City Council Approves Nine Month Extension of Cañon Drive Closure

The City Council approved a nine-month extension for the temporary closure of North Cañon Drive at Wilshire Boulevard. The closure, now extended until September 30, 2025, allows the city to maintain safety measures and control construction impacts from the Metro Purple Line Extension Project.

Originally enacted in 2018 to manage construction-related issues, the closure has been extended multiple times as construction progressed. A sound wall featuring a mural by artist Tomokazu Matsuyama stands across North Cañon Drive, helping to reduce noise, dust, and traffic disruptions. City officials believe this setup ensures safe, uninterrupted access to local businesses along North Cañon Drive and maintains a buffer against the heavy construction activity nearby.

In 2025, Metro intends to tackle major projects, including removing deck panels and restoring Wilshire Boulevard, which will involve multiple full weekend closures and weekday lane reductions. Traffic studies will be conducted, and additional precautions taken to mitigate the impact on local businesses and pedestrian access.

City staff and Metro representatives will continue to provide regular updates to the community on construction timelines and any changes in traffic management.

Beverly Hills Considers Replacing Aging Ficus Trees on South Santa Monica Boulevard

The City of Beverly Hills is reviewing options to replace aging Ficus trees on the 9800-9900 blocks of South Santa Monica

BHEF Holds 4th Annual "Poker at Fred's"

The Beverly Hills Education Foundation (BHEF) hosted the fourth annual "Poker at Fred's" tournament and auction on November 7 at the home of BHEF Board Members Azy and Fred Farahmand.

Boulevard due to infrastructure damage caused by the trees' extensive root systems. The Public Works Commission is expected to provide input on a new phase of the Street Tree Master Plan to select a suitable replacement tree, at its Thursday meeting.

The Ficus trees on South Santa Monica Boulevard date back at least 65 years, with initial plantings noted in a 1963 city document detailing previous street tree plans from 1944 and 1957. Over the years, conflicts between the Ficus trees' roots and public infrastructure have led to frequent sidewalk repairs, which have sometimes required root cutting. These repairs have diminished the health and stability of the trees, prompting the removal of approximately 45% of the Ficus trees on these blocks.

In 2000-2001, a major sidewalk project removed 66 Ficus trees between South Crescent Drive and Wilshire Boulevard, where Mexican Fan Palms were

selected as replacements due to limited space in tree wells.

The narrow setback area, which averages about 10 feet from building facades to the street, poses challenges for selecting replacement trees with large crowns, as they may block storefront signage, interfere with canopies, and cause damage to buildings, according to a city staff report. Hardwood canopy trees, while preferable for shade, are less compatible with these narrow growth spaces and could obstruct pedestrian travel.

Given these constraints, the commission is expected to consider a continuation of the Mexican Fan Palm theme already planted along adjacent stretches of South Santa Monica Boulevard. Although palms provide minimal canopy cover, they meet the criteria established by the Public Works Com-

mission, including suitability for limited growth space, drought tolerance, and minimal maintenance costs.

To change the tree type from the Ficus, a new phase of the Street Tree Master Plan is required, along with a process where over 50% of affected property owners must respond for any recommendation to move forward. Staff plans to consult with the Public Works Commission, present ballot options to residents and businesses, and bring back results for final consideration early next year.

City Council Approves ADU Ordinance to Increase Housing Options

On November 7, the City Council approved an ordinance to amend accessory dwelling unit (ADU) regulations, specifically for multi-family residences and large single-family properties. The ordinance seeks to encourage ADU construction, adding flexibility to design standards and creating new housing options aligned with the city's 2021-2029 Housing Element goals.

The ordinance updates ADU standards, allowing larger units, higher structures, and streamlined setback requirements for properties adjoining alleys. These adjustments will simplify building options, enabling more creative use of space and facilitating construction of ADUs above existing garages. Additionally, the ordinance allows for inward-facing balconies on ADUs to provide residents with outdoor space while preserving the privacy of neighboring properties.

Under the new ordinance, owners of single-family properties with a lot area of at least 13,000 square feet may add one extra ADU beyond state requirements if one unit

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is designated as a rental with a one-year minimum lease term. This incentive aims to expand rental housing opportunities, particularly in areas of Beverly Hills known for larger lots and lower-density housing, thereby supporting fair housing goals.

