Beverly Hills Considers New Parking Permit Zone for North Maple Drive **Blocks**

The Traffic and Parking Commission is expected to discuss possibly implementing a preferential parking permit (PPP) regulation on the 200 and 300 blocks of North Maple Drive, at its Thursday meeting. This measure aims to address commuter parking concerns raised by residents.

The recommended regulation would designate parking on these blocks as: 2-Hour Parking, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Daily and No Parking, 6 p.m. to 2:30 a.m., Daily, Permit 'G' Exempt.

The changes are designed to limit parking by employees and patrons of nearby restaurants and businesses while preserving spaces for residents.

In October 2024, residents on both blocks submitted petitions with strong support for parking restrictions. On the 200 block, 70% of households backed the proposal, while 63% of households supported the measure on the 300 block. Currently, both blocks have "2-hour parking, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., Except Sunday" rules, with no preferential parking zones in place.

A parking survey conducted on October 8 found that commuter vehicles accounted for approximately 60% of parked cars during the evening hours. While average parking occupancy was relatively low (17-27%), peak-hour activity and weekend observations by the Police Department indicated significant commuter presence.

The recommendation to implement the PPP Zone is based on the following:

- •Strong resident support for the petitions.
- •The high percentage of commuter vehicles identified.
- •The need to align regulations with neighboring streets, such as North Elm Drive, which already fall under Permit Zone "G."
- •Mitigating parking spillover from surrounding areas with existing restrictions.

Permit Zone "G" was first established in 1979 to address parking intrusions from Wilshire Boulevard businesses. Over time, it has expanded to include nearby streets, providing a mix of "No Parking Anytime" and "2-Hour Parking" regulations. These rules have successfully reduced commuter parking and late-night disruptions in residential

If approved, the new signage for the 200 and 300 blocks of North Maple Drive will cost approximately \$2,800 for materials and labor. Residents on surrounding streets have been notified about the proposed changes, and public feedback will be reviewed at the Traffic and Parking Commission's meeting on December 5.

Traffic and Parking **Commission to Review** Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program

The Traffic and Parking Commission is set to receive an update on the Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program (NTCP) at its Thursday meeting. City staff will present a one-year progress report on the program and seek feedback on potential modifications to its guide-

The Beverly Hills City Council approved the Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program on November 7, 2023, as a tool to address resident concerns about traffic safety and provide a structured approach for approving and installing traffic calming measures. The program opened to resident applications in December 2023 and has since received a total of 16 applications from various neighborhoods.

The program's guidelines identify traffic calming options and establish a multi-step process for community engagement and approval of proposed measures.

Since the last six-month update in June 2024, the city has received an additional 10 applications. These applications are in various stages of the process, which includes conducting community surveys and analyzing resident feedback. However, many projects have faced challenges in meeting the required approval thresholds.

Applications for speed humps, traffic circles, and other measures on streets such as S. Clark Drive, S. Peck Drive, and N. La Peer Drive are still in progress but have not yet received sufficient survey responses to move forward.

Some applications, such as those for 400 S. Camden Drive and 700 N. Palm Drive, have been closed due to insufficient approval or failure to meet installation criteria.

Despite strong initial interest, several obstacles have arisen during the program's implementation:

- •Low Response Rates: Many community surveys have not met the required response thresholds. Current guidelines require approval based on total dwelling units rather than just survey participants, leading to frustration among applicants who support the measures.
- •Approval Requirements for Speed Humps: Gaining consent from property owners near proposed speed hump locations has proven difficult, particularly on streets with absentee landlords or complex ownership struc-
- •High Approval Thresholds: Current guidelines require 50-70% support depending on the type of measure, which can allow a small number of non-responsive or opposing households to block projects.

City staff will present potential changes to address the following challenges:

•Adjusting Support Calculations: Approval thresholds could be based on survey respondents rather than total

dwelling units, as seen in some other municipalities. For example, a project could move forward if a minimum response rate is achieved and a majority of those responses support the mea-

- •Lowering Approval Thresholds: Reducing required support percentages could make it easier to implement traffic calming measures while still ensuring community input.
- •Amending Speed Hump Procedures: Removing the requirement for approval from abutting property owners could streamline the process, particularly for multi-family housing areas.

