

### City Council Upholds Tree Removal on North Roxbury

The City Council upheld the Planning Commission's decision approving a Tree Removal Permit to allow the removal of three heritage trees located within front setback areas for the property located at 1001 North Roxbury Drive, at its Tuesday meeting.

The project site is located within the western side of the 1000 block of North Roxbury Drive in the central area of the city, with Lexington Road to the south and Whittier Drive to the west. The site is currently vacant and planned for the construction of a new single-family residence.

"The trees associated with this request are not listed on the city's list of native trees. However, as the circumference of the identified trees is 48" or greater, they are considered heritage trees and are protected by the city's tree protection ordinance," according to a city staff report.

The project site contains 44 trees. The commission's approval of the permit included the removal of two Coastal Redwood and one London Plane Sycamore.

The Planning Commission imposed additional conditions to further minimize the impact by requesting larger, more mature replacement trees. This was also intended to minimize the impact the removals may have on the streetscape, however, a past staff report indicated the replacement would not affect the garden quality.

On July 9, Ellis Raskin of Hanson Bridgett LLP, on behalf of Maple Leaf Ventures, LLC, filed an appeal of the decision, requesting that the City Council review the proposed Tree Removal Permit request. Specifically, the appeal alleges the Planning Commission's findings and decisions were not based on substantial evidence in the record. The applicant also claimed that the city failed to comply with the California Environmental Quality Act and that it failed to provide legally required noticing.

Several public comments were also written in support of the removal of the protected heritage trees.

### **City Council Approves Voting Delegates**

The City Council approved a resolution as part of its consent calendar, designating Councilmember Craig Corman as the city's voting delegate, Councilmember Mary Wells as the primary alternate voting delegate, and Deputy City Manager Keith Sterling as the secondary alternate voting delegate, to represent the city at the League of California Cities Annual Conference.

The Cal Cities Annual Conference is an event where city representatives from across California gather to address issues facing municipalities. The conference includes general sessions, networking opportunities, interactive expos, and breakout discussions on topics crucial to cities.

A highlight of the conference is the Annual Business Meeting, where member cities vote on policy resolutions that will guide Cal Cities' agenda for the upcoming year. The General Assembly will convene on the final day, October 18., to consider these resolutions and swear in the new Board of

BHHS Football Team Set to Play

Beverly High is scheduled to play a nonleague football game at Nordhoff Friday at 7 p.m., facing a team that has outscored its opponents, 77-8.

The Normans and Rangers have one common opponent – Vasquez, who Beverly Hills defeated 26-21 in its season opener Aug. 30 and Nordhoff defeated 35-0 Friday.

The Rangers (3-0) are 300th in the Southern Section rankings, 49 spots ahead of Beverly Hills (2-1). The Normans rose four spots in the rankings used to determine which divisions qualified teams will play in during the playoffs despite their

46-7 loss to Pasadena Poly Friday.

The high school football website projects a 35-10 victory for Nordhoff and gives the Rangers a 95% chance of winning and Beverly Hills a 5% chance.

### **Pasadena Poly 46, Beverly Hills 7** Freshman Rocco Taylor returned a first-quarter kickoff 70 yards for a touchdown for the Normans in a nonleague game Friday night at Nickoll Field.

"We didn't execute at the level we felt that we could execute at," Beverly Hills coach Hasan Muhammad said when asked about his offense's play. "We had a couple of injuries that affected us. But you know, next guy up mentality. We just got to keep developing, keep working."

Muhammad praised the play of Taylor and senior running back Logan Chong, who he said is "a good veteran presence to have out there."

Quarterback Matthew Recupero said, "It just wasn't my best game today. The team has a lot to improve from here and I have lot to improve from here, but we'll get better. We'll be back and we'll be ready to beat some of the next teams we play."

On defense, "we weren't physical enough," Muhammad said. "There were a lot of mental mistakes and we just didn't tackle at the level we needed to."

However, "we had a lot of good things happen at different points. The problem we had collectively (is) to get all of our guys on the same page consistently every play."

Muhammad said he thought "our safeties did a good job."

