I have recently added to that list the Cultural Heritage Commission, because unbeknownst to me, they deliberated on the Frank Lloyd Building on Rodeo Drive and approved of the demolition of the brilliant school building designed by Sidney Eisenstadt on Burton Way, one of my favorites, based upon the most absurd rationalization by the owner's selected consultant who defended the demolition on the basis that they preferred the Sidney Eisenstadt building on the corner of Wilshire Boulevard and Beverly Drives, a building which the Architectural Commission just approved additional inappropriate changes, further diminishing the Architects original concept. 
The Planning Commission does not have even one member who is educated or trained in that field.

The Cultural Heritage Commission, likewise has no one who is educated in Architectural History, nor Architecture or Planning, yet the fate of the significant Ar-

Because of our City's position and reputation, we have a wealth of both Architecturally important buildings as well as wonderfully fashionable, idiosyncratic buildings.

Considering the lack of qualifications, how can these truly be considered anything other than an honorary position? #### **Teacher Alleges Racism**, **Files Formal Complaint Against BHUSD**

A Beverly High teacher has stepped forward with claims that reports of racism on campus, brought to the administration's attention since 2022, have been overlooked. The teacher, Bella Ivory, has decided to pursue legal action with the representation of attorney Brad Gage.

Gage previously represented several litigants against former BHPD Chief

#### **Clippers Honor LA Rabbi and Israeli Teens' Basketball** Coach

The Clippers honored Sinai Temple Rabbi Erez Sherman and Omer Bilansky, an Israeli teens' basketball coach, as Community Heroes.

This was the first time the Israeli basketball team was together since October 7, 2023, when war broke out in their neighborhoods. The fifteen-year-old basketball players have endured repeated tragedies since October 7. One of their coaches was killed, three players were kidnapped, and some have family members being held hostage in Gaza, amid ongoing attacks from Hamas and Hezbollah.

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

Gage cited several incidents to demonstrate what he believes is a harmful culture at the school.

"School is a place that children go to learn. A responsible school will endeavor to teach respect, love, compassion and equality. Sadly, in the BHUSD system, the students are preaching messages of hate, prejudice and discrimination. Those messages include profanities, as well as racial slurs to both Black

their race or national origin. When the children try to defend themselves, the "minorities" are then targeted with discipline, and at least one arrest. Many parents are removing their children from the school system because of fear, prejudice, violence and a seeming utter disregard by the Administration, including the BHUSD and Supervisors. I was told by one parent that when the Superintendent was invited to go to a meeting on racism, he came late and left early for a Rotary Club meeting. If that is accurate, it shows just how unimportant these concerns are," Gage said.

Gage has filed an official complaint with the Beverly Hills Unified School District on behalf of Ivory. The complaint alleges "discrimination, harassment, retaliation, racial comments, and physical threats." He also stated his intention to file a lawsuit and that the district needs to adequately address these complaints

In one video, a student records a bathroom floor with feces before focusing on a racist slur written on the wall, according to Gage.

"Most of the janitors at BHHS are African American. Accordingly, students defecated in the Boys bathroom on the floor and scrawled on the wall 'nig...r,' according to the complaint.

Another clip reportedly captures two female students who Gage believes are mocking Black students in the cafeteria.

According to the complaint, two girls zoom in on a table where Black students are enjoying their lunch. "The White girls say, this is disgusting, I am repulsed. Normans you seriously need to consider how much...(video ends here)," the complaint further alleges.

Ivory also claimed a group of students donning MAGA hats and carrying a Trump flag marched through the school, shouting offensive remarks, including "F\*\*\* Kamala," aimed at Vice President Kamala Harris. Ivory also claims the group's behavior escalated as they gathered near her classroom.

"We do not have evidence that suggests that there was racism at the recent spirited demonstrations; however BHU-SD has implemented proactive measures to ensure that any concerns related to racism and anti-semitism -perceived or real-are addressed promptly and effectively," Superintendent Michael Bregy said.

"BHUSD recognizes that incidents of this nature can heighten tensions, which is why we are unwavering in our efforts to engage students, families, and community members in solutions that uphold our core values. We believe this proactive approach not only addresses immediate concerns but also builds a foundation for long-term inclusivity and unity," Bregy added.

