"OneBh Wants Financing— Should It Come From Us?" Issue 1347

I understand that questions have been raised in Beverly Hills about the establishment of a Community Facilities District in your City. I have read the opinion pieces and letters to the editor, and I want to take this opportunity to provide you with facts.

I was a principal co-author of what is now commonly called the Mello-Roos Community Facilities Act of 1982. It passed with overwhelming support in the State Legislature

When Senator Henry Mello and I crafted this legislation, our goal was to provide California's local governments with a flexible and robust mechanism to finance public infrastructure and services in a post-Proposition 13 era, yet preserving a 2/3 vote by the landowners in the district. We envisioned a tool that could support growth and enhance quality of life without burdening existing taxpayers and cities.

The beauty of Mello-Roos, and its enduring relevance, lies in its broad applicability. It allows for the funding of a vast array of public improvements like parks, roads, water, and sewer systems and other important services whether built by cities or developers.

Crucially, and this is a point I cannot stress enough, the Mello-Roos mechanism is designed to be entirely risk-free to the city's general fund, its existing property owners, and its residents. When a Community Facilities District (CFD) is formed, the special tax is levied only on the properties within that newly designated district – in your case, only within the boundaries of the One Beverly Hills development. This means:

- * No Impact on Existing Residents: Your current property owners will not see this special tax on their bills. The financial responsibility for the new infrastructure rests solely with the properties that are in the district
- * No Risk to the City's General Fund: The bonds are repaid directly by the special taxes collected within the CFD. They do not rely on the city's general revenue, nor do they create a liability for the broader city budget. This allows the city to maintain its fiscal health while still facilitating community improvements.

This is precisely how Mello-Roos was intended to function: as a responsible, self-funding pathway to progress. It empowers communities to invest in their future, enhance their amenities, and accommodate growth, all while safeguarding the financial interests of their long-standing residents.

I commend your City Council for considering this prudent and effective financial tool. Your approach is entirely consistent with the intent and protective nature of

Mello-Roos and it reflects a commitment to smart growth and fiscal responsibility that will benefit your community for generations to come.

August 19th agenda item: two words: Final approval? A \$550 million bond issuance by our City to help a developer? How is this even possible? Huge thank you to columnist Peter Ostroff, for his article or we, the residents of Beverly Hills, might not have heard about this until after the fact.

And thank you, Jeffrey Auerbach, for last week's Letter to the Editor. I totally agreed with his thoughtful argument until the end when he offered the suggestion of a loan. The City of Beverly Hills is not a financial institution, nor is it the City's responsibility. Why wouldn't every developer ask for it in the future? Or a business needing a cash infusion? Hell, I'm thinking about buying a new car...

That project is no more ambitious today than it was all those years ago when Oasis LLC desperately lobbied the community in a referendum, complete with an army of lobbyists, catered meetings and Tiffany party favors. The developer, the architect, and the financiers all knew the project needed infrastructure. Shucks, even I knew it needed infrastructure, and I'm just someone who enjoys the luxury of electricity and water running through my house.

So what's changed? Well, when I attended an earlier OBH iteration's dog and pony show, they were expecting that the six and seven bedroom condos they were building would attract wealthy foreigners, oligarchs, and such, and be used as a pied-â-terre, allegedly not impacting traffic and, wait for it, infrastructure. Another difference? Time has not been kind to this project. Construction costs have probably sky rocketed, with supply tariffs and unforeseen labor costs.

I do not see any upside for the residents in providing this bond. If there were an upside, we would have heard about it. So please, explain to me how this bond serves the residents?

I have been a resident of Beverly Hills for 43 years. As a retired actuary, finance is my area of expertise.

I have been following the Weekly's coverage of the One Beverly Hills (OBH) financing proposal currently under consideration by the Beverly Hills City Council. I oppose this scheme for the following reasons:

- 1) It has the appearance of a bait-andswitch. Why didn't OBH arrange for proper financing when they first received their original entitlements? If they currently can't get adequate financing, please explain why?
- 2) I am concerned about financial liability to the city if this project goes "belly up" (as was the case with one of the parcel's previous owners, the Wanda Group).
- 3) The \$10 million payment to the City seems inadequate given the windfall in tax dollars the developer will be receiving if this is approved.