Taylor's touchdown tied the score 7-7. The Panthers (3-1) scored twice in the final minute of the first half on the first of freshman Kaiden Thorell's three touchdown passes and senior T.J. McElrath's 50-yard run which came after the Normans were unable to control the ensuing kickoff.

McElrath ran 71 yards for a second-quarter touchdown and Thorell threw a 10-yard touchdown pass two seconds before halftime to give Pasadena Poly a 34-7 lead.

Thorell threw a touchdown pass in the third quarter and freshman Alister Chan threw a fourth-quarter touchdown pass.

McElrath opened the scoring with a 10yard run midway through the first quarter.

"We thought that they had a really strong run game, and we noticed that they were missing the back we started to key in on some of the other players a little bit," said Pasadena Poly coach Ken Henderson, whose team dropped 11 spots to 287th among the 373 Southern Section 11-man teams.

"It's nice to see that they take pride in ownership and the sport that they're trying to learn and execute out there."

#### What's Next?

The Normans are set to play host to Centennial today at 3 p.m. in an Ocean League game at Nickoll Field.

The Apaches lost to Santa Monica 26-0, Sept. 5. Ramsey said Beverly Hills and Centennial are comparable.

### **Team Beverly Hills and Citizens Police Academy**

Two of the City's most popular and constructive programs are getting underway for the 2024-5 year so I thought that it would be good to describe them and tell you about the experiences that they offer. The two programs are:

Team Beverly Hills; and

The BHPD Citizens Police Academy.

Team Beverly Hills is a well-established program commenced more than 25 years ago by then Mayor Tom Levyn. Since that time approximately 750 Beverly Hills residents have participated in and completed the program. It is almost a sine qua non for appointment to a city commission as it is a comprehensive introduction to the operation and functioning of the city. An express objective is "to build a resource of involved community members for future Commissions, committees, programs, and projects for the benefit of the Beverly Hills community."

The program informs community members about their local government representatives, departments and programs; community associations; and current community issues.

The fact that the program is now managed by Deputy City Manager Keith Sterling is indicative of the importance of Team Beverly Hills.

Former BHUSD Trustee Isabel Hacker explained: "Team Beverly Hills effectively introduces and delivers practical and informative education for the various divisions of the City. An awesome opportunity of learning and true civic engagement is what Team Team Beverly Hills is all about."

Over the course of ten or so weekly meetings, Team Team Beverly Hills participants are treated to presentations City officials and representatives (Mayor and

City Councilmembers, City Treasurer, City Clerk, City Attorney, City Manager, City Department Heads from Community Development, Community Services, Finance, Human Resources, Information Technology, Public Works, including the Police Chief and the Fire Chief); as well as community groups, local business, and education leaders.

Cultural Heritage Commissioner and former chair and member of the Traffic and Parking Commission and Planning Commission Andy Licht said: "Team Beverly Hills is an excellent opportunity to learn about how the City functions. It was perfect for me because I love learning how things work. So much so, that my wife called it "Camp Beverly Hills" because I always looked forward to it. I also learned that we have many great people working for us '

Long-time Beverly Hills resident and charter member of the Mature Men's Book Discussion Group Joel Krischer strongly recommends participation: "Team Beverly Hills was both informative and fun. It was an enjoyable way not only to learn about how our city functions, but to meet the very dedicated staff -- in all areas, including those one would never think about -who keep our city working smoothly. We had a great time and would recommend it to anybody."

I am a proud member of the Team Beverly Hills Class of 2017. I enjoyed every minute of this program but there were two highlights. First, the tour of the main firehouse on Rexford and being served a "home cooked" meal by several of the firemen who had prepared it for the members of the department who would be staying overnight. Second, the opportunity to role play the part of a rapacious developer in a mock Planning Commission hearing.

While it is somewhat newer than Team Beverly Hills, the success of the Citizens Police Academy is illustrated by the intense competition to be one of the twenty residents to be selected, generally by lottery, to participate.

