Midblock Crosswalk on La Cienega Boulevard in the Works

The Traffic and Parking Commission was expected to discuss a conceptual design for a new midblock pedestrian crosswalk with a signal on La Cienega Boulevard at its Wednesday meeting, which occurred after the *Weekly's* deadline. The crossing is proposed between Gregory Way and Olympic Boulevard, adjacent to La Cienega Park.

The location has been identified as a Tier 1 priority under the Complete Streets Action Plan due to the current lack of pedestrian crossings in the area.

La Cienega Boulevard in this segment is a principal arterial street with three southbound lanes and two northbound lanes that include metered parking. A fenced median currently separates traffic directions, and a prior city project added barriers to prevent midblock crossings due to safety concerns.

The conceptual plan includes a pedestrian signal that would operate similarly to others used in the city's Triangle area. When activated, the signal would require vehicles to stop for crossing pedestrians. The design would also involve the removal of some metered parking on the east side of the street to comply with state visibility requirements. According to the staff report, the new crosswalk would connect the east side of La Cienega Park with the public parking structure located on the west side of the street.

The estimated cost for developing design plans and specifications is \$99,500.

Consideration by the Beverly Hills City Council is expected in mid to late 2025.

Beverly Hills Drafts Interim Objective Design Standards for Affordable Housing Projects

The City of Beverly Hills has developed a set of Interim Objective Design Standards for multi-family housing projects that include affordable units, in response to evolving state housing laws and local policy commitments. The Architectural and Design Review Commission was expected to discuss the draft standards during a study session on Wednesday, July 16, which occurred after the *Weekly's* deadline.

The standards aim to streamline the approval process for qualifying projects by removing the requirement for architectural review, provided the project complies fully with a newly proposed checklist of objective design criteria. All other city approvals, such as Development Plan Review and tract maps, would still apply.

The standards are intended to help implement Program 12.1 of the City's certified 2021–2029 Housing Element and to align with state legislation such as the Housing Accountability Act and Senate Bill 330. These laws require that cities rely solely on objective—and not discretionary—design standards when evaluating certain housing projects, especially those that include affordable units.

According to a city staff report, the proposed standards translate longstanding design goals into 20 specific yes/no requirements covering massing, privacy, materials, landscaping, and other architectural elements. These criteria are designed to eliminate ambiguity, increase transparency for applicants, and maintain the established design character.

Under the draft, a project that meets all the listed standards would bypass architectural review by the commission. However, applicants can request up to five deviations from the standards through the Development Plan Review process. Projects seeking more than five deviations would still require full commission review.

According to a city staff report, the draft standards were created through a collaborative process involving both the Architectural and Design Review Commission and the Planning Commission, with input from a joint Ad



Hoc Committee and local design professionals. Architects who participated in a public listening session earlier this year expressed general support for an objective review process but raised concerns about certain restrictions, such as side-wall modulation requirements and limitations on materials like vinyl windows. In response, staff revised several standards for clarity and flexibility.

While the design standards are initially limited to multi-family projects that include affordable housing, city officials are already planning a broader Phase 2 initiative to develop permanent objective design standards that would apply to all multi-family and mixed-use developments.

No formal vote or adoption was expected at the Wednesday meeting. Instead, commissioners were expected to provide feedback that will help shape the next version of the draft. The Planning Commission is expected to take up the updated proposal in a study session later this summer, after which the City Council may consider it for adoption.

City to Present Traffic Safety Proposal for Olympic Boulevard at Upcoming Commission Meeting

The Traffic and Parking Commission was scheduled to receive a staff presentation regarding proposed peak hour turn restrictions on Olympic Boulevard during Wednesday's meeting, which occurred after the *Weekly's* deadline. The measure is intended to improve traffic safety at several non-signalized intersections along the corridor, which has been identified as one of the city's highest collision zones.

The presentation will outline plans to install new "right turn only" restrictions for northbound and southbound drivers at select intersections along Olympic Boulevard. These restrictions would be in effect during weekday peak hours—7 to 10 a.m. and 3 to 7 p.m.—when parking lanes convert into additional travel lanes.

The proposed changes stem from the City's Local Road Safety Plan, finalized in August 2024, which ranked Olympic Boulevard among the top five streets in Beverly Hills most in need of safety improvements. According to a city staff report, non-signalized intersections along this corridor experience frequent collisions, particularly involving drivers turning left or attempting to cross multiple lanes of traffic from side streets.

Olympic Boulevard's configuration

includes two travel lanes in each direction, a center turn lane, and parking lanes that function as travel lanes during peak hours. This roadway design results in drivers crossing up to seven lanes of moving traffic during rush hour, increasing the risk of accidents.