For these reasons, I urge the Beverly Hills City Council to reject this ill-conceived proposal.

A typographical error omitted parts of the following letter in last week's issue, so we are re-printing it again in full below:

AN OPEN LETTER TO THE BEVER-LY HILLS CITY COUNCIL:

Dear Mayor and City Council Members, I am writing to express my profound concern and strong opposition to the City of Beverly Hills seriously considering the issuance of bonds not to exceed \$550 million to Oasis BH, LLC, the private real estate developer and owner of the One Beverly Hills (OBH) project at 9900 Wilshire Blvd. I have been a dedicated resident of Beverly Hills for over 27 years, and my son attended El Rodeo School, directly across the street from the OBH development site, for nine years from kindergarten through eighth grade.

I have watched this site, and the various iterations of this project, for decades.

Let me state unequivocally that I have long been a supporter of the One Beverly Hills development. I understand the city's long-standing frustrations with the many changes in ownership, developers, and the starts and stops that have plagued this significant site. I share in the collective enthusiasm for its eventual completion and the positive impact it could have on our city. My desire is for the city's contribution and assistance to be smart, fair, and above all, ethical.

However, the prospect of our city contributing and issuing bonds in the staggering amount of up to \$550 million to a private developer to merely reduce its financing costs and burden strikes me as highly reckless, inappropriate, suspect, and quite possibly illegal.

The City Council is being asked to facilitate a bond issuance not to exceed \$550 million for a private developer's infrastructure, a sum that is more than twice the City's entire annual operating budget for fiscal year 2025-26. While the developer proposes that the repayment of these bonds would be passed on directly to future condominium owners via special property assessments, this extraordinary financial accommodation, despite claims of 'no risk' to the City, carries significant latent dangers for all Beverly Hills residents and taxpayers. These include potential reputational damage to the City, risks to its credit rating, exposure to costly litigation in the event of defaults, developer bankruptcy, or financial restructurings, and the concerning precedent of using municipal power to effectively underwrite a private project with substantial indirect costs to our community.

As a former Vice President of the Philadelphia Eagles, I was deeply involved in the initial development of the team's new football stadium and training facility with the City of Philadelphia. I understand, firsthand, the concept of "public use" in the context of large-scale development. A football stadium, like the one I helped develop, serves a clear and undeniable public purpose: it is a facility where tens of thousands of people gather, generating

significant public engagement, tax revenue from events, and broad community benefit through shared experiences.

The proposed bond issuance for One Beverly Hills, as currently described, fails dramatically to meet any recognizable "public purpose" or "public good" that would justify such an immense public commitment. My understanding of legitimate public benefits for municipal bond financing, as outlined by established legal and financial principles, includes:

- Affordable Housing: If a significant portion of the OBH project were dedicated to addressing our city's dire need for affordable housing, there would be a clear public benefit. However, this is not the primary purpose of these luxury condominiums.
- Essential Public Infrastructure: Bonds are appropriately used for critical infrastructure that benefits the entire community, such as roads, water and sewer systems, public parks, or schools. While the OBH project may have some associated infrastructure, it is highly unlikely to justify a \$550 million bond issuance.
- Genuine Economic Development and Job Creation: While construction jobs are created, the long-term economic benefit to the broader public, beyond the sale of high-end condominiums, is not clearly defined in a way that warrants this level of direct financial aid to a private entity. The primary "public good" seems to terminate at the resident's purchase of a private condominium.

In its current form, this proposed bond issuance appears to be a direct subsidy to a private, for-profit venture, shifting the financial risk and burden from the developer, Oasis BH, LLC, onto the taxpayers of Beverly Hills. This is a dangerous precedent and a misuse of our city's financial standing

Alternatively, if the city's intention is genuinely to assist in the completion of this long-gestating development project and ensure its success, I would be in favor if any issued bond were structured as a 100% loan to Oasis BH, LLC, to be repaid to the city over a clearly defined number of years, with appropriate interest and penalties for default. This approach would demonstrate a responsible use of public resources, ensuring a return to the city while still facilitating the project's progress.