ADUs have been increasingly promoted statewide as a solution to the housing shortage. Since 2016, California legislation has encouraged ADU construction by easing local barriers and mandating streamlined approval processes. As part of the Beverly Hills Housing Element's Implementation Program, the city has been directed to ease restrictions on multi-family ADU construction and incentivize rental ADUs on large single-family properties.

Beverly Hills to Consider Plans for New Retail Conversion on North Roxbury Drive

The Planning Commission is expected to review a proposal at its Thursday meeting to convert part of the ground floor of a parking structure at 450 North Roxbury Drive into retail space. This change would require amending the city's general plan and zoning codes, which currently limit floor area ratio within the Business Triangle. If approved, the project would add 6,797 square feet of retail space to the area, increasing the building's FAR from 2.65 to 2.84.

The property features a 10-story office building with an attached parking garage built in 1970. The proposed plan focuses on converting 29 parking spaces on the ground floor of the garage into retail space while maintaining overall parking capacity. The project also aligns with recent changes in California law, specifically AB 2097, which removes minimum parking requirements for projects within a half-mile of major transit stops. This legislation affects 450 North Roxbury Drive, located near major bus routes and the future Metro D Line station at Wilshire/Rodeo, so additional parking will not be mandated.

To support the development, city staff conducted a parking study in collaboration with the Parking Services Division, indicating nearby public parking structures can accommodate increased demand if needed.

While the site's structures, built in a modern interpretation of the Corporate International style, date back over 50 years, they do not qualify as historic landmarks under state or federal criteria.

City to Reevaluate Red Ironbark Trees on Willaman Drive Following Resident Concerns

Ironbark (Eucalyptus sideroxylon) trees on Willaman Drive, at its Thursday meeting. City staff is evaluating the potential development of a Street Tree Master Plan phase to address issues surrounding these trees, which have faced increasing complaints from local residents due to insect infestations, sap leaks, and other challenges. In response, residents have formally petitioned to replace the trees, prompting the city to reconsider their continued use on the street.

Initially, Arizona Ash trees lined Willaman Drive, but they struggled with wooly aphid infestations that spread across other city trees. To curb pest problems, Beverly Hills adopted the 1996 Street Tree Master

Plan, which increased tree species diversity across 28 streets. Red Ironbark was selected as a replacement for the Arizona Ash on Willaman Drive, but issues have persisted. Now 27 years old, many of these trees have required replacement due to wind damage and poor establishment, and Red Ironbark sap leaks and pest problems have affected residents and properties

In May and September, residents from both North and South Willaman met with city staff to discuss their dissatisfaction with the trees, citing ongoing insect problems and sap drips that impact cars, sidewalks, and properties. In response, the city held an on-site meeting in October to assess the trees' conditions and explore solutions.

The commission is expected to consider replacing the trees, with possible new tree options presented to residents for input.

A final decision is expected in early 2025.

Planning Commission to Discuss Decarbonization, Water Conservation, and Wildfire Resilience in Climate Action Plan

As part of its comprehensive Climate Action and Adaptation Plan (CAAP), Beverly Hills is considering measures aimed at reducing greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions. At a recent meeting, staff recommended the Planning Commission focus on adopting specific reach codes for new construction, water conservation measures, and a home hardening program to protect against wild-fires, according to a city staff report.

At its Thursday meeting, the Planning Commission is expected to discuss adopting a reach code to decarbonize new and substantially remodeled buildings and water

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conservation measures as the primary greenhouse gas (GHG) mitigation measures.

Reach codes, which exceed California's current building requirements, will drive new construction toward all-electric models, increase EV charger availability, and boost overall energy efficiency. Beverly Hills will partner with the Clean Power Alliance to help craft these reach codes, making use of their expertise in developing model ordinances for building electrification, according to a city staff report. The Planning Commission will also emphasize water conservation strategies, which include stricter landscaping standards, increased use of rainwater capture and alternative irrigation sources, and promoting "water-neutral" development that uses no more water than the structures it replaces.

Beverly Hills Police Awarded a \$100,000 Traffic Safety Grant

The Beverly Hills Police Department (BHPD) announced that it received a \$100,000 grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) to support its ongoing enforcement and education programs to reduce serious injuries and fatalities on local roads. The grant program will run through September 2025.

