester Friedman directed staff to produce this first festival at the size and scale of a Farmers Market special event with an estimated budget of \$10,000-\$15,000.

The goal of this initiative is to showcase a culturally diverse spectrum of food, cultures, artists, workshops, and performances.

There are several proposed activities scheduled from 8am-1pm on Sunday, March 12. This includes: farmers and vendors - creative booths, expanded youth workshops and craft making, a youth food competition - Oscars-inspired food board, diverse musical and dance showcases, and global rhythms at the Market.

BHPD Issues 58 Citations For Cell Phone Violations

Fifty-eight drivers were cited for hands-free cell phone violations during a distracted driving enforcement operation on Friday, Feb. 3.

"Despite repeated efforts to warn drivers about the hands-free cell phone law, some drivers continue to use their phones while operating a vehicle," Chief Mark Stainbrook said. "Our ultimate goal is to change behaviors that help make our roads safer."

California has had distracted driving laws on the books since 2008. Under current law, drivers are not allowed to hold their phone or other electronic device while driving. This includes talking, texting, or using an app.

Using a handheld cell phone while driving is punishable by a fine. Violating the hands-free law for a second time within 36 months of a prior conviction for the same offense will result in a point being added to a driver's record.

If you have an important phone call or need to program directions, the Police Department suggests pulling over to a safe parking spot, and before driving, either silence your phone or put it somewhere out of reach.

Funding for this program was provided by a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.

The Arts and Culture Commission discussed the 2023 edition of the 29th Music in the Mansion Festival, at their Tuesday meeting.

The Festival began in 1994 as Sun-

days at Two, a music series held at the library. In 1999, the concert series moved to the living room of Greystone Mansion and was then known as Music in the Mansion. After 20 years of concerts, the City saw the return of the program with a one-day festival in 2022. This year the concerts will take place at Greystone on Thursday, April 20-Sunday, April 23, featuring performances by nine groups over four days.

Artists are juried into this series by participating in the Beverly Hills National Audition. Auditions are open to instrumentalists, pianists, vocalists, and chamber ensembles. An audition committee selects all of the finalists. Since the beginning, Artistic Director Laura Schmieder has been dedicated to this program, volunteering to oversee auditions and curate the performance series. Schmieder was recognized by the City Council in 2014 and given a proclamation to honor her years of service.

Rodeo Drive Committee Approves Request for Special Event Alleyway Closure

On Tuesday City Council liaisons Mayor Lili Bosse and Councilmember Lester Friedman approved a request from Allen Media Group for special event alleyway closures at the Beverly Wilshire Hotel on March 12.

The Beverly Wilshire, Mindy Weiss Event Company, and Allen Media Group CEO/ host Byron Allen had requested approval for a one-day special event, which includes a street closure of the alleyway connecting Charleville with South Rodeo Drive. The closure will also include lane use of South Rodeo Drive on Sunday, March 12, for an Oscar Gala benefiting Children's Hospital Los Angeles. A sidewalk closure will also be in effect on South Rodeo Drive, with regular hotel and valet operations to continue.

This request has support of the Beverly Wilshire Hotel and the business mostly affected by the closure, the Gang, Tyre, Ramer, Brown & Passman, Inc. Previous closures for this event were conducted by the same organizers in 2019, and 2020, with no safety issues reported in either year.

The closure of the alleyway is from

Saturday, March 11, at 10:00 pm through Monday, March 13, at 12:00 pm. The alleyway will be used for a step and repeat, red carpet area, guest arrivals, and a tent covering the stretch of the alleyway. This is an invite-only event that takes place from 3:00 pm through 2:00 am. Pick-ups for guests would be through the normal valet operations of the Beverly Wilshire Hotel. A section of meters on Charleville from South Rodeo Drive to the alleyway opening will be utilized to queue limo/cars, in an attempt to minimize traffic impacts.

This event occurs on the same date as the Vanity Fair Oscar Party as well as the Cultural Festival Event at the Farmers Market.