To address these patterns, city staff recommend implementing peak hour left-turn and cross-traffic restrictions at the following intersections:

- Southbound only: Linden Drive, McCarty Drive, Bedford Drive, El Camino Drive
- Northbound only: Crescent Drive, alley between Doheny Drive and Wetherly Drive, alley between Clark Drive and Robertson Boulevard
- Both directions: Elm Drive, Maple Drive, Palm Drive, Almont Drive, Swall Drive, Clark Drive

Following installation, the Beverly Hills Police Department (BHPD) will conduct targeted enforcement to help inform drivers of the new regulations.

The total estimated cost for the signage installation is \$5,000.

Filmmaker Kyle Newman Joins BHUSD as Broadcast Production Program Director

The Beverly Hills Unified School District has announced the appointment of filmmaker and author Kyle Newman as the new Director of its Broadcast Production Program. Newman, known for directing films such as Fanboys, Barely Lethal, and 1Up, will lead the district's media-focused career pathway while continuing his work in the entertainment industry.

According to the district, the move is intended to integrate professional-level film and television production into the classroom, offering students direct exposure to real-world industry practices. Newman, who has worked with names like Taylor Swift and Lana Del Rey and co-authored multiple *New York Times* bestsellers, said the program is designed to offer students hands-on experience across all stages of production.

"If you want to learn what it really takes to become a filmmaker, this is the class," said Newman. "From story development to editing, set experience to post-production, students will have the chance to work on real projects, meet real professionals, and take their skills beyond the classroom."

Newman is also developing content for the district's broadcast platforms, which BHUSD says will soon expand to

streaming services including Apple TV, Amazon Fire, and Roku. The programming will include both student-created work and district features.

"Kyle brings the highest level of expertise and credibility. He is here to help our students build real careers, not just classroom projects," said Superintendent Alex Cherniss. "This is a perfect example of how BHUSD blends academic rigor with career readiness. We're proud to support a program that sets students up for meaningful success."

Applications Open for 2025 Team Beverly Hills Program

The City of Beverly Hills has opened the recruitment period for the 2025 Team Beverly Hills program, with applications being accepted through Friday, August 15.

Established in 1996, Team Beverly Hills is a municipal education program aimed at providing residents with an in-depth view of city operations. The program includes a series of interactive sessions with

departments such as Public Works, Emergency Management, Information Technology, Community Services, and Public Safety.

To date, more than 800 residents have participated in the program. According to the City, over 70 percent of current elected officials and commissioners are graduates of Team Beverly Hills.

The upcoming class will include 50 residents: 30 appointed by the City Council, 18 selected through a random lottery, and two chosen by the Beverly Hills Unified School District. In addition, five members of the business community will be appointed by the City Council to participate.

Beverly High Reports 2024 AP Exam Results for 438 Students

Beverly High administered 936 Advanced Placement (AP) exams to 438 students in May 2024. According to school data, 84% of the exams scored 3 or higher, with 34% earning the top score of 5.

The exams covered a range of subjects, including Calculus AB and BC, Biology, Chemistry, various Art and Design courses, English Language and Literature, and several social science and language courses. The percentage of students scoring 3 or better varied by subject, with some courses such as 3D Art and Design, Drawing, French Language and Culture, and Precalculus reporting 100%, while others like Psychology had 51%.

The exams spanned a variety of subjects, with pass rates (scores of 3 or better) differing by course. Some of the reported pass rates include:

- 2D Art and Design: 73%
- 3D Art and Design: 100%
- Biology: 95%

Since its founding, the department has been led by 10 Fire Chiefs and continues to provide fire protection and emergency services to the community. Currently led by Chief Greg Barton, the BHFD holds a Class 1 rating.

Way Too Early Take on City Council Race

As the next Beverly Hills City Council Election is less than a year away on June 2, 2026, my "way too early" take is overdue.

I tried to stimulate interest in the November 2024 election for the Board of Education but waited too late to start the process. As I noted then, a robust list of good candidates can lead to a meaningful public discussion of issues. Such discussion and debate is very important for the City. Unfortunately we did not get that during the race for three open seats on the Board of Education and only four candidates.

I have learned from my ineffective attempt to encourage Board of Education candidates in addition to the highly qualified-incumbent **Dr. Amanda Stern**, who was running for reelection, that I should not wait until the last minute.

This is a way too early commentary on the June 2, 2026 City council election intended to stimulate discussion, interest and maybe a well-qualified candidate or two.

