"Merging Architectural and Design Review Commissions"

I believe the Frank Lloyd Wright building on Rodeo Drive is one of Beverly Hill's greatest Architectural assets and should be treated accordingly. There would be great rage if Michelangelo's David was covered with graffiti and had a sign on a pole stuck on its head.

When I became aware of the fact that the Cultural Heritage Commission had ruled on the Frank Lloyd Wright building on Rodeo Drive I viewed the video of the proceeding.

Certain astute commissioners seemed oddly curious as to why no residents were present to speak on the subject given the significance of the building.

I would like to bring some light onto that matter, give my opinion of the results and my suggestions.

Years ago, as soon as I became aware of Battaglia vacating the building, I sent each of the members of the Architectural Commission an individual email to their city-issued email address asking them to kindly notify me when the building came up for review. I sent the same email to each of them periodically to remind them and ensure my presence.

I never received a single response from any of them, not even the sole Architect on the commission of five

I was also never made aware that it would not be coming before them but instead before the Cultural Heritage Commission

In viewing the video I felt that the Chairman of that commission had a good handle on the workings of the commission and some commissioners contributed positively concerning certain aspects of the building.

The Spire, one of the several unique features of the building, garnered much discussion. The applicant proposed turning the crowning element into a "flag pole". However, the "flag" proposed was not a flag but a rigid, fixed sign of substantial size. Not only did it bastardize the Spire but it made the entire composition unbalanced. It should have been rejected immediately but was instead approved. When the size of the "flag" was discussed one of the commissioners reached behind holding the corner of an actual draped flag and stated it was not much bigger than that flag which spread to only about one foot in diameter at the bottom, not six feet and off-center. This was certainly not an apt comparison.

Besides its inappropriateness, It is highly questionable if the spire's current structure can support the sign or can handle the wind shear of such a large, tall, heavy rigid object.

In regards to the inappropriately add-

ed extant concealment screen on the roof of the South portion, the majority of the commission acted appropriately by strongly advocating its removal despite push-back from the applicant's attorney. It was shocking, however, to hear one of the commissioners say they liked it because it helped the building compete in size with the newly enlarged buildings on either side. This comment shocked me and made me seriously question the commissioner's competency.

If one looks at the glazing on the lower floors one will notice the original silver-colored minimal glazing supports on the South side which exhibit Wright's mastery of glazing and the much larger black glazing supports on the North side. This was altered and Wright's butt-jointed corner was removed and replaced by the larger black-colored metal supports so that an awning could be installed by a tenant. The minimum that should have been required would have been to dictate the silver color be restored. This would have been simple and inexpensive but was never even suggested.

The balcony on the top floor of the North side has a glass rail that was placed for safety purposes but with a clumsy black metal frame. It should have been required that the frame be removed so that it matched the frameless glass rail on the ground floor. This was discussed briefly but inappropriately dropped.

The sculptural ornament on each floor at Wright's direction was originally painted a green color to emulate weathered copper. It was essential that color be brought back, even though the applicant did not feel it coincided with their image. With the black color currently in place and as approved by the commission, the sculptural shade and shadowing visible in the original green would not be present as shadows do not appear on black. One of the commissioners was rightfully adamant and should have pushed harder but the others did not understand its significance. Simply put, painting it black eliminates the detail and renders it completely ineffective.

One matter that should have been discussed but was not discussed at all is the diamond patterning and up-lighting in the ground floor entry. area. They should have required duplicating the original lighting and made sure the essential diamond patterning was clearly evident.

The idea that the building be occupied by one tenant utilizing the clever outdoor circulation is a fine one. The building itself is the best sign the company can use, additional signage beyond its name and logo on the building is not necessary.

Givenchy in the Frank Lloyd Wright Building on Rodeo Drive - what a calling card. That is why attention to detail is so important and why a rigid, fixed, off-center sign trying to parade as a flag, not on a flagpole but on a spire is unbelievably inappropriate. Please, at least get rid of the sign and why on earth did the commission approve it.

Is this nit-picking? No, it is not. It is giving our Architectural asset its proper due. As Mies has always said, "God is in the

Will anything be done to address the issues I raise, probably not. Should something be done, yes, at least the removal of the proposed sign on the pole that desecrates the spire and the building as a whole. It is still not too late.

The real question is how did we get to this point when we are supposed to have appropriate safeguards especially when I believe the commission did the best it knew how to do. It is because the problem is with the commission system itself which places people with no education or experience in the fields they oversee.

Californians for **Homeownership Sues City Over Linden Drive Project**

Californians for Homeownership, a nonprofit organization sponsored by the California Association of Realtors that aims to address housing issues through litigation, filed a lawsuit Monday against the city for denying an appeal to construct a new 19-story residential and commercial mixed use building at 125-129 South Linden Drive.

This is the group's second lawsuit filed against Beverly Hills, and its first regarding the "builder's remedy", which relies on the provisions of the Housing Accountability Act, by providing at least 20 percent of the total units in a development to lower income households.

The lawsuit seeks a court order approving the project.