"We are grateful to receive this grant, which will strengthen our traffic enforcement efforts and improve road safety," said Beverly Hills Police Chief Mark Stainbrook. "By increasing enforcement of traffic laws and focusing on high-risk areas, we aim to reduce dangerous driving behaviors, prevent crashes, and make our roads safer for everyone."

The grant will fund several additional programs and resources, including:

- •DUI checkpoints and patrols targeting suspected impaired drivers.
- •High visibility distracted driving enforcement operations target drivers violating California's hands- free cell phone law.
- •Enforcement operations focused on dangerous driving behaviors that threaten the safety of bicyclists and pedestrians.
- •Enforcement operations targeting the top

crash-causing violations: speeding, failure to yield, stop sign and red-light running, and improper turning or lane changes.

- •Community presentations on traffic safety topics such as distracted driving, impaired driving, speeding, and bicycle and pedestrian safety.
- •Officer training and recertification for the Standard Field Sobriety Test (SFST), Advanced Roadside Impaired Driving Enforcement (ARIDE), and Drug Recognition Expert (DRE) programs.

This program was funded by a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety through the National Highway Traffic Safetv Administration.

Apathy about BHUSD

I have been concerned for some time about the surprising relatively disappointing rankings of BHUSD schools and the apparent lack of interest in the community about the race for three open seats on the Board of Education.

Consequently, I decided to attempt to explore the reasons for the troublesome apathy of many residents. A few weeks ago, I sent the following memo to approximately thirty engaged City residents:

"I am writing a column that will explore the reasons for the apparent lack of interest in the current campaign for election to the BHUSD Board of Education. Three open seats are contested by only four candidates. Unfortunately, there has been only one forum for the candidates and questions at that forum were limited to students. The campaign events have often been poorly attended. I am interested in your thoughts as to the reasons for this."

I was pleased to receive thoughtful and insightful responses from most of the recipients

It is fair to note that reluctance to serve on local school boards is not unique to Beverly HIlls. I reviewed a report that stated that in 56% of the public school districts which had races for positions on school boards, there were no elections either because there were either no candidates or the number of candidates did not exceed the open positions.

That fact did not diminish my alarm about the situation in our city or my enthusiasm for trying to identify the causes and potential solutions.

Toward this end, I shall report on what our residents said. As most requested anonymity, I will report on the substance of the comments without attribution, and then offer my thoughts about the issues and how to address them

The following is a summary of some of the contributions that I received:

• There is no pursuit of excellence – the

reputation and ranking of our schools have markedly deteriorated over time.

- Schools are irrelevant to too many res-
- Elections can be very nasty; smear campaigns are too prevalent.
- BHUSD offers no commissions or programs like Team Beverly Hills to train, recruit future leaders; PTA or BHEF are not enough.
- We have an aging population; schools are not perceived to have an impact on property values.
- · Sense of pride in Police or Fire Departments does not extend to schools.
- · Grade inflation results in a lack of effort to achieve academic success. Some parents do not push their children to achieve academic excellence.
- · Board members have their own personal agendas that distract from focus on pursuit of academic excellence

Recent board members have been reluctant to rock the boat or ruffle feathers. Like minded people are chosen to be on committees.

- · Board members defer unduly to the Superintendent and other administrators who typically adhere to the status quo and recite impediments to change rather than look for creative solutions
- · National politics and international issues such as the conflict in the Middle East have been very distracting
- Too much grade inflation can create a false perception of high achievement
- City Council should demand better
- Residents have lost hope that schools will improve
- Too many students go to private schools
- There were no public forums during the campaign that would have allowed for discussion of the important issues

What should we make of these wide-ranging and disturbing thoughts?

First, we must acknowledge that, for the most part, these comments are true.

It is clear that our schools are no longer a shining gem of the community. Worse, not

many residents seem to care.

Once, residents took pride in our outstanding schools that attracted young families whose priority was a strong education of their children. Residents who had no children viewed outstanding schools as central to the City's reputation and property values. This does not seem to be the case any longer.

Consequently, many of our residents who do not have children in the schools, have no particular interest in

investing the time and being exposed to the pressure that participation in the Board of Education demands

The widespread unwillingness to serve on the Board of Education stems from a perception that it is a thankless and time consuming quest for solutions to intractable problems.

