### "Beverly Hills Considers **Paramedic Subscription** Program to Offset **Emergency Medical Costs**" [Issue #1354]

The proposed city Paramedic Subscription Program, as reported in your last issue, seems like an interesting concept. Households with older people, or those with family members who have special medical needs, might benefit from such a program. As long as they don't call 911 too often. My question is, are only residential households offered this plan? For example, we live near the Sunrise facility, and there are ambulance calls day and night. Sometimes paramedics drop by the place several times a day. They should have a reserved parking space.

When the Sunrise developers first came before the city's Planning Commission, some years ago, nearby residents voiced concern that there'd be lots of disruptive ambulance calls. When asked about this, the applicant assured commissioners that Sunrise would have its own emergency transportation onsite. But did that ever happen? It seems to me that with all the paramedic calls Sunrise gets, if the city isn't already assessing a special fee, perhaps it should look into setting up an insurance plan for commercial users as well as residential households.

Also, if this subscription program takes effect, will the city be earning revenue on it, or is it a break-even plan designed merely to cover service costs? If a subscriber pays "x" amount of dollars a year but never calls the paramedics, or maybe calls them once every three years, where do those premiums go? How much of a fee or percentage does the plan administrator get? This insurance program sounds like something akin to a medical "concierge" plan. Extra revenue for the plan sponsor, but limited insurance benefits for subscribers.

### "Short Term Rentals"

Instead of handling their civic duties in a fair, principled, objective manner, Cultural Heritage Commissioner Lori Greene Gordon and Planning Commissioner Myra Demeter banded together with city gadfly Peter Ostroff to retaliate against those they do not like.

The trio became friends when they served overlapping terms on the Planning Commission when it appeared that Gordon and Demeter would rely on Ostroff to review complicated agendas and determine their position.

The conduct at hand involves the city

### **Mayor Highlights Local Businesses**

Mayor Sharona Nazarian visited local businesses as part of her spotlight initiative in partnership with the Beverly Hills Chamber of Commerce. Members of the community joined the event on Wednesday, September 10, which featured Pompadour, Le Reve Beauty Lounge, Castanea Sicilian Cafe, Beverly Hills Cookies, and Urth

council's proposed historic properties exception to the ban against short term rentals. Its purpose is to enable historic property owners to derive greater income from their guest houses to cover the increased expenses of maintaining their historic property. The exception was also designed to serve as an incentive for owners to landmark and preserve their historic properties.

At a time when Beverly Hills contemplates massive development projects that will transform the landscape of our city, preserving our historic architecture is vitally important.

Each council member voiced support for such an exception provided the property owner would reside on premises and would pay transient occupancy tax to the city. The council referred the matter to both the Cultural Heritage Commission and the Planning Commission for suggestions on how many days the minimum stay should be, should there be a limitation on the number of stays per year, etc.

The aforementioned trio determined to oppose the exception to retaliate against our longtime historic property owner, Deborah Blum, and your undersigned who supported the exception and rallied residents to support it.

Telltale signs of retaliatory decision making include the presentation of poor, irrational arguments, the making of inaccurate statements, and unusual adamance.

There are 18 historic landmarked homes in Beverly Hills which the exception would apply to, including an extraordinary 1914 Craftsman house at 801 N. Rodeo Drive owned by Blum and her husband. Blum has always been generous with her exceptional home, offering its use for city community meetings, including a celebration when John Mirisch was first elected, and a meet and greet for Lili Bosse. Her home was one of the first stops on the late Phil Savenick's

tour of historical Beverly Hills. She also offered her home for the first residents' meeting to oppose the Cheval Blanc project.

Ostroff has expressed in his BH Weekly editorials on more than one occasion, his upset over the loss of the Cheval Blanc project as well as his disdain for community leaders and groups comprised of residents who work to preserve quality of life in the city. Ostroff does not like Blum because she worked to defeat the Cheval Blanc project, and nor does he like your undersigned because I led the residents' campaign against Cheval Blanc. Also, when he was promoting the mixed use ordinance, I exposed that he was concealing the fact that developers would be entitled to greater height and reduced parking due to the application of the State Density Bonus Program.