#### Judge Rules in Favor of **Beverly Hills and Dismisses** Almost Entirety of **Abortion Clinic Lawsuit**

Los Angeles County Superior Court Judge Michael Schultz Wednesday upheld the City of Beverly Hills' motion to dismiss the vast majority of DuPont Clinic's claims stating that: "There is not a shred of admissible evidence for any of the allegations asserted by the Plaintiffs and none is cited."

DuPont Clinic is an abortion provider that intended to locate in the City of Beverly Hills but whose lease was rescinded by its landlord in 2023. DuPont Clinic chose to sue the City for allegedly pressuring the landlord to rescind its lease

"We are pleased that the Court has vindicated the City's position through a neutral evaluation of the evidence," said Mayor Les Friedman. "As the City has indicated time and again, it vigorously supports a woman's right to choose and the decision to rescind DuPont Clinic's lease was not made by the City of Beverly Hills. We welcome future medical facilities that offer complete reproductive health services to Beverly Hills."

As a result of this decision, the city is entitled to its attorney's fees and intends to pursue them.

#### **Planning Commission** to Discuss Proposed **Eight-Story Residential Development at 412 North Oakhurst Drive**

The Planning Commission is expected to discuss a proposed multi-family residential development at 412 North

#### Breathe Southern California Receives Proclamation from the City of Beverly Hills

In recognition of its contributions to promoting clean air and healthy lungs, Breathe Southern California (Breathe SoCal) was honored with a proclamation from the City of Beverly Hills during a presentation at City Hall. The proclamation, presented by the Beverly Hills City Council, highlighted Breathe SoCal's commitment to improving lung health and advancing environmental advocacy throughout Southern California.

Skyline LLC and represented by former Mayor Steve Webb, seeks approval for a Development Plan Review, a Density Bonus Permit, and an R-4 Permit to allow for construction.

The development proposes an eight-story building reaching a height of 86 feet, 11 inches, with a total of 52 residential units. Twelve units would be located within Beverly Hills, while the remaining 40 would fall under Los Angeles jurisdiction. The project site currently houses a three-story, 15-unit building, which will be demolished to make way for the new construction.

Key features of the development include:

•Parking: Two subterranean levels and a surface parking area will accommodate 75 parking spaces, with 18 spaces in Beverly Hills and 57 in Los Angeles.

•Access: Primary pedestrian access will be from North Oakhurst Drive, with vehicular access via an allev connected to Alden Drive and Beverly Boulevard.

•Outdoor Space: A total of 1,727 square feet of outdoor living areas will be provided

through private and communal spaces.

The design includes three walkways for pedestrian access. with one walkway requiring the R-4 Permit approval in

Beverly Hills. The project incorporates three affordable housing units to align with local and state requirements. These units, located on

the first through third floors, will include: two and one unit for a low-income household.

The affordable units will match the size and design quality of the other oneand two-bedroom apartments.

The development seeks an 88.75% density bonus under California's Density Bonus Law to increase the number of units beyond standard zoning limits. The Los Angeles portion of the project has already been deemed statutorily exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) due to its alignment with density bonus provisions.

#### Arts and Culture **Commission Plans Enhanced MLK Day Commemoration for 2025**

The Arts and Culture Commission is planning an enhanced commemoration of Martin Luther King Jr. Day in January 2025

Chair Karla Gordy Bristol initiated the discussion during the commission's November 12 meeting, expressing a desire to elevate the city's recognition of King's legacy. Bristol and Vice Chair Pamela Beck subsequently met with staff on December 2 to review past observances and explore new ways to honor the civil rights leader.

In previous years, the City of Beverly Hills acknowledged MLK Day with several activities:

•Prepared Remarks: In 2023 and 2024, the Commission Chair delivered remarks on King's work and legacy during January meetings.



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•Event Listings: A calendar of regional MLK Day events was shared during the Commission's January meetings and included in agendas.



•Library Displays: The Beverly Hills Public Library highlighted book titles for adults and children about Dr. King's life and contributions. The Com-

to build on these efforts with new initiatives that further spotlight the significance of Dr. King's contributions:

•Notable Speaker Presentation: The Commission plans to host a special presentation during its January 14, 2025 meeting featuring a prominent speaker or organization to discuss Dr. King's enduring legacy.

•Library Display: The Beverly Hills Public Library will continue its tradition of showcasing books and materials about Dr. King's life and legacy. •Expanded Event Calendar: A comprehensive list of regional MLK Day events will be shared during the January 2025 Arts and Culture Commis-

sion meetings, providing community members with opportunities to participate in local celebrations.

