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

When he was a Planning Commissioner I had little respect for Peter Ostroff because he, being educated only as a trial lawyer practicing until his retirement, had no expertise or experience in matters of planning. In his conversations and actions, he constantly showed extreme prejudices against the spirit of the General Plan as evidenced by his March 21 article on which I previously commented he stated without evidence "not many residents appear to support the mindless "no" on anything in excess of 45 feet" on which I commented on previously.

In another example in the same article, he exhibits more of his blatant ignorance by stating "Perhaps it would be a good idea to install gates to limit entry onto the busses". What does this even mean, where would the gates go? If they were on the bus, the drivers would have to take on the additional responsibility of being security guards for which none of them are qualified or so inclined making it an even slower mode of transportation than it is now because of additional distractions and time-consuming interactions.

From this article, I deduce that he knows very little about this complex issue but as when he was a Planning Commissioner he does not hesitate to pontificate.

Board Approves El Rodeo Construction Plaque

The Board of Education approved a El Rodeo Elementary school modernization plaque option, at its Tuesday meeting.

The plaque will consist of all board members who contributed to the proj-

The following former and current board members include: Myra Demeter, Steven Fenton, Brian Goldberg, Howard Goldstein, Isabel Hacker, Gabriel Halimi, Lewis Hall, Lisa Korbatov, Myra Lurie, Jake Manaster, Judith Manoucheri, Rachelle Marcus, Nooshin Meshkaty, Mel Spitz, Mandy Stern, Tristen Walker-Shuman, and Mary

Stern, Marcus, Manoucheri, Margo, and Wells will be included under the Board of Education portion, while the rest of the names will be placed under those who contributed to Measure E and BH as past board members.

The names of district and school administration will include Superintendent Michael Bregy, Executive Director Will Karrat, Assistant Superintendent Raphael Guzman, Principal Sarah Kaber, and Assistant Principals Kevin Painter and Christine Kim.

HMC Architects, Prowest Constructors, and Fonder-Salari Inc. will also be listed under the construction portion. However, TCDS, the former bond manager, will not be listed on the plaque.

The board previously approved a different plaque option at its June 4 meeting that only included the following past board members: Wells, Goldberg, Goldstein, Hacker, Hall, Korbatov, Manaster, and Spitz.

Margo requested that the board look into including all board members who contributed to the project, as a small appreciation of gratitude. Stern agreed with this sentiment.

"I don't see a risk of over sharing, as I do with under-recognition," Stern said.

Marcus said she was concerned that the board is being asked to revise the plaque, as she believed the discussion took time away from other matters. However, she added that she did not have a problem with including more

Margo recommended that a new policy be created for future plaques, which the board agreed to.

Manouchehri was concerned with

more names being added to the plaque because she said it would take longer, and that it's her personal perspective that "the longer it goes on, the worse it is" because it means the board is "not finishing our projects in an expeditious way."

Manouchehri also pointed out that some names on the plaque were not on the other plaque for B1/B2. She claimed she would not name names because she was not "singling anyone out because for [her], it is not an individual thing" but she requested that Bregy fact check who was actually on past boards, as she implied several times that she was uncertain who had served since the passage of the ballot measures.

"I ask questions because I want to make sure where I am getting to is 'the truth'. I have no issue with these individual people, I would just like to verify what you are trying to do is include all board members," Manouchehri said. "I don't have an issue with this, I just would like to verify these folks.

Margo and Bregy both confirmed several times that all board members listed had a part in the process. However, prior to board approval, Manouchehri emphasized again that Bregy should make sure the board members on the plaque actually had a part in the construction projects.

City Council Mulls Overview of Rent Stabilization Commission

The City Council discussed the overview of the Rent Stabilization Commission and decided to sunset the commission, as well as make some changes to the process regarding how certain disputes are standardized, at its Tuesday Study Session.

In 2019, the City Council adopted an ordinance establishing the Rent Stabilization Commission, which was composed of an equal number of tenants, landlords, and at-large residents, to act as an advisory body regarding matters related to the Rent Stabilization Ordinance. It's also the only commission that consists of six members.

The City Council charged the Rent Stabilization Commission with discussing the following topics related to the Rent Stabilization Ordinance:

- Modification to the Major Remodel eviction category.
- Regulations regarding the Cash for Keys process.
- Evaluation of relocation fee amounts where tenants are evicted for any No Fault reason.
- Review of habitability standards and the implementation of a proactive inspection program.
- Review of allowable pass-through surcharges for.
- Review of the Landlord Tenant Handbook.

The Rent Stabilization Commission does not currently have specific matters to discuss. The commission will also have a lack of quorum by July. Five

vacancies are currently open, however, recruitments were placed on hold.

The City Council was in favor of disbanding the commission. Mayor Les Friedman also suggested that there should still be a forum where tenant and landlord disputes are heard. Subsequently, this process may go back to the Human Relations Commission.

