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"LVMH Submits Legislative Advocate Form"

Poor Mr. Ostroff, he just can't stand to be a loser. He laments having been upbraided by the citizens of Beverly Hills when he was overruled in a city-wide referendum election. Instead of applauding the democratic process, he demeans it by claiming that "only a very small % of the City's registered voters participated." Worse still, he demeans those who disagreed with him by the invective of NIMBY, notwithstanding that many of us who voted in favor of the referendum live nowhere near the proposed project. He nicely omits that the developer spent almost \$2 million for the singular purpose of defeating the referendum and we grass-root-underfunded citizens beat his project. He can't accept that his judgment was flawed, that a 9-story code busting traffic nightmare was lost because it was a terrible project. Nor did he mention that the City Council's budget woes, which he claims stems from the loss of TOT taxes, resulted from the Council prematurely budgeting for revenue which never materialized.

And then Ostroff postures himself as an expert on antisemitism, which today has exploded not only here, but internationally. He notes that because the architect which may be chosen by the developer happens to be Jewish, that "should put to rest claims that the developer is not antisemetic." Really? Not once has LVMH made any effort to disavow the antisemetic rants of its paid for spokesperson, Bella Hadid, nor to reach out to the Jewish community with any contrition. Mr. Ostroff, contrary to your claim, you are wallowing in your own "spilt milk." As for the currently projected project, we will take Mr. Ostroff at his word, namely that "I can't tell you much about the project in detail," and will await an objective and full disclosure.

I take exception to Peter Ostroff's "Short Takes" column in the Weekly concerning the Cheval Blanc hotel that was proposed for the block-long property along South Santa Monica Boulevard between Rodeo and Beverly Drives, and rejected by a majority of Beverly Hills voters in 2022. As an opposition voter I am offended by Ostroff's characterization of the outcome of that referendum as "lamentable" and by former mayor Julian Gold's characterization as "tragic". It seems to me that a more appropriate response would be something like "the voters have spoken and their decision should be respected". Mr. Ostroff also makes reference to the deteriorated conditions in Westwood's commercial sector caused by "NIM-BYs who have mindlessly put obstacles in front of any and all efforts to invest in the area". Surely he is not likening Westwood's commercial sector to our golden triangle; therefore I interpret his comment as another slander of the 2022 referendum's opposition

During the vigorous campaign for the project, I and other voters with whom I spoke were mindful that a majority of the City Councilpersons endorsed the project; but we were convinced it would generate unacceptable vehicular traffic onto the boulevard and drives which are currently clogged at various times of the day. We were also unimpressed by architectural depictions of the project that showed only partial views that concealed the enormity of the building relative to the site and surroundings.

Mr. Ostroff asserts that "the City lost the substantial and sorely needed revenues that the hotel would have generated, principally through Transit Occupancy Taxes (TOT)". But the City's latest annual financial report shows Current Assets of \$801 million, which is roughly double the annual budget, and an increase in net income of \$57 million. Even if portions of those amounts are somehow restricted, they do not support an assertion that the City is sorely in need of revenue. Even his assertion that the TOT revenue generated by the Cheval Blanc hotel would have been "substantial" is questionable. In all probability a significant portion of that occupancy would have resulted in reduced occupancy of the existing premier hotels in our city; thereby a "wash" in tax revenue for the City and School District.

I am delighted to learn from Ostroff's column that the owner of the property, LVMT, is moving forward with an alternate proposal featuring retail, exhibition, dining and related usages, to be designed by Frank Gehry. That promises to be a world-class development appropriate for the site, and worthy of city-wide support.

Two Hospitalized After Armed Robbery on Rodeo

Two people were hospitalized following an armed robbery on Rodeo Drive on Sunday afternoon.

Beverly Hills Police Department officers responded to the robbery on the 400 block of North Rodeo Drive, near Brighton Way, shortly before 1:30 p.m.

Two people were waiting outside a store when they were confronted by four suspects. During a physical altercation, one suspect brandished a firearm, according to a police news release.

"During the altercation, the suspects forcibly took two designer handbags - one from each victim - containing cash and cellphones," the statement said.

Police added that one of the cellphones was later found nearby. The suspects also attempted but failed to steal jewelry from the male victim.

Footage circling social media shows four individuals in dark clothing and hooded sweatshirts fleeing the scene. One suspect, who looked to be carrying an item, appeared to be holding one of the stolen handbags.

The suspects were last seen running along Rodeo Drive before disappearing into a nearby alleyway.

While the extent of injuries remains unclear, video footage showed a male victim lying on the ground as another person knelt beside him, calling for help. Emergency responders from the Beverly Hills Fire Department arrived at the location, but the victims ultimately sought treatment at a hospital on their own.

Their current conditions have not been disclosed.