The Commission will provide feedback on these proposed modifications. If changes are recommended, city staff will draft revisions and present them at a future Commission meeting before seeking City Council approval.

BHPD Impounds Three Illegal Electric Motorcycles

The Beverly Hills Police Department (BHPD) announced on November 22,



that three illegal electric motorcycles were impounded as part of an effort to enforce regulations and ensure public safety.

The department also emphasized the legal distinctions between e-bikes and electric motorcycles to prevent confusion and potential hazards.

E-Bikes must have operable pedals, are limited to speeds of 20-28 mph, depending on the class, with motors not exceeding 750 watts. They also do not require DMV registration, insurance, or a motorcycle license. Electric Motorcycles lack of pedals means the vehicle is not classified as an e-bike. Speeds over 28 mph require DMV registration, insurance, and a motorcycle license.

The department is urging parents and prospective buyers to understand the laws before purchasing electric two-wheelers, particularly for minors.

As electric vehicles grow in popularity, the BHPD is ramping up efforts to educate the public about safety and compliance. The department encourages residents to review California's laws on electric vehicles and consider the risks before making a purchase.

City Council Reappointments Commissioners

The City Council approved the Reappointments of Public Works Commissioner Mark Nehoray, Human Relations Commissioner Pam Kraushaar, and Recreation And Parks Commissioner Deborah Termeie, at its Tuesday Study Session.

The following Commissioners' first two-year terms are scheduled to end on December 31; they are eligible for reappointment to a second term of four years. The Commissioners have submitted correspondence indicating willingness to serve a second term from January 1 – December 31, 2028.

Mayors Conference Against Antisemitism to Take Place Dec. 11

The City Council approved the use of a complimentary day at the Wallis to host sessions for the U.S. Mayors Conference Against Antisemitism. This event, chaired by Mayor Les Friedman and hosted by the Combat Antisemitism Movement (CAM), will take place from December 11 to 13.

The 2024 Mayors Summit Against Antisemitism is expected to draw 200 mayors, policymakers, and advocates from the U.S. and Canada to collaborate on combating antisemitism and fostering societal tolerance. CAM, a global coalition with over 700 partner organizations and a reach of more than three million people, is organizing the three-day conference. The movement aims to build a network of leaders committed to safeguarding Jewish life and addressing antisemitism through localized city initiatives.

As part of its efforts, CAM has held similar events in previous years, with summits in Athens, Greece, in 2022 and Fort Lauderdale, Florida, in 2023. This year's summit is themed "Directing Change from City Hall."

While the city would provide access to the venue, CAM would cover any additional costs for labor, production, or cleaning directly with The Wallis.

The City Council previously approved funding of up to \$250,000 in September 2024 to support various aspects of the conference. However, the costs associated with the use of The Wallis, beyond the free-use day itself, will be taken on by CAM.

Beverly Hills Considers Fee Waivers for 82nd Annual Golden Globes Ceremony

The Rodeo Drive Committee is set to review a request from Dick Clark Productions for partial fee waivers associated with the 82nd Annual Golden Globes Award Ceremony, scheduled for January 5. This follows the City Council's approval of the special event permit and related street closures for the event on October 10. The request for fee waivers was directed to be brought back to the liaisons for further consideration.

Dick Clark Productions is seeking one

of three fee waiver options for the Golden Globes ceremony: a \$30,000 waiver of permit application fees, a \$15,000 waiver of personnel costs specifically related to overtime for staff, or a flat fee of \$100,000 to cover all application and staff fees, with all other fees being waived. In exchange for the fee waivers, Dick Clark Productions has proposed several promotional opportunities for the city, including showcasing the city's imagery during the televised Cold Open of the Golden Globes ceremony. The segment would feature a 10-second clip with a voiceover mentioning Beverly Hills.

Additionally, Dick Clark Productions is offering an educational opportunity for local students. Selected Beverly High students will have the chance to participate in a mentorship program with Rick Pizante, Executive Vice President of Dick Clark Productions. Students will gain behind-the-scenes production access, meet industry professionals, and have red carpet access to interview celebrities on show day.

In another partnership offer, Dick Clark Productions has proposed that the Beverly Hills Conference and Visitors Bureau (CVB) pay \$30,000 for an opportunity to capture content at the Golden Globes and the Beverly Hilton Hotel. The content would support the city's branding, marketing, and social media initiatives.

