City to Survey Coldwater Canyon Residents on Future of Street Trees

The Public Works Commission is expected to discuss a vote among Coldwater Canyon Drive residents on the future of street trees, at its Thursday meeting.

The effort focuses on selecting a new tree type to replace vacant tree sites and to eventually succeed the existing Canary Island Pines as they die or are removed.

The move follows concerns about the long-term suitability of Canary Island Pines, particularly their performance over time and their presence in a designated High Severity Fire Zone.

During its March 13 meeting, the commission agreed to begin the process of evaluating replacement tree options as part of a potential Street Tree Master Plan phase

The city organized an on-site meeting with residents on May 18, to review possible tree alternatives and gather community feedback. According to a city staff report, three residents—representing three addresses out of a total of 69 on the street—attended the meeting.

During the meeting, attendees were shown three candidate tree species selected by the city arborist:

- •Chinese Pistache
- •Holly Oak
- •Sky Climber Oak

The city advised that each tree met multiple criteria used to assess suitability, including water needs, local performance history, maintenance impact, and compatibility with the city's Urban Forest Management Plan goals.

Attendees expressed a general preference for an evergreen or semi-deciduous tree over a fully deciduous one, though none of the alternatives received unanimous support.

The city now recommends that a formal ballot be sent to Coldwater Canyon Drive residents.

The ballot will give property owners the option to either leave tree sites vacant or vote for one of the proposed replacement species. If at least 51% of households respond, staff will bring the results back to the commission for consideration. If approved, the plan would then require final approval by the City Council.

Planning Commission Approves Three-Story Commercial Building at 414 North Beverly Drive

The Planning Commission approved a development proposal for the construction of a new three-story commercial building

at 414 North Beverly Drive. The proposed project would replace the existing one-story structure currently occupied by the restaurant Nate 'n Al's.

The applicant requested to construct a 45-foot-tall commercial building totaling approximately 19,481 square feet. The new building, designed in a modern contemporary style, would feature glass storefronts, white plaster walls, black window trim, and landscaped terraces on the upper levels.

No specific tenants have been identified for the new building, though future occupancy is expected to include retail or restaurant uses. If rooftop dining is later proposed, the applicant would need to return for further review and approval.

Because the site is located within half a mile of the planned Wilshire/Rodeo Metro Station, Assembly Bill 2097 exempts it from minimum parking requirements.

A local transportation assessment estimated 48 additional AM peak hour trips and 43 PM trips. However, it concluded that surrounding intersections would continue to operate at acceptable levels of service.

Historic resource assessments determined that the current building, constructed in the early 1920s, does not meet historic significance criteria. Nate 'n Al's is not tied to the building's architectural features but the restaurant has indicated it may relocate elsewhere in Beverly Hills.

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circulation for the County of Los Angeles. Case # BS065841 of the Los Angeles Superior Court, on November 30, 2000.

Kevin J. Gregory, 57, was sentenced to 57 months in prison by Judge Josephine L. Staton. He was also ordered to pay \$2.77 million in restitution. Gregory has been in federal custody since May 2023 and pleaded guilty to one count of making false claims to the IRS.

programs, using a purported Beverly Hills

business as part of the scheme.

According to court documents, from November 2020 through April 2022, Gregory submitted multiple fraudulent tax returns on behalf of a company he claimed was based in Beverly Hills. The business, Elijah USA Farm Holdings, was described in filings as a farming and transportation company with dozens of employees and millions in payroll expenses. In reality, investigators found the company had no employees, conducted no farming or transportation work, and paid no wages.

Authorities say Gregory falsely claimed the business was eligible for COVID-19 tax credits, including the employee retention credit and paid sick and family leave credit. The IRS issued some of the requested refunds, and Gregory used over \$2.7 million of that money on personal expenses.

One of the largest fraudulent filings occurred in January 2022, when Gregory submitted a tax return claiming a refund of nearly \$24 million for one quarter. In that return, he falsely reported that Elijah Farm employed 33 people and paid nearly \$1.6 million in wages, along with nearly \$18 million in tax deposits-none of which occurred, according to prosecutors.

For those in the early stages of memory loss, OPICA's weekly three-hour Brain Train program offers emotional support, cognitive stimulation, and social connection. Activities include therapist-led groups, memory-boosting exercises, and Yoga for the Brain, which combines mindfulness and movement to reduce stress.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE

The Council of the City of Beverly Hills, at its regular meeting to be held on Tuesday, **July 1, 2025, at 7:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard**, in the Council Chamber of the City Hall, 455 N. Rexford Drive, Beverly Hills, CA 90210, will hold a public hearing to consider:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS AMENDING SHORT TERM RENTAL REGULATIONS (TRANSIENT USES) FOR SINGLE FAMILY AND MULTIFAMILY RESIDENTIAL ZONES, AND MAKING A DETERMINATION OF EXEMPTION UNDER THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA)