Ostroff urged the rejection of the historic property short term rental exception in two separate BH Weekly editorials; he appeared at a Cultural Heritage Commission meeting; and he wrote in to a Planning Commission Meeting. No doubt he also coordinated with his two pals who would be deciding the issue.

In his September 4 Beverly HIlls Weekly editorial, he demonstrated his hostility toward Blum by unnecessarily mentioning her name, and indicating in an insulting manner that she "wants to raise cash by offering very short term (two nights) rentals" even though she never sought a two night rental term. He also referred to the historic exception as the "Blum exception" even though it would apply to 18 historic homes.

It has never been questioned that historic houses are more expensive to maintain because one must locate materials consistent with the original construction, employ historic experts, and hire special craftsmen. Nevertheless, Ostroff stated that the exception should be rejected because there was no evidence that land-

marked houses are more expensive to maintain.

If Ostroff would have simply asked ChatGBT, he would have confirmed that historic homes are more expensive to maintain as well as an explanation why.

At a September 3 Cultural Heritage Commission meeting, Gordon's statements were particularly troublesome because as the chair of the commission, she expressed that she did not understand why a historic property should receive benefits that other property owners will not receive. Staff had to explain to her that historic property owners generally receive special benefits.

Gordon also stated that the reason she thought the historic exception was unfair was because the proposed ordinance did not indicate it was designed to incentivize other property owners to landmark their properties, which was quite obvious.

Although commissioners often feel obligated to support the views of fellow commissioners when adamant, other Cultural Heritage Commissioners had no difficulty in supporting the incentive that the proposed historic exception would create.

Like Ostroff and Gordon, Demeter, at the September 11 Planning Commission meeting falsely claimed that the historic exception would only benefit Blum ignoring 15 other historic homes and that the exception would incentivize others to landmark their homes.

Demeter's troubling comments indicated that she didn't really have an understanding of the issues, including how more people landmarking their properties would help the city. Staff had to explain to her that there was an inherent value in landmarking and preserving historic structures in the city because it contributes to the character of the city and reminds visitors of the history of the city.

Demeter said that there are hundreds of structures in the city which are near 100 years old, and they all cost a lot to maintain, as if it was unfair for them not to be able to rent short term. She failed to realize that if their owners would landmark, preserve, and maintain their properties, they would be entitled to the same exception.

A planning commissioner sitting next to Demeter had a former colleague who was able to stay in a Greene & Greene House in Pasadena, which was a big highlight for him, so she understood how people would enjoy staying at a historic property. However after she and Demeter appeared to exchange notes, she aligned with Demeter.

When asked, Jeff Wolfe, chair of the Planning Commission, falsely stated that the council members had not supported the exclusion. He also explained that he had been opposed to the short term rental ban, but he would oppose the exception to honor the council's ban on short term rentals. One would think that if someone was against a short term rental ban, they would want to allow as

many exceptions as possible.

The matter should return to the city council at which time we trust that our council members will continue to handle the matter fairly as they initially did.

### Attorney Delivers Ceaseand-Desist Letter to BHUSD Board Over Public Comment Violations

At its Sept. 9 meeting, the Beverly Hills Unified School District Board received a cease-and-desist letter from attorney Daniel Lifschitz, a BHU-SD parent, alleging procedural violations during board meetings. Lifschitz claimed the board has repeatedly failed to provide the public an opportunity to comment on agenda items before taking action, as required under California Government Code Section 54954.3.

Under this law, members of the public must be allowed to speak on the substance of each agenda item, and the obligation refreshes whenever the board substantially changes an item. Lifschitz argued that the board has allowed public comment on initial proposals, then substantially revised and passed those proposals later in the same meeting, effectively denying residents a chance to address the final version before it is approved.