City Council Approves CVB Work Plan and **Funding**

The City Council approved the annual work plan and funding request for the Beverly Hills Conference and Visitors Bureau's (CVB), in the amount of \$4.9 million, as well as a carry over of \$250,00 in unused funding, for the next fiscal year.

The CVB conducts a variety of mar-

keting and tourism programs promoting the city. They receive funding to promote Beverly Hills worldwide as a destination through programs and events that are intended to drive consumer revenue.

Of the remaining funds, \$150,000 was intended for two domestic events in Miami and Dallas, and would instead be put towards \$75,000 for a February 2025

Miami event to coincide with the Chamber's Miami Business Mission; and \$75,000 towards International Marketing for social media and traditional media, according

"Although some believe this type of sign can help create a pedestrian-oriented, quaint neighborhood feeling in commercial districts and act as a valuable resource for businesses, others believe this can create visual clutter and blight. While portable signage can provide necessary business information, especially for advertising time-sensitive information, these signs can also present a potential conflict for the use of the public right-of-way, amongst other concerns," according to a city staff report.

There are certain types of signs for which a permit may be issued over the counter, however, if a sign does not comply with certain requirements, the applicant would need to apply for a sign accommodation from the Architectural Commission, according to a city staff

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

Builder's Remedy Explained

Imagine yourself in a year or two walking down one of your neighborhood streets with a friend and looking up to see a new 25 story building looming over

You ask your friend: "What on earth is that?" How was that built in Beverly Hills?"

Your friend gives you a two word answer: "Builder's Remedy."

The friend continued: "This all happened because we weren't paying attention when something might have been done.!"

This scenario is more realistic than you might think. And if you want to see what it could look like you need to do no more than drive on Lindbrook Drive in Westwood from Hilgard to Beverly Glen. Wall to wall high rises loom over beautiful elegant single family residences.

I confess that this is a bit of a wonky policy column. Some say that I should concentrate more on less serious subjects such as the one about my journey from Malibu to Beverly Hills and not so much on "policy issues." My view is that a bit of both is good and that the Builder's Remedy subject is one that you should know about. Let me know what you think. You can reach me at petero@ ostroff.la.

So let's look at three Builder's Remedy questions:

What is happening? Why? and

What can we do about it?

What is happening?

Applications have been filed for more than twenty so-called "Builder's Remedy" projects (explained below) that exceed by a large margin our City's height and other restrictions.

tions themselves of some of the proposed "Builder's Remedy" projects currentgoing through the planning process: These

are in addition to the numerous State Density Bonus mean that "affordable" rent can be no more than one third to one half of "market" rent in Beverly Hills. And few, if any, City employees, police or firefighters would qualify because their incomes are too high to be considered "low income" or even "moderate income."

So, developers contend that from 2021 until May 1, 2024 when the state certified the City's Revised Housing Element, the City did not have a compliant Housing Element. Therefore, applications for projects submitted before May must be approved/ cannot be denied even if they ignored City's restrictions on height, zoning, etc.

In theory, taken to an extreme, this would mean that a Housing Developer

could acquire a few contiguous lots in the "700 Block" in the flats and propose a 100 story builder's remedy project (so long as 20% of the units were "affordable" to low income persons). Hello, Sierra Towers!

Preliminary applications for all of the projects listed above were submitted during the window from 2021 until May 1, 2024. Assuming that formal entitlement applications are submitted within 180 days of the Preliminary Application, developers contend that their rights are vested in that their projects are subject only to the "ordinances, policies and standards adopted in effect" and that includes the fact that there is no legally compliant Housing Element and the Builder's Remedy is available even if the Housing Element subsequently becomes certified.specified.

There are numerous sections of the HAA that would appear to support this contention.

For example, the HAA provides:

"The Legislature's intent in enacting this section is ... to significantly increase the approval and construction of new housing for all economic segments of California's communities by meaningfully and effectively curbing the capability of local governments to deny, reduce the density for, or render infeasible housing development projects and emergency shelters. That intent has not been fulfilled." (My emphasis)

In short, the legislature's expressed intent was to get local governments out of the way of housing development.

Further, while the HAA allows cities to deny projects if they identify specific adverse impacts on public health and safety, this latitude is ostensibly curtailed by the following:

"It is the policy of the state that **this** section be interpreted and implemented in a manner to afford the fullest possible weight to the interest of, and the approval and provision of, housing." (Again, my emphasis)

It is reasonable to ask why it took the City over two years to adopt a certified Housing Element which left open a window of many months for developers to apply for approvals of projects that did not meet our zoning requirements. In short, there are several reasons and no heroes (except for the excellent planning staff members including Masa Alkire, Chloe Chen, Cindy Gordon and others who were tasked with obtaining and spent thousands of hours in unchartered territory to obtain certification)

But there is no virtue in crying over "spilt milk."