Staff will bring the proposal to the City Council as a consent item at the Feb. 21, meeting.

Beverly Hills to Celebrate 2023 Earth Day

Beverly Hills will be celebrating the 20th Annual Earth Day event at the Farmer's market on Sunday, April 23rd. This year's theme is "Investing in Our Planet."

The Public Works department will have a booth with information about the City's sustainability efforts, vendor and organizations booths, free compost giveaway, and free shredding services for the community to take part of on that day.

In addition to the Earth Day Celebration on April 23rd, the City will be participating in month-long activities during the month of April.

Human Relations Commission to Discuss Updated Work Plan

The Human Relations Commission is expected to discuss their updated 2023 work plan that was approved in Jan.

The work plan consists of four areas of focus: Embrace Civility, Anti-Hate Initiative, Community Assistance Grant Fund, and Homeless and Mental Health.

The Embrace Civility section consists of the annual Civility Month Celebration and Embrace Civility Award, Kindness week, and Kindness Matters.

Civility Month is celebrated in Beverly Hills in Oct. Human Services staff, with participation from the commission, plans community events, social media campaigns, and citywide promotion. In 2022 the commission launched their Inaugural Day of Giving.

Kindness Week is recognized annually in Feb. and closes out this week. It consists of a week of programming to promote kindness in the community.

Commissioners highlight community members that have been an example of kindness each month for the Kindness Matters component.

The Anti-Hate Initiative has two components - Diversity, Equity & Inclusion Awareness Initiative- Critical Conversations and Embrace and Celebrate Culture Initiative.

The Diversity, Equity & Inclusion Initiative prioritizes policies and programs that is intended to promote the

representation and participation of different groups of individuals through a semi-annual Critical Conversations speaker series, as well as ongoing engagement with the BHUSD.

The Embrace and Celebrate Culture Initiative Promotes arts and culture events in collaboration with the Arts and Culture Commission.

The Community Assistance Grant Fund (CAGF) supports non-profit organizations that provide direct social services to vulnerable members of the community.

The Homeless and Mental Health Initiative has three components: the homeless section, mental health awareness, and the Beverly Hills Ambassador Program.

The Homeless Initiative consists of an educational and an advocacy component. The advocacy component aims to find new ways to address homelessness through expanded City services and partnerships. The educational component is designed to help the community learn more about the issue.

Mental Health Awareness Monthly presentations are provided during commission meetings from community based mental health providers in an effort to inform the general public about accessible mental health support.

Ambassadors from the Beverly Hills Ambassador Program work in partnership with the Human Services Division, police, and other departments to address panhandling and connect individuals with social service needs to the City's Beverly Hills Outreach Team.

Allen Introduces Legislation to Strengthen Safety and Training for Young Drivers

In an effort to improve the safety of young drivers and those on the road around them, Senator Ben Allen (D - Santa Monica) introduced SB 473, which will expand California's Graduated Driver License (GDL) program to include new drivers under 21 years of age. Currently, the program only covers 16- and 17-year-old drivers in their first year of driving.

"As a father, I am heartbroken by the stories of parents who lost their children due to an accident caused by an untrained driver," Allen said. "With this practical expansion of the Graduated Driver License program, research shows we can annually save the lives of 500 young people just beginning to make their mark on the world."

Implemented in 1998, California's GDL program requires teens under 18 to gradually earn full driving privileges. These drivers must attend driver education courses, spend six hours behind the wheel with a driving school instructor, and devote 50 hours to on-the-road practice under the supervision of a licensed adult over the age of 25.

After successfully completing the necessary education and DMV driving tests, the young drivers receive provisional licenses with additional restric-

tions on nighttime driving and driving with other teen passengers.

SB 473 will require all new drivers under age 21 to undergo driver training and provisional licensing periods. A 2013 study funded by NHTSA found that GDL programs have reduced the overall number of crashes among teen drivers up to 30 percent nationwide. The same study showed inexperienced 18- to 20-year-old drivers are involved in fatal crashes at rates up to 60 percent higher than other age groups.