He cited specific instances, including resolutions on standards-based instructional environments, anti-Semitism, and flag bans, as examples of this practice. Lifschitz emphasized that California law allows legal action against boards that violate public comment requirements. His letter requested a formal commitment from the board to follow public comment rules moving forward and to refrain from voting on substantially revised items in the same meeting in which changes occur.

### City Hosts Annual Day of Wellness at Roxbury Park

The city held its third annual Day of Wellness on Sunday, September 14, at Roxbury Park and Community Center. The event was presented in collaboration with the city's Community Services Department, Human Relations Commission, Recreation and Parks Commission, and Health and Safety Commission.

Scheduled workshops and demonstrations covered a wide range of topics, including yoga, tai chi, meditation, dance-based fitness, chair yoga, and pilates.

### Planning Commission Rejects Short-Term Rental Exemption for Historic Landmarked Homes

The Beverly Hills Planning Commission reviewed a draft ordinance Thursday that would have allowed short-term rentals at historic landmarked properties in single-family residential zones, but the proposal was rejected.

The ordinance, originally drafted following the City Council's adoption of new short-term rental regulations on September 5, 2025, sought to create an exemption for landmarked homes. The city's updated rules prohibit short-term rentals in both single-family and multi-family housing, defining them as leases or subleases of fewer than 12 consecutive months. The regulations also require all residential leases to begin with a minimum one-year term and establish fines for violations, including advertising properties as short-term rentals

The draft ordinance considered by the Planning Commission would have allowed short-term rentals in accessory structures such as guest houses or accessory dwelling units, with property owners required to reside on-site. Rentals would have had a two-night minimum stay, though commissioners had the option to adjust that requirement.

The Cultural Heritage Commission reviewed the proposal on September 3, offering mixed feedback. Some members supported the exemption as an incentive to help maintain historic properties, while others expressed concerns about impacts on neighbors, fairness to non-landmarked homeowners, and potential wear on historic structures. Suggestions included extending the minimum rental period or limiting the total number of rentals per year.

At Thursday's meeting, some Planning Commissioners supported the

idea as a preservation incentive, but the motion to approve a resolution recommending the draft ordinance to the City Council failed, with a 3-2 vote against.

City staff said they will provide an update to the City Council at a future hearing, with the date yet to be determined.

### City Council Approves Tree Replacement Plan on South Santa Monica Boulevard

The Beverly Hills City Council approved a plan to plant Mexican Fan Palm trees on currently vacant sites along the 9800-9900 blocks of South Santa Monica Boulevard. The council also approved using Mexican Fan Palms to replace Ficus trees in the future when they decline or become structurally unstable.

According to staff reports, the Ficus trees in this section of the boulevard have caused repeated damage to public and private infrastructure due to their invasive root systems. Past root cutting and infrastructure repairs resulted in the loss of 18 trees, roughly 45% of the original 40 trees in the area. Officials noted that continued growth of remaining Ficus trees could lead to additional infrastructure issues and further tree loss.

The Mexican Fan Palm has previously been used successfully in nearby sections of South Santa Monica Boulevard and is considered suitable for narrow commercial setbacks where larger canopy trees may not thrive. Staff and the Public Works Commission determined that expanding sidewalks or tree wells to accommodate non-palm trees would negatively affect parking and traffic flow.

The project will begin with planting 14-foot-tall Mexican Fan Palms in vacant sites. Existing Ficus trees will remain until they decline or require removal for infrastructure repair. Regular

maintenance will be provided for both tree types.

The estimated cost for installing 18 Mexican Fan Palms is approximately \$42,000. Funding will come from the City's existing Capital Improvement Program allocation for the Street Tree Master Plan, which also covers future Ficus tree replacements as needed.