The rejected proposal exceeds zoning limits on density and height but the applicant believed the project "maintains vested rights pursuant to the Housing Crisis Act" and that the "Builder's Remedy provision of the Housing Account-

ability Act applies to the project."

The commercial portion of the project rejected consisted of a 73room hotel located on the first through fifth floors of the building. The residential portion consisted of 165 apartment dwellunits, ranging from ing to two-bedroom units, located on

the sixth through the 19th floors of the building. Of the 165 dwelling units proposed, 33 of the units were proposed to be reserved for lower income house-

"Californians for Homeownership continues to lead the way in enforcing state housing laws in the courts," said C.A.R. President Melanie Barker. "It is

critical that cities like Beverly Hills do their part in addressing the state's housing crisis, and this new case will help ensure that they do."

The California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) also sent a letter to the city last week, urging the City Council to grant the appeal and direct staff to process the project without imposing a requirement for a general plan amendment.

"We won our last case against Beverly Hills because the city's housing plans were unreasonable and unlikely to produce affordable housing," said Matthew Gelfand, the in-house litigator for the nonprofit. "Now, a developer has come forward with a real plan to build housing, including income-restricted affordable units, and the City said, 'no.' We had no choice but to return to court to address the city's continued resistance to housing development."

According to the organization, if the court determines that Beverly Hills acted in bad faith, the court can order the project approved with no further hearing by the city.

"The City believes that the application associated with the development located at 125-129 S. Linden Drive was and is incomplete. The plaintiff is asking that this conclusion be reviewed in court, and so it will," City Attorney Larry Wiener said.

City Council Denies Appeal for 9229 Wilshire Boulevard Project

The City Council unanimously denied an appeal of the Planning Commission's approval of an eight-story mixed-use development project with ground floor commercial uses and 56 residential units at 9229 Wilshire Boulevard, at its Tuesday special meeting.

Six of the 56 residential units would be reserved for very low-income households. The project site is located on the northwest corner of Wilshire Boulevard and North Maple Drive. The commission's approval included waivers, as

The waivers include the following:

- Building Height: Increased the overall building height from 45' to 83'-11", inclusive of rooftop restrooms;
- Number of Stories: Increased the number of stories from three to eight, inclusive of rooftop restrooms; and
- Rear Setbacks: Reduced the rear building setback from 6' to 0'

As part of the Planning Commission's review, the commission evaluated whether the project met the findings for a development plan review, which they ultimately determined it did and unanimously voted to approve the project.

On Feb. 22, Aria Ahdoot filed a timely appeal of the commission's decision.

Specifically, the appeal alleges the following:

- The city incorrectly granted the waivers, which would subsequently have a negative impact on the surrounding neighborhood.
- The amenity space in the project could be converted to additional units
- The project does not qualify for a categorical exemption under the California Environmental Quality Act; and an environmental impact report (EIR) is required.

Many residents voiced their concerns regarding privacy, a lack of parking for the property, security, construction impacts, safety, zoning, and more.

The City Council was understanding of residents' concerns, but cited constraints by the state's density bonus law.

"Our office has completed a thorough review of the incident involving Mr. Edan On who allegedly assaulted another protestor," Gascón said. "We cannot establish beyond a reasonable doubt that Mr. On's conduct directly caused the victim's injury. There is no evidence to suggest that Mr. On was working in

> collaboration with any other individuals; and our investigation found no proof of conspiracy or any organized effort by Mr. On related to the incident.

> According to UCLA campus officers, on the night of Tuesday, April 30, a group of instigators came to Royce Quad and violently attacked students and other people

who were part of the pro-Palestine encamp-During ment. that incident, one individual was seen on video assaultencamping ment occupants with a wooden pole, which police say caused serious injuries to at least one victim.

Following an investigation by UCLA campus police, officers detained the suspect, who was identified as 18-yearold On, at a business in Beverly Hills in connection to that crime.

One other matter involving the UCLA demonstration has been presented to the district attorney's office and is currently under review.

"Given these factors, we believe that the appropriate course of action is to refer the matter to the Los Angeles City Attorney's Office, which will consider misdemeanor filing. This referral aligns with our commitment to applying the law fairly and ensuring that justice is served based on the available evidence," Gascón added.

City Council Approves 'Run of the Stars" Event

The City Council approved a request for a special event permit from Not Today Cancer, a nonprofit organization supporting research for cures for pediatric cancer, to hold its annual Charity 5K Run/Walk, "Run of the Stars" event on Sunday, Oct. 6.

"Not Today Cancer" was established in 2021 by Stacey Book and Jennifer Duncan who lost their 11-year-old son Mason Duncan-Book, to T-Cell Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia in 2020.

The request included a waiver of permit fees, personnel fees, posting no parking signs, and use of parking lanes along the race route.

"In 2023, NTC granted \$50,000 to a cutting-edge research study being performed at Texas Children's Hospital in conjunction with Baylor College of Medicine. The T-Cell malignancy study is developing a breakthrough immunotherapy treatment targeting leukemia and lymphoma in children and young adults," according to the staff report.

