

In addition, please consider the following information when granting any concessions or incentives to this project:

- · Lack of Low Income, Inclusionary Housing with Market Rate Rental and Entrance Fees: Lazer Properties was unable to provide a rental range or buy-in amount for Margaux Beverly Hills, stating only that they would be "market rate." There are concerns that the facility may only be affordable for the wealthy, despite incentives for including low-income units. According to 10-3-1264, if rental rates are not subject to control by a public agency, they must be set by the planning commission as a condition of issuing a conditional use permit in accordance with city regulations. These regulations should ensure that rental rates are affordable at all times for elderly and handicapped persons whose incomes would otherwise restrict their opportunities to find adequate rental housing in the city. Additionally, the City of Beverly Hills is pursuing development of an affordable housing project targeted towards extremely-low- and lower-income residents, and the lack of provisions for low-income seniors in Margaux Beverly Hills should be considered when granting incentives, specifically the height restriction waiver.
- Number of two-bedroom units: Margaux Beverly Hills has proposed 9 two-bedroom units out of a total of 55 bedrooms, which equals 16.36%, exceeding the maximum of 5% and appearing to be in noncompliance with 10-3-1258, which limits the number of two-bedroom units in any one development to no more than 5% of the total number of units.
- Memory care accommodations: There does not appear to be any planned accommodations for memory care at Margaux Beverly Hills. As about 40% of people aged 65 or older have age-associated memory impairment, this could result in residents requiring memory care being "exited" from the facility. This approach does not seem humane and may result in a lot of turnover. As there could be a significant initiation fee, this lack of accommodation for memory care may be seen as a hidden profit center rather than a compassionate method of dealing with a common trait of aging.
- Loss of sunlight, view, and property value: There are concerns that the construction of Margaux Beverly Hills will result in significant loss of sunlight for east-facing residents at 300 N. Swall Dr. as well as for pedestrians on Clark. Additionally, the existing owners of condominiums on Swall Drive may experience a loss of view and property value, especially those with east-facing property.

In summary, we feel that this project not receive a conditional use permit with variances to which they should not be entitled

Police Department to Fully Enforce Parking Permit Program in April

The Police Department provided an update to the City Council regarding the Preferential Parking Program at their Tuesday meeting after several residents previously voiced their frustration with the recent changes to the system.

The parking permit program relaunched with the intent of relying primarily on vehicle license plates, also known as "Permit by Plate". The Police Department said they will utilize license plate recognition technology to further expand consistent coverage and maintain visibility within neighborhoods. Residents will now be given the option to register their license plates should they choose not to utilize the current placard system, however they can no longer use hang tags for overnight parking. The purpose of this change in the system was said to be for safety and security, automated DMV verification, integrated technologies, and improved parking management efficiency.

As of Feb. 27 a total of 7,576 permits have been issued.

Common concerns previously voiced by residents include, application and account difficulty, logistical changes, the renewal process, and utilizing guest parking.

Due to the fact that so many residents have had issues registering their license plates, the Police Department extended the registration deadline from Feb. 1 to March 1. They also said they will not begin issuing tickets right away, and rely more on warnings.

The most asked questions/concerns include: "I need help signing up," "I do not want to give my plate," "how do I get a permit for my gardener, guest, etc.", and "can I still use my hangtags?"

For residents who qualify for Legacy permits, they do not have to provide a license plate. Residents can purchase permits or obtain exemptions as needed for service workers. Residents with permits prior to 2019 qualify for hangtags. Some parking zones do not qualify for hangtags, such as residents needing both daytime and overnight permits

The Police Department said they will begin full enforcement of the program on April 1

City Council Grants Continuance Request for 910 North Bedford Drive Appeal

At their Tuesday meeting the City Council granted a continuance request related to the appeal hearing scheduled to consider the Planning Commission's decision denying a Historic Incentive Permit (HIP) for the property at 910 North Bedford Drive.

On Sept. 8, 2021, the property owner filed an appeal of the decision, seeking Council approval for a Historic Incen-

tive Permit. On Oct. 26, 2021, the City Council set the appeal hearing for the first meeting in April 2022, in order to provide the property owner time to consider redesigning the project so that waivers or deviations would not be required.

So far the Council has granted two continuances of the appeal hearing. Each



continuance was for six months. With the most recent request, the Council continued the hearing to the first meeting in April.