### City Council Receives First Annual Report on Retail Queueing Program

The Beverly Hills City Council reviewed the first annual report on the city's retail queueing program, which allows businesses to set up customer lines on public sidewalks under a minor encroachment permit. The program was originally approved on July 2, 2024, and uses provisions from the city's Open-BH program to control customer flow through stanchions and other temporary installations.

The report was provided for informational purposes, and no further action was required by the City Council.

The report covers the period from the program's start through August 31, 2025. During this time, five retail queueing permit applications were submitted and are currently being processed. Code Enforcement has been monitoring commercial areas to ensure compliance and address any businesses operating without permits.

Staff reported that retail queueing remains most requested by luxury goods retailers seeking to manage customer flow and address security concerns. No adverse impacts to nearby properties or businesses have been identified. The program is intended to provide a standardized process for orderly queue management

### City Council Approves Delegates for CalCities Annual Conference

The City Council approved designating officials to represent the city at the League of California Cities (CalCities) Annual Conference, scheduled for October 8-10, at the Long Beach Convention Center. Mayor Sharona Nazarian was approved as the city's Voting Delegate, Vice Mayor John Mirisch as the Alternate Voting Delegate, and Deputy City Manager Keith Sterling as the second Alternate Voting Delegate.

The CalCities Annual Conference provides sessions, workshops, networking opportunities, and an interactive Expo for city officials. A key component of the event is the General Assembly meeting on Friday, October 10, 2025, where member cities may vote on resolutions establishing CalCities' policies for the upcoming year. This year, no policy resolutions have been submitted for consideration.

Under new procedures, cities no longer need to pass a formal resolution to designate voting delegates. Instead, an online form attesting to Council approval must be submitted by September 24, 2025.

### Beverly Hills Highlights Emergency Preparedness During National Preparedness Month

The Beverly Hills City Council received an update on the City's National Preparedness Month initiatives, which take place each September to encourage residents, businesses, and schools to prepare for emergencies. The program emphasizes disaster planning, mitigation, and public awareness.

This year's theme, "Creating a Culture of Preparedness," focuses on encouraging community members to take steps to protect themselves, their families, and their neighbors during disasters. According to an informational update on the Council agenda, planning ahead can reduce the impact of major emergencies and shorten recovery times, particularly in cases where local resources may be overwhelmed. Residents are advised to be self-sufficient for at least seven days and to store enough water for up to 14 days.

The 2025 campaign includes information on preparing for extreme weather events, such as windstorms, floods, heat waves, and winter storms.

Public outreach efforts this month include banners at City streets and facilities, cable TV announcements, and information booths at the Senior Health Fair on September 22.

The report was provided for informational purposes, and no action was required by the City Council.

### Wallis Annenberg Legacy Foundation Receives \$10 Million Gift to Fund Signature Initiatives

The Wallis Annenberg Legacy Foundation announced a \$10 million donation intended to support four of its ongoing projects, following the death of founder Wallis Annenberg in late July. The foundation stated that the gift represents its first major philanthropic initiative since her passing.

According to the foundation, the funds will be allocated to the Annenberg Community Beach House in Santa Monica, student internships at Wallis Annenberg Hall at the University of Southern California, free and low-cost performances at the Wallis Annenberg Center for the Performing Arts in Beverly Hills, and the Wildlife Crossing Fund in Agoura Hills

The foundation also plans to continue funding two existing projects: Wallis Annenberg GenSpace, a program for older adults, and Wallis Annenberg PetSpace, an animal adoption center with community programming.

Board members of the foundation released statements noting that they intend to continue Annenberg's initiatives, emphasizing the expansion of the foundation's work beyond her lifetime.

Representatives from the organizations receiving the grants outlined how the funds would be used. The Beach House plans to maintain its public access, the performing arts center intends to continue offering performances, USC will support student internships, and the Wildlife Crossing Fund will advance connectivity projects for wildlife.