BHPD Support K-9 Nominated For National Award

Renderings Unveiled for 12-Story Builder's Remedy **Development at 9430 Olympic**

Plans for a 12-story building at 9430 West Olympic Boulevard have been unveiled by Ottinger Architects through a recent social media post.

The project, led by local development firm Fisch Properties, aims to bring about 65 residential units and ground-floor commercial space to the corner of Olympic Boulevard and Beverly Drive.

The development, classified as a Builder's Remedy project, emerged earlier this year while Beverly Hills' housing element was out of compliance. As such, it bypasses typical zoning restrictions, including height limits. For eligibility under Builder's Remedy rules, the project must allocate either 100%

will offer views of the city, while the structure's rounded edges and lines aim to create a sense of movement and elegance.

The project adds to a growing cluster of developments near the Beverly and Olympic intersection, including a second, larger proposal from Fisch Properties at 9441 Olympic Boulevard.

City Council Approves \$50,000 Grant for Wildfire **Protection Plan**

The City Council approved a resolution to accept a \$50,000 grant from the 2023 California Fire Safe Council. The grant, funded by the U.S. Department of Agriculture and U.S. Forest Service, will be used to develop the city's first-ever Community Wildland Protection Plan (CWPP)

The CWPP initiative aims to enhance wildfire risk reduction strategies, and improve emergency readiness. The \$100,000 project—funded equally by the grant and a matching \$50,000 contribution from the city-will engage a contractor to create the plan.

The plan aligns with federal strategies outlined in the Healthy Forest Restoration Act and aims to address hazards specific to the wildland-urban interface, Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zones, and other atrisk areas.

The plan is intended to serve as a strategic blueprint to prioritize the city's financial and human resources in protecting infrastructure and properties. It is also intended to boost community awareness about wildfire risks and create actionable steps to safeguard lives and property.

The project requires the city to match the \$50,000 grant. The California Fire Safe Council will reimburse up to \$50,000 for eligible expenses related to the plan's development.

Books for the Holidays

Now that we are starting the holiday season, some of you may enjoy a few of my suggestions for books to read when and if you have time to relax. So I thought that you might appreciate some suggestions for books to read during the upcoming weeks.

The criteria that I have used to recommend these books are that they are engaging or informative or both. Some are new but most are not. They are fiction and non-fiction. There are autobiographies and biographies. A few were discussed by the Mature Men's Book Discussion Group. The only thing that this eclectic collection has in common is that I was engaged by, learned from and enjoyed all of them. I hope that one or more will be of interest to you.

They are listed alphabetically by author.

"Americanah" by Chimananda Ngozi Adiche. Ms. Adiche tells the somewhat autobiographical fictional account of a young Nigerian woman who is a student at Princeton University. It covers her life in the US and in her hometown of Lagos, Nigeria. A reviewer wrote: "Adiche is to Blackness what Philip Roth is to Jewishness." Both writers engage with the cultural, social and historical contexts of their identities which shape their experiences. You will find "Americanah" is eye-opening.

"Reagan-His Life and Legend" by Max Boot. This is a comprehensive biography that discusses not only President Ronald Reagan's life but also describes what America was like during his lifetime. Interestingly, President Reagan was born in 1911 in the small town of Tampico, Illinois which then and now had less than 1,000 residents. **Abraham Lincoln** was born in 1809 in Hodgenville, Kentucky and raised in Indiana and Illinois in areas much like Tampico. When Lincoln was born, he lived in small houses without electricity or indoor plumbing and paved roads were rare. One hundred years later, when President Reagan was born, those same conditions persisted in his hometown.

"Jane Eyre" by Charlotte Bronte. This is an all-time classic, written in 1847,

most likely read by most of you in high school. But not me. As Anne told me that this was the greatest novel ever written,I decided to read it a few months ago. While I am not sure that I share Anne's enthusiasm, I thoroughly enjoyed it. It was considered ground-breaking when it was published because of the introspective writing style which was revealed through the first person narrative. Surprisingly, it holds up 150 years later.

"The Power Broker - Robert Moses and the Fall of New York" by Robert A. Caro. As the unelected New York Parks Commissioner (and many other appointed positions) he was one of the most powerful persons in the history of the City of New York. For decades in the middle of the 20th Century, virtually all public development projects in the New York City area were under his control. Moses' developments are a case study in both what to do and what not to do. Los Angeles Dodgers fans owe Moses a debt of gratitude because his objections to Walter O'Malley's efforts in the mid-1950's to build a new baseball stadium to house the Brooklyn Dodgers were, at least in part, responsible for the Dodgers' move to Los Angeles. Importantly, at least to me, when Robert Moses and Nathan Ostroff, my father, were born, a few years apart, their families lived on Dwight Street in New Haven CT and both went, as "townies", to Yale College.