Please know I completely admire and support our City Council and the tremendous job you all do in running our beautiful community. While I normally would not interject my concerns in such a direct manner, I hope you understand the spirit in which I have expressed them. My deep commitment to Beverly Hills compels me to speak out on an issue of this magnitude.

Thank you for your time and consideration of these critical concerns. I would welcome the opportunity to discuss this matter further if you have any questions or require additional information.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on July 15, 2025, the City Council (the "City Council") of the City of Beverly Hills (the "City") adopted its Resolution No. 25-R-13554 (the "Resolution of Intention"), declaring its intention to form Community Facilities District No. 2025-1 of the City of Beverly Hills (One Beverly Hills) ("CFD No. 2025-1" or the "District") pursuant to the MelloRoos Community Facilities Act of 1982, as amended (the "Act"), to form two improvement areas within proposed CFD No. 2025-1 to be known as "Improvement Area No. 1 of Community Facilities District No. 2025-1 of the City of Beverly Hills (One Beverly Hills)" ("Improvement Area No. 1") and "Improvement Area No. 2 of Community Facilities District No. 2025-1 of the City of Beverly Hills)" ("Improvement Area No. 2" and together with Improvement Area No. 1 the "Improvement Areas"), and to levy a special tax (the "Special Tax") within each of the Improvement Areas for the purpose of financing certain Facilities, Services and Incidental Expenses (as such terms are defined below). CFD No. 2025-1 is proposed to have the boundaries depicted on the map therefor on file with the City Clerk.

Also on July 15, 2025, the City Council adopted its Resolution No. 25-R-13555 declaring its intention to incur bonded indebtedness to be issued by CFD No. 2025-1 in the maximum principal amount of \$100,000,000 for Improvement Area No. 1 and \$450,000,000 for Improvement Area No. 2 to finance the Facilities and Incidental Expenses, the repayment of which bonded indebtedness is to be secured by the Facilities Special Taxes.

Capitalized terms that are not otherwise defined herein shall have the respective meanings ascribed to them in the Resolution of Intention and the exhibits thereto.

The proposed "Facilities" to be financed by bond proceeds and/or the special taxes levied by or on behalf of the District include the construction, purchase, modification, expansion, rehabilitation and/or improvement of certain roadways and roadway improvements, tunnels, parks, biking trails, storm drains and basins, water and wastewater facilities (including, without limitation, domestic and non-domestic water facilities, wells, pre-treatment basins, infiltration basins, reservoirs, pipelines, storm and sewer drains and related infrastructure and improvements), wet and dry utilities, bridges and pedestrian bridges, traffic signals, and related infrastructure improvements, both onsite and offsite, all appurtenances and appurtenant work in connection with the foregoing (including utility line relocations and electric, gas and cable utilities), and any real property interests in the foregoing, and all appurtenances and appurtenant work in connection with the foregoing Facilities, including the cost of engineering, planning, designing, materials testing, coordination, construction staking, construction management and supervision for such Facilities.

The Facilities listed herein are representative of the types of improvements authorized to be financed by CFD No. 2025-1. Detailed scope and limits of specific projects will be determined as appropriate, consistent with the standards of the City. Addition, deletion or modification of descriptions of the Facilities may be made consistent with the requirements of the City Council, CFD No. 2025-1 and the Act.

The proposed "Services" to be financed by the special taxes levied by or on behalf of the District include but are not limited to the maintenance, repair, replacement and cleaning of certain roadways and publicly accessible botanical gardens.

The "Incidental Expenses" to be paid from bond proceeds and/or special taxes levied by or on behalf of the District include:

All costs, including (1) costs of engineering, planning and designing the Facilities; (2) all costs, including costs of the property owner petitioning to form CFD No. 2025-1, associated with the creation of CFD No. 2025-1, the issuance of the bonds, the determination of the amount of special taxes to be levied and costs otherwise incurred in order to carry out the authorized purposes of CFD No. 2025-1; and (3) any other expenses incidental to the construction, acquisition, modification, rehabilitation, completion and inspection of the Facilities.