### Beverly Hills to Host "The Great Outdoors at Greystone" Event

The City of Beverly Hills Community Services Department will hold The Great Outdoors at Greystone on Saturday, September 20, from 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at Greystone Mansion & Gardens.

The event coincides with the anniversary of Greystone Mansion's designation as a public park. The estate, which covers 18 acres above Sunset Boulevard, was dedicated as a city park in September 1971. The month also marks the anniversary of when the Doheny family first moved into the mansion in 1928

Activities planned for the event include live music, poetry displays and readings, Ikebana (Japanese flower arrangement) demonstrations, art projects, and sustainability information. A poetry component will feature fifteen selected poems along Cypress Lane, with a reading scheduled for 3:15 p.m. This year's open call for submissions received over 50 entries.

The day's schedule includes:

- 11:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m.: Live music
- 11:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m.: Custom poetry with Brian Sonia-Wallace
- 12:30 p.m.-2:00 p.m.: Ikebana demonstration with Gabriel Pacheco
- 11:00 a.m.–4:00 p.m.: Tours of the Greystone Demonstration Garden, art projects, Poetry Lane, sustainability booth, and shuttle transportation

# Beverly Hills Sees 3.8% Increase in 2025 Property Assessment Roll

The Los Angeles County Assessor's Office announced the 2025 Assessment Roll, showing continued growth in property values across the county, including Beverly Hills. The roll, closed as

of June 30, 2025, reflects assessed values for all real estate and business property in Los Angeles County.

Countywide, the 2025 Assessment Roll totals \$2.176 trillion, marking the 15th consecutive year of growth. This represents an

increase of \$1.76 billion, or 3.91%, over 2024. The assessed values provide the basis for property taxes that fund public services such as healthcare, police, fire, schools, and libraries.

In Beverly Hills, the taxable value of property for 2025 is \$48.59 billion, a 3.8% increase from 2024. The city's roll includes 8,236 single-family homes, 1,116 apartment complexes, and 840 commercial-industrial parcels, totaling 10,192 taxable properties.

The Assessment Roll covers 2,398,007 real estate parcels countywide and includes business property assessments. It counts 1,897,905 single-family homes, 251,236 apartment complexes, and 248,866 commercial and industrial properties, along with over 160,367 business property assessments.

Contributors to the increase in the roll include property sales, which added \$51 billion, cost-of-living adjustments mandated by Proposition 13 adding \$41 billion, and new construction adding \$8 billion.

According to Assessor Jeff Prang, the roll reflects ongoing property value growth despite recent challenges such as the January wildfires. The Assessor's Office provides a full breakdown of assessment growth and parcel counts for all cities and unincorporated areas on its website

### **Builder's Remedy/New Housing Law/Political** Violence

I have heard a lot about Leo Pustilnikov and his efforts to develop five "builder's remedy" projects in the City including his trial court victory ordering the processing of his project on Linden Drive. I was pleased that he agreed to speak with me on September 12 about the status of his plans.

Notably, Mr. Pustilnikov says that he is not a real estate developer but, rather, is a real estate investor with a focus on "complex situations." And like it or not, that's what we have

Mr. Pustilnikov has taken a very aggressive approach to applications for entitlements. He says that he wants the City to "work with him" but that Beverly Hills has fought his applications every step of the way. His stated position is that the more the City fights his projects, the larger the projects will become and the greater the City's potential liability will be.

Under California's Housing Accountability Act and its builder's remedy provision, multifamily projects that provide a % of affordable units may bypass a City's zoning rules unless the City has adopted a Housing Element of its General Plan that has been certified by the state as compliant with the law. The City's Housing Element was certified in early 2024 and applications for projects for which a Preliminary Application had been submitted prior to that time are eligible for builder's remedy treatment.

Mr. Pustilnikov filed the first Beverly Hills builder's remedy application in 2022 for a project on Linden Drive. He currently has applications for five builder's remedy projects in Beverly Hills.