Regarding the fiscal impact, Dick Clark Productions and The Beverly Hilton Hotel are responsible for all expenses, including city permits, street closures, personnel costs, and other event-related fees. The total fees for last year's Golden Globes ceremony amounted to \$28,821 in permit application and processing fees, along with \$187,681.25 in personnel costs. Given increases in permit fees and staff salaries, total costs for this year's event are expected to be higher.

Beverly Hills to Host 56th NAACP Image Awards Nominee Luncheon at the Beverly Wilshire Hotel

The Rodeo Drive Committee will review a request from the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP) to host the 56th NAACP Image Awards Nominee Luncheon at the Beverly Wilshire Hotel. The event, scheduled for Saturday, February 1, will celebrate achievements in film, television, music, and literature, recognizing individuals of color in the entertainment industry.

The preparations will involve a temporary alleyway closure south of the Beverly Wilshire Hotel, impacting the "L-shaped" alleyway that runs east-west off South Rodeo Drive and north-south off Charleville Blvd. The alleyway closure will begin on Friday, January 31, at 7:00 PM for setup and will conclude on the event day, Saturday, February 1, at 7:00 PM.

No exterior amplified sound is planned for the event, ensuring minimal disruption to the surrounding area.

Vahagn Setian Charitable Foundation Holds Annual Tree Planting Ceremony

The City Council took part in the annual Vahagn Setian Charitable Foundation's tree ceremony event at La Cienega Park last Sunday.

The NAACP is responsible for all expenses related to the event, including city permits, closure fees, and staffing costs. As a nonprofit organization, the NAACP will receive a nonprofit rate for the closure fees in accordance with the city's fee schedule.

The full City Council is expected to consider the proposal at its meeting on January 9.

City Council to Review McCourt Foundation's Request for 40th Annual Los Angeles Marathon

The Beverly Hills Rodeo Drive/Special Events Committee approved a request from The McCourt Foundation (TMF) to host the 40th Annual Los Angeles Marathon, scheduled for Sunday, March 16. The event, which will involve street closures and traffic detours, requires approval of a special event permit by the City Council.

The marathon, which is expected to attract 20,000 participants, will start at 7 a.m. and conclude by 3 p.m. on March 16, with street closures beginning at 5 a.m. and ending at 6 p.m. The closures will affect key Beverly Hills streets, including Doheny Drive, Burton Way, South Santa Monica Blvd, Rodeo Drive, Wilshire Blvd, and North Santa Monica Blvd. A rolling reopening of streets will begin at noon, with all streets fully reopened by 1 p.m.

Although the marathon's finish line is in Century City, Beverly Hills will experience traffic disruptions, particularly on South Santa Monica Blvd and North Santa Monica Blvd. Beverly Hills traffic control staff will manage the detours and ensure roads are reopened by 6 p.m. The event will also include sponsor activations, media coverage across multiple platforms, and a bus service for Beverly Hills residents to the start line.

The McCourt Foundation, a nonprofit focused on finding a cure for neurological diseases, will follow all conditions of the Charitable Solicitations permit and has raised over \$70 million for non-profit causes. The event's activities will include a 26.2-mile racecourse, media coverage, and approximately 1,500 participants from Students Run LA.

The McCourt Foundation is responsible for all expenses related to permits, street closures, personnel costs, and other event-related fees, with a nonprofit rate applied for street closures due to the event's charitable nature. Fees will be based on the City's current fiscal year 2024/25 fee schedule.

Metro Construction Continues to Progress

The Rodeo Station, a component of the Metro Purple Line Extension, continues to advance, according to a city staff report. Structural components, including the invert slab, station walls, concourse slab, mid-level walls, and roof deck, have been completed. Current work focuses on interior wall construction, waterproofing, fire protection systems, plumbing, electrical installations, and backfill operations.

Ground improvements for emergency cross-passages along Wilshire Boulevard were initiated in May 2022. With the majority of well decommissioning and area restorations complete, pavement work on Wilshire Boulevard is paused for the holiday moratorium but will resume in January 2025.