The race has grown each year and organizers hope to reach the goal of 1,000 participants and attendees for 2024.

Travels Without Charley, etc.

I have long been an admirer of President **Biden** and believe that he has done a commendable job as President. In my opinion **Donald Trump** is a despicable human being who was a terrible President and, if elected again, will likely be much worse the second time around.

Therefore, I was both saddened and, I must confess, somewhat panicked when I watched President Biden's performance last Thursday during the debate with Mr. Trump.

To put it in proper context it is important to remember that the rules of the debate were proposed by the Biden campaign and, more importantly, that President Biden had been closeted with the best and brightest of his aides for several days preparing for the debate. It is also notable that President Biden rarely appears in an unscripted environment and has fewer press conferences (the best trial by fire) than any President in recent times. Now, we have a better notion as to why that is the case.

President Biden's performance was shockingly dreadful. He appeared as though he was auditioning for the title role in a remake of "Weekend at Bernie's". And this is for four years, not a weekend. The beginning was awful and so was the middle and end. I don't care what the talking heads say, I believe my own eyes and ears. Most people will. There is a great likelihood that many who would be inclined to vote against Trump will change their minds or just stay home. Either way, with President Biden at the head of the "ticket", Trump will win and many good "down ballot" candidates, not to mention the country and the world, will lose.

It is vital that President Biden make a prompt and dignified exit from the race.

How can that happen? If he does not have sufficient self-awareness to step down, he must be told to do so. This could be done by an intervention by **Bill Clinton**, **Barack Obama**, Senator **Chuck Schumer**, Rep. **Hakeem Jeffries** and, crucially, **Jill Biden** (although she may be more of a problem than a solution). And it must be done quickly.

Who would replace him? It almost doesn't matter as whoever it might be would have a better chance to defeat Trump than President Biden in his current apparent condition. We can worry about that later. The priority is for President Biden to exit stage left and make room for someone who would have a chance to beat the felon with a black belt in prevarication, Donald Trump.

John Steinbeck starts "Travels with Charley" like this:

"When I was very young and the urge to be someplace else was on me, I was assured by mature people that maturity would cure this itch. When years described me as mature, the remedy prescribed was middle age. In middle age I was assured that greater age would calm my fever and now that I am 58 perhaps senility will do the job. Nothing has worked."

Anne and I have similar afflictions and now that I am in my 9th decade of life I must confess that I am in no hurry to cure the itch. But without "Charley" (a large poodle).

On the contrary, my haste is because my road ahead is predictably short so my guiding principle is "Do It While You Can." Anne's complementary guiding principle is "If I haven't been there, I want to go." By way of example, when we were sitting at dinner a few nites ago, she planned a trip to Cabo Verde, the Canary Islands and the Azores by way of Portugal. Why? Because we have never been there.

At the outset I must acknowledge the gratitude that I have for the resources, good health and the best possible traveling companion to continue to see the world.

Before I met Anne (on October 6, 1999), a client, a South African entrepreneur, had just opened a fabulous private game resort, Singita, on the west side of Kruger National Park in South Africa. On a visit to Los Angeles, he said: "Someday, you will meet a special woman and I would like you to come to Singita as my guest."

I mentioned this to Anne, a very special woman, and the next thing I knew we were on an airplane flying to Cape Town, a city that I had always wanted to visit.

While Cape Town has several "seven" star hotels, we picked a winner in a small but fabulous guest resort overlooking Bantry Bay between Cape Town's central business district and Camp's Bay, a beach side community. This is Ellerman House, a former residential mansion with spectacular views of the ocean and surf. Meals there were completely bespoke. Ask for anything, the chefs would pre-

pare it. We enjoyed two dinners there with South African venison that we requested, kudu and springbok..

And Singita was unbelievable. A very short trip (maybe 500 yards) outside of camp brings you in direct contact with giraffes, zebras and big cats – and that's only the start. Today, there are several branches of Singita all of which are wonderful with

rates that are out of sight but for that trip, the price was right.

That trip commenced acting on our

That trip commenced acting on our shared wanderlust. In the last nearly 25 years, we have traveled together to over 50 countries.

Steinbeck also pointed out that: "Once a journey is designed, equipped, and put in process, a new factor takes over. A trip, safari, an exploration, is an entity, different from all other journeys. It has personality, temperament, individuality, and uniqueness. A journey is a person itself; no two are alike. And all plans, safeguards, policing and coercion are fruitless...we do not take a trip; a trip takes us...The certain way to be wrong is to think you control it."

Very true. We don't know what we don't know and don't anticipate the unforeseeable.

With that important caveat, let me tell you about some recent and upcoming adventures in case you share the Do It While You Can mentality (and if you don't, I respectfully suggest, you should).

Last year, 2022-3, was a particularly busy one.

In late 2022, we went to Bhutan via Chiang Mai in Thailand.

Chiang Mai has a few nice Buddhist temples but not much else. Forgettable.

Bhutan is a small kingdom with around 800,000 people nestled between Himalayan Peaks.