The property owner submitted a third request to continue the appeal hearing an additional six months as they have for-

mally applied for a Certificate of Appropriateness for consideration of a by-right project, one that would not require a Historic Incentive Permit, which is scheduled to be heard by the Cultural Heritage Commission next month. If the certificate is granted, the property owner could then submit the plans to the City's Development Services Program for building permit plan review.

HIPs allow deviations and waivers from development standards and are available to properties that are designated as local historic landmarks.

On Aug. 26, 2021, the Planning Commission adopted a resolution denying a Historic Incentive Permit for the property known as the Anthony-Kerry House.

The commission was specifically concerned with whether the project

met the intent of a HIP; the scale of the addition to the property; and maintaining the garden quality of the city.

The property is a two-story single-family residence with an area of approximately 33,971 square feet. The residence was originally constructed in 1909 on a prop-

erty in Los Angeles. In 1923, the property was relocated to Beverly Hills by actor Norman Kerry after he and his wife purchased the house to avoid its demolition. The residence has retained most of its character-defining features and is known

as the best example of high-style Craftsman architecture in the city.

The Cultural Heritage Commission has previewed the proposed project at various meetings in 2019 and 2020 and was unable to provide unanimous support for the



The Planning Commission of the City of Beverly Hills, at its REGULAR meeting on Thursday, March 23, 2023, will hold a public hearing beginning at **1:30 PM**, or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard to consider the following:

Zone Text Amendment. A City-initiated Zone Text Amendment (ZTA) establishing requirements to allow for surface parking lots, staging for construction, film projection and similar uses, storage of construction materials, partial assembly of building

components, and the placement of temporary construction offices and related structures as conditionally permitted uses on lots located within the City's T-1 and T-2 Transportation Zones. The establishment of such uses would require the issuance of a Conditional Use Permit.

Conditional Use Permit. A request by Roxbury Managers, LTD. (the "owner") for a Conditional Use Permit (CUP) to allow for construction related parking and staging associated with an off-site development project on a vacant lot located at 9900



North Santa Monica Boulevard (the "project site"). This request would allow for the project site to be used for construction parking and the staging of construction materials and temporary offices associated with the development of the One Beverly Hills project to the north of the project site, at 9900 Wilshire Boulevard, with future use of the site as a public parking lot once construction of the One Beverly Hills project has concluded. This request is contingent on approval of the proposed City-initiated ZTA to allow for these uses as part of a CUP entitlement process.

This project has been assessed in accordance with the authority and criteria contained

in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA, Public Resources Code Sections 21000 et seq.), the State CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Sections 15000 et seq.), and the environmental regulations of the City. Upon review, the project appears to qualify for a Categorical Exemption in accordance with the requirements of the State CEQA Guidelines. Accordingly, the Planning Commission will consider a recommendation to find the project categorically exempt from further environmental review under CEQA.

Written comments should identify the Agenda Item number or topic in the subject line of the email. In order to be read at the meeting, written comments will be allowed with a maximum of 350 words, which corresponds to approximately three (3) minutes of speaking time.

If a comment is received after the agenda item is heard, it will not be a part of the record. Any written comments received by end of the day on Tuesday, March 14, 2023, will be attached to the agenda report regarding this item. Any comments received after Tuesday, March 14, 2023, but prior the public hearing, will be distributed to the Commission under separate cover. According to Government Code Section 65009, if you challenge the City's action in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City, either at or prior to the public hearing. Please note that any comments received prior to or during the public hearing will be considered as part of the public record.

Public Works Commission Discusses Progress Update on Wastewater Ordinance Amendment

At their Friday meeting the Public Works Commission discussed a progress update on the Wastewater Ordinance Amendment prior to the adoption of a draft ordinance.

The goal of the ordinance is intended to protect the environment through regulations on the operations of the system. This includes regulating connections, maintenance, and discharges from commercial, residential and industrial sectors.

The intent of amending the ordinance was to further protect the environment and public health from sewer overflows.

The following topics were previously presented for ordinance consideration:

Permitting private lateral cleaning, proper termination of sewer lateral connections, protruding private lateral connection, deteriorating private laterals, prescribing easement locations, and permitting groundwater discharges to the sewer system.

At a previous meeting the commission supported the following items in the framework:

Proper termination of lateral connections at the sewer main, permitting the installation of lining to prevent protruding lateral to the sewer main, and prescribing the location of easements.

According to the staff report, city staff has seen root growth protruding in the public sewer main from abandoned lateral connections where the owner of the property does not have access to the line. The ordinance will make it so that private lateral terminations occur at the public sewer main. Termination will include excavation in the public right-of way.