The City Council will consider adoption of an ordinance to amend the short term rental regulations applicable to single-family and multifamily residential zones, which are referred to as "single-family and multifamily transient uses" in the Beverly Hills Municipal Code (BHMC). The Planning Commission previously reviewed this topic at the August 8, 2024 study session and adopted Planning Commission Resolution No. 2076 unanimously recommending the City Council adopt the draft ordinance at their November 14, 2024 regular meeting. The draft ordinance includes, but is not limited to the following changes:

- •A prohibition on short term rental uses in any residential zone of the City, including the use of accessory features such as pools or tennis courts;
- •A minimum initial lease term of one year for the rental of units in single-family residential zones and a minimum initial lease term of 6 months for multi-family units in the City: and
- •Changes to other sections of the BHMC related to short term rentals, such as a penalty fee structure specific to short term rentals.

This summary of the ordinance is prepared and published in accordance with the requirements of Government Code §36933. Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code §36933, a certified copy of the entirety of the text of the proposed ordinance will be available for review during normal business hours at the Office of the City Clerk Office located at City Hall, 455 N. Rexford Drive, Second Floor, Beverly Hills, CA 90210 at least five days before the City Council will consider adoption of the ordinance.

ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW

This project has been assessed in accordance with the authority and criteria contained in the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), the State CEQA Guidelines, and the environmental regulations of the City. Since the project does not authorize construction, and actually imposes greater use restrictions on certain properties to protect the public health, safety and general welfare, there is no possibility that it may have a significant effect on the environment. In addition, the project reflects minor changes in land use limitations, and do not result in changes to land use or density. Accordingly, the City Council will consider a recommendation to find the project categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to Sections 15061(b)(3) and 15305 of Title 14 of the California Code of

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

Metro Planning

On May 30, Mayor **Sharona Nazarian** sent a letter to the community providing updates on the City's public safety plans for the opening of the Wilshire/La Cienega Metro station so I thought that it would be a good time to provide my current random observations and thoughts.

As I have written about both Metro and the City's proposal to provide a Micro Transit system to facilitate transportation to and from the Metro station(s), this updates the proposal.

The starting point is the questions of when will service begin at the La Cienega station and when will service begin at the Wilshire/Rodeo station that has been projected to open approximately one year later. Metro has said for months that the service to La Cienega will commence in the "late fall" of 2025. As of now, no specific date has been announced and Metro has not set a date but most Metro and City folks think that it will be before December 31, 2025. As that is less than seven months from now, it is fair to be a bit skeptical that opening will occur in 2025. But almost certainly, within a year from now the trains will be running into and out of Beverly Hills.

Metro Security

By far the most important issue now in the minds of Beverly Hills residents is security. Specifically, what is being done to ensure that Metro passengers arriving in Beverly Hills will not threaten the persons or properties of Beverly Hills residents or businesses.

It is appropriate to remind ourselves that for many years the City has been served by numerous express and local bus lines who bring people into and out of the City and while the Metro may carry more passengers it is not as though the City was previously inaccessible to non-reidents.

But we are now focused on Metro and Mayor Nazarian's May 30 letter identifies a number of security steps that are being taken in anticipation of its arrival including, but not limited to, the following:

- •Two police officers and one sergeant "exclusive" to the Beverly Hills stations 24/7;
- •Two security officers at each station 24/7;
- •A public safety structure on the above ground station plaza with Beverly Hills public safety staff present;
- •Connection between the BHPD Real Time Watch Center and Metro's cam-

eras in the stations and on the trains; •Upgraded physical security at the platform including the latest high security fare gates deployed on the Met-

ro system.

There are other steps being taken including authorization to hire eight additional sworn police positions.

By far, in my judgment, for reasons that I will explain, the most important guarantors of security are entry and exit gates that ensure that only fare-paying passengers can enter or, most important for the security of our city, can exit.

The Metro system consists of more than 100 stations. Entry and exit by fare-evaders is very easy. At some stations, substantially more than half of the "passengers" entering do not pay fares. And fare-evaders are a huge problem. For the 2023-24 year, more than 94% of the people arrested for violent crimes on Metro were fare evaders.

Now Metro has started a program to install tall 7' gates with sensors and locks that will ensure that only fare paying passengers can enter and they can be programmed to require that only fare paying passengers can exit. (The use of a paid ticket to "tap in" and "tap out.")

Here is what Metro says about these new gates:

- •They're taller. Standing over 7 feet tall, it's impossible for fare evaders to jump over the new gates. (The current faregates, by contrast, hover around 3 feet.)
- •They're more precise. The new faregates are equipped with additional sensors that detect motion more precisely than their predecessors. This has been proven to reduce the potential for non-paying riders "piggybacking" or "tailgating" behind paying riders.
- •They're sturdier: The new gates have special electromechanical locks, so determined fare evaders can't force open the door by pushing them.
- •They're more user-friendly.
- •They're "smarter": If a fare evader does manage to squeeze through the new gates, the sensors can record the incident, providing valuable data that will help us deploy our staff more effectively.