We then flew to Bhutan on Bhutan's airline Druk ("Dragon" in Bhutanese) Air to Paro, site of the only international airport in Bhutan. Paro is located in a very narrow valley and the approach by air is challenging. Only Druk Air can fly in or out and fewer than 10 pilots are authorized to make the flite. Bhutan is highly dependent on tourism and promotes two themes. First, it publicizes its "Gross National Happiness Index" and bills itself as the happiest country on earth. Second, it imposes very strict architectural standards. When you are in Bhutan, you know it. Further, the country is not interested in backpackers and discourages them by charging all tourists a fee of \$100 per day simply to visit.

We spent eight days hiking at altitudes of 8,000 to 10,000 feet. The altitude was a problem "only" on the 50% of the time that we were going uphill. The scenery was magnificent and the accommodations at Aman and Six Senses resorts were fantastic. The picture of me at the top of this column was taken overlooking the famous Tiger's Nest Monastery. I am smiling in the picture because I had just completed the terrifying climb down and

up to the monastery. Not for the faint of heart or balance-challenged, i.e. me.

In early March, 2023 Anne and I went to NYC where we greatly enjoyed Broadway shows "Company" and "Merrily We Roll Along". While Los Angeles may be the entertainment capital of the world, nothing compares to Broadway shows. And we had a great meal at Aquavit.

We then did a driving trip in late March with Mark and Eleonore Hess (who we met on a biking trip to Puglia) to the National Parks of Utah and Arizona including Zion, Bryce, Canyonland, Arches, Monument Valley and Antelope Canyon. All spectacular. This was not a camping trip. My view is that if the good Lord had intended that we sleep outside, he/she never would have invented the "Ritz Carlton" or its like. The last three nights we stayed at the amazing Amangiri outside of Page, AZ. The setting was magnificent. Service was ok.

In May, we went to the eastern US and then France. **To Be Continued**

More about Builder's Remedy:

Former three-time Mayor **Tom Levyn** raised some interesting questions about the Builder's Remedy column that appeared in Issue 1290.

Here are the questions with my responses.

Q: Why are you assuming your last paragraph is true?

PIO Response: Because I am confident that our City Council will act aggressively to allow for affordable housing while protecting our neighborhoods.

Q: The legal issues you raise are interesting. Were they raised in any of the three trial court decisions you mention?

PIO Response: Several of these issues were raised and resolved at the trial court level, generally in favor of the developers but all are subject to appellate review. However, the unintended consequences and unlimited nature of this so-called remedy are highly questionable under constitutional limitations or legislative intent or otherwise and those issues have not been addressed or resolved.

Q: You did not mention that the City already lost the case of "substantial compliance" in the trial court. Why should we expect a different result on appeal? What does this loss mean in practical terms?

PIO Response: The trial court upheld the state's refusal to certify an earlier version of the City's Revised Housing Element. The current version of the RHE has been certified. If the trial court ruling about the earlier version is affirmed, we cannot contend that the window closed much earlier than March 18, 2024 the date of adoption of the current version. [See discussion below.]

O: From a policy standpoint, is Builder's Remedy a good or bad thing? Do our state representatives think it's a good thing and why? Did our City Council think it was a bad thing? If so, what did they do to notify residents?

PIO Response: Builder's remedy" has been in the Housing Accountability Act since at least 1990. It was intended

to incentivize submission of a compliant RHE at the end of every 8 year cycle (not a bad thing) but was not a serious issue for most cities in prior RHNA cycles because allocations of required # of units were very small (Beverly Hills' was three units in the past cycle v. 3100 in this cycle). Thus, it was very easy to achieve certification. As the legislators and governor struggle to solve homeless issues, I'm sure that some think it is a good thing and likely instructed HCD to seize upon this "loophole" but that is not how it was intended.

One other question (from me):

Q: When did the Builder's Remedy

"window" for submitting a Preliminary Application close because of the **current Revised Housing Element?**

PIO Response:

The City Council adopted the current Revised Housing Element on March 18, 2024 that was certified by the state on May 1, 2024. The Housing Accountability Act purports to preclude denial of a project that violates zoning or other standards UNLESS the city has adopted a compliant RHE. The preliminary applications for several of the purported Builder's Remedy projects were filed after the Council adopted the RHE on March 18. Therefore, these are not eligible for Builder's Remedy treatment.

BHPD Urges Drivers to Designate a Sober Driver

The Beverly Hills Police Department is reminding drivers to prioritize the safety of everyone on the road this Fourth of July by planning ahead and celebrating the holiday responsibly.

In 2022, 487 people were killed in crashes throughout the country during the Fourth of July holiday period. Of those deadly crashes, 40% involved alcohol. In California, 68 people were killed in crashes during last year's Inde-

pendence Day holiday period. In addition, California Highway Patrol officers made nearly 1,224 arrests for driving under the influence – an average of one DUI arrest every five minutes.

"Choosing a sober driver is not just about following the law; it's about saving lives," Chief Mark Stainbrook said. "If you plan on celebrating

the Fourth of July with a drink, we want you to make a plan to go safely with a sober ride home. Think of your loved ones, friends, and family before getting behind the wheel."