The projects with # of stories, units and parking spaces are as follows:

Recently, Mr. Pustilnikov has announced, but not yet filed an application with the City, that the Linden project will be increased from 19 stories and 200 feet tall to 36 stories, 400 feet tall. It seems likely to me that he will amend the other applications to increase height and density. This is consistent with his theme that the more the City delays approvals, the bigger the projects will become.

does not "work with him" he will sue to invalidate the state's certification of the City's Housing Element. If successful, this will, in theory, re-open the window for more large builder's remedy projects. He points out that he has obtained a tentative court ruling that the Redondo Beach Housing Element was improperly certified and will do the same with the Beverly Hills Housing Element. I have reviewed the court ruling that he is relying on and the alleged Redondo Beach defects are not in any way applicable to the Beverly Hills certified Housing Element. So I asked him: "On what basis would you challenge the Beverly Hills Housing Element. He refused to say, stating only "That's for me to know." Fair enough but I cannot take seriously unexplained threats.

It appears that, with Mr. Pustilnikov's recent victory in which the court ordered the City to process the Linden Drive application, he is sitting in the catbird's seat holding all the cards. (As you know, I love cliches.) So, why the threats? Why is it so important that the City "work with" him (translation: negotiate)?

There are several possible reasons. First, the California legislature is in the latter stages of passing Senate Bill 838.

His bigger threat is that if the City

If this passes, it will have retroactive applicability and render projects that have a hotel component, as does the Linden Drive project, ineligible for builder's remedy status. At a minimum, it will rule out the hotel and, perhaps, disqual-

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was revised into a two-act version in 2017.

Further, there is a serious question as to whether any of these projects as proposed will be financially viable. Costs of construction and interest rates have risen sharply in recent years. Moreover, there are aspects of all of these proposals that affect their financial viability. While, under

state law, the City cannot require that any of these projects provide parking, that doesn't mean that there will be great interest in acquiring or renting a unit in a building that doesn't offer parking spaces. Notably, Mr. Pustilnikov's Hamilton Drive project proposes 13 parking spaces for 90 residential unit occupiers and their guests. The Maple Drive, Tower Drive and Oakhurst Drive projects are not much better. When I pointed this out to Mr. Pustilnikov, he shrugged it off, stating: "In five years everyone will be riding Waymos." Maybe so.

Builder's remedy projects, and even density bonus projects for that matter, must have a specified % of affordable housing units on-site. None of the recently constructed or under construction luxury housing developments have affordable units on site because of a perception that purchasers of multimillion \$

Units do not want to share their space with low income residents. Absent some accommodation from the City, allowing the affordable units to be off-site, whether or not the builder's remedy window is open, placing the affordable units offsite will not happen.

My conclusion is that the City continues to hold some important "cards". While it is possible that some of the builder's remedy projects in some form or another may be built, in order to keep such construction to reasonable levels, it will be important that our City leaders not be unduly risk averse.

Last week, the California legislature passed and sent to the Governor another significant "housing" bill, SB 79, further eroding local control over land use. Most observers believe that the Governor will sign this bill into law.

It's purpose is to increase height and density for housing projects near certain transit stops. Most significantly for the City are provisions that pertain to the new La Cienega and Reeves/Beverly Metro subway stations. Under SB 79, height limits are increased to 9 stories adjacent (sharing a border) to the stations, 7 stories within a 1/4 mile of the station and 6 stories between 1/4 and 1/2 mile from the stations. Density is increased to 120 units/acre and a 3.5 Floor Area

Ratio (square footage of the structure may be 3.5x the lot size).

Significantly, these rules allow for such development not only in areas zoned for multifamily residential, mixed use or commercial uses. This could result in a significant change by allowing residential development in the Triangle or on Wilshire Blvd. now zoned solely for commercial use. For a number of reasons, the City has precluded any residential development in the Triangle.

There is some question as to whether these rules apply to property zoned for single family residential uses but it is likely that it does.

