"City Council Public Comment Guidelines"

At the end of Tuesday's City Council meeting, Mayor Lester Friedman proposed new Non-Agendized Public Comment guidelines for Beverly Hills City Council meetings. The rest of the Council concurred.

Non-Agendized Public Comment is usually known as Public Comment delivered by residents at the beginning of the "Regular Meeting of the City of Beverly Hills City Council." In the past, speakers would be provided three minutes.

During the last City Council term, then-Mayor Julian Gold truncated the three minutes historically provided to Beverly Hills residents to as little as a minute. He claimed he had the concurrence of the rest of the City Council. It was never formally proposed, much less approved, during a City Council meeting.

If there is a "full agenda," there will be two sessions of Non-Agendized Public Comment:

• Session 1: 30 minutes will be set aside at the beginning of the meeting for a total of 15 people.

• Session 2: There will be an unlimited time before "City Councilmember and Committee Reports and Comments" at the end of the meeting

Mayor Friedman proposed the bifurcated system because he believes it is unfair for those who wish to provide Public Comment on Agendized Items to have to wait.

Tuesday, for example, Mayor Friedman indicated there were 30 public speakers, all but a few speaking about Dupont Clinic. Since it was not a "full agenda" (where there were no public hearings Tuesday), he provided three minutes to each.

It is unclear as to what constitutes a "full agenda."

It is also unclear if the public would also be restricted during the second session to two minutes

City Council Reschedules Hearing For Builder's Remedy Appeal

The City Council rescheduled a public hearing that would have considered an appeal for an application to construct a new 19-story residential and commercial mixed use building at the property located at 125-129 South Linden Drive, at its Tuesday meeting.

The project has been postponed at least several times since the original hearing date was set. The new hearing is expected to take place on June 27.

City staff previously determined the application was incomplete. Since the last hearing date, city staff has received additional comment letters in opposition of the project, which includes concerns citing the potential to increase traffic on Linden and Wilshire, a lack of parking, as well as height limits.

The proposal currently exceeds zoning limits on density and height but the applicant believes the project "maintains vested rights pursuant to the Housing Crisis Act" and that the "Builder's Remedy provision of the Housing Accountability Act applies to the project."



Beverly Vista Middle School Class of 2024

On May 30 Beverly Vista Middle School students will take part in their eighth grade promotion ceremony.

The commercial portion of the proposed project consists of a 73-room hotel located on the first through fifth floors of the building. The residential portion consists of 165 apartment dwelling units, ranging from studio to two-bedroom units, located on the sixth through the 19th floors of the building. Of the 165 dwelling units proposed, 33 of the units are proposed to be reserved for lower income households.

Parking for the project is proposed within a four-level subterranean parking structure that would be accessed from an alley, providing parking for 126 vehicles.

The "Builder's Remedy" relies on the provisions of the Housing Accountability Act, by providing at least 20 percent of the total units in the development to lower income households.

The project is backed by developer Leo Pustilnikov and Ottinger Architects is currently designing the complex.

If completed, the building would stand among one of the tallest in the city.

Hamilton Drive LLC and SDLP Hold-

ings LLC have submitted a preliminary application on April 26 for an eight-story, 99-unit multi-family residential building located at 214-216 South Hamilton Drive, according to the current development project list. These entities are also owned by Pustilnikov.

The project on Hamilton Drive would be in close proximity to the Metro D Line extension if it is completed.

City Council Appoints Standby Officers

The City Council approved an updated list of individuals listed as Standby Officers, at its Tuesday meeting. This is intended to ensure the continuation of government operations in the event of an emergency or disaster.

The succession plan includes three individuals to temporarily succeed councilmembers if they become unavailable due to one of these events.

Councilmember Craig Corman appointed Karen Corman, Noah Furie, and Lori Greene Gordon.

County Investigating Hepatitis A Case At Beverly Hills Whole Foods

The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health is investigating a report of a hepatitis A virus infection in an employee of Whole Foods in Beverly Hills.

Hepatitis A is a highly contagious liver infection that usually spreads when a person unknowingly ingests the virus from objects, food, or drinks contaminated by small, undetected amounts of stool from an infected person.