City staff is working to confirm a speaker for the January meeting. Bristol is also expected to deliver remarks reflecting on King's life and influence during the event.

#### **Beverly Hills Considers Tightening Synthetic Turf** Regulations

The Beverly Hills Planning Commission is set to deliberate potential changes to synthetic turf regulations in residential front yards following the enactment of Senate Bill 676, at its Thursday meeting. The new state law, effective in 2024, reinstates local authority to regulate or ban synthetic turf installations, reversing restrictions introduced during California's historic drought.

Synthetic turf, often made from plastic and rubber materials, became a popular water-saving alternative during California's drought emergency in 2014. To comply with state mandates, Beverly Hills adopted an ordinance in 2015, allowing synthetic turf in up to 40% of residential front yards during severe water restrictions, known as "Stage D" events.

Despite its water-saving benefits, synthetic turf has drawn scrutiny for environmental concerns, such as microplastic pollution, chemical runoff, and harm to soil and tree health, according to a city staff report. Current city regulations prohibit synthetic turf in public rightsof-way and ban materials like rubber infill and nylon-based products.

Senate Bill 676, authored by Senator Ben Allen, restores the power of cities to regulate synthetic turf based on environmental and health considerations. This legislative change allows Beverly Hills to revisit its existing policies and consider revisions or a potential ban.

The Planning Commission will discuss whether to maintain, revise, or prohibit synthetic turf in residential front yards.

#### **City Council Continues Appeal For Proposed 14-Story Residential** Project

The City Council continued a public hearing regarding the appeal of an October 18, determination by city staff that deemed an application for a proposed 14-story residential building at 211-217 South Hamilton Drive incomplete.

The appeal, filed by representatives of Flamingo Investments and 18 Hamilton LLC, challenges City staff's decision that the application for the housing project was incomplete. The project includes two major components:

•Development Plan Review (DPR): Approval to construct a 14-story, 145-foot-tall residential building.

•General Plan Amendment (GPA), Zone Change (ZC), and Zone Text Amendment (ZTA): Changes to citywide land use regulations affecting commercial, multi-family, and mixeduse zones.

#### **City Council Honors BHPD Lead Traffic Control Officer**

On Tuesday, the City Council honored BHPD Lead Traffic Control Officer Jeffrey Grijalva for his 32 years of service to the City of Beverly Hills.

On December 4, Murray Fischer, representing the property owners, formally waived the 60-day limit, allowing the city more time to consider the matter.

#### **Arts and Culture Commission Discusses Art Installation Yayoi Kusama** and Carol Bove

City officials provided status updates on two public art installations in Beverly Gardens Park during a recent presentation to the Arts and Culture Com-

mission.

Acuna reported on the ongoing fabrication of Hymn of Life: Tulips, a whimsical sculpture by world-renowned artist Yayoi Kusama. Originally installed in 2007, the fiberglass artwork faced

structural issues caused bv weather exposure and frequent public interaction. To ensure its longevity, the sculpture was removed 2020 and sent to Art Bronze for refabrication in durable

stainless steel. Acuna's update detailed the timeline from the piece's deinstallation to its current progress. Once complete, the sculpture will return to Beverly Gardens Park.

In addition to Kusama's piece, offi-

cials discussed the restoration and reinstallation of Carol Bove's IO, a painted stainless steel sculpture acquired and installed in Beverly Gardens Park in 2015. Originally placed flush with the ground on a level cement pad, the piece sustained damage due to public interaction. To protect the artwork, it was removed, restored, and reinstalled on an elevated base surrounded by dense landscaping to reduce accessibility and prevent further damage.

Staff also highlighted challenges with the redesigned base and issues encountered during the artwork's restoration. Since the sculpture's initial purchase, the artist, Carol Bove, has changed gallery representation from Zwirner Gallery to Gagosian Gallery. A comprehensive history of the piece, including these concerns, will be presented to the City Council early next year for direction and next steps.

#### **City Council Approves National Opioid Settlement Funds for Police Department Programs**

The City Council accepted \$334,066 in funds from the National Opioid Litigation Settlement. These funds, distributed through the California Abatement Account, the National Opioid Abatement Trust II. and the Endo Public Opioid Trust Abatement Fund, will be allocated to the Police Department to address opioid-related initiatives.