Pipe lining has become a viable option to rehabilitate old sewer lateral lines, according to the staff report. City staff has seen an increase of lining jobs and consequently lining that protrudes into the public sewer main preventing proper

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flow. This may eventually result in sewer overflow and property damages, according to the staff report. In 2022, the Public Works Department saw four instances of this and anticipate more as the technology becomes more viable. For the ordinance amendment, pipe lining will be included in the definition of house sewer connection maintenance.

According to the staff report, current wastewater municipal code is not specific on sewer easements and fails to provide general provisions on how to manage relocating easements. The draft code is intended to address this issue by including language that relocating easements will conform with good practices.

At a previous meeting the commission said they did not support permitting private lateral cleaning and requiring CCTV inspection of private laterals for remodeled and new construction projects. The commission at first did not support allowing groundwater discharges to the sewer system but eased their concerns because the dewatering issues in residential properties will be included in the ordinance.

The commission previously expressed issues permitting lateral cleaning because there is no inherent issue resulting from sewer lateral cleaning, and private lateral blockages will impact the owner and will not have an impact on other private properties. The commision also said that permitting will further delay mitigation measures in removing blockages from private properties, and be an unnecessary permit cost.

The ordinance will also include language to allow groundwater to be discharged to the sewer system.

The aforementioned items are intended to further protect the environment and public health while having policies to reduce sewer overflows and reduce property damage.

A draft ordinance will be presented to the Public Works Commission in the Spring.

Planning Commission Expected to Adopt Draft Fractional Ownership Ordinance

At their Thursday meeting the Planning Commission is expected to discuss and possibly approve resolution that would recommend the adoption of a draft ordinance to the City Council to prohibit fractional ownership of properties.

The Commission previously reviewed the draft ordinance, which included regulations that are substantially the same as those that have been in effect under the current interim ordinance. City staff has since revised the draft ordinance to incorporate the feedback.

The Commission previously expressed that the draft ordinance did not provide an opportunity for those who wished to receive a determination by the Council regarding whether their fractional ownership circumstances should be subject to the City's prohibition. The only opportunity was for those who were already subject to a Community Preservation action. Additionally, the Commission expressed a desire to change the requirements for the

Council's review of the fractional ownership subject to a Community Preservation action, and make them more specific to the situation.

The Commission directed staff to revise the ordinance to address these concerns.

According to the staff report, city staff is not aware of any activity that would be considered a fractional ownership structure prohibited by these regulations. There has also been no complaints or citations that may require review before the Council for an exemption from these regulations. Thus, city staff believe the current process is working to address the potential issues.

Fractional ownership is when shares of ownership rights are sold to multiple buyers. This allows each buyer an ownership interest and right to use the property for a certain period of time.

This operates similarly to a timeshare, although it conveys actual ownership rights instead of a narrow right for use of the property for a certain time period, and also divides a property into fewer fractions

On July 15, 2021, the City Council adopted an interim ordinance to prohibit the fractional ownership of residential and commercial properties in the city as it was believed this would detract from the sense of community in some neighborhoods and have a negative impact on the existing housing crisis. The Council also discussed this topic in relation to a proposed development project.

The One Beverly Hills project was ap-

proved in 2021 and includes a fractional ownership component.

The City Council extended the ordinance, with an expiration date of July 14. City staff has drafted an ordinance with permanent regulations to replace those in the interim ordinance, with the intent that the permanent regulations would become effective before July 14 when the interim ordinance expires.

The Planning Commission is expected to conduct the public hearing, discuss the draft ordinance, and possibly adopt a resolution recommending approval of the ordinance to the City Council.

coverstory **CATCHING UP WITH ZEV**

Former County Supervisor Zev Yaroslavsky on Los Angeles Politics and His New Memoir

You have been out of office just over eight years now. What have you been up to?

The chancellor at UCLA invited me to come teach and I've been doing that for the last eight years. I teach two courses [at the Luskin Center], one in post World War II LA history, and a graduate public policy course about how today's Los Angeles leaders and institutions make it work. I also oversee a project called the 'Los Angeles Initiative,' where we do an annual countywide Quality of Life survey, which has become a staple of public opinion research about LA. I've been at UCLA for almost eight years now. I have

enjoyed it immensely, helping students, especially in the public policy realm to help guide them in their public service aspirations and avoid making some of the mistakes that I made when I was getting into public policy. So, it's been very reward-


You retired from the Board of Supervisors in 2014. The Third District recently elected West Hollywood Councilmember Lindsey Horvath. What issues are different today from when you served on the Board?