During the holiday moratorium, Metro will conduct the following:

- •Material and Concrete Deliveries: Limited to two key areas on Wilshire Boulevard: between Beverly Drive and Crescent Drive and from Willaman Drive to Carson Drive.
- •Concrete Placement for Tunnel Walkways: Scheduled between Reeves Drive and the Willaman-Carson area during overnight hours.

After completing ventilation structures, S. Cañon Drive reopened to traffic on November 15, following an 11-week full closure.

On S. Beverly Drive, ongoing construction is paused during the holiday moratorium and on N. Cañon Drive Yard, sidewalks near the yard remain narrowed for ongoing wall modifications.

Looking ahead, deck removal and street restoration along Wilshire Boulevard are slated to begin in early 2025.

Liaisons Approves Vanity Fair's Annual Academy Award Dinner and Post-Oscar Party Event

City Council Liaisons Mayor Les Friedman and Councilmember Mary Wells gave support for Vanity Fair's request to host its Annual Academy Award Dinner and Post-Oscar Party on March 2. This event will take place in the 400 block of Crescent Drive, with street and sidewalk closures set to begin on February 17, at 10 PM and lasting until March 7, at 10 PM. The event is expected to draw between 800 to 1,000 attendees.

The street closures will affect several major areas, including the 400 block of North Crescent Drive, South Santa Monica Boulevard, North Canon Drive, and Park Way. The most significant closure will occur on March 2, 2025, from 2 PM to midnight, with additional closures from 10 PM to 2 AM on the same day.

Vanity Fair's Academy Award Dinner and Post-Oscar Party will feature a small viewing dinner followed by a reception. The event will have staggered guest arrivals, with each attendee receiving a time-coded admission card and parking pass. The event will also include a large tent structure, a red carpet photo area, and a temporary kitchen for food preparation by Chef Evan Funke. No exterior amplified sound will be used.

Vanity Fair has requested a fee waiver for the street closure permit fee, which would normally amount to \$523,610 for the event's closure duration. The company has requested to pay a reduced flat fee of \$24,453, the same rate they received in previous years.


Greystone In The Movies to Take Place Dec. 15

Beverly Hills Commissions: To Be or Not to Be

A Meeting of the previously unknown Council Liaison Ad Hoc on Commission Standardization occurred on Monday November 18.

The ostensible purpose of the meeting was to discuss publicly what apparently had previously been discussed at length privately, the elimination of two commissions by merging the Health & Safety Commission with the Human Relations Commission and by merging the Recreation & Parks Commission with the Arts & Culture Commission. The expressed rationale for raising this issue was to achieve efficiency and economy given that the Commissions' functions "overlapped" and because the City was facing a deficit of approximately \$25M/year.

I will discuss this in more detail but first I want to make two points clearly to avoid any confusion:

Council and Staff have little regard for the Commissions and don't allow them to play their assigned roles of independent advisors to the Council – as this is the case, rather than nibble at the edges, let's just eliminate all Commissions (except for the Planning Commission which is required by state law) if the Commissions will be ignored or precluded by bureaucratic roadblocks from doing anything of substance; I do not advocate abolition of the commissions but maintenance of the status quo (plus or minus a Commission or two) is a waste of everyone's time;

The expenses of supporting the Commissions are no more than a rounding error; if the City was serious about trimming expenses, it would have allowed the two year Blue Ribbon Finance Committee announced by former Mayor Julian Gold at the outset

of his term as Mayor to do its job.

Our Councilmembers and our departments' staff are generally well meaning and generally do good work. On occasion, however, their hubris or arrogance gets the best of them. This is one of those instances

Let's examine the situation. The disdain that the Council and staff have for the Commissions is exemplified by the fact that the Commissions immediately affected by these proposed combinations were first notified that the combination was being considered was by a Notice sent at 5:30pm on Friday November 15 of a meeting at 10:15am on Monday morning.

But this is just a symptom of the underlying issue. We have a number of Commissions. Their job, as established by the Municipal Code, is to advise the Council about matters within their purview. The role of staff is to provide administrative support, not micromanage.