SB 473 is cosponsored by the California Coalition of Children's Safety and Health, Impact Teen Drivers, and the Nora Rose-Hines Foundation.

Partial Crescent Drive Closure To Begin Feb. 28 For Vanity Fair Event

Vanity Fair will be returning to Beverly Hills to host its post-Academy Awards Party on the 400 block of North Crescent Drive, adjacent to City Hall, on the evening of Sunday, March 12.

As crews begin work to assemble the tent on North Crescent Drive between North Santa Monica Boulevard and South Santa Monica Boulevard, the 400 block of the street will be closed beginning Tuesday, Feb. 28 at 10 p.m. to Thursday, March 16, reopening by 10 p.m.

All businesses on Crescent Drive are accessible during the closure. Motorists are urged to use alternate routes and heed all directional signage. Access remains open to local parking garages.

Additionally, on the event day beginning at 3 p.m. on Sunday, March 12 to 2 a.m. Monday, March 13, the following roads surrounding the tent will be impacted. Motorists are urged to use alternate routes during that time.

North Cañon Drive between North and South Santa Monica Blvd. will be closed. Eastbound lanes on South Santa Monica Boulevard starting at Civic Center will be impacted, with lanes closed from Rexford Drive to North Cañon Drive. Detours will be in place routing traffic North and South on Rexford Drive. North Santa Monica Boulevard Westbound lane closures will be in place from Rodeo Drive to Rexford Drive.

Metro Working on Appendage Structures for South Side of Wilshire

By Danielle Berjikian

Station construction is currently ongoing through 2023 after Metro announced in Jan. of 2022 that both tunnel boring machines (TBMs) excavated tunnels between Century City and the Wilshire/ Rodeo station under Beverly Hills.

The two TBMs, named Harriet and Ruth, began digging at Century City on April 30, 2020, and traveled to the east. Both TBMs excavated for about 1.1 miles, between Century City and the Wilshire/Rodeo station. The first TBM, Harriet, reached Wilshire/Rodeo on Jan. 11, 2022. The second TBM, Ruth, reached the station box on Jan. 28, 2022.

Currently, the contractor for Metro is working on appendage structures on the south side of Wilshire Boulevard between La Cienega Boulevard and Tower Drive; removing and sawcutting existing pavements; and beginning excavation for the construction of the append-



age structures.

Construction for the Wilshire/Rodeo station is still in progress and the contractor has begun installation of SCE duct banks for the permanent power to the station. The easterly phase of work for the installation of conduits and vaults between South Canon Drive and Rexford Drive is about 70% complete. The westerly phase started on Jan. 2, and is expected to be completed sometime next month. The work will be performed during the day on weekends and night on weekdays.

Construction is also underway on the

ORDINANCE NO. 23-0-2872

- AN URGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS READOPTING RESIDENTIAL TENANT REPAYMENT
- PROTECTIONS AND READOPTING THE CAP ON ANNUAL RENT INCREASES FOR THE 2022-2023 FISCAL YEAR, AND
- DECLARING THE URGENCY THEREOF

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, international, national, state and local health and governmental authorities have responded to an outbreak of respiratory disease caused by a novel coronavirus named "SARSCOV-2" and the disease it causes has been named "coronavirus disease 2019," abbreviated COVID-19, ("COVID-19"); and

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2020, the City Manager, in his role as the Director of Emergency Services, proclaimed the existence of a local emergency pursuant to Section 2-4-107 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code to ensure the availability of mutual aid and an effective City response to the novel coronavirus ("COVID-19") and that state of emergency was ratified by the City Council on March 16, 2020 ("local state of emergency"); and

WHEREAS, the City of Beverly Hills enacted emergency regulations to ease financial burdens and slow the spread of the virus;

