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"Beverly Hills Reaches **Agreement Regarding DuPont Clinic Investigation**"

Last week, Councilmember John Mirisch issued a statement against California Attorney General Rob Bonta in the Dupont Clinic case.

John accused Bonta of engaging in "political showmanship'

This was in response to the filing of a "Complaint for Injunctive Relief" by the California Department of Justice and the City acceding to a "Stipulated Judgment."

John wrote: "I have seen no evidence that the Dupont Clinic's failure to open in Beverly Hills was a result of the City's actions or was essentially anything other than a tenant/landlord dispute."

John, a cursory reading of the complaint, clearly demonstrates that your employees and the former mayor BROKE THE LAW. There was no ambiguity.

The City got off easy.

The Attorney General could easily have required that those employees be fired and pensions lost and the former Mayor be barred from public office ever again.

Instead, the City will have to appoint a Reproductive Compliance Officer. The five-year estimate for such compliance could easily approach \$1 million per year.

The settlement of the separate Dupont Clinic lawsuit could easily approach \$10 million, if not \$20 million.

Further, John, the DOJ matter was hidden in the City Council Closed Session agendas for months, transparency be damned. Your constituents were not allowed to weigh-in.

And these same employees, because they were not disciplined by the Council, will feel emboldened to act even more capriciously.

So, John, let's review: bad-acting employees, a hidden DOJ investigation only known by the Council and those employees, and potentially \$25 million lost by a deficit-spending Council.



Stern, Sabag and Stuart Win **Board of Education Race**

In the Beverly Hills Board of Education election Tuesday, initial ballot counts as of Wednesday morning indicate Mandy Stern placed first with 5,543 votes, and will take one of the three open seats.



"I am equally humbled and excited to have won a second term on the school board. I Think we all would agree that the last couple of Months have been tense as we faced the ups and downs of the election roller coaster. This journey has been deeply rewarding, and I am immensely grateful for the trust and support of our Beverly Hills community. With a profound commitment to our students, I am ready to make a lasting and positive impact on their education and future," Sabag said. "Thank you to everyone who voted and believed in my vision for our schools. Your support and dedication to our students mean the world to me, and I am beyond grateful to have you by my side. I look forward to working alongside my fellow board members to create a brighter future for BHUSD, support our students, families, superintendent, teachers, staff and administration, and make our community

Russell Stuart is expected to take the third open seat with 5,337 votes.

"I am incredibly grateful and optimistic about last night's election results. To hold a potential seat on the Beverly Hills School Board is both humbling and inspiring. I want to extend my heartfelt thanks to every voter who believed in our vision and to my amazing team for their hard work and dedication. A special thank you goes to my wife, Lisa, who has been my rock throughout this journey—I couldn't have done it without her unwavering support," Stuart said. "While I'm very pleased with where we stand, I believe it's important to wait until every vote has been counted before fully celebrating. Dela Peykar Ronen came in fourth place with 4,901 votes.

"I want to extend my sincere gratitude to everyone who supported my campaign and believed in our vision. Running in this election has been an incredible experience, and I am so grateful for the connections made and the important conversations sparked. I congratulate the winners. Thank you to everyone who joined me on this journey," Ronen said.

Additional ballots still need to be counted but final results are not expected to change.

Beverly Hills Reaches Agreement Regarding DuPont Clinic Investigation

The City of Beverly Hills and the California Attorney General's Office have finalized a stipulated judgment concerning the planned opening of the DuPont Clinic, a facility that offers elective abortions during the third trimester through 31 weeks and 6 days gestation.

The agreement, which comes after an investigation into the city's involvement in the clinic's opening, contains no admission of wrongdoing by Beverly Hills. Furthermore, under the judgment, the city is free from any fines or penalties, and the judgment cannot be referenced in any future or ongoing legal matters.

"The City cooperated fully with the Attorney General's investigation, and the evidence demonstrated that the city did not interfere with the planned opening of the clinic. The decision to rescind

DuPont Clinic's lease was not made by the City of Beverly Hills. We disagree with the allegations in the Attorney General's complaint," Mayor Les Friedman said.