While some festivities may include alcohol, driving under the influence also includes impairment from prescription drugs, over-the-counter medications, and marijuana.

The BHPD is also urging residents who are hosting friends and family for barbecues and watching fireworks shows, to offer nonalcoholic drinks for designated sober drivers and monitor who is drinking.

You grew up in Beverly Hills. Tell us about that.

I moved here when I was five years old. My family was in the music entertainment industry, and we moved for the business. We actually moved north of Sunset to a gorgeous estate, my aunt's house. Then I grew up on Maple Drive. I went to Beverly Vista and then Beverly High, where I had a good time. I was in the Advanced Dance Theater Group in high school, so the arts were a big part of my life. From birth on, I continued to find other areas of the arts that excited

What made you want to serve on the **Arts and Culture Commission?**

I lived in Atlanta for a while when I was married, and got very involved in the political realm. I [connected] with everyone from the mayor to city council members to Congress members. [Although] I was primarily involved on the entertainment end, I attended many [political] events, including the congressional Black caucus. I enjoyed having a

voice and impacting the community posi-

I worked on an awards show for being of good to others Turner Broadcasting and leaving a legacy called the Trumpet Awards as a talent coordinator for three years. This [expeer extension of my [upbringing] in the arts. I found a new [passion] for creat-

ing events, productions, and shows that bring joy to people. Throughout my career, whether modeling as a kid, dancing in music videos, or producing events, my goal has always been to make people happy and [spread positivity].

I looked at a couple of commissions and realized I wanted to focus on what I excelled at, especially in the city I grew up in. I had already been involved in several other events, I was on the Centennial Committee, where I [chaired] the official Centennial documentary project. This led to other projects, including the "100 Stories" series. I had also participated in the city's 75th anniversary celebrations in high school, I danced in that. I feel like I have always done things involving the city. Even at Beverly Vista, I was featured in the police department's bicycle

I [have the mentality of seizing oppor-

tunities] to make a positive difference and offer something to people. I don't limit myself, that's why I have multiple careers and roles.

I also believe [we should all give] back, which is why I've been involved in various charitable organizations, such as the Ava's Heart Foundation, Make Music Day Foundation, Motown Museum, West Coast Advisory Committee, and the Little Miss African-American Beauty Pageant.

All these things embody the arts and celebrate youth. I love helping youth, [which has been a constant theme] since college, where I studied business administration and dance at Michigan State University. When I interviewed for the Arts and Culture Commission, I emphasized my experience in music, performance arts, [media arts, and more]. I [expressed my] vision of creating a big music festival to engage families and youth, and thought I would love doing this. I really enjoy this space; it's embedded in my DNA.

We're working on "Festival Beverly Hills". I just filmed an episode for it on Bev-That's what I want for erly Hills TV. I have been a TV host there rience] was anoth- create something that, since 2017. I've always wanted to be a TV host since I was 19, and I also produce and direct my segments.

> Organizing a music festival embodies so many elements [I love]. This festival includes music performances and dance, which are [both my world]. There are also arts activities and activities for the youth, whom I love to engage.

> All these elements for the festival was a [shared] vision. When I joined the commission, [former Chair Liliana Filipovic] had already started, and it turned out we both wanted a music festival. We realized this in a meeting and [as a commission we decided to celebrate different cultures at a music festival]. I believe in everybody having a win-win and it came together.

> Festival Beverly Hills is now in its second year. Last year, the City Council asked us to start small, so we began at the farmers market, which wasn't our original vision. However, [we made the most of it], and people loved it. This year,

we're expanding to an outdoor music festival at Beverly Gardens by the Lily Pond, spanning two blocks with three stages. I expect it to grow every year, becoming a destination event and the word expanding to neighboring cities and be-

You come from the Gordy family, who are very well known in the music industry. What made you want to pursue real estate?

My family, of course, founded Motown Records. My uncle [Berry] founded it along with his sisters and my grandparents. My mother, Iris Gordy, worked as Vice President, and my father, Johnny Bristol, was a songwriter and producer there. It was truly a family business, with even those not directly related becoming part of the Motown family. I worked there for a while, but I got tired of being connected to that and wanted to do my own thing.

So, I decided to enter real estate, and passed the licensing exam on my first try. Just like how I know the arts, I know real estate. I started in residential real estate and later moved into commercial, working with high-profile clients such as athletes, entertainers, singers, managers, and agents. My first clients included the comedian Sinbad and his wife, Johnny Gill of New Edition, and the NBA player Spud Webb.

Helping people with significant parts of their lives, like where they were going to live, was very [fulfilling] for me.

I got divorced right after giving birth to my second child, raising my two young kids alone in Atlanta, Georgia, without my family [there]. Coming from a family of strong women in the Gordy family, who were responsible for Motown's history, I learned to [get things done]. I always say I'm on autopilot – I just keep going and get things done. [Besides real estate], I took on entertainment, dancing in music videos, and choreographing shows both in the States and Jamaica. I [also] currently own one-third of [my dad's] music catalog with my two

half-siblings.