WHEREAS, during the City's local emergency, and in the interest of protecting the public health and preventing transmission of COVID-19, it was essential to avoid unnecessary housing displacement, to protect the City's affordable housing stock, and to prevent housed individuals from falling into homelessness: and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 20-O-2818 ("Ordinance"), as amended by Ordinance No. 22-O-2861, the City Council imposed a temporary moratorium on (1) evictions for non-payment of rent by residential tenants substantially impacted by the COVID-19 crisis; (2) no-fault evictions, unless necessary for the health and safety of tenants, neighbors, or the landlord, other than based on illness of the tenant or any other occupant of the residential rental unit; and (3) the annual rent increases authorized by Sections 4-5-303(C) and 4-6-3 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code with respect to any rent increase scheduled to take effect on or after March 15, 2020; provided that nothing in the Ordinance shall alter the date of annual rent increases in future years; and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance provides that nothing in the Ordinance relieves a tenant of liability for the unpaid rent, which the landlord may seek after May 31, 2023, and which the tenant must pay in full by May 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance prescribes a maximum allowable rent increase from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023 of 3.10%; and

WHEREAS, upon the end of the local state of emergency, the Ordinance shall cease to be effective; and

WHEREAS, the sudden and unanticipated repeal of the unpaid rent repayment provisions and cap on annual rent increases could cause significant financial burdens on residential tenants in the City leading to eviction and the displacement of housing; and,

WHEREAS, to avoid unnecessary housing displacement, protect the City's affordable housing stock, and prevent housed individuals from falling into homelessness, it is essential that the emergency unpaid rent repayment protections for residential tenants and cap on annual rent increases remain in effect until their prescribed conclusions; and

WHEREAS, based on the foregoing, the City Council finds that in order to fully protect the public health, safety and welfare, the repayment deadline for unpaid rent for those residential tenants substantially impacted by the COVID-19 crisis and the cap on annual rent increases must be preserved.

Section 1. Urgency Declaration. Based upon the recitals above, the City Council finds that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare. The City Council finds and determines that the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare requires that this Ordinance be enacted as an urgency ordinance pursuant to Government Code Section 36937(b) and take effect immediately upon adoption. This Ordinance must be adopted and must become effective immediately in order to protect residential tenants within the City who could face eviction and homelessness upon the acceleration of unpaid rent and the immediate end of the emergency annual rent increase protections when the City proclaims the local state of emergency has ended.

Section 2. All unpaid rent accrued from March 15, 2020 to May 31, 2022 by residential tenants due to substantial financial impacts related to the COVID-19 emergency must be paid in full by May 31, 2023. After May 31, 2023, unless the rent is paid in full, a landlord may charge or collect a late fee for rent that is delayed ; or a landlord may seek rent that is delayed through the eviction or other appropriate legal process. No fee for the late payment of such unpaid rent shall be charged by a landlord during the period March 15, 2020 through May 31, 2023. If a landlord makes an accommodation with respect to rent forbearance and the tenant is in conformance with the tenant's obligations under that accommodation, then the landlord shall not make a negative report to a credit bureau so long as the tenant remains in compliance with the accommodation.

Section 3. The maximum allowable rent increase allowed pursuant to Section 4-5-303(C) and 4-6-3 from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023 is 3.10%. Provided, further, if the rent increase was imposed at a rate less than 3.10%, then the maximum allowable rent increase from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023 shall be reduced by the percent increase that was imposed. Nothing in this Ordinance shall alter the date of annual rent increases in future years. Section 4. Uncodified. This Ordinance shall not be codified.

<u>Section 5.</u> <u>Severability.</u> If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be considered a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity and enforceability of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 6. Publication. The City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation published and circulated in the city within fifteen (15) days after its passage in accordance with Section 36933 of the Government Code, shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause this Ordinance and the City Clerk's certification, together with proof of publication, to be entered in the Book of Ordinances of the Council of this City.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance is adopted as an urgency ordinance for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety within the meaning of Government Code Section 36937(b), and therefore shall be passed immediately upon its introduction and shall become effective at 12:01 AM on February 8, 2023, upon its adoption by a minimum 4/5 vote of the City Council.

<u>Section 8. Certification.</u> This City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance.