As part of the stipulated agreement, Beverly Hills will develop training for certain city employees and elected officials to ensure compliance with state and federal laws on reproductive healthcare access.

The City Council voted to accept the stipulated legal judgment, with Councilmember John Mirich voting against. Despite being an advocate for abortion, Mirisch expressed concerns about the Attorney General's decision, arguing that the city was unfairly singled out. He cited the Attorney General's office's inaction in similar cases in other cities, such as Fontana, which he claims has implemented repeated measures to prevent Planned Parenthood from opening a clinic there.

"The Attorney General's silence on Fontana is deafening," Mirisch stated, noting that Fontana's actions impact residents' access to birth control and other services. In contrast, Beverly Hills has multiple clinics providing these services.

Mirisch also criticized the Attorney General's perceived lack of action to address growing concerns of anti-Jewish bias and violence in California, highlighting a rise in incidents on K-12 and college campuses. He characterized this as "political theater" by Attorney General Rob Bonta, suggesting that resources should be focused on protecting reproductive access in underserved areas and addressing the needs of Jewish students and residents facing discrimination.

"You don't have to be Texas or a red state to be a place where reproductive health care is under attack," Bonta said during a press conference last Thursday. "We can't just say this is a somewhere else problem, this is a right here problem. The threat to reproductive freedom is pervasive, even here in California."

The clinic would have been located at

LVMH Submits Legislative Advocate Form

LVMH reportedly plans to establish a massive Louis Vuitton flagship store on Rodeo Drive, stepping away from the previously planned Cheval Blanc hotel.

The company is re-envisioning the property at 468 Rodeo Drive as a retail and lifestyle space, replacing its failed hotel concept, which was narrowly rejected by Beverly Hills voters.

LVMH submitted a legislative advocate form on October 29, through attorney Deborah Quick, seeking approvals for the expansive retail space under various Beverly Hills municipal codes.

This comes after the company purchased the former Brooks Brothers building on the site in 2018 for \$245 million, later winning city approval to build a luxury hotel. However, local opposition, spurred by labor union Unite Here Local 11, ultimately led to a citywide ballot measure that overturned the hotel proposal.

LVMH now aims to create an expansive luxury retail experience across the more than 50,000-square-foot space. Under the leadership of CEO Pietro Beccari, the company is focusing on combining retail with cultural and lifestyle elements.

Howard Hughes of Cumming Management Group and architect Frank Gehry have also filed a legislative advocate form for the project.

HBC Incorporates Community Feedback in Redesign of 9600 Wilshire Project

HBC has submitted updated plans for its 9600 Wilshire project, following discussions with the Beverly Hills community.

One of the changes is a redesign aimed at reducing traffic impacts. According to HBC, the updated plan is projected to lower peak morning traffic by 35% and evening traffic by 15%, addressing one of the community's top concerns. Additionally, the revised plan adds more residential units while adhering to the community's desire to limit density and intensity in the area.

The initial concept for the 9600 Wilshire project was introduced in 2022 to redevelop properties along Wilshire Boulevard with a mix of commercial and residential spaces. This revised proposal "enhances public spaces, substitutes residential use for higher-intensity office space, and prioritizes pedestrian access over vehicular traffic," according to HBC.

The initial proposal, created in partnership with the architects at Marmol Radziner, planned for the restoration of the Saks Fifth Avenue building. This building is set to transform into a boutique hotel featuring a spa, restaurant, and social club, while maintaining the Saks Fifth Avenue women's store at 9570 Wilshire Boulevard. The project initially included two new office buildings along Wilshire Boulevard and a residential buffer of up to 70 apartments to replace surface parking lots.

Based on community feedback, HBC said it adjusted the proposal to replace one planned office building with a residential one, which is intended to reduce traffic and parking demands. Other changes include relocating commercial pickup and drop-off zones to improve public spaces for community use.