So far, these gates have been installed at only a few Metro stations out of more than 100 stations. Early results are very encouraging as two of the first stations where these were installed have seen increases in fare-paying passengers of 148% and 248% and a 75% reductions in reported incidents.

Metro has committed and a Metro spokesperson has assured me that such gates will be installed at all new stations including the Beverly Hills stations.

The most important thing that our City officials can do is to make certain that Metro does install and maintain these gates for entry and exit and apprehend promptly any fare-evaders.

The other steps outlined are less likely to be implemented or, if implemented, less likely to be effective.

The one that caught my eye was the first one mentioned in Mayor Nazarian's letter: "Two police officers and one sergeant per shift "exclusive" to the Beverly Hills stations 24/7";

Deputy City Manager **Keith Sterling** told me that the two police officers and one police sergeant referenced in Mayor Nazarian's letter are not BHPD personnel but, rather, from the new or planned Metro police force. Specifically, Mr. Sterling said: "The cost of providing this level of law enforcement (2 officers and 1 sergeant) will be the responsibility of Metro."

But...

It strikes me as highly unlikely that Metro will provide police protection at this level that is "exclusive", that is, dedicated to the Beverly Hills stations. ("Dedicted" is my word but I see no other reasonable interpretation of "exclusive" in this context.) Metro is only in the beginning stages of a five year plan to form its own police capabilities and is now facing a budget deficit of over \$2B over the next five years. It would take a substantial number of officers to cover each Metro station at this level and, as Metro could not likely provide this dedicated or exclusive level of service to Beverly Hills and nowhere else, a substantial number would be needed to cover all of the Metro stations.

My review of the contract between the City and Metro did not leave me with a conclusion that Metro would provide two police officers and one police sergeant 24/7 or otherwise dedicated to the City's Metro stations.

So, I asked Metro to confirm that it had made such a commitment.

Metro spokesperson Maya Pogoda told me that: "Metro doesn't usually publicly discuss deployment for security reasons" but did not respond to my specific request to state whether or not Metro will provide or pay the cost of the announced level of two police officers and one police sergeant 24/7 that will be exclusive or dedicated to the Beverly Hills stations.

I will believe that Metro will provide two police officers and one police sergeant whose duties will be exclusive to or dedicated to the Beverly Hills stations when I see it. I may have been born at night, but not last night.

I am pleased that the City Council has approved eight additional sworn BHPD officers but note that actually hiring new officers has become more and more of a challenge. At the City recent Council budget meeting, Chief **Mark Stainbrook** stated that BHPD was currently "down" 13 officers out of an authorized strength of 154 sworn officers. I do not know whether the 154 sworn officer authorization or being "down" 13 officers includes the eight new positions.

Notably, while these security measures will be useful in minimizing threats from Metro passengers entering the City, they will do nothing to improve the safety or attractiveness of riding the Metro. At a minimum, security on the trains will not improve until fare-evaders will be minimized throughout the system. Metro cars should be used only by those who are using them to travel to where they want to be, not as simply a place to be.

Microtransit

Turning to Microtransit, last year, the City's Public Works Department announced that on November 15, 2024 it had published Requests for Proposals (RFPs) for the provision of key "microtransit" services. This is for a flexible transit service for an 18-month pilot program in the form of mobility on-demand or microtransit services for general public use within the City of Beverly Hills and identified destinations. The objective was to have this service up and running by early summer, 2025 so that it could operate smoothly in time for the opening of the Wilshire/La Cienega Metro station.

As I had heard nothing further about this, I inquired about the status.

Mr. Sterling advised me that a number of proposals had been received and that they would be presented to the Council Liaisons in July or August. No vendor has been selected and there is no provision for the cost of such a system in the budget for the 2025-26 fiscal year commencing July 1, 2025. Procedurally, there is a long way to go before this proposal comes to fruition or even comes before the City Council. My prediction is that this will not happen prior to the opening of either the Wilshire/La Cienega or the Wilshire/Rodeo stations, if ever

A few bottom line conclusions:

Strong gates precluding fare evaders from entering the Metro from Beverly Hills or, more importantly, exiting Metro into Beverly Hills will go a long way to ensuring security. Together with the other measures, if and to the extent implemented, I am not alarmed by the prospect that our security will be impaired by the advent of the subway.

I do not anticipate that a Beverly Hills Microtransit system will be implemented in time to provide transport to and from the Metro stations when they are first open for business. However, unless and until Metro solves the problems of security on the trains and in its stations, there will be, regrettably, little demand from Beverly Hills residents for such a service.