There are three open seats as the fourth term of Vice Mayor John Mirisch, the second term of Lester Friedman and first term of Mayor Sharona Nazarian are coming to an end.

I am NOT now endorsing anyone but, rather, reporting. And with an opinion or two or comment or two.

Also, I welcome any comments or suggestions that you wish to offer.

Given the importance of name recognition and incumbency, I will start with our three incumbents. While neither Mayor **Nazarian** nor Councilmember **Friedman** have announced their candidacy, I am certain that both are considering running, Mayor **Nazarian** for her second term and Councilmember **Friedman** for his third term. Similarly, Councilmember Mirisch may be considering running for his fifth term.

Councilmember **Mirisch** had completed three terms when the Beverly Hills voters approved a three term limit on elected officers in the City. At the same time, John Mirisch was elected for his fourth term. He may consider running for a fifth term in the event that he can present a strong legal argument that, under California law, terms completed prior to enactment of term limits for General Law cities, such as Beverly Hills, do not count against the limit.

All three would be strong candidates. However, whether or not Councilmember Mirisch is eligible to run, no Beverly Hills Councilmember other than John has served more than three terms.

Assuming that Mayor Nazarian and Councilmember Friedman run, it is realistic to observe that there is, at most, one open seat that is up for grabs.

Others who have run unsuccessfully in the recent past and who may be considering running again include (in alphabetical order):

Tiffany Davis – finished 9th in 2024 Andy Licht – finished 5th in 2022

Vera Markowitz – finished 6th in 2022

Nooshin Meshkaty – finished 6th in 2024

Alissa Roston – finished 3d in 2024 I note that for these, it may be an uphill battle as no candidate who ran unsuccessfully for the City Council once or more times ran again successfully in more than 20 years. However, Nancy Krasne was elected to a second non-consecutive term by seven votes in 2013 after losing in 2011. Alissa Roston may be an exception as she finished only one place below the two successful candidates.

Here are other potential candidates (alphabetically) who should consider running; their candidacies can only enhance the campaign discussions.

Karen Afra-Maghen – Chair, Traffic & Parking Commission

Noelle Freeman Batista – Commissioner, Human Re-

lations Commission; Chair of Next Beverly Hills; very knowledgeable about City issues.

Alan Block – Commissioner, Cultural Heritage Commission; former commissioner Planning Commission and Recreation and Parks Commission.

Bobbe Jo Dawson – recently completed a term as Chair of the Board of Directors of the Beverly Hills Chamber of Commerce.

Jill or **Lee Egerman** – Son and daughter-in-law of former Mayor Mark Egerman; very active in Beverly Hills Education Foundation.

Dr. Erica Felsenthal – recently completed a six year term on Health & Safety Commission; member of City's Climate Action & Adaptation Committee (CAAC); sponsored Day of Wellness for the City.

Howard Fisher – former member of Planning Commission; City Treasurer.

Lori Greene Gordon – Cultural Heritage Commissioner; former member of Planning Commission; a brilliant and energetic member of the community; ran in 2020 and finished third to \$100,000+ of PAC opposition and City staff thumbs on the scale.

Isabel Hacker – former member of Board of Education.

Terri Kaplan – Chair, Planning Commission

Myra Lurie – Co-Chair of Maple Counseling Center; former member of Recreation and Parks Commission; member of CAAC; former member, Board of Education.

David Mirharooni – former Chairman of the Board of the Chamber of Commerce; member, City Council Property Owners Task Force.

Mark Nehoray – current chair of the Public Works Commission

Wendy Nystrom – member of the Public Works Commission; co-chair of CAAC **Rebecca Pynoos** – currently vice chair of the Architectural & Design Commission; former member of the Cultural Heritage Commission; member of softball team that I coached in early 1990's (and tried to hide in right field).

Tara Riceberg – Commissioner, Recreation & Parks Commission.

Gary Ross – accomplished labor and employment lawyer; member of Planning Commission; former member of Health & Safety Commission.

Amie Nebenzahl Sherry – former member of the Recreation & Parks Commission.

Dr. Amanda Stern – educational psychologist; now in second term as elected member of the Board of Education; reelected as top vote getter.

Tina Wiener – President of the Beverly Hills Education Foundation.

Allison Witmer – effective slow growth activist.

Jeff Wolfe – Vice Chair of Planning Commission; former member of Public Works Commission.

Bob Wunderlich – former Mayor and Councilmember; narrowly (less than 1%) lost bid for reelection in 2022.

Note to the above: Please consider tossing your hat in the ring.