"Saks Fifth Avenue has been part of the

Beverly Hills community for over 86 years and is deeply committed to being a part of the community for many more years. That means listening to our neighbors and integrating their feedback into the project," said Douglas Adams, Senior Vice President at Streetworks Development, an affiliate of Saks Fifth Avenue's parent company,

HBC, which is managing the development process.

According to Southwest Homeowners Association President Ken Goldman, the projected five-year construction timeline, with up to 120 construction vehicles accessing the site daily in the early stages, is a major concern. Residents are also troubled by the cumulative impact of several large projects in the area, including proposed buildings up to 19 stories high on South Linden and other projects they feel are oversized and lack sufficient parking.

"Residential space produces substantially less traffic than office space. So that should help. But there will still be increased traffic in the adjacent residential area. And Saks is still planning an almost five-year construction period with the initial months of construction having 120 construction vehicles to-and-from the site a day," Goldman said, adding that all surrounding projects "are ridiculously out-of-code and under-parked."

City Considers New Pedestrian Crossings

The Traffic and Parking Commission will review plans for new pedestrian crossings designed to enhance walkability and safety, at its Thursday meeting.

The commission is set to provide feedback on two proposed locations: Robertson Boulevard at Gregory Way and Olympic Boulevard between Wetherly and Almont Drives

By increasing crossing points, the city hopes to encourage more residents and visitors to walk, improving the overall pedes-

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trian experience.

At a February 2023 meeting, the commission identified several potential crossing locations on arterial and collector streets based on pedestrian activity and traffic data. Locations were ranked into three tiers of priority, with Robertson Boulevard/Gregory Way and Olympic Boulevard mid block section falling into Tier 1, the highest priority level.

The conceptual designs for the crossings feature Pedestrian Hybrid Beacon (PHB) signals, commonly known as "HAWK" signals. HAWK signals are designed for midblock crossings where standard crosswalks mav not provide enough safety due to higher traffic speeds. Activated by pedestri-

ans, the HAWK signal alerts drivers to stop by flashing and solid lights, allowing pedestrians to cross before returning to a dark mode when not in use. This setup is intended to minimize unnecessary interruptions to traffic flow while enhancing pedestrian safety.

The crossing at Gregory Way will use a HAWK signal combined with curb extensions to facilitate safer crossings. A dedicated bicycle pocket and push-button system are also proposed to make left turns easier for cyclists traveling eastbound on Gregory Way.

Traffic and Parking Commission to Discuss Clifton Way Traffic-Calming Project

The City of Beverly Hills is currently assessing the future of a six-month traffic-calming demonstration along Clifton Way, between Robertson and La Cienega Boulevards.

Installed earlier this year as part of the Clifton-Le Doux Corridor Mobility Study, the project aims to reduce vehicle speeds, discourage cut-through traffic, and improve safety for pedestrians and cyclists. The Traffic and Parking Commission is set to review traffic data and survey results from local residents before making a recommendation to the City Council, at its Thursday meeting.

The demonstration project includes traffic circles at key intersections, such as Clifton/Arnaz and Clifton/Le Doux, as well as curb extensions at several intersections, all using temporary materials like painted ar-

eas, flexible bollards, and planters. According to city data, the traffic circles led to a modest reduction in average vehicle speeds and collisions, while curb extensions contributed to increased pedestrian safety by shortening crossing distances.

Community response to these features, however, has been mixed. Of 214 survey participants, 60% expressed interest in keeping the project in some form, although opinions on specific elements varied. While 52% of residents support the traffic circles, citing their ability to slow down traffic and improve safety, others expressed concerns about confusion and congestion, particularly for elderly and disabled drivers. Approximately 51% of respondents expressed disapproval of the curb extensions, citing difficulties in navigating narrower lanes, accessibility challenges, and impacts on street parking.