The Resolution of Intention specifies a Rate and Method of Apportionment of Special Taxes for each of Improvement Area No. 1 and Improvement Area No. 2 (each

a "Rate and Method"). Each Rate and Method includes an initial Maximum Facilities Special Tax of \$7.64 per Non-Residential Square Foot and \$15.23 per Residential Square Foot for Fiscal Year 2025-26. The Maximum Facilities Special Tax rates for subdivided parcels will be apportioned in accordance with each Rate and Method. Each Rate and Method includes an initial Maximum Services Special Tax of \$1.91 per Non-Residential Square Foot and \$3.81 per Residential Square Foot. The foregoing rates for Fiscal Year 2025-26 increase on each July 1 beginning July 1, 2026, as set forth in each Rate and Method.

Mark Mead Cleared of Misconduct After Investigation by BHUSD

The Beverly Hills Unified School District (BHUSD) has announced the conclusion of an investigation into concerns raised about Mark Mead, Executive Director of School Safety. According to the district, the investigation found the claims to be unsubstantiated.

The investigation was conducted by a third-party firm and included witness interviews, a review of documentation, and analysis of security footage. Following this process, the district reported that no evidence supported the concerns raised, and Mead has been cleared of misconduct in connection with the matter.

Although BHUSD recently made structural changes within its administrative departments, district officials confirmed that Mead will remain with the district in a different role.

UCLA Reaches Settlement in Antisemitism Lawsuit

UCLA announced a settlement last Tuesday, resolving claims related to UCLA's handling of protest activity on campus in 2024. The lawsuit centered on concerns about antisemitism and campus safety.

As part of the agreement, UCLA will continue implementing measures designed to enhance the safety and well-being of Jewish students, faculty, and staff. The University will also contribute \$2.33 million to eight organizations dedicated to combating antisemitism and supporting the Jewish community at UCLA. These organizations include Hillel at UCLA, the Ac-

ademic Engagement Network, the Anti-Defamation League, and the Jewish Federation Los Angeles's Campus Impact Network.

Additionally, \$320,000 will be allocated to UCLA's Initiative to Combat Antisemitism. This campus initiative, launched in March by Chancellor Julio Frenk, aims to coordinate university-wide efforts to address and prevent antisemitism.

"Antisemitism, harassment, and other forms of intimidation are antithetical to our values and have no place at the University of California. We have been clear about where we have fallen short, and we are committed to doing better moving forward. Today's settlement reflects a critically important goal that we share with the plaintiffs: to foster a safe, secure and inclusive environment for all members of our community and ensure that there is no room for antisemitism anywhere on campus," said University of California Board of Regents Chair Janet Reilly. "As we build upon our systemwide efforts to further this goal, we remain steadfastly committed to cultivating an environment where all are afforded the opportunity to live, learn and teach safely and peacefully, no matter who they are, where they come from, or how they pray."

The Facts about the One Beverly Hills Community Facilities District

A recent op-ed incorrectly explained the proposed Community Facilities District for the One Beverly Hills project. We have asked the City to approve a Community Facilities District under the Mello-Roos Act of 1982. The Act was established to help developers finance the public improvements they're required to build while protecting the city from financial risk or liability for the improvements or the bonds issued by the District.

The bonds issued by the District are only paid back by the property owners in the Community Facilities District (the property owners of One Beverly Hills). The City has no liability for the bonds.

So here are the facts:

1. What is a Community Facilities District?

A Community Facilities District ("CFD") is a special taxing district created through the California Mello-Roos Act to assist with the financing of public improvements required for developments in the state. CFDs only involve properties that have elected to create the district and impose a special tax only on those properties electing to participate (and no other properties outside the boundaries of the CFD).

2. How many CFDs are there in

California?

There are over 1,500 active CFDs. Many billions of dollars in CFD bonds have been issued in California. CFDs are used by hundreds of cities, counties and other agencies. Irvine, Los Angeles, Orange County, Carlsbad, San Luis Obispo, San Francisco, San Diego, Santa Margarita, Anaheim, Long Beach, San Clemente are just a few of the places where CFDs have been created. The legality and constitutionality of Mello Roos/CFDs has been confirmed by California courts and the US Supreme Court.