The truth is that the more things change, the more they stay the same. If you read the memoir of John Anson Ford, who was a supervisor in the third district between 1934 and 1958, the issues are very similar, juvenile justice, crime, poverty, immigration. It was on a different scale but the issues don't change that much. Homelessness is a much more acute issue today than it was 45 years ago when I got into office, and 25 years ago, when I got into the Board of Supervisors. The economic divide is much more acute. The shrinking middle class, the growing economic underclass, and this enormous concentration of wealth in a handful of people is much more pronounced today. The challenges are greater. Over the course of my career, we had Proposition 13, which changed the whole nature of local government finance, in some cases for the better, in some cases for the worse. But it changed

the way local government was funded. It made it more difficult to make robust investment in social welfare problems that we have in our society. Public safety remains an issue, always was. We actually had a reduction in crime during the early part of this century. In the latter part of the 1990s, in public opinion surveys, crime actually went down as a priority. Traffic went down as a priority. But the thing that people are most concerned about, based on our surveys that I do at UCLA Luskin Center [Public Policy School] is cost of living.

Affordable housing is the single biggest crisis we face. It is much more acute

> than it's ever been before, maybe with the exception in the immediate aftermath of World War II. But affordable housing remains the number one public policy issue in our society, especially in Southern California. The way we deal with it has to be dealt with intelligently. You have this economic divide, it's a two sided equation. You have escalating real estate values and escalating rent costs. On the other hand, salaries and wages are not going

keeps people up at night.

I don't like to rub people's noses in it, but I will. "I told you so." I told it to the Board of Education members, and I told it to the City Council. They spent, I don't

know how much it was, \$25 million last time I checked, filing lawsuits. I think there ought to be an investigation into why they spent that kind of money. Who were the lawyers? Who were the law firms that got it? They were being paid exorbitant fees for a losing case and everybody knew it would be a losing case. The City figured it out after a while, but the school district couldn't admit failure. Every time they tried to get a decision, the decision went against them. They lost the state court from day one and ultimately in the federal court because the lawsuit had no merit. What the people of Beverly Hills ought to know is that I negotiated with the [former] president of the school board, Jake Manaster. We were prepared to spend the money just to give the Beverly Hills School Board some victory. We were prepared to move the line from under the main school building so it would be under the tennis courts. It would have cost us several million dollars more, but it would have

saved the taxpayers of Beverly Hills a fortune. [Manaster] couldn't get three votes. He was the only one willing to even consider it. Not

only did they lose the lawsuit, but [as a last offer,] the MTA offered them \$1 million, and the court gave them \$800,000. They didn't even take what the MTA was offering. Their heads were stuck in the sand. I think it was a fatal error. Most of them, if not all of them, are no longer in public office, which is a good thing. They didn't even know when the tunneling was going on because the courts never stopped the project. They just asked them to tweak the environmental report. They didn't even know that they were tunneling under the school because it was 80 feet underground. That was the whole stupidity of it.

I'm looking forward to the subway coming to Westwood. Westwood is a huge employment center. I think UCLA is the fourth largest employer in the county. The ability for people to get there on public transportation, which will be faster and cheaper than using their car, is going to be a huge amenity and it's something that [former LA Mayor] Tom Bradley dreamed of in 1993. [Former LA Mayor Antonio Villaraigosa] talked about 'the subway to the sea' when he was elected. As long as I remember, I've been praying, hoping, and working towards bringing public transportation to the west side.

Now, a lot has changed because of the pandemic. Metro has to deal with the crime and public safety issues on the trains. It's not complicated, but they have to deal with it. They can't be timid about dealing with public safety or the trains will be empty.

As we approach the Olympics in 2028, you look back at what the Olympics were in 1984. We didn't have a single rail line then. Every facility that's going to be used for the Olympics except for the Coliseum, was not in existence in 1984. Since 1990 we have built this incredible mass transit network, which was long overdue. Unlike New York, Paris, London, or Hong Kong, where it's a vertical city, to reach a million people in LA, you have to go miles and miles, in New York, vou have to go a few blocks. So, it's going to be a while before you have a complete transit system that serves all parts of the region. But every time we build a new line, it's a whole that is bigger than the sum of its parts. When we built the Expo Line, it not only connected Santa Monica to Culver City, it connected you to Long Beach, the San Fernando Valley, and Pasadena. So, every time we build a line, it grows the system exponentially.

Your daughter-in-law Katy Young Yaroslavsky was recently elected to the LA City Council Council District 5. What was that experience like?