This comprehensive introduction to the many aspects of law enforcement is led by BHPD Sgt. Billy Fair. The current academy started only a few weeks ago. It

is a ten week program that includes visits to the crime lab and the shooting range and demonstrations by the SWAT team, the fabulous police canines, detectives and defense tactics

Most challenging is role-playing in a number of realistic scenarios of the type that our law enforcement officers confront every day. During my time at the academy, we went through four different scenarios. I did everything wrong that could possibly done wrong and then some. You all should be thankful that I am not a member of BHPD.

The reaction of participants could not be more enthusiastically favorable.

Current Academy participant and City Treasurer Howard Fisher said: "The Beverly Hills Citizen Police Academy provides residents with an eye-opening experience into the demanding and courageous world of policing, highlighting the extensive training, education, and expertise that our officers possess. From our very first class, where we role-played two intense scenarios - a routine traffic stop and a delicate situation involving a suicidal person with a knife, we gained a profound understanding of the split-second decisions and dangers officers face daily. These exercises revealed the depth of skill, compassion, and quick thinking required to handle the unpredictable and often perilous nature of police work. It became clear that it takes a truly special person to wear the badgesomeone committed to service, bravery, and unwavering dedication to keeping our community safe. Through this program, we not only learned about the realities of law enforcement but also developed a deep respect for the men and women who stand on the front lines every day."

Abrams had a similar report: "I found the Beverly Hills Citizen Academy very effective in educating community members regarding the complicated and challenging responsibilities of our police officers and law enforcement in Beverly Hills and all over our country. The program is very well conceived and effectively administered. The officers and staff divide each week by subject focused on the various Police Divisions such as Detectives, Drones and Technology, SWAT, K-9, state and federal law enforcement policies and procedures, etc. It is truly fascinating. I found each class to be engaging, fun, frightening and mostly educational. As part of the program, the staff does an incredible job replicating real life behind the scenes experiences allowing individuals to understand what it is like to be in the shoes of officers who are compelled to make life and death decisions. Although I have always empathized and appreciated the difficult job of law enforcement, I walked away with so much more knowledge and empathy for our officers as they negotiate the delicate balance between keeping our communities safe and themselves while respecting civil liberties and the complex laws that often tie their hands

"Every community across the country would benefit from this program."

Similarly, Jacques Wertheimer, told me: "I learned about the broad scope of police operations and services and how best to personally use them should the need arise. Rather than "teach" 20 students twice a year, I suggest that the program be changed to a larger format/venue that could permit instruction of 100+ residents. Very very valuable course."

Further, Mr. Wertheimer observes that when Beverly Hills residents wave at members of the BHPD, they use all of the fingers on their hand. He speculates that it is because of the good will inspired by the Citizens Police Academy and the many other good works done by our police.

My only complaint is that there are not more programs like these. Perhaps we can convince our personable fire chief Greg Barton to consider putting together a BHFD academy.

### COVERSTORY CRIME CHRONICLES Scott Huver Discusses His New Book Beverly Hills Noir

## You got your start in journalism as a reporter for the *Beverly Hills Courier* in the 1990s. Tell us about that.

It was an interesting period of time. I had just moved here [from Michigan], and it was literally the first job I got in Los Angeles. I kind of thought it was going to be hilarious. I had never worked as a reporter covering city beats before and didn't know what to expect. In many ways, it was both educational and eye-opening.

I fell in love with the history and unique nature of the city the more I learned about it, particularly with covering the police and crime beat and learning about the stories of Beverly Hills—many of them unique, sometimes bizarre, but always fascinating—and the events [unfolding] while I was reporting.

It was a formative time. And, of course, given Beverly Hills' proximity to the entertainment industry, it was a great launching pad for my segue into what I've been doing for the past 20 years: entertainment reporting.

## You worked under the late *Courier* founder March Schwartz. Tell us about that.

March was quite the character. He had his pluses and minuses, and I definitely experienced some of the minuses. But I also have mostly fond memories of March himself. He was a self-made man who had built a little empire that he was very protective of in Beverly Hills, and he made quite a success of it.

He had worked in newspapers before, mostly on the sales side, and had also been involved in restaurants, helping to launch some successful ones. He eventually decided to do something local, [gathering] some of his friends from other papers to contribute. A lot of talented people were happy to help because they were fond of March, both personally and professionally. He created quite a unique little paper that thrived, especially during the heyday of Beverly Hills in the 1970s and 1980s, when the city was catching the attention of the whole world. It was a small-town paper in every respect.