But this is not what happens with very rare exceptions. Typically, staff sets the agendas for the meetings of the Commissions with little input or regard for what the Commission Chairs have in mind. Then staff controls the meetings by devices such as reports crafted to achieve the desired result and/or lengthy presentations that consume most of the meeting

Another justification offered for considering the elimination of two Commissions is that sometimes it was difficult to find applicants for open Commission positions. This is a self-inflicted injury. Why should busy engaged residents seek membership on Commissions that do nothing?

Even the Planning Commission is not immune from the efforts of Council and staff to exercise control. For a number of

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years, the Planning Commission was charged with reviewing, for consistency with the General Plan, Development Agreements negotiated between two members of the Council and developers who sought major variations from zoning rules. In exchange for allowing those variations, Council would exact substantial payments, in addition to all of the customary charges, as a "public benefit" payment.

The proposed Development Agreement for the One Beverly Hills project was submitted to the Planning Commission to review for General Plan consistency. Staff presented a report which selected some provisions of the General Plan but omitted the requirement of the General Plan for promotion of affordable housing. The Development Agreement for the One Beverly Hills project involved no affordable housing even though at least 35 affordable residential units would have been required by the Beverly Hills Municipal Code. The Planning Commission refused to find that the Development Agreement was consistent with the General Plan given the lack of any provision for affordable housing. This independent advice was viewed by the Council negotiators as insubordination.

Shortly thereafter, the Council retaliated against the Planning Commission by amending the Municipal Code to eliminate any review of Development Agreements by the Planning Commission. The message that even the Planning Commission is expected to toe the line and be mindless "team players" was clear. (I believe that had a public review by the Planning Commission occurred of the Development Agreement for the Cheval Blanc project, the referendum that rescinded the permits granted by the Council could have been avoided or defeated. But we will never know.)

I should emphasize that the Council does not have to take the advice of the Commissions. But wouldn't the Council's decisions potentially be aided by independent advice from a cross-section of engaged residents who have taken the time to serve as Commissions?

If Council and staff do not want the input of the Commissions or for the Commissions to take initiative and make proposals within their purview, let's **cut the** pretense and disband them all.

I do not doubt the need for a quest for more efficiency and economy. But the City's major expenses are for employee payroll (including massive overtime expenses) and third party contracts. These include what I consider profligate use of consultants largely as a way to diffuse responsibility for decisions. Further, it works against accountability and responsibility at great expense.

Former Mayor Gold established, at the outset of his term as Mayor, a two year Blue Ribbon Finance Committee under City Treasurer Howard Fisher. The purpose was to examine potential ways to increase City revenues and decrease expenses. It was acknowledged by then Mayor Gold that this project would likely extend beyond his term but that then Vice Mayor Lester Friedman would continue it to completion. During Mayor Gold's term, the Blue Ribbon Committee addressed revenues. As of today, Mayor Friedman has not requested that the Committee address expenses.

I do assume that reduction of expenses is a major concern of the Council and that some person or persons are addressing this issue. I hope and expect that they will address the major expense components. These do not include the expenses of the Commissions which are very minor and the potential benefits of active Commissions are great.

I personally believe that there is a real prospect that the Commissions could play a valuable role as truly independent advisors. They also play an important role in increasing community engagement in and understanding of the operations of the City.

If the Council does not value or even wish to tolerate the advice of the Commissions, so be it. But the Council should not indulge in or promote the fantasy that its disinterest in independent advice or initiative is in furtherance of efficiency or economy.

Retiring Board Member Noah Margo Discusses His 13 Years on the Board of Education

You are completing 13 years on the Board of Education. What would you say has gotten better and what still needs improvement?

These students' opportunities, both academically and co-curricular, have vastly improved. Especially since the reconfiguration in 2019 and 2020. We have a strong administration that supports student success and learning first, I think that's in place at all of our schools. We have amazing new facilities that have come on board and continue to come on board. That does help, even if it might seem superficial., but there's a sense of spirit, togetherness, and unity when people love where they go to school.

Things that still need improvement: I think the current climate of the country-and even the globe-has done ev-

erything it can to divert attention away from actual learning. Everything else seems to take priority, whether it's infusing national politics into a local school district or addressing safety concerns due to the horrific incidents that have occurred through- start out popular, there out our country.

When these issues arise, our school district ends up dealing with what I like to call **You have to have thick** well-being solely on "necessary distractions." We have to ensure our kids are safe

and do everything possible to create a secure learning environment. Unfortunately, these efforts often shift focus and attention away from the actual content of learning.