Los Angeles officials said last week that hepatitis A is spreading among the city's homeless population.

No additional cases have been identified at this time. The investigation is ongoing.

City Council Re-Appoints Commissioners

The City Council reappointed Architectural Commission Rebecca Pynoos, Planning Commissioners Jeff Wolfe and Terri Kaplan, Traffic and Parking Commissioner Hadar Geller, and Arts and Culture Commissioner Pamela Beck for a second term of four years from July 1 - June 30, 2028, at its Tuesday meeting.

The City Council also extended the commission terms for Cultural Heritage Commissioner Jill Tavelman Collins and Charitable Solicitations Commissioner Ira Friedman.

Collins' term will conclude on June 30. However, she will now complete former commissioner Craig Corman's term which was scheduled to conclude in Dec.

"This will allow for a continuity of the commission with an experienced member of the group. The commission as it stands now, is scheduled to have four new commissioners within a very short period of time," according to a city staff report.

Currently, there are enough applications to move forward with interviews and a new person is expected to be appointed to fill Collins' vacancy starting July, as well as another person to fill Corman's seat starting Jan. 1, 2025. A third person may also be appointed to fill Commissioner Kimberly Vinokur's upcoming vacancy, which would begin on July 1, 2025.

The term for Friedman is scheduled to conclude on June 30, however, there has been very little response in recruitment efforts and interviews cannot take place without a minimum of three applicants for one position.

The Commission Standardization Committee is currently reviewing various commissions and their roles. Friedman's position will be extended until the position is either filled or a determination regarding the future of this commission has been made.

Additionally, in a separate consent calendar item, the City

City Announces Spring Art Show Winners

Over 230 artists participated in the 51st spring Beverly Hills Art Show this past weekend exhibiting art in eleven categories: ceramics, digital art, drawing and printmaking, glass, jewelry, mixed media 2D, mixed media 3D, painting, photography, sculpture and watercolor. First, second and third place awards were presented in each category, and five specialty awards were presented, including the Mayor's Purchase Award, which was established to affirm the city's support of the arts and its commitment to offering public art for everyone to enjoy. Mayor Les Friedman selected glass artist Larry Sterling's piece, named Our Colorful Country, which will be installed in the Beverly Hills Public Library.

Council approved a one-time waiver to be granted to applicants so that they may apply to multiple commission openings for this cycle, as the City Clerk's Office has received a limited number of applications from qualified residents. With the exception of the Rent Stabilization Commission, which is on hold and may be disbanded, the department will continue to recruit for open positions, with a new deadline of Friday, June 14.

City Council Extends Temporary Closure of North Cañon Drive

The City Council approved the temporary closure of North Cañon Drive for an additional six months, at its Tuesday meeting.

On July 24, 2018, the City Council approved the initial closure of North DONATE YOUR UNWANTED CAR.

Cañon Drive in an effort to mitigate the impacts from the construction of the Metro Purple Line Extension project. A cul-de-sac was created in

Sept. 2019 after the street

was closed, followed by the construction of the temporary sound wall at Wilshire Boulevard. The City Council approved a mural designed by Tomokazu Matsuyama, which was completed in Nov. of that year.

"The 20-foot-high sound wall has successfully mitigated the noise, dust, and traffic control disruption impacts of these major construction activities. The closure has also provided a consistent traffic pattern and uninterrupted access for businesses located on North Cañon Drive," according to a city staff report.

Had the council denied the extension, traffic patterns at North Cañon Drive and Wilshire Boulevard would have required daily changes

with closures and turn restrictions.

City staff has received support and no objection to the extension until Dec. 2024 from the residential and business communities.

City Sends Opposition Letter for SB 1037

The City Council ratified an action taken by City Manager Nancy Hunt-Coffey regarding a letter of opposition for Senate Bill 1037 (Scott Wiener, D-San Francisco), at the direction of Mayor Les Friedman, at its Tuesday meeting.

What to Do About the Commissions?