Tell us about your family.

I have a very supportive family and a great friend base. My daughters, Morgan and Kiarra, both graduated from Beverly Vista and Beverly High. Morgan was in a girl singing group for two years, and they were offered two record contracts. They even performed for Katherine Jackson, Michael Jackson's mother, at a festival in Gary, Indiana. They did very well but I, knowing the industry and being a protective "mama bear", [recommended she not move forward with those] contracts. Morgan did some acting, appeared on BET television, and worked on other projects and side shows. Her passion is theater, and she wants to produce a horror

film. She hasn't given up on that dream, but she earned a psychology degree from Loyola Marymount University.

My other daughter is in San Diego, where she owns her own esthetician business, which she opened in January.

As a single mom, I'm incredibly proud of my daughters. Single motherhood is challenging, and it took a village of supportive family members. I've poured everything into my children and am proud of their achievements.

My mom [Iris] is doing well and still lives in the city. She's still involved in music and serves on the boards of wonderful charitable organizations like the Rhythm and Blues Foundation, helping artists in need. People love reaching out to her for help, and she enjoys helping others. Overall, I come from a family that believes in helping people. My grandfather was the same way; he was a vice president at Motown, a professional bowler, and one of the first Black professional bowlers in Michigan. He was inducted into the Professional Bowling Association and was quite the rock star in his day.

My mother and I have been producing an event for 13 years called Friends of Fuller Gordy Strike Fest. It's a music extravaganza where we bowl, have a concert stage with well-known singers, including Motown artists, and enjoy a big dinner and silent auction. This year marks the 65th anniversary of Motown, and it's a big deal.

In October 2022, I produced a Motown show at the Wallis, which sold out in three weeks. People were begging for a second show, but it couldn't happen due to staffing issues. However, the show was a success, and my uncle Berry loved it.

What are some goals you have as chair?

As chair, I want to see us grow longterm installations in Beverly Hills that the community can engage with. One

of my most passionate projects, which I presented in 2020, is an arts and culture space that highlights love and kindness. This could be called the Love and Kindness Garden or Space. It would be a designated Arts and Culture Commission area with sculptures, signage, benches, arches, beautiful flowers, vibrant colors, and a small water feature. The sounds of water and all these things help create a sense of zen and joy, and I believe we need a space like that where people can relax, [especially] with mental illness numbers rising. It's in the queue on our work plan, and I'm hoping it will move forward when we address the plan again in August. That is something I am passionate about, not for me, but for the community. It's a selfless project for me that I think would be a great gift to the community.

I'm also involved with the CTE Advisory Committee for Beverly High, [Career Education Coordinator] Cindy Dubin has a great program. She is very passionate about youth education and providing them opportunities within the community. I love being a bridge for the youth, and I was able to get them to participate in our first festival with their own stage, where Beverly High musicians performed, most for the very first time. Things like that make me emotionally full and bring immense joy to my heart.

As a producer of events and productions, I [understand the challenges] of putting things together, but I have vision and I see the possibilities. With the right support from sponsors or budget handlers, we can make a hugely positive difference in people's lives. We only get one life, so why not live it being of good to others and leaving a legacy for the commission? That's what I want for the commission—to create something that, ten years from now, we can look back on. Focusing on the same goal [allows us] to pool our energies for the bigger picture, and there is no reason we can't succeed.

ORDINANCE NO. 24-O-2897

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY
HILLS ADOPTING AND AMENDING THE
STATE MID-CYCLE UPDATES TO THE
2022 CALIFORNIA GREEN BUILDING
STANDARDS CODE, AMENDING TITLE
9 OF THE BEVERLY HILLS MUNICIPAL
CODE, AND APPROVING A CEQA
EXEMPTION DETERMINATION

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 9-1-1102 of Article 11 of Title 9 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"9-1-1102: AMENDMENTS TO CALIFORNIA GREEN BUILDING STANDARDS CODE:

The California Green Building Standards Code adopted pursuant to Section 9-1-1101 is hereby amended as follows:

'Section 102.1.1 is added to the California Green Building Standards Code to read as follows:

102.1.1 Electronic construction documents. The enforcing agency is authorized to require construction documents, including plans, to be submitted in an acceptable electronic format.

[Note: this Section 102.1.1 unaffected by State mid-cycle amendments]'

'Section 4.106.4 of the California Green Building Standards Code is adopted and amended to read as follows:

4.106.4 Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging for New Construction

New construction shall comply with Section 4.106.4.1 or 4.106.4.2. Electric vehicle supply equipment (EVSE) shall comply with the California Electrical Code.

Exception:

- 1. On a case-by-case basis, where the local enforcing agency has determined EV charging and infrastructure are not feasible based upon one or more of the following conditions:
- 1. Where there is no local utility power supply or the local utility is unable to supply adequate power.
- adequate power.

 2. Where there is evidence suitable to the local enforcing agency substantiating that additional local utility infrastructure design requirements, directly related to the implementation of Section 4.106.4, may adversely impact

the construction cost of the project.