When I started there, everything was still done with a typesetting machine—no computers. I ended up being the one who computerized the office for the first time. There was one lady in the area who knew how to work the typesetting machine, and only one repairman in all of LA and Orange County who could fix it, which he had to do often. There was almost a sitcom-like quality to the old-fashioned nature of the place. March was a traditional guy and wasn't big on embracing change, but he eventually did, to the betterment of the paper.

March also knew how to exercise the power of small-town journalism. He had an outsized influence on elections, both at the city council and school board levels. If you wanted to make any headway in your campaign in Beverly Hills, you definitely [needed his endorsement]. He made it clear to everyone that he was the path to power. Sometimes, that caught up with him. He once backed a candidate who [clashed] with the police department, and by the time I started, there was zero relationship between the newspaper and the police department.

It was interesting to cover that dynamic, and I was able to mend the rift unintentionally. The police department learned to trust me and appreciated my interest in both their current work and the historic crimes in Beverly Hills. It was a really interesting time. It was also "March's way or the highway," and eventually, it became the highway for me. I just wasn't prepared to keep working under his unorthodox rule.

Still, I was very impressed by how he managed to get himself on the White House press corps. He traveled with presidents all over the world and would bring me little souvenirs, like the peanuts from Air Force One. I even saw photos of President Clinton reading the newspaper. The fact that March, with a small-town paper, was able to accomplish all that was a testament to his charm and personality.

### The book is called *Beverly Hills Noir*. What made you want to write it?

It has been in my hands for practically three decades—the stories that I either worked on myself or learned about. I always thought they would make a great book. Initially, I was thinking of something more like a history of the police department. But the more time I spent with them, the more it became sort of a hobby for me to research these things. I really enjoyed spending time at the library, finding books that might have one new piece of information, digging into old newspapers and microfiche. So, I kept gathering new stories and more information, knowing I wanted to do something with them.

I had a couple of different ideas and a few false starts, especially since my entertainment journalism career kept me very busy. But finally, it took the pandemic when I actually had free time—to sit down and look at all these stories. I realized I had enough material for probably four books, so I really focused and drilled down on them in an immersive way.

I didn't just want to tell the familiar

stories. I wanted to pick some really interesting, different ones and get into the nitty-gritty details. I got very lucky because, right out of the gate, after finishing a book proposal and some sample chapters, I was able to find an agent, secure a publisher, and then put the pedal to the metal to get the book finished.

### Your previous book was called *Inside Rodeo Drive*, which you co-wrote. How do you feel the Rodeo Drive story plays into your new book?

That came from my relationship with the Rodeo Drive Committee in the late 1990s and early 2000s, when I was publishing and promoting a magazine for them. It was a really fun experience, and it eventually led to the book. The entire time I was working on the magazine, I kept saying, "I wish there was a book we could draw information from." We were assembling pieces here and there, and then we said, "Why don't we write that book ourselves?"

In the process, I learned a lot about the history of Rodeo Drive and, by extension, the history of Beverly Hills. There's one story in particular in *Beverly Hills Noir* that takes place on Rodeo Drive during the big era of the 1980s when it was really a global sensation.

We covered some unusual crimes in *Inside Rodeo Drive*, [which was a more lighthearted, tourist-oriented book]. One of the stories was a bit darker, though, and I knew it wasn't the right fit for that book. But that story always haunted me when I first heard about it, and I know it haunted many of the police officers involved as well. I was really committed to telling that story in depth. So, when I worked on Beverly Hills, I knew that story had to be included because of my familiarity with it.

### You now work as a freelance entertainment journalist. Tell us about your career since the *Courier*.

Yeah, my career led to working with the Rodeo Drive Committee, where I published many of their magazines. At the same time, [Publisher Josh Gross] launched *Beverly Hills Weekly*. I would frequently contribute to that, which gave me an opportunity. The *Weekly* was interested in letting me do some historical pieces, and the timing was right. While writing *Inside Rodeo Drive*, I had a lot of stories that didn't fit in that book, and I wanted to expand on them. Josh was very open to running stories from the city's history stories I just wanted to tell but hadn't included in the book.