BEVERLY HILLS POLICE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION TO ISSUE VOTE OF NO **CONFIDENCE IN CHIEF**

The Beverly Hills Police Officers Association (BHPOA) has called for a vote of no confidence in Police Chief Mark Stainbrook, according to an internal email obtained by The Weekly. The email, sent to BHPOA members by association president Christian Bond, outlines a list of concerns related to department leadership and management practices.

In the message, Bond stated that the decision to initiate the vote followed what he described as "an overwhelmingly large number of BHPOA members" raising concerns with the board of directors. The board determined that a formal vote was "warranted and necessary," according to

Among the issues raised in the communication were the reassignment of sergeants from specialty roles without explanation or a formal process, and the denial of opportunities for other qualified sergeants to apply for those positions. The association also cited a departmental strategy that emphasizes the use of private security contractors and technology—such

as the Real Time Watch Center—over the recruitment and retention of sworn offi-

Additional concerns included the intent to fill key command staff positions, such as captain, with outside candidates rather than promoting internally. The email also noted proposed policy changes involving rotation schedules and bonus assignments that had previously been discontinued, and which the association believes may impact department stability and morale.

The BHPOA further pointed to a perceived lack of transparency and communication within the department, as well as what it described as a diminished role for input from both the association and command staff. Questions were also raised about the accuracy of staffing reports presented to the City Council, particularly regarding the inclusion of annuitants, cadets, and pending hires in sworn personnel counts.

The association also expressed concern over the continued use of acting sergeants, lieutenants, and captains, and cited instances of personnel remaining in positions despite not meeting required training standards. Lastly, the message referenced

reports that Stainbrook had interviewed for a position with the Los Angeles District Attorney's Office as a sign of possible lack of long-term commitment to the department.

The BHPOA clarified that the vote is not a legal mechanism to remove the Chief but is meant as a formal statement by members regarding their level of confidence in the department's leadership.

The vote was expected to be conducted anonymously through SurveyMonkey and results were released after the Weekly's deadline.

Following the BHPOA announcement, Stainbrook sent a separate message to department personnel, also obtained by The Weekly, responding to the call for a vote.

In his email, Stainbrook expressed disappointment at the timing of the decision and indicated a willingness to discuss the

"I am happy to discuss these point by point with anyone who wishes to speak with me," Stainbrook wrote. He added that he would be available to meet with staff and also stated that he intends to release additional information when appro-

ORDINANCE NO. 25-O-2914

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF BEVER-LY HILLS PROHIBITING INTERFERENCE WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT DRONES AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS AND ADDING CHAPTER 13 TO TITLE 5 OF THE BEVERLY HILLS MUNICIPAL CODE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEVERLY HILLS HEREBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Chapter 13 is hereby added to Title 5 of the Beverly Hills Municipal Code regarding law enforcement drones to read as follows:

"CHAPTER 13. PROHIBITING INTER-FERENCE WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT DRONES 5-13-1: DEFINITIONS:

As used in this chapter, unless the context otherwise clearly indicates, the words and phrases are defined as follows:

A. "Law Enforcement Drone" refers to any unmanned aerial vehicle, including a drone, that is operated by or under the authority of the City of Beverly Hills Police Department or any other law enforcement agency or the Beverly Hills Fire Department.

B. "Interference" means any action, including but not limited to physical obstruction or intentional jamming, or any other attempt to disrupt, damage, or hinder the operation of a Law Enforcement Drone.

C. "Operator" refers to the individual or entity controlling or directing the operation of a Law Enforcement Drone.

5-13-2: PROHIBITED ACTIONS:

A. No person shall Interfere with the operation of a Law Enforcement Drone, including but not limited to:

1. Physically obstructing or damaging a Law Enforcement Drone.

2. Using any device or equipment, including drones, lasers, or other tools, to disrupt, block, or jam signals used by Law Enforcement Drones.

3. Any other act intended to Interfere with the lawful operation of a Law Enforcement

Drone.

B. No person shall operate an

B. No person shall operate an unmanned aerial vehicle, including a drone, or any other device in such a way that it poses a risk of collision, damage, or Interference with the operation of a Law Enforcement Drone.

C. No person shall operate an unmanned aerial vehicle, including a drone, or any other device so that the unmanned aerial vehicle flies within two hundred (200) feet of a Law Enforcement Drone.

5-13-3: PENALTIES:

In addition to other penalties set forth in this Municipal Code or State law, if the Interference with a Law Enforcement Drone results in damage or destruction of the drone, the responsible person shall be liable for the full cost of the repair or replacement of the Law Enforcement Drone."

Section 2. Severability. If any section, subsection, subdivision, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or place, is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the final decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this Ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect.

<u>Section 3.</u> <u>Publication</u>. The City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published at least once in a newspaper of general circulation