2. Accessory Dwelling Units (ADU) and Junior Accessory Dwelling Units (JADU) without additional parking facilities.

4.106.4.1 New One- And Two-Family Dwellings and Townhouses With Attached Private Garages

For each new dwelling unit that is provided with parking, install a minimum of one (1) Low Power Level 2 Electric Vehicle Charging Receptacle or a Level 2 Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment (EVSE).

Exception: Deleted

4.106.4.1.1 Identification Deleted

4.106.4.2 New multifamily dwellings, hotels and motels and new residential parking facilities. When parking is provided, parking spaces for new multifamily dwellings, hotels and motels shall meet the requirements of Section 4.106.4.2.2. Calculations for spaces shall be rounded up to the nearest whole number. A parking space served by electric vehicle supply equipment or designed as an EV charging space shall count as at least one standard automobile parking space only for the purpose of complying with any applicable minimum parking space requirements established by a local jurisdiction. See Vehicle Code Section 22511.2 for further details.

4.106.4.2.1 Reserved

- 4.106.4.2.2 Multifamily dwellings, hotels and motels.
- 1. EV ready parking spaces with receptacles.
- a. **Hotels and motels.** Forty (40) percent of the total number of parking spaces shall be equipped with low power Level 2 EV charging receptacles.
- b. **Multifamily parking facilities.** Forty (40) percent of the total number of parking spaces shall be equipped with low power Level 2 EV charging receptacles. EV charging receptacles required by this section shall be located in at least one assigned parking space per dwelling unit where assigned parking is provided.

Exception: Areas of parking facilities served by parking lifts, including but not limited to automated mechanical-access open parking garages as defined in the California Building Code; or parking facilities otherwise incapable of supporting electric vehicle charging.

c. Receptacle power source. EV charging receptacles in multifamily parking facilities shall be provided with a dedicated branch circuit connected to the dwelling unit's electrical panel, unless determined as infeasible by the project builder or designer and subject to concurrence of the local enforcing agency.

Exception: Areas of parking facilities served by parking lifts, including but not limited to automated mechanical-access open parking garages as defined in the California Building Code; or parking facilities otherwise incapable of supporting electric vehicle charging.

- d. **Receptacle configurations.** 208/240V EV charging receptacles shall comply with one of the following configurations:
- 1. For 20-ampere receptacles, NEMA 6-20R 2. For 30-ampere receptacles, NEMA 14-30R 3. For 50-ampere receptacles, NEMA 14-50R
- 2. EV ready parking spaces with EV chargers.
- a. **Hotels and motels.** Ten (10) percent of the total number of parking spaces shall be equipped with Level 2 EV chargers. At least fifty (50) percent of the required EV chargers shall

be equipped with J1772 connectors

b. **Multifamily parking facilities.** Ten (10) percent of the total number of parking spaces shall be equipped with Level 2 EV chargers. At least fifty (50) percent of the required EV chargers shall be equipped with J1772 connectors. Where common use parking or unassigned parking is provided, EV chargers shall be located in common use or unassigned parking areas and shall be available for use by all residents

Where low power Level 2 EV charging receptacles or Level 2 EV chargers are installed beyond the minimum required, an automatic load management system (ALMS) may be used to reduce the maximum required electrical capacity to each space served by the ALMS. The electrical system and any on-site distribution

transformers shall have sufficient capacity to deliver at least 3.3 kW simultaneously to each EV charging station (EVCS) served by the ALMS. The branch circuit shall have a minimum capacity of 40 amperes, and installed EV chargers shall have a capacity of not less than 30 amperes.

4.106.4.2.3 Electric vehicle charging stations (EVCS). Electric vehicle charging stations required by Section 4.106.4.2.2, Item 2, with EV chargers installed shall comply with Section 4.106.4.2.3.1.

Exception: Electric vehicle charging stations serving public accommodations, public housing, motels, and hotels shall not be required to comply with this section. See California Building Code, Chapter 11B, for applicable requirements.

- 4.106.4.2.3.1 Electric vehicle charging stations (EVCS) spaces with EV chargers installed; dimensions and location. EVCS spaces shall be designed to comply with the following:
- 1. The minimum length of each EVCS space shall be 18 feet (5486 mm).
- 2. The minimum width of each EVCS space shall be 9 feet (2743 mm).
- 3. One in every 25 EVCS spaces, but not less than one, shall also have an 8-foot (2438 mm) wide minimum aisle. A 5-foot (1524 mm) wide minimum aisle shall be permitted provided the minimum width of the EVCS space is 12 feet (3658 mm). Surface slope for this EVCS space and the aisle shall not exceed 1 unit vertical in 48 units horizontal (2.083 percent slope) in any direction. These EVCS spaces shall also comply with at least one of the following:
- a. The EVCS space shall be located adjacent to an accessible parking space meeting the requirements of the California Building Code, Chapter 11A, to allow use of the EV charger from the accessible parking space.
- b. The EVCS space shall be located on an accessible route, as defined in the California Building Code, Chapter 2, to the building.