Traffic data collected before and after the project's installation revealed some positive trends, including a reduction in maximum vehicle speeds from 45-50 mph to 35-40 mph, which could enhance safety for all road users. Traffic volumes in the area showed an overall decrease, with some streets experiencing fewer vehicles, while others saw a slight increase, likely due to natural fluctuations in daily traffic patterns.

However, despite these changes, stop sign compliance among drivers remained inconsistent, and two collisions were reported along Clifton Way since the demonstration began, both unrelated to the traffic-calming devices.

Wilshire/La Cienega Station Progresses Toward 2025 Completion

The Wilshire/La Cienega Metro Station remains on track for completion by fall 2025, according to an update on a city staff report.

Underground crews are installing elevators, escalators, and finishing interior elements. Entrance plaza construction is advancing, while a key access hatch on Wilshire Boulevard, near Tower Drive,

was completed in October to aid in rail testing. The contractor has finished structural work along Wilshire Boulevard's south side, and sidewalk restoration continues, with north side work expected to wrap up by early 2025. Utility upgrades are ongoing, requiring nighttime lane reductions.

Metro has requested to work through the holiday season, which the Beverly Hills City Council will review on November 7, along with a proposed nine-month extension of the N. Cañon Drive closure. Restoration on Wilshire Boulevard is expected to require weekend closures beginning in early 2025.

Residents should plan for temporary lane reductions and periodic road closures as construction progresses.

City to Kickoff Winter 2024 Transportation Safety Campaign

The city has kicked off the 2024 transportation campaign and will promote the winter message "I know the dangerous consequences of driving under the influence."

The city's initiative highlights the impact of DUIs on road safety. Although DUI-related crashes made up only 3% of incidents from 2017 to 2022, they accounted for almost 15% of all severe injuries and fatalities

This fall, residents are urged to reflect on how their choices affect the safety of everyone in Beverly Hills. The campaign also serves as a reminder that responsible celebrations help keep everyone safe during the holidays and beyond.

The city has previously completed various safety campaigns as part of events or projects that focused on transportation. For example, in 2019, city staff produced the Bicycle and Pedestrian Awareness Campaign meant to bring attention to traveling safely as cyclists and pedestrians.

This year's campaign incorporates quarterly messages derived from the calls to action established in the 2023 campaign

Reflecting on the Dodgers' Win

Now that the remarkable 2024 MLB season is over, it is a good time to talk about what we die-hard Dodgers fans have been through during this ultimately triumphant season.

As background, I tuned into major league (sort of) baseball in 1948 and lived and died with the hapless Washington Senators through my primary and secondary school years. "Sort of" refers to the fact that from 1948 through 1960 (when I finished high school and the Senators moved to Minnesota), the Senators never finished higher than fifth in the then eight team American League.

A fictionalized version of the Senators was the subject of the popular musical "Damn Yankees" which debuted in 1955 and was premised on the facts that the Yankees won the American League pennant every year and the Senators were consistently at or near the bottom. But there was a hopeful note in the song "You Gotta Have Heart" – surely you remember: "When your luck is batting zero, get your chin up off the floor..."

For a kid, the Senators' performance (and corresponding lack of fan support) made them very accessible. I could take the streetcar down Georgia Avenue to Griffith Stadium for a dime. Then, if you were under 12 (and I could carry that off well into my teenage years) general admission was free if accompanied by an adult. All I had to do was find a friendly adult who would take me through the turnstiles. So, baseball was absorbed into my genes during formative years. And I must confess, after my baseball upbringing, I feel a bit guilty about replacing the Senators with a team as successful as the Dodgers have been.

Through the next ten years of college, law school and teaching, I paid little attention to baseball.

But in 1969, I moved to Los Angeles and was quickly hooked by the Dodgers. They included **Don Drysdale, Steve Garvey, Willie Davis, Willie Crawford, Wes Parker** and **Don Sutton**. Midway into the season, they acquired **Maury Wills** who grew up in my DC neighborhood. Maury was a great base stealer but we should not overlook the fact that over 15 MLB seasons, Maury hit 20 home runs.