The settlement resolves lawsuits filed between 2014 and 2020 against major pharmaceutical distributors, manufacturers, and pharmacies, including McKesson, Cardinal Health, Cencora (formerly AmerisourceBergen), Janssen Pharmaceuticals (a Johnson & Johnson subsidiary), Teva, Allergan, Walmart, Walgreens, and CVS. These lawsuits sought to mitigate the impact of the opioid crisis on communities.

To sustain and expand these efforts, the settlement funds will support the following:

•Naloxone Program Expansion: Pro-

curing additional supplies of Naloxone for new staff and ongoing program maintenance.

•Training Initiatives: Contracting with outside organizations to train staff on opioid recognition, evaluation, and prevention techniques.

•Safety Equipment: Purchasing AED devices, batteries, personal protective equipment, and safe packaging for handling suspected narcotics.

•Community Outreach: Funding opioid education programs, including high-profile panels at local high schools featuring experts and celebrities who have faced addiction challenges.

Additionally, the Police Department plans to partner with organizations like the Drug Awareness Foundation to promote drug prevention through school outreach and media campaigns, including billboards and bus advertisements.

The settlement funds will be appropriated into the Law Enforcement Grant Fund to finance these programs. The Police Department will use the funds for opioid-related training, equipment, community education, and operational needs.

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#### Social Media Ban

The Australian Parliament just enacted countrywide restrictions on the use of "social media" by the country's youth. Essentially, as I understand it, this would prohibit social media companies from providing accounts to children under 16.

The rationale expressed includes harm to children stemming from addiction and choices between the mental stresses, bullying, body shaming and social isolation.

According to the Associated Press:

"The harms to children from social media have been well documented in the two decades since Facebook's launch ushered in a new era in how the world communicates. Kids who spend more time on social media, especially as tweens or young teenagers, are more likely to experience depression and anxiety, according to multiple studies — though it is not yet clear if there is a causal relationship."

Further, the Associated Press reported:

"What's more, many are exposed to content that is not appropriate for their age, including pornography and violence, as well as social pressures about body image and makeup. They also face bullying, sexual harassment and unwanted advances from their peers as well as adult strangers. Because their brains are not fully developed, teenagers, especially younger ones the law is focused on, are also more affected by social comparisons than adults, so even happy posts from friends can send them into a negative spiral."

Paul Taske, associate director of litigation at the tech lobbying group NetChoice, says he considers the ban "one of the most extreme violations of free speech on the world stage today" even as he expressed relief that the First Amendment prevents such law in the United States.

"These restrictions would create a massive cultural shift," Taske said.

"Not only is the Australian government preventing young people from engaging with issues they're passionate about, but they're also doing so even if their parents are ok with them using digital services," he said. "Parents know their children and their needs the best, and they should be making these decisions for their families — not big government. That kind of forcible control over families inevitably will have downstream cultural impacts."

The details of Australia's ban are currently being worked out for the new law which would take effect in a year or so. "Social media" is not a defined term. An Australian minister has identified a number of companies including Meta Platform's Facebook and Instagram, Snapchat, Tik Tok, X and YouTube that would be off-limits to youngsters.

Principal Responsibility for implementation of and compliance with the ban is placed squarely on the shoulders of the social media providers-not the children or their parents. They are charged with adopting effective measures to ensure that no one under 16 will have accounts or otherwise be able to use their platform. Failure to do so will expose the companies to very substantial fines of up to \$50 million or so.

Other countries and jurisdictions have enacted or are considering similar measures.

As I come from the rotary dial era (some of you may know what I am referring to by "rotary dial"), and have not lived with teenagers for many years, I have little familiarity with social media. So I thought that I would dig a bit.

The first thing that I learned was that California has recently enacted a law intended to curb the use of social media by our youth. Other states are considering imposing controls on use of social media by youth.

The California law is called the "Protecting Our Kids from Social Media Addiction Act".

The bill would take effect on January 1, 2027. It makes unlawful for the provider of an "addictive" internet-based service or application to provide an addictive feed to a user, unless the operator does not have actual knowledge that the user is a minor; has reasonably determined that the user is not a minor; or has obtained verifiable parental consent to provide an addictive feed to the user who is a minor.