3. Who is responsible for paying the Special Tax?

Only the property within the boundaries of the One Beverly Hills project site. No other properties in Beverly Hills are affected. In a CFD, the bonds are "land secured," meaning that the property owners in the CFD district are responsible for the payment of the special tax that is used to pay off bonds. No property owner outside of the CFD district has any responsibility for payment of the special tax.

4. Is this a giveaway of public funds?

No. These are <u>not</u> general obligation bonds of the City; they are not secured by any general funds of the City, and they are not repaid by any general funds of the City. The bonds are repaid solely from special taxes paid by property owners in the district. Taxpayers are not providing a subsidy or any public funding. The City's credit rating is not involved.

5. As a homeowner or business

owner in Beverly Hills, will my property tax bill go up if I do not live in the CFD district?

No, the CFD tax only applies to the property owners within the footprint of the One Beverly Hills project. The CFD does not affect taxes for any property outside the boundaries of the CFD.

6. Is there liability for the City if the project goes bankrupt?

No. The City has no financial liability, as the bonds are land secured and the purchasers of the bonds understand that (i) these bonds are non-recourse to the City, and (ii) the only collateral for these bonds is the property within the CFD district (in this case the One Beverly Hills project).

7. If OBH goes bankrupt, will my property tax bill go up?

No, your property tax bill is not affected by the CFD and will not go up in the event the property owners in the CFD district fail to pay the special tax.

8. How does the CFD benefit the residents of Beverly Hills beyond the project?

The One Beverly Hills CFD will provide an additional revenue stream for public infrastructure and ongoing maintenance, instead of relying on general city funds or raising taxes on existing property owners.

9. What public infrastructure is proposed to be funded by the CFD and how are they public?

The CFD will finance public infrastructure including street and sidewalk improvements on Wilshire and Santa Monica Boulevards, new and upgraded traffic signals, utility improvements, street trees, landscape, and the realignment of Merv Griffin Way.

10. Who maintains the public infrastructure being financed by the CFD?

The property owners of the One Beverly Hills project will fund the ongoing maintenance of the public infrastructure.

11. Has the City ever done a CFD?

Yes, the City formed a CFD for the "Business Triangle" in 2002 (CFD 2002-A). The City issued new bonds (refunding bonds) for this CFD in 2013.

12. Why was the CFD not part of the presentations made during entitlements?

Sources of funding are not known with certainty at the entitlement stage. Once entitlements are approved, a list of potential funding sources is refined. Cain explored a variety of funding sources, including the possibility of forming a CFD. As the project progressed into construction funding, the CFD was viewed as an important part of the project's funding (i.e., capital stack).

13. How is the City being paid for the costs it incurs?

The City is fully reimbursed for all costs incurred related to the CFD. The City's consultants and staff that provide ongoing work administering the CFD are paid from the special taxes that are levied and paid in the CFD.

These are the facts. Your property taxes will not go up. The City is protected from liability, and its credit rating is not affected. A CFD is not unusual or a giveaway of public funds

District 24 Senate Race

Our three term California State Senator Ben Allen from the 24th District will be "termed out" at the end of 2026 and the race to replace him has begun in earnest

The 24th District has a total population of approximately 1 million and includes the entirety of the City of Beverly Hills. It extends from West Hollywood to the east, then west through Calabasas then south to Malibu and much further south through most of Palos Verdes. It is a relatively affluent district with relatively engaged residents. Beverly Hills and nearby neighborhoods punch "above their weight" because of our involved residents. The 24th District was once represented by Beverly Hills Human Rights Commissioner Helena Rosenthal's grandfather, Hershcel Rosen-

The primary election will be held on June 2, 2026 (voting for three Beverly Hills City Council positions will also occur on that date). It is a non-partisan blanket election in which the top two vote-getting candidates (regardless of party) will advance to the general election which will occur on that date.

This is very early in the process and I do not have and do not intend to express any preference. My sole purpose is to inform about who the candidates are and, to some extent, their backgrounds and positions.