Ever since then, I have lived and died with the Dodgers. In fact, even when the LA Times had a real sports page, I dreaded picking up the Times on mornings after the Dodgers had lost.

So, with that backdrop, we turn to the 2024 Dodgers.

The Dodgers in recent years have had extraordinary success. They had won the Western Division of the National League nine times in the last ten years and had made the playoffs in all ten years. This has been an almost unbelievable history of success with Dave Roberts as their manager since 2016. Yet, they have been a disappointment because they won the World Series in only 2020 and have been knocked out of the playoffs numerous times when expected to do better.

It was supposed to be different in 2024. The Dodgers spent enormously to make it happen. They spent \$1B on three players: Shohei Ohtani, a unique talent as he is arguably the best hitter, the best home run hitter and the best pitcher in MLB; **Yoshinobu Yamamoto**, the best pitcher from Japan's very high level major league; and Orange County's **Tyler Glasnow**, who was expected to be the "ace" of the staff.

Now I digress to discuss the downside of this largesse. The Dodgers have been a commercial success since they moved to Los Angeles from Brooklyn in 1958. In 2017, 2018, 2019, 2022, 2023 and 2024 attendance at Dodger Stadium has been nearly 4m, nearly double the MLB average. In 2008, they drew the most fans to see a major league baseball game,115,300 to an exhibition game against the Boston Red Sox in the LA Coliseum (where the Dodgers had played from 1958-61 while Dodger Stadium was being constructed). I was there - what a lousy place for a baseball game with the left field fence only 250 feet from home plate compared with a more normal of 330 feet at Dodger Stadium.

Coupled with this box office success is a very high player payroll. Because the Dodgers draw so well no matter what and have spent so much, attending a Dodger game is both very expensive and a logistical nightmare. Box seats can range in price from \$1000 to \$10,000 or more. Unreserved general parking costs \$50. As a practical matter, the only way to get to the stadium is by car and the congestion getting in and getting out is horrendous. And the Dodgers don't seem to care as almost every game is a sell out or close. Remember what I said above about the Senators games being accessible? Not so for Dodgers games. I rarely attend in person. Home television is much

better with far less brain damage.

Now, let's go Back to the

Now, let's go Back to th 2024 season.

With the acquisition of the three superstars mentioned above added to the superstars already on the roster including Mookie Betts, Freddy Freeman and Clayton Kershaw and numerous mere stars, the Dodgers had seemingly put to-

gether an offensive powerhouse. And they had as the Dodgers led MLB in many categories and outscored their opponents by more runs than any other MLB team. They had also put together a great group of starting pitchers – or so we thought.

During the regular season, the Dodgers were very successful and had the best record of all MLB teams, mainly on the backs of the offensive stars and unusually good relief pitchers.

But then we got to the playoffs. For the playoffs, which start at best two games out of three, then progress to three out of five and then four out of seven, starting pitching is a key. To be successful, a team needs at least three but preferably four or five front line pitchers. But the Dodgers' starting pitchers were, without exception, snake bit by injuries that kept them off the field for extended periods or for the entire season. It was known going in that Shohei Ohtani would not be able to pitch in 2024 because of a serious injury sustained in the 2023 season, the injuries to eight other starting pitchers, most of whom were out for the season once they had sustained injuries, was not known.

For most of the season, the Dodgers did well and seemingly effortlessly led the league so there was little emotional stress. But then came the playoffs which brought a whole new world of emotional stress.

Success in the playoffs, which involves only the very best teams, requires a strong offense, three or four outstanding starting pitchers and a group of strong relief pitchers.

The Dodgers' starting pitching was a mess – at least seven of the best Dodger starting pitchers were not able to play due to injury. So the Dodgers headed to the playoffs knowing that their fate would depend upon how well the offense and the relief pitchers performed.

Because of their outstanding record, the Dodgers had a bye and did not have to play in the first round. But then came the second round, the National League Division Series where they would meet their arch rivals from 120 miles south, the San Diego Padres.