The same can be said for post-COVID challenges. Everyone acknowledges the "hiccup" that happened in education, and emotional well-being—while [incredibly important]—has also taken [precedence] over actual content. I've always strived to keep my conversations [centered] on students' learning. Yet, over the years, we've faced a constant bombardment of distractions: lawsuits, Metro issues, COVID, politics, construction—the list

We have to stay grounded in our mission: educating children.

You have often said that 3-2 votes rarely turn out well. However, the decision to turn Beverly Vista into a middle school was decided in a 3-2 vote, with you voting in favor. Do you think on balance, reconfiguration has been a

success?

Yes, I think it was a success. I think it was necessary. I'm honest about the trials and tribulations along the way. There were certainly things to consider in the reconfiguration, and some of those are still being worked through. But for a couple of reasons, [I believe it was the right decision].

The academic opportunities for our middle schoolers—and technically the athletic opportunities as well-have improved more than anyone could have imagined. On top of that, there's the dynamic of gathering more of these prepubescent students, whether we call them children, teens, tweens—pick the best term—and concentrating them in one place.

The problems we've seen at the middle

school would have happened regardless of whether we were operating as K-8 or as a middle school. They just seem more pronounced because everything is concentrated in one location.

On the other side will be times when you of that: You don't govern or base student success, learning, safety, and money because all of those things are priorities. However,

if we hadn't reconfigured, based on the direction of our demographic reports, we likely would have had to close a campus anyway.

We didn't have the numbers to justify keeping all of our buildings open. The demographic trends are clear, and they are primarily driven by live birth rates. That's the first factor—there are simply fewer live births in the area. On top of that, people aren't moving into the district. Prior generations are staying in their homes and not moving, which contributes to the lack of housing inventory.

This lack of inventory ties directly to affordability. Decreasing affordability and limited housing availability are key reasons why people either cannot move here or aren't here in the first place. That, in turn, drives enrollment numbers down.

Over the last two to three years, our enrollment numbers have slowly steadied. There haven't been any significant declines recently, but we'll have to see what happens moving forward. We have

wonderful buildings in our district, and it would be great to keep them full.

What lessons can be learned from the costly, and ultimately unsuccessful, Metro litigation fight?

You know, the whole David and Goliath scenario really, I think, only works well in the Bible, right? But the truth is, my colleagues who [were waving the red flags], saying "the sky is falling," were actually right.

Metro hit two wells under the school, which cost them millions to remediate. If it hadn't been for that little thing called COVID, which had already evacuated the school in March 2020, we would have had a real crisis on our hands. To remediate the issue, they needed to bring in a crane, and for that, they would have had to clear a significant portion of the campus to create a safety radius.

Because everyone was learning at home on their computers due to COVID, Metro avoided having to evacuate the school. They got out of it on a technicality. But the fact remains: they really didn't know what they were dealing with under there. They hit two wells during their work, and that's what the whole issue was about. They shouldn't have been going that route.

If anything had happened, we would have been left scrambling to relocate students. COVID sent students home, but had it not been for that, we would have had to figure out where to relocate the high school. The other schools were occupied. What would we have done?

So as controversial as it was—and as much as it diverted time and attention—I think those who argued that Metro could and should choose a better route were not wrong. Was everything handled correctly? I don't know.

I also know that Metro is reportedly still dealing with water drainage issues in the area near the high school. They're constantly pumping water. There are a lot of unknowns we pointed out to them back then.

It does make you wonder just how much taxpayer money is continuing to be poured into this project. We had said from the start they'd end up spending far more taxpayer money doing it their way

than if they'd followed the original plan we had agreed upon.

Declining enrollment has been an issue in the BHUSD. Has the district handled this effectively?

I think those two things are out of the district's control. We have to adapt, and reconfiguration was one way to adapt to declining enrollment. That was an option—there were other options—but I think the administration and the "think tank" involved really felt that the optimal use of shifting campuses around would be to create a dedicated middle school.

I know there are people who love the idea, and there are others who aren't as fond of it. I respect everyone's opinion. It's very hard to come up with something that works for everyone.