Our City Council functions best when it has thoughtful input from different sources. Otherwise, decisions can be the result of information from a small bubble consisting of staff and a few loud voices. To a large extent, that is the case today. I suggest that there are two things that could be done that would improve things greatly. The first is for our city commissions to play their prescribed and intended role as the advisors to the Council. The second is to encourage the formation of truly representative and engaged neighborhood associations.

OK, call me "pollyanna" but hear me out.

<u>City Commissions</u>

I have for a number of years observed the operations of most of our city commissions. My conclusion is that we are not using our commissions to their fullest advantage. I have written about the Planning Commission previously and it is not the subject of this column.

As for the other commissions, they are largely a lost opportunity. Notably, service on our commissions is apparently not as attractive as it once was. There are currently vacancies on several commissions and terms of sitting commissioners are being extended because of a lack of applicants to replace them as their terms expire.

Let's first look at why we have commissions.

They can provide expertise and advice to the City Council; facilitate and broaden public participation; and they are a vehicle for in depth analysis of issues.

There are three principles that have been enacted by the Council to effect fulfillment of these purposes.

Currently, when a court finds a city in violation of housing law, penalties can only be imposed 60 days after a court has ordered compliance.

According to Weiner, local governments have no real incentive to follow the law, as he claims they can wait for the state to sue them and then lose in court to then remedy their violation to avoid penalties.

Should this bill become law, the city could potentially face fines in the future if a certified housing element is not in place by established deadlines or for violating unspecified state housing laws that require ministerial approval of certain housing projects. As a result, the commissions do not fulfill their proper role. Members of the commissions often are frustrated and become disaffected so neither the purpose of generating knowledgeable advice nor the purpose of creating a feeling of engagement is accomplished.

I have two suggestions for improvement.

First, the commission chairs should be more aggressive in providing input for their meeting agendas to ensure time for meaningful discussion and to permit discussion of advice and direction, not only discussion. In short, put their big boy or big girl pants on and insist on taking an appropriate level of control.

Second, at the initiative of either a commission or the Council, commissions should provide advice in the form of written reports on appropriate subjects or issues to the Council. Solely by way of example, the Public Works Commission could provide a report regarding the status of the Cabrillo "reservoir"; the Traffic & Parking Commission could provide a report on the "permit parking" program.

These reports could be drafted by an ad hoc committee of commissioners, not staff, and then submitted to the full commission for discussion and approval before submission to the Council.

At present, too few residents are applying for open Commission positions.

I suspect that changing the operations in practice of the commissions to make service more meaningful will attract more applicants.

What do you think?

Neighborhood "Associations"

I have often felt that one of the things that has been missing from discussions of significant projects is meaningful and accurate input of a true sense of the residents of various neighborhoods over things that affect the neighborhood directly.

From time to time, issues arise that

stimulate somewhat uniform comment from a substantial number of concerned residents. But what we do not have are truly representative associations that study issues of special concern to the group. We do not have neighborhood associations that have substantial memberships, perhaps charging nominal dues, that elect a leadership and then formulate positions that represent a true consensus.

Instead, what we have is self-appointed individuals or small groups who purport, without any principled basis, to speak for a large number of residents. Often, these self-appointed "leaders" come to Commission or City Council meetings and ask for substantial additional time to make their views known. Generally, these requests are denied in part because there is no way to determine that these individuals speak for anyone other than themselves.

Notably our councilmembers are elected at large, not by districts. This is entirely appropriate for a small city that does not have diverse groups where a small majority could control or diminish the impact of distinct minorities. Our current councilmembers are from the "Flats", the Hillside and the Southeast so not every area is covered.

There are times when the special concerns and knowledge of residents of a particular neighborhood would be valuable input into Commission's or Council's decisions.

It seems to me that there is a better way than to have nothing more than the voices of self-appointed individuals whose "association" meetings occur in front of their own bathroom mirrors..

That is, that residents of various areas of the City, from Trousdale to the Southwest get together and create truly representative associations that can form and communicate a consensus on behalf of the residents of their area.

If the Commissions would play their intended roles and if we had truly representative neighborhood associations, we would have a better informed Council. And that would be a good thing.