Further, there are people who believe that the State of California wants to punish and make an example of Beverly Hills as an enclave for the wealthy or for other reasons. I have no reason to believe that this is true. The City of Palo Alto is also an affluent community and has yet to have its Revised Housing Element certified by the state despite several tries. Thus, Builder's Remedy is ostensibly available in Palo Alto. Accordingly,

there are numerous large Builder's Remedy projects that have been submitted to the Palo Alto planning department including two seven-story projects proposing 380 apartments and 335 apartments respectively and another which proposes 189 residences and 137 hotel rooms. All involve substantially more units than any proposed for the City.

The rules are not "rigged" against us as far as I can tell.

What Can the City Do Now to Avoid the Scenario Described Above?

There are both political and legal strategies that may be productively employed.

Politically, it is important for our residents to study carefully projects in their neighborhoods (all plans are public record and available for inspection by anyone on request) and communicate early and often, in writing and orally, to the Planning Department, the Planning Commission and the City Council the specific impacts that are presented by proposed projects.

No one is in a better position to assess a project than those whose residences are closest to it.

Importantly, the state legislature has been considering a number of potential amendments and clarifications which reflects a level of discomfort with a number of provisions of the HAA that are much too generous or vague or ambiguous or both. We cannot predict whether any will become law or, if they do, whether they will have any retroactive effect on previously proposed projects.

A good example of resident action is the reaction to the 8840 Burton Way project. This was the site of the two story Temple Emanuel education building. The developer who purchased the site now proposes a 20 story/200 residential unit structure that will dwarf the two, three and four story multifamily buildings that surround it. Residents of the IV Seasons project immediately south of the proposed building under the leadership of Renee Strauss have commenced communicating their views now to the planning staff well in advance of any formal entitlement hearings before the Planning Commission or the City Council.

Legally, it is important to understand that the bases for the developers' contentions described above or any interpretations by state or local entities have NOT been tested in any California appellate court. There are at least three trial court decisions. For the most part these have resolved the issues presented in favor of the applicants. These decisions, however, are not binding on anyone other than the parties to those cases.

It is possible that some of the applicants have made intentionally overly aggressive proposals to give them bargaining leverage to negotiate very substantial entitlements. We should not, however, assume that is the case or make undue compromises.

Open legal questions that have not been resolved at the appellate level are numerous

The following are simply examples of open legal questions.

Can a certification by the state of the City's Housing Element after filing of a preliminary application or even after the submission of an application for entitlements before entitlements have been granted eliminate the "builder's remedy"?

Did the window for potential builder's remedy projects close on May 1, 2024 when the state certified the City's Housing Element or on March 22, when the City Council adopted the Housing element that the state certified a few weeks later? If the latter, several of the projects listed above may not be eligible for builder's remedy status.

The HAA specifically provides that the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) remain applicable. To what extent can the City deny or require material alterations of an applica-

tion for environmental reasons?

The HAA allows cities to require developments to comply with objective, quantifiable, written development standards, conditions and policies..." Under what circumstances may a city deny an application based on written development standards, conditions or policies (whatever that means)?

To what extent will a court determine that a city's housing element is in substantial compliance that the state has refused to certify?

Are there any limitations on the size of a "builder's remedy" project? More specifically, must the City approve a residential project that is fifty stories tall on the corner of Wilshire and Beverly Drive that includes 20% of its units that are "affordable"

Are there provisions of the HAA that are in conflict with the provisions of the federal or state constitution?

We should assume that our City Council will ensure that these questions and more will be analyzed, evaluated and employed by the most sophisticated counsel available to protect our special city.

For example, Rodeo Drive might not be an appropriate location, which the Architectural Commission agreed.

Business owners have provided input and stressed the importance of using these signs for their businesses.

The city may create a pilot program to test a period in which these signs are allowed, and to allow tracking of the total number of these signs that are used by businesses.

The city is expected to form an ad hoc committee with the Planning Commission and the Architectural Commission so that business owners can provide input on proposed regulations.

City Council Adopts Road Repair Projects

The City Council adopted a list of projects, which are to be funded in the next fiscal year by Senate Bill 1: The Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017, at its Tuesday meeting.

The adoption of this bill increased fuel taxes, diesel taxes and vehicle registration; these taxes are a funding source for

local roads and infrastructure projects.

The program guidelines require that eligible cities and counties submit a resolution each year that includes a project list.

The projects that will be submitted include the Copley Place Reconstruction, as well as the Burton Way Street

Improvements.

Copley Place includes the full reconstruction, including demolition of roadway, full depth excavation, installation of 8-inch Portland Cement Concrete over 8-inch aggregate base, and replacement of adjacent curb and gutter.

The Burton Way Street improvements project will include grind and asphalt concrete overlay, replace damaged curb and gutter, reconstruct ADA ramps, bikeway striping improvements, and pedestrian crossing improvements.

The city has received a total of \$4 million dollars in funding, since the program's inception.

BHPD Shines at High Sierra Motorcycle Competition

The Beverly Hills Police Department announced that Motor Officer Guzman achieved third place at the High Sierra Motorcycle Competition held in Reno, NV, from June 6 to the 8. 