Similar to other recent enactments, there is a requirement for affordable units of 7% extremely low income, 10 % very low income or 13 % low income.

While the state density bonus laws apply to projects allowed under SB 79. importantly, there is a cap that limits height to the levels allowed by the act and does not require a local authority to grant density bonus law increases in height beyond what the applicable SB 79 limit permits.

I have touched upon some of the highlights of this legislation. Undoubtedly, there will be numerous complexities to be worked through. But it is fair to say that this new law, if and when enacted, could have a significant impact on the

'What we as a culture have to get back to is being able to have a reasonable disagreement, where violence is not an option."

This advice should be an important part of Mr. Kirk's legacy.

# CITY COUNCIL APPROVES LA CIENEGA PARK PLAYGROUND **IMPROVEMENTS**

### By Danielle Berjikian

The Beverly Hills City Council has approved a proposed playground improvement project at La Cienega Park. The approval allows the project to move forward to the bidding phase, with a formal construction agreement to be presented to the Council at a later date.

The project, aimed at updating the park's 12,400-square-foot playground, follows a city-led community feedback

process. A survey conducted last year gathered more than 570 responses from residents and park users, shaping the preliminary design.

The approved plans feature an abstract natural landscape playscape with rubber "hills" connecting multiple age-specific play zones. Equipment for toddlers and young children includes spring riders and parent-child swings, while old-



er children will have access to slides, swings, and rotating play structures. The design also includes a "riverbed" of concrete pebbles leading to a small performance stage, which could host outdoor youth programming.

Safety and accessibility were key considerations. The playground will be fully fenced, include ADA-accessible ramps,

and use poured-inplace rubber surfacing. Shade is provided through a combination of trees, canopies, sail shades, and rigid structures over the performance stage. Features intended to deter skateboarding are also incorporated.

The playground equipment will be supplied by Kompan, a manufacturer previously used in Roxbury Park. City officials

note that most items could be repurposed in the future as part of a broader master plan for La Cienega Park.

No immediate fiscal impact is associated with the project. The next step is for the City to solicit bids, after which a construction agreement will be presented to the Council.



### **Architectural Review Scheduled for Proposed Seven-Story Mixed-Use Building on La Cienega**

The Architectural and Design Review Commission was expected to hold a discussion on Wednesday regarding a proposed seven-story, 140-unit mixed-use building at 55 North La Cienega Boulevard. The meeting took place after The Weekly's deadline.

The project would replace an existing one-story commercial building and adjacent surface parking lot. The proposal includes three levels of subterranean parking, rooftop and common outdoor spaces, and landscaping.

The Planning Commission initially reviewed and conditionally approved the project on March 13, 2025, along with a Development Plan Review and Density Bonus. A subsequent de novo hearing before the City Council on July 1, upheld the approval with additional conditions addressing privacy, noise, and permitted uses for residential balconies and rooftop areas. Concessions and waivers from certain development standards, including building height, number of stories, setbacks, and outdoor living area requirements, were granted under State Density Bonus Law for providing deed-restricted affordable housing.

The proposed building is designed in a contemporary style, featuring white marble tiles, smooth-finish stucco, tempered glass balconies, custom aluminum windows and storefronts, and illuminated aluminum address signage. Landscaping is planned along the rear property line, rooftop, and common outdoor spaces, including drought-tolerant plants and a 20-foot hedge intended to provide privacy for neighboring resi-

Ground-floor commercial space will feature recessed glazing accessible to public sidewalks, designed to accommodate pedestrian activity and outdoor

### **BHPD Highlights Child** Passenger Safety Week, Sept. 21–27

The Beverly Hills Police Department is participating in Child Passenger Safety Week, a national campaign running September 21–27 to promote proper use

of car seats, booster seats, and seat belts for children.