I understand that the City Council has enacted or is considering enacting a rule limiting service on City Commissions to six year terms on two commissions. This strikes me as a bad idea for several reasons. It could serve to preclude service from some of our residents who are most knowledgeable about the operation of the City. We have enough trouble attracting applicants for service on City Commissions as it is. On several recent occasions. interviews to fill commission vacancies had to be postponed because there were insufficient applicants. I have heard no justification for this arbitrary rule other than that City Councilmembers are limited to 12 years (three four year terms) so let's impose the same limits on commissioners. But term limits for Councilmembers were voted on by the voters. No such expression of a need for limits on Commission service has occurred

City Council Round Up

The Tuesday City Council meeting started with the surprise announcement that the City had decided to support the lawsuit brought by the American Civil Liberties Union and many others challenging the ICE raids as unconstitutional detentions and arrests without probable cause and as a result of racial profiling. The following statement from the Council was read:

"While the City of Beverly Hills supports enforcement of the law, we stand against any unconstitutional immigraWe are deeply concerned by allegations that federal agents have targeted individuals based solely on race or ethnicity, conducted raids and arrests without probable cause and used excessive force. As a diverse community including many immigrants, we join the mo-

tion enforcement actions.

tion to intervene." A number of residents, including Commissioner Rebecca Pynoos, had attended for the purpose of urging the intervention. Instead they expressed sincere appreciation and thanks for this action.

The Council then turned to a proposed ordinance which would have restricted

Proposed Building to Stand Six Stories

A proposal submitted to Beverly Hills city planners outlines plans for a new residential development at 416–418 North Maple Drive. The project would involve demolishing four existing multifamily buildings, which currently contain 13 residential units, to make room for a six-story apartment building with 70 units.

The application, filed in mid-June, appears on the city's current project list. Public records identify the appli-

the use of artificial turf in the front yards of residences. As a practical matter, the installation of artificial turf in front yards is not currently permitted because we are not in a severe drought. The Council concluded that no action was appropriate at this time.

The City in conjunction with the developer of the One Beverly Hills project has proposed the issuance of up to \$550M in bonds for a Community Facilities District(s). The bond proceeds are to be used for construction of infrastructure that the Developer has committed to provide as part of the project. The bonds are proposed to be repaid by the purchasers of residential and other properties on site through additional property taxes. It is also proposed that the Developer will pay the City \$10M which will in part be used to defray certain administrative costs that the City will incur. The Council voted 3-1 to present this proposal for a full hearing at the City Council meeting on August 19, 2025. Councilmember John Mirisch

The proposed development would be located one block north of another planned residential project-a 12-story, 65-unit tower at 346 North Maple Drive submitted under California's

Builder's Remedy provision. It is also situated near a city-owned parcel on 3rd Street designated for affordable housing for seniors.

In addition to the Maple Drive proposal, Lazer Properties is pursuing a separate project in Beverly Hills involving the construction of an assisted living facility on Clark Drive.

voted against this proposal because he stated that the City was not receiving sufficient consideration for the cost savings that this would provide for the Developer. Councilmember Craig Corman recused himself because he is a member of the neighboring Los Angeles Country Club.

The Council received a report from Fire Chief Greg Barton and Fire Marshall Trevor Richmond and adopted new Very High Fire Hazard Severity Zone Maps prepared by the state. These maps

have, for the first time, included all parts of the City north of Lomitas in the highest fire hazard severity zone.

Finally, the Council passed an ordinance that prohibits leases or subleases of all residential properties, including accessory dwelling units, in single family, multi-family or the mixed use overlay zones for periods shorter than one vear.

COMES NOW Plaintiff, YONA INVESTMENT GROUP, LLC, which hereby alleges as follows:

PARTIES 1. Plaintiff YONA INVESTMENT GROUP, LLC (hereinafter "YONA" or "Plaintiff") is, and at all relevant times hereto was, a limited liability company, formed and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware, and conducting business in the County of Los Angeles, and the holder of the Promissory Note which is the subject of within action.

2. Defendant DAVID ROSS (hereinafter "ROSS" or "Defendant") is, and at all relevant times hereto was, an individual residing in the County of Los Angeles, State of California.

3. Plaintiff is informed and believes, and based thereon alleges, that Defendants DOES 1 through 20, inclusive, are individually and/ or jointly liable to Plaintiff for the conduct al-leged herein. The true names and capacities, whether individual, corporate, associate or otherwise, of Defendants DOES 1 through 20, inclusive, are unknown to Plaintiff at this time. Accordingly, Plaintiff sues Defendants DOES 1 through 20, inclusive, by fictitious names and will amend this Complaint to allege their true names and capacities after they are ascertained. For ease of reference, the term "De-fendants" refers to all defendants, including DOES 1 through 20.