"Addictive feed" is defined as "an internet website, online service, online application, or mobile application, in which multiple pieces of media generated or shared by users are recommended, selected, or prioritized for display to a user based on information provided by the user, or otherwise associated with the user or the user's device" with certain exceptions.

A significant difference between this legislation and the Australian approach, for better or worse, is that the California law allows exceptions based on parental consent while the Australian approach does not allow for parents to make decisions. It occurred to me that some parents might appreciate taking enforcement of limits on social media use out of their hands.

Apart from this rudimentary legal research, I thought that I would ask some parents and community parents about whether they would favor meaningful restrictions on social media by youngsters. The first person I asked was my daughter, **Natalie Anne Cookson**, who is the mother of my 12 year old grandson, **Elliott**, and 10 year old granddaughter, **Emma**. Her answer: "100%!!"

Former Board of Education member Isabel Hacker told me:

"Students lack adequate control required to monitor moderate or limited use of social media. In

many instances for youth, social media leads to social withdrawal and poor academic achievement and other issues. AUSTRALIA is on the right path for recognizing that the well being of their young is a priority."

Gaby Alexander said:

"I think Australia has the right idea. There is just so much data on the harmful effects social media has on kids and teens. It is very hard for a parent to keep your kid off of social (as I do) when almost all of the kids at school are on it - it makes your kid out of the loop on a daily basis. And causes innumerable arguments about the issue. Which is enough to keep most parents from prohibiting it. Making it illegal protects the kids across the board."

From recently re-elected Board of Education President **Mandy Stern**:

"I believe any type of addiction is, of course, detrimental to any user, young or old. I understand that many platforms intentionally embed algorithms that hook young people in, so that they KEEP watching. (TikTok for one, will analyze what seems to interest the user and KEEP SERVING and feeding them with similar content). This is arguably evil to do to young people.

"Any screen activity that is done in a silo; in excessive isolation [is troublesome]. Some teen boys or pre-teen boys commonly spend 6 or more hours per day on certain fast-paced games or "quest" online...It's already bad if they are doing this simultaneously with a known friend from school. BUT it is even more depressing and alienating if they play solo, without any 'sharing' or strategizing with another soul for hours on end. If they do not have exposure to in-person socializing, especially with the opposite sex, many fall victim to online pornography addiction. And then they really never meet or date successfully."

Former popular three-time Beverly Hills Mayor **Tom Levyn** raised a number of questions:

"What about online libraries? They provide a service used by children."

"The cost of the study may bankrupt some of the providers."

"Is a child defined? What about CNN? What about ABC, NBC, etc when they provide election results, stories about climate change, etc?

"What about every advertiser online that provides a product (Fisher Price for kids, Amazon?)

"Seems like an idea that appears to have merit to some, but is completely unenforceable and very costly."

"Most important: what is the desired goal of the legislation? Is it mental health?

Social ability? Nicer to parents?"

**Ronit Stone** had some reservations: "Although in theory I support the concept of limiting screen time---I don't know how banning social media can be enforced if kids have cell phones. Not sure that it is "fair" or that penalties be levied only on the tech companies. I think parents have a responsibility to restrict the use of cell phones and screen time by their children. It is not just social media-it is video games and the addiction to the internet and incessant cell phone usage.

"Many tech execs themselves limit phone use and screen time for their own children up to age 14--that says a lot! If people whose livelihood depends on screen time don't let their own kids use it....they must know something about its deleterious effects."

**Ellie Yadegar**, the mother of two children in our schools, told me:

"I don't know any parent who thinks that social media has had a positive impact on their kids. It has actually destroyed them. But having said that, even if it were banned, what needs to be done is to have the culture and mentality of the parent population changed.

Not everyone felt that what they referred to as a "nanny state" measure thought that such legislation was a good idea. Former three-term Beverly Hills City Treasurer Eliot Finkel expressed a strong view that restrictions of this type should be left entirely to the discretion of parents.

Personally, I am inclined to think that imposing restrictions on the use of social media by youngsters and placing responsibility for enforcement on the social media providers AND parents is a good idea.