That coincided with an opportunity that came right after I finished *Inside Rodeo Drive*, where I realized, "Okay, this was fun, but I've got to get back on a career track again." A friend told me about an opening at a website called hollywood. com, which was one of the leaders in entertainment coverage online in the late 1990s and early 2000s. I started working with them in 2001. I had actually been invited to the premiere of American Pie 2, and I took it upon myself to approach the stars at the after-party, do some quick interviews, and put together a story.

When I went in for my interview with hollywood.com, I brought the story I had written and offered it to them, saying, "If you want to run this, I'm happy to let you have it." I hadn't even gotten back to my car when they called me to tell me I'd gotten the job. It was a space I had really wanted to get into, and it was a great opportunity for me. I had a lot of room to grow, develop, and experiment. I ended up being in charge of the LA office for several years, which put me on red carpets, at junkets, and doing all kinds of entertainment coverage. That allowed me to connect with clients like People Magazine, InStyle, TV Guide, Variety, The Hollywood Reporter, and many other outlets.

I've been with *People* for, I think, about 17 years now, and it's been incredibly rewarding. It also paid off for the book because I have a strong understanding of how Hollywood works. Hollywood has been so married with Beverly Hills from the very beginning, and being able to bring that perspective to the book was valuable. Despite 100 years of history, a lot of the basics of how Hollywood and Beverly Hills works remain the same. It's been fun to apply that perspective in a different way for this book.

### What do you want readers to take away from the book?

I think the cases I cover—some of them are familiar in local lore, like the murder-suicide at Greystone Mansion—will feel brand new [because it's so in-dept], even to those who think they know them well. The story has a very Chinatown narrative, and as I dug into it, I found an interesting perspective to view it. I tried to do that with each story, mixing up the types of crimes so it's not all about murder.

I have a case involving a cat burglar targeting high society, a barroom brawl with a Rat Pack and a few millionaires, a very tragic hostage situation, and then Rodeo Drive in the 1980s. I also cover more recent events, like the Winona Ryder shoplifting case, which I personally covered during her trial. I found a bunch of different cases from the 1990s and 2000s that are just so uniquely Beverly Hills, with twists and turns you're not going to find in other cities.

Some stories you may have heard of, like Greystone or Winona Ryder, but I tell them in a way you haven't heard before. That was fun for me, and I hope it will be for the reader as well. Then there are stories that people might not be as familiar with—ones that they might vaguely recall, but they'll find them fresh here.

There are also plenty of fun tangents I go off on, with connections to pop culture. So, even though some of the stories are dark, there's also a lot of light and fun to it. I think readers will enjoy it—I certainly had a fun time writing it. It's going to be a good read for anyone who loves Beverly Hills, loves local history, or loves true crime.



#### ORDINANCE NO. 24-O-2900

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS AMENDING SECTIONS OF Article 2 (parades and assemblies) of Chapter 3 (OTHER ACTIVITIES REQUIRING REGULATORY

ACTIVITIES REQUIRING REGULATORY PERMITS) of Title 4 (regulation of certain types of businesses and activities) of the beverly hills MUNICIPAL Code AND MAKING A DETERMI-

NATION OF EXEMPTION FROM THE CALI-FORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT

WHEREAS, the City of Beverly Hills recognizes the importance of public gatherings that allow the community to collectively express its concerns about public issues, and supports the rights of all people to peacefully exercise their First Amendment rights to free speech and assembly; and

WHEREAS, as set forth in section 4-3-200 et seq. the Beverly Hills Municipal Code attempts to balance protection of the First Amendment right to demonstrate with the physical and fiscal impacts of these demonstrations on the City, the Police Department, and the City's residents and businesses; and

WHEREAS, the City now seeks to revise its parade and assembly regulations to provide minor updates and clarifications in the City regulations; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to adopt regulations that will promote the free exercise of First Amendment rights through parades and assemblies, and simultaneously serve the significant interests of protecting the public health and safety of our community; and

WHEREAS, the City particularly desires to protect its residents' rights to enjoy free and unfettered access to the City's public parks and the features thereof, and to protect the health and safety of demonstrators, drivers, and pedestrians. THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEVER-LY HILLS HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City Council hereby finds that all of the facts set forth in the Recitals above are true and correct.