There is no question that important public service is time-consuming but there have in the recent past been no shortage of residents willing to invest time in efforts to improve our city. Similarly there can be no debate about the importance of our schools to our city as they are one of three pillars (police and fire protection are the others) that define our city. Further, intractable problems can be solved.

What can be done?

We now have a Board of Education with two newcomers and many challenges.By far the most important challenge is to improve the academic quality of our schools. This must be the focus of the Board.

While the implementation of improvements must be the province of school administrators and educators, the Board must demand that improvement and provide for real and transparent accountability.

I have previously outlined a process as

- Setting aggressive but achievable priority objectives;
- Adopting performance objective metrics such as improvement of State proficiency test scores (and comparison of those scores with classroom grades) and/or graduation rates and/ or enrollment in AP classes and/or performance on AP exams; and
- Assigning specific responsibility for achievement of each objective to an identified person or persons.

This process for the 2025-26 academic year should start now as soon as the new Board takes office and be completed and

published no later than next April. In recent years, the School District has published so-called "Strategic Plans" only shortly before the commencement of the academic year in August. Not only have these "Plans" consisted largely of platitudinous jargon, but also their suggestions, such as they are, come much too late for implementation.

As part of this process, at the conclusion of the academic year we should hold those responsible accountable for achievement, or lack thereof, and, where appropriate, develop an action plan for corrective mea-

In addition, I have two other suggestions. First, recognizing the importance of parents to their children's education, I recommend that the board members increase the already substantial efforts to reach out to parents and other community members to get ideas and promote their involvement with the schools. For example, each board member should create opportunities to engage individually. A booth at the Farmer's Market and parks could be useful.

Second, declining enrollment often results in an inability to offer the widest range of educational programs. For example, an expansion of the current Permit program from the existing program for grandchildren of Beverly Hills to children of relatives of Beverly Hills residents could help enroll high quality students. If we cannot accommodate more students at the elementary school level, we could target middle or high school students. Additional students could result in an ability to offer additional programs.

We should have a reasonable limit on Permit students. Because BHUSD is a "basic aid" district, we do not get additional funding for additional students. There is a limit on the number of additional students that the District could accommodate without compromising individual attention. An increase from the current cap of 100 to 250 or 300 strikes me as reasonable.

I believe that the implementation of meaningful academic improvements could create a renewed sense of excitement about public education in the City. This is now in the hands of the newly constituted Board of Education. If this can be accomplished or at least if the Board can make meaningful steps in the right direction, apathy could be relegated to the rear view mirror.

Concerns For Campus Safety Clash With Student Free Speech Rights. But Did They Make the Right Call?

In response to a pro-Trump demonstration at Beverly High, school administrators

have decided to limit students' ability to assemble in large groups, aiming to reduce disruptions and maintain a "safe environment". Principal Drew Stewart issued a statement informing the school community that students would no longer be allowed to "congregate, circle up, shout, jump, etc."

The restriction folerings on campus, sparked by the recent presidential election results. A video of

the rallies, which went viral on TikTok, showed large groups of students cheering, dancing, and holding Trump banners.

In his message, Stewart explained that while students still have the right to express

> their views individually, they would be restricted from assembling in ways that disrupt school activities or make other students feel uncomfortable.

> Superintendent Michael Bregy supported the decision, stressing the importance of balancing freedom of expression with maintaining a "safe and supportive environ-

"We value students" freedom of expression and encourage respectful civic engagement,

always prioritizing the safety and well-being of our community," Bregy said.

The district's commitment, he said, re-

mains focused on fostering respectful dialogue, helping students understand the balance between free expression and responsibility.

"This moment serves as an important learning opportunity for students to understand the balance between expression and responsibility within a school setting," he added.

The Highlights editorial board, which is the student newspaper, released a statement condemning the actions of their fellow students, claiming that "students who treated such an important moment in our country's history as a joke are undermining the real world consequences of" the election. They also added that it "is a shame that an environment which elevates and normalizes this behavior has been created in our country."

First Amendment attorney Douglas Mirell criticized the school's approach, calling the restrictions "wildly overbroad."

Mirell explained that under California's Education Code, public high school students have First Amendment rights, including the right to peaceful assembly, and restrictions can only be imposed in cases of "clear and present danger," violation of lawful school regulations, or "substantial disruption of the orderly operation of the school."