Exception: Electric vehicle charging stations designed and constructed in compliance with the California Building Code, Chapter 11B, are not required to comply with Section 4.106.4.2.3.1.

4.106.4.2.3.2 Accessible electric vehicle charging station spaces. In addition to the requirements in Section 4.106.4.2.3.1, all EV chargers, where installed, shall comply with the accessibility provisions for EV chargers in the California Building Code, Chapter 11B. EV ready spaces and EVCS in multifamily developments shall comply with California Building Code, Chapter 11A, Section 1109A.

4.106.4.2.4 Electric Vehicle Ready Space Signage. Electric vehicle ready spaces shall be identified by signage or pavement markings, in compliance with Caltrans Traffic Operations Policy Directive 13-01 (Zero Emission Vehicle Signs and Pavement Markings) or its successor(s)

4.106.4.3 Electric vehicle charging for additions and alterations of parking facilities serving existing multifamily buildings. Where new parking facilities are added, or electrical systems or lighting of existing parking facilities are added or altered and the work requires a building permit, ten (10) percent of the total number of parking spaces added or altered shall be EV capable spaces to of support future Level 2 electric vehicle supply equipment. The service panel or subpanel circuit directory shall identify the overcurrent protective device space(s) reserved for future EV charging purposes as 'EV CAPABLE.'

Notes:

- 1. Construction documents are intended to demonstrate the project's capability and capacity for facilitating future EV charging.
- 2. There is no requirement for EV spaces to be constructed or available until EV chargers are installed for use.'

'Section 4.304.2 is added to the California Green Building Standards Code to read as follows:

4.304.2 Metering Outdoor Water Use. A landscape water meter provided by the City of Beverly Hills shall be installed for landscape irrigation for the following projects. The term aggregate landscape area includes areas of

new landscaping, relandscaping, and existing landscaping to remain.

New residential building on a site with an aggregate landscape area of 500 square feet or more.

Exception: Accessory Dwelling Units that do not meet any of the other conditions.

- 2. Additions and/or alterations to an existing residential building on a site with an aggregate landscape area of 500 square feet or more, where the building supply line or water meter is being replaced or upgraded.
- 3. Relandscaping or new landscaping projects of 2,500 square feet or more.

[Note: this Section 4.304.2 unaffected by State mid-cycle amendments]'

'Section 4.305 of the California Green Building Standards Code is amended to read as follows:

SECTION 4.305 WATER REUSE SYSTEMS

- **4.305.1 Cooling Towers [N]**. Cooling towers shall comply with Section 4.305.2.1 or 4.305.2.2.
- **4.305.1.1 Existing Buildings.** Buildings with existing cooling towers shall install cooling towers of a minimum of 6 cycles of concentration (blowdown) or better upon replacement.
- **4.305.1.2 New Buildings.** New Buildings shall with cooling towers shall install cooling towers of a minimum of 6 cycles of concentration (blowdown) or better.'

Any construction project for which a ne water meter is being requested.

3. When required by the California Department of Water Resources Model Water Efficient Landscape Ordinance.

[Note: this Section 5.304.7 unaffected by State mid-cycle amendments]'

'Section 5.305 of the California Green

Building Standards Code is amended to read as follows:

SECTION 5.305 WATER REUSE SYSTEMS

5.305.1. Cooling Towers. Cooling towers shall comply with Section 5.305.1.1 or 5.305.1.2.

5.305.1.1 Existing Buildings. Buildings with existing cooling towers shall install cooling towers of a minimum of 6 cycles of concentration (blowdown) or better upon replacement.

5.305.1.2. New Buildings [N]. New Buildings with cooling towers shall install cooling towers of a minimum of 6 cycles of concentration (blowdown) or better.

[Note: this Section 5.305 unaffected by State mid-cycle amendments]"

Section 2. CEQA. The City Council finds that it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility the adoption of this Ordinance may have a significant effect on the environment because the adoption of this Ordinance will provide for improved air quality and thereby contribute to the overall public health, safety and welfare. It is therefore exempt from California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) review pursuant to Title 14, Section 15061(b)(3), of the California Code of Regulations (CEQA Guidelines).

Section 3. Penalty. Except where

specified to be an infraction, violation of any provision of this Ordinance or any Code adopted or amended herein by reference shall constitute a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or by imprisonment for a period not to exceed six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Each and every day such a violation exists shall constitute a separate and distinct violation of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Civil Remedies. The violation of any of the provisions of this Ordinance or any Code adopted or amended herein by reference shall constitute a nuisance and may be abated by the City through civil process by means of restraining order, preliminary or permanent injunction or in any other manner provided by law for the abatement of such nuisances.

Section 5. Severability. The City Council declares that, should any provision, section, paragraph, sentence, or word of this Ordinance be rendered or declared invalid by any final court action in a court of competent jurisdiction, or by reason of any preemptive legislation, the remaining provisions, sections, paragraphs, sentences and words of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. Certification. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance and shall cause the same to be pub-

lished in the manner prescribed by law.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective and be in full force and effect at 12:01 a.m. on the thirty-first (31st) date after its passage.