"Every child deserves to travel safely," Beverly Hills Police Chief Mark Stainbrook said. "During Child Passenger Safety Week, we urge all parents and caregivers to know for sure that their children are in the right seats and that those seats are installed correctly. Keeping a child in the right seat for their age and size can make all the difference in a crash."

According to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHT-SA), 46% of car seats are used incorrectly. Research cited by NHTSA shows that correctly installed car seats can reduce the risk of fatal injury in crashes by 71% for infants under one year old and 54% for children ages one through

California law requires children under 2 years old to ride in a rear-facing car seat unless they weigh at least 40 pounds or are 40 inches tall. Children under 8 years old must be secured in a car seat or booster seat in the back seat. Those 8 years and older, or at least 4 feet 9 inches tall, may use a booster seat or seat belt but must be secured at all times

Officials recommend parents and caregivers keep children in rear- or forward-facing seats for as long as possible based on the seat's size limits. Families can also use the "Five-Step Test" to help determine when a child is ready to use a seat belt without a booster.

### BHHS Football Team Set To Play Home Opener Friday

The Beverly High football team is scheduled to play its home opener Friday night, playing host to Nordhoff at Nick-oll Field in a nonleague game beginning at 7 p.m., seeking its first on-field victory since Sept. 6, 2024.

"A big victory for us would just be to play with passion and the desire to finish every play," Norman coach Hasan Muhammad said.

The team's level of passion had had "ebbs and flows," Muhammad said.

"At times we've looked like a team that's right on the brink of crossing the winning threshold and then there are times when I didn't see the level of competition that we need at the varsity level," Muhammad said.

Beverly Hills lost at Boron, 54-0, Friday, dropping to 0-3 with its10th consecutive on-field loss dating back to last season

"Boron was a tough opponent," Muhammad said of the Bobcats (2-1). "Anytime you take a school ... and have to travel 3 ½ hours that in itself is a kind of a buzz kill."

Muhammad described Boron as "a team that's been together basically since they started Pop Warner Football.

"They were polished," Muhammad

Norman sophomore quarterback Luca Brenner was sidelined after suffering what was later diagnosed as a hip injury in the first quarter.

"It was just a tough team to improvise against on the fly," Muhammad said.

Beverly Hills was outgained 381 yards to 15, with all of the Normans' yardage coming on the ground.

Brenner was 0-for-5 before being injured, according to statistics posted on the high school sports website, Maxpreps.

Bobcats senior quarterback Jalen York was 2-for-2 for 107 yards and two touchdowns and ran three yards for a touchdown on his only carry.

Boron sophomore quarterback Jaxon Carter completed his only pass for a 26-yard touchdown to junior tight end Deegan Per-

kins and ran for two touchdowns.

Following seven consecutive losses, Beverly Hills ended the 2024 season with a forfeit victory over Morningside which did not have enough players. Morningside closed as planned following the conclusion of the 2024-25 school year because of declining enrollment.

The Normans are 368th among 375 Southern Section in the computerized rankings compiled by HSRatings.com which are used to determine playoff divisions. Nordhoff (3-1) is ranked 272nd after three consecutive victories following a season-opening loss.

HSRankings.com projects a 58-7 victory for the Rangers, which it gives a more than 99% chance of winning.

Brenner threw two touchdown passes and senior Kyle Boardley-Wise returned a kickoff 72 yards for a score for the Normans in their season-opening nonleague loss at Vasquez Aug. 22.

The Mustangs took a 20-0 lead in the first quarter following 2- and 14-yard touchdown runs by senior running back Jayden Lopez and an 82-yard touchdown run by senior quarterback Zack Van Orum.

Beverly Hills' first points came on a 35-yard pass from Brenner to junior Aiden Gecovich with about one minute left in the quarter.

Isaiah Sanchez ran 1 yard for a touchdown for Vasquez following a blocked punt midway through the second quarter, increasing its lead to 32-7.

Boardley-Wise returned the ensuing kickoff for a touchdown.