"Bad Blood - Secrets and Lies in a Silicon Valley Startup" by John Carreyrou. This is the absolutely riveting story of Elizabeth Holmes and her startup company, Theranos. Theranos under Ms. Holmes' leadership raised many millions of \$ by promoting a revolutionary machine that would make blood testing faster and cheaper. By 2015, Theranos was valued at \$9B and Ms. Holmes had a net worth of around \$4B. Except the machine didn't work and the Silicon Valley mantra of "Fake it until you make it" was put to the test. Mr. Carreyrou was a Wall Street Journal reporter who, among others, exposed Theranos and Ms. Holmes. By 2017, the value of Theranos was Zero. You will find yourself hoping for the death penalty

for Ms. Holmes who was charged with fraud. She is now in prison serving a lengthy sentence.

""The Waiting" by Michael Connelly. This is the latest of nearly 40 mysteries/police procedurals by Mr. Connelly, a former Los Angeles Times reporter, mostly set in Los Angeles and mostly involving the fictional now retired LAPD detective Hieronymous Bosch. These books are not only

imaginative but also depict accurately the geography and life of the City of Los Angeles. Mr. Connelly is now an industry unto himself.. In addition to his books, he is responsible for three streaming series, "Bosch", "Bosch:Legacy" and "The Lincoln Lawyer" featuring Bosch's fictional half-brother **Mickey Haller**.

"The Best Team Money Can Buy – The Los Angeles Dodgers' Wild Struggle to Build a Baseball Powerhouse" by Molly Knight. You should have expected that I would include a book about baseball and, better yet, the Dodgers. Molly Knight is a Los Angeles-based sportswriter who publishes a blog entitled "The Long Game" available on Substack. This book and the blog are an endless source of truly inside baseball. Molly will be returning to speak at a meeting of the Rotary Club of Beverly Hills in February, 2025.

"Bibi-My Story" the autobiography of Benjamin Netanyahu and "Zev's Los Angeles - From Boyle Heights to the Halls of Power - A Political Memoir" which is the autobiography of Zev Yaro**slavsky**. These are listed together because there are some contrasts and some similarities. They are both 75 years old, prominent Jewish leaders and both remain in the public eye. Mr. Yaroslavsky was "termed out" of both the Los Angeles City Council and the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors. For better or worse, Mr. Netanyahu has not been subject to term limits and remains as Israel's longest serving Prime Minister. Netanyahu's book is about the perilous history of Israel. Mr. Yaroslavsky's book is about the history of modern Los Angeles, perilous in its own way. "Man of Tomorrow-The Relentless Life of Jerry Brown" by Jim Newton. This is an examination of California history during the life and times of former California Governor Jerry Brown and his service as governor first starting in 1972 and then again nearly thirty years later. Jim Newton is a former Los Angeles Times Editorial

Page editor, reporter and columnist who now teaches at UCLA and is the founder of Blueprint Magazine.

"Guardian Angel" by Sara Paretsky. Sara Paretsky is a Chicago mystery writer who has created the character of Vicki I. Warshavsky, a Chicago based working class private investigator with whom you will fall in love. Ms. Warshavsky is the central character in most of Ms. Paretsky's twenty or so mysteries. Most of these are set in and evocative of Chicago from the 1980's when Ms. Paretsky started to the present. Ms. Paretsky has earned my respect because she holds three advanced degrees (including a PhD in history) from the University of Chicago. I have only one. Although I have picked Guardian Angel, you will also enjoy "Killing Orders", "Burn Marks", "Blood Shot" and all the

"When the Lion Feeds" by Wilbur Smith. Wilbur Smith is one of my favorite writers. He was born in what is now Zambia in 1932, and became an accountant. Commencing in around 1962, he became a full time author and wrote a novel a year until he passed away in 2021. Most of his early books are historical adventure fiction which blend gold mining, hunting and fractious families set in southern Africa. He also wrote a series set in ancient Egypt and another series about contemporary South Africa. For me, the historical adventure stories are the best. When the Lion Feeds was his first. There are several others that are equally enthralling including "A Time to Die", "The Sound of Thunder" and "A Sparrow Falls." Try one of these and you will be hooked with more than forty to go.

"The Last Trial" by Scott Turow. I am a great fan of courtroom novels and few authors do them as well as Scott Turow. His novels drew upon his several years' experience as a federal prosecutor in Chicago. His first book of fiction was the ground-breaking "Presumed Innocent". It was first made into a movie starring Harrison Ford as the accused, Rusty Sabich. Raul Julia played the part of a young trial lawyer, Alejandro (Sandy) Stein who was the counsel for the accused. "The Last Trial" is about the last trial of the now aged, and failing before our eyes, Sandy Stein and is almost as good as "Presumed Innocent" or perhaps even better as it realistically describes the arc of the development of this character.

I hope that at least one of these attracts your interest.