"The punishment here does not fit the crime," Mirell noted, adding that First Amendment protections allow for reasonable "time, place, and manner" restrictions, but that such sweeping prohibitions would likely be deemed overly vague and broad.

Mirell also pointed to Education Code

sections 48907 and 48950, which guarantee public high school students the right to wear badges or insignia of their choice, including political flags and banners. He suggested that while banning flag poles for safety might be a reasonable restriction, an outright ban on flags or banners would exceed reasonable limits, especially if selectively enforced.

This new policy, according to Mirell, risks undermining student rights without clear justification. He also noted that the school could have focused on disciplinary actions for any specific rule violations by individuals, rather than implementing restrictions affecting the entire student body.

He further stated, "No court would uphold that. It's vague and overbroad, which are typically fatal flaws when attempting to impose intentional restrictions on First Amendment rights."

Mirell is an entertainment litigator with a focus on First Amendment rights and intellectual property law. His career includes handling high-profile cases, contributing to legislative initiatives, and advising on issues in media, privacy, and constitutional

Instead of a broad policy, Mirell argued, "The law already exists that allows for discipline to be imposed on those individuals, but taking the next step to create a whole new set of rules and regulations that are as vague and [expansive as this]—rules that preclude people from congregating, gathering, or even jumping-well, that's a bridge too far from a First Amendment perspective."

ORDINANCE NO. 24-0-2902

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS TO AMEND THE BEVERLY HILLS MUNICIPAL CODE TO REVISE OCCUPANCY PRIORITY STANDARDS FOR ELIGIBLE AFFORDABLE HOUSING UNITS, ADD A DEFINITION OF DISPLACEMENT, AND FINDING THE ORDINANCE TO BE EXEMPT UNDER THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA)

WHEREAS, the City of Beverly Hills ("City") desires to amend regulations in the Beverly Hills Municipal Code ("BHMC") regarding priorities utilized to establish the order in which income restricted housing units will be offered to qualifying households, and include a definition of displacement from existing housing;

WHEREAS, on September 12, 2024, the Planning Commission held a duly noticed public hearing and which it adopted Resolution No. 2068 recommending that the City Council amend Article 15.2 (Residential Density Bonus) and Article 48 (Inclusionary Housing Requirements for Residential Development) of Chapter 3 (Zoning) of Title 10 (Planning and Zoning) of the BHMC addressing priority standards to be utilized to establish the order in which income restricted housing units will be offered to qualifying households, taking into account state law requirements, reducing the number of occupancy priority tiers, include a tier prioritizing individuals who work in the city; and to add a definition of displacement and provide a consistent time limit for Tier 2 which households are considered displaced (collectively, the "Amendments"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council considered the Ordinance on October 10, 2024, at a duly noticed public hearing, as prescribed by law, at which time City staff presented the matter, and interested persons had an opportunity to and did testify either in support or against the ordinance. Following the public hearing, the City Council considered the entire record of information received at the public hearing before the City Council.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEVER-LY HILLS HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS: Section 1. The City Council finds that the adoption of this Ordinance is consistent with the General Plan because it fulfills the following General Plan and Housing Element Goals and Policies:

•H2 Housing Supply and Diversity. Provide a variety of housing types and adequate affordable housing supply

•H 2.2 Inclusionary Housing. Continue to implement an inclusionary housing program to integrate affordable units within market rate developments, and increase the availability of affordable housing throughout the community. (Imp. 10.2)

•H 2.9 Jobs-Housing Balance. Promote programs seeking to provide housing opportunities for people who work in the City as a means of reducing long commutes, easing local traffic, improving air quality and helping to achieve a balanced regional jobs-housing distribution for the western portion of Los Angeles County. (lmp. 10.6)

•H 2.10 Workforce Housing. Study and develop programs to increase the amount of rental and ownership housing affordable to the local workforce. (Imp. 10.3, 10.4)

•H 3 Fair Housing and Special Needs Residents. Promote equal housing opportunities for all residents; including Beverly Hills' special needs populations, so residents have a choice of appropriate housing.