<u>Section 2.</u> Section 4-3-200, entitled "Parades or Assemblies of Less Than Five Hundred People," of Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 4 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"4-3-200: PARADES OR ASSEMBLIES OF LESS THAN FIVE HUNDRED PEOPLE:

A. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Article, parades and assemblies of fewer than five hundred (500) people will be allowed without a permit in La Cienega Park and on the Crescent Drive side of the City Hall.

B. No sound amplification equipment shall be allowed if it will generate significant noise impacts.

C. To protect public access to City parks for public uses other than parades and assemblies, if La Cienega Park experiences any unpermitted parade or assembly which either: (a) takes place in the park for more than two (2) hours within the same six (6) hour time period for six (6) weeks within a twelve week (12) period, or (b) takes place in the park for at least two hours on a Saturday or Sunday for six (6) weeks within a twelve (12) week period, then the park shall be closed to unpermitted parades and assemblies for a period of six (6) weeks and unpermitted parades or assemblies may take place on the Crescent Drive side of the City Hall."

<u>Section 3.</u> Section 4-3-202, entitled "Definitions," of Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 4 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"4-3-202: DEFINITIONS:

For the purposes of this article, the following words and phrases shall have the following meanings:

ASSEMBLY: Any meeting, demonstration, picket line, rally, gathering, or group of persons, animals, or vehicles, or a combination thereof, having a common purpose, design, or goal, either (1) upon any public street, sidewalk, alley, or city park path which numbers twenty-five (25) or more and which assembly will or tends to substantially inhibit the usual flow of pedestrian or vehicular traffic, other than a "parade," as defined in this section, or (2) upon any park or other public place not specified in (1) which numbers seventy-five (75) or more and which occupies any public area, other than a "parade," as defined in this section.

PARADE: Any march, demonstration, procession, motorcade, or promenade consisting of persons, animals, or vehicles, or a combination thereof, having a common purpose, design, destination, or goal; upon any public place, which parade, march, demonstration, procession, motorcade, or promenade does not comply with normal and usual traffic regulations or control.

SIGNIFICANT NOISE IMPACTS: The generation of noise that is distinctly audible from within the nearest residence or dwelling."

<u>Section 4.</u> Section 4-3-203, entitled "Exemptions," of Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 4 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

"In addition to the parades or assemblies described in Section 4-3-200 above, the permit application provisions of this article shall not apply to the following:

A. Spontaneous parades or assemblies occasioned by news or affairs coming into public knowledge within three (3) days before such assembly, provided that the organizers thereof, if any, give written notice to the City at least twenty four (24) hours prior to such parade or assembly.

1. Such written notice shall contain all of the following information:

a. The name, address and telephone number of the person or persons seeking to organize or conduct the parade or assembly. This person or these persons shall be considered a permittee for the purposes of this article.

b. The name, address and telephone number of the headquarters of the organization, if any, and of the organizer or responsible head of such organization by whom or on whose behalf the parade or assembly is proposed to be conducted.

c. The name, address and telephone number

of the person who will chair the parade or assembly and who will be responsible for its conduct.

d. The location and date of the proposed parade or assembly, including the assembly area, disbanding area, and the route to be traveled.

e. An estimate of the approximate number of persons who will be participating in the parade or assembly and an estimate of the approximate number of persons who will be observing the parade or assembly.

f. The time at which the parade or assembly will start and conclude.

g. The type of security or other arrangements that will be provided to assure that participants are properly directed.

h. The number and type of sound amplification equipment, if any, indicating the maximum sound-producing power of the equipment in terms of the specific wattage to be used, the volume in decibels of sound which will be produced, and the approximate distance for which sound will be audible from the sound-amplifying equipment, as well as the electrical generators that will be used, if any.

i. Whether participants in the parade or assembly will be wearing masks.

2. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee may deny permission to conduct the parade or assembly within eighteen (18) hours of the submission of the notice pursuant to subsection B of section 4-3-205 if the City Manager or the City Manager's designee makes a finding requiring denial pursuant to subsection B of sec-tion 4-3-205. If the City Manager makes a finding requiring denial pursuant to that subsection, the City Manager shall immediately provide notice of the denial, including the reason for the denial, by telephone to the permittee and shall also provide written notice of the denial including the reason for the denial. If the permittee provides an email address for the purpose of receiving notices, the City Manager shall provide written notice of the denial by email immediately upon making the denial decision. If the proposed parade or assembly is denied, an assembly of less than five hundred (500) persons may still occur pursuant to section 4-3-200 of this article."

Section 5. Section 4-3-204, entitled "Application for Permit," of Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 4 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code is hereby amended to include the following paragraphs 13 through 16 of subsection C, with the remainder of Section 4-3-204 remaining unchanged to read as follows:

"13. A statement to be signed by the person seeking the permit that the permittee will hold harmless and indemnify the City of Beverly Hills, its elected officials, officers, employees and agents from any damages which may arise as a result of the alleged willful or negligent acts or omissions of permittee, its officers, agents, or employees in connection with the permitted parade or assembly, except for losses to the City occasioned by the reaction to the permittees' expressive activity.

14. A proposed parade or assembly involving expressive activity shall be required to provide insurance only when there is a specific demonstrable history of personal injury or property damage claims being awarded against the applicant attributable to the applicant's conduct of previous events in the City that are similar in nature to the proposed event. Where there is a specific demonstrable history of property damage, this insurance requirement may be waived by the City Manager if the applicant designs the parade or assembly to respond to specific risks, hazards and dangers to the public health and safety identified by the City Manager as being reasonably foreseeable consequences of the permitted event to avoid repetition of past injuries or property damage.

15. If the parade or the assembly set up or dispersal is to be conducted on private property, the applicant must submit with the application proof of the property owner's permission for the property to be used for that purpose.

16. The number and type of sound amplification equipment that will be used in the parade or assembly, if any, indicating the maximum sound-producing power in terms of wattage to be used, the volume in decibels of sound which will be produced, and the approximate distance for which sound will be audible from the sound-amplifying equipment, as well as the electrical generators that will be used, if any."

<u>Section 6.</u> Section 4-3-206, entitled "Nondiscrimination," of Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 4 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows: "4-3-206: NONDISCRIMINATION:

The official designated by the City to act on permit applications shall uniformly consider each application upon its merits and shall not discriminate in granting or denying applications; and, shall not deny any permit based upon political or religious grounds or expressive content reasons.'

Section 7. Section 4-3-210, entitled "Content of Permit," of Article 2 of Chapter 3 of Title 4 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code is hereby amended to add subsection "O" to read as follows, with the remainder of the Section unchanged:

"O. The number and type of electrical generators and sound amplification equipment, indicating the maximum sound-producing power in terms of specific wattage that will be used in the parade or assembly, the volume, in decibels, of sound which will be produced, as well as the approximate distance for which sound will be audible from the sound-amplifying equipment."

Section 8. CEQA. The City Council hereby finds, in the exercise of its independent judgment and analysis, that this ordinance is not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as State CEQA Guidelines Section 15378(b)(5) provides that a project does not include organizational or administrative activities of governments that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment. This ordinance merely amends the City's regulations governing parades and assemblies, and does not allow any new uses of land within the City that would result in direct or indirect physical changes to the environment. In addition, this ordinance is also exempt from the California En-vironmental Quality Act (CEQA) as there is no possibility the proposed ordinance would have a significant impact on the environment pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3). A Notice of Exemption has been prepared and will be filed in accordance with CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.

Section 9. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be considered a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity and enforceability of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 10. Publication. The City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation published and circulated in the City within fifteen 15) days after its passage in accordance with Section 36933 of the Government Code, shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance, and shall cause this Ordinance and this certification, together with proof of publication, to be entered in the Book of Ordinances of the Council of this City.

Section 11. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall go into effect and be in full force and effect at 12:01 a.m. on the thirty-first (31st) day after its passage.

Section 12. Certification. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance.