This was not a good thing. The Padres had beaten the Dodgers in a majority of the games they played during the regular season. Knowledgeable baseball experts believed that the Padres were the best team in the National League. The Padres' expressed goal

was to beat the "big brother" Dodgers from up the I-5 freeway. And their biggest stars could not resist talking about how they would do it.

After the first three games of a best of five series, the Padres were up two games to one. We had hit almost bottom and it appeared that the Dodgers once again would have an early exit from the playoffs. To fight off despair, we had to rely on the sentence attributed to **Yogi Berra**: "It ain't over 'til it's over' but things looked bleak as the Dodgers had to use only relief pitchers for game 4 because they were out of starting pitchers.

Dodgers fans were prepared to say once again: "Wait 'til next year!"

But somehow a combination of eight relief pitchers shut out the Padres 8-0. We went into the deciding game 5. The Padres starting pitcher was **Yu Darvish**; the Dodgers starting pitcher was **Yoshinobu Yamamoto**. Both were Japanese born. Interest in Japan was so high that 8M more people watched the game in Japan than in the US. On solo homeruns by **Teoscar Hernandez** and **Kike Hernandez** (no relation) the Dodgers knocked the Padres out of the playoffs 2-0.

For that alone, to me the season would have been a success but there was more, much more to come.

Now all the Dodgers had to do was beat the Mets to bring about a dream Dodgers-Yankees World Series. And the Dodgers did, four games to two.

On Friday October 25, the Dodgers and Yankees met in the first game of the World Series. It was the 12th time that the Dodgers and Yankees have met in the World Series. Among the players there were numerous Southern California connections. Starting pitchers for game one were Dodgers' Jack Flaherty from Harvard-Westlake High School against Yankee Gerrit Cole from Orange Lutheran High and UCLA. Yankee Manager Aaron Boone was from Villa Park High School and USC; Dodgers Manager Dave Roberts was from UCLA; Roberts and Boone played for their schools against each other. The Dodgers won, 6-3, on Freddy Freeman's walk off grand slam home run in the bottom of the 10th inning. It was the best game that I had ever seen.

Best of all, I went with Nick who was generous enough to buy an outrageously expensive excellent ticket for his dad. Nick's first World Series memory was attending the 1981 Yankees – Dodgers Series. Now, we attend a Series when I am 81.

After that the Dodgers four games to two victory over the Yankees was almost anticlimactic.

I am a happy camper. And all that I can say is: Wait 'til next year – the Dodgers will be even better.

COVERSTORY TAKE YOUR SPOUSE TO WORK DAY

The Husband-and-Wife Duo: Sinai Temple Rabbis Erez Sherman and Nicole Guzik

They say you should never work with your spouse. How do you two make it work?

Erez: I think a big theme of what we do is to model family and community. The way we model family to our children at home is different from how we model family to our members and those who are part of our Sinai family. What we love to do in our lives [aligns] with what we love to do in our synagogue, [blending] our personal passions with our professional [roles].

Nicole: I also think our personalities are so different and that also dictates which areas of the synagogue we focus on. [For instance], Erez is a connector; [he often brings] in different speakers, authors, or athletes. [Meanwhile], I might focus on understanding the synagogue's mission, [considering] how the smaller components fit together into the larger picture. Our differing personalities [complement] each other well in [our roles.]

What makes the Sinai congregation unique?

Nicole: One is the diverse nature of the Sinai family. You can walk into Sinai and [encounter a variety of backgrounds]; you might be someone who is Ashkenazi or Persian, Cuban or a Mexican Jew.

Erez: Jew by birth and a Jew by choice. It's truly beautiful.

Nicole: The Jewish world is incredibly diverse. When you walk in on a Shabbat morning, you'll likely see upwards of 800 people, and it's remarkable to witness the diversity of Judaism within one sanctuary.

That's one aspect that makes Sinai Temple special. I think another important piece is that Sinai is all about saying 'yes'. For example, we recently shut down Holmby Avenue, which is directly adjacent to Sinai Temple, to host a huge Simchat Torah. This [event served] both as a memorial and a recognition of what occurred on October 7th, [while also] celebrating the continuation of Jewish life.