•H 3.1 Affirmatively Further Fair Housing Practices. Promote fair housing and non-discrimination in the sale and rental of housing by coordinating with organizations that provide information, counseling and mediation on fair housing laws and landlord-tenant disputes. (lmp. 11.1)

Section 2. Section 10-3-1528 (Occupancy Priority) of Article 15.2 (Residential Density Bonus) of Chapter 3 (Zoning) of Title 10 (Planning and Zoning) of the BHMC is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

"10-3-1528: OCCUPANCY PRIORITY:

A. Income restricted affordable housing units shall be offered to households meeting the income qualification and other occupancy requirements, in the order established by the following priority tiers:

1. Tier 1 - Existing occupants of protected units, as defined in Government Code Section 66300.5(h) as it may be amended from time to time, who are lower-income households on a project site and who are displaced by a new development on the same site and are exercising a right of first refusal for a comparable unit in the new housing development, or in any required replacement units associated with a new development that is not a housing development, pursuant to Government Code Section 66300.6(b)(4)(B), as amended from time to time.

2. Tier 2 - Households displaced from a property within the City of Beverly Hills in the past ten years in the following order:

i. Senior households (62 years and older)

ii. Households with student(s) in 10th grade or lower enrolled in the Beverly Hills Unified School District

iii. Other displaced households

3. Tier $\bf 3$ - Senior Households (62 years and older).

4. Tier 4 - Individuals employed full-time by a public or private entity located and operating in the City of Beverly Hills, and whose primary work location is located within the City of Beverly Hills. For purposes of this section, full-time employment is defined as a minimum average of 130 hours of service per calendar month over a six month period.

5. For purposes of this section, displacement or displaced shall be defined as when persons have permanently vacated their primary housing unit in the City, or are at risk of having to permanently vacate their primary housing unit within the City of Beverly Hills as a result of any of the following:

 a. Demolition of the housing unit due to a new development project on the subject property;

b. Voluntary vacation of the housing unit related to a new development project on the subject property (for example, accepting cash for keys offer);

c. Withdrawal of the housing unit from the

rental housing market under the Ellis Act;

d. Involuntary vacation of a housing unit due to a natural disaster such as an earthquake, fire, or flood;

e. Involuntary vacation of a housing unit as a result of a dangerous condition of the property making the unit unsafe to occupy on a permanent basis as deemed by the City, including but not limited to, when occupancy is no longer permitted pursuant to California Health and Safety Code regulations relating to a unit or building deemed substandard or uninhabitable.

6. Exceptions:

1. In the event that a density bonus is granted for specific tenants pursuant to State Density Bonus Law (California Government Code § 65915 (b)(1)(E)) then the tiered list provided in this section shall not be used to fill the affordable housing units.

2. In the implementation of these priorities, the City shall in no way discriminate against any person or family due to disability or other impermissible basis."

Section 3. Section 10-3-4802 (Applicability) of

Article 48 (Inclusionary Housing Requirements for Residential Development) of Chapter 3 (Zoning) of Title 10 (Planning and Zoning) of the BHMC is hereby amended to read as follows:

"10-3-4802: APPLICABILITY:

A. This article shall apply to all residential developments, as defined herein, where the lots or units will be offered for sale or for rent, and when the development application or applications for the residential development is deemed complete after the effective date of Ordinance 21-O-2850.

B. Notwithstanding subsection A, inclusionary units shall not be required for any project for which the city enters into a development agreement or for any project that is otherwise exempt under state law.

C. All inclusionary units shall be subject to the occupancy standards set forth in BHMC §10-3-1528.

Section 4. CEQA Determination. The Amendments have been environmentally reviewed pursuant to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code Sections 21000, et seq.("CEQA"), the State CEQA Guidelines (California Code of Regu-

lations, Title 14, Sections 15000, et seq.), and the City's Local CEQA Guidelines (hereafter the "Guidelines"). The City Council finds that the introduction and adoption of the Amendments are exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15061(b) (3) of the State CEQA Guidelines, which applies the 'general rule' that CEQA does not extend to projects with no significant environmental effect. As such, there is no possibility that the Amendments would result in a significant effect on the environment because the modifications do not enable any physical changes to the environment, directly or indirectly.

Section 5. Severability. If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or place, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect.

<u>Section 6.</u> Publication. The City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation published and circulated in the City within fifteen (15) days after its passage in accordance with Section 36933 of the Government Code, shall certify to

the adoption of this Ordinance, and shall cause this Ordinance and her certification, together with proof of publication, to be entered in the Book of Ordinances of the Council of this City.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall go into effect and be in full force and effect at 12:01 a.m. on the thirty-first (31st) day after its passage.