There are already at least ten announced candidates from all over the district. While this is a large number, it is not uncommon where there is no incumbent candidate

The candidates that I am aware of

- Eric Alegria Palos Verdes Peninsula USD Board member; former Mayor of Rancho Palos Verdes
- Ellen Evans President, Doheny-Sunset Plaza Neighborhood Council
- John Erickson West Hollywood City Councilmember, former Mayor; Vice Chair of the Contract Cities Association
- Brian Goldsmith Political consultant; journalist; aide to Rick Caruso
- Kristina Irwin Palisades Charter High School Board Trustee
- **Brittany McKinley** Member of the Los Angeles Human Relations Commission
- Mike Newhouse Member of the Los Angeles Planning Commission
- **Dr. Sion Roy** Santa Monica Community College Trustee; former chair of the Los Angeles County Medical Association
- Nico Ruderman Venice Neighborhood Council Commissioner

Notably, only Kristina Irwin is a Republican, all of the others are Democrats

Two of the more well-known locally are **Brian Goldsmith** and **John Erickson, Ph.D.** Mr. Goldsmith's family has been prominent in Beverly Hills for its leadership of City National Bank and the Bram Goldsmith Theater which is the principal venue at the Wallis Annenberg Center for the Performing Arts. The late philanthropist **Bram Goldsmith** was Brian's grandfather.

Mr. Goldsmith has an undergraduate degree from Harvard and a law degree from Stanford. He has never practiced law. He has just reported raising over \$1 Million in the second quarter of 2025, far more than any other candidate. Financial resources will matter greatly in this election and could be dispositive. He also reports that he has received endorsements from more than 115 community leaders across the district, including former LA Mayor Antonio Villaraigosa and longtime civic leader Rick Caruso and many prominent Beverly Hills residents...

Dr. Erickson has served for five years on the West Hollywood City Council including a term as Mayor. He has an undergraduate degree from the University of Wisconsin, Oshkosh (he is from Ripon, Wisconsin) and a Ph.D from Claremont in American Religious History. He is supported by four of the five Los Angeles County Supervisors including our Supervisor, Lindsay Horvath, US Senator Adam Schiff and former Beverly Hills Mayors Julian Gold and Lester Friedman. Importantly, he is the Vice President of the California Contract Cities Association through which he works with the elected officers of several of the cities in the District. Dr. Erickson has been a strong advocate for building housing in West Hollywood including promoting ministerial approval for large housing developments. This idea would not be popular in Beverly Hills. He assured me that he was a believer in local control and that what may be right for West Hollywood is not necessarily right for Beverly Hills.

Mike Newhouse is an attorney and community activist living in the Venice area and a member of the Los Angeles City Planning Commission. Newhouse says he has raised the second highest amount during Q2 of 2025, more than \$265K from more than 300 individual donors. Notably, Mr. Newhouse ran for the Los Angeles City Council in 2022 and finished fifth in the primary with less than 8% of the votes cast so he did not advance to the general election.

There are two candidates from other population centers in the District who appear to have substantial support.

They are **Dr. Sion Roy**, a physician, from Malibu/Santa Monica and **Eric Alegria** from Palos Verdes.

Dr. Sion Roy was the first to declare for the 2026 District 24 Senate Race. He is a cardiologist who practices at a UCLA hospital. He is the vice-chair of the Santa Monica College Board of Trustees, and a resident of Malibu. Roy has twice been elected with the support of the Santa Monica Democratic Club, Santa Monicans for Renters Rights and other progressive advocacy groups. Roy, like WeHo City Councilman John Erickson runs with previous backing from the UNITE HERE Local 11.

And the South Bay Cities are also represented by a local candidate, Eric Alegria. Mr. Alegria is a nonprofit executive and former Rancho Palos Verdes Mayor and educator who was elected to the Palos Verdes Peninsula Unified School District Board of Education when he termed out as a Rancho Palos Verdes City Councilmember.

The involvement of such an interesting group of candidates (and there could be more) promises a lively race.

As you may know, I have written quite a bit about the proposal to float up to \$550 Million in tax exempt City issue bonds to "reimburse" the One Beverly Hills (OBH) developers for certain costs that may be incurred as they perform their obligations to build out the project as contemplated in the Development Agreement and the entitlements that have been granted.