In last week's column entitled "Beverly Hills Commissions – To Be or Not to Be", I wrote about the fact that City Council and staff have little interest in the involvement of or obtaining independent advice from Commissions. Two recent events provide further evidence supporting this observation:

1) On Sunday November 24, all five members of the City Council had their pictures taken while attending the **Vahagn Setian** Foundation Tree Planting Ceremony at La Cienega Park; a member of the Recreation and Parks Commission told me that the Commission was not invited to or even informed of this event;

2) In mid-November, the Public Works Department sent out an RFP for "Mictrotransit [typo in original] Turnkey Services", an on demand service for the City. As far as I can tell, the Traffic & Parking Commission was not consulted. [This RFP will be the subject of a future column.]

To repeat: If the independent advice of commissions is not wanted, let's just disband all of them.

#### **BHPD to Hold Checkpoint Friday**

The Beverly Hills Police Department (BHPD) Traffic Bureau will conduct a sobriety and driver's license checkpoint on Friday, December 13, in the area of North Santa Monica Blvd. and Crescent Drive.

The checkpoint will be operational from approximately 7:00 PM until 2:00 AM. All traffic will pass through the checkpoint, and uniformed officers will stop and contact motorists. Officers will check for alcohol and/or drug-impaired drivers and verify that all contacted drivers possess a valid driver's license.

"Impaired drivers put others on the road at significant risk," Chief Mark Stainbrook said. "Any prevention measures that reduce the number of impaired drivers on our roads significantly improve traffic safety."

The BHPD reminds the public that impaired driving is not limited to alcohol. Some prescription medications and over-the-counter drugs may interfere with the ability to drive safely. Additionally, while medicinal and recreational marijuana is legal, driving under the influence of marijuana is illegal.

A grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration provides funding for impaired driving enforcement operations.



#### **ORDINANCE NO. 24-0-2906**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS AMENDING THE BEVERLY HILLS MUNICIPAL CODE TO ELIMINATE THE RENT STABILIZATION COMMISSION AND FINDING THE ORDINANCE EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA)

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEV-ERLY HILLS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. In 2018, the City Council amended Chapter 6 of Title 4 of the Bev-erly Hills Municipal Code to establish more comprehensive rent stabilization rules for the majority of rental units in the City that are subject to that Chapter of the Code, including regulations governing just cause evictions. The City Council further directed that the Rent Stabilization Commission ("Commis-sion") should be established to review and provide recommendations to the City Council

regarding possible revisions to Chapter 5 and Chapter 6 of Title 4 of the Municipal Code that had not been resolved by the City Council and to undertake other tasks assigned by the City Council to the Commisssion from time to time. Accordingly, the City Council adopted an ordinance that established the Commission and thereafter appointed members and alternates to serve on the Commission. The Commission subsequently conducted duly noticed public meetings and reviewed and analyzed the issues that the City Council had instructed the Commission to consider and provided recommendations to the City Council about those issues.

Section 2. On June 18, 2024, the City Council conducted a duly noticed study session and determined that because the Rent Stabilization Commission had complet-ed the tasks that the City Council had assigned to the Commission, that the Commission was no longer necessary and should be discontinued.

Section 3. This Ordinance and the elimination of the Commission were assessed in accordance with the authority and criteria contained in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the State CEQA Guidelines, and the environmental regula-tions of the City. The City Council finds that the elimination of the Commission and the adoption of this Ordinance will not have a significant environmental impact and is exempt from CEQA pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations, which states that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. This exemption is applicable because this Ordinance is making a change to the Beverly Hills Municipal Code that eliminates an adminis-trative body that provides recommendations to the City Council regarding rent stabilization issues. Therefore, it can be seen with certainty that this Ordinance and the elimination of the Commission have no potential to cause a significant effect on the environment.

Section 4. The City Council hereby repeals Article 5 ("Rent Stabilization Commission") of Chapter 2 of Title 2 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code.

Section 5. Notwithstanding the pro-

visions of Section 2-2-105 D of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code, former members and alternates of the Rent Stabilization Commission shall not be required to wait one year after the end of their term of service on the Commission before applying to serve on another City commission.

Section 6. Severability. If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, If any clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or place, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect.

Section 7. Publication. The City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation published and circulated in the City within fifteen (15) days after its passage in accordance with Section 36933 of the Government Code, shall certify to the adoption of this Ordinance, and shall cause this Or-dinance and her certification, together with proof of publication, to be entered in the Book

of Ordinances of the Council of this City.

Section 8. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall go into effect and be in full force and effect at 12:01 a.m. on the thirty-first (31st) day after its passage. Adopted: December 3, 2024 Effective: January 3, 2025