Erez: I think this ties into our theme for the year, which is "Proud to Be Jewish." This theme is inspired by a phrase from Daniel Pearl's last words, "I am a Jew," and we use that as inspiration to express our pride in what we stand for. One of our [core] values is our [commitment] to our people and the land of Israel, a [belief] we held well before October 7th. It feels natural for us to lead for our community members, as well as for those in Los Angeles and nationally.

Would you say your Persian congregants are more culturally conservative?

Nicole: I think that across the board, if you come to Sinai Temple, you will find very committed and dedicated Jews. If you ask a typical Sinai Temple congregant, regardless of their ethnic background, they will likely be celebrating Shabbat dinner that night. Often, Shabbat morning is a part of their weekly ritual. This is a community that is deeply committed to ritual, culture, and theology, which is one of the reasons why the two of us have wanted to be rabbis here for so long.

How did you two meet?

Erez: I'm from upstate New York, specifically Syracuse, and I went to Columbia University. We met in New York while attending rabbinical school at the Jewish Theological Seminary of America, but we didn't start dating until we spent a year in Jerusalem in 2007.

She was working at an amazing congregation under the leadership of Rabbi David Wolpe. We were both passionate about being in the field and doing the same work.

Nicole: After a [brief] breakup—just one day—we realized we couldn't ignore each other, even though we tried but that did not last even for 23 hours. We [decided to commit to making] it work. We are very dedicated to upholding each other's dreams and how those dreams will manifest and change over the years.

We both wanted to have pulpits, which can be challenging for two rabbis married to each other. I'm a native Californian, so I took the [initiative] to set up an itinerary to meet every possible rabbi or Jewish leader in Southern California during a five-day trip.

Erez: The rabbis gave us a shot. They saw potential individually as well as in a unit.

Fast forward to 2014; by then, we had two children. I was in the Valley. Rabbi Wolpe said, "Wouldn't it be interesting to have a model where two rabbis lead a synagogue together?" He took a risk by [giving us the opportunity] to do this, and we have been doing this for about ten years now.

Erez, tell us about your podcast "Rabbi On The Sidelines."

Being from Syracuse, New York, I grew up with a love for basketball. My dad, who is also a rabbi, taught me that you can embrace both sports and faith.

In 2020, when COVID hit and there

was no programming in the synagogue, I thought about who I knew that might have interesting stories that I'd never seen on TV. I began connecting with sportscasters, athletes, coaches, managers, owners, and super fans. Instead of focusing on the [usual topics] like box scores or trade deadlines, I asked them about what was in their heart and soul —they told me stories that were hard to believe and truly amazing.

I asked Rabbi Wolpe if he was okay with a Rabbi doing sports. And he said, "One day, there's going to be a need for that voice in that space."

When anti-Semitism began to rise in the sports world, ESPN and people inside the NBA were discussing these issues and

they called on me to provide insight as a

I was able to use my voice to address not just sports but also the need to bring communities together.

Nicole, you launched the Sinai Temple Mental Health Center in August 2021. Tell us about that.

It all goes back to Rabbi Wolpe. I remember sitting with him, expressing my frustration about the [limitations I faced] when [speaking with congregants]. I often felt I could dive deeper into conversations, but it didn't feel appropriate since I wasn't a therapist. Rabbi Wolpe looked at me and asked, "So why don't you become a therapist?"

This happened during COVID, which made the timing and need more significant

I did an internship at the Maple Counseling Center, which was a fantastic place for my internship. I earned my master's degree and became a marriage and family therapist.

Through that, along the same lines, we are always asking how we bridge our professional development and passions into synagogue life. This is when the Sinai Temple Mental Health Center was born.

During COVID, when we were seeing increased feelings of isolation and loneliness, we [recognized the urgent need for mental health support.]