4. Plaintiff is informed and believes, and on that basis alleges, that except as otherwise alleged herein, each of the Defendants is, and at all times relevant to this Complaint were, the employee, agent, employer, partner, joint ven-ture, affiliate, and/or co-conspirator of the Defendants and, in doing the acts alleged herein, were acting within the course and scope of such positions at the direction of, and/or with the permission, knowledge, consent and/ or ratification of the other Defendants. In the alternative, Plaintiff is informed and believes, and on that basis alleges, that each Defendant, through its acts and omissions, is responsible for the wrongdoing alleged herein and for the damages suffered by Plaintiff.

JURISDICTION AND VENUE

5. This action is properly brought in this Court because the agreement which is the subject of this lawsuit was entered into in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, and the Defendant's place of business and residence is in

the County of Los Angeles, State of California. FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION BREACH OF PROMISSORY NOTE

(As Against All Defendants)

6. Plaintiff realleges and incorporates by reference paragraphs 1 through 5, inclusive, as though fully set forth herein.

On November 1, 2023, YONA provided a loan to ROSS, and in accordance therewith entered into a Promissory Note. The loan was in the amount of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000), and matured on February 1, 2024. A true and correct copy of the Promissory Note is attached hereto as Exhibit "A.

8. The loan was made and arranged by a li-censed California real estate broker, and therefore exempt from usury limitations. In addition, the loan that was provided to ROSS was not for personal, family or household purposes, but instead was a business purpose loan.

9. The Note provided for interest at the rate calculated of 34.4% per annum. In addition, all unpaid principal and interest was due and payable on the date of maturity. If the principal and interest amount of the loan was not timely paid, interest would be calculated upon and after the date of breach at the default rate of 44.34%, per annum.

10. YONA has performed any and all covenants, conditions and obligations required of it under the terms of the Note, except as otherwise excused or prevented.

11. Beginning on February 1, 2024, and con-tinuing thereafter, ROSS breached the terms of the Note by failing to pay the sum due on February 1, 2024. Thus, ROSS is in breach of the terms of the Note in the present amount of \$100,000, not including interest at the rate of 34.4% per annum, from November 1, 2023 to February 1, 2024, and thereafter increased to 44.4% percent per annum from the date of breach

12. YONA has made demand upon ROSS for all amounts due and owing under the terms of the Note, but despite such demand ROSS has failed and refused to tender payment.

13. There is currently due, owing and unpaid from ROSS on the Note the principal sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000), as of the filing of this lawsuit, plus interest at the rate of 34.4% interest per annum from November 1, 2023 to February 1, 2024, and after February 1, 2024, at the rate of 44.4% per annum, to the present, and according to proof at trial.

SECOND CAUSE OF ACTION COMMON COUNT - FOR MONEY LENT

(As Against All Defendants) 14. Plaintiff realleges and incorporates by reference paragraphs 1 through 13, inclusive, as though fully set forth herein.

15. Within the last year four years past, or on or about November 1, 2023, at Los Angeles, California, ROSS became indebted to YONA in the principal sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) for money lent by YONA to ROSS at his special insistence and request. 16. ROSS failed to repay the loan, in accor-dance with the installment payments as required, and there is, therefore, the principal sum of \$100,000 due and owing, and accrued interest thereon from the date such payment was due at 34.4% per annum from November 1, 2023 to February 1, 2024, and thereafter from and after February 1, 2024 at the interest rate of 44.4% per annum, but according to proof at trial.

THIRD CAUSE OF ACTION COMMON COUNT – MON-EY HAD AND RECEIVED (As Against All Defendants)

17. Plaintiff realleges and incorporates by reference paragraphs 1 through 16, inclusive, as though fully set forth herein.

18. On or about November 1, 2023 at Los Angeles, California, ROSS became indebted to YONA in the principal sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00), for money had and received by ROSS for the use and benefit of ROSS.

19. Although demand has been made, there is now due, owing and unpaid from ROSS to YONA the principal sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000), plus interest at the rate of 34.4% per annum from November 1, 2023 to February 1, 2024, and thereafter from and after February 1, 2024 at the interest rate of 44.4% per annum, but according to proof at trial

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff requests judgment against Defendant as follows: ON ALL CAUSES OF ACTION

1. For damages in the sum of \$100.000, plus pre-judgment interest thereon at the rate of 34.4% per annum from November 1, 2023 to February 1, 2024, and thereafter from and after February 1, 2024 at the interest rate of 44.4% per annum, but according to proof at trial;

2. For post-judgment interest;