I don't want to go through that again. Being a relative of somebody who's in politics or in a contest of some sort, is

more difficult than it is if you're a contestant because there's nothing you can do. But she turned out to be a really good can-

didate. I was so excit-

because she was my daughter-in-law, but because she is smart. She's competitive in a good way. She's a policy wonk, she's not a politician. Those qualities will come in handy. It was hard to see \$2 million spent to try to destroy her character. Fortunately, in the west side, at least in the city as a whole, if you look at the race for mayor, people saw through it and she won quite convincingly. More importantly, I'm really happy with the way she's handled her first hundred days. Poor Katy with the floods, landslides, and shootings in Pico-Robertson, it's a welcome to the City Council.' We had a shooting when I was a councilman in the early eighties, four people were killed by gang members. Two gang members who were involved in a gang initiation shot four random people and killed them. It shook the community's confidence. She handled this and she didn't ask me for any advice, which is just fine. She's all over the issues and I'm really pleased to see that. She believes her first priority is the constituents, the people who elected her, and even the people who didn't vote for her. So, I'm very excited for her. But the experience was very difficult. It's a tough job and it's a lot tougher than it was when I got elected.

What is one thing in Los Angeles politics that has changed significantly since you first ran 1975?

I think the biggest change in terms of politics as a science, is the change of the elections from odd-numbered years to even-number years. In even-numbered years, either the governor is up for election or the president's up for election. In an odd-numbered year where a mayor is not running, the turnout is very anemic.

It was about a 40% turnout in November, maybe a little more. In 2017, which was the last time there was a mayor's race before 2022, the turnout was around 15%. So, that almost tripled the turnout and changed the demographic of the electorate. You have more renters and more young people. We also have mailin ballots. It democratized the election process far more than it was. It creates more access and more people participate. Who are the people who make up the difference between what it was in 2017 and what it was in 2022? It's working people, it's poor people, it's people of color, it's renters. So, their voices are now more on par with their percentage of the population than they ever were. That's a good thing for democracy. Some people might think, 'well, we don't want that.' You know the more progressive electorate will be there because it'll be more progressive policies. But, if we have a democracy, everybody should be at the table, everybody should have access to the franchise, and that's a huge change.

Other than that, the City is different. The City is far more diverse than it was when I first started. It was nothing like it is now. We've had a huge influx of growth in the Latino population and one that is oftentimes not given enough attention is the growth in the Asian Pacific Islander population. There are probably more Koreans in Southern California than there are anywhere else in the world except for Korea. Same with Armenians and Israelis. [Los Angeles] is a world class city. It's an international city, it's very diverse. I do believe that diversity is our strength, and the economic divide is our weakness.

Tell us about your new memoir, which will be released soon.

I'm a historian by training, not by profession. I got my Master's in history at UCLA. I read a lot of history and I believe that people ought to write their memoirs, especially people who've been in consequential walks of life. I wanted to write a memoir, but I didn't want it to be a vanity project. I take some really

hard shots at mistakes that I made. It's a political memoir nested in the history of the same period in which I served. So, it's kind of a history of LA as much as it is my own political career. It's [written in] three parts. The first third of the book is about my ancestors, my upbringing, my social action work, and then my activity in Soviet Jewry, which was a big part of my life. The second third is about my city government days. The third part is about my county days. It tells my story and it tells my story simultaneously with the story of LA during that period of time.

The essence is to describe how to govern in the seemingly ungovernable, Balkanized governance structure of Southern California. How we overcame the fiscal upheaval of Proposition 13; how we built a new and expanding transit system in a county with 88 cities; how we partnered with the Clinton Administration to avert a county bankruptcy in 1995; how we sought to deal with the ever-challenging issue of constitutional policing, land-use, the 1984 Olympics, and much more. My

book takes you behind the scenes and into the rooms where this all happened.

One of my disappointments is that not enough public officials who have been consequential in their jurisdictions ever wrote a memoir. [Former Mayors] Tom Bradley, Fletcher Bowron, and [Former Supervisor] Kenny Hahn never wrote a memoir. [Former LA Councilmember] Roz Wyman, despite me begging her to write a memoir, never did. Those are people who were consequential to this region in very profound ways and if you don't write it, somebody else will. This is my effort to contribute to the historical literature of the period. It's dedicated to my late wife [Barbara Yaroslavsky] who I wish could be here to be a part of this. She was a part of it in so many ways and continues to be even in her absence. I'm very excited about it. It should come out later this spring.