We hired a full-time licensed social

worker named Carolyn Hoffman, who has become a phenomenal asset to both our community and staff. She is fully accessible to everyone, including our religious school teachers and administrative staff. Whether someone is experiencing a depressive episode or seeking marital counseling, she is here to help. She has become part of the fabric of our temple community, and people have come to trust her.

I also offer premarital counseling for couples. This has brought me so much fulfillment, allowing me to bridge both pieces of my two worlds.

What advice has Rabbi David Wolpe given you?

Nicole: First of all, he gives us advice all the time. I feel so lucky that he continues to be a friend, mentor, and rabbi to us. He consistently offers us guidance whenever we seek it, and we feel blessed to have that relationship.

Erez: As for the value of being in this community, he would always look out into the congregation and express how it is a true privilege to lead this community and to do the work we do because of the people we serve. Whether it's about Israel, social action, mental health, sports, or entertainment, we are so diverse in those ways too.

In his way of preaching, we learned under the best and we hope to live up to that model as well.

What's something each of you has learned from the other while working together?

Erez: Nicole is a dreamer, but she turns those ideas into reality. When I have ideas of things she's [helped] to step back and figure out how to actually make them happen. For instance, [she helped me connect] my interviews with people in the sports world and their faith journeys. So, learning how to bring those dreams into a structured reality.

Nicole: What I've learned from Erez is how different we are in terms of socializing with people. I used to think I was an extrovert until I met him, and then I realized what the true definition of an extrovert is. He has more fun off the bimah than on it. Even during Rosh Hashanah services, he's connecting and schmoozing with congregant after congregant.

This dynamic isn't just within the congregation. If you look at his text messages and emails, you'll see that he's connected with people he's known throughout his life, over the last 40 years. He's like a living version of the game Jewish geography, and it's such a benefit. What he teaches me is that, in a world where we're increasingly isolating ourselves and erecting walls between different stages of our lives—like saying, "Oh, that was elementary school," or "I haven't spoken to those college friends in 20 years"—Erez shows the value of keeping in touch and deepening roots.

The stories I can share about maintaining relationships for over 40 years are miraculous. So, I'm learning to be a better connector myself.

BHHS First-Year Football Coach To Return For 2025 Season

Beverly High football coach Hasan Muhammad said in an interview Wednesday that he told his players last week he would return for a second season.

"The number one question for them is, 'Coach, are you coming back next year?" Muhammad said. "So I wanted to ease their attention in that regard, for sure, we are coming back and we're eager to do the

"I think that it was important for the kids to hear that" because of the "high turnover" in the position, Muhammad

Muhammad is the program's sixth coach since 2013, including Tim Ellis, the Beverly Hills Unified School District's executive director of athletics, who served as interim coach in 2023, because Frank Lenoard, who had been hired as coach after the resignation of Marquis Bowling, did not have the proper credentials.

Only one coach during that span coached as many as three seasons - Charlie Stansbury, the coach from 2013 through 2015. The Normans have not won more than three games in a season since 2010 under Donald Paysinger, the most recent time they reached the Southern Section play-

The Normans were 3-7 in Muhammad's first season, winning their first two games, the first time they had accomplished that feat since 2010, lost their next seven and ended the season with a forfeit victory over Morningside because of the Monarchs' lack of players.

"The season was a season of growth," Muhammad said. "We had to kind of do some evaluation and see where we really are as a program. We gauged the interest and everything else.

"I feel like the interest is very high from our kids and now I think that the work is on us as adults, on a kind of build it out for them, so that they can have an opportunity to have success.

Muhammad said his hopes for the future include having middle school students "who want to pursue football" come to Beverly High "at least two or three days a week ... and get those needs met, just like a soccer (player) or anyone else."

Muhammad said he would also like to conduct tackling clinics and, as part of a "five-year plan" have a Pop Warner youth football program.

Ellis, who has been in his position since August 2018, said, "We are very fortunate that we have coach Muhammad leading our program. For the first time since I have been here, we will have a serious off-season program."