I grew up with a K-8 system at Beverly Vista, and I was the deciding vote on making it a dedicated middle school. But when you look at programming, policy, and budget, those factors tend to lean you in that direction.

Will it always be this way? I never say "always" about anything. There were even people who thought I'd always be on the school board.

Do you have any advice for new board members stepping into this role?

I do. I would say, try not to have an agenda. Try to learn what the position entails. Take the time to understand your responsibilities as a governing board member. It's important to know the role and recognize that we are not problem-solvers for everyday issues in the district.

There's a lot of administration between us and the community—people who are paid to handle those matters. It really muddies the waters when board members step in and try to solve individual problems or address specific school issues. That's not our purview when we are doing our jobs correctly.

I've maintained this perspective for 13 years: nobody should really know who we are. When I was in school, not only did we not know who the Board of Education members were—we never even gave them a thought. If you got to your principal, that was a big deal. And that's how it should be.

Learning happens on the school sites. Everything good that happens in our district happens in the classroom, involving students and teachers. We, as board members, need to get out of the way and make sure they have the space

and resources to do their jobs—to educate our students and help them succeed. That's our job: ensuring everyone has what they need to succeed.

Another thing to remember is that all of our administrators are human beings. They're not programmable robots that you wind up and send off to run schools. They're people, and *invaluable experience* I think sometimes we in my life, giving back lose sight of that.

Many of our read- that I absolutely loved ers know you are the drummer for The Tokens. What's next for the group?

We are already gearing up for, hopefully, twice as many shows next year as we've done this year. We did about ten shows in 2024, and we're aiming for about 20 next year. We're excited. We just finished a three-day show near Sacramento, and we even did some local TV news up there. It really brought back memories of how it felt 30 years ago when I first started. Back then, my father and uncle were in charge, but now I'm the one in charge.

It's more responsibility, but I enjoy the challenge. I want to see how far we can take it. That's my goal—to push things further.

Besides doing my best to keep the board focused on education, some of the work I am most proud of during my three terms includes building up educational and career pathways for all students, including hiring a dedicated college admissions counselor. We expanded our Career Technical Education offerings, maintained our A-G graduation requirements, and instituted SAT and PSAT for all students while adding several AP courses. We also expanded our mental health and student well-being resources throughout the district, including the first-ever Bulldog-Aid Wellness Center at Beverly Vista. Financially, we created a district reserve fund, began pre-funding our OPEB obligations, created deferred maintenance budget categories, and increased teacher salaries and benefits with every union negotiation. We went one-to-one with technology and, through all of that, had no deficit spending in the last thirteen years. Recently, we completed updating every Board Policy and Administrative Regulation.

We also added "Financial Literacy" to our graduation requirements, before the state jumped in and did the same.

My first term focused on setting the district's bond construction program on track. To date, we have completed both Horace Mann Elementary School and El Rodeo Elementary School, as well as the high school's B1 and B2 classrooms, administrative offices, a renovated swim gym, and upgrades to the football field. We have substantially completed the high school's main auditorium and performance arts buildings, and let's not forget remediating the oil wells during that time. We also reconfigured Beverly Vista to serve as a dedicated middle school. Finally, I am proud that we haven't chased away a superintendent in eight years.

Anything else you want to say?

They say that being a school board

member is the hardest elected official position in the country. It's quite thankless and time-consuming. If you start out popular, there will be times when you become everybody's least favorite person. You have to have thick skin. I've developed a pretty thick skin over the last 13 years, but I wouldn't trade it for anything. It has been an invaluable experience in my life, giving back to a school district that I absolutely loved being part of. Some of the best years of my life were spent at my school, and I know for a lot of people, those might have been the worst years of their lives—awkward years, perhaps. But for me, I really enjoyed it. I did a lot of what I could to give back to what this district gave me and how it has helped me move forward in life.

To add to that, because of this experience, I'm considering running for state office in 2026. I'm going to take some time off, research it, and try to figure out what might fit or not. But I feel that my years dealing with a local school district, which answers to the state, have taught me a lot about how things work—and don't work-and I think I can lend my skills to an office up north as well.

I also want to acknowledge that I couldn't have done any of this without the support of my wife, Laura, and my kids, who had to go through most of their public school years with me on the school board. So, a big shoutout to Laura and my kids.