I may write more next week in advance of the Council meeting that will consider final approval on August 19.

At this point, I want to report that I have heard from dozens of Beverly Hills residents about this issue. I often hear from Beverly Hills residents about the opinions that I express. Some agree with me and others strongly disagree with me depending on what I have said. On the issue of whether the City should indulge in this bond issuance, no one, not a single person (who is not on the OBH payroll) has said to me that they think that this is a good idea.

BEVERLY HILLS RESPONDS TO BHPOA CLAIMS **AMID ONGOING LABOR NEGOTIATIONS**

As contract negotiations continue between the city and the Beverly Hills Police Officers Association (BHPOA), city officials released a statement on Saturday addressing what they described as inaccurate claims made by the union regarding compensation, staffing, and public safety.

According to the city, public safety in Beverly Hills remains a top priority, supported by a police department budget of \$117 million — a more than

\$30 million increase since 2020. Officials report that crime has declined across the city by an average of 20% year over year.

In the current negotiations, the city states it is offering BHPOA a fouryear agreement with a compensation increase exceeding 22%. Officials also noted that Beverly Hills Police Department (BHPD) officers are already among the most highly compensated law enforcement personnel in Cali-

fornia, with additional increases proposed.

The city acknowledged that recruitment challenges are affecting public safety agencies statewide but said it continues to use "innovative and creative" strategies to attract candidates.

City officials also said the BHPD's Crime Impact Team is fully staffed with undercover officers and that the Motor Unit currently includes two sergeants and at least six motor officers.

The city also refuted BHPOA's claim that Glendale Police Department officers earn approximately 10% more than their Beverly Hills counterparts, stating that even before any new raises, Beverly Hills officers receive higher total compensation.

The City also responded to BHPOA's comparison with Inglewood Police Department's recent four-year agreement, which includes a 33% salary increase. According to the City, Beverly Hills officers already earn more and would continue to do so each year under the current offer.

Additionally, officials addressed a BHPOA claim that Santa Monica officers make roughly 19% more than BHPD officers. The City says that with the current offer, the difference would be 6.29%

Regarding the METRO line, the City reported it is actively hiring more officers and coordinating with METRO and other law enforcement agencies in preparation for the opening of Beverly Hills stations. The La Cienega station is expected to feature a multi-million-dollar public safety center, which the city claims will be the first of its kind along the METRO commuter rail

On the topic of school safety, the city disputed BHPOA's assertion that there is only one School Resource Officer assigned to local schools, stating that two officers are currently serving campuses within Beverly Hills.

The city concluded its statement by reiterating its commitment to factbased discussions and collaborative negotiations.


OBITUARIES Rose Norton 1929-2025

Longtime South Rodeo Drive resident Rose Norton has passed away at

Norton was born in Orlando, Florida on June 29, 1929. At a young age, she moved with her family to New York and then to Los Angeles.

Known as a force of nature, Rose was raised by her mother and aunts – strong, no-nonsense Jewish women. She attended University High School and UCLA. Her college career was cut short by an early marriage, which produced her beloved son, Phil Savenick, a filmmaker and a 1969 Beverly High graduate, who passed away in 2024.

Rose was married for 55 years to former Beverly Hills Mayor Benjamin Norton, with whom she shared a love of Beverly Hills and civic engagement, until his death in 2010. During Ben's tenure as a City Councilmember and then as Mayor, Rose was known as the First Lady of Beverly Hills. She took great pride in her community and as a busy and vociferous member of the Planning Commission for eight years was passionate about the city's preservation. Rose ran unsuccessfully for



Beverly Hills City Council in 1986.

Rose's commitment to community service began when she joined the Nation-

al Council of Jewish Women at age 25. She was especially dedicated to one of NCJW's programs, El Nido Family Centers. She led the effort to establish El Nido, which serves underprivileged children, as an independent nonprofit, and served as its first board president.

Rose Norton is survived by her cousin Anthony Allina, his wife Christiane Schlumberger, his daughters Amy Allina and Crystal Kirkland, his grandchildren Niko Allina-Chambers, Eli Kirkland and Kaiya Kirkland, and by Suzanne Hertfelder, who was "better than a daughter."
